(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a gaming mouse, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a left-side view of the same.

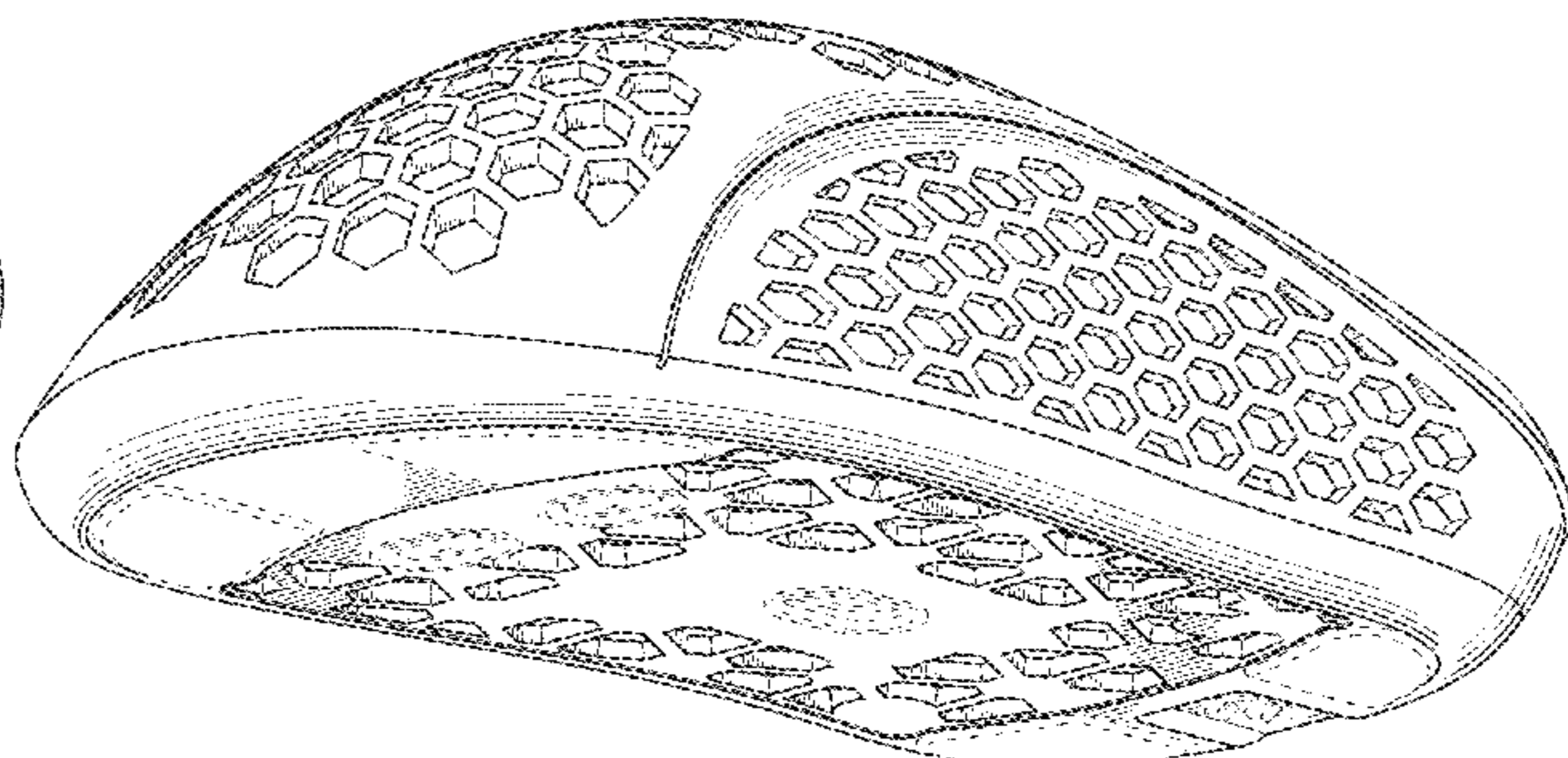
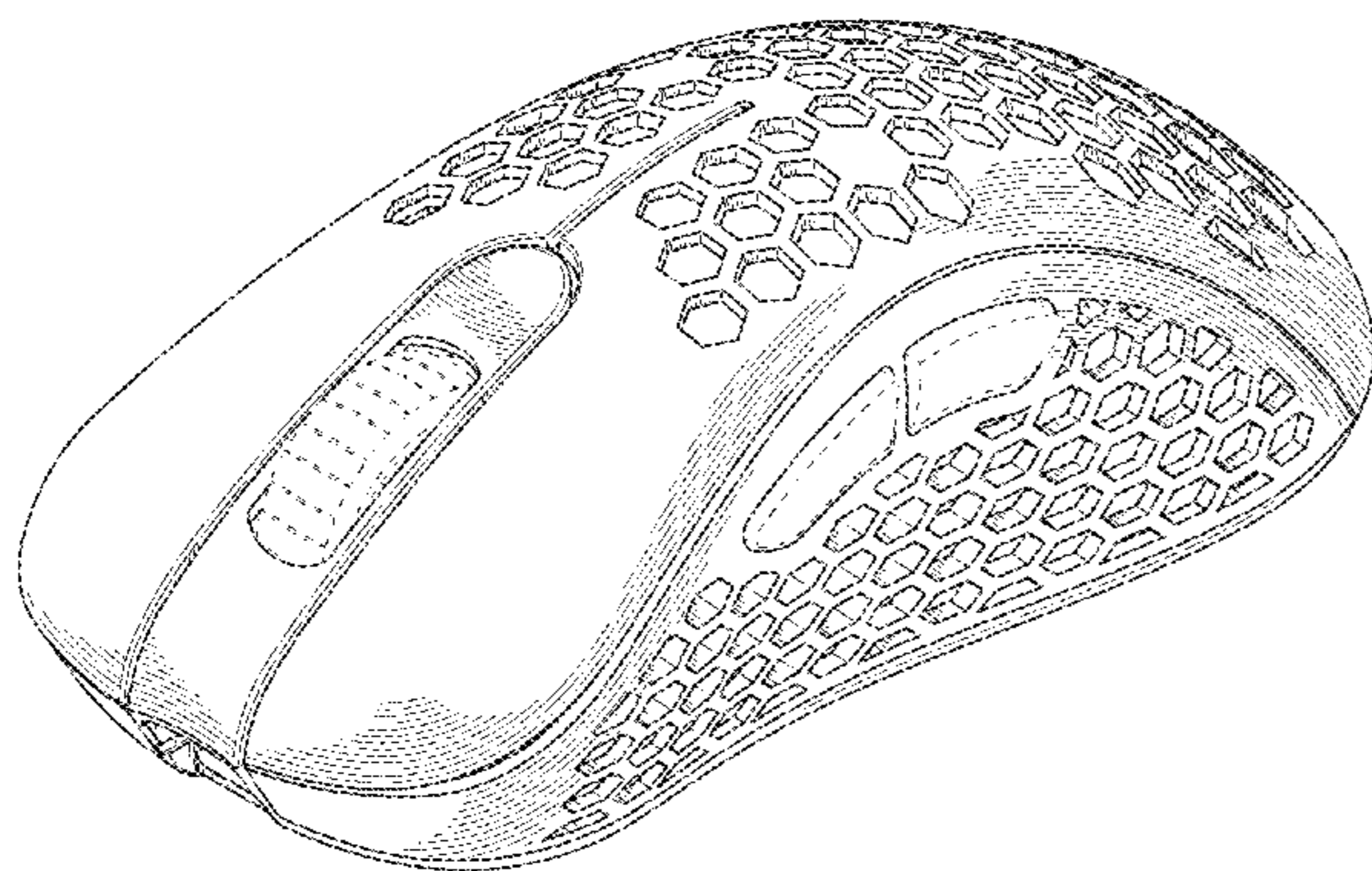
FIG. 6 is a right-side view of the same.

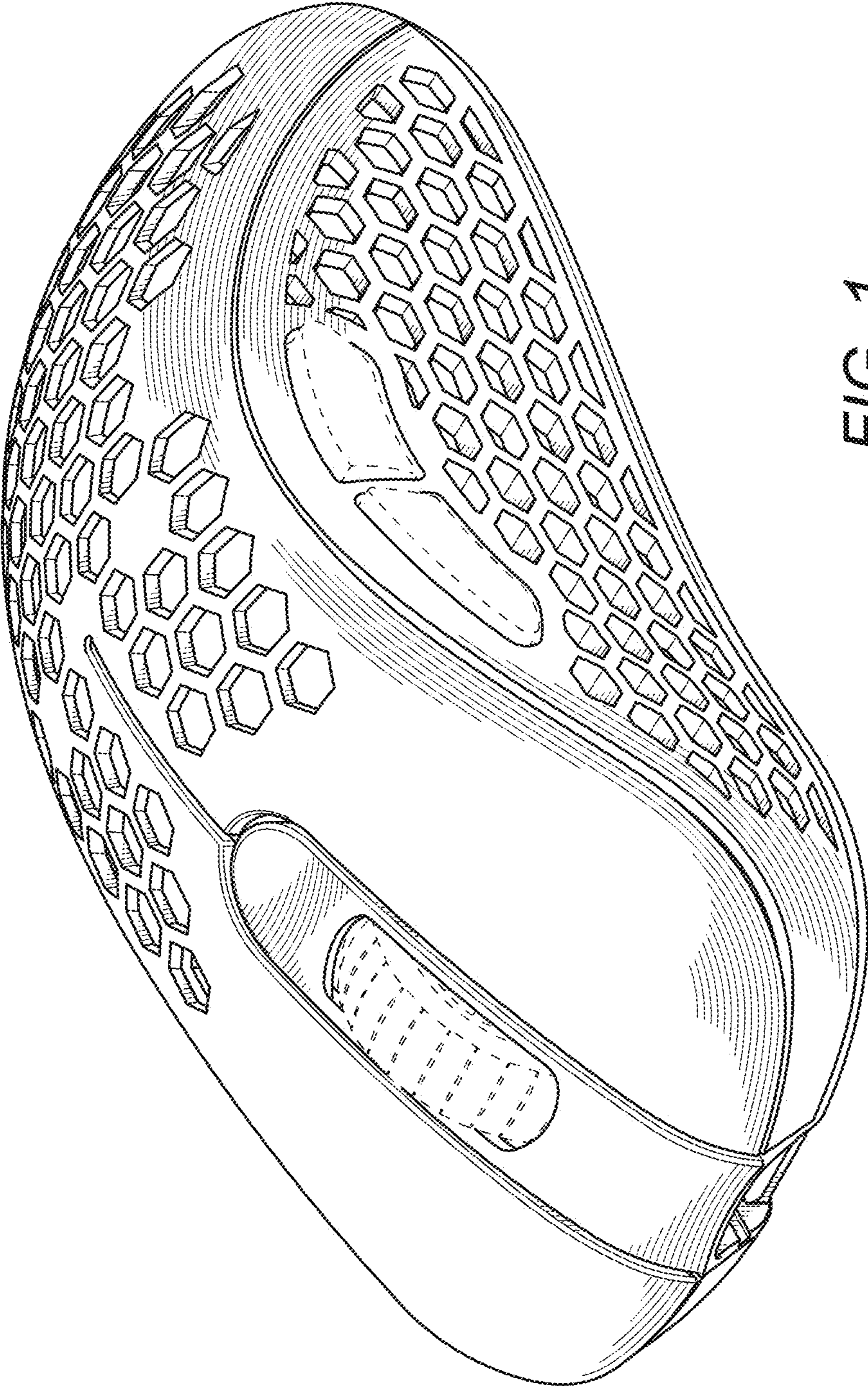

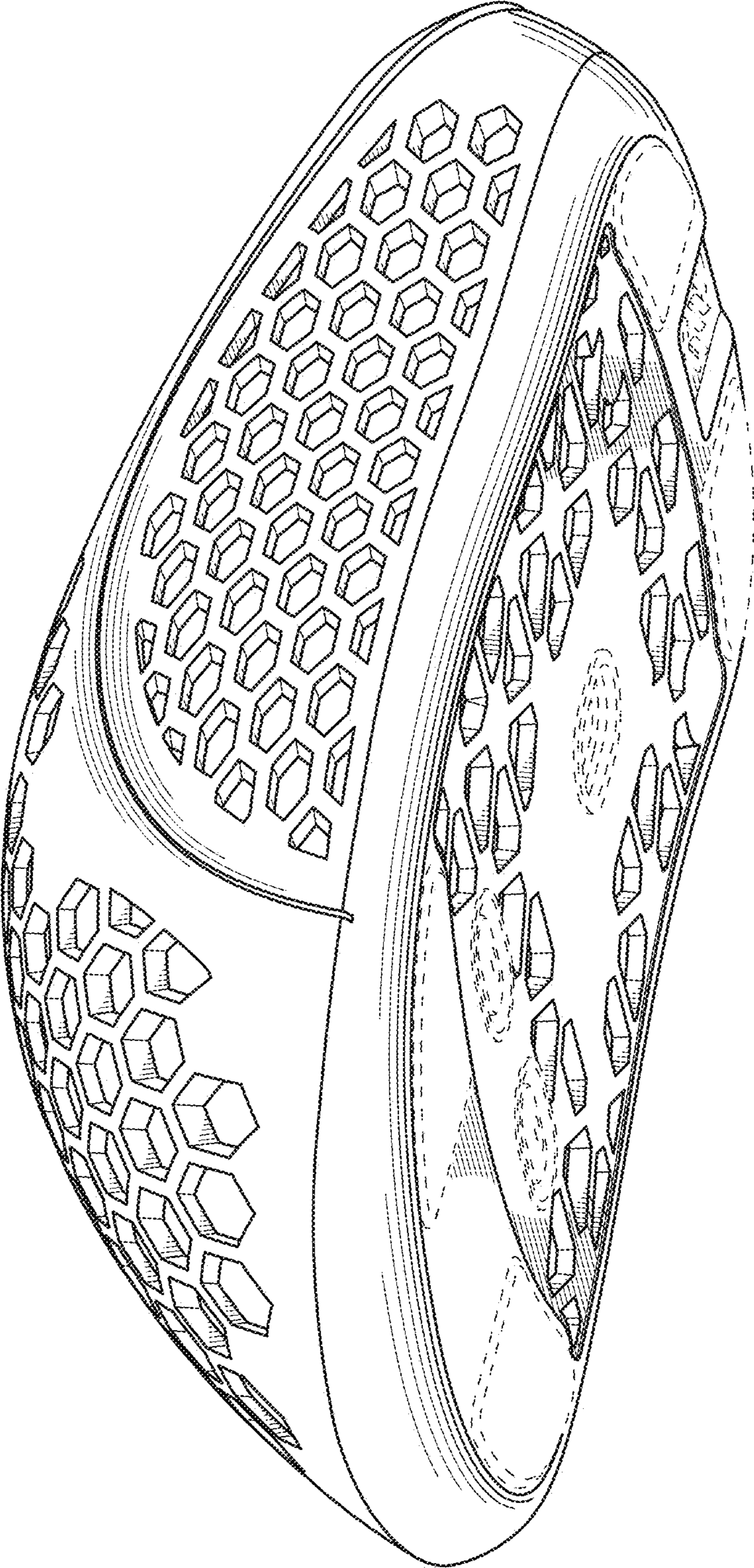

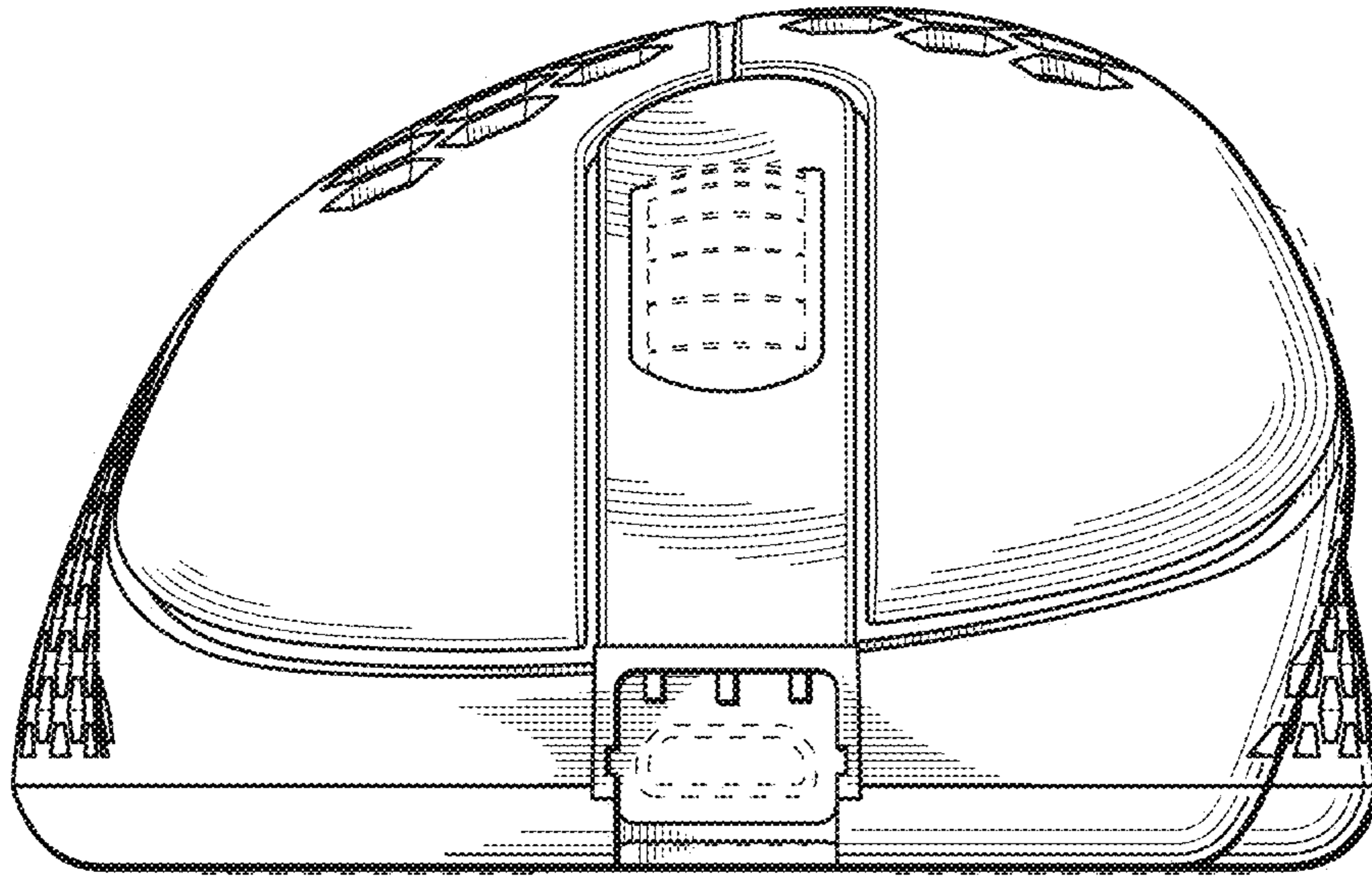

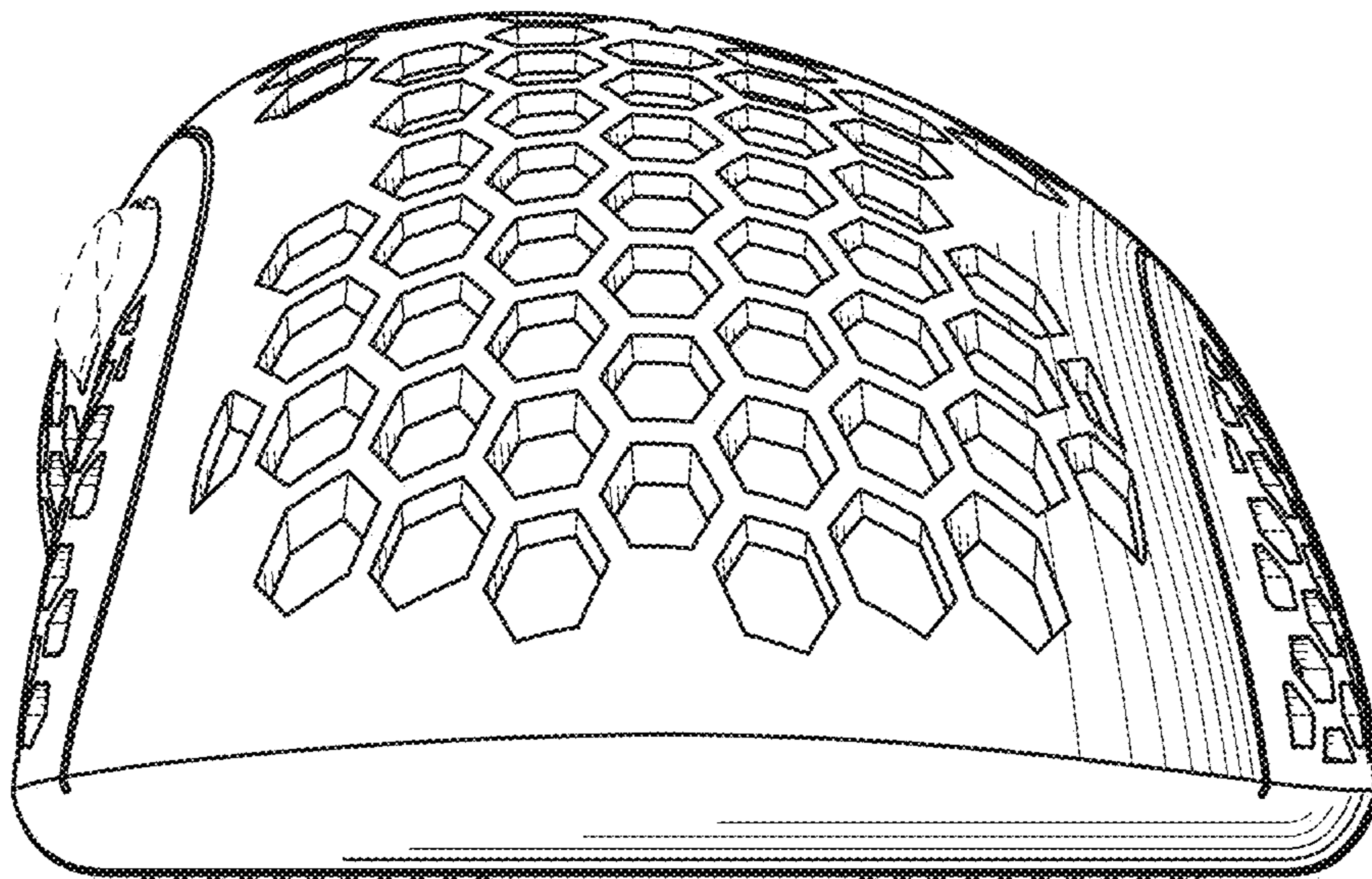

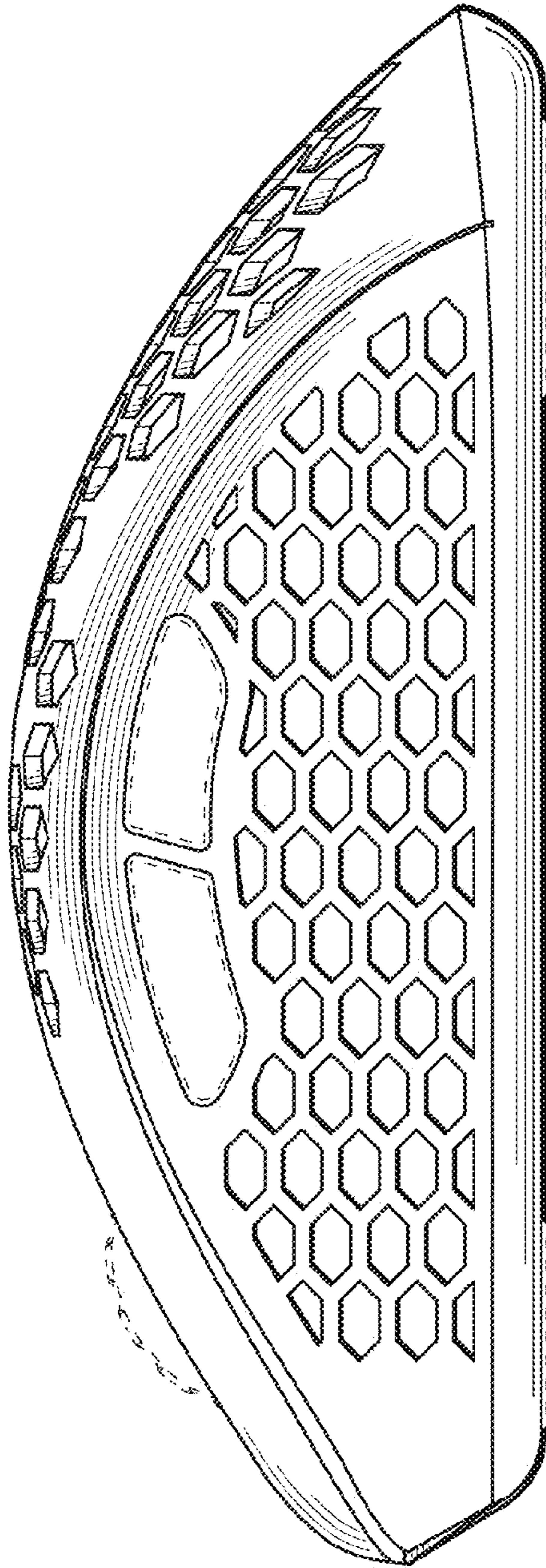

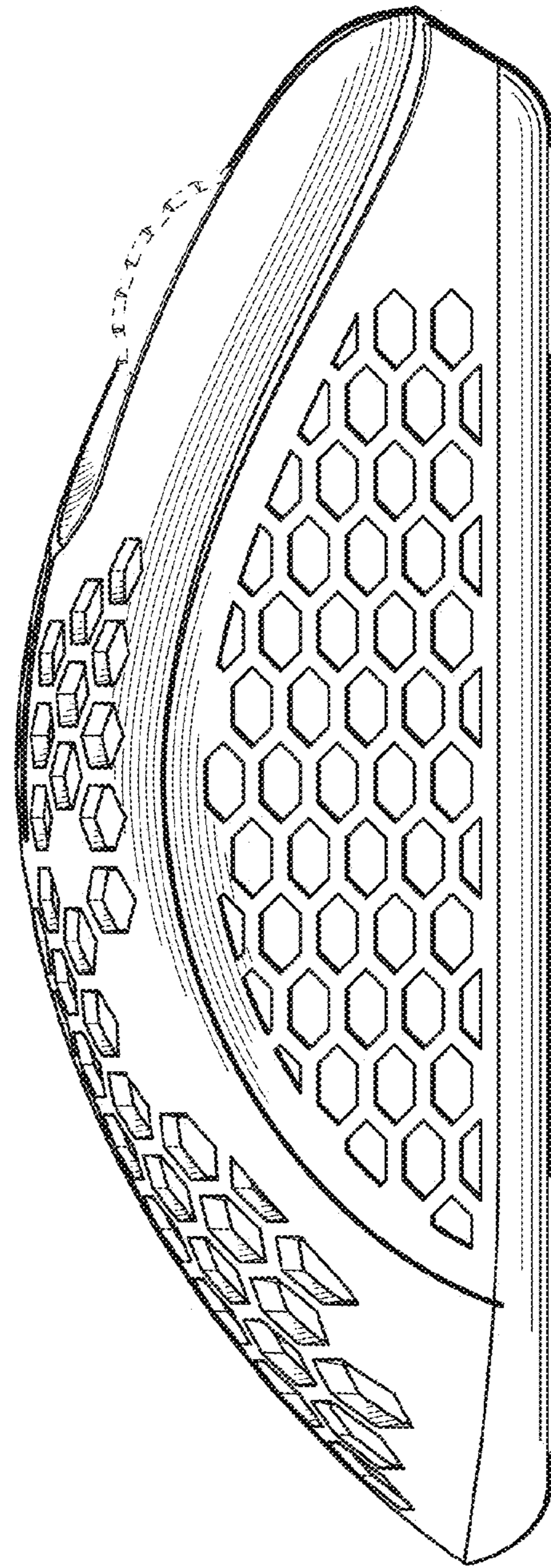

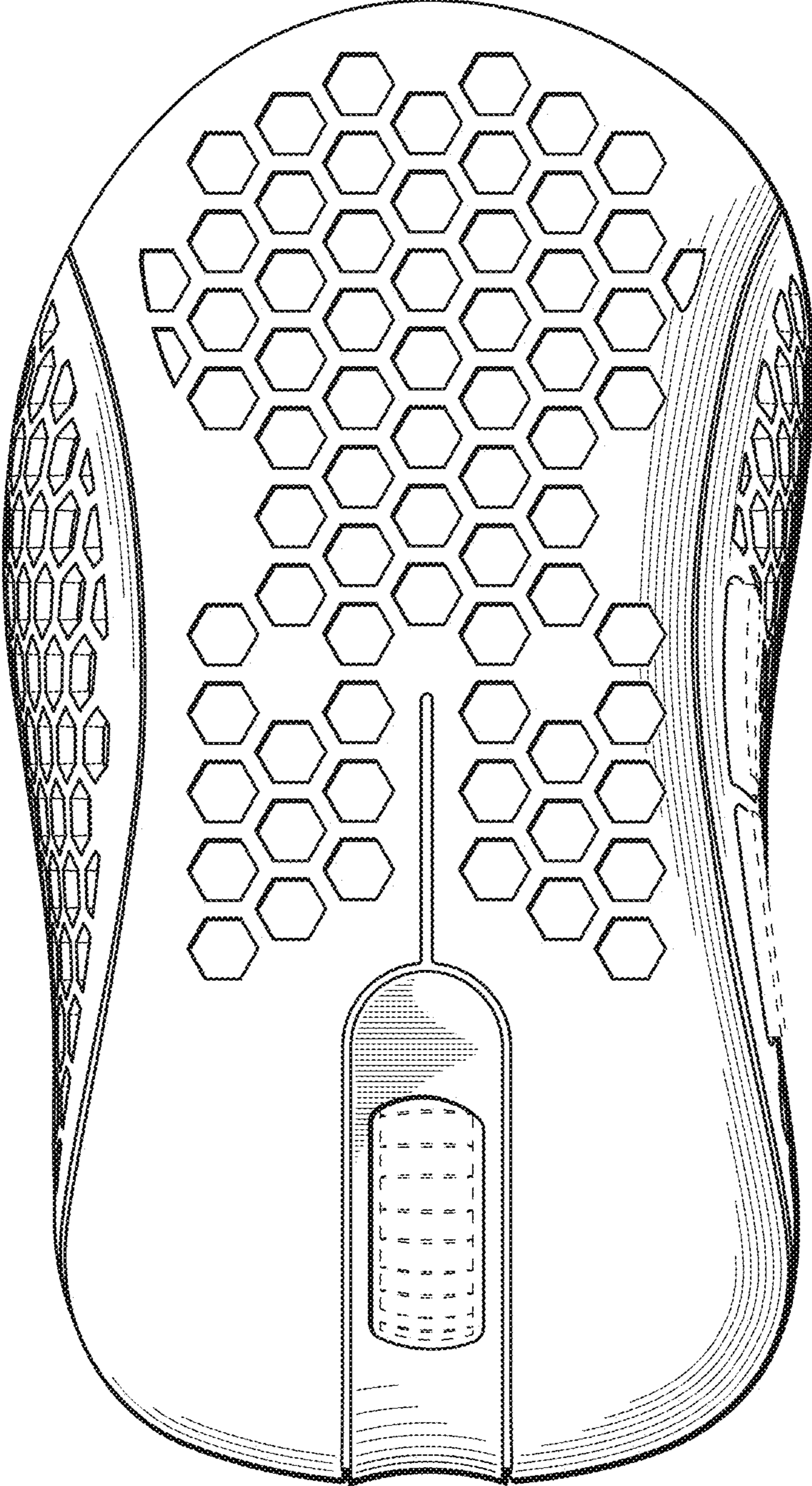

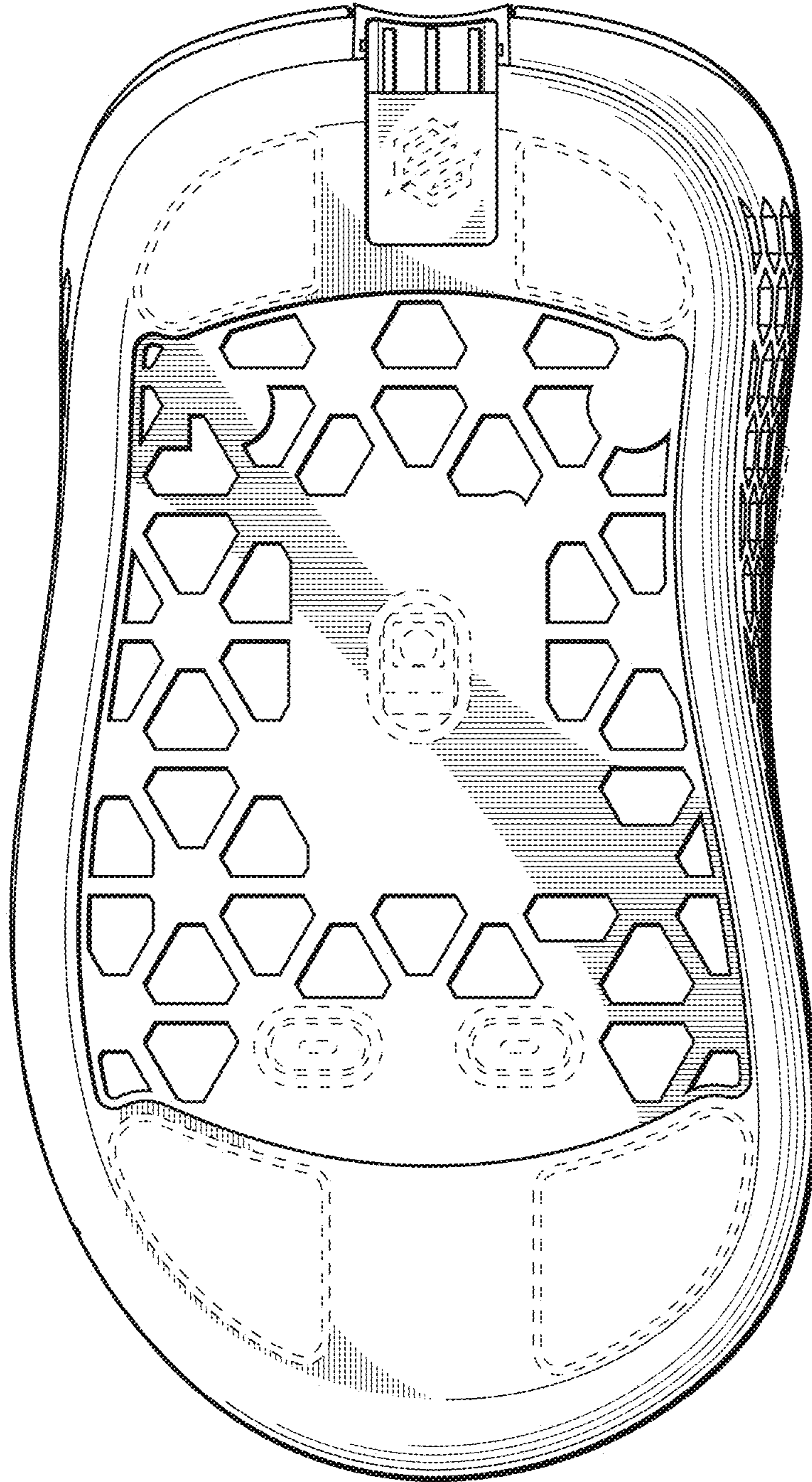
