FIG. 7 is a close-up view of a portion of the claimed design illustrated in FIG. 3.

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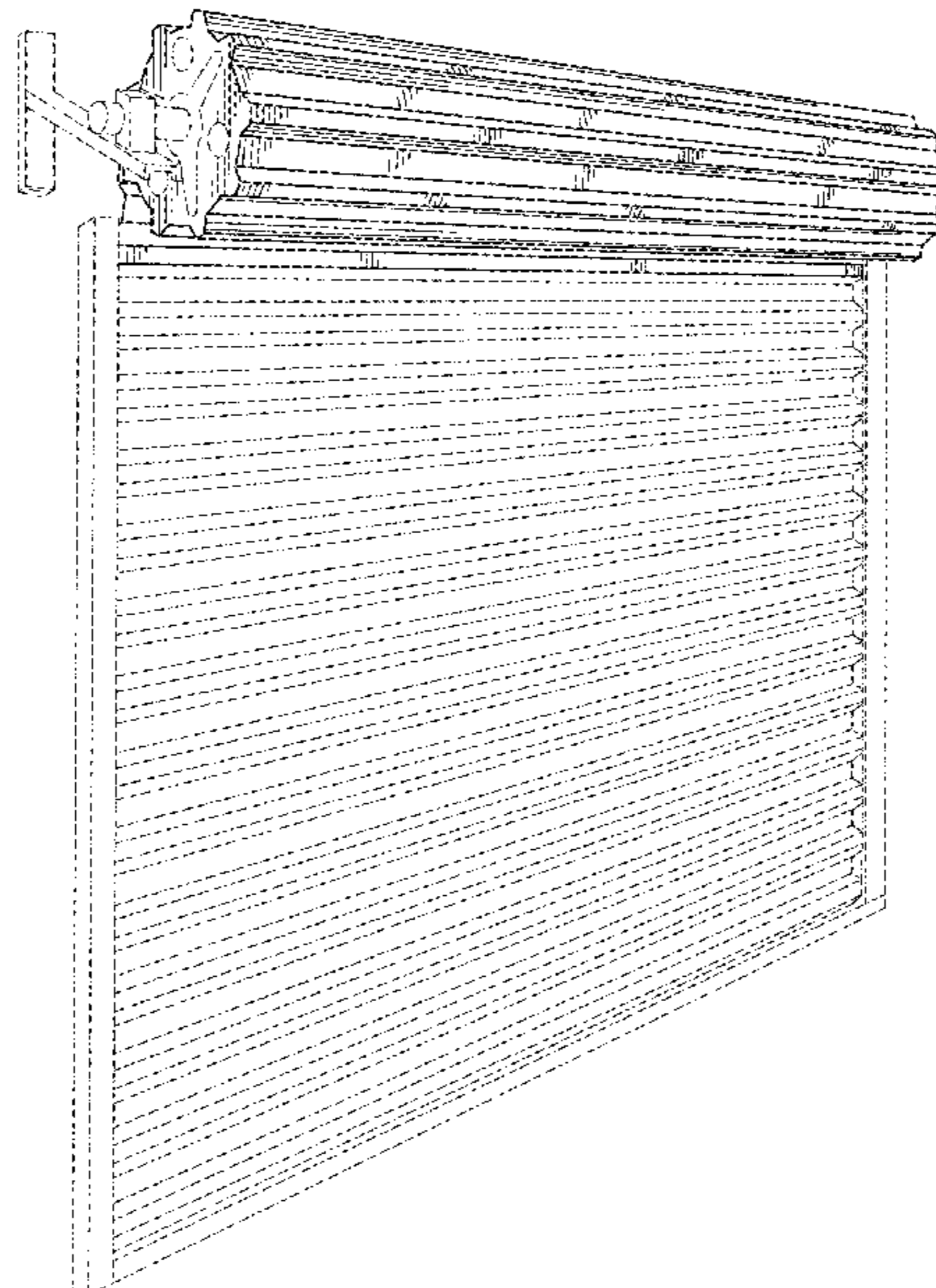
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In the drawings, the broken lines are for the purpose of showing environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

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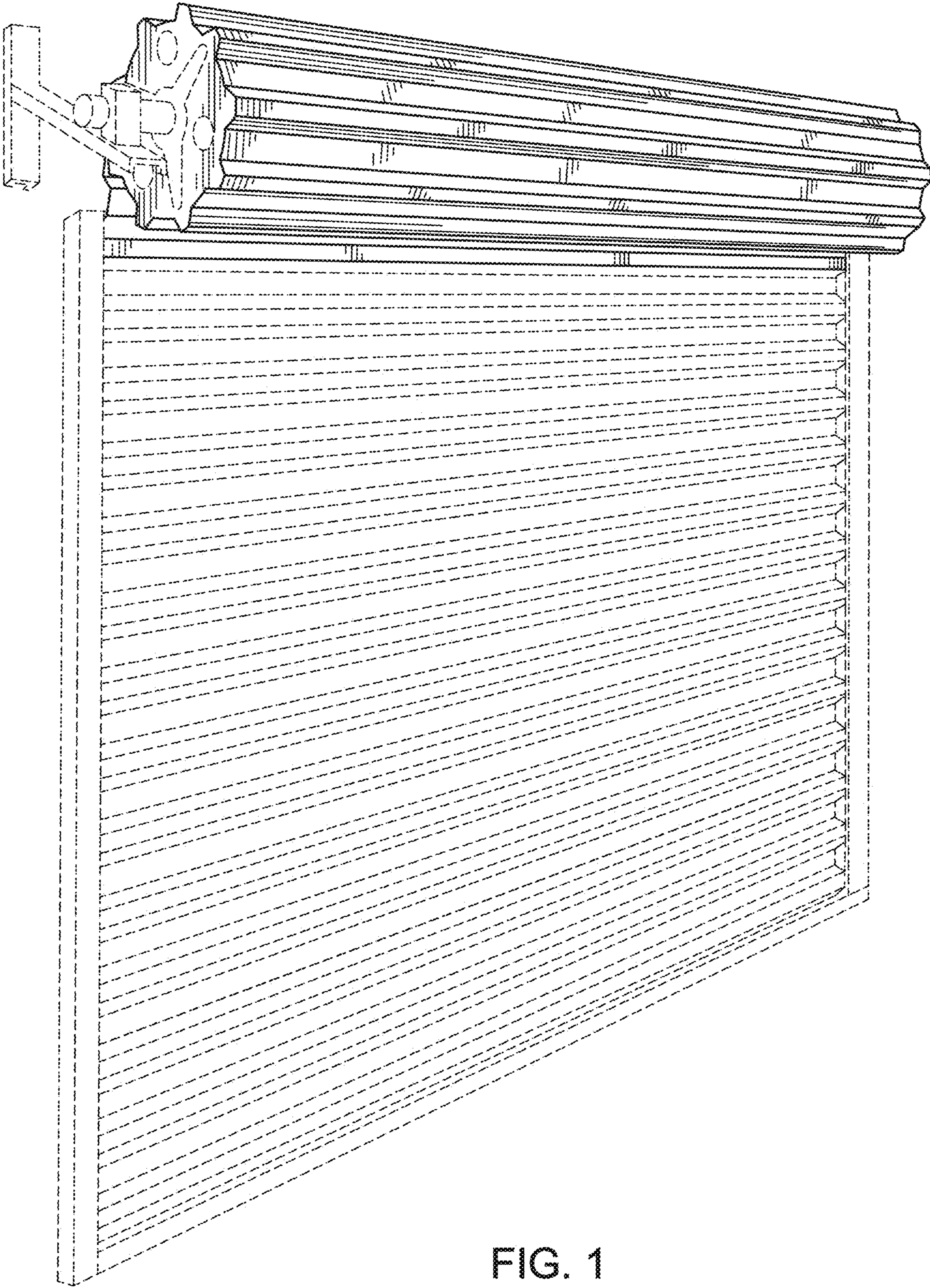

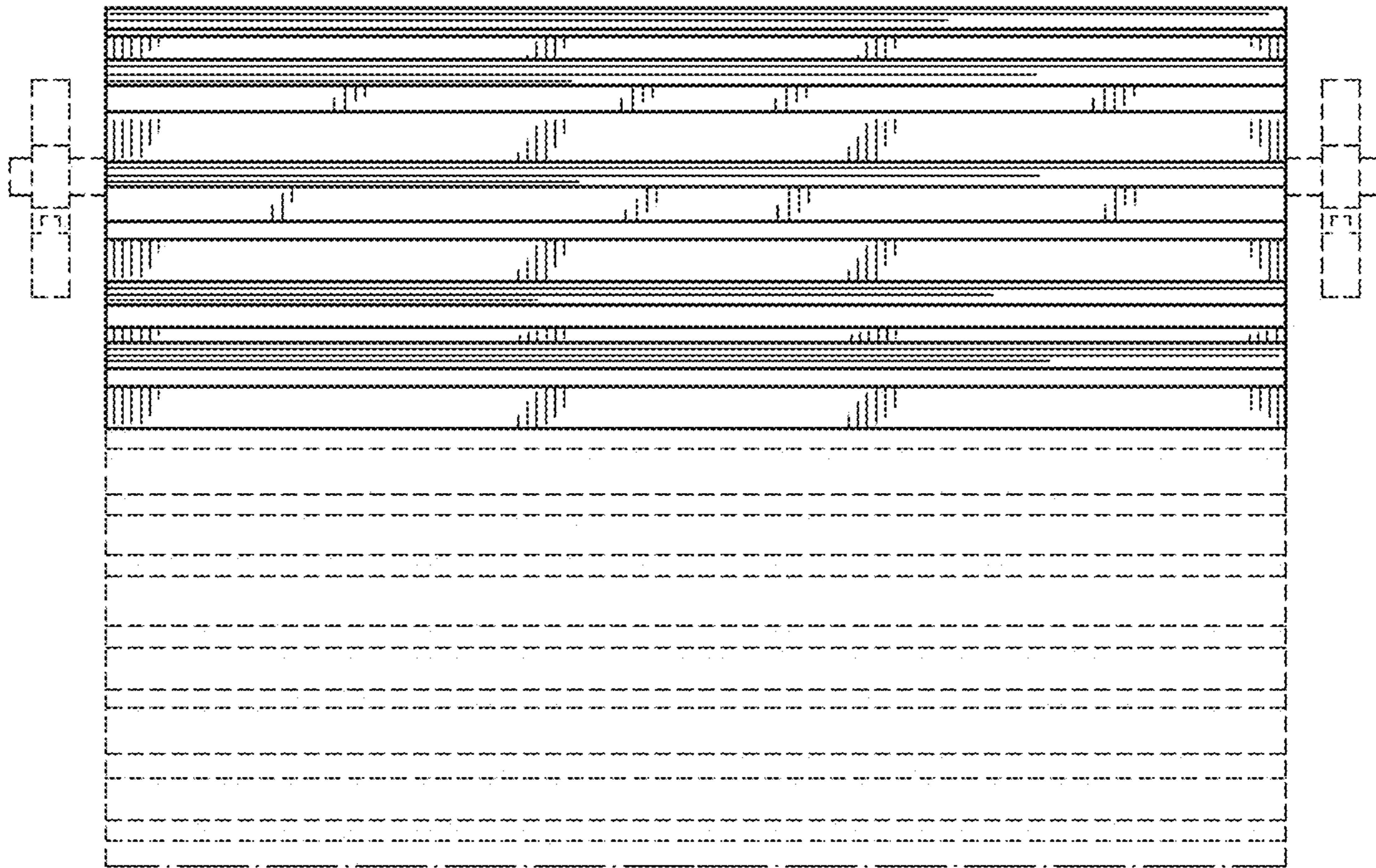

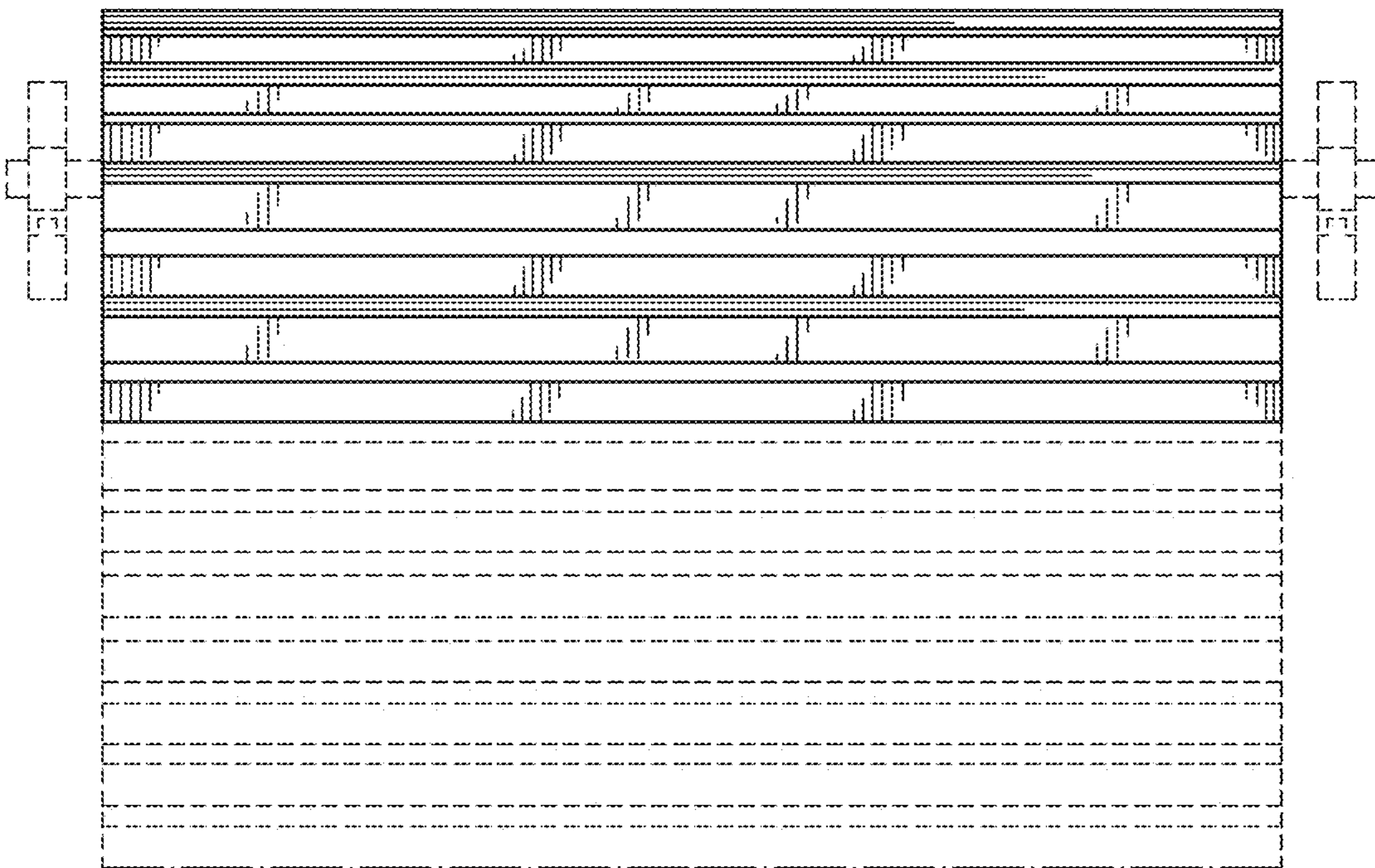

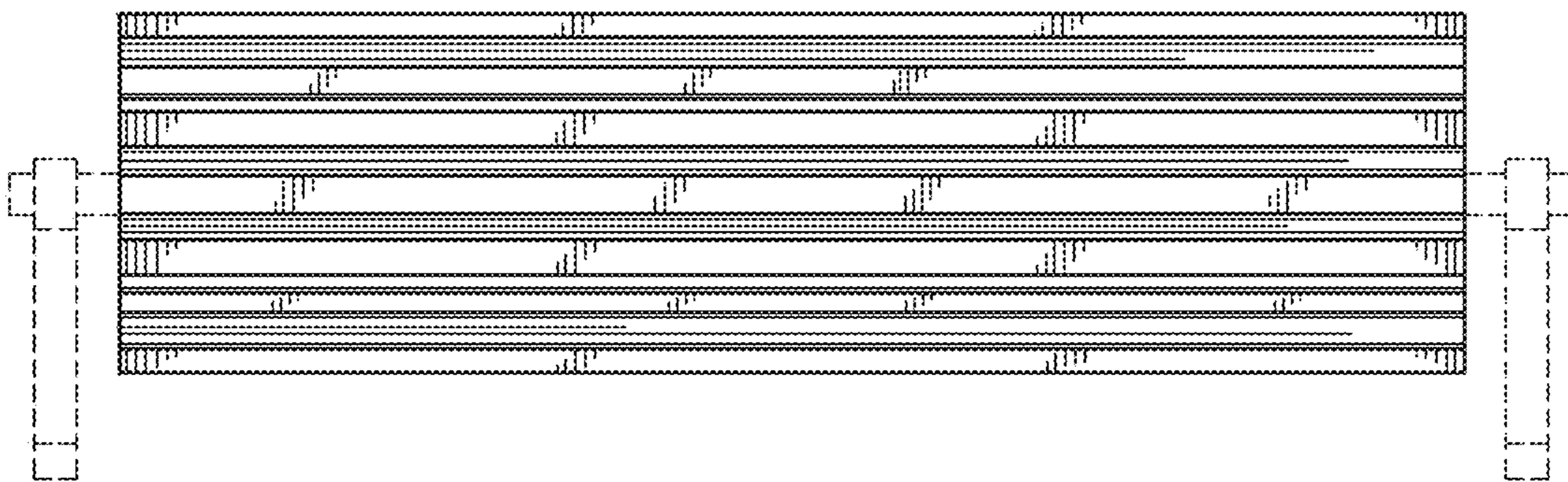
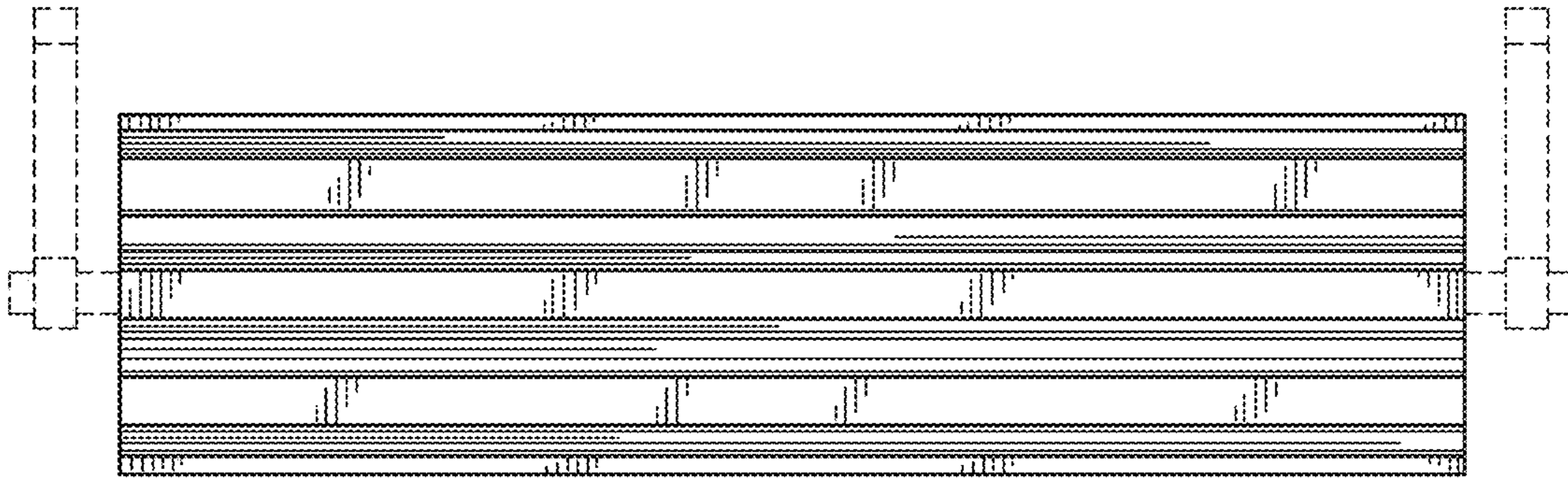

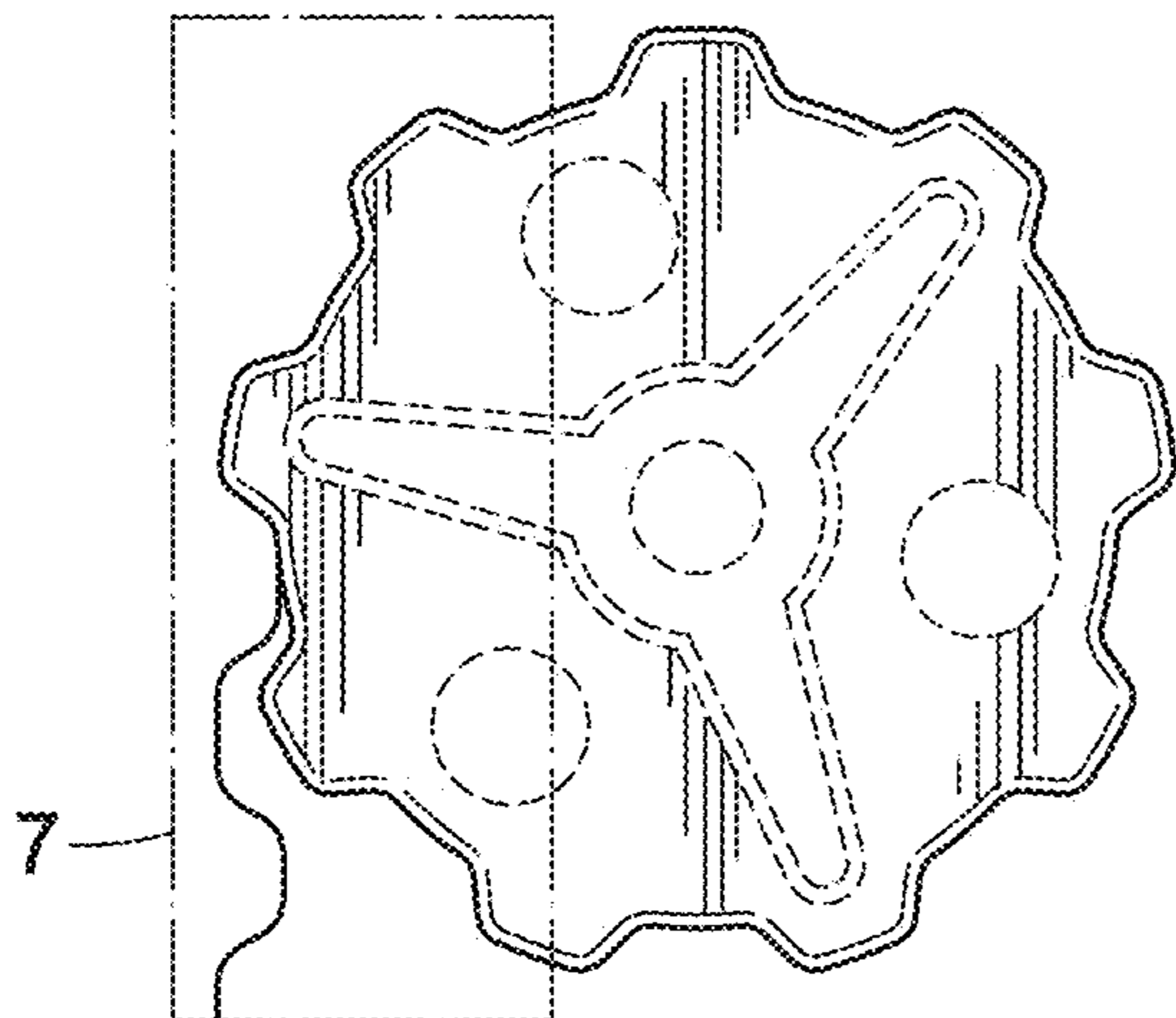
