(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a first image in a sequence of a display screen or portion thereof with animated graphical user interface, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front view of a second image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view of a third image thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a front view of a fourth image thereof.

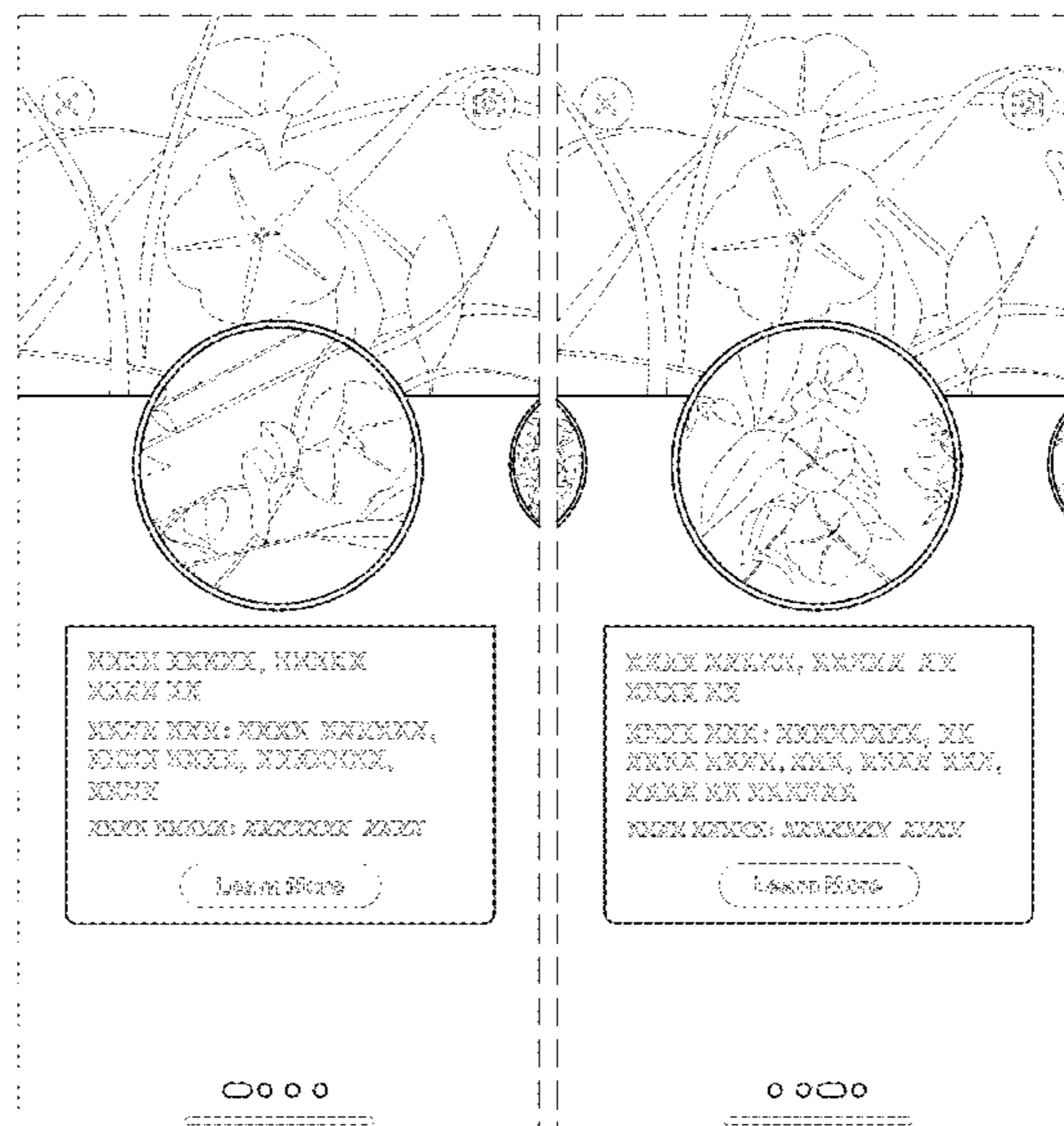

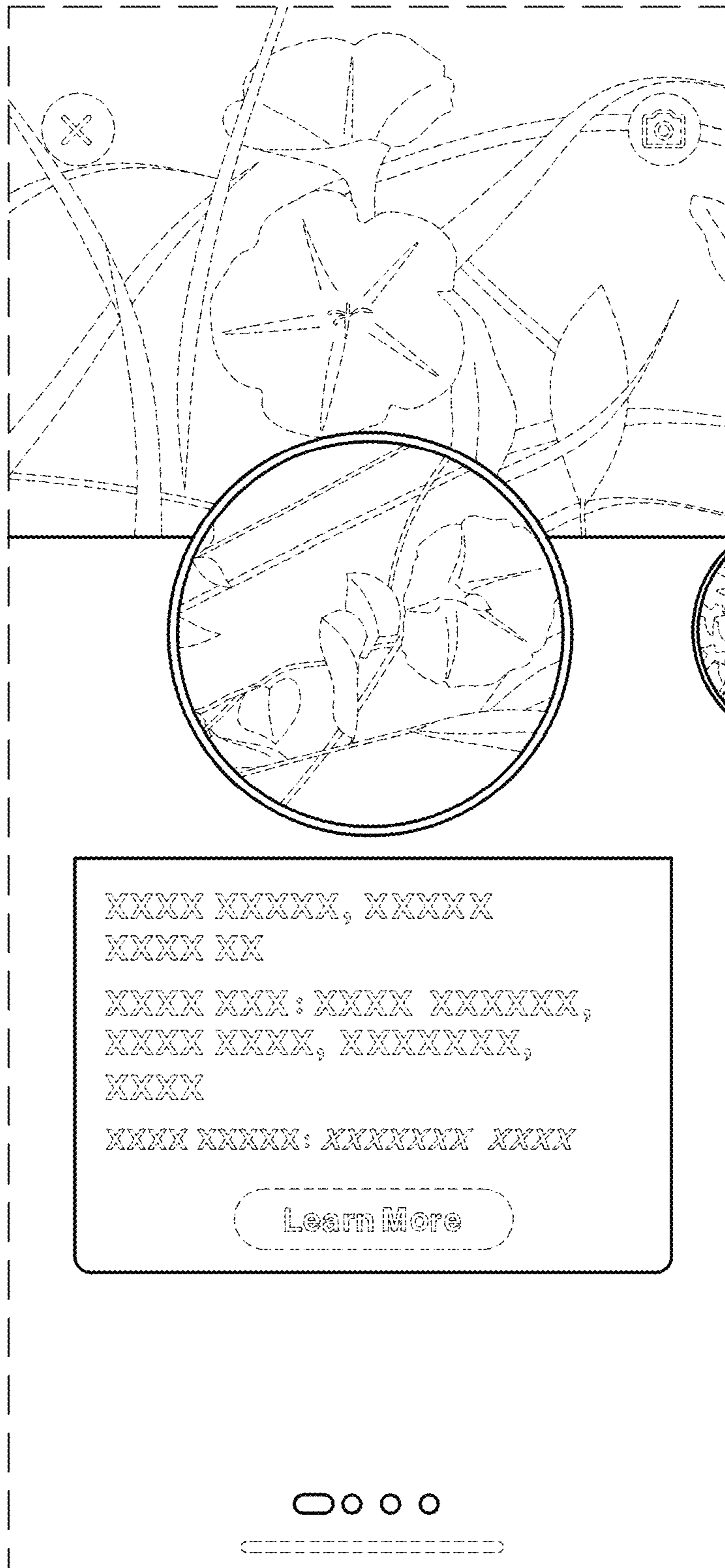

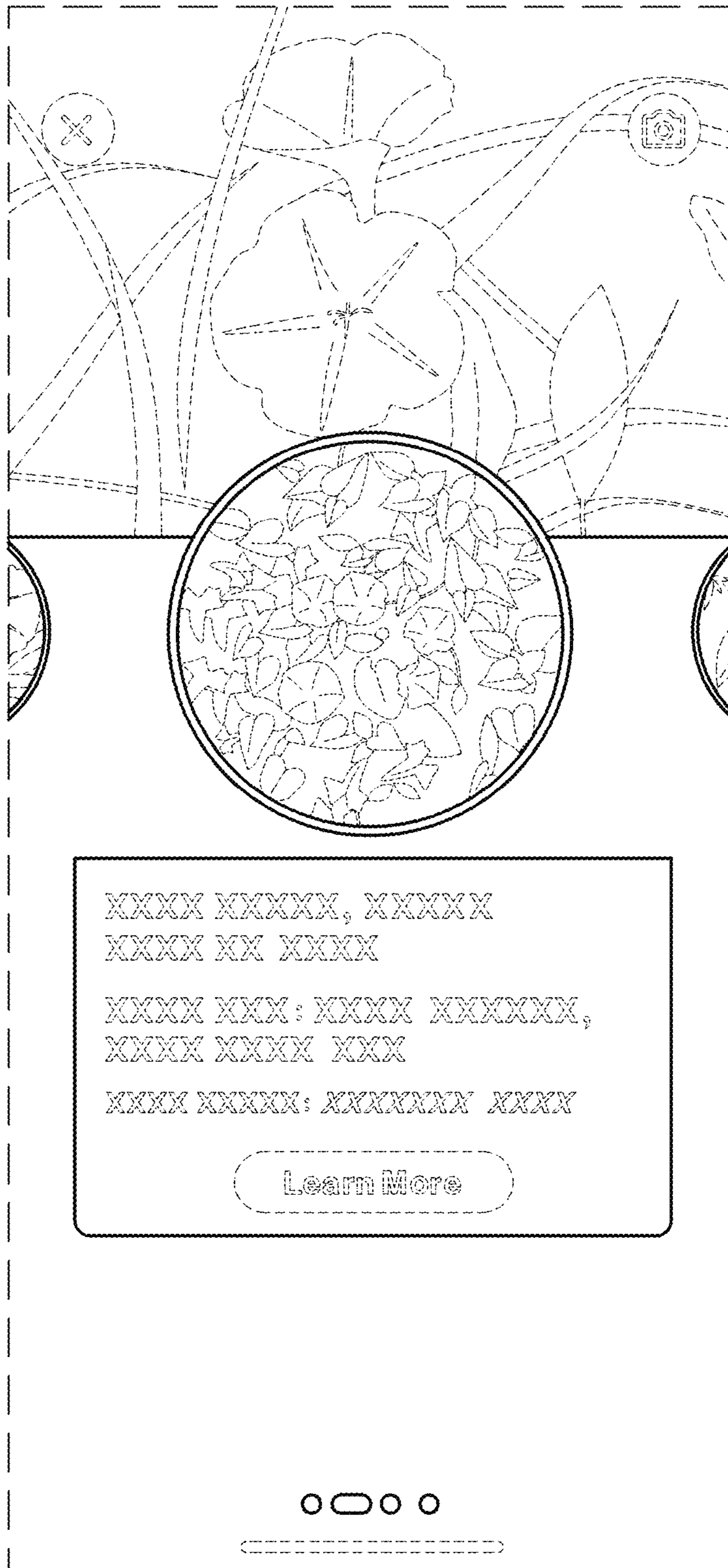

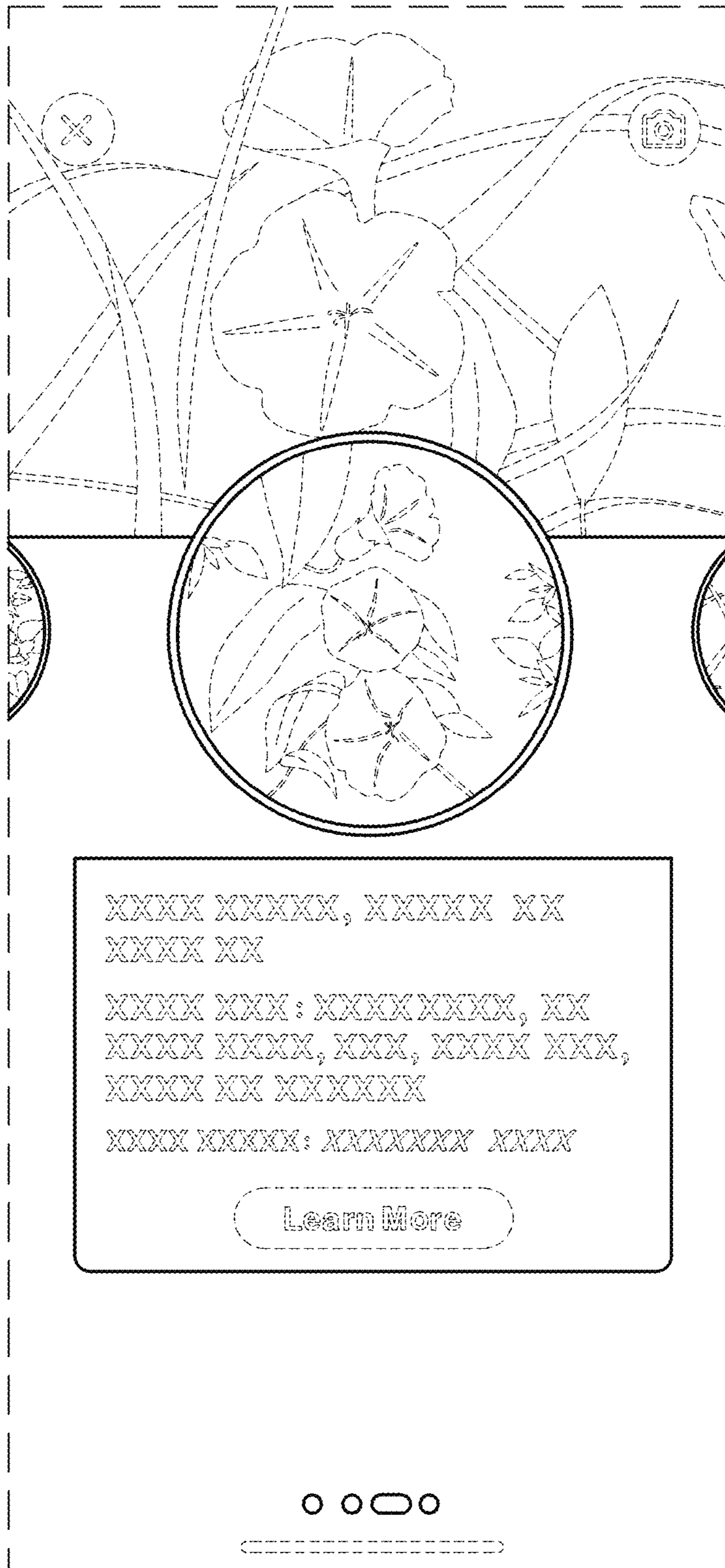

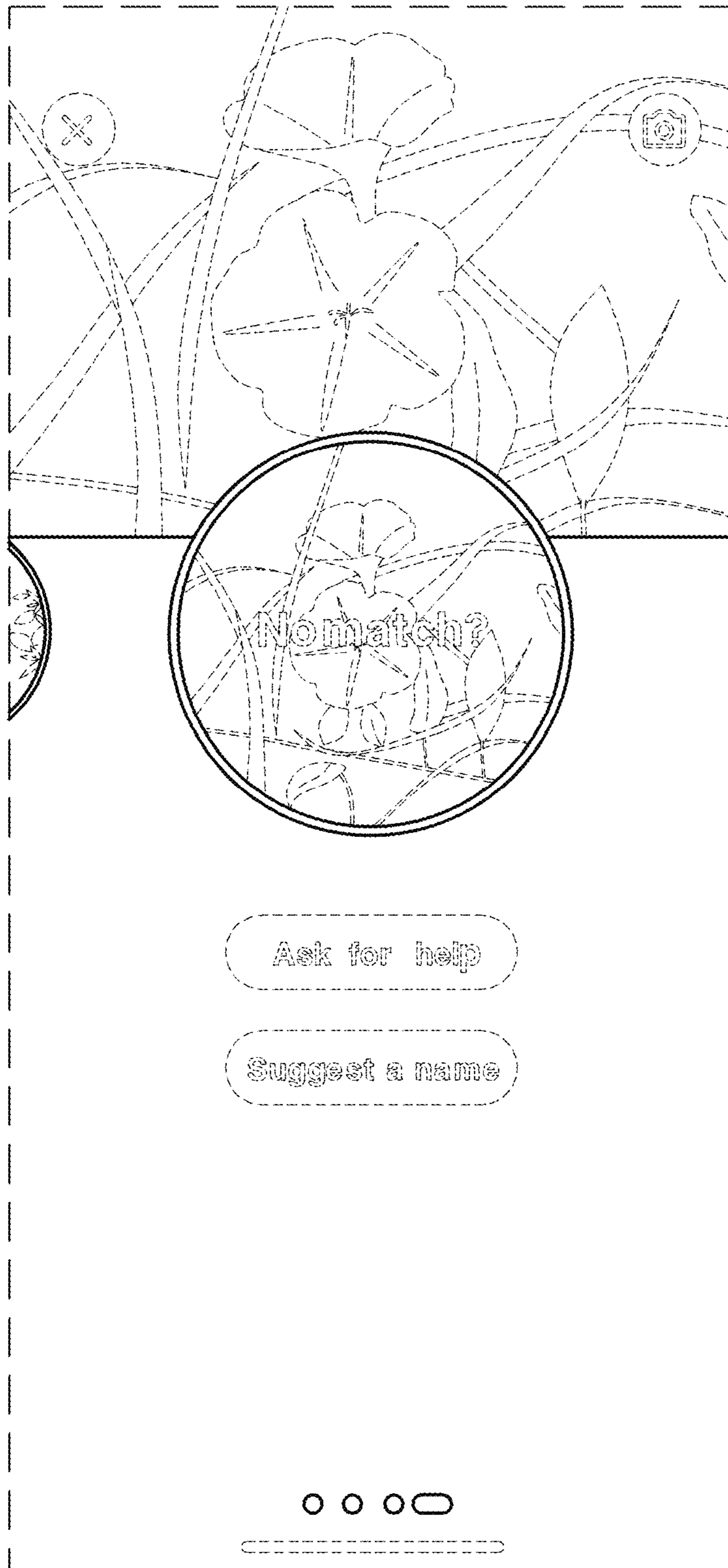
