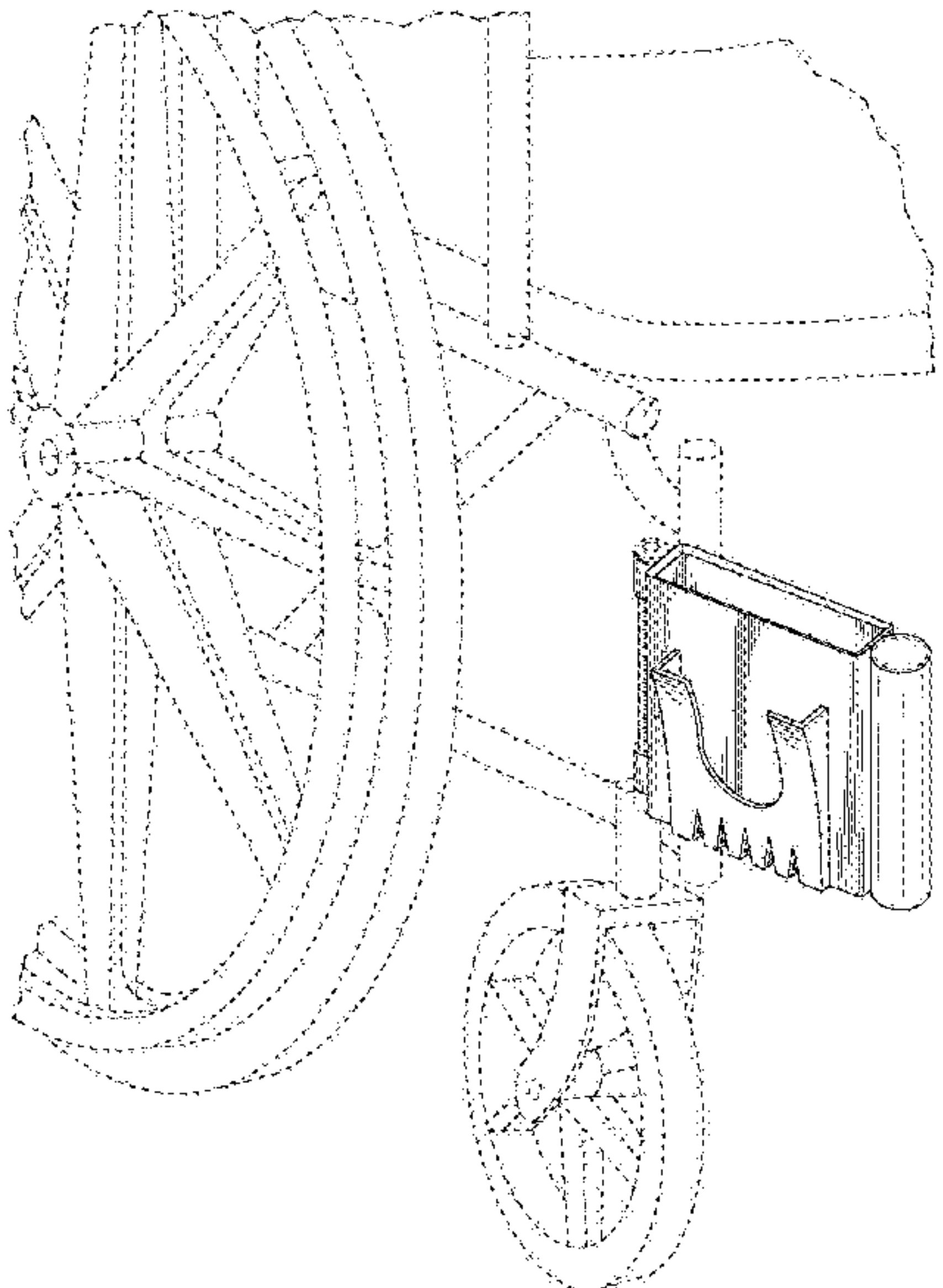
The ornamental design for a carrying case for mobile phones

DESCRIPTION

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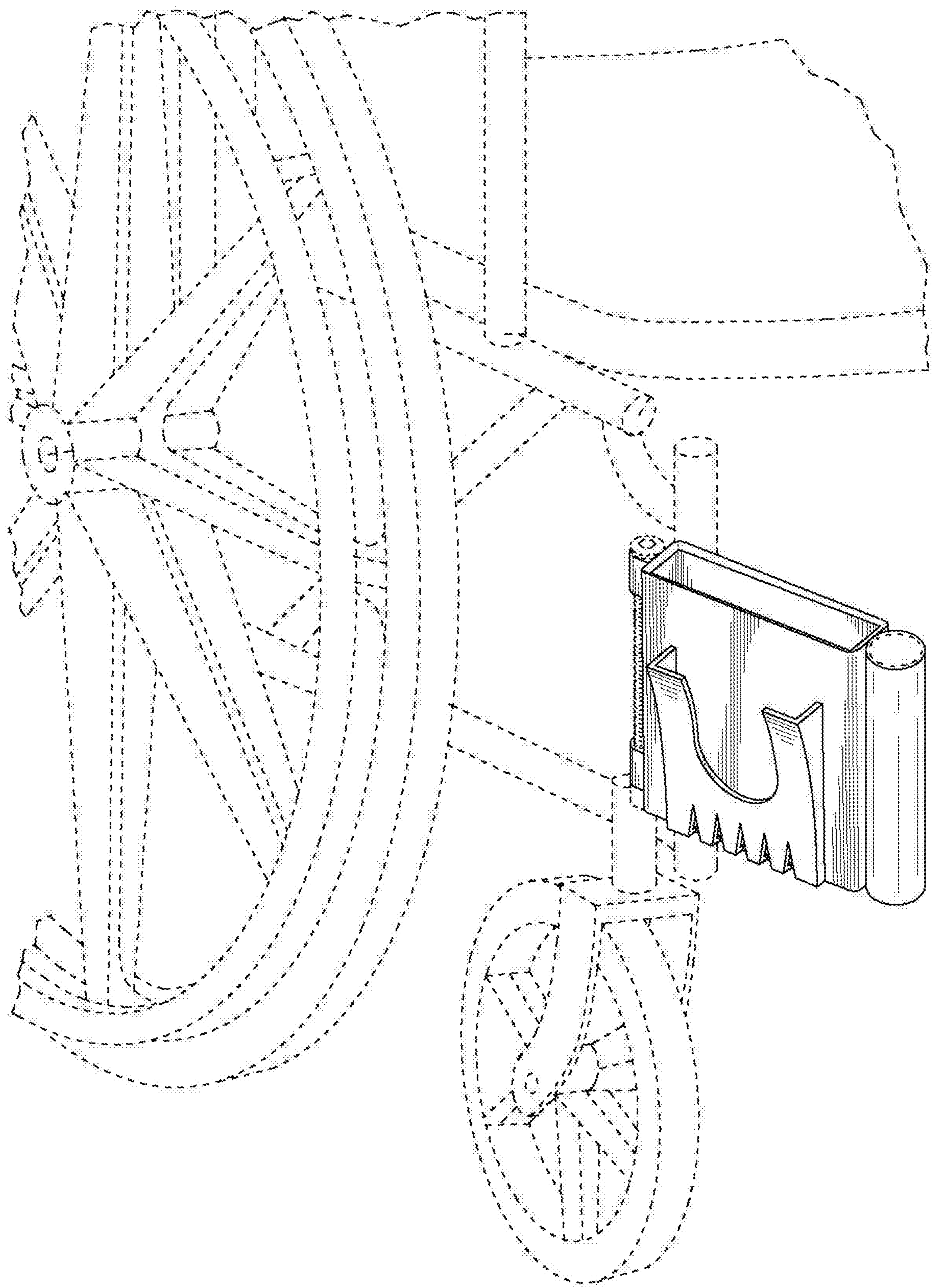

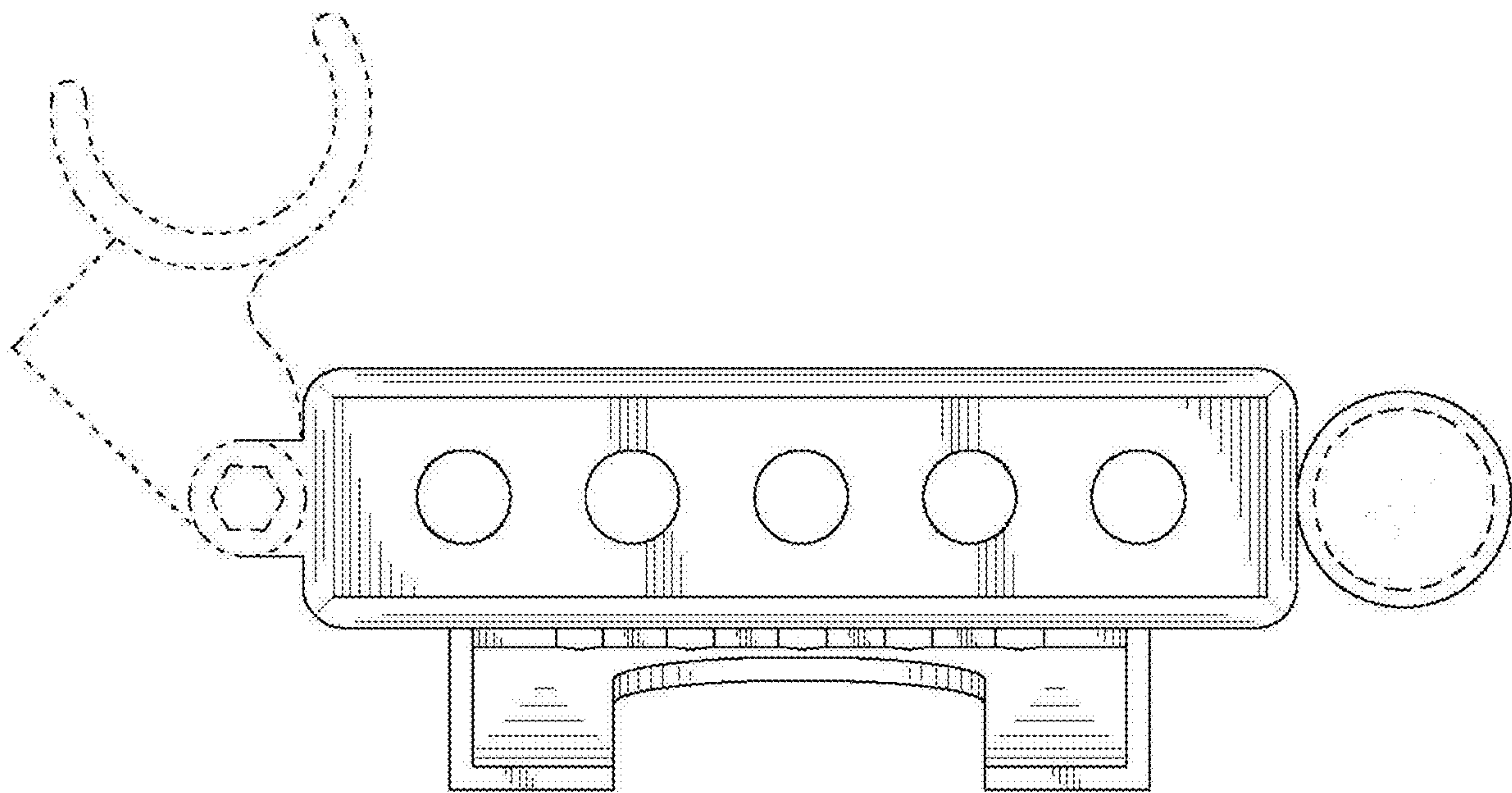

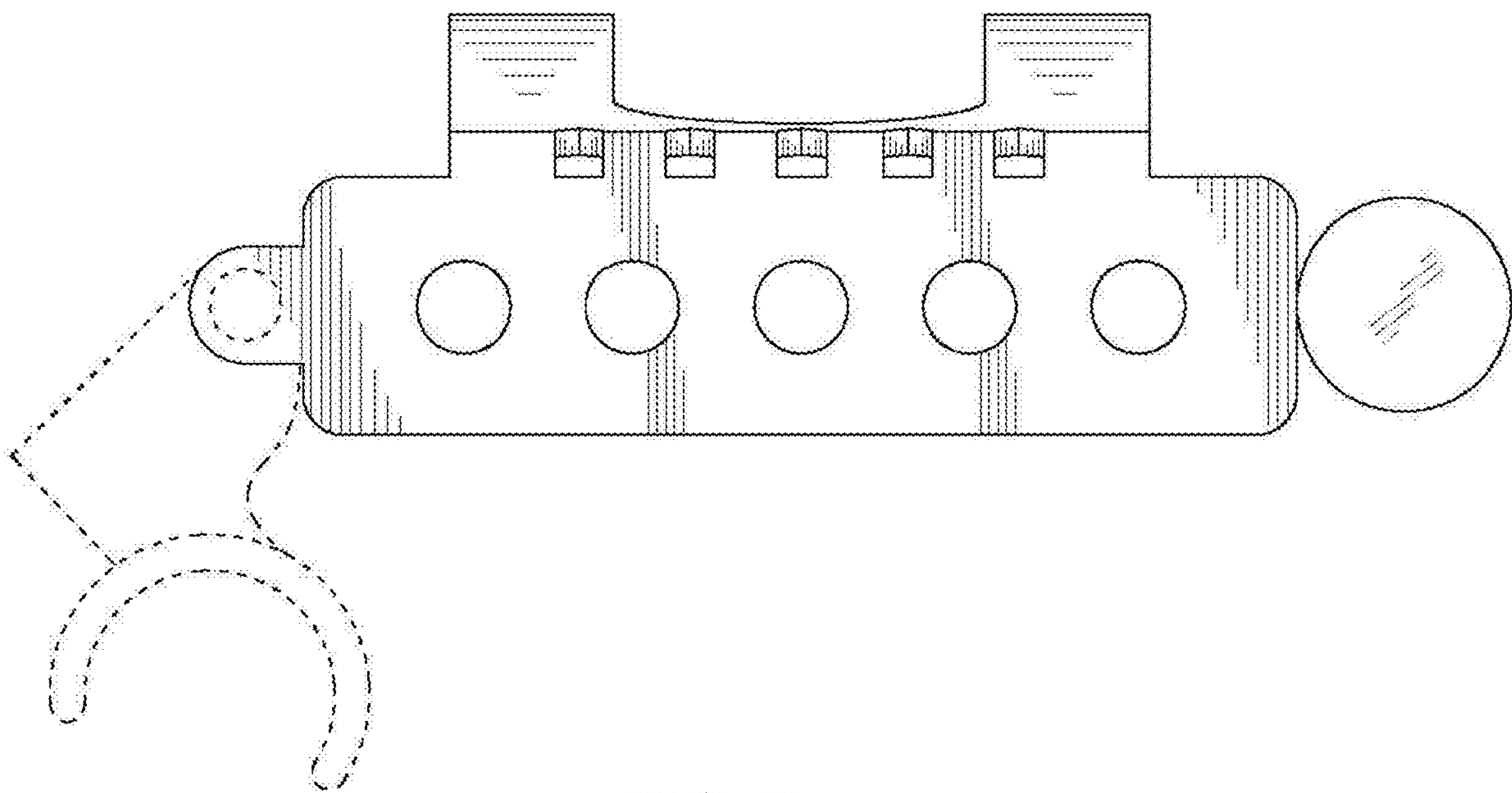

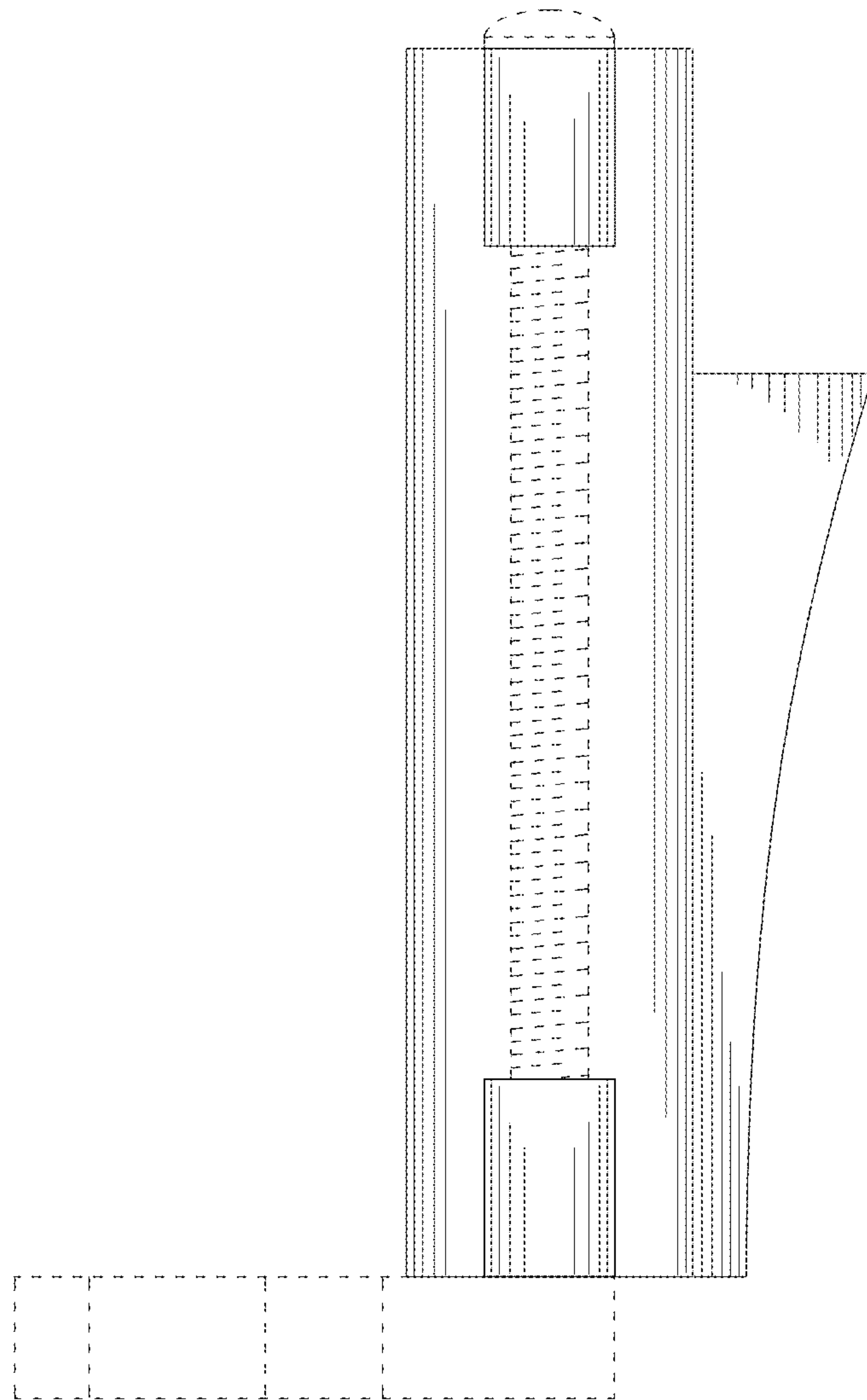

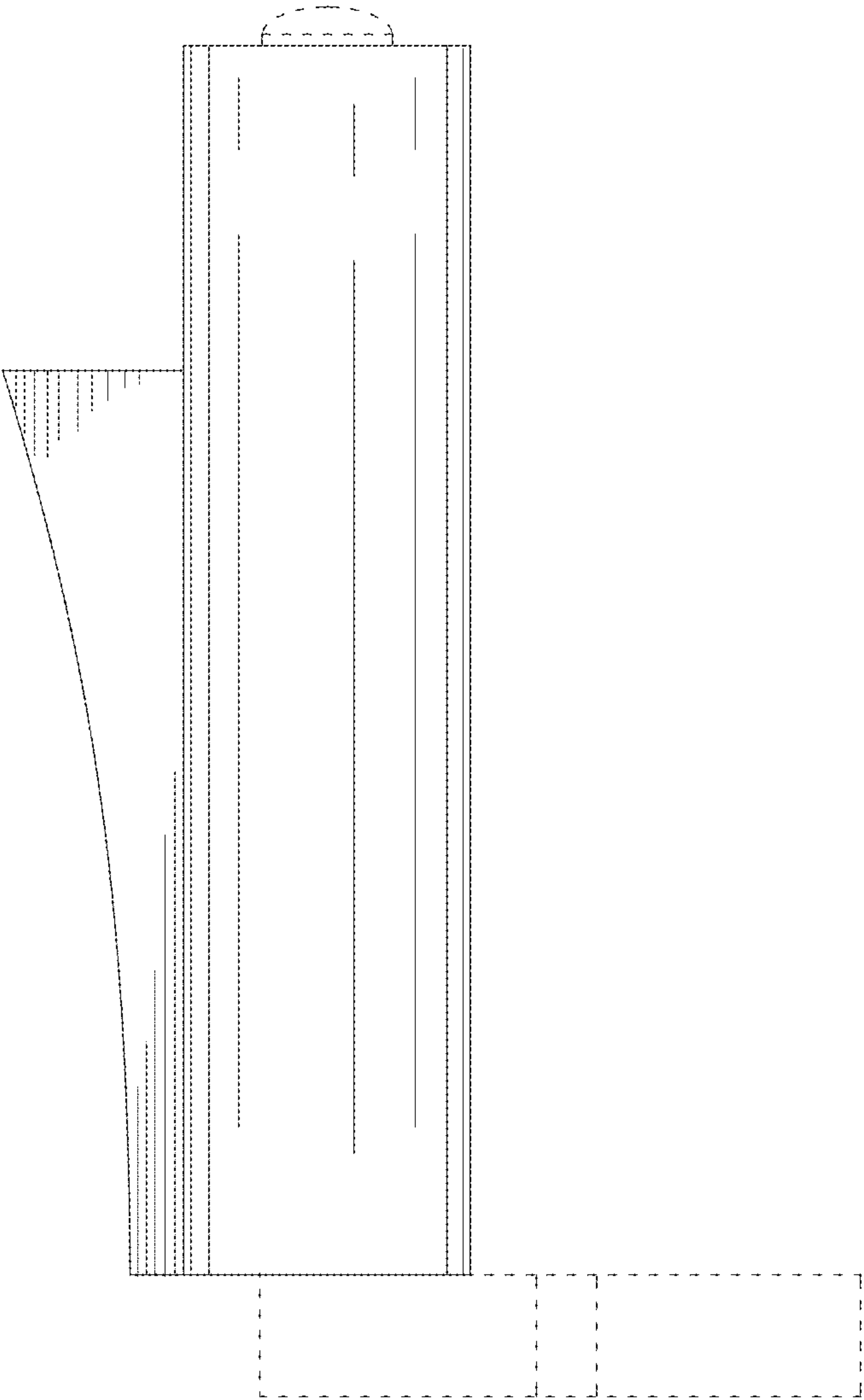

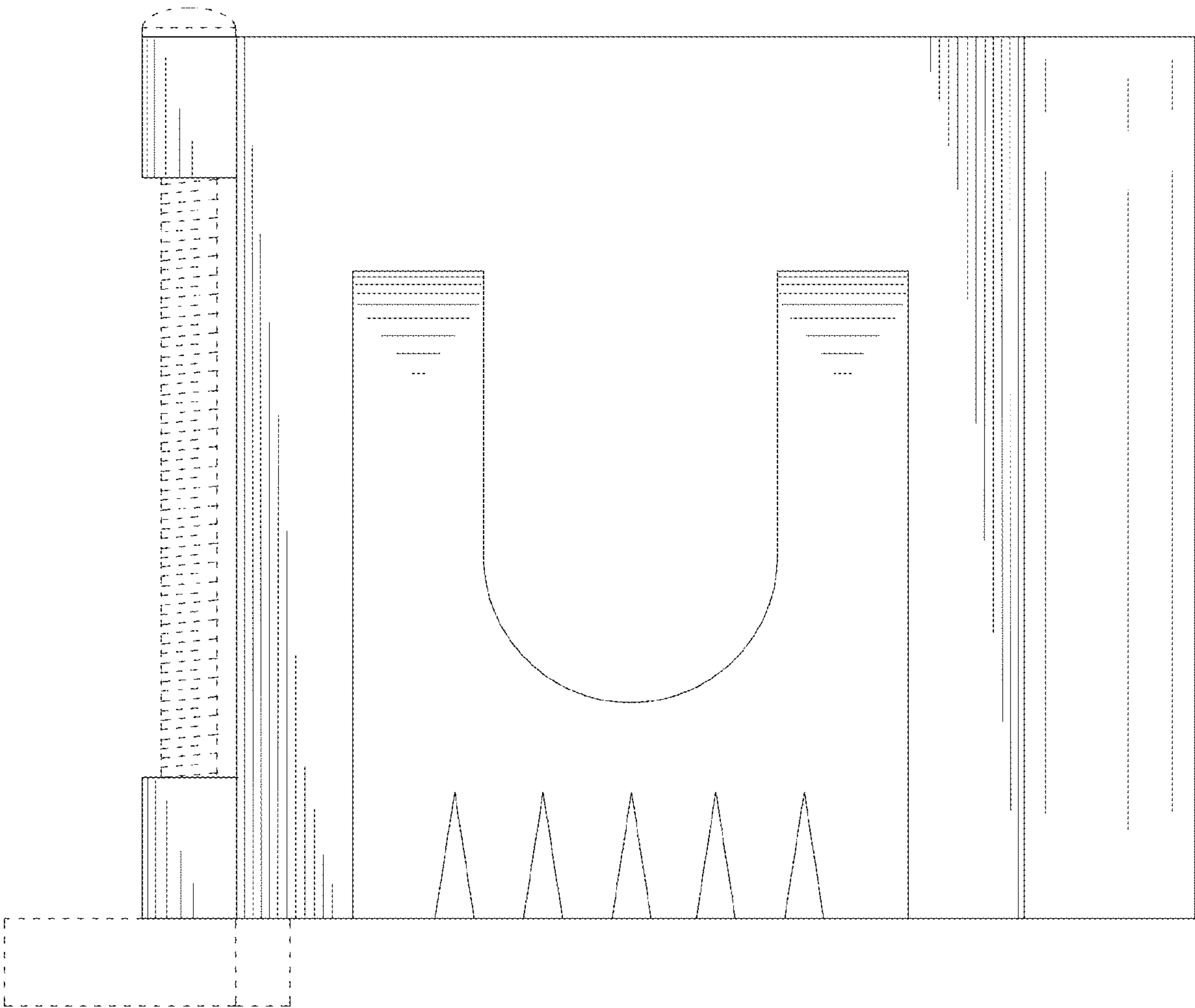

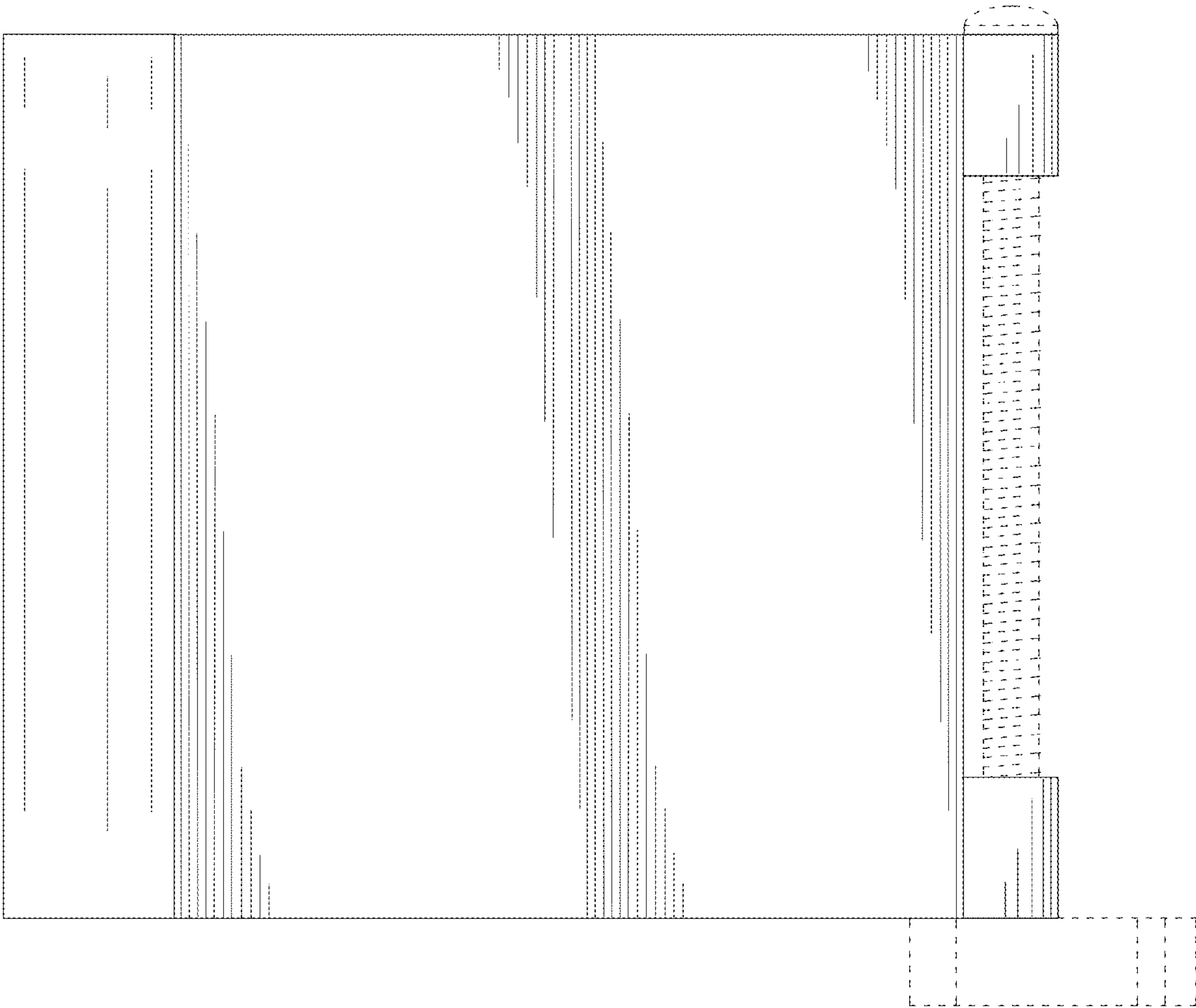
