I claim the ornamental design for a toy vehicle flashlight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view for a toy vehicle flashlight, with an all terrain vehicle;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment for a toy remote vehicle flashlight, showing with an amphibious raft vehicle;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof;

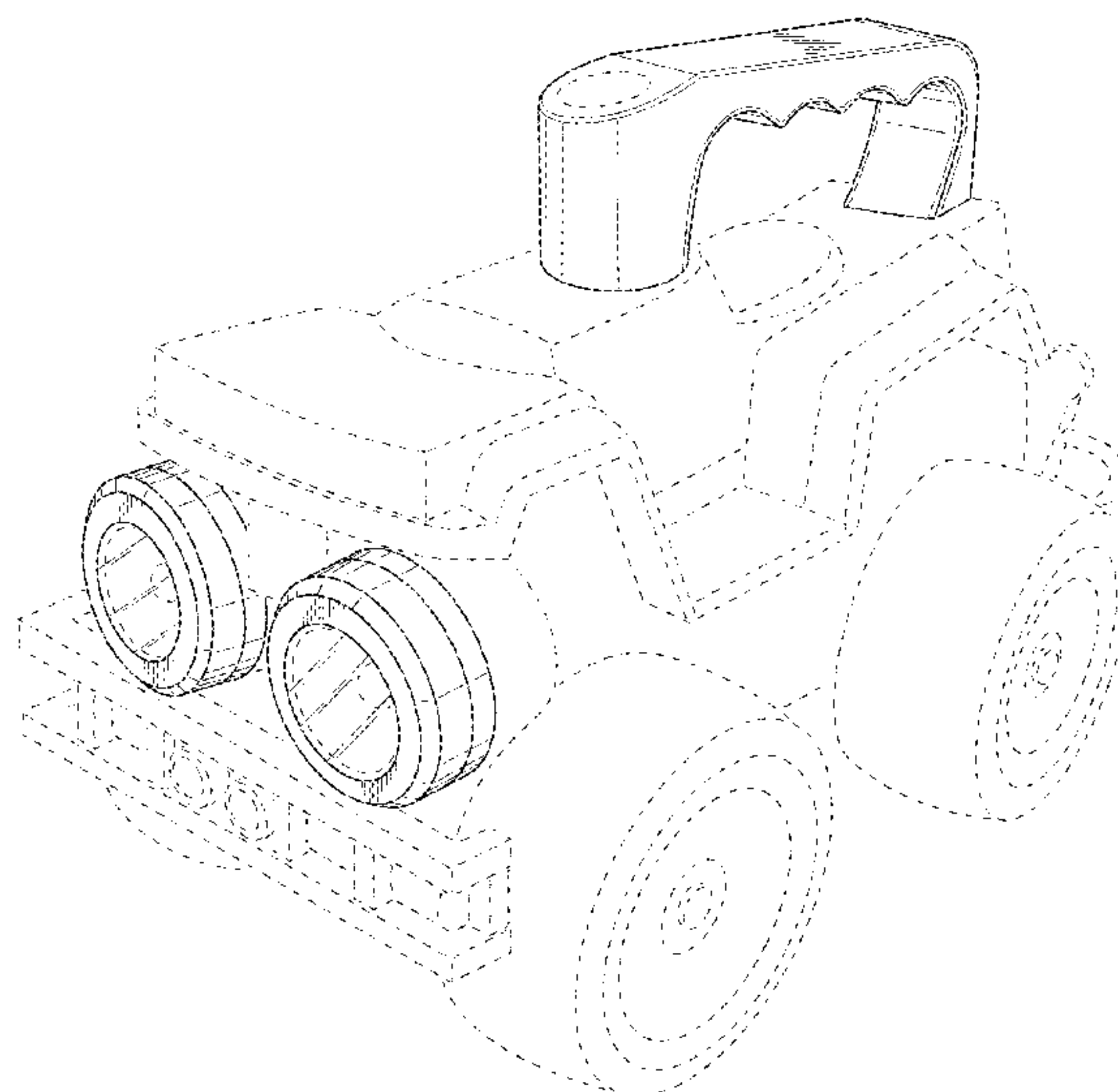
FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view thereof;

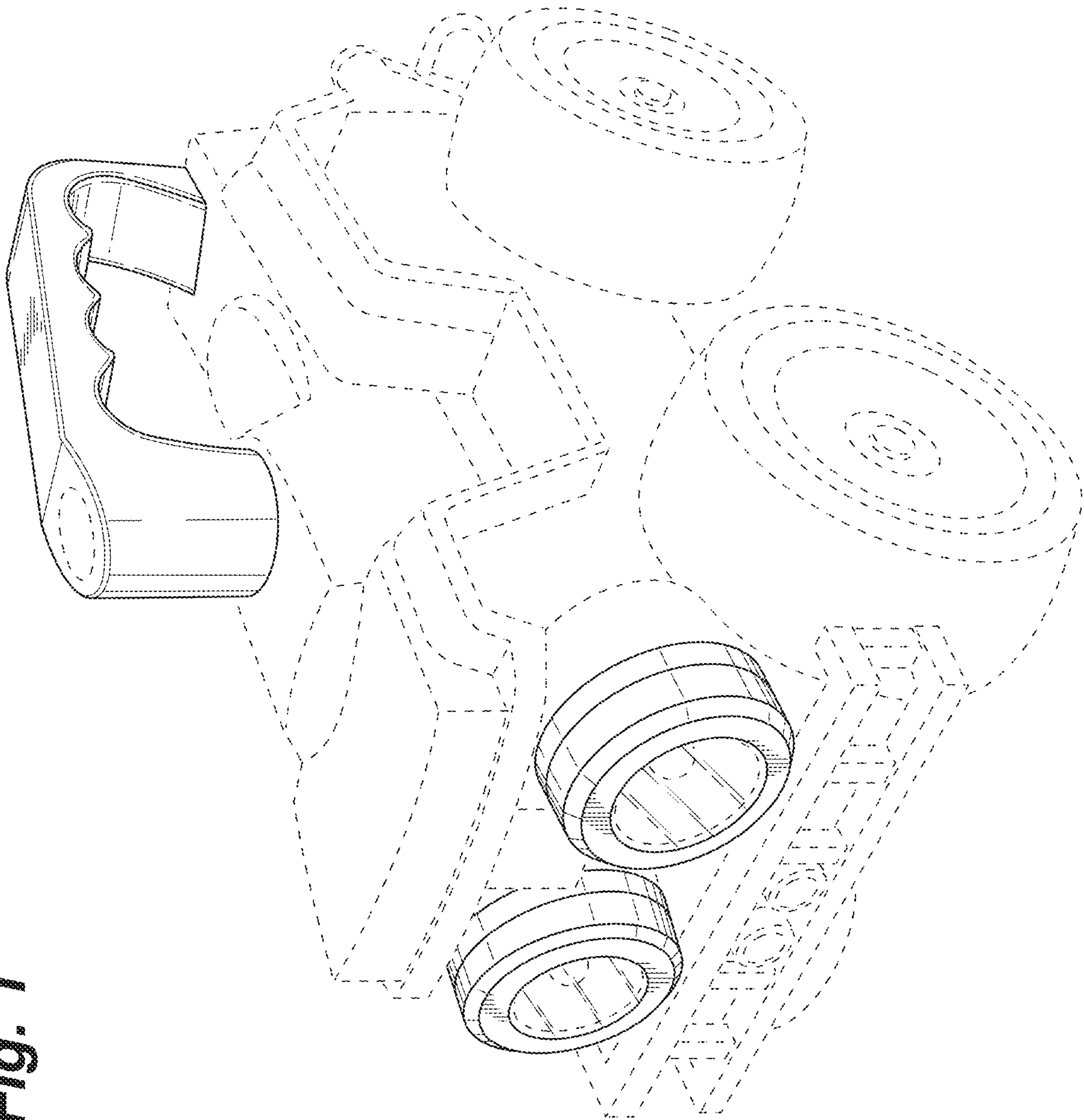

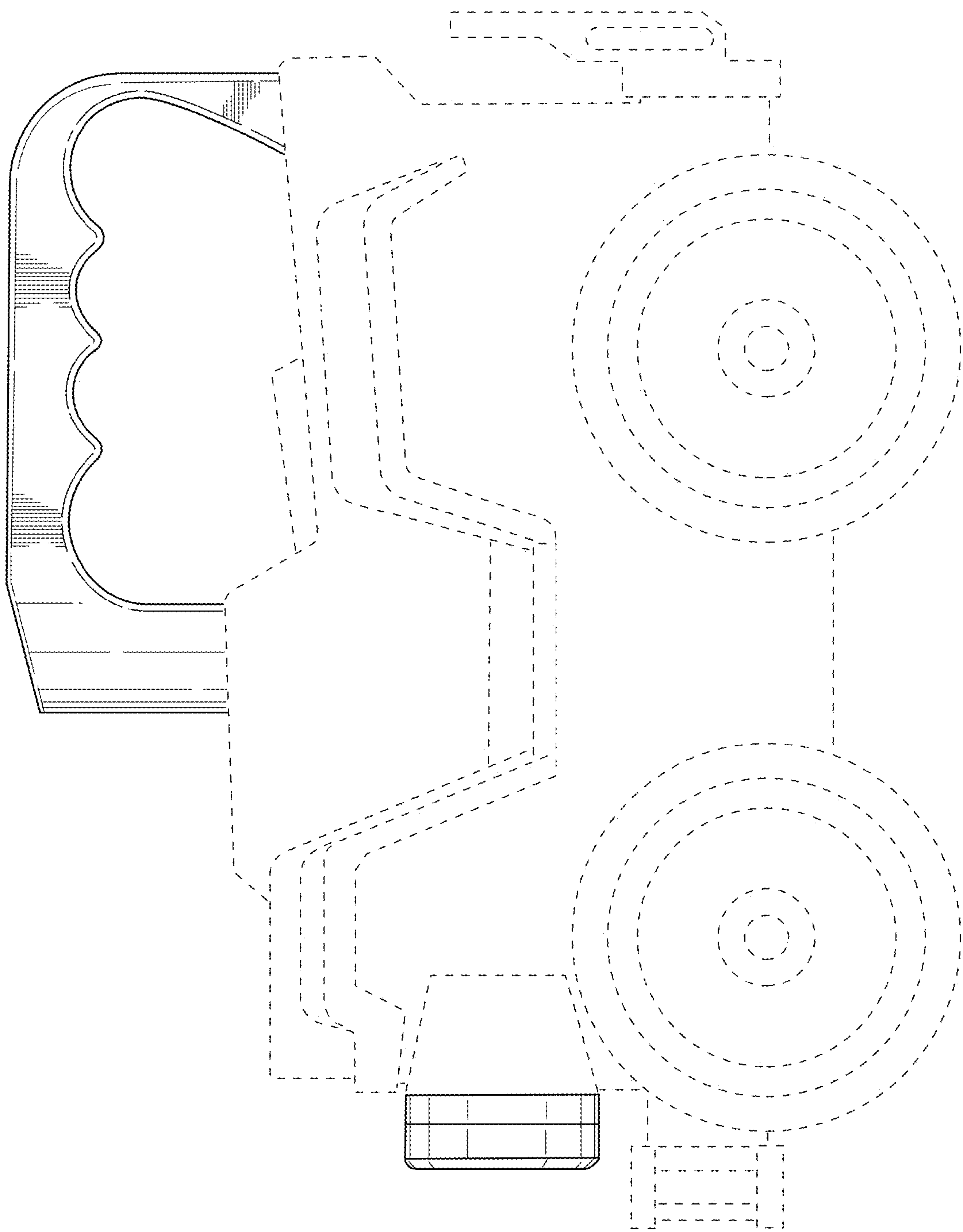

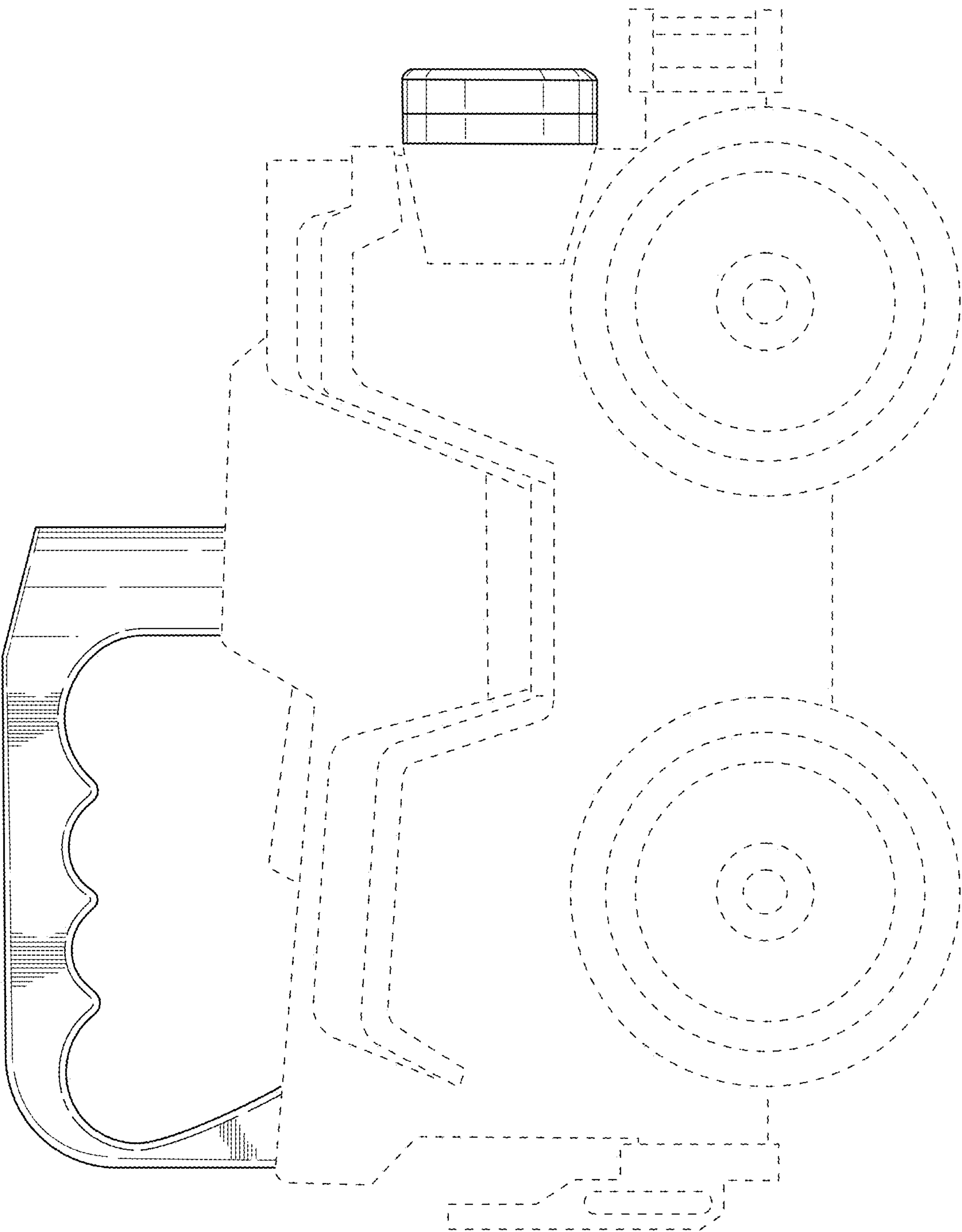

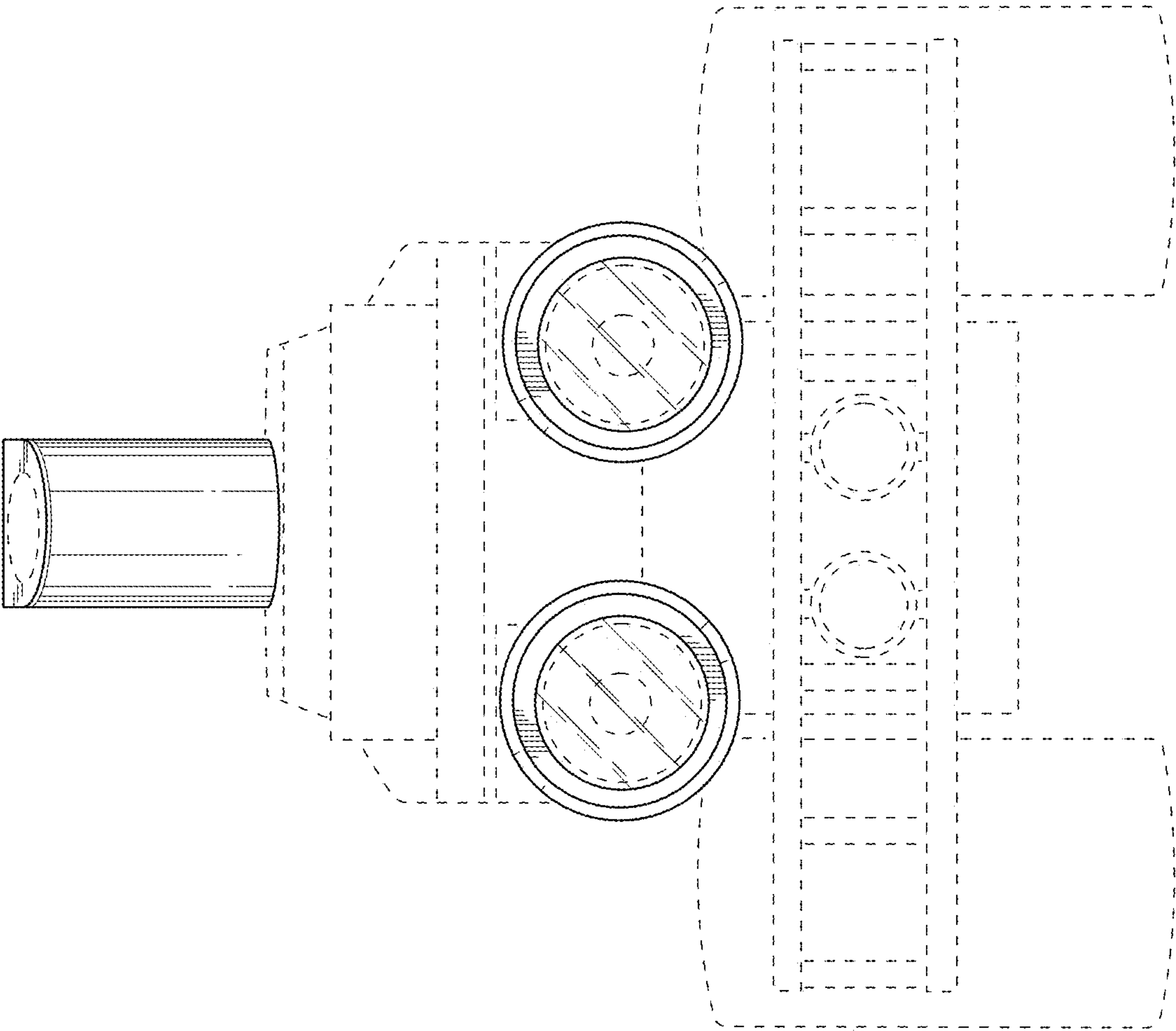
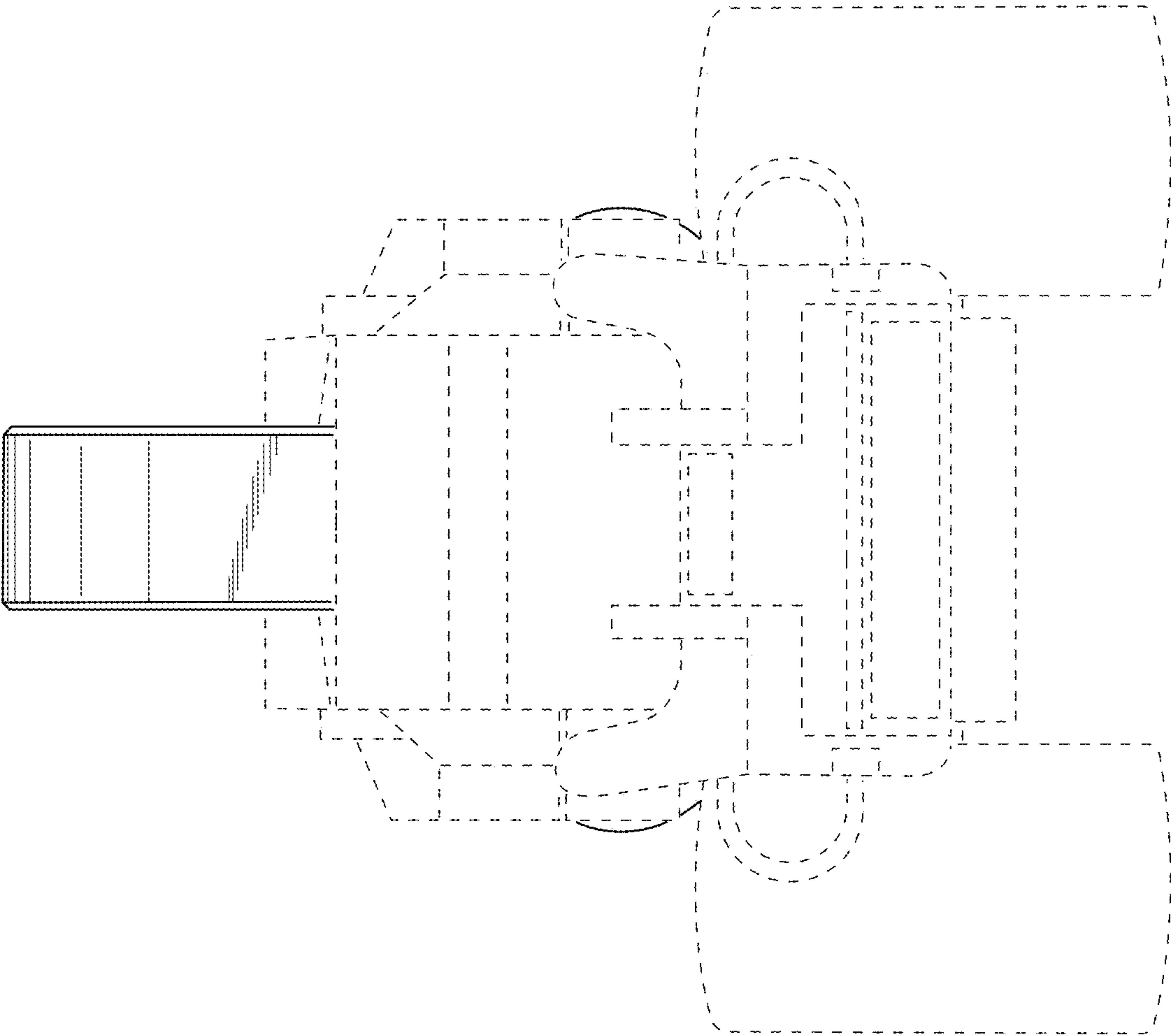

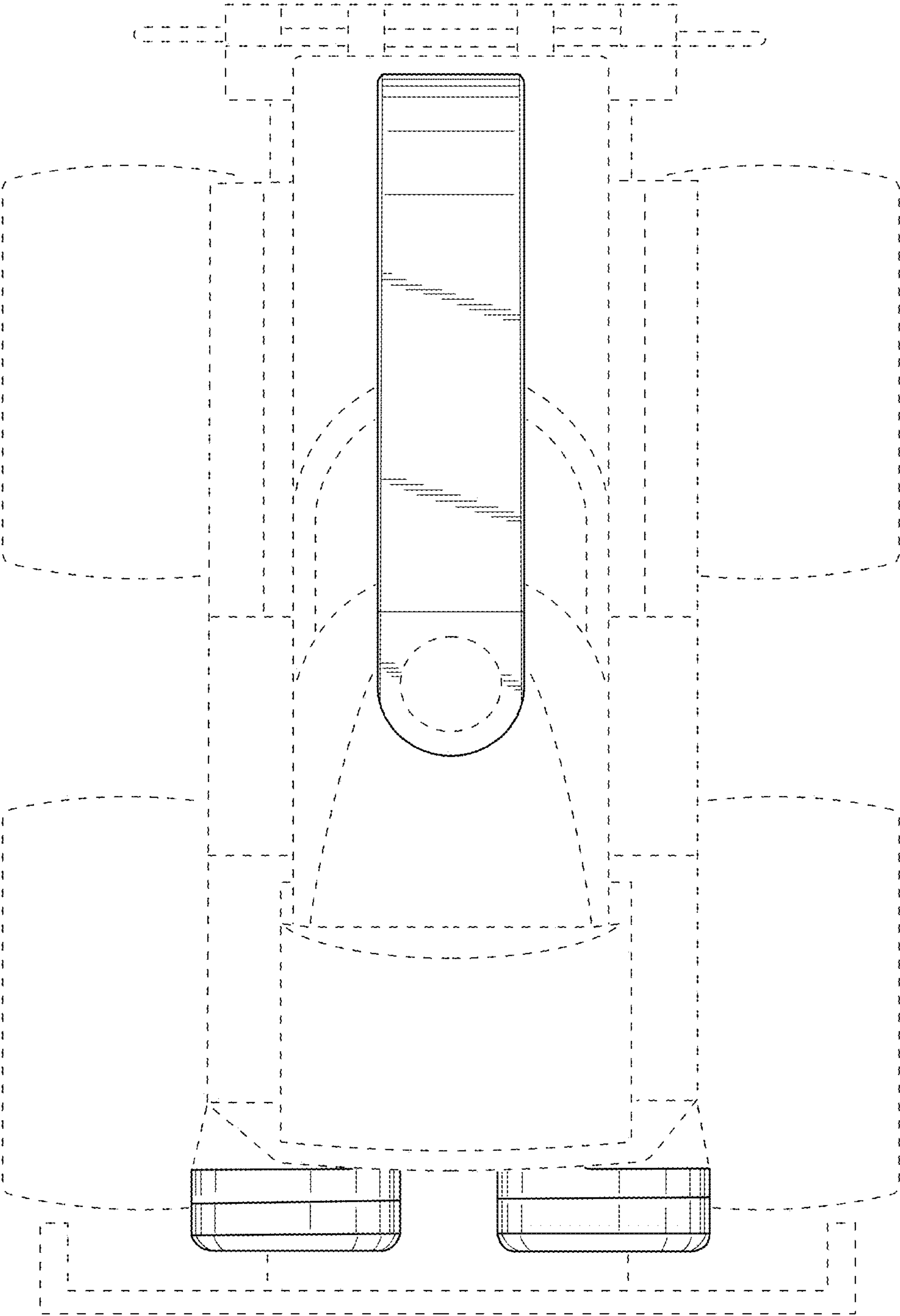

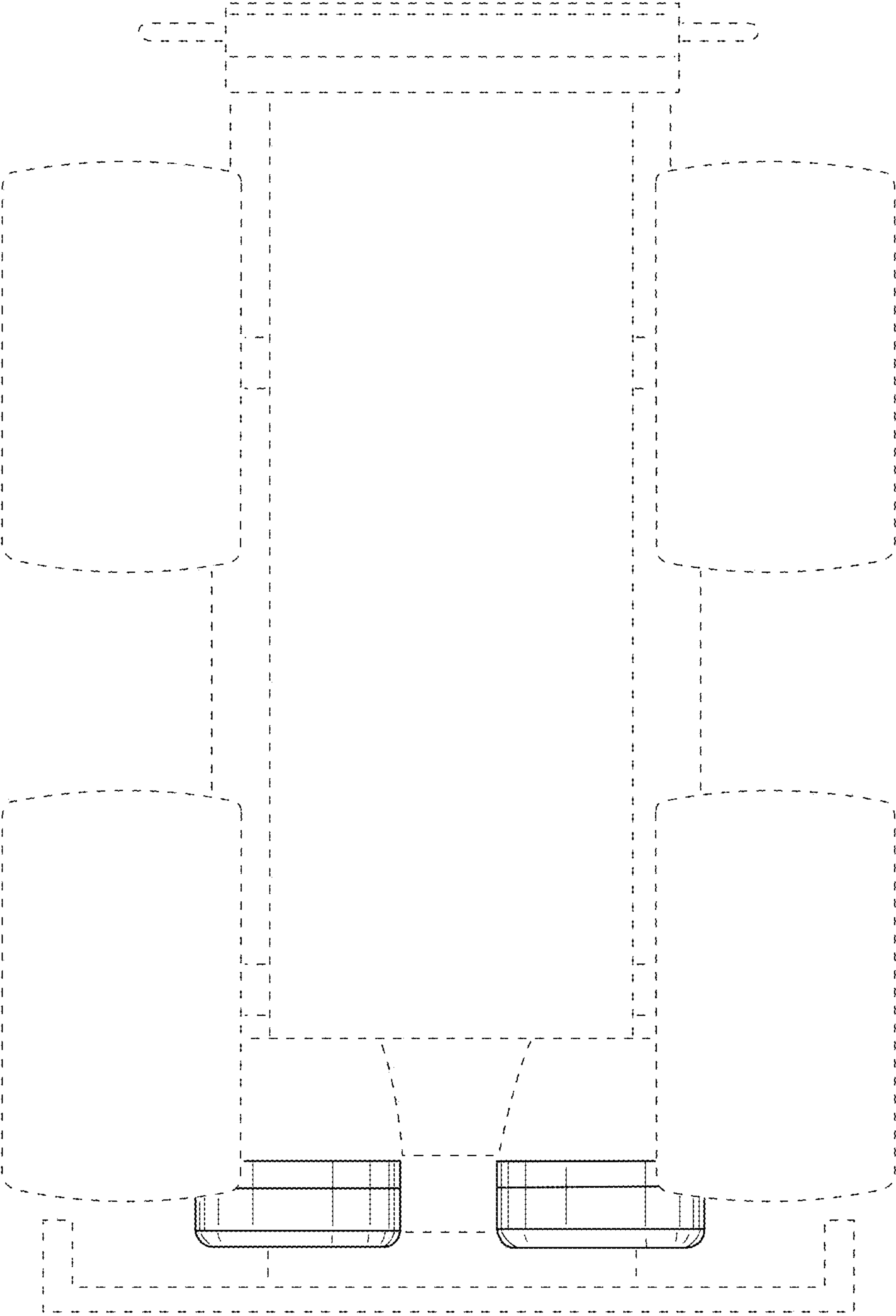

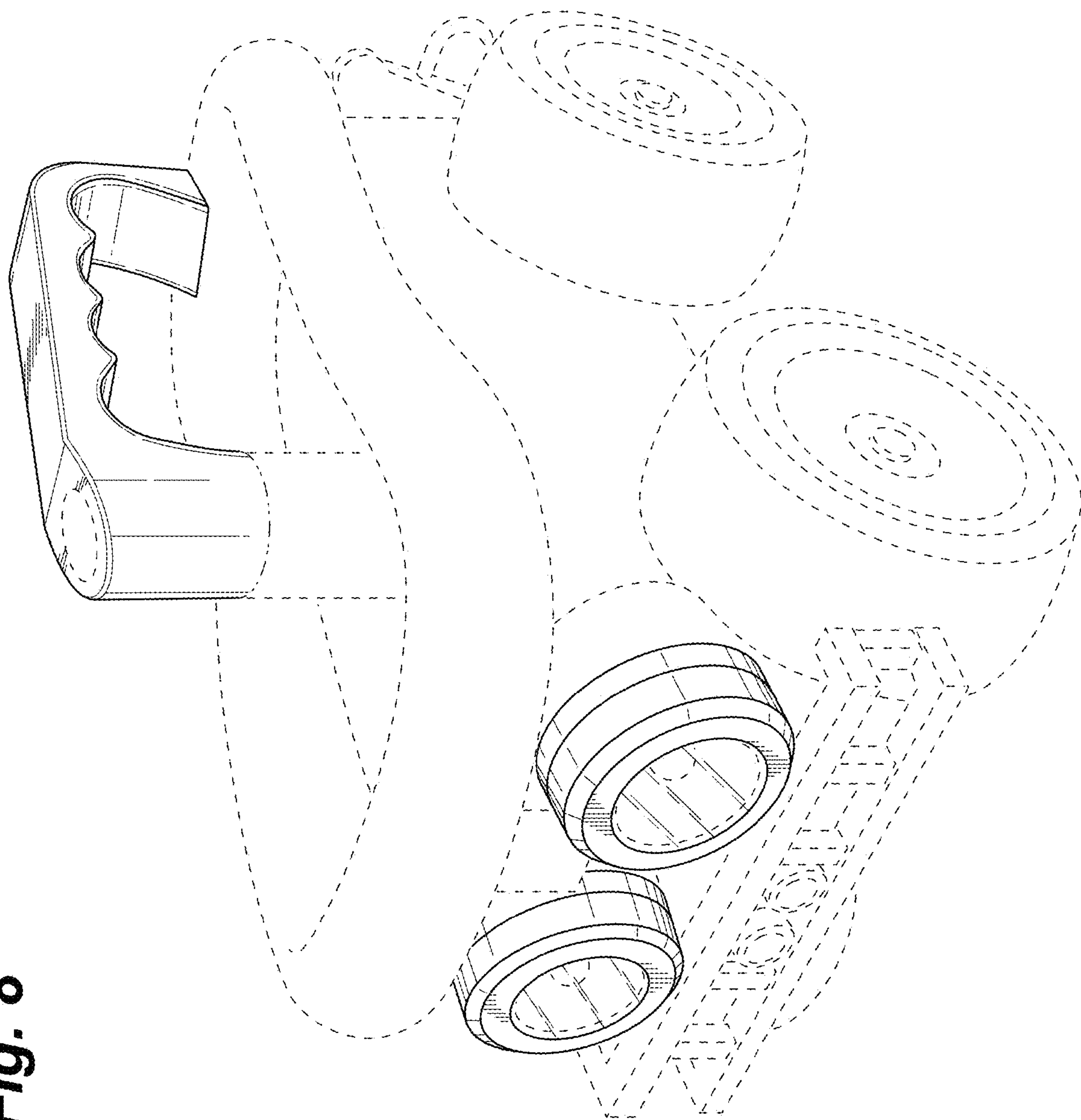

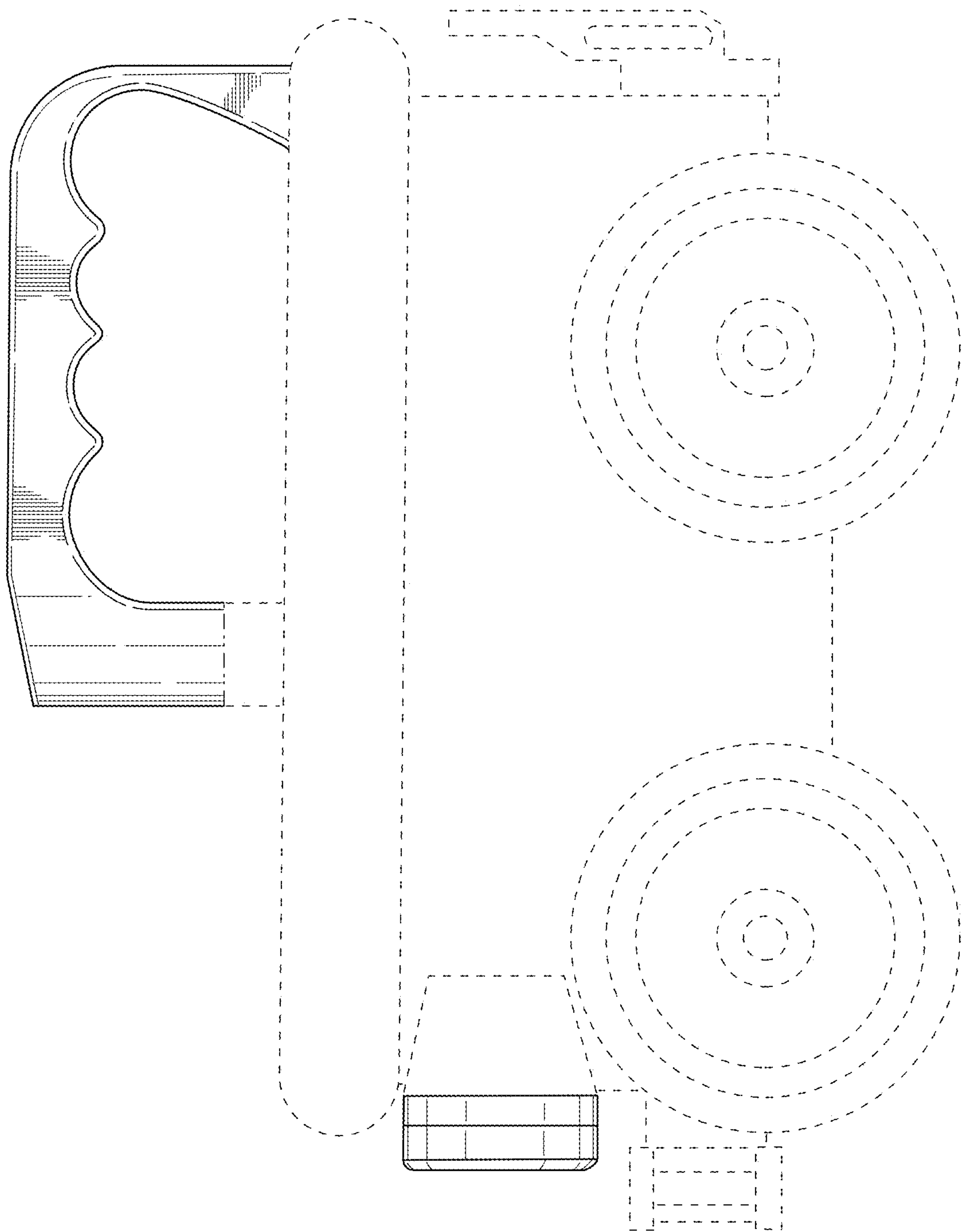

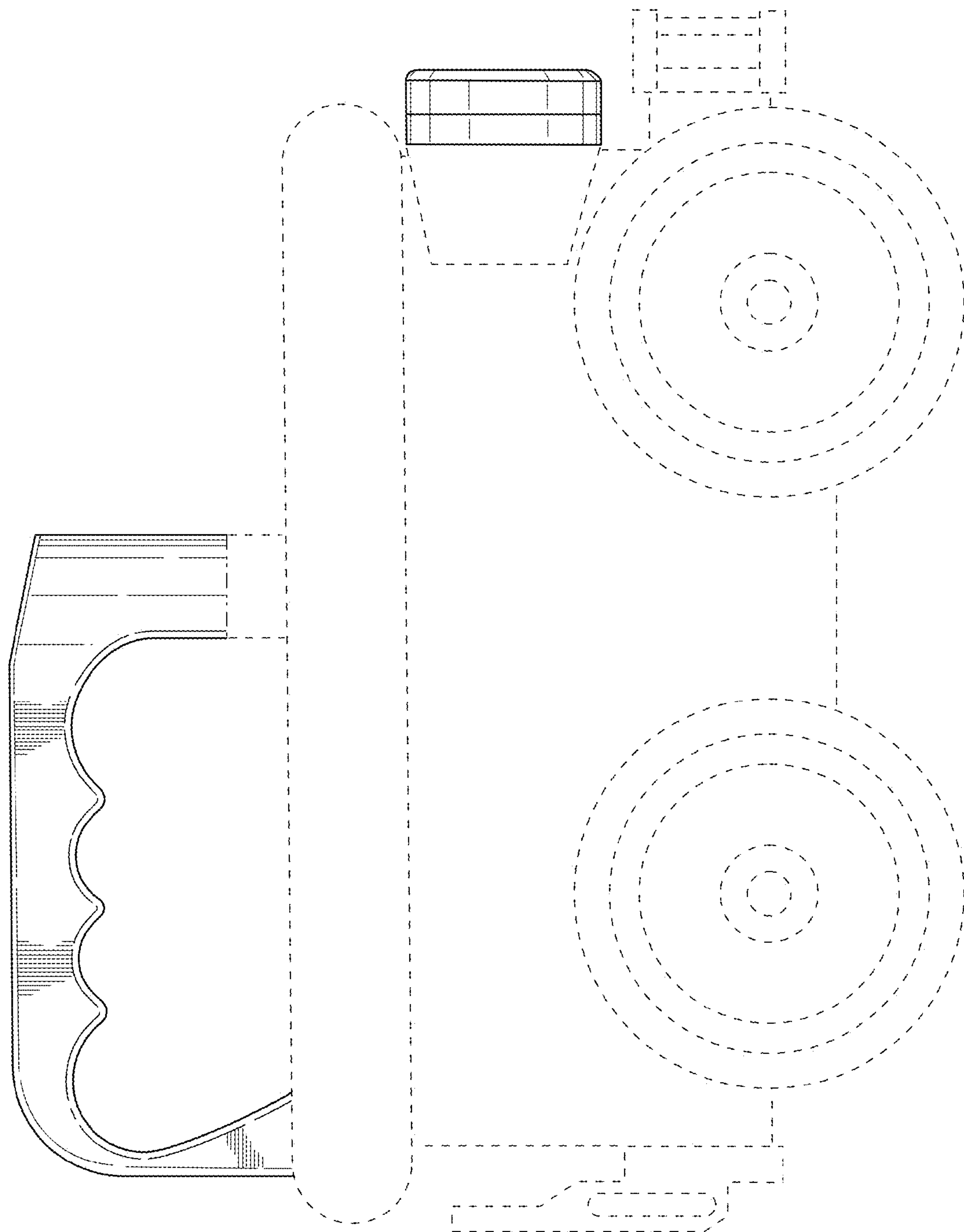

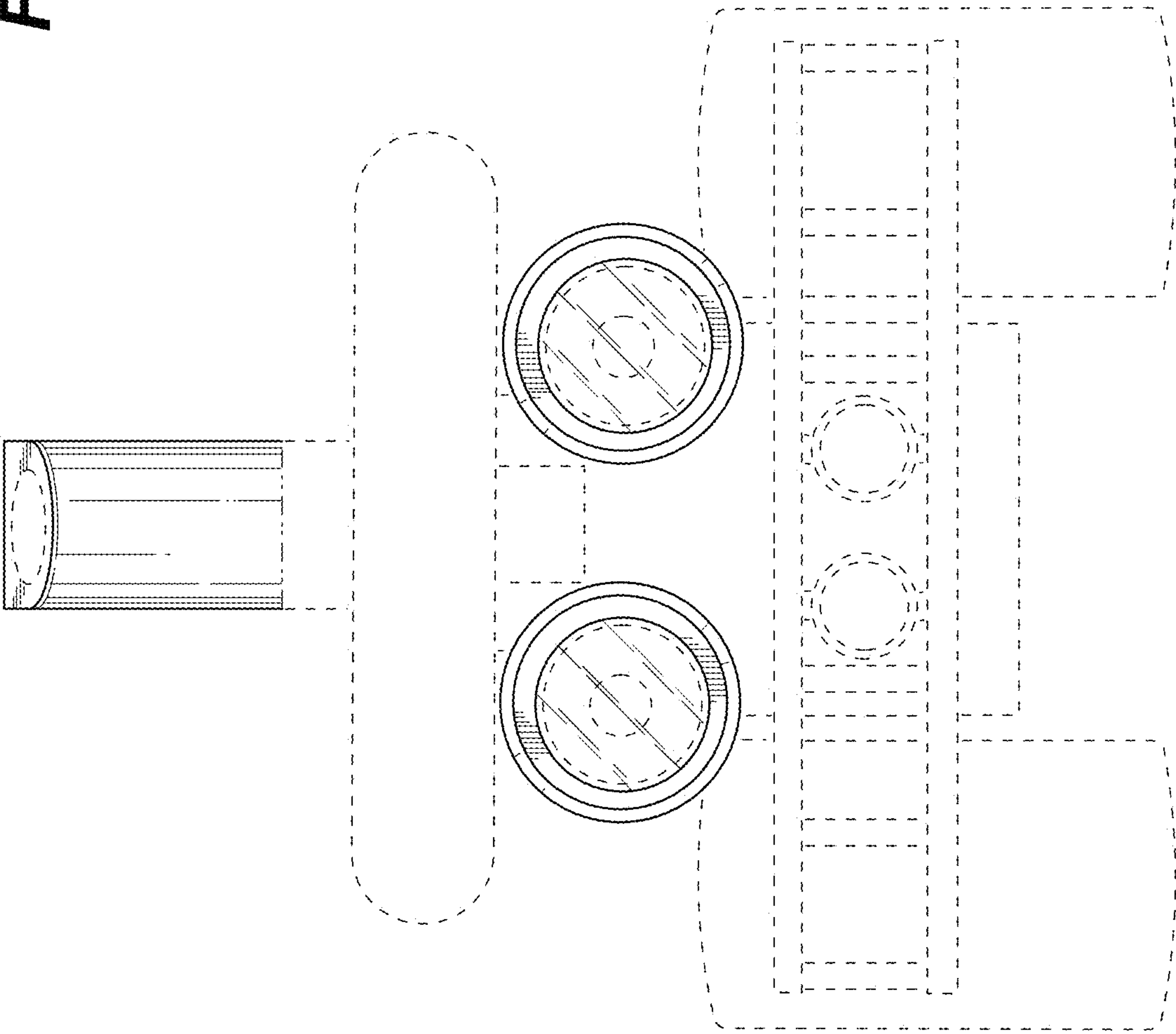
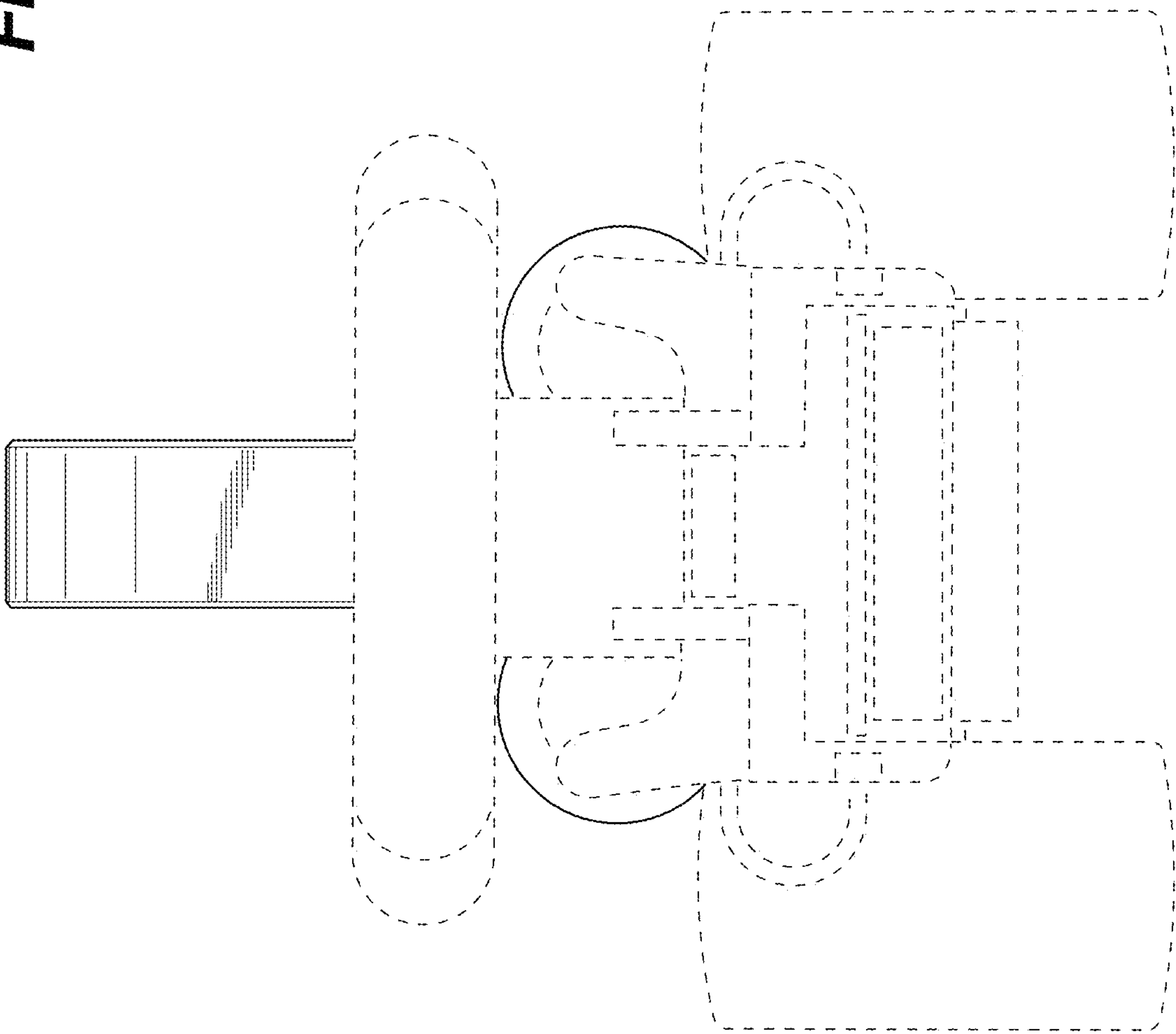

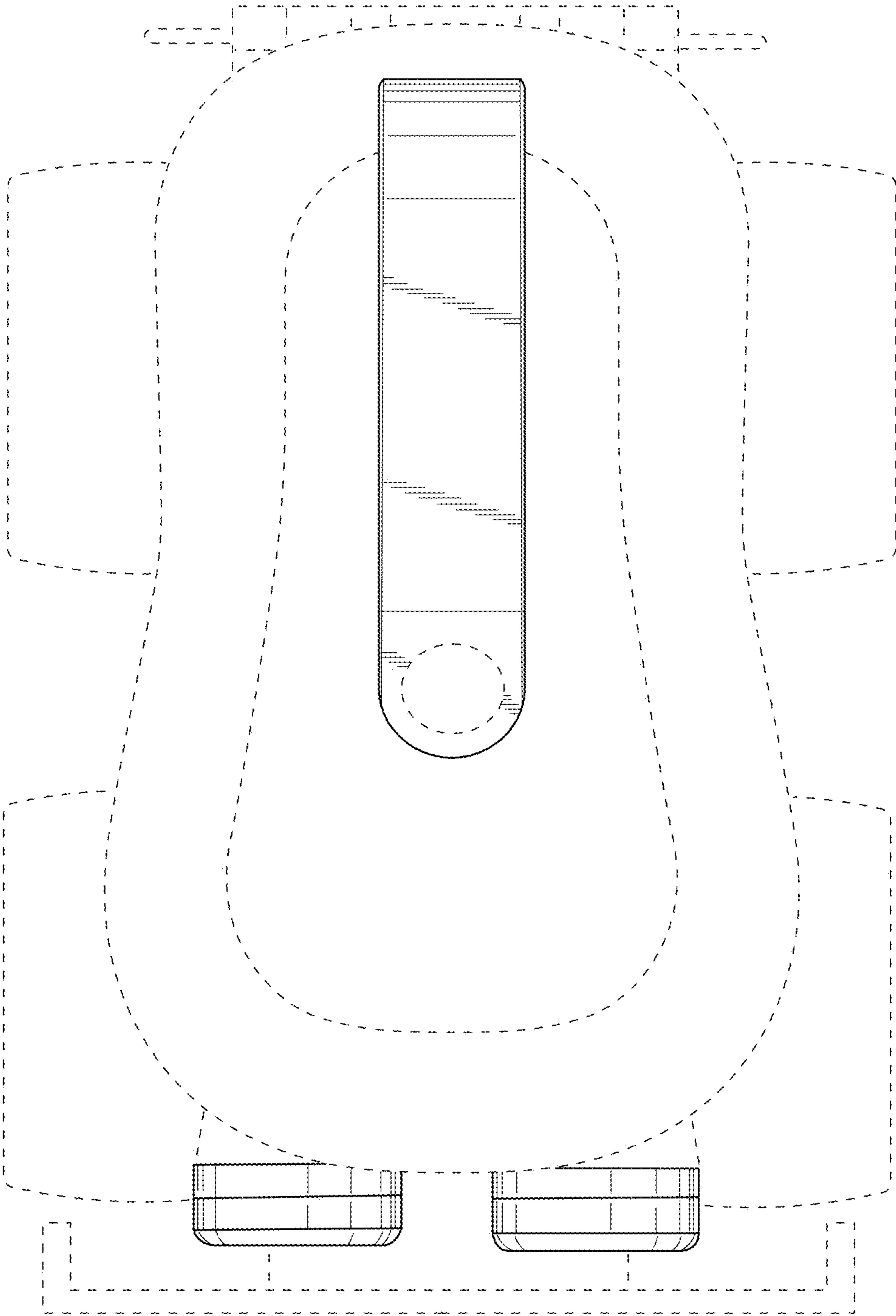

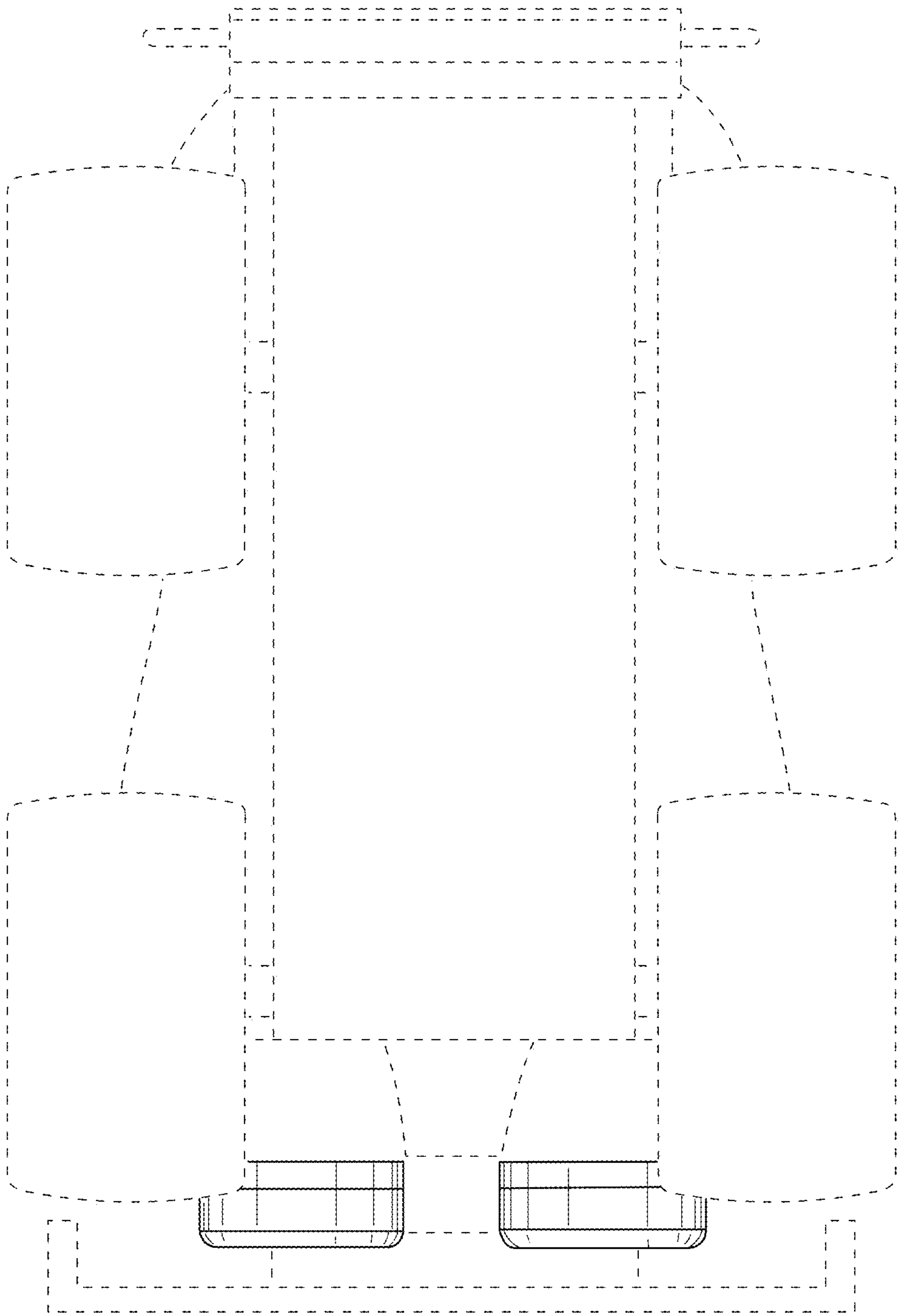
