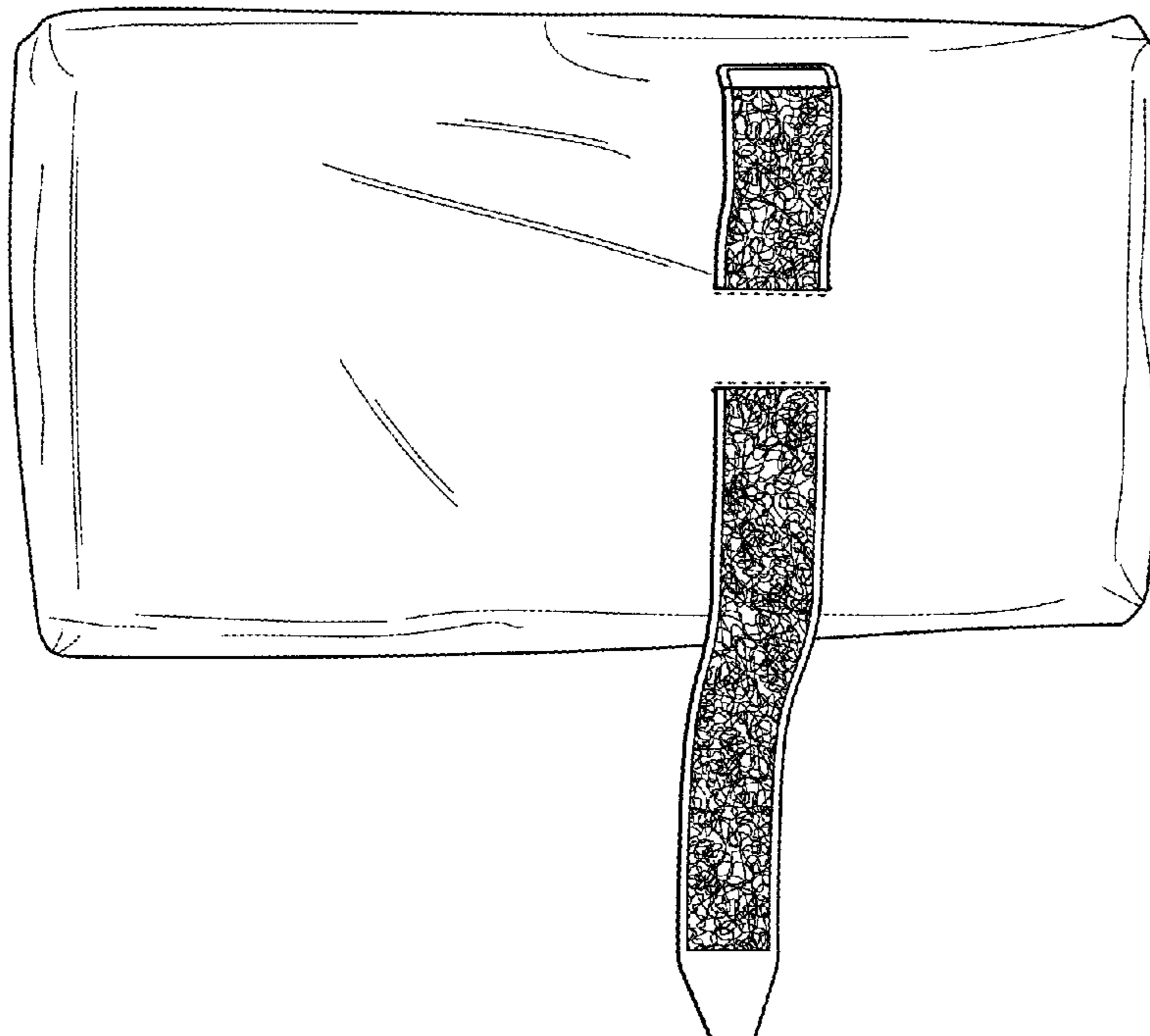
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a diaper changing pad cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top elevation view of the diaper changing pad cover with a strap in an unfastened position; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view; FIG. 3 is side elevation view; FIG. 4 is an enlarged detail top elevation view with the strap in a fastened position; and FIG. 5 is an enlarged detail rear (underside) elevation view; and, FIG. 6 is a top elevation of the diaper changing pad cover in-use. The broken lines represent an infant that show an exemplary environment of use and form no part of the claim.

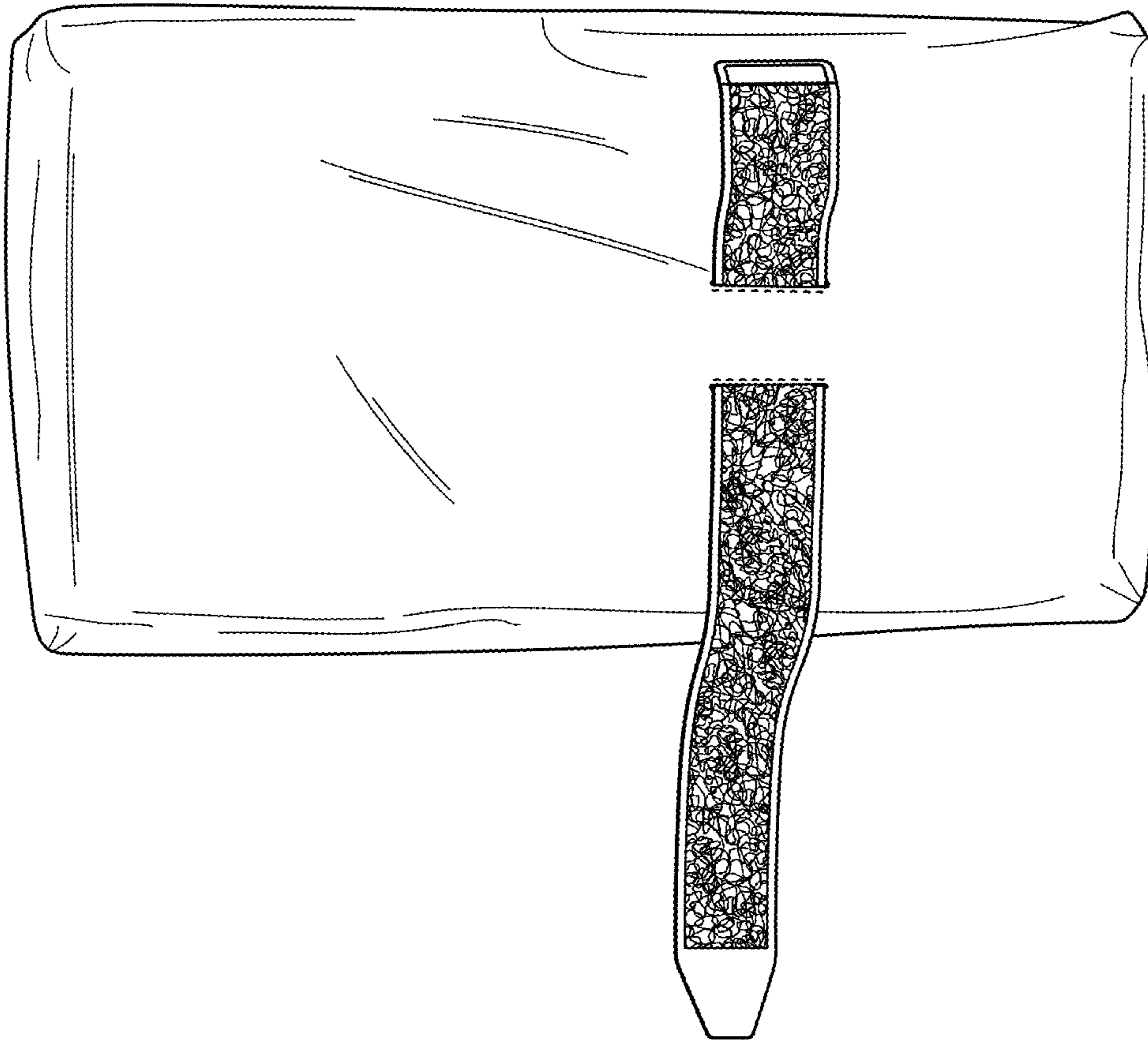

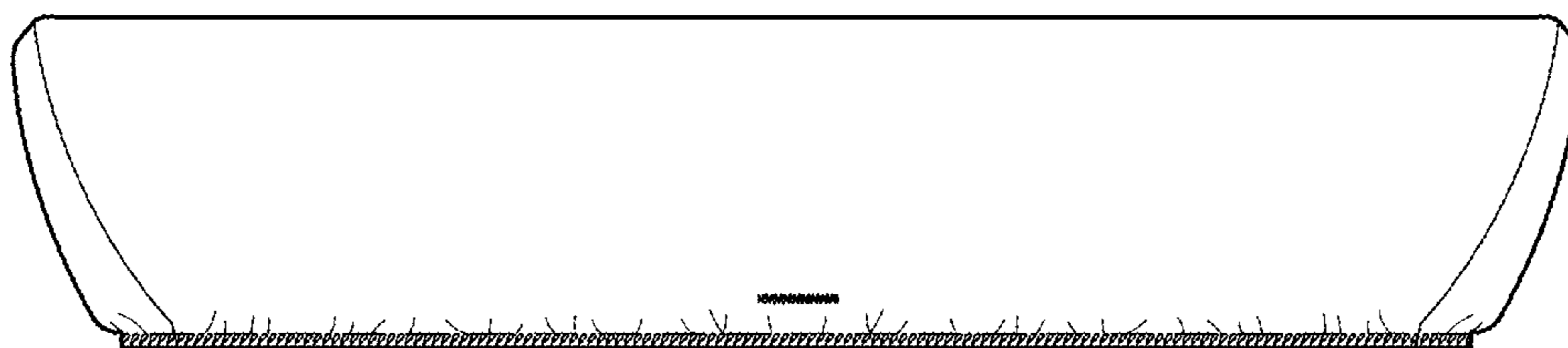

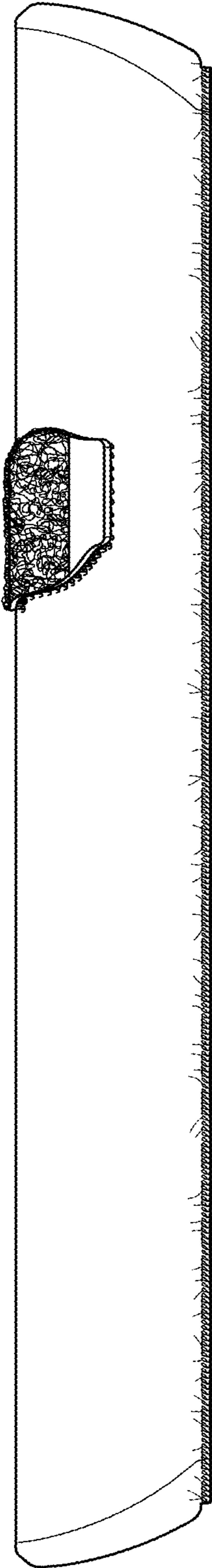

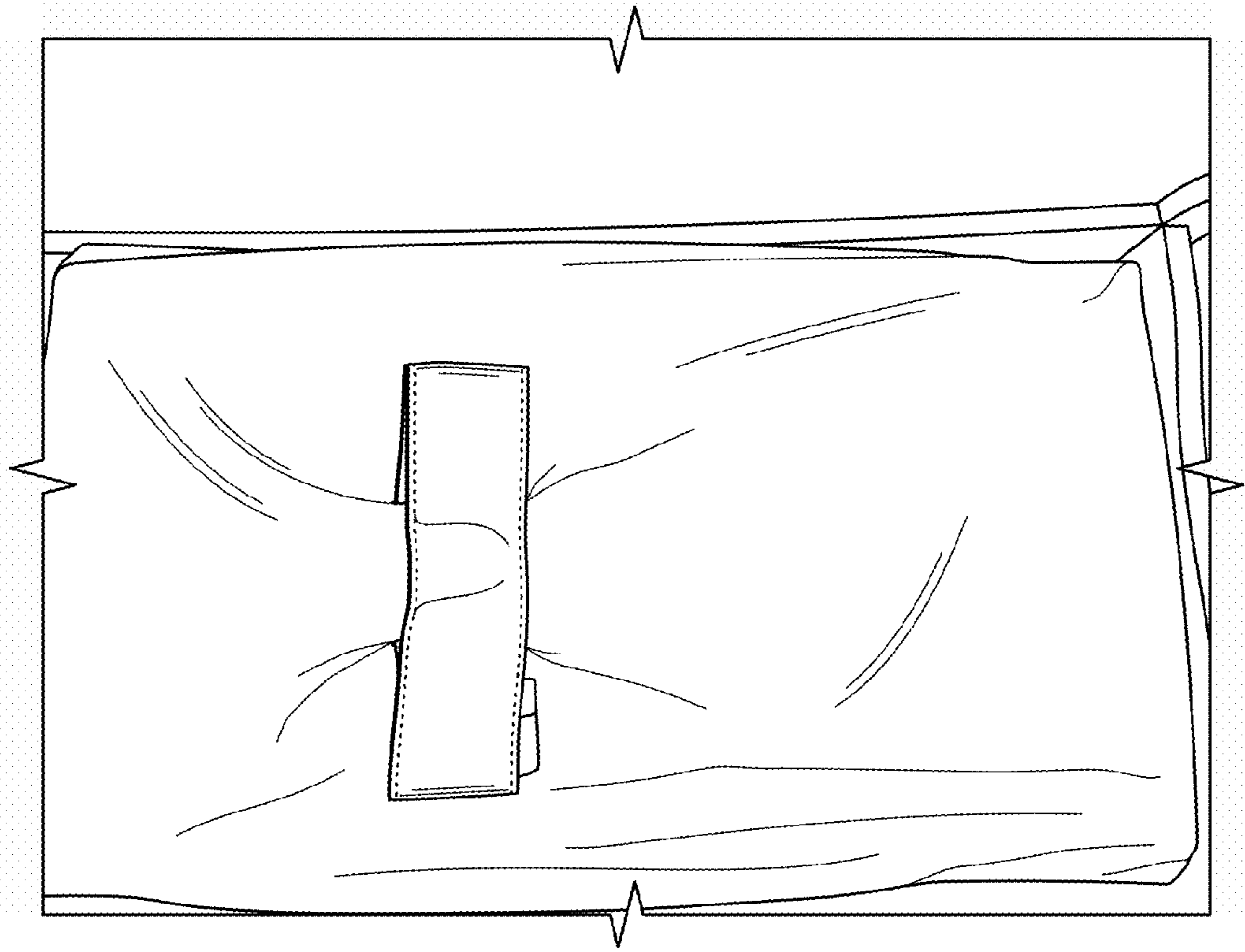

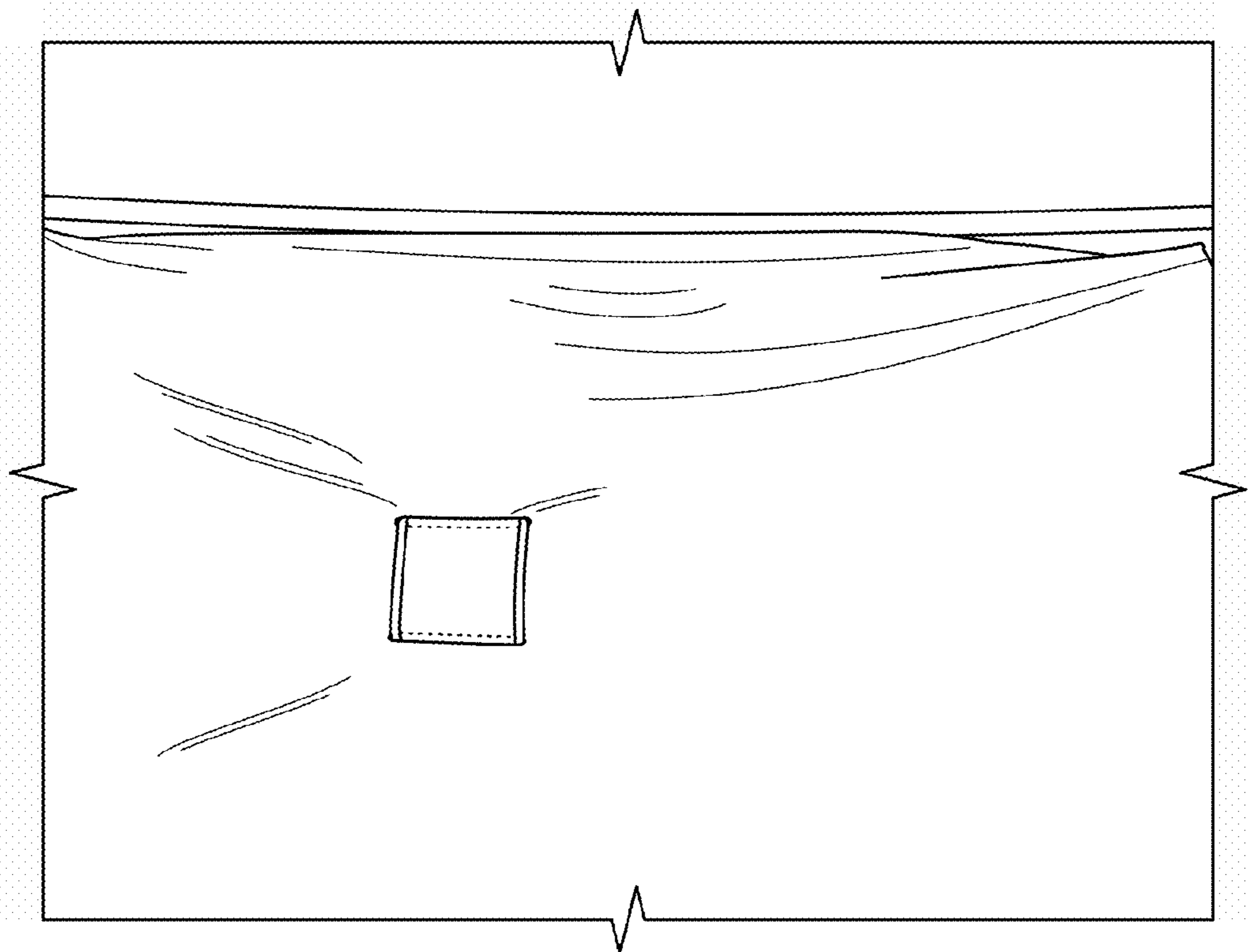

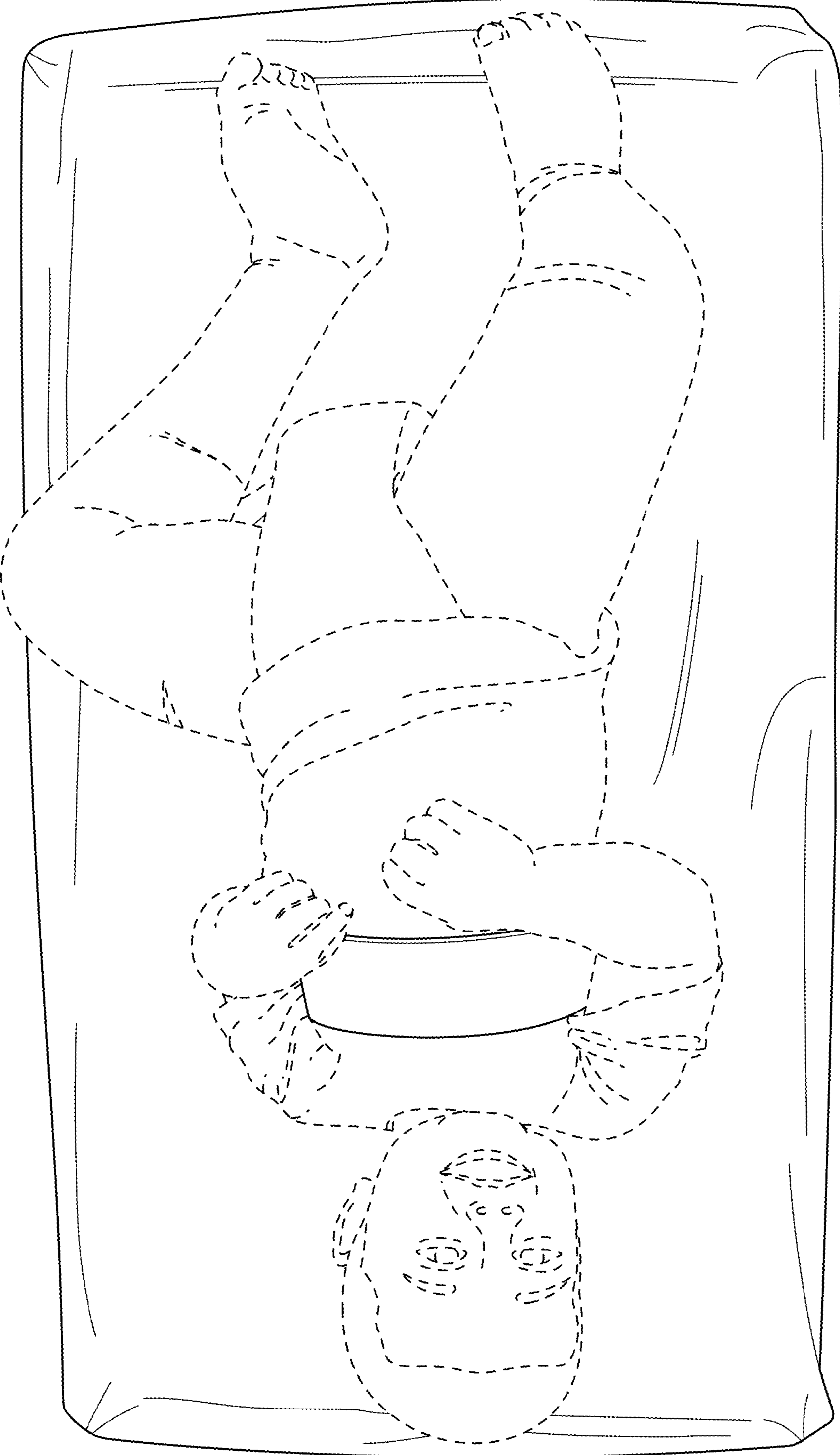
