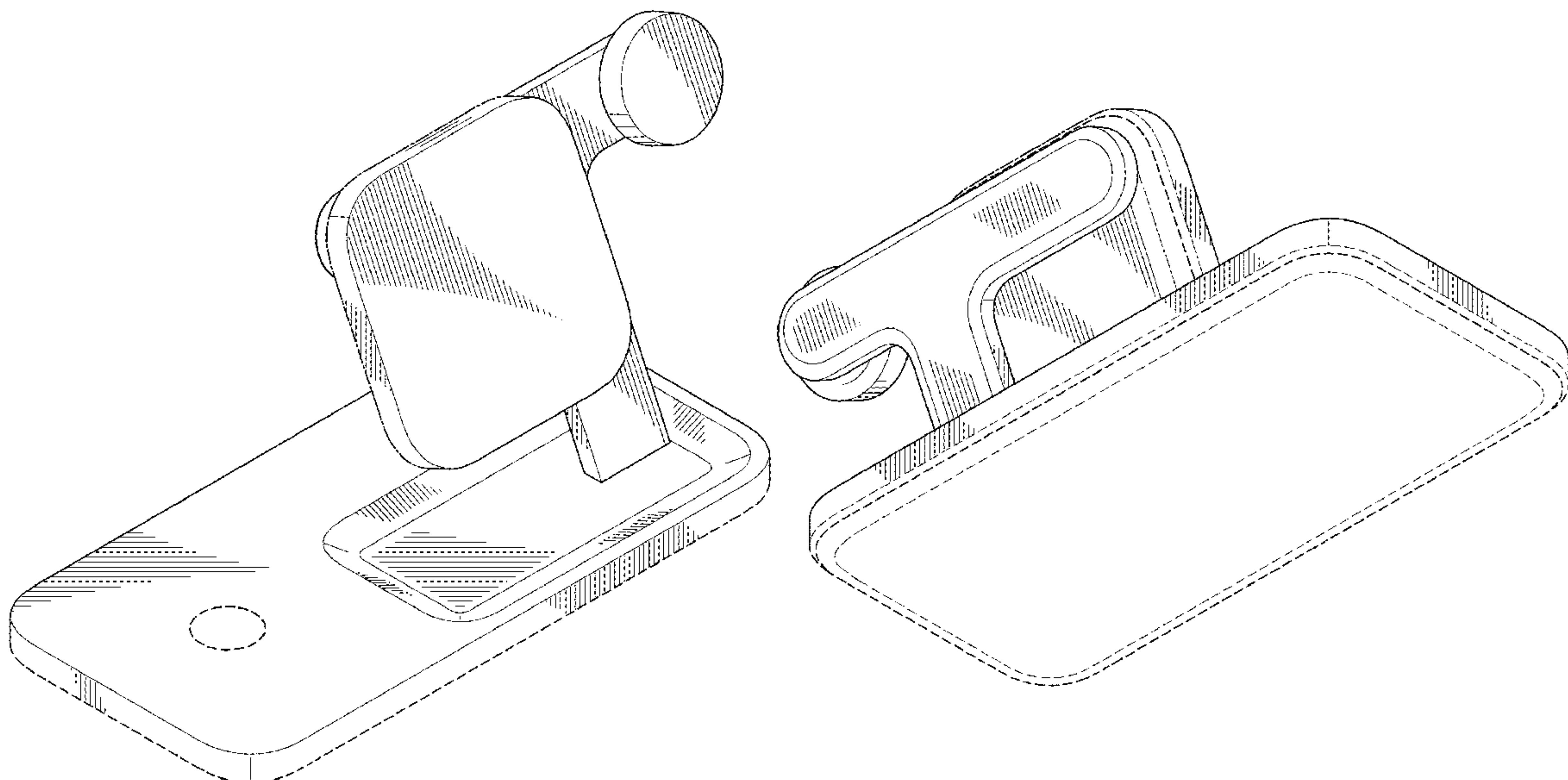
The ornamental design of a wireless charging station, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a wireless charging station, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top, rear, left side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom, front, left side perspective view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom, rear, right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional front elevation view of the wireless charging station of FIG. 1, taken in the direction of line 11-11 shown in FIG. 9.

The equal-length broken lines in the drawings depict portions of the wireless charging station that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot-dash lines define the boundaries of the claim.

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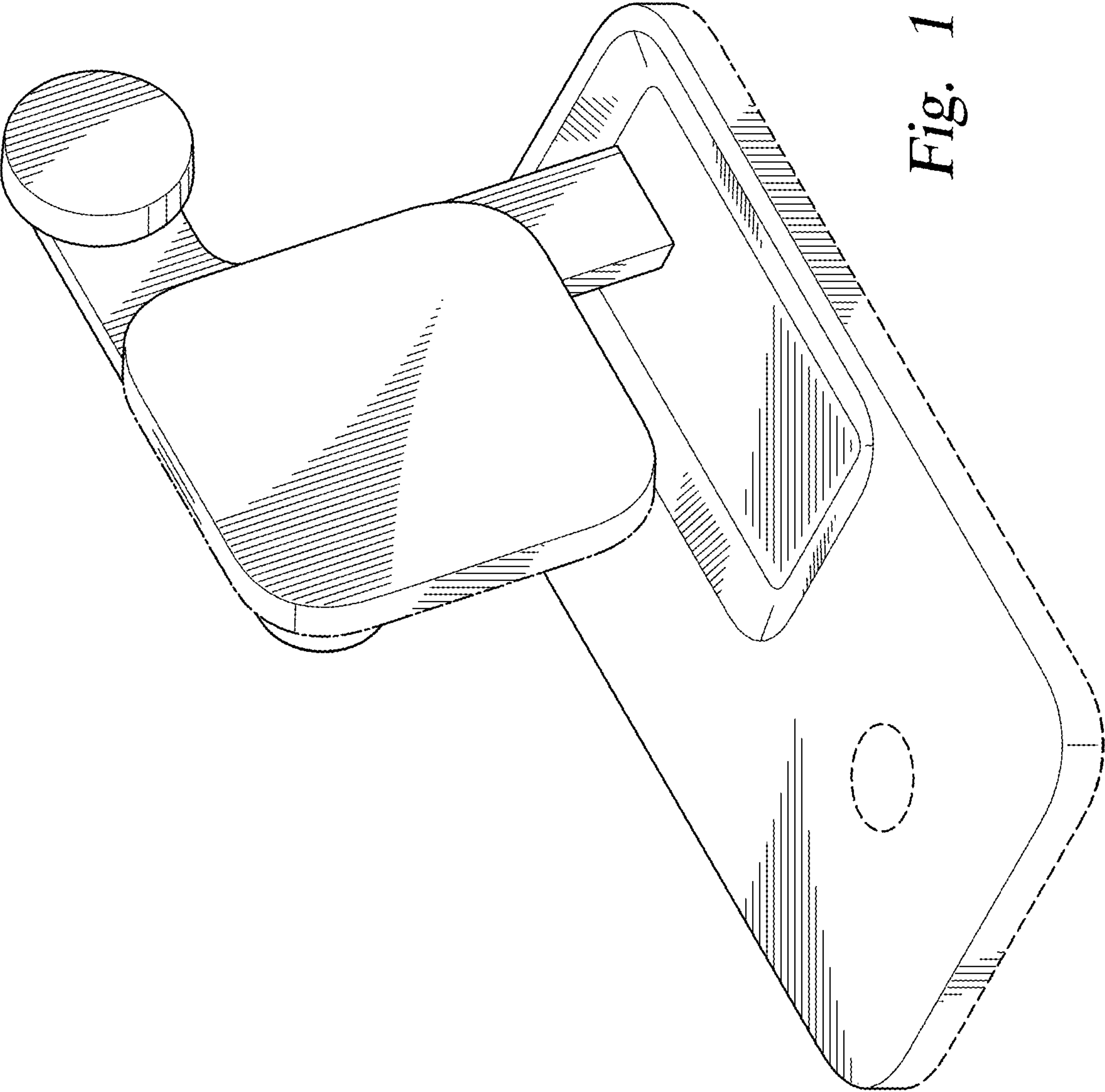

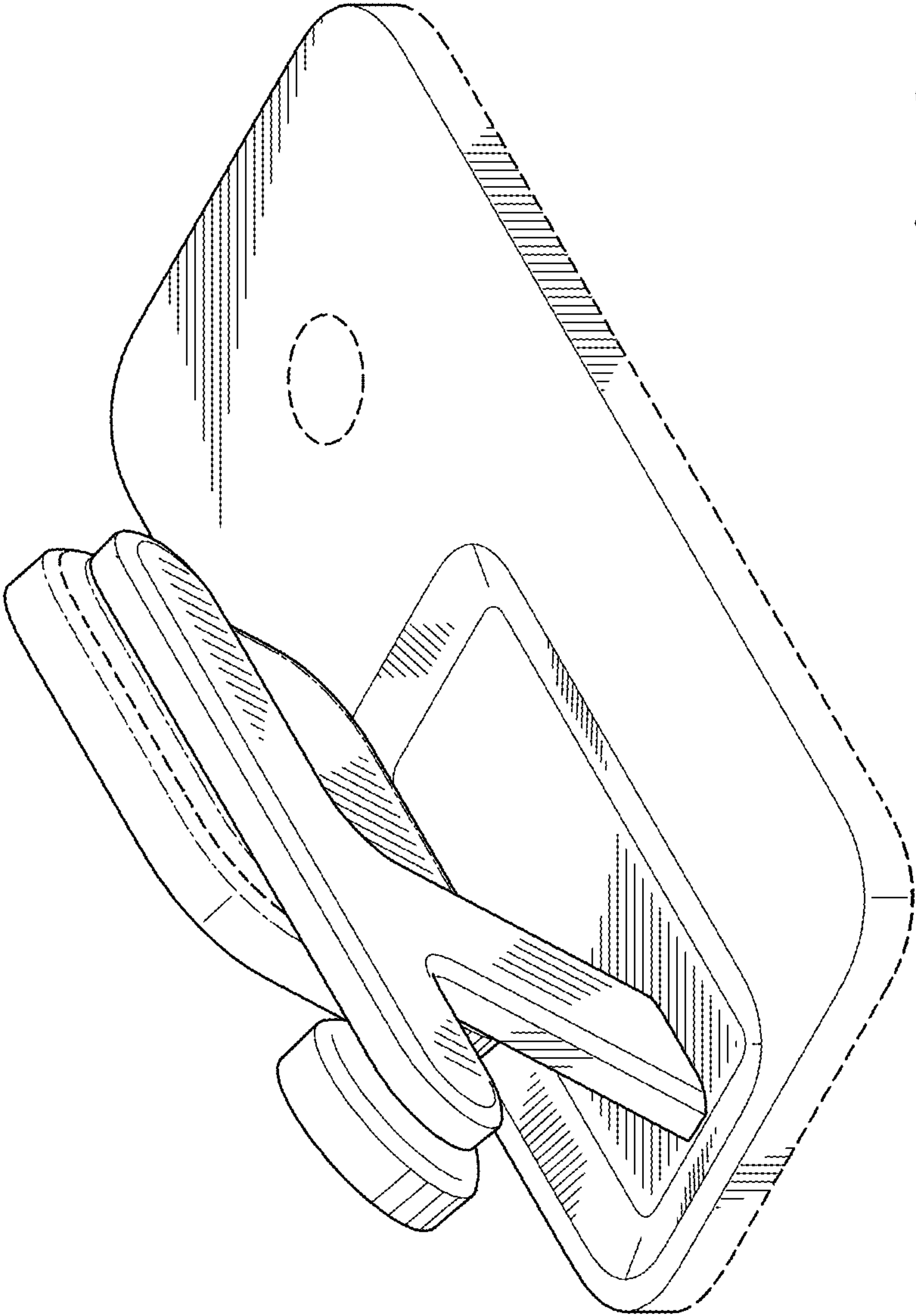

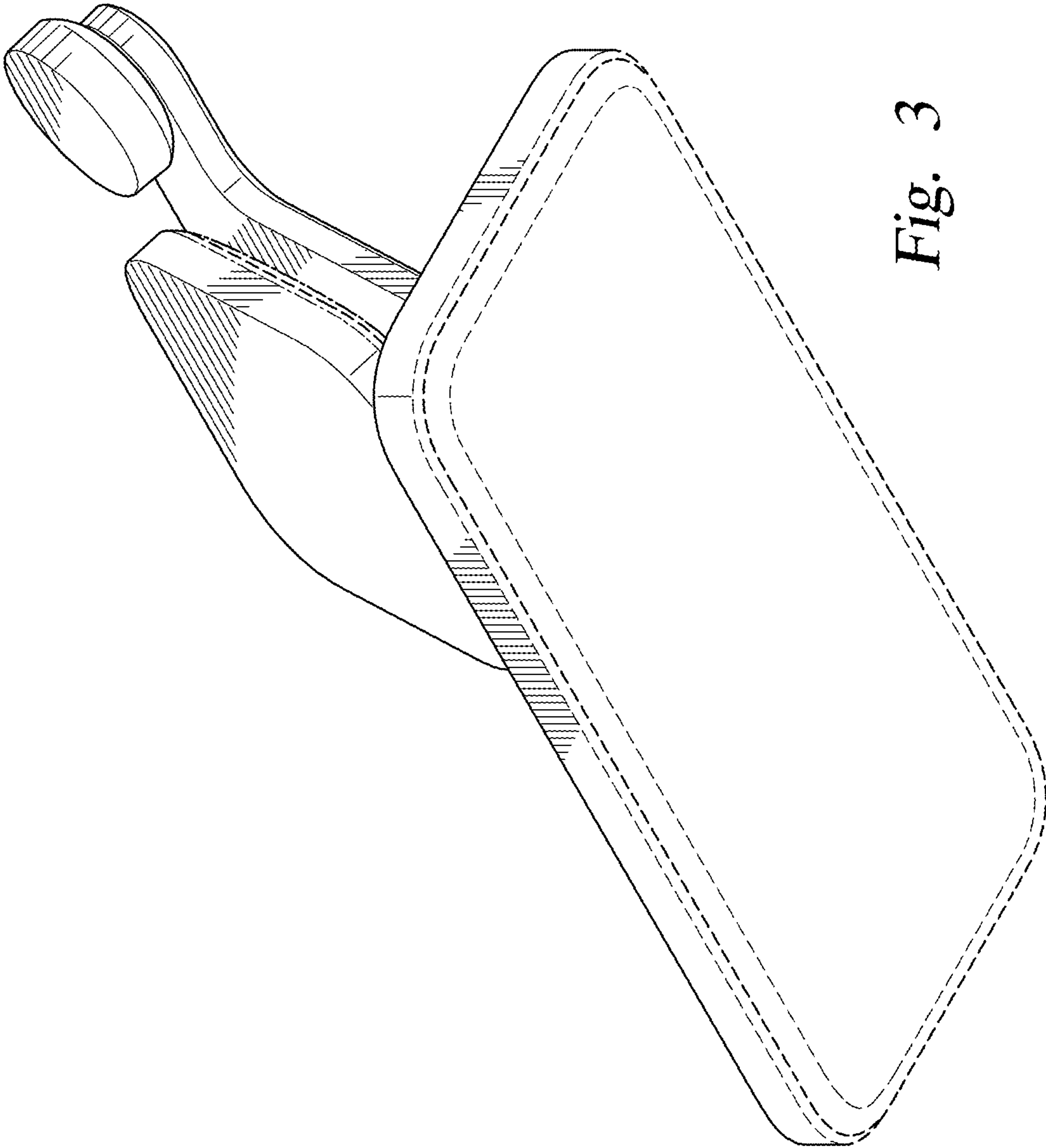

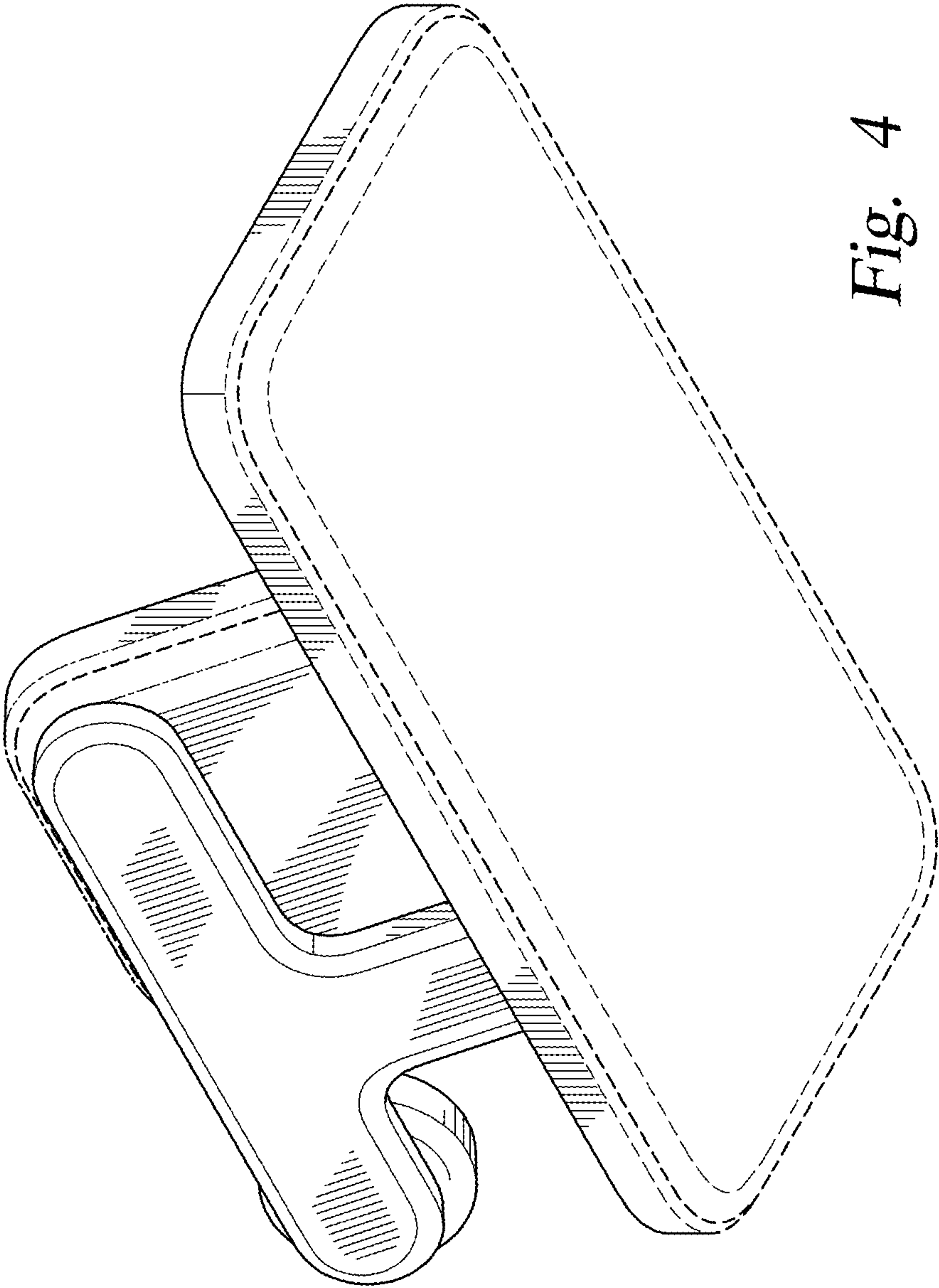

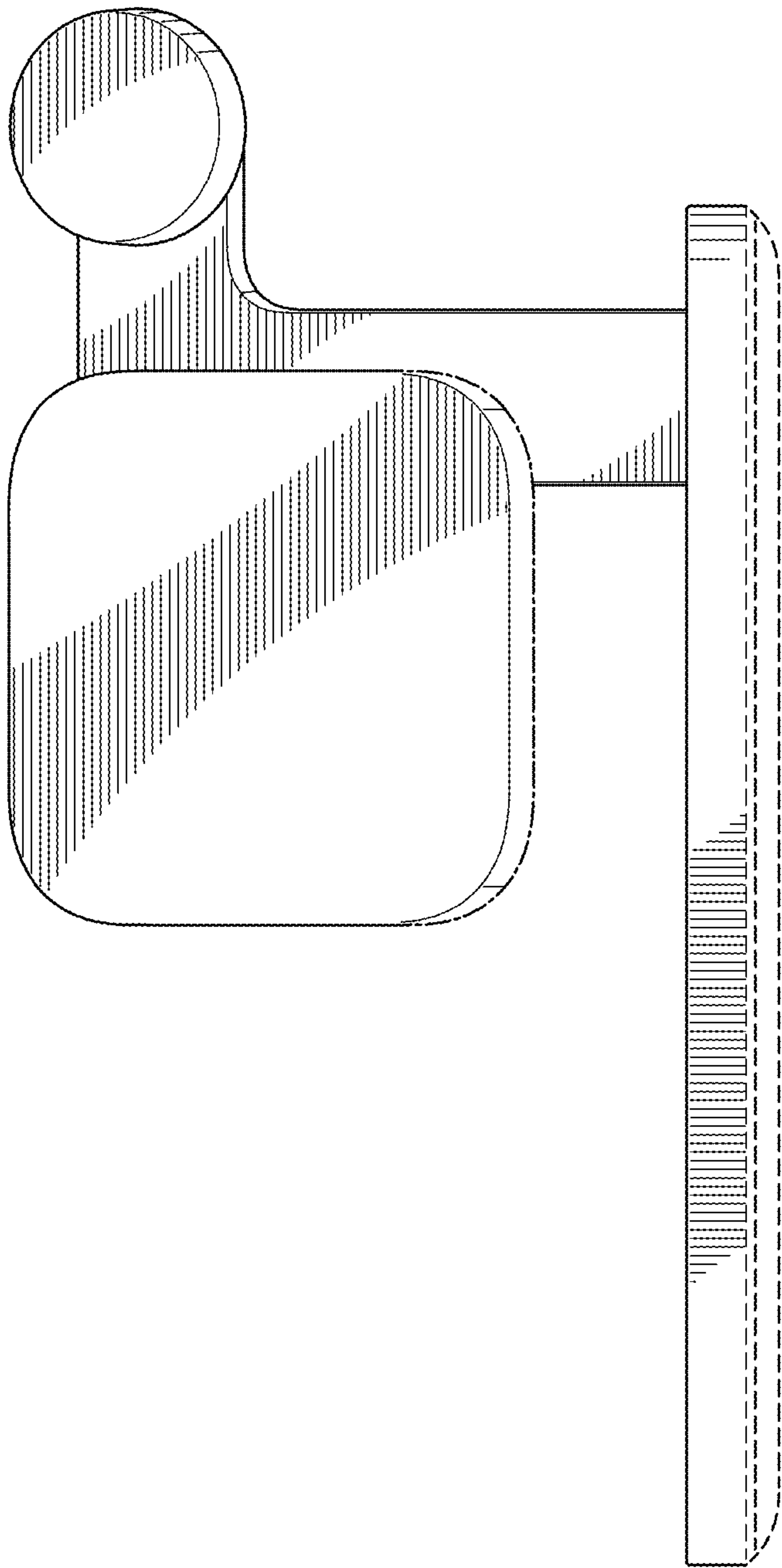

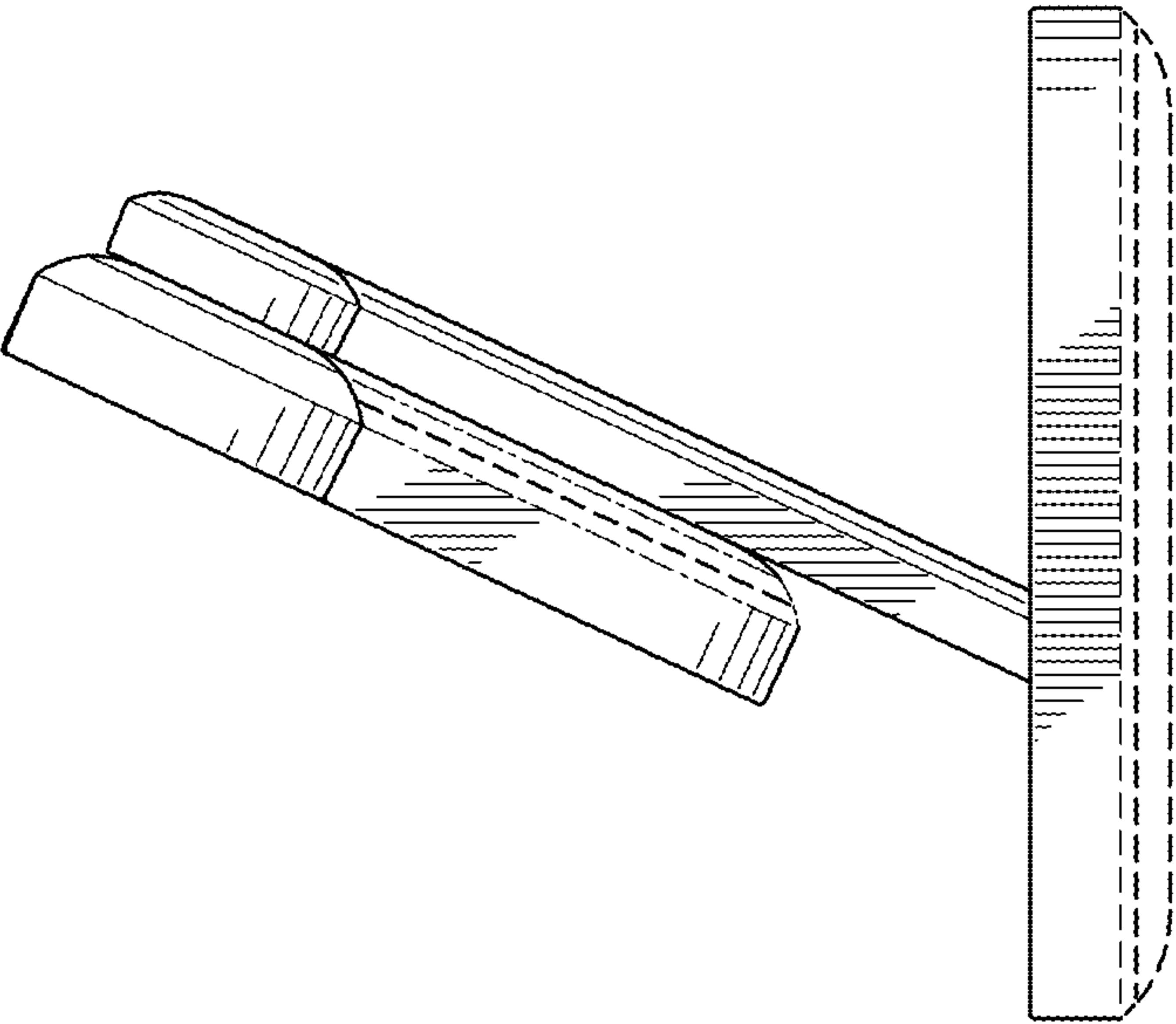

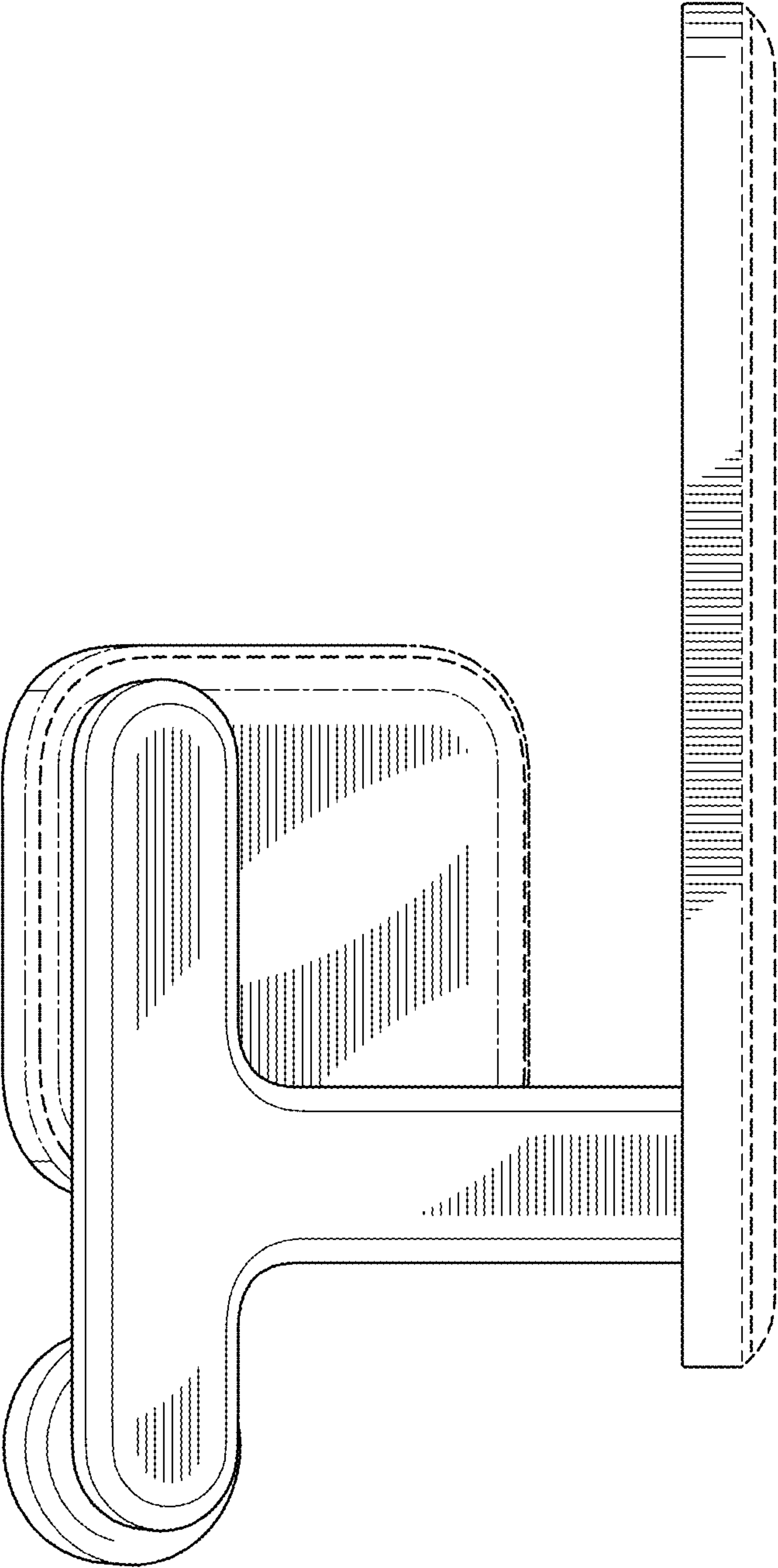

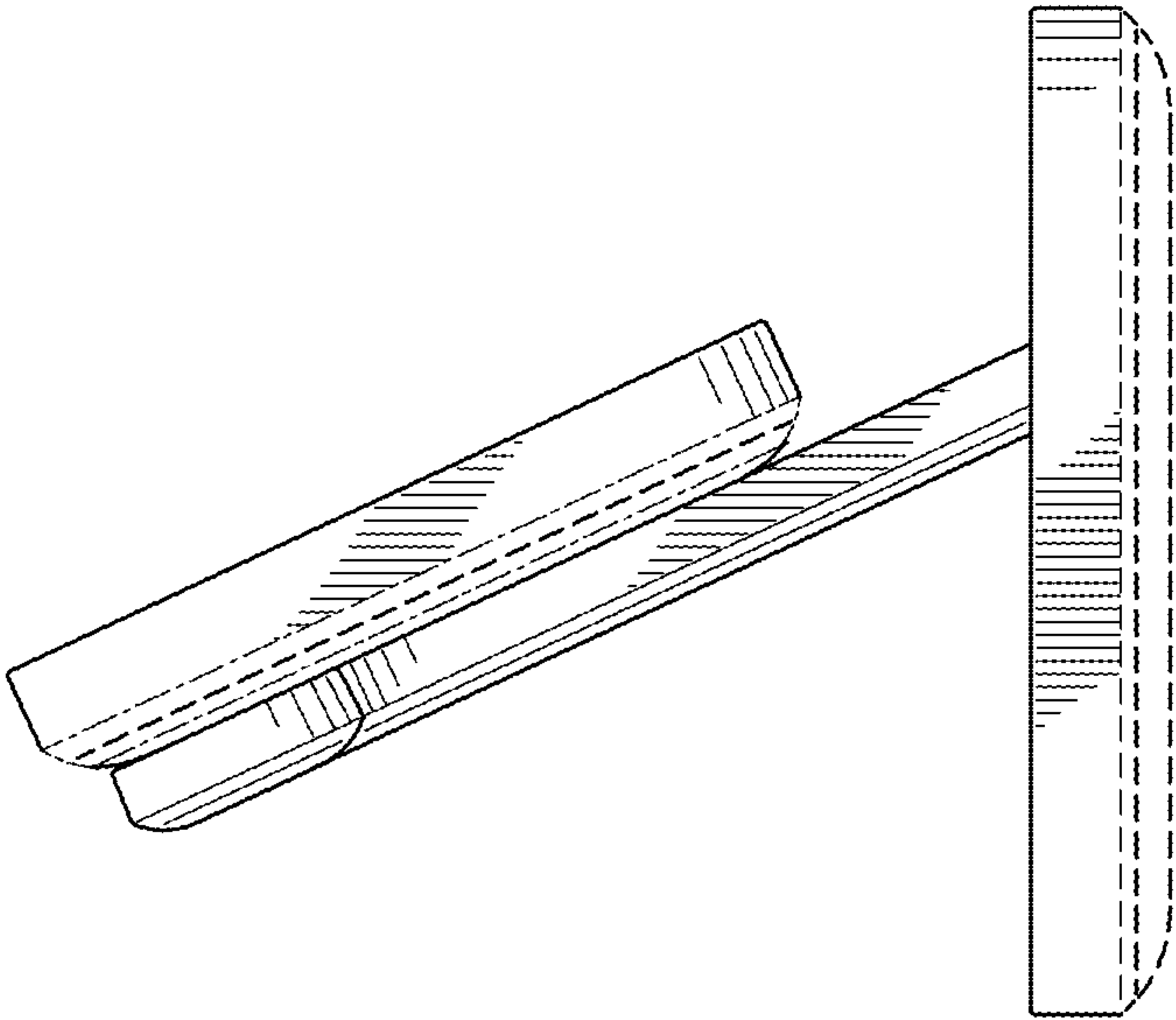

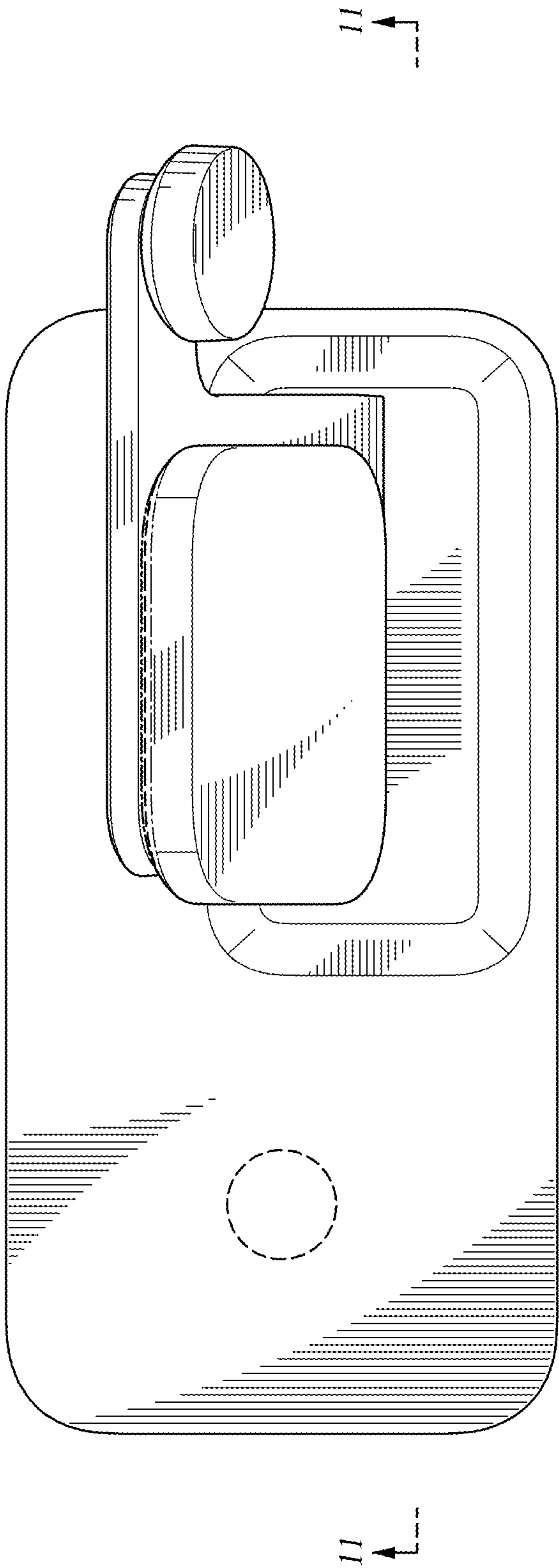

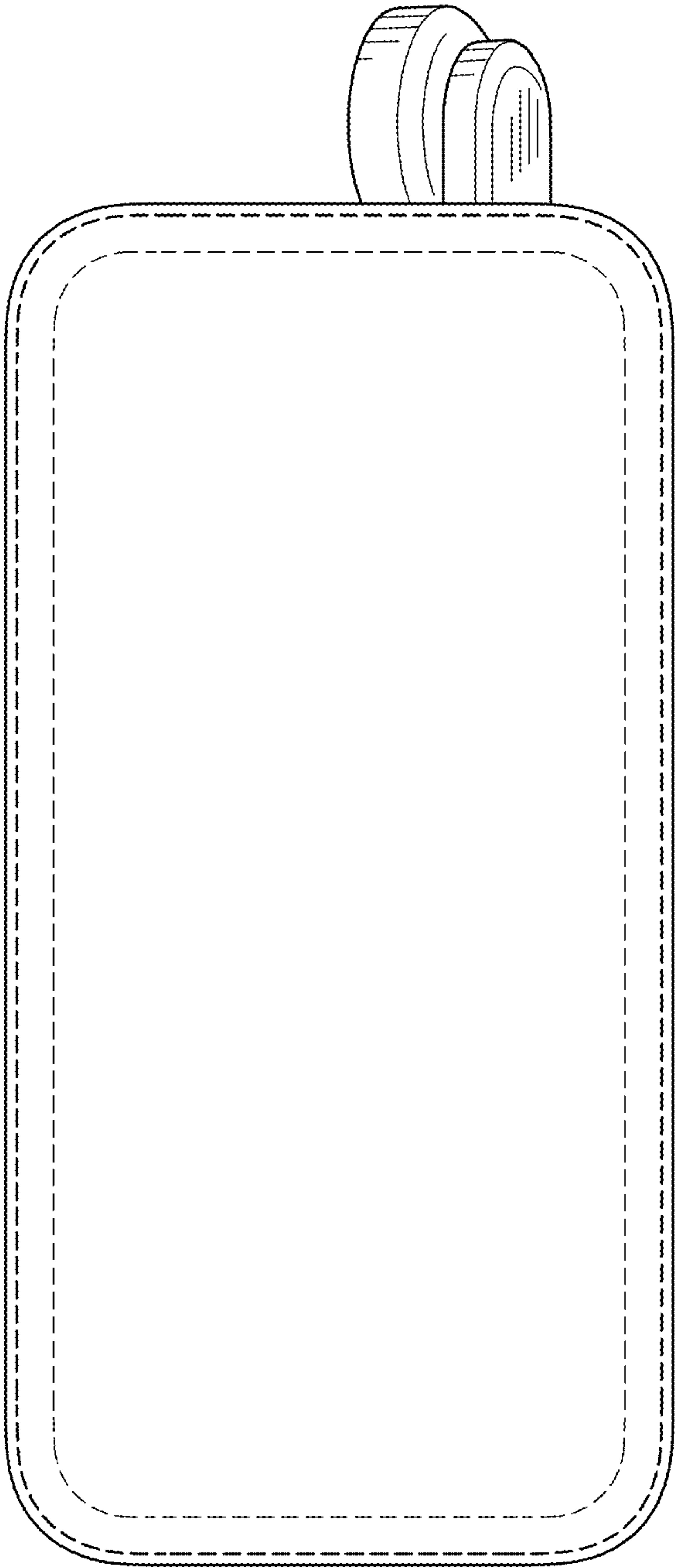

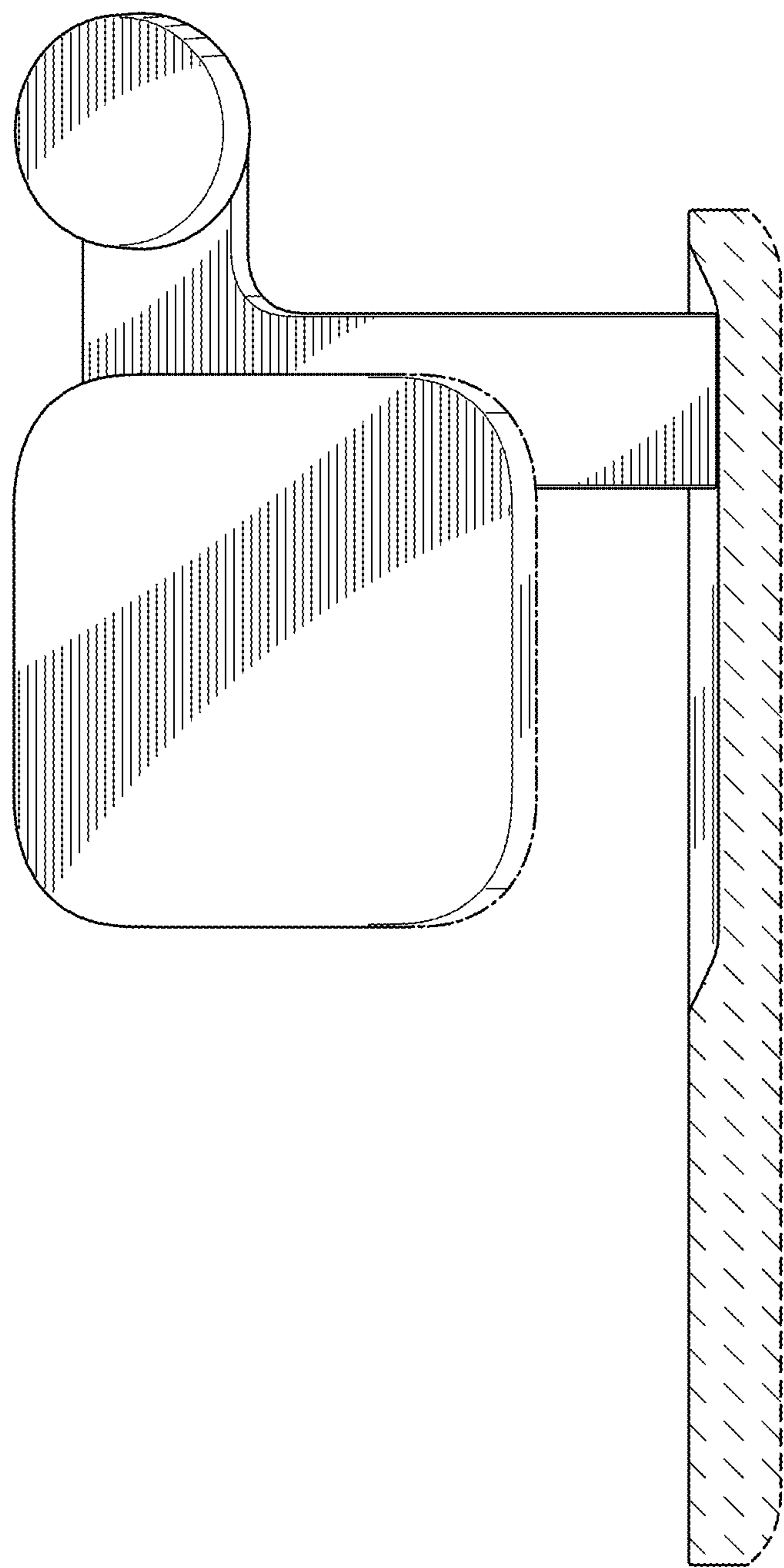
