We claim the ornamental design for a locking device, as shown and described in FIGS. 1-8.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right pictorial view of a locking device according to another embodiment;

FIG. 2 is a rear, left pictorial view of the locking device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the locking device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the locking device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the locking device of FIG. 1;

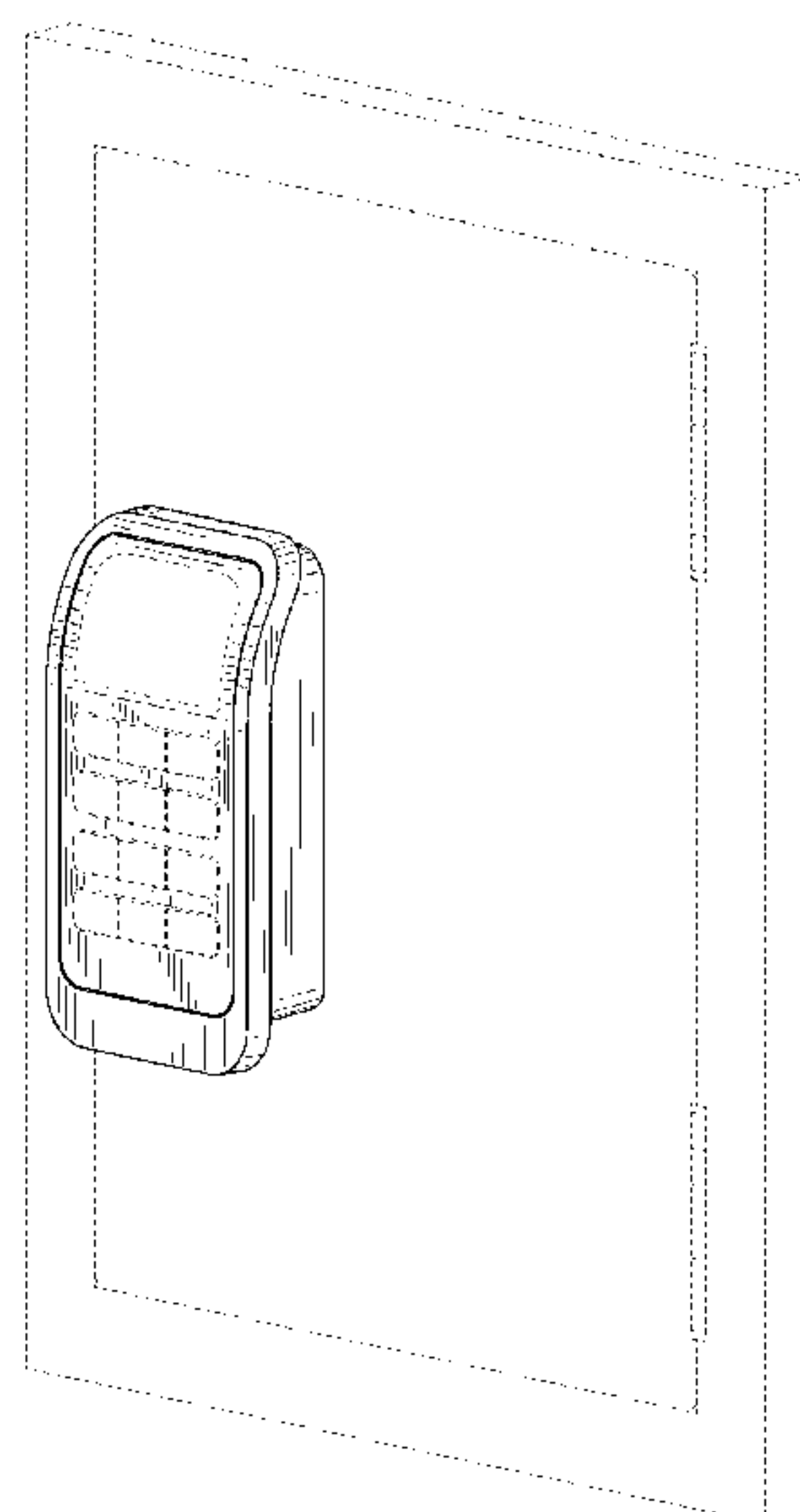
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view of the locking device of FIG. 1;

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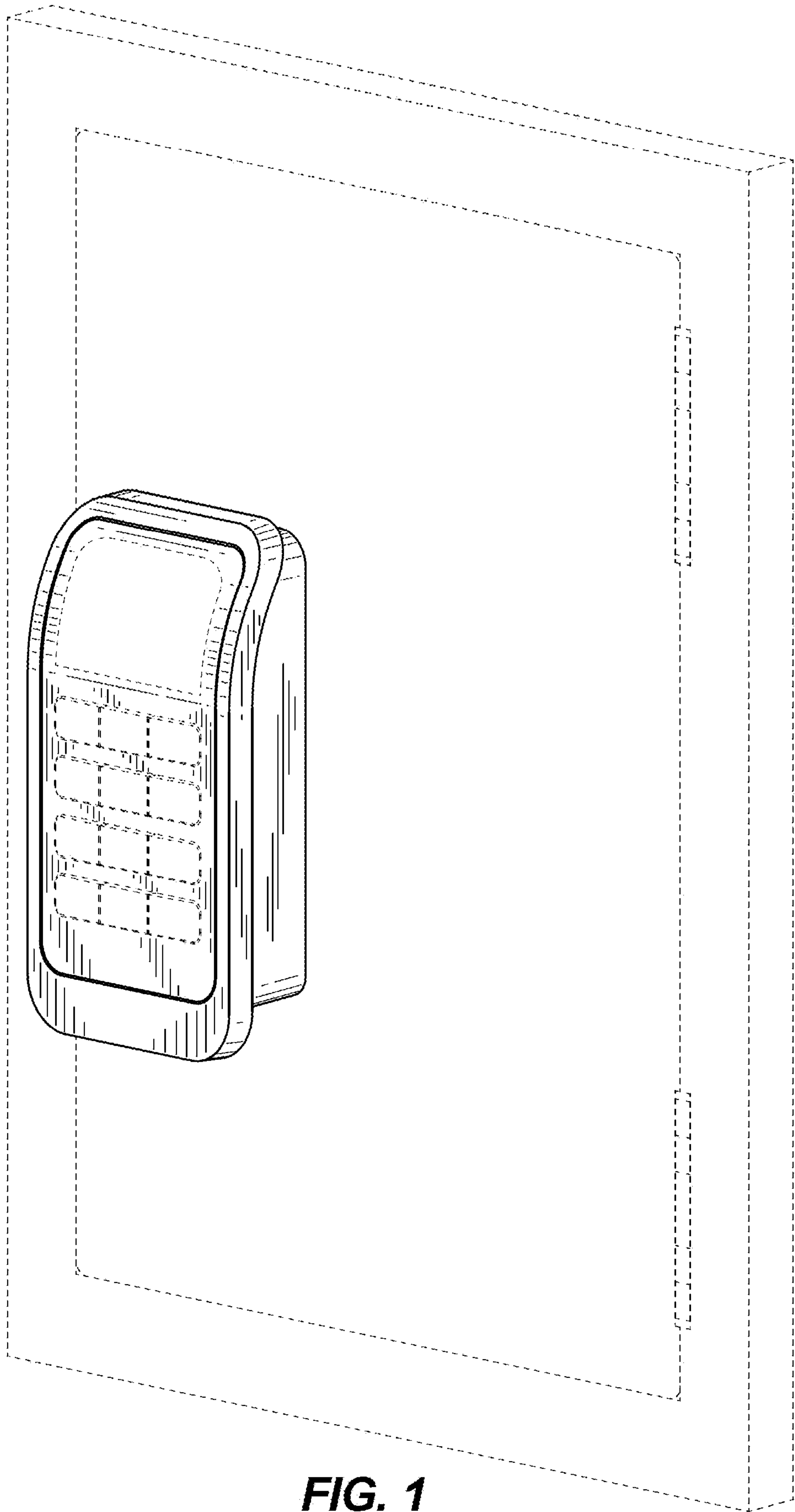

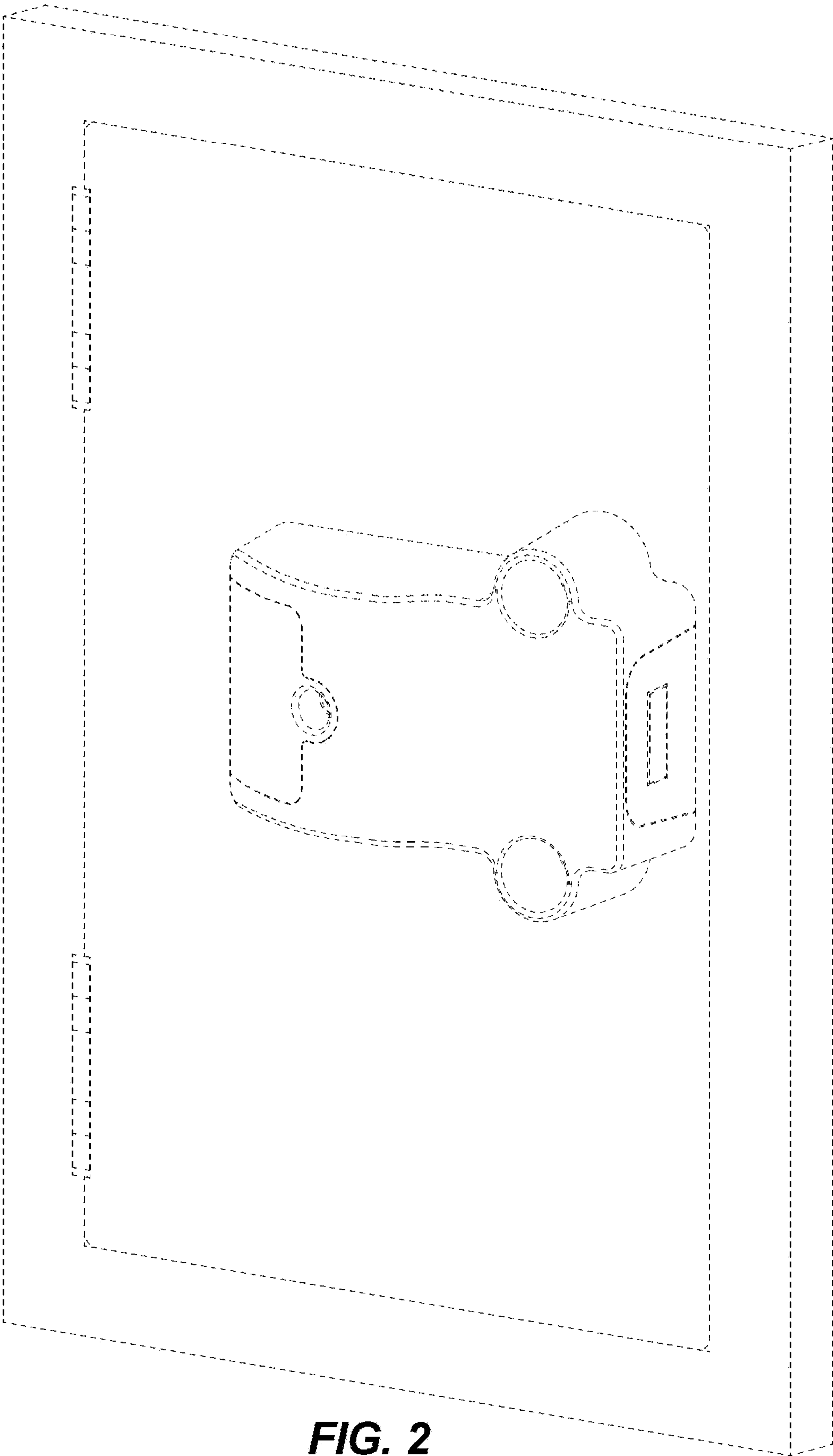

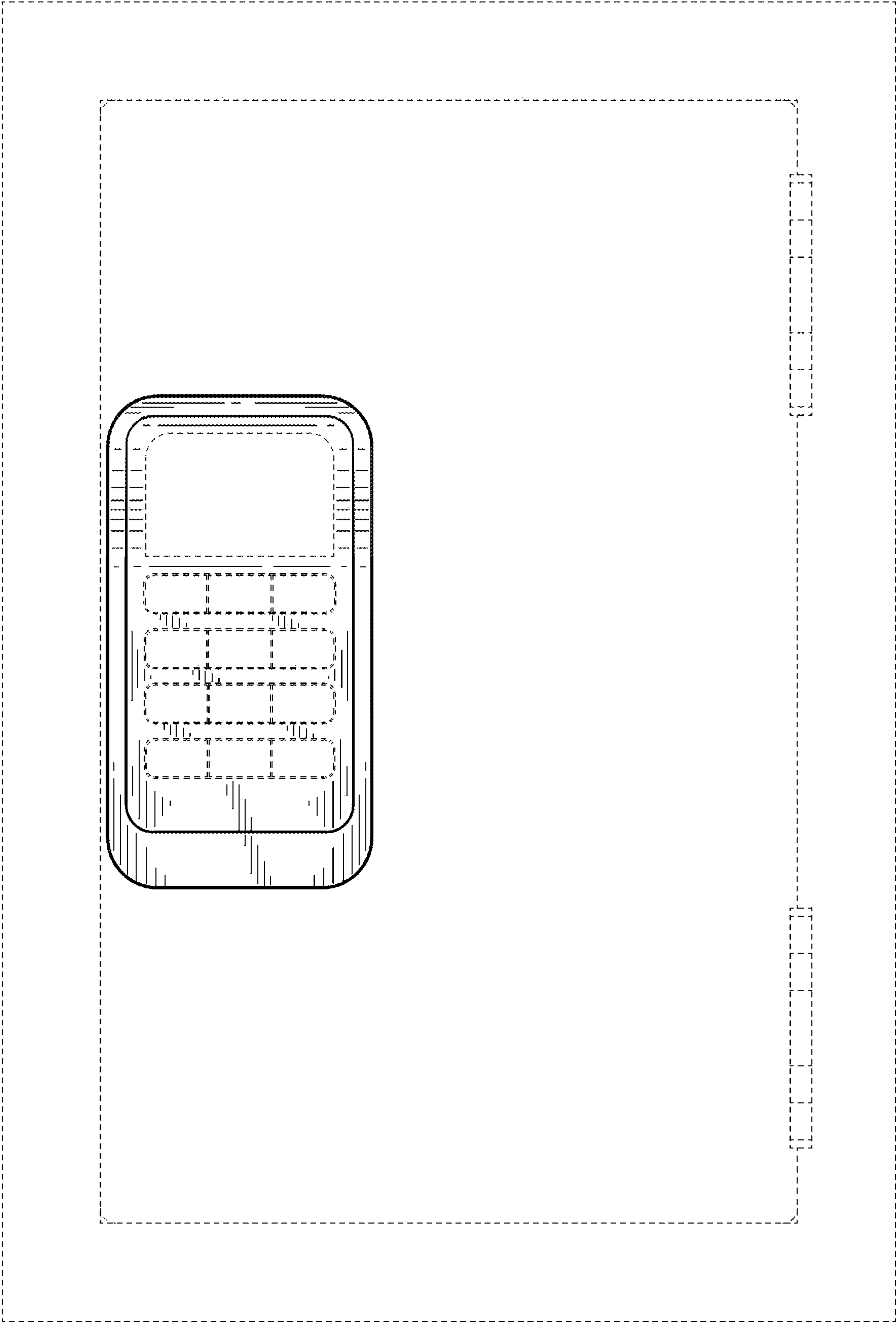

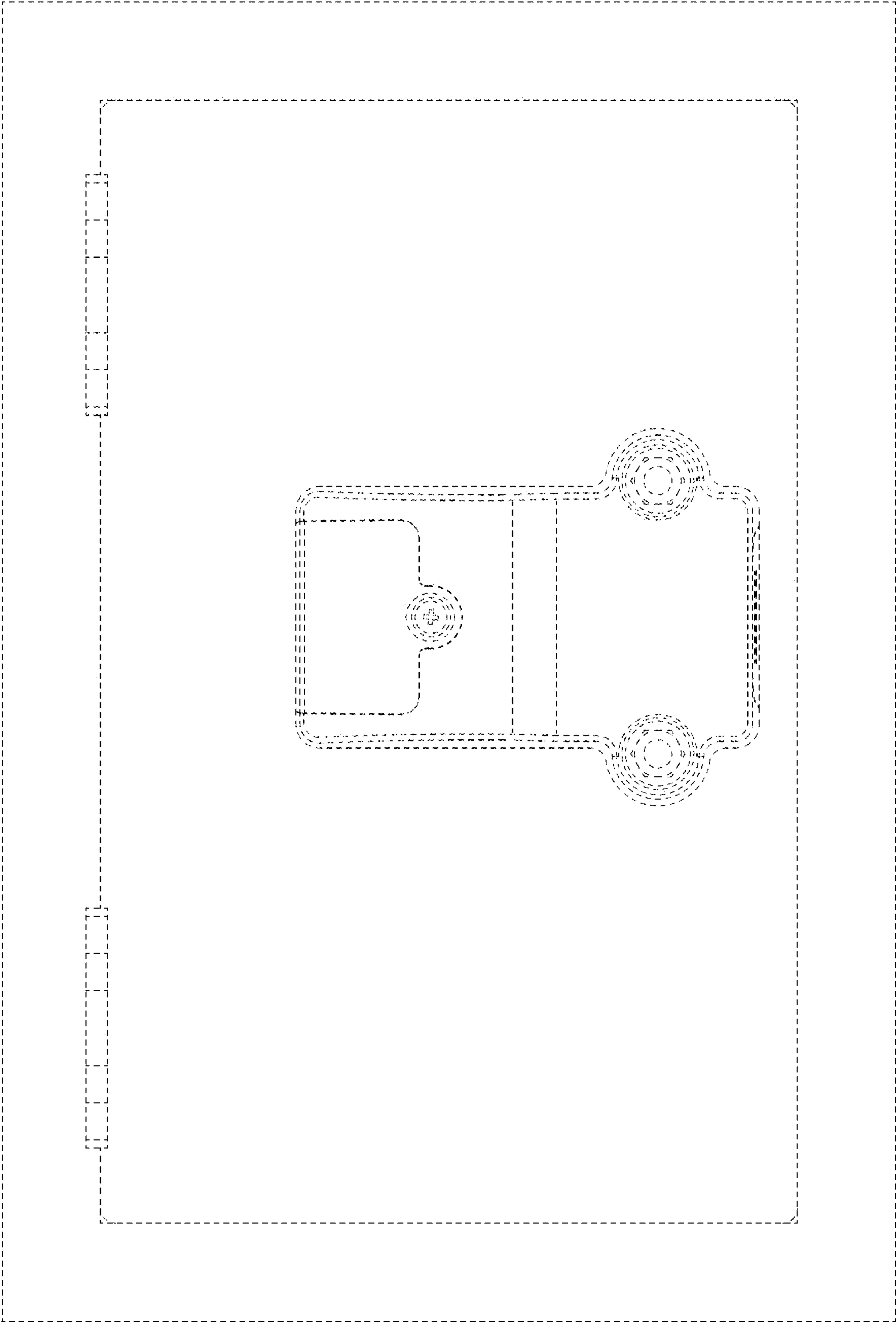

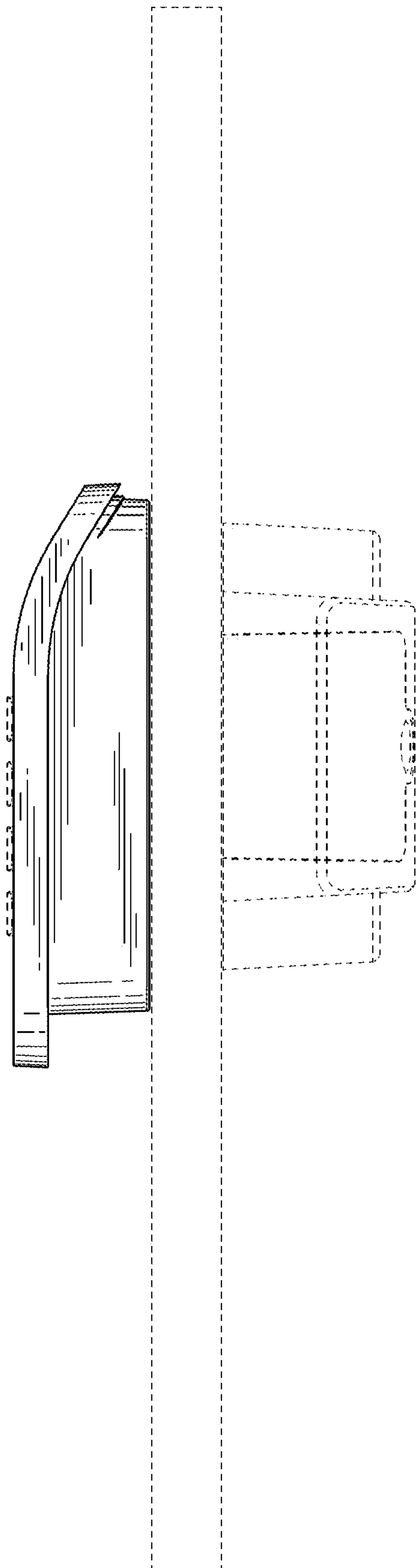

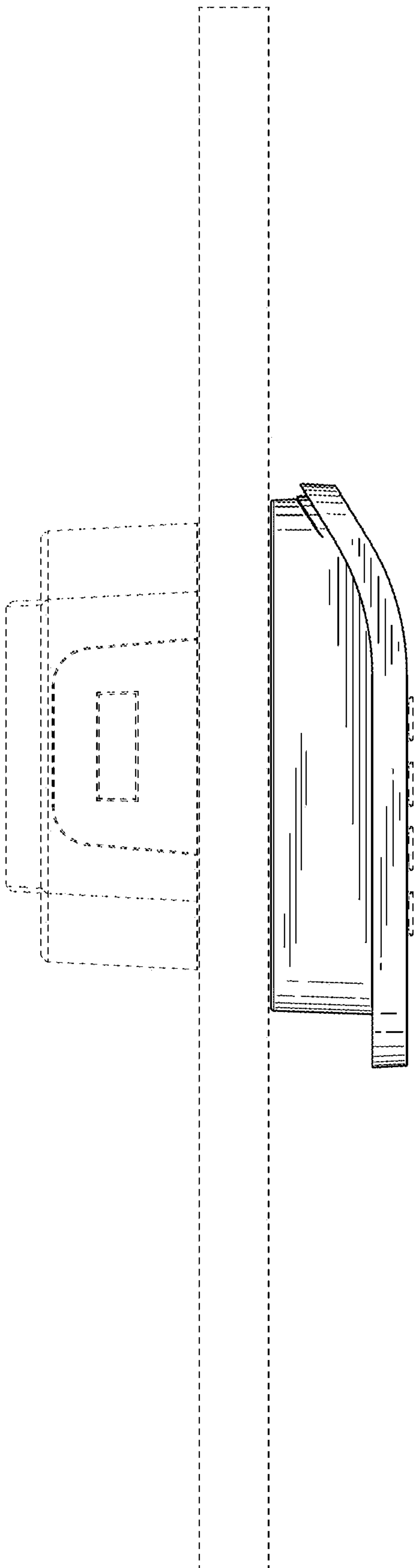

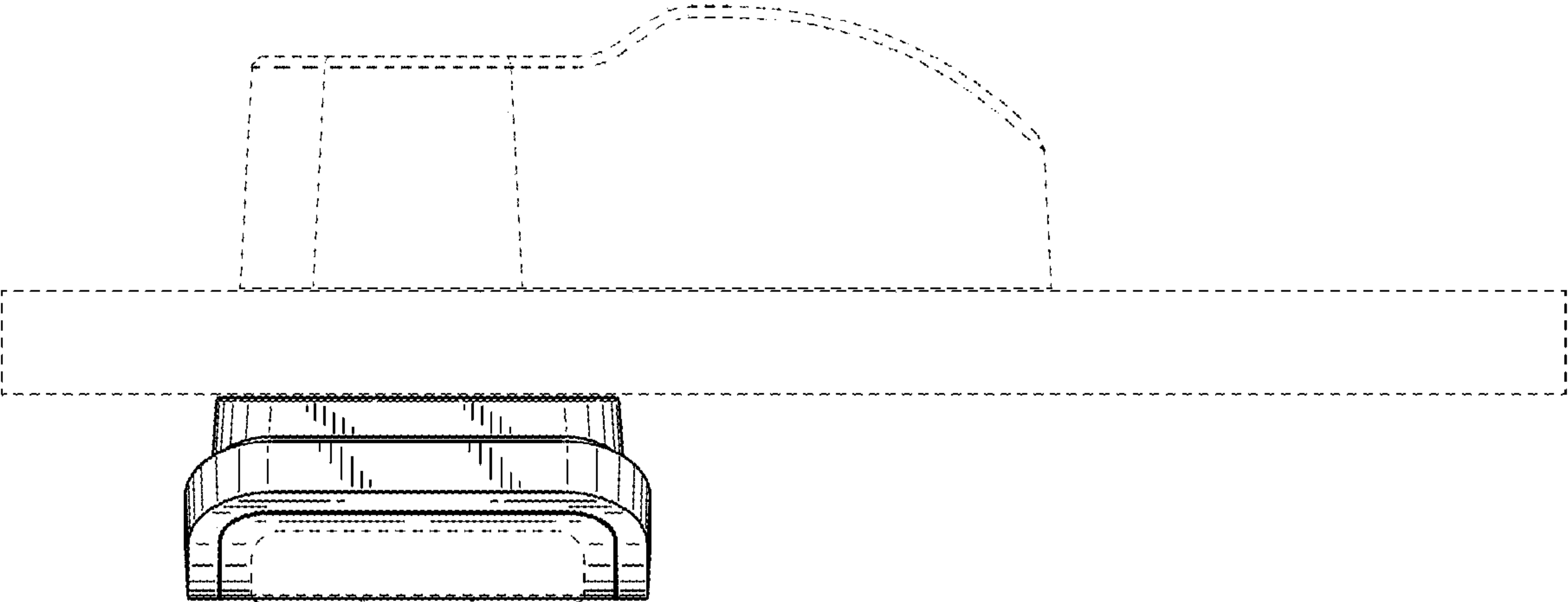

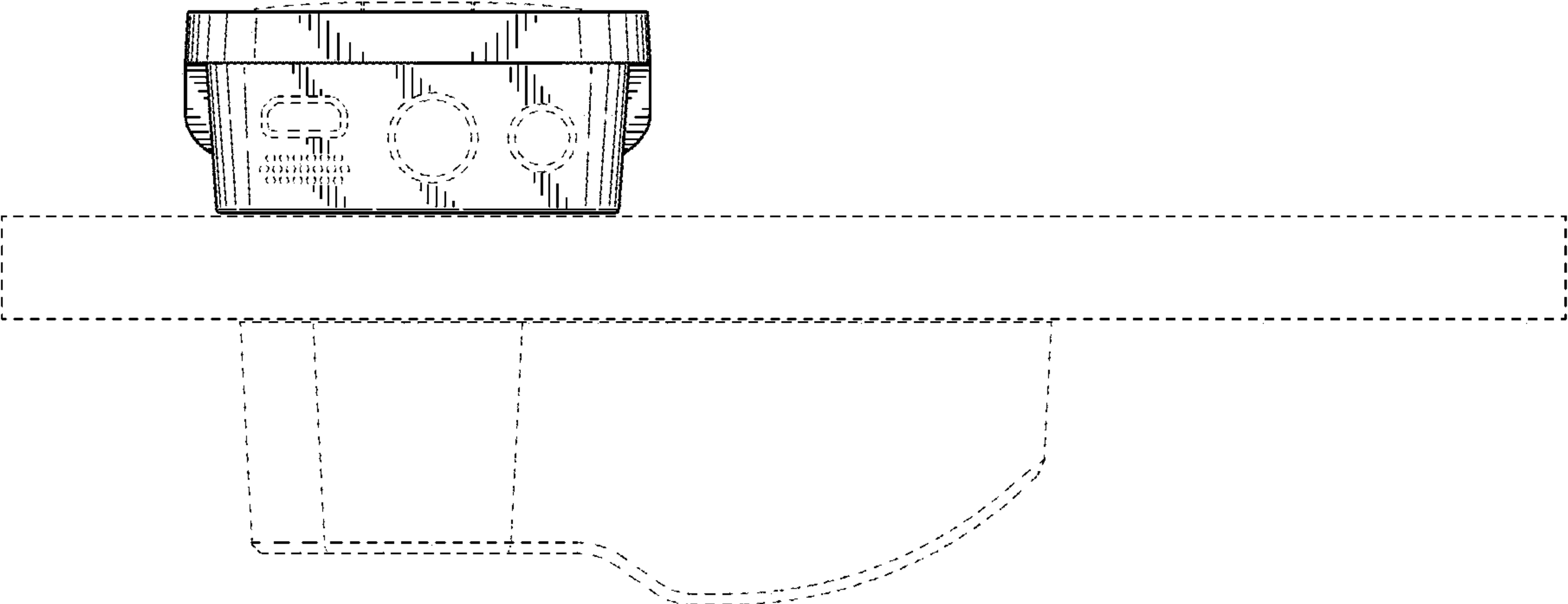
