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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a charging dock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, rear, right side perspective view of a first embodiment of a charging dock, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a top, rear, right side perspective view of the charging dock of FIG. 1, shown in a condition of use; and, FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a charging dock.

The broken lines in each of FIGS. 1, 4-7, and 9 show portions of the charging dock that form no part of the claimed design.

The broken lines in FIG. 8 show unclaimed environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

The second embodiment of the charging dock is identical to the first embodiment except that the second embodiment is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

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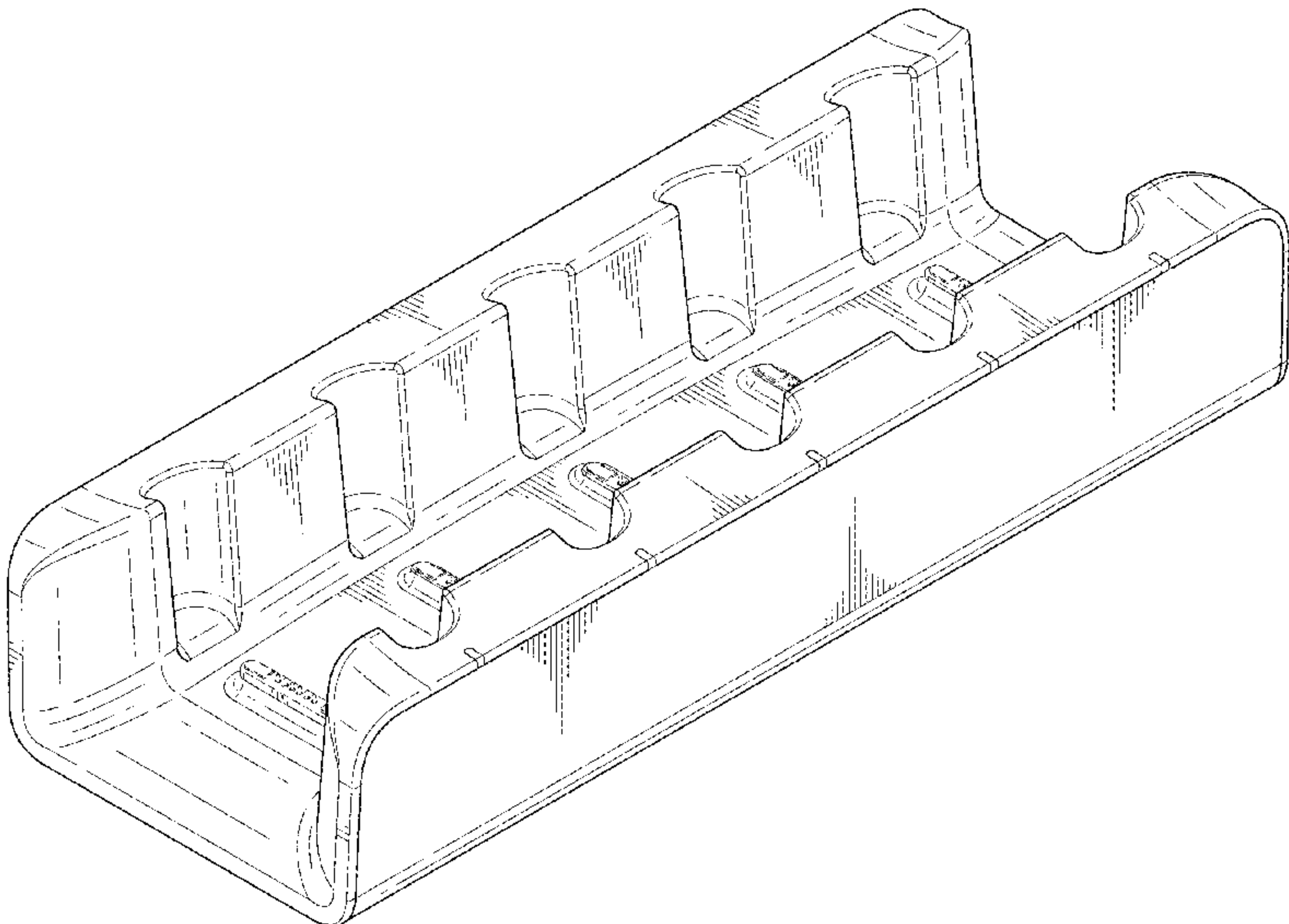

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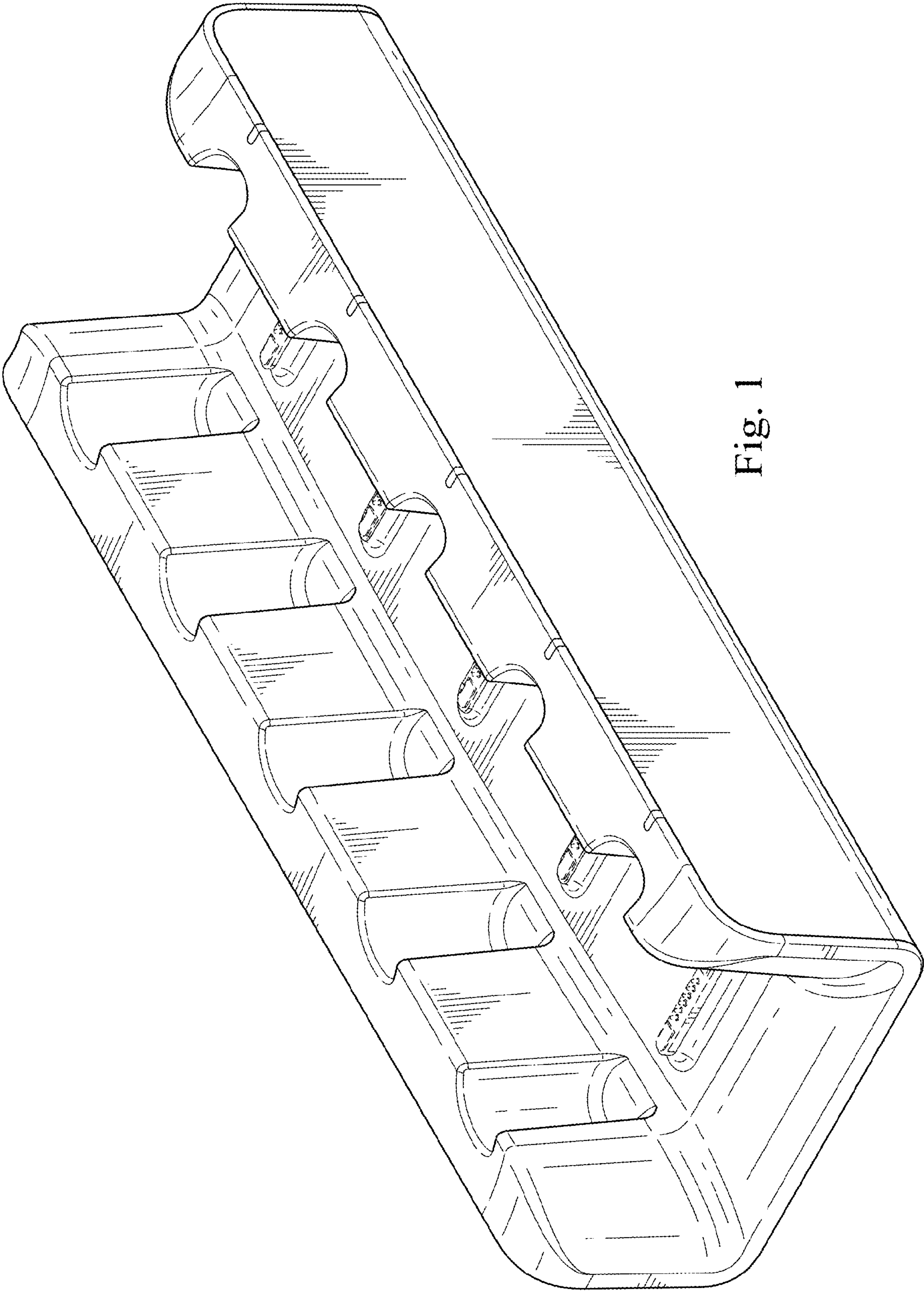

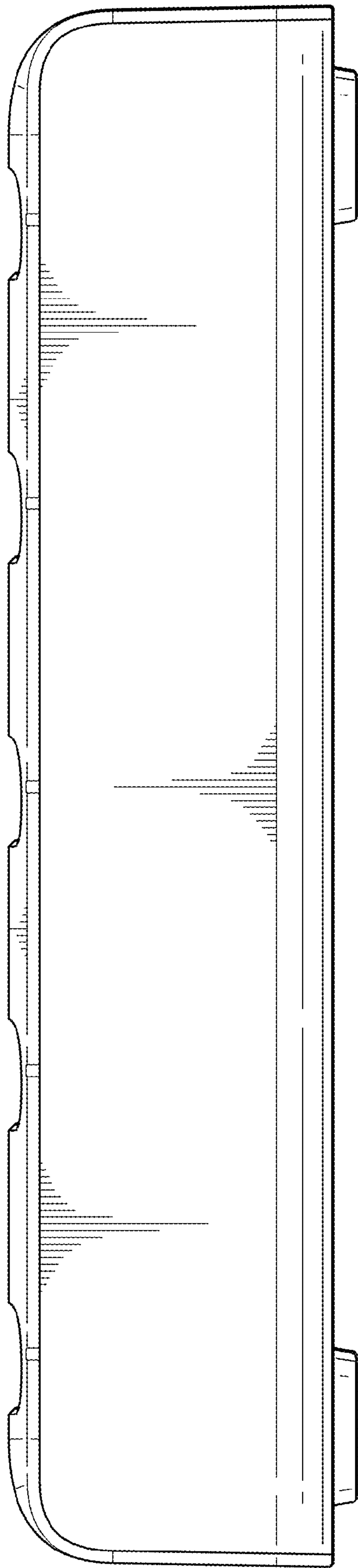

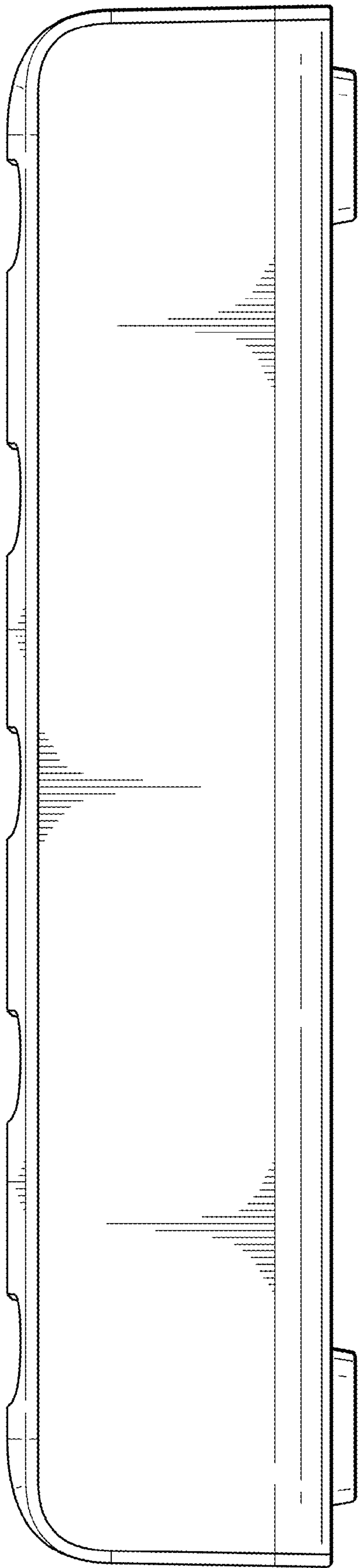

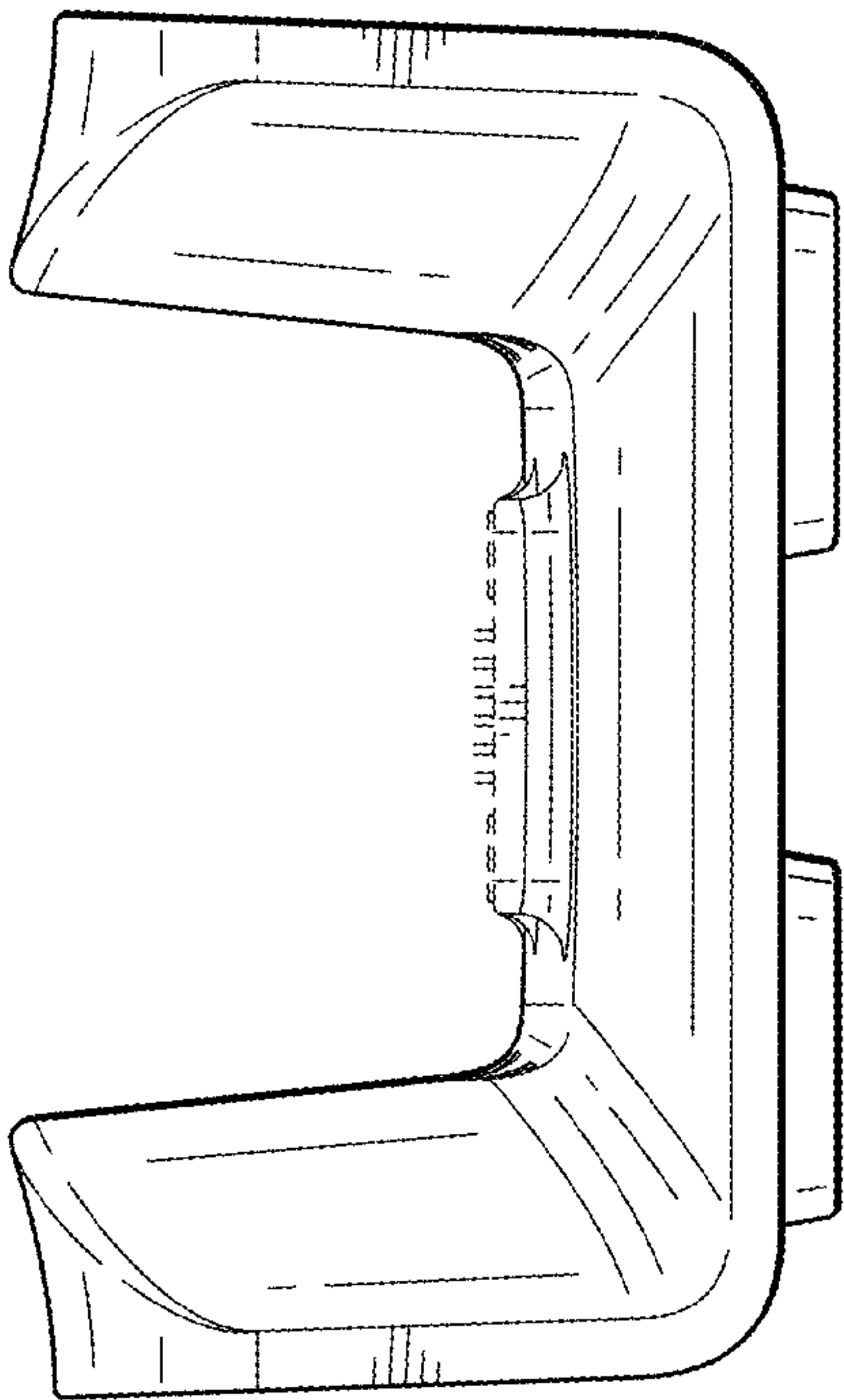

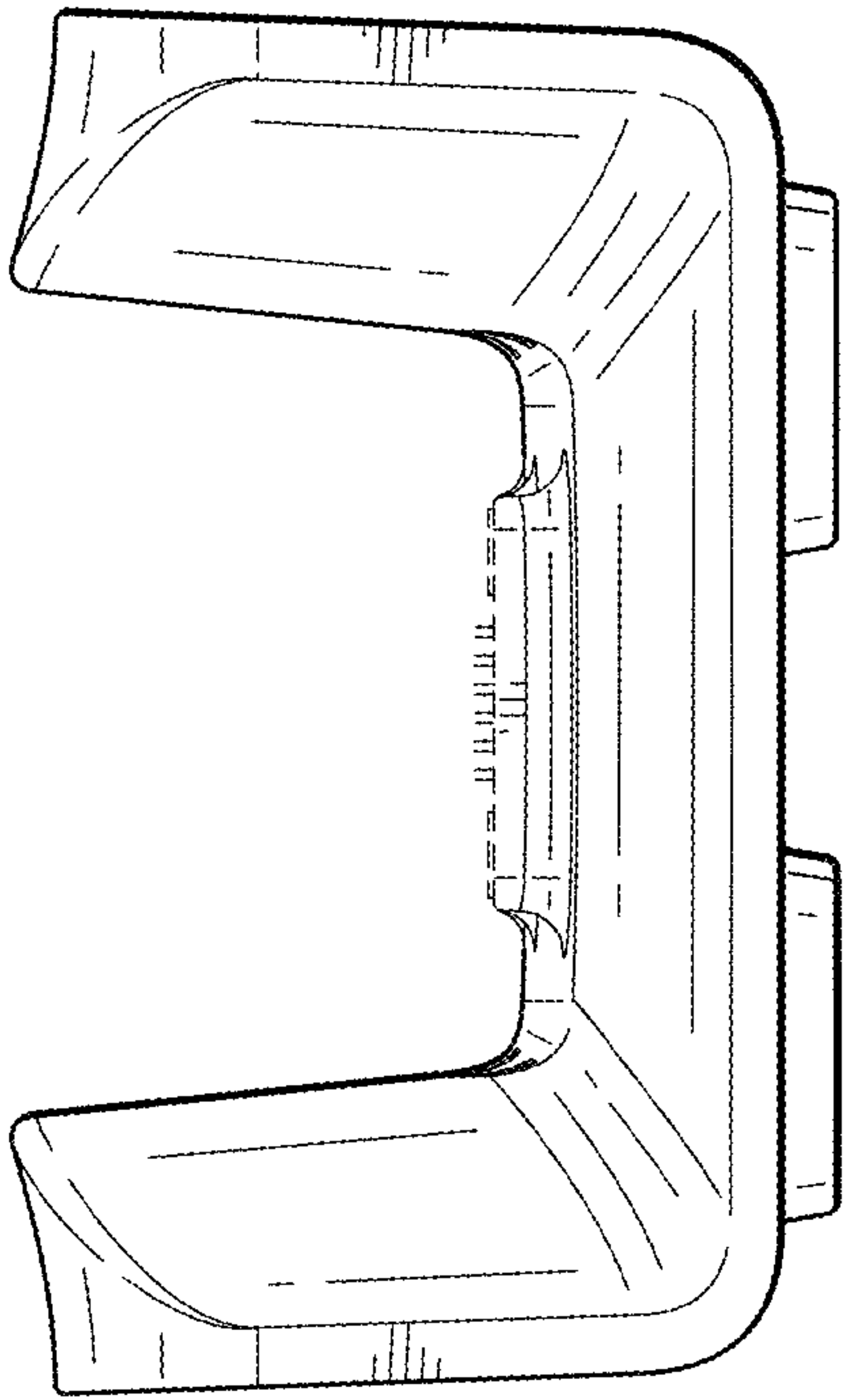

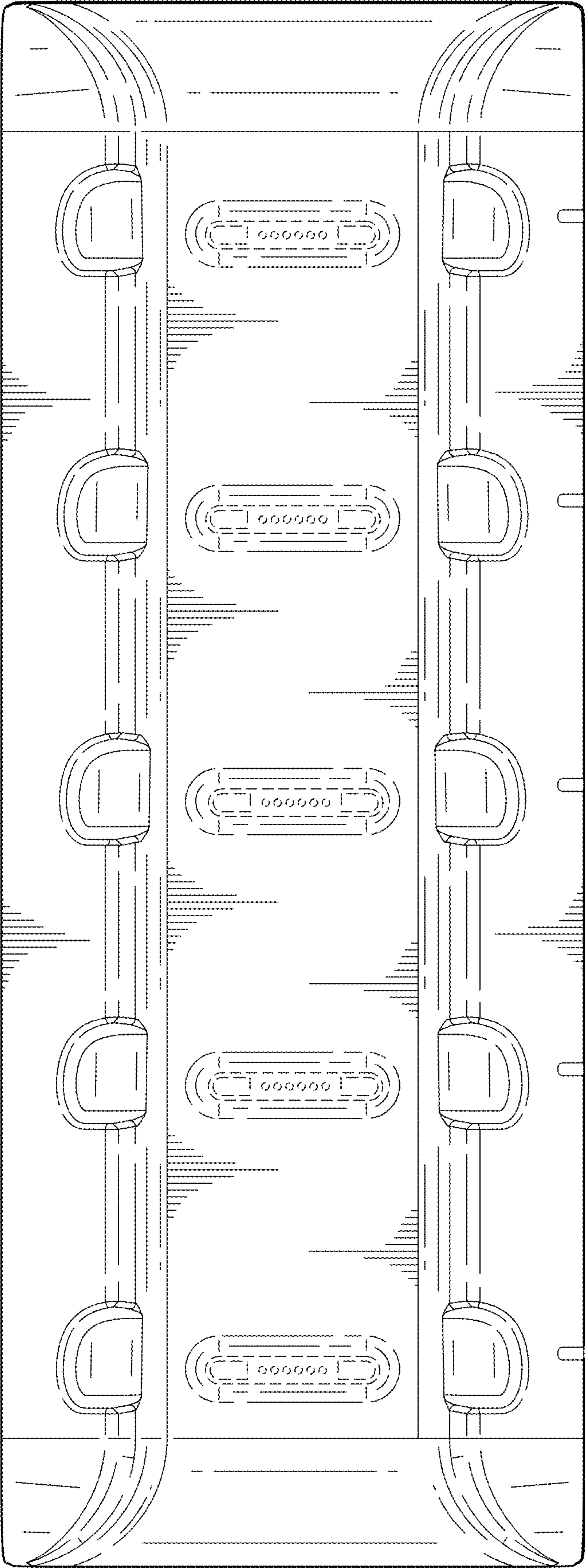

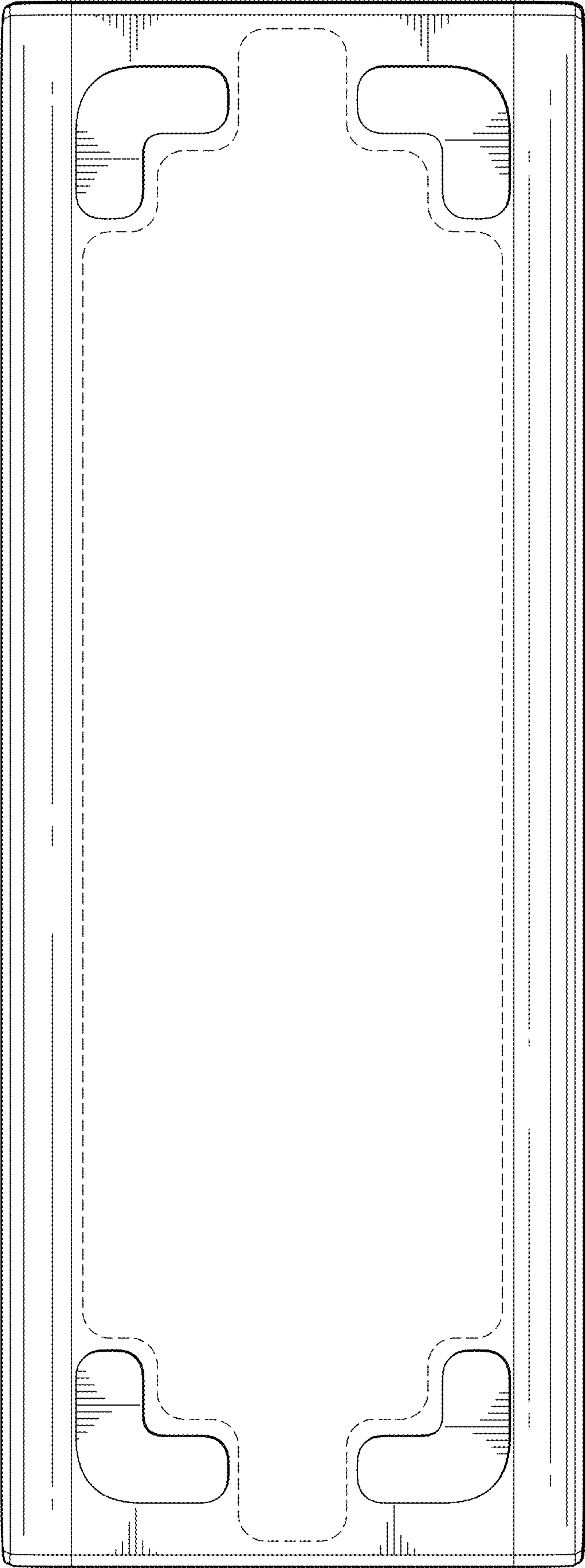

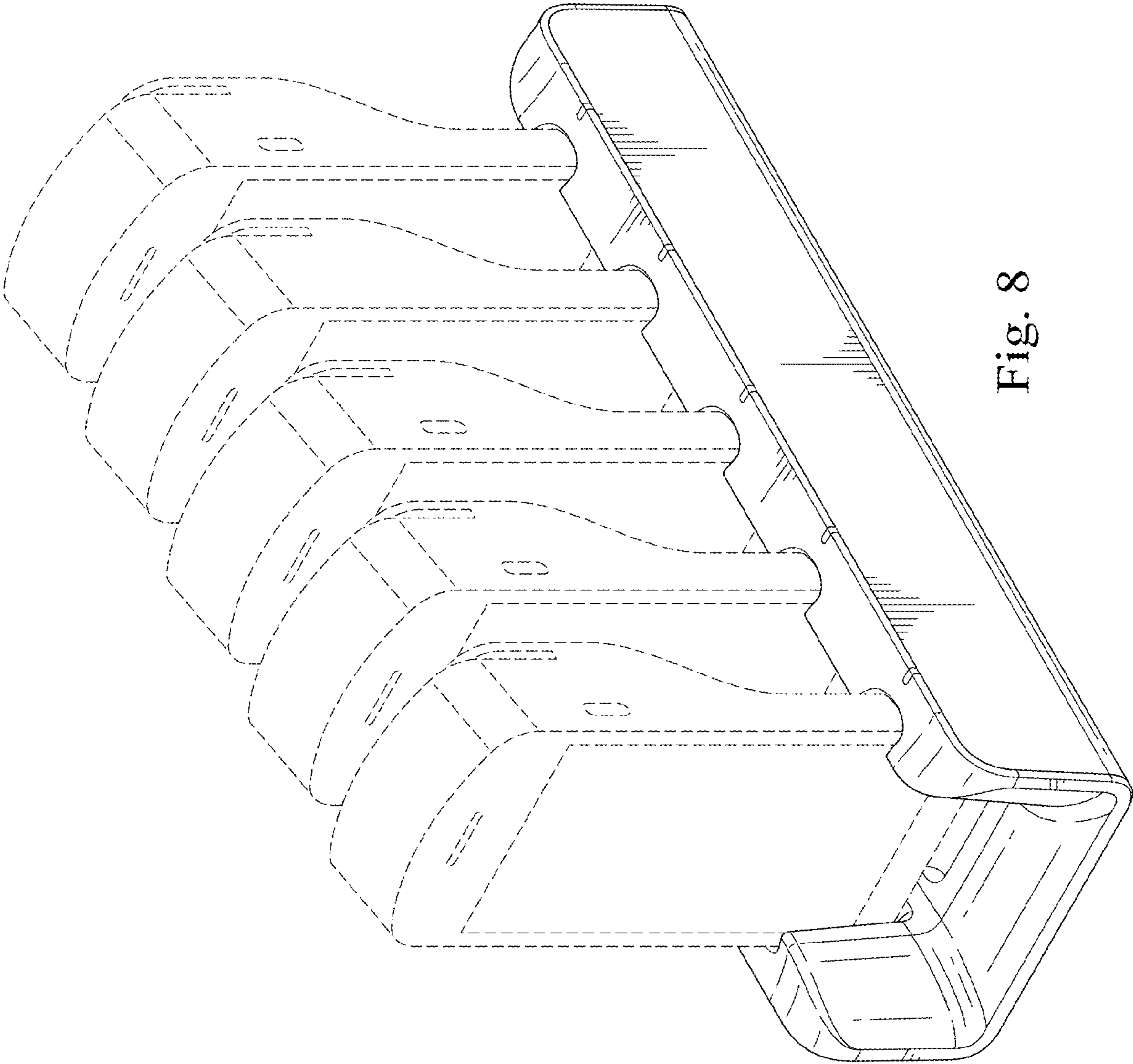

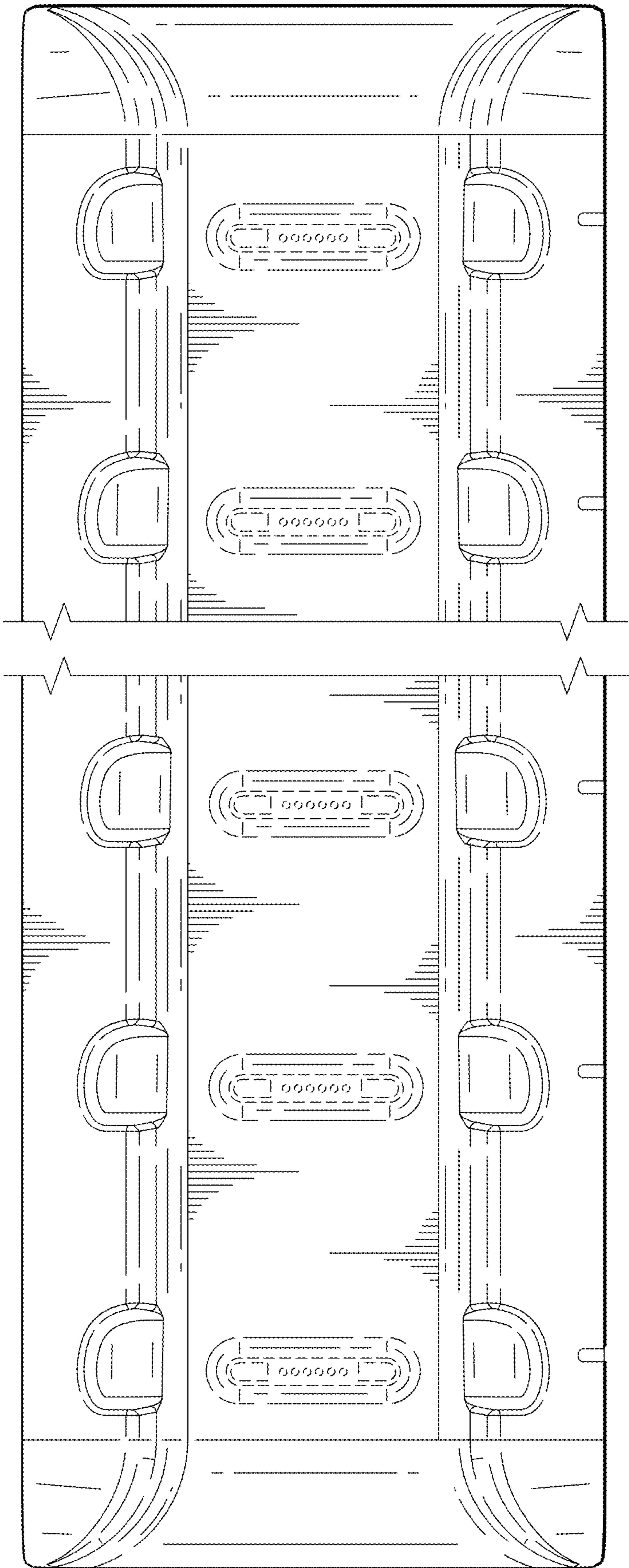
