FIG. 2 is a front view of the convertible electronic device of FIG. 1.

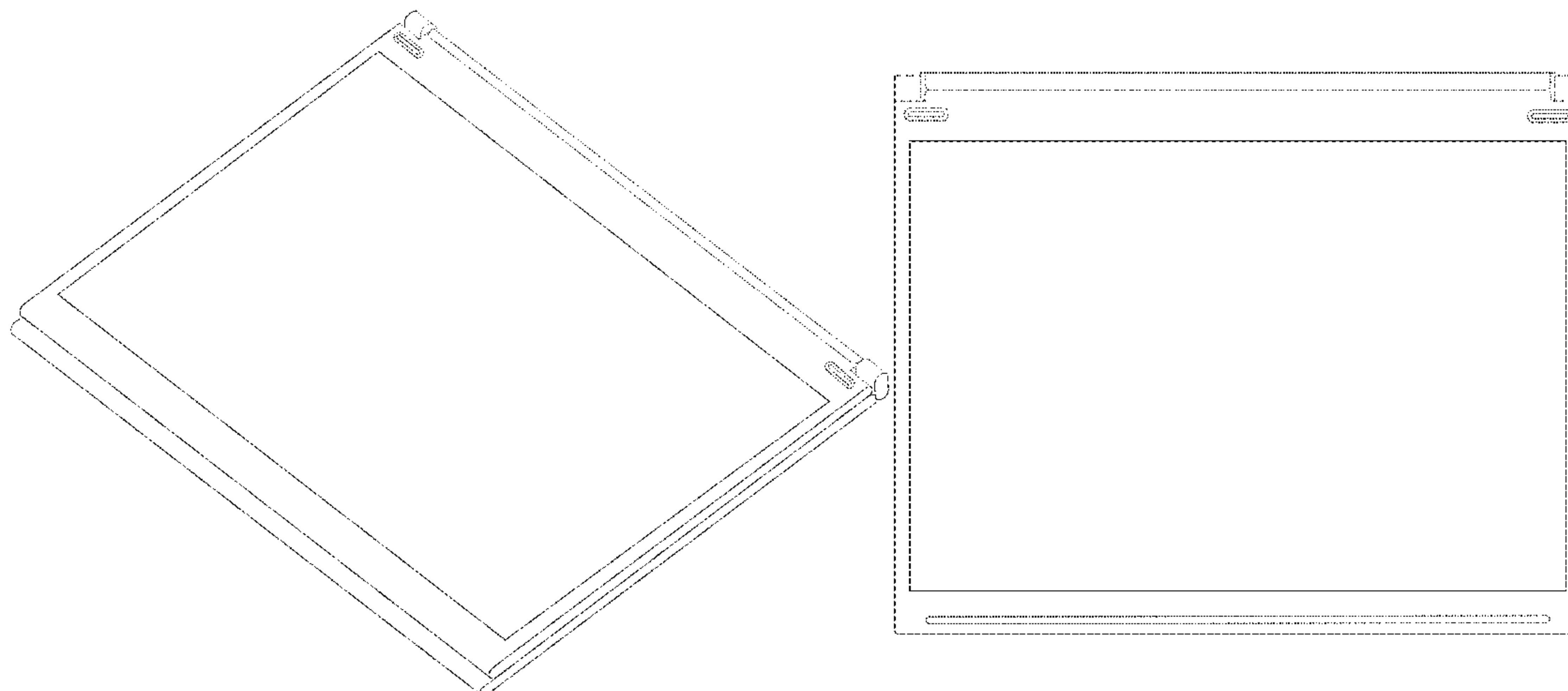
FIG. 3 is a rear view of the convertible electronic device of FIG. 1.

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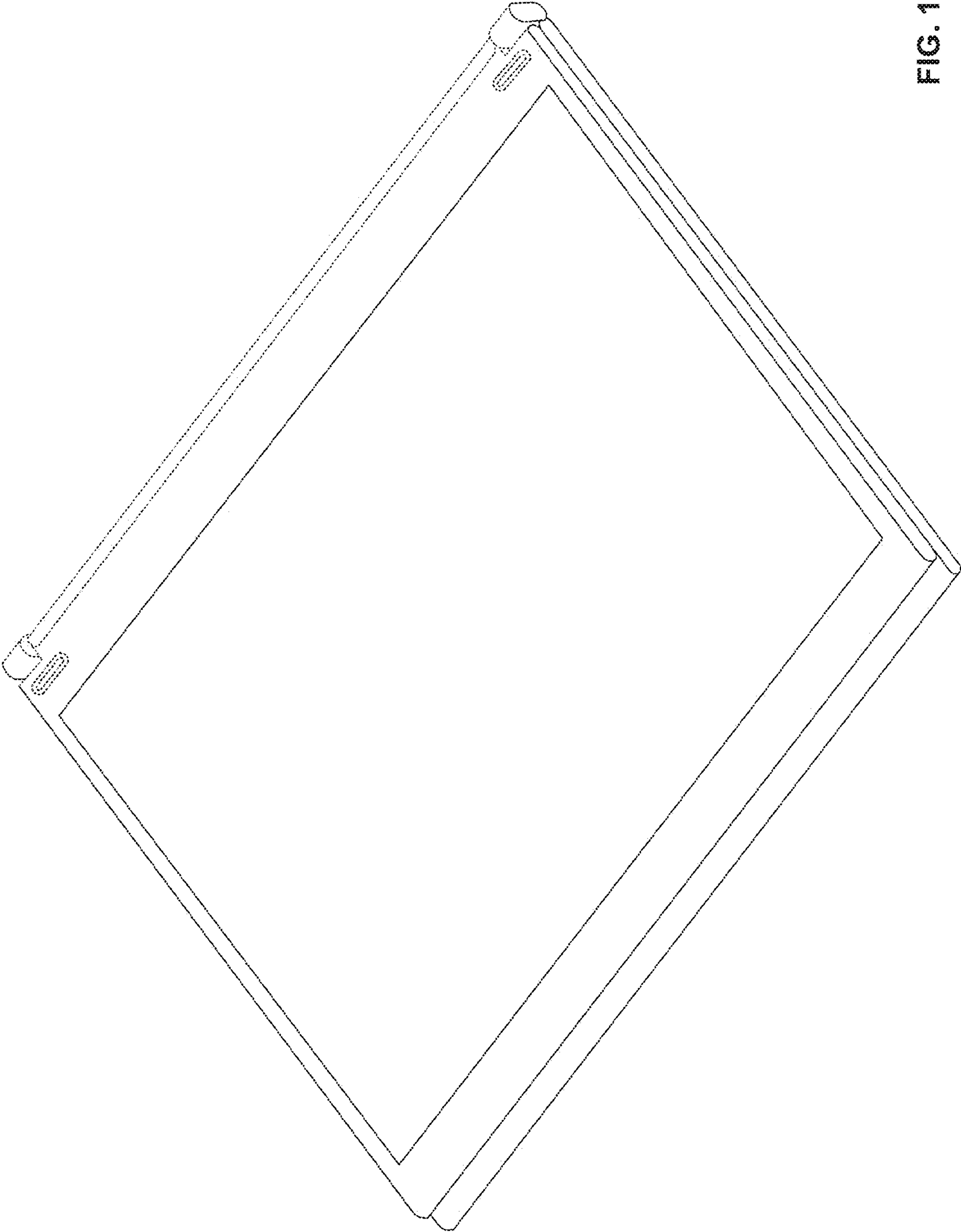

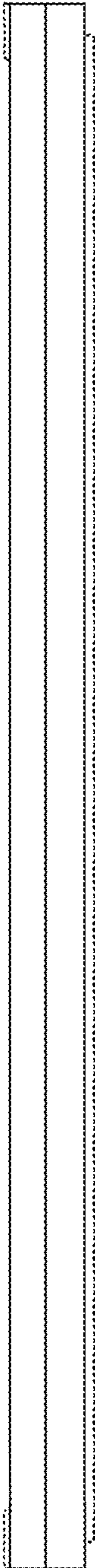
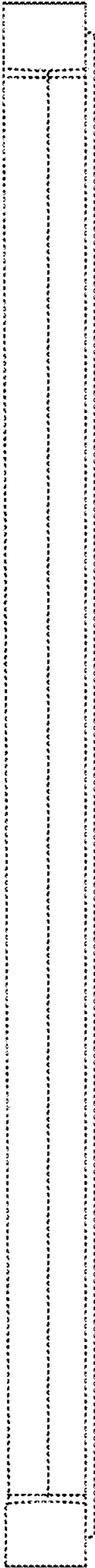

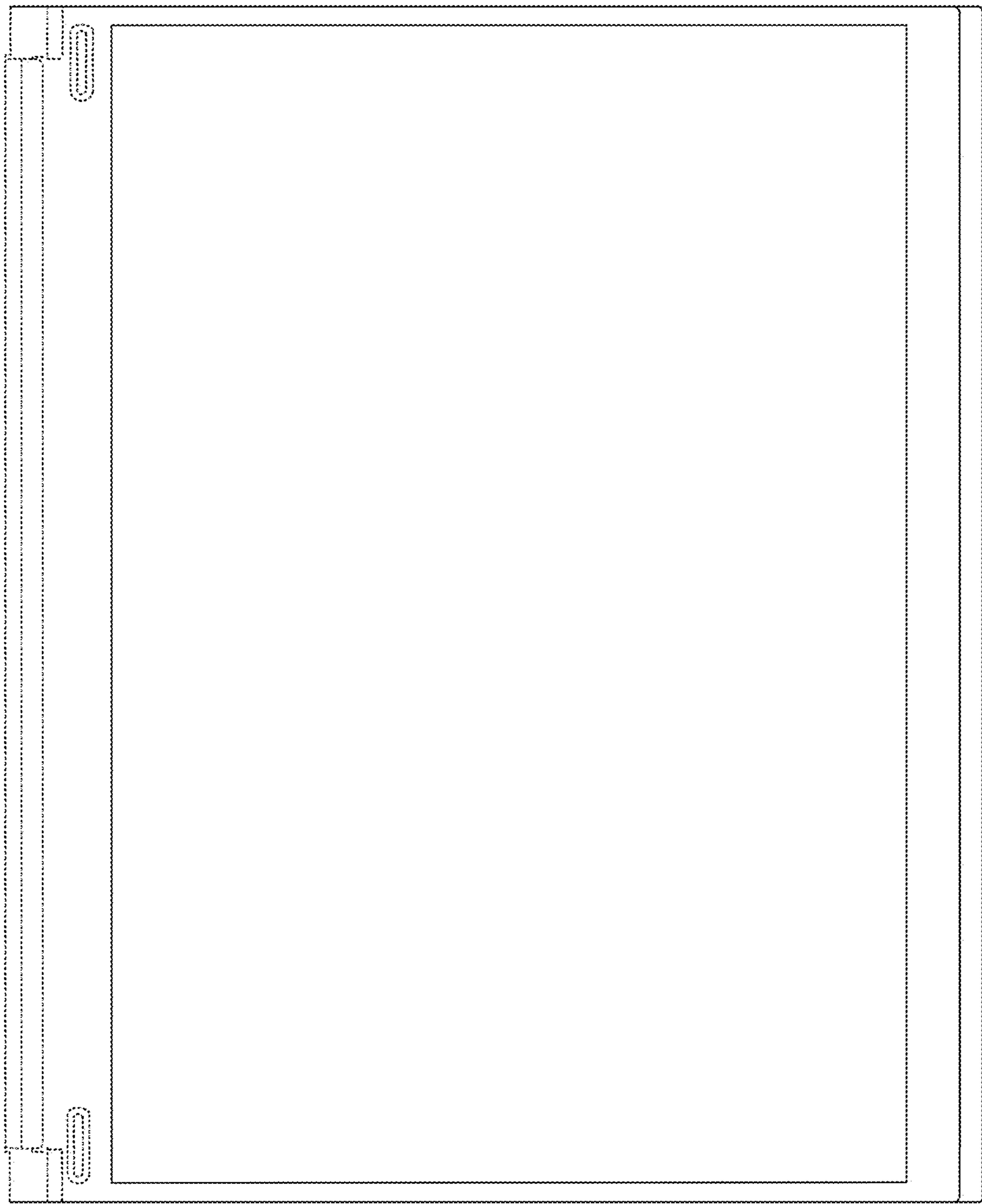

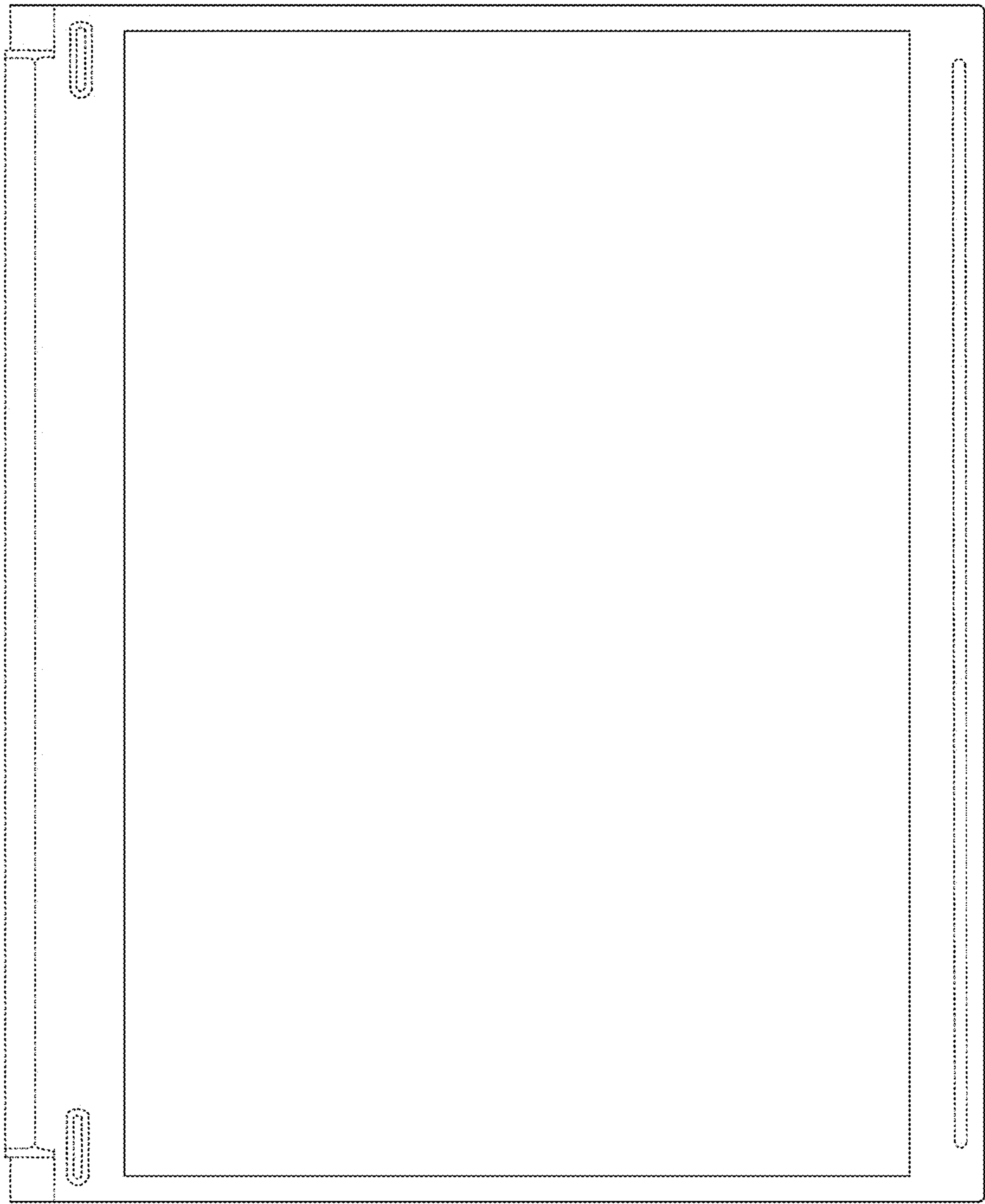
