The ornamental design for a brush tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is side perspective view of a brush tool, with a bristle holder shown in place, in accordance with an embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a side perspective view of the brush tool, with the bristle holder shown in FIG. 1 removed, for completeness of illustration;

FIG. 3 is a right-side elevation view of the brush tool shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view of the brush tool shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the brush tool shown in FIG. 2;

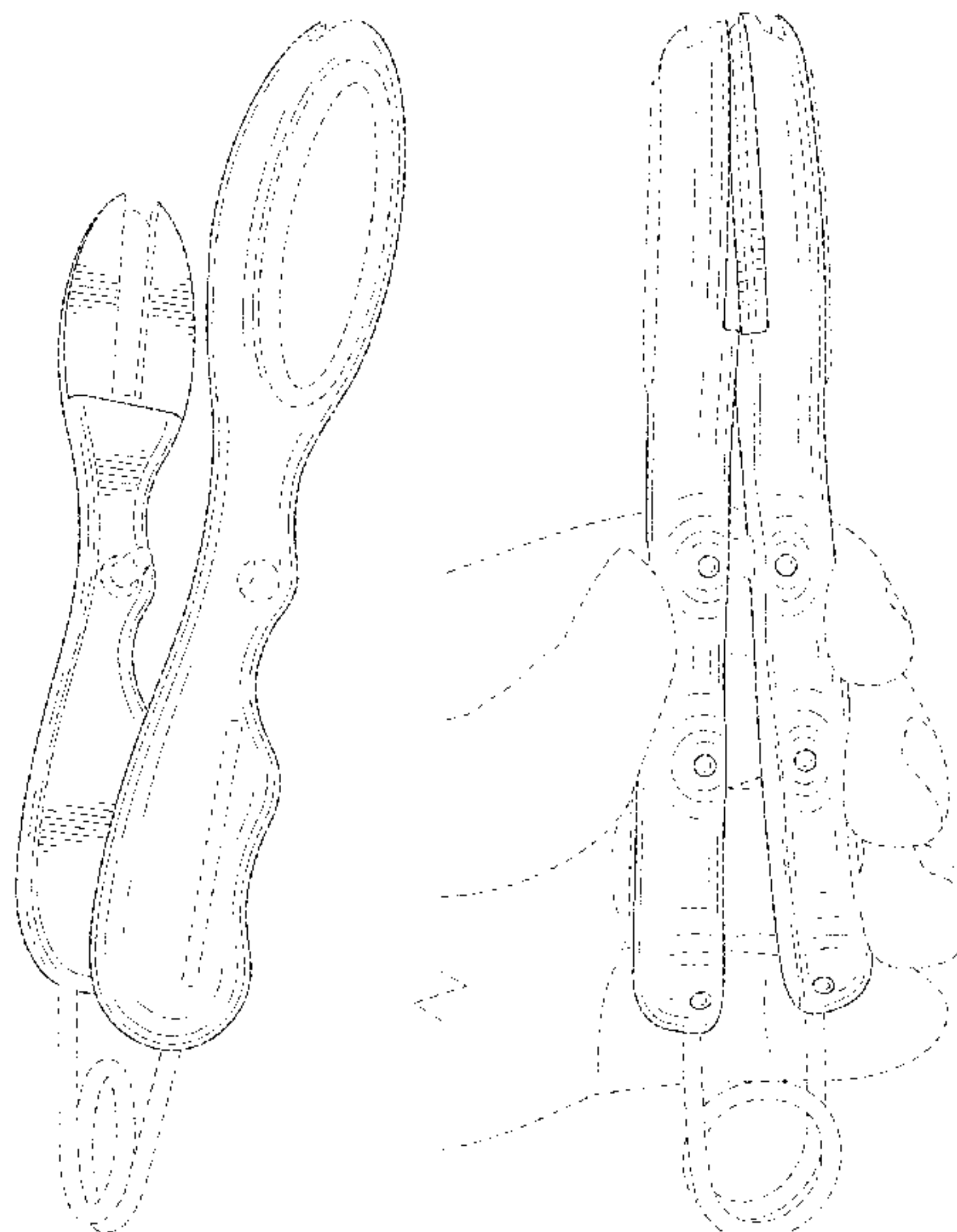
FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of the brush tool shown in FIG. 2;

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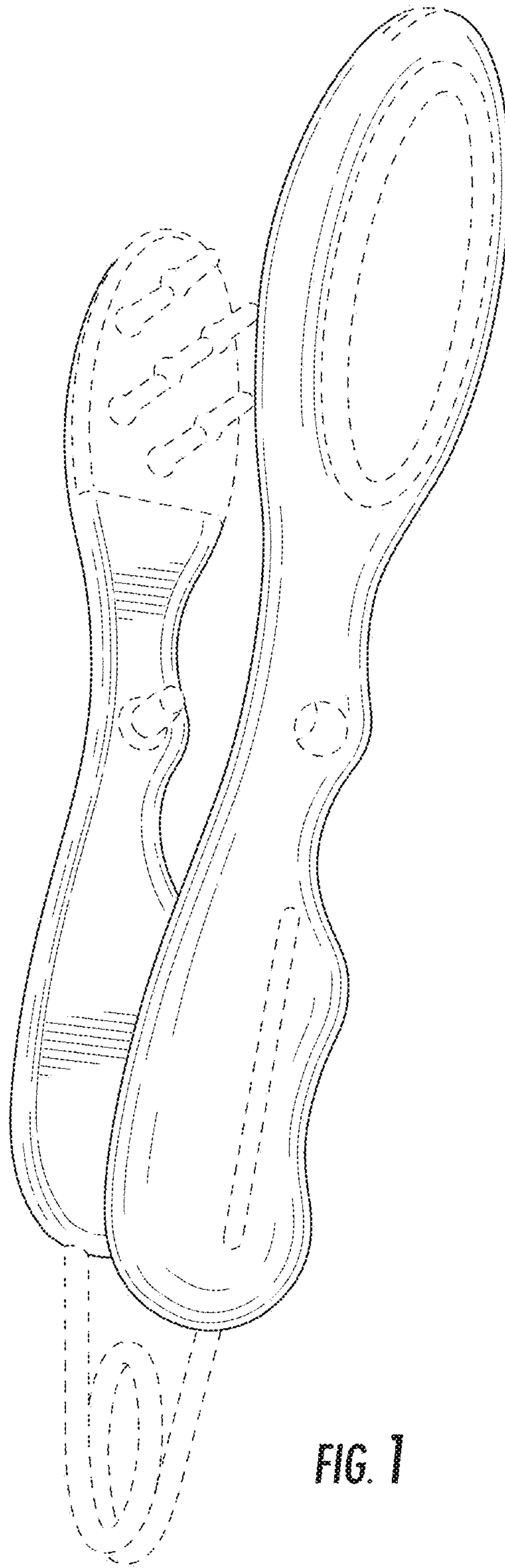

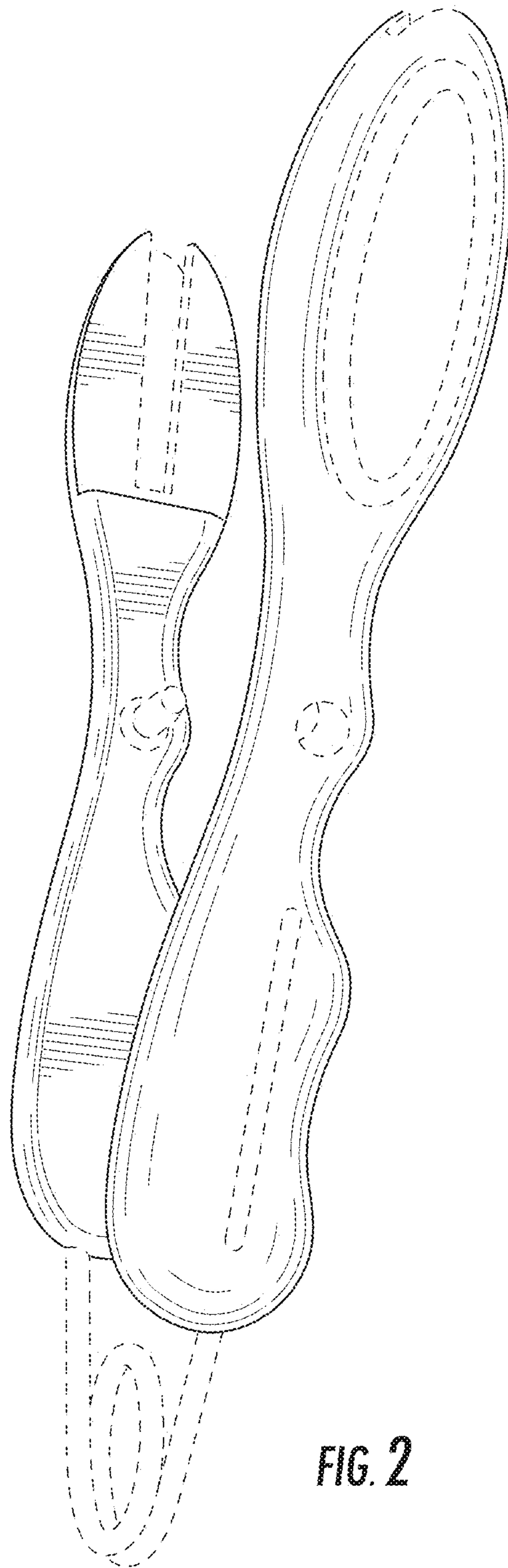

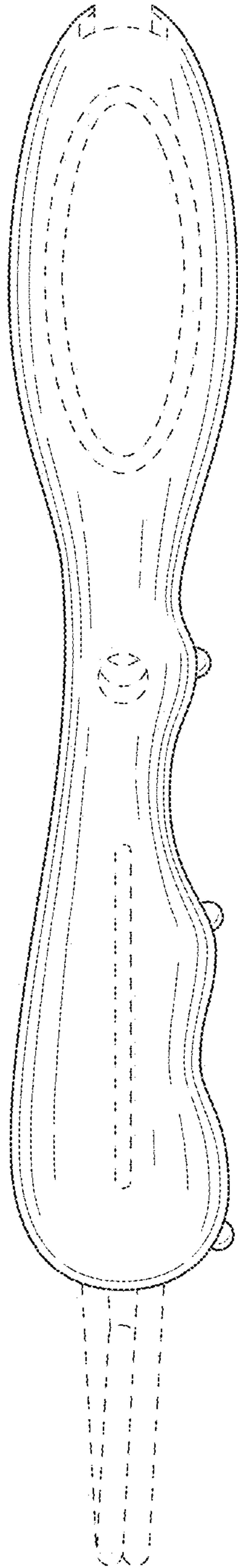

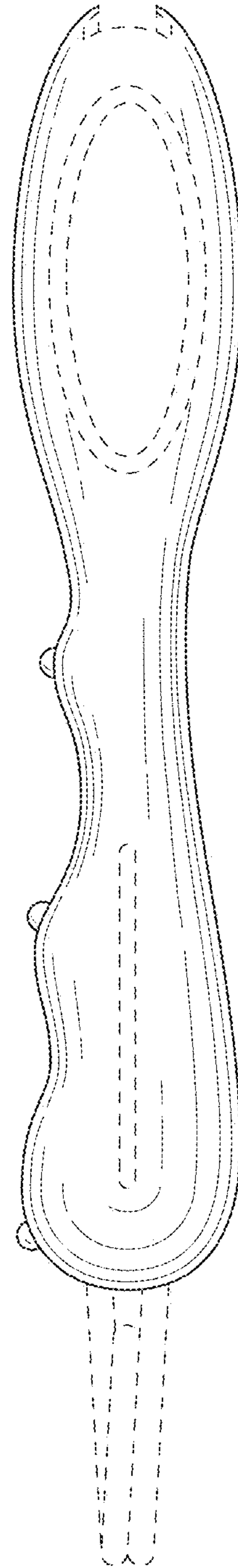

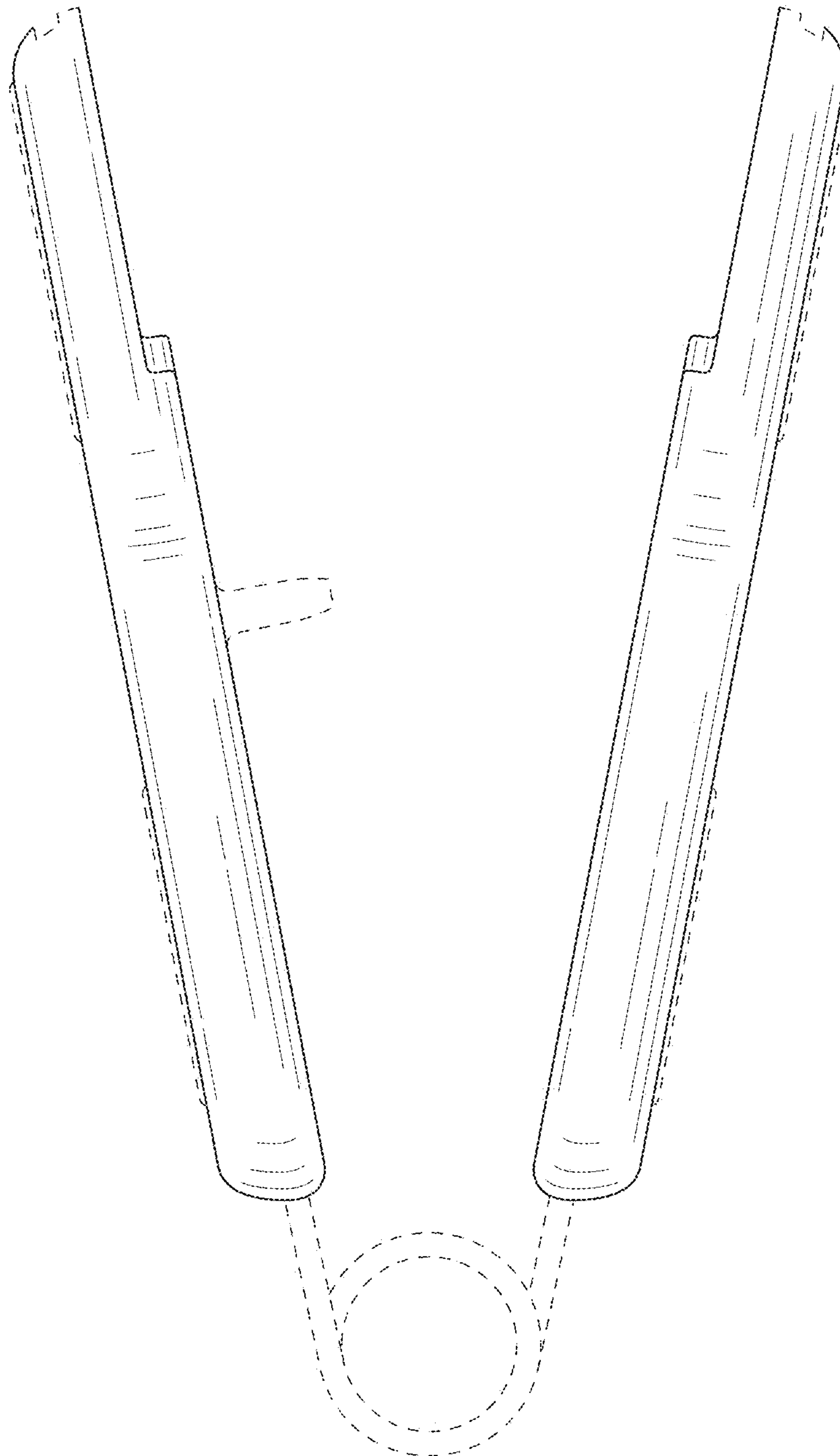

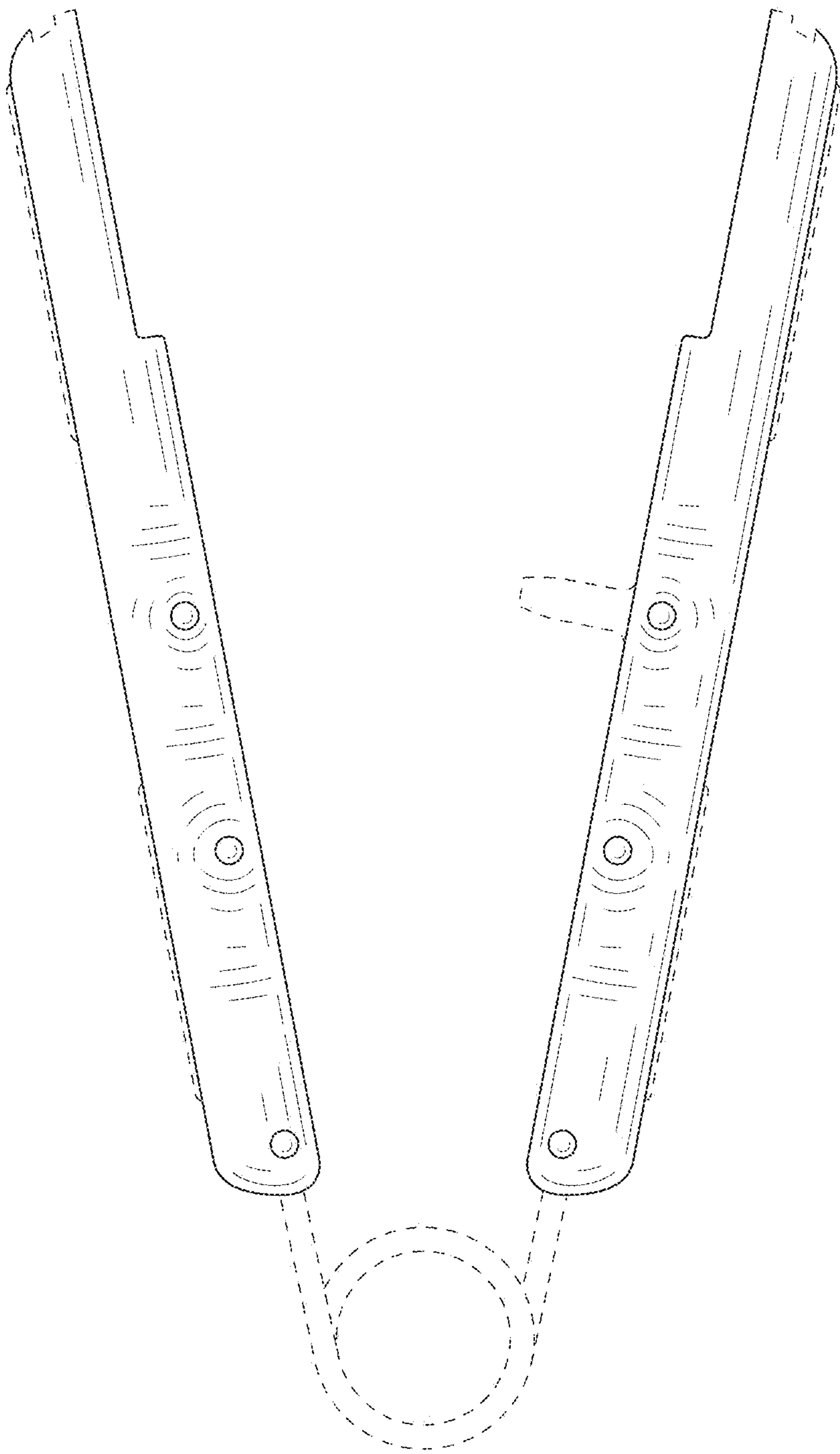

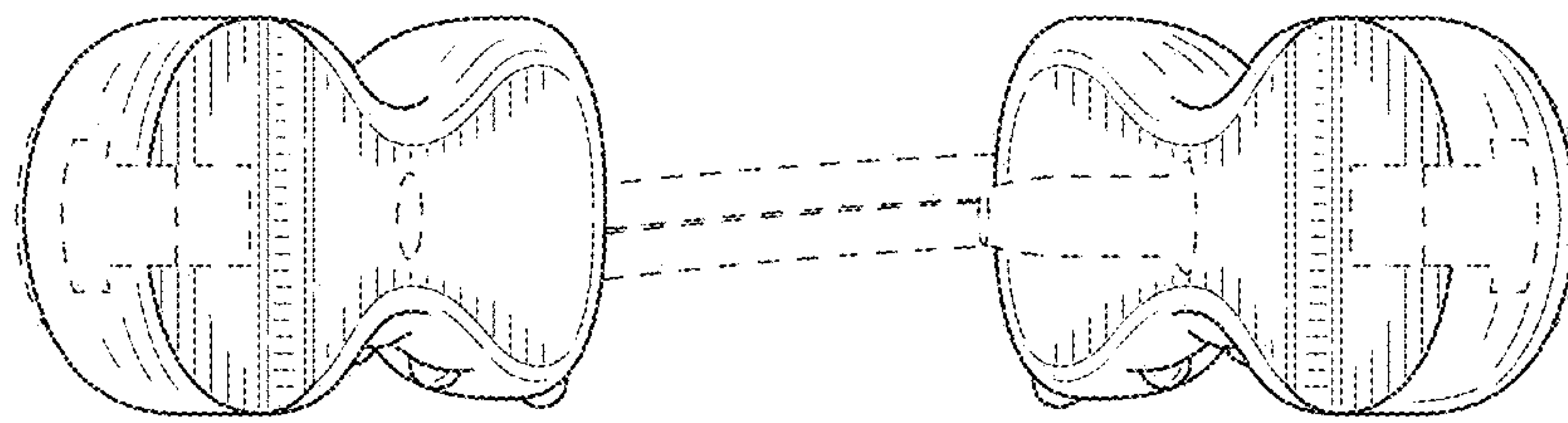

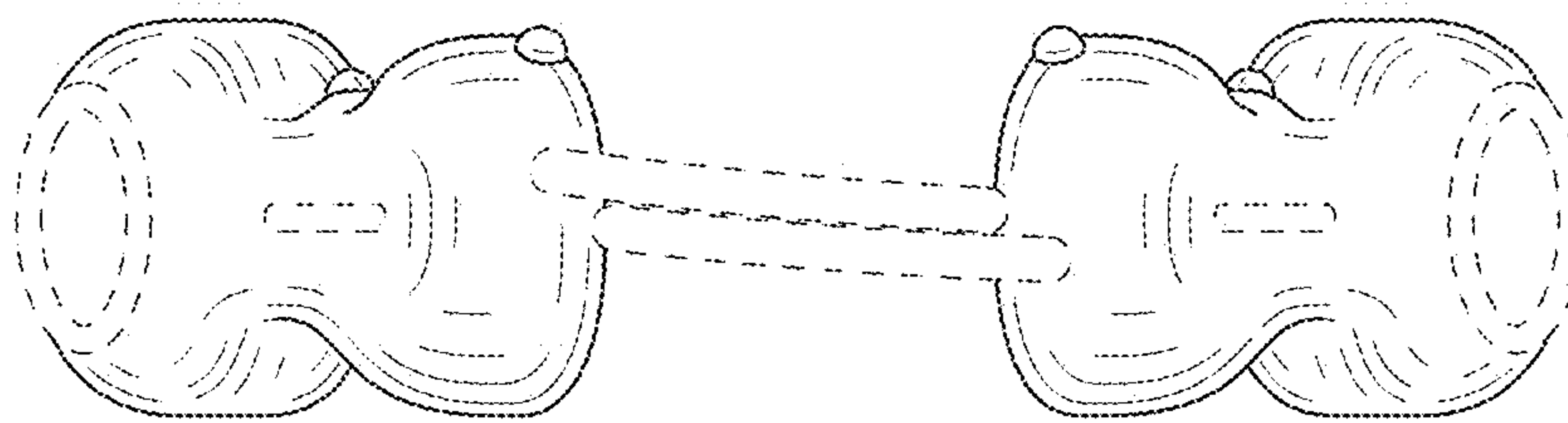

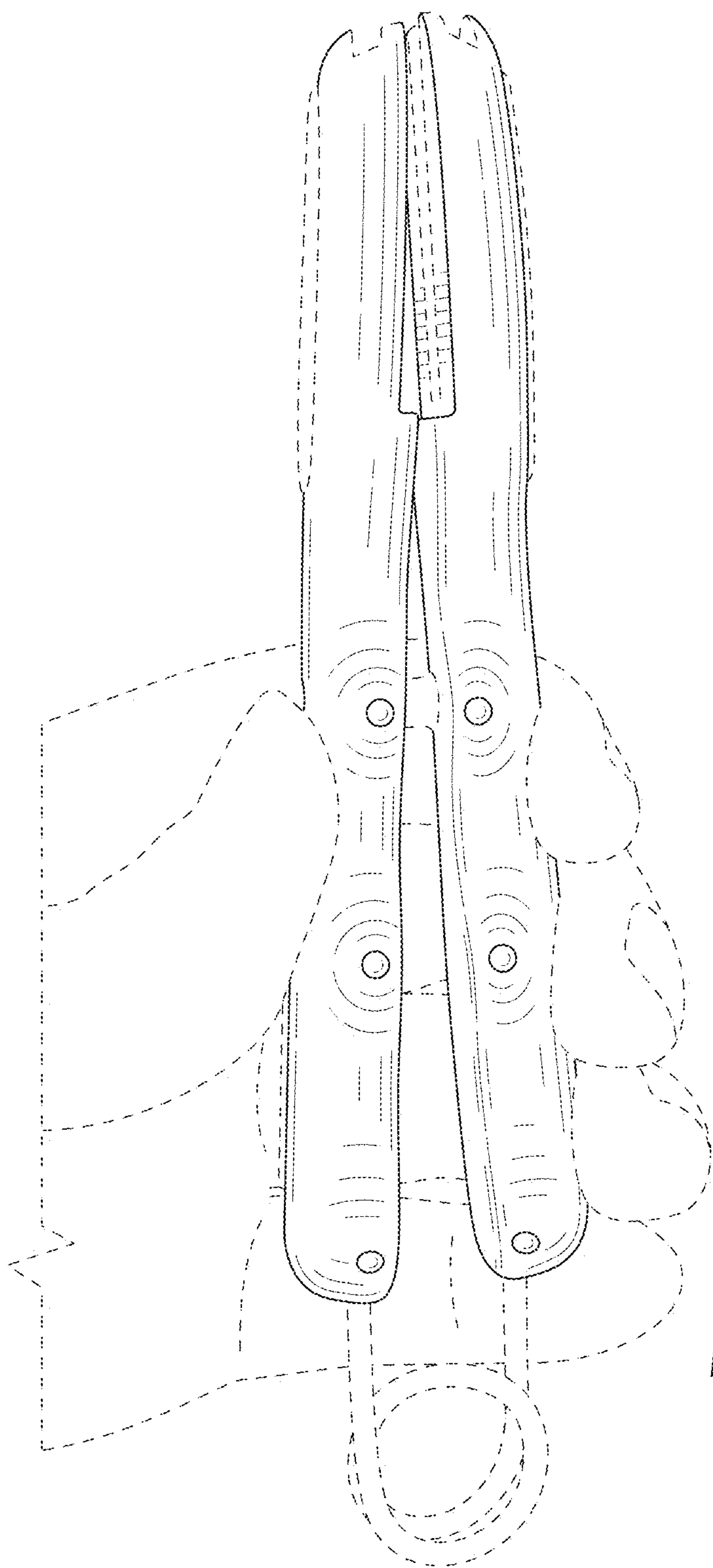
