Within the scope of the appended claim, in which we intend to cover only the ornamental and novel elements shown in the drawings, our invention may be practiced otherwise than as specifically shown and described herein.

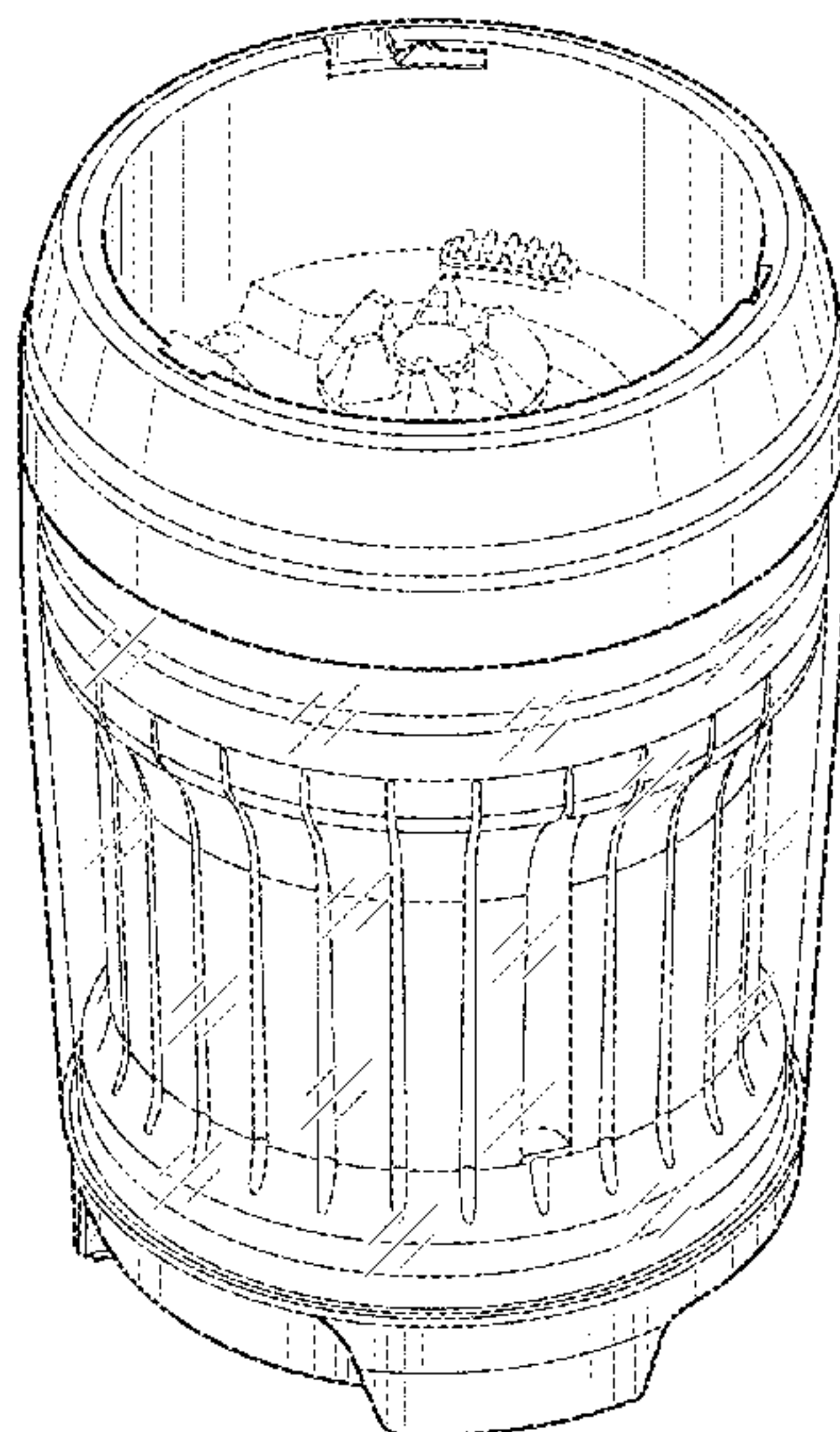

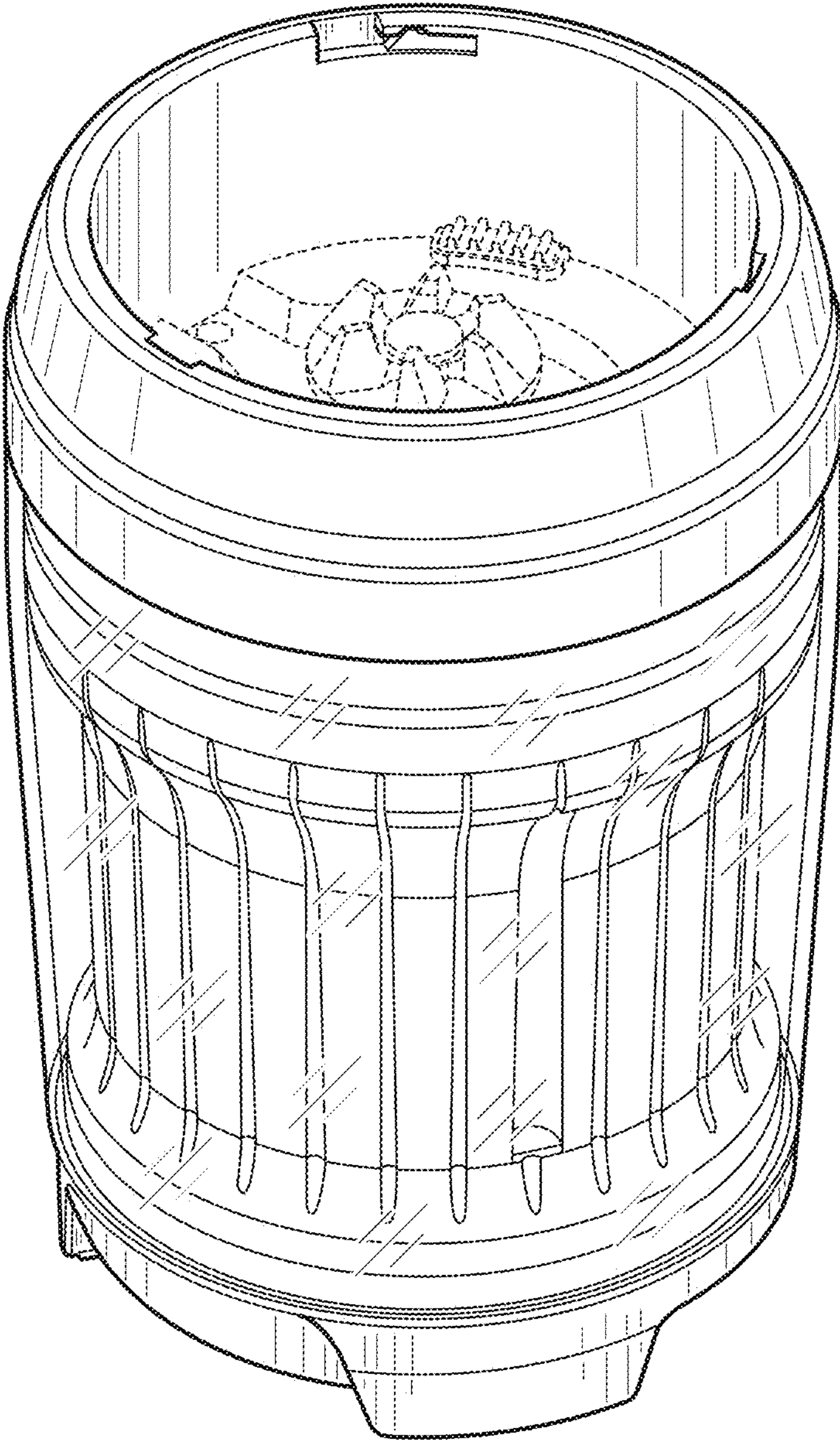

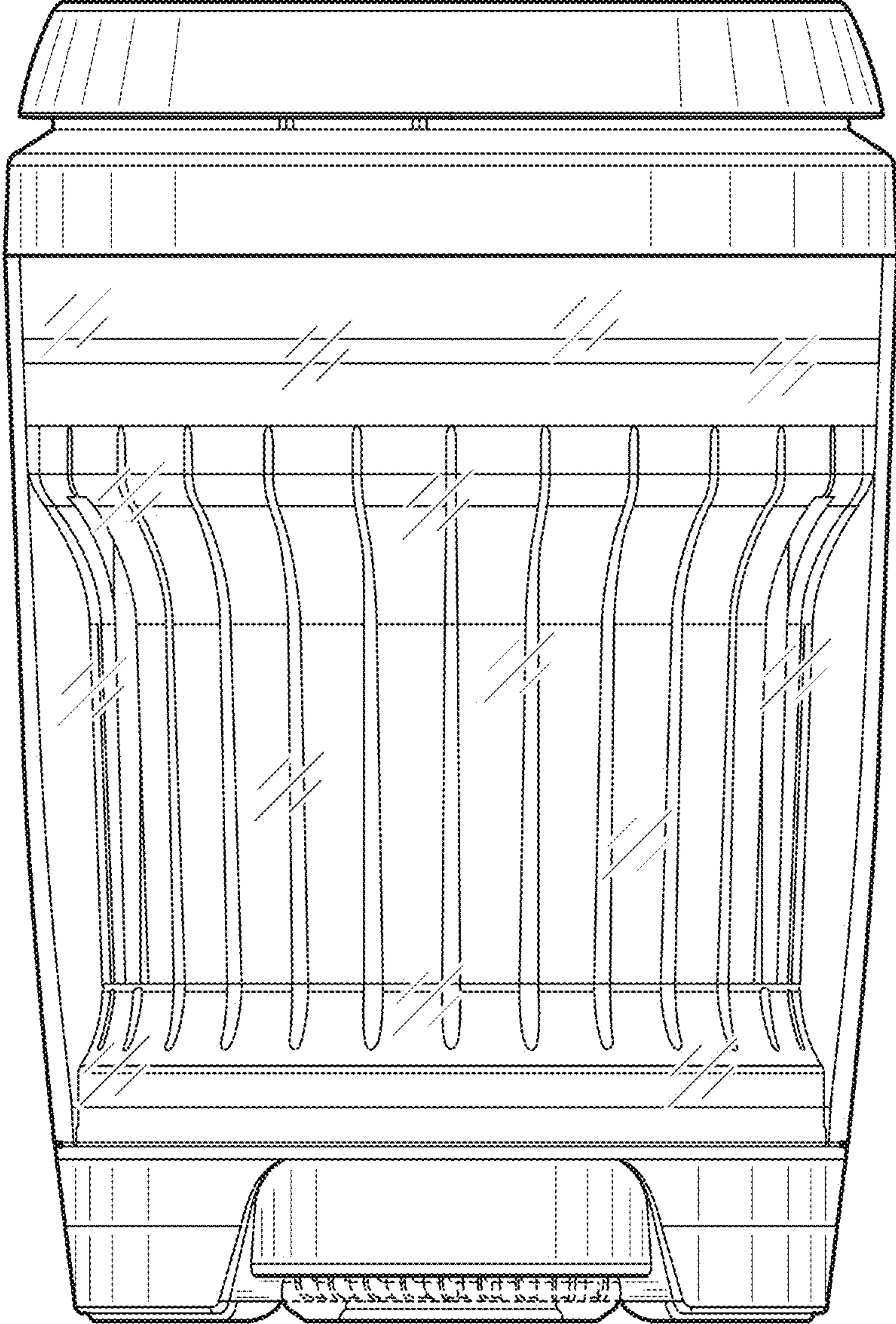

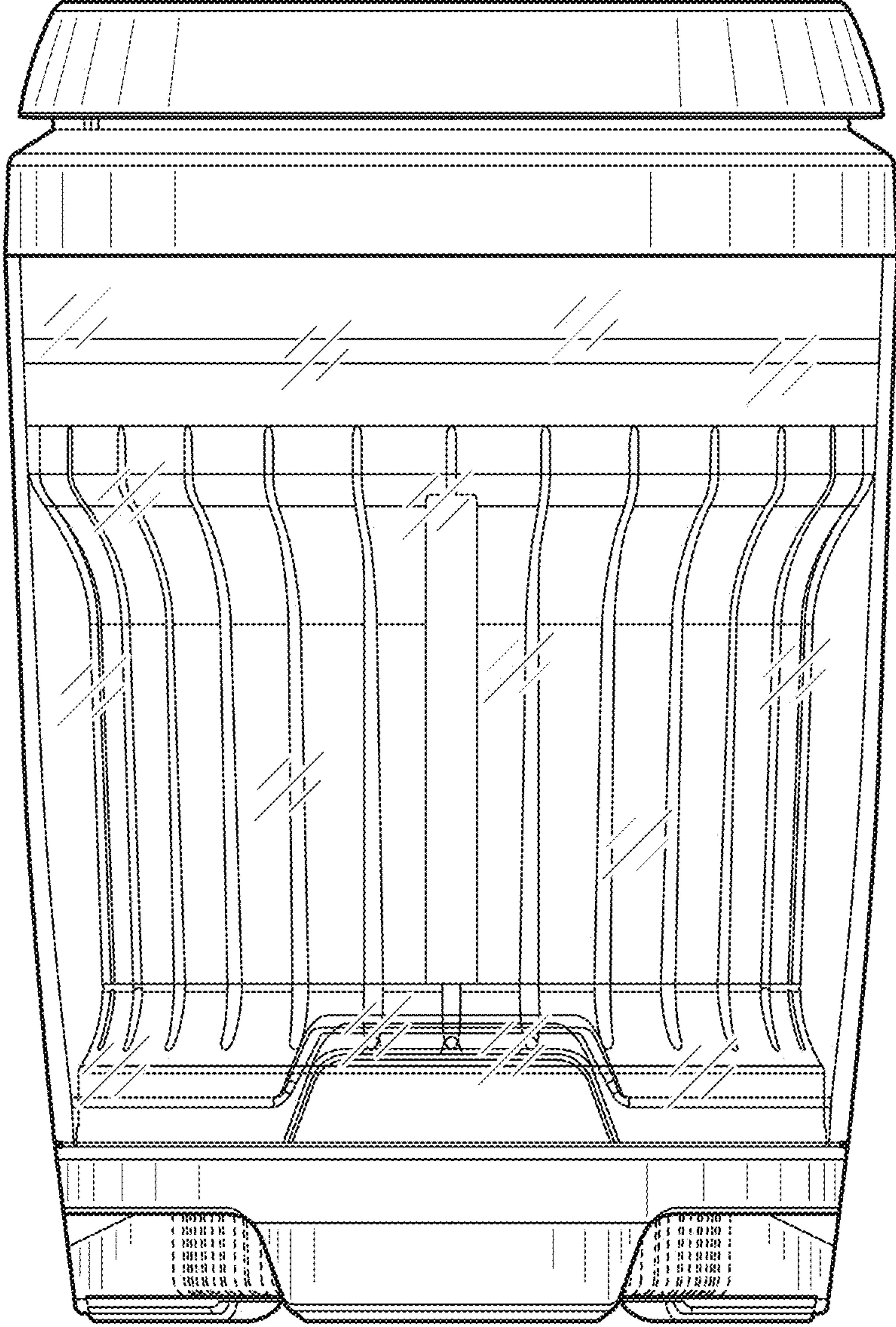

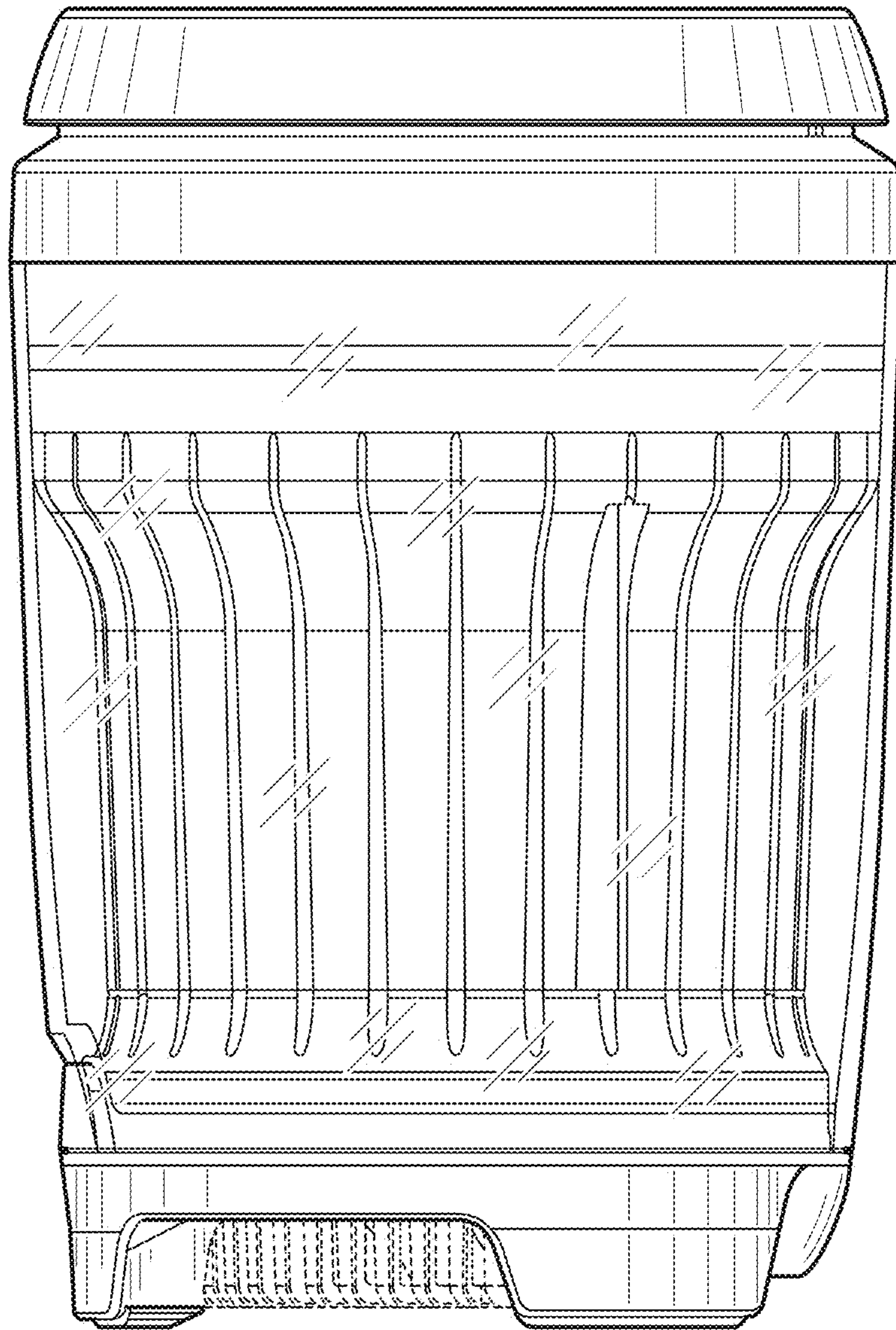

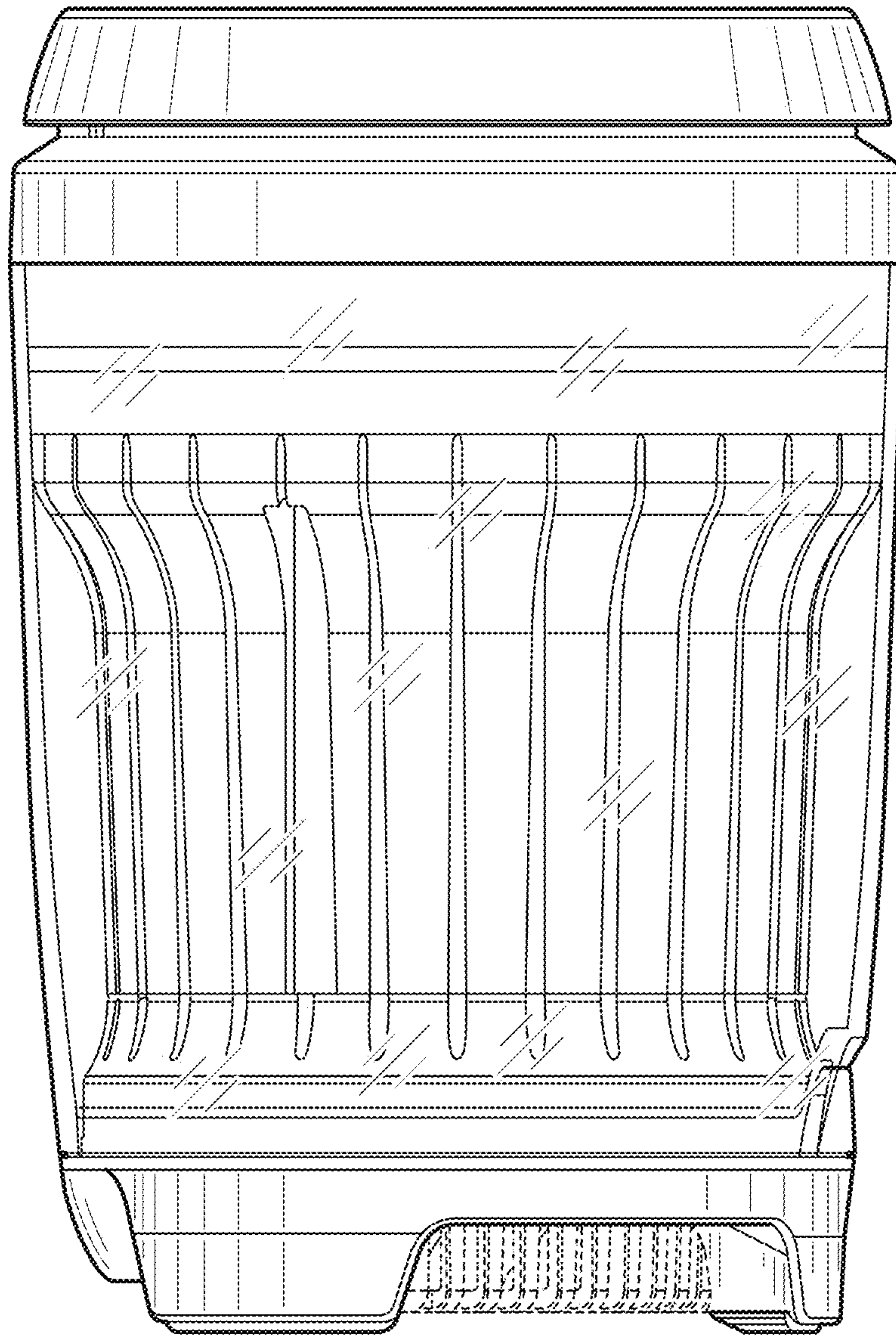

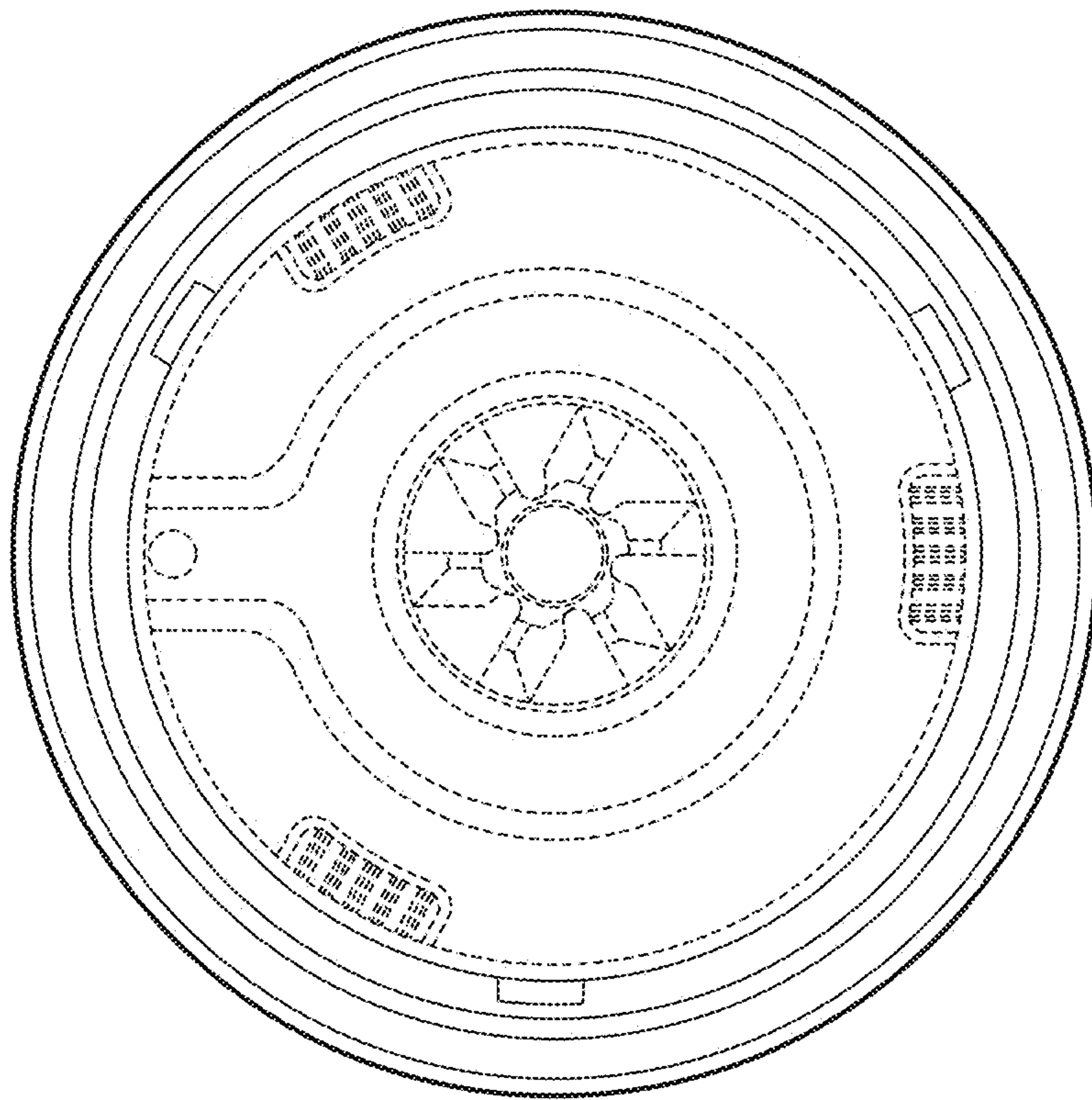

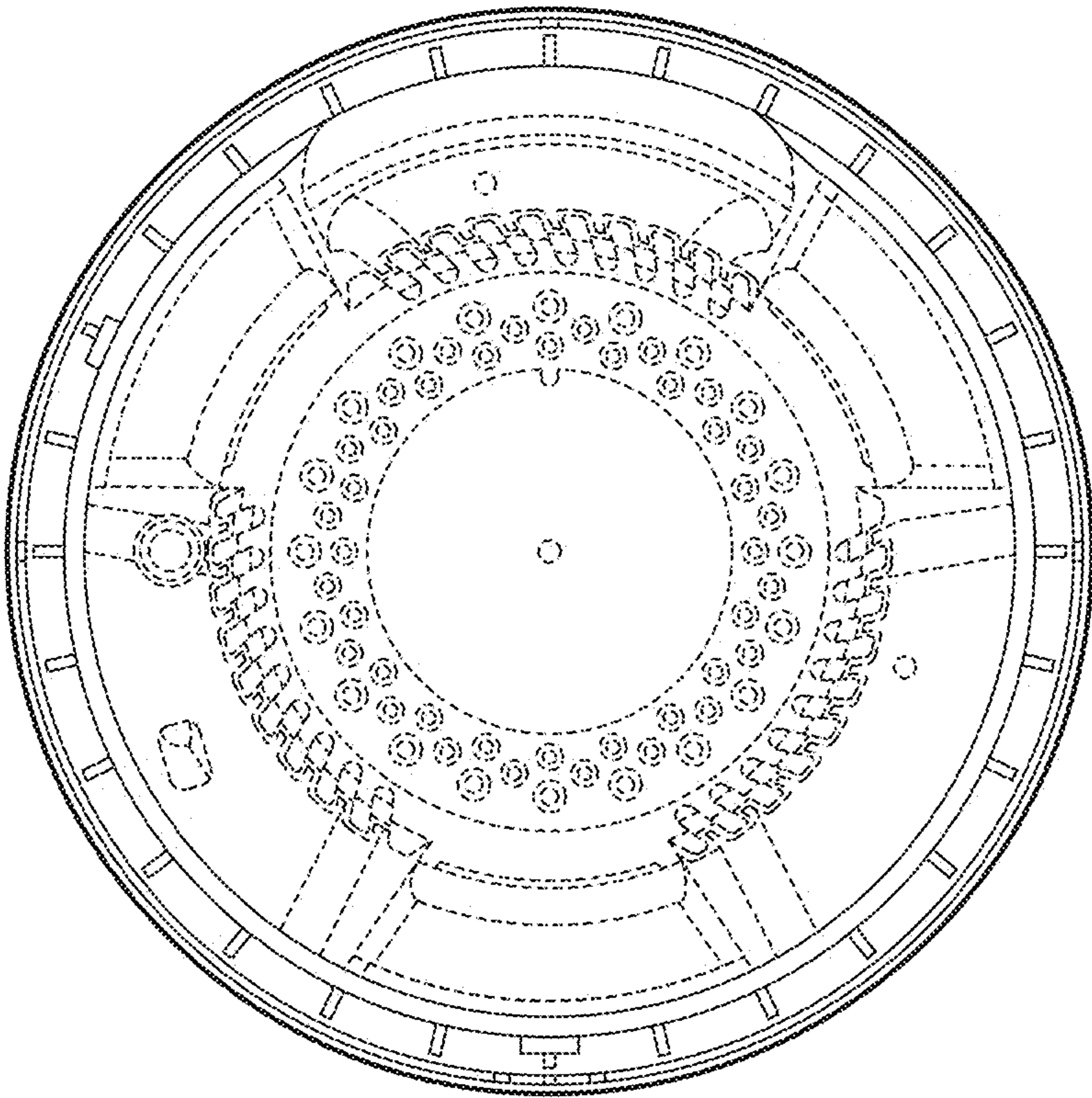
