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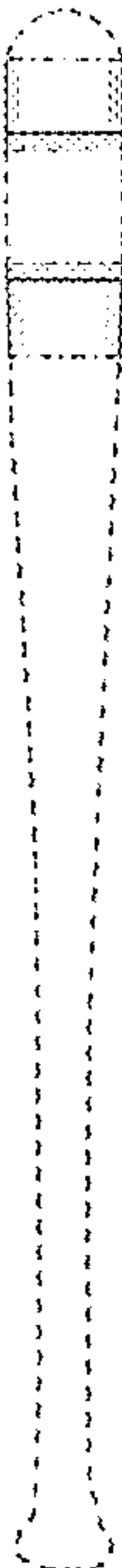
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a bat.
FIG. 2 is an opposite side view of the bat of FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is an end view of the bat of FIG. 1.
FIG. 4 is another end view of the bat of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 5 is a close up of a portion of the bat shown in FIG. 2.
The broken lines form no part of the claimed design. The line and dot shading shown in the Figures indicates a contrast between those portions of the bat.

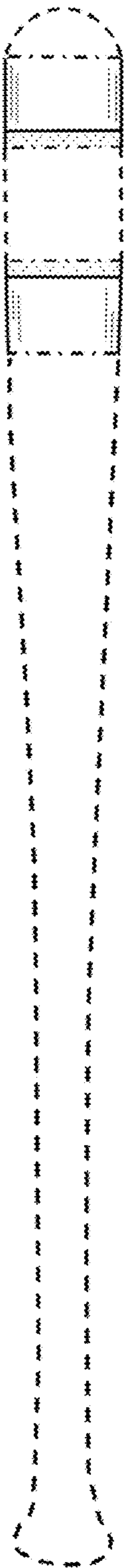

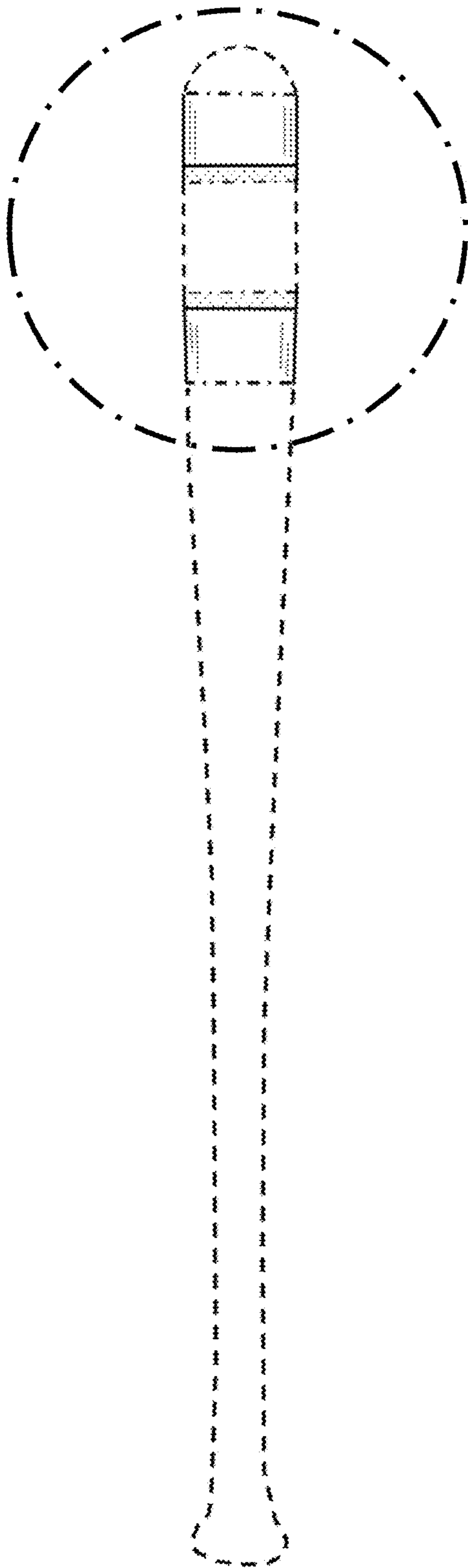

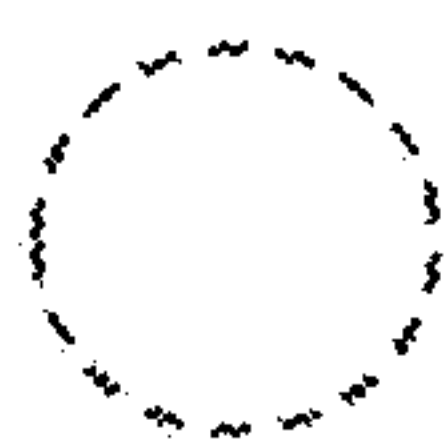

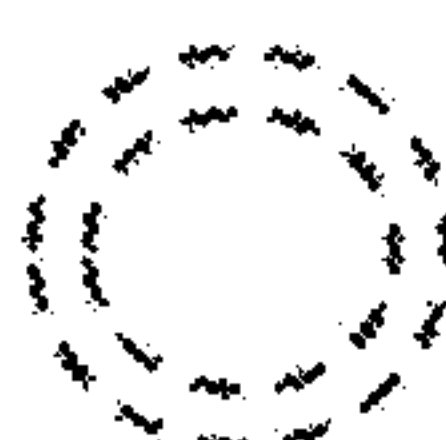

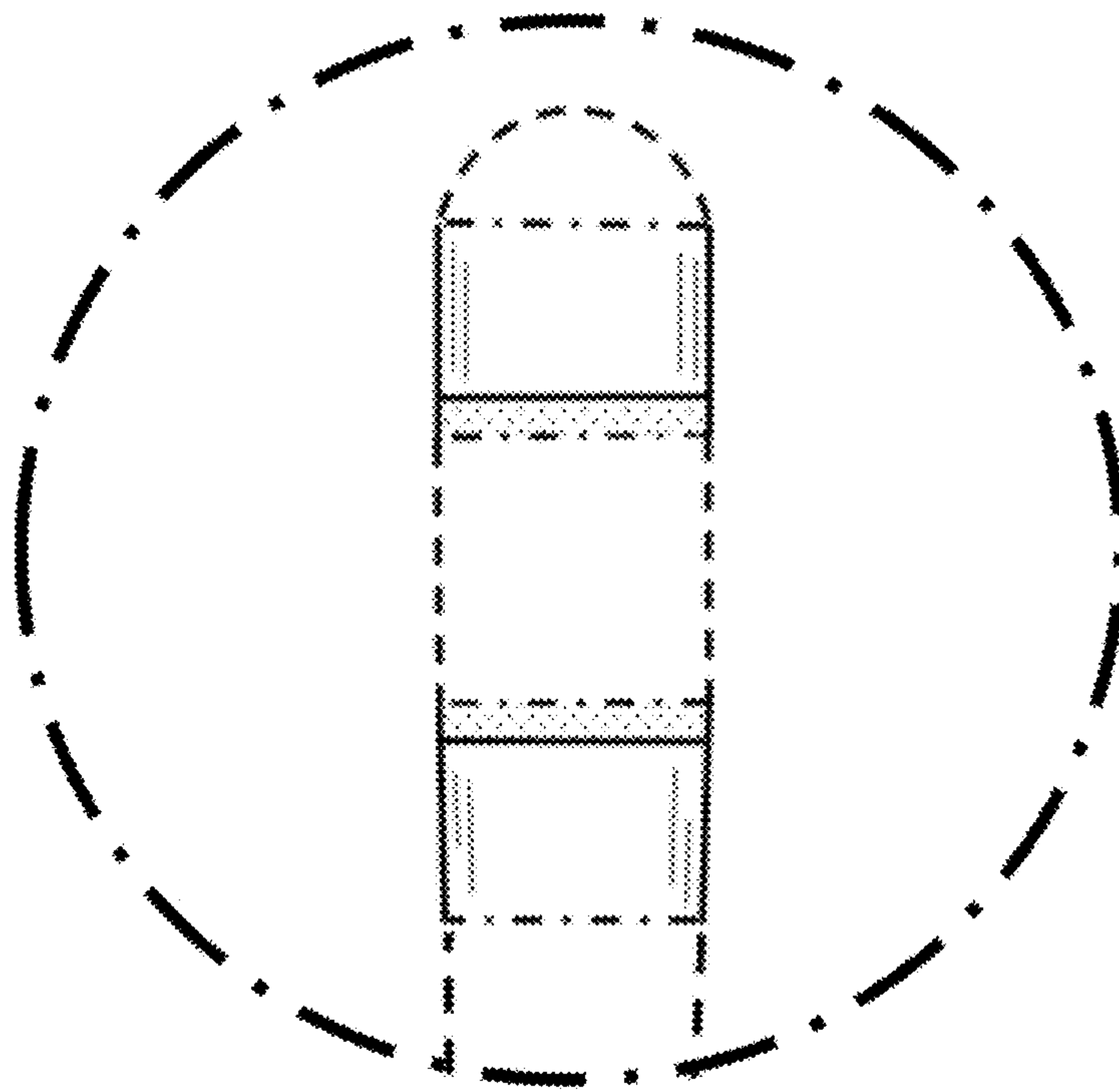
