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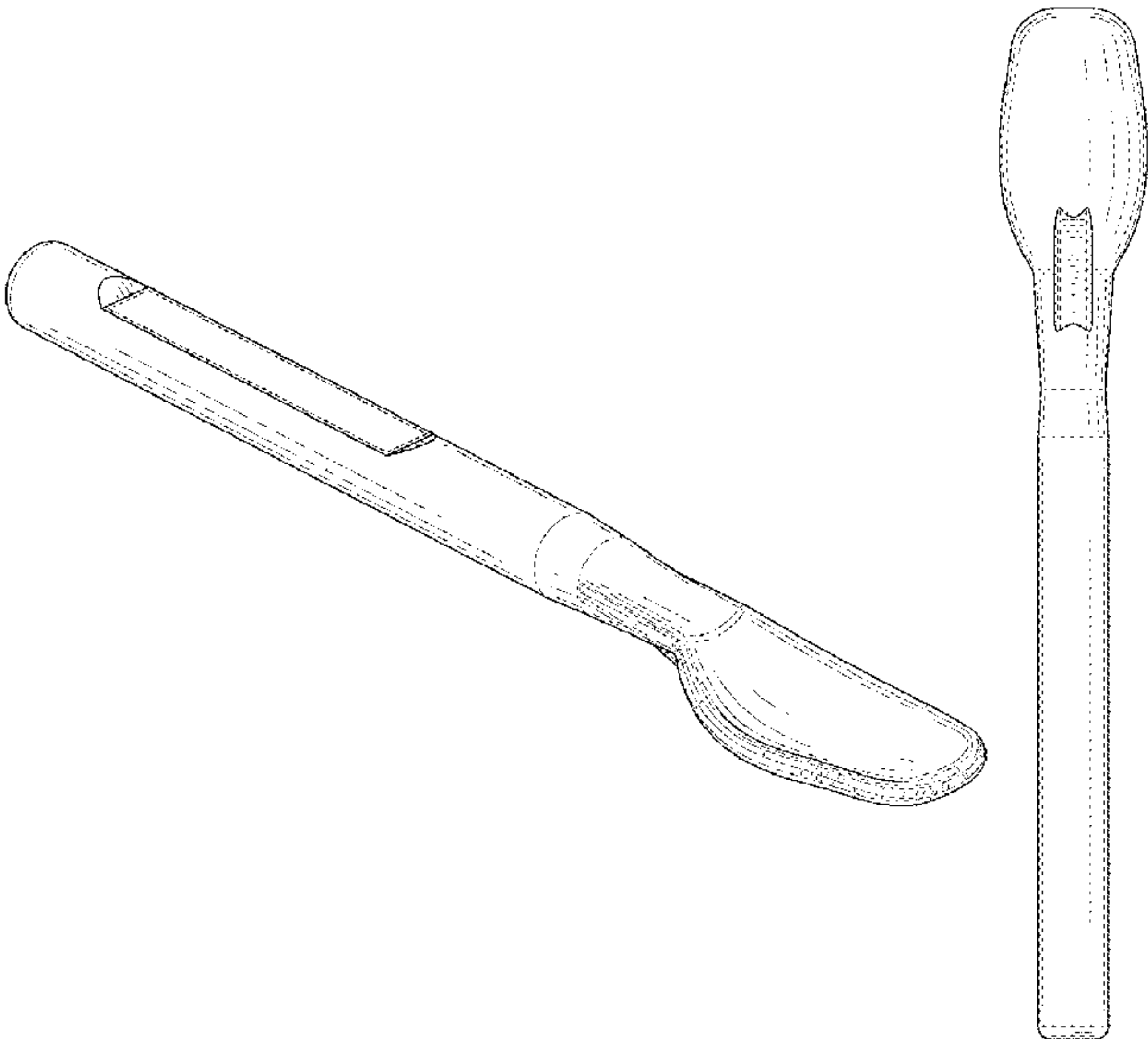
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left perspective view of a feeder spoon, in accordance with my design;

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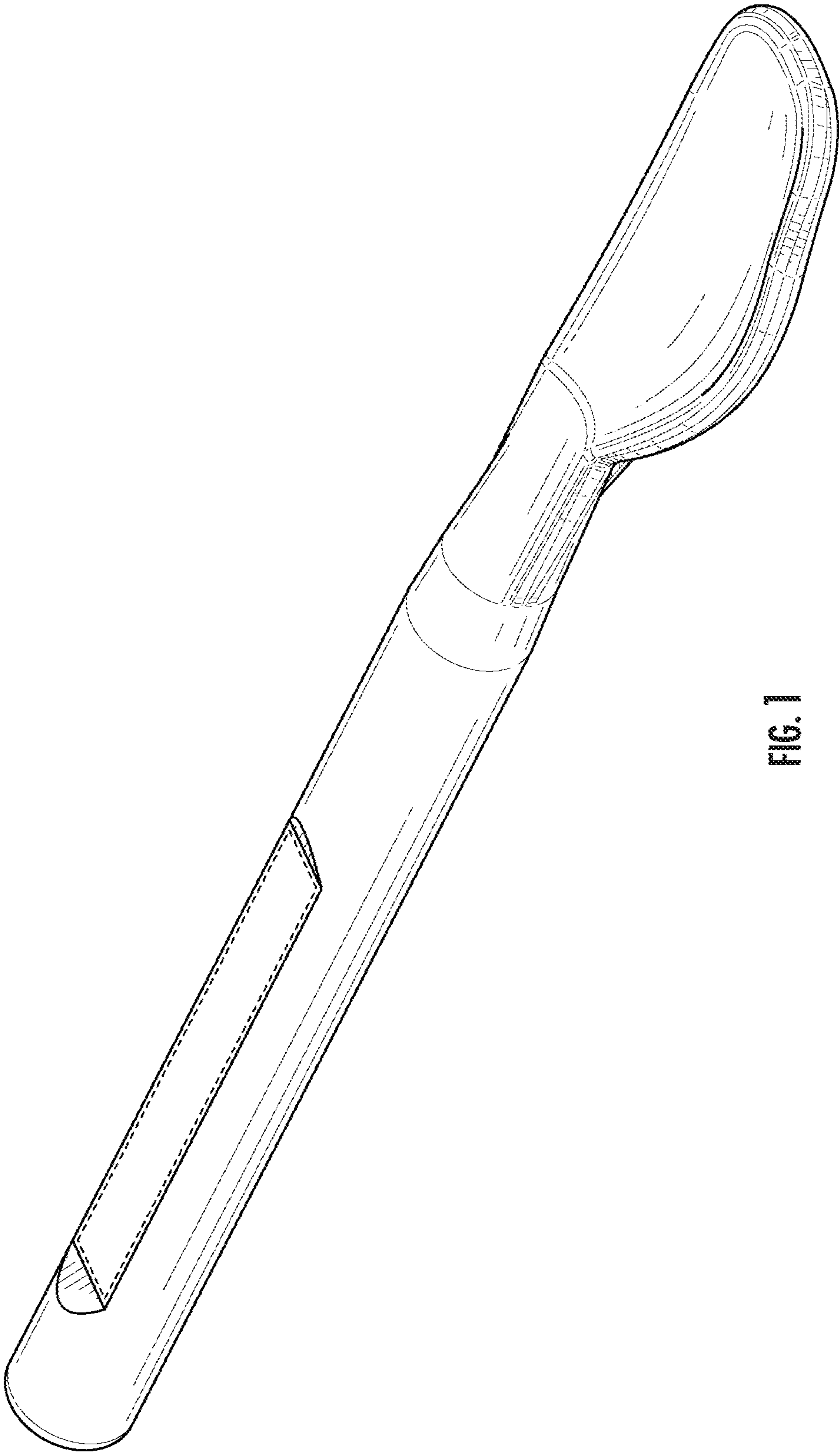

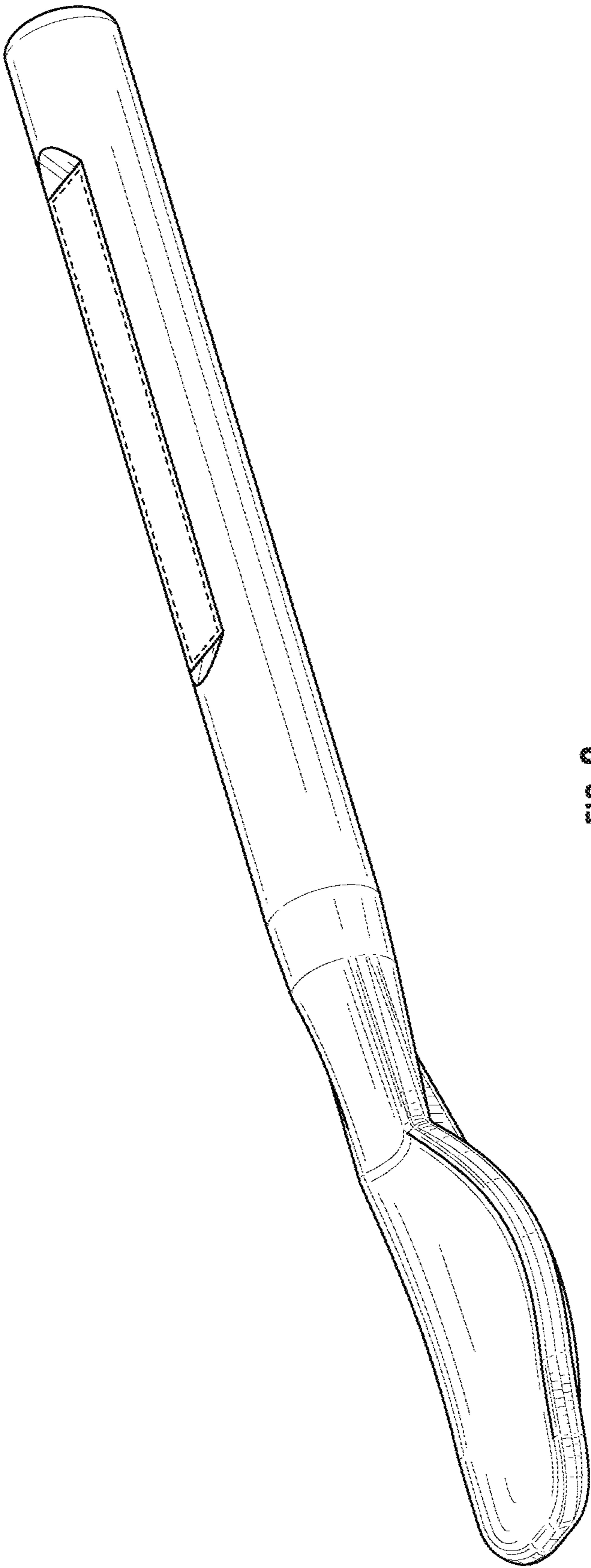

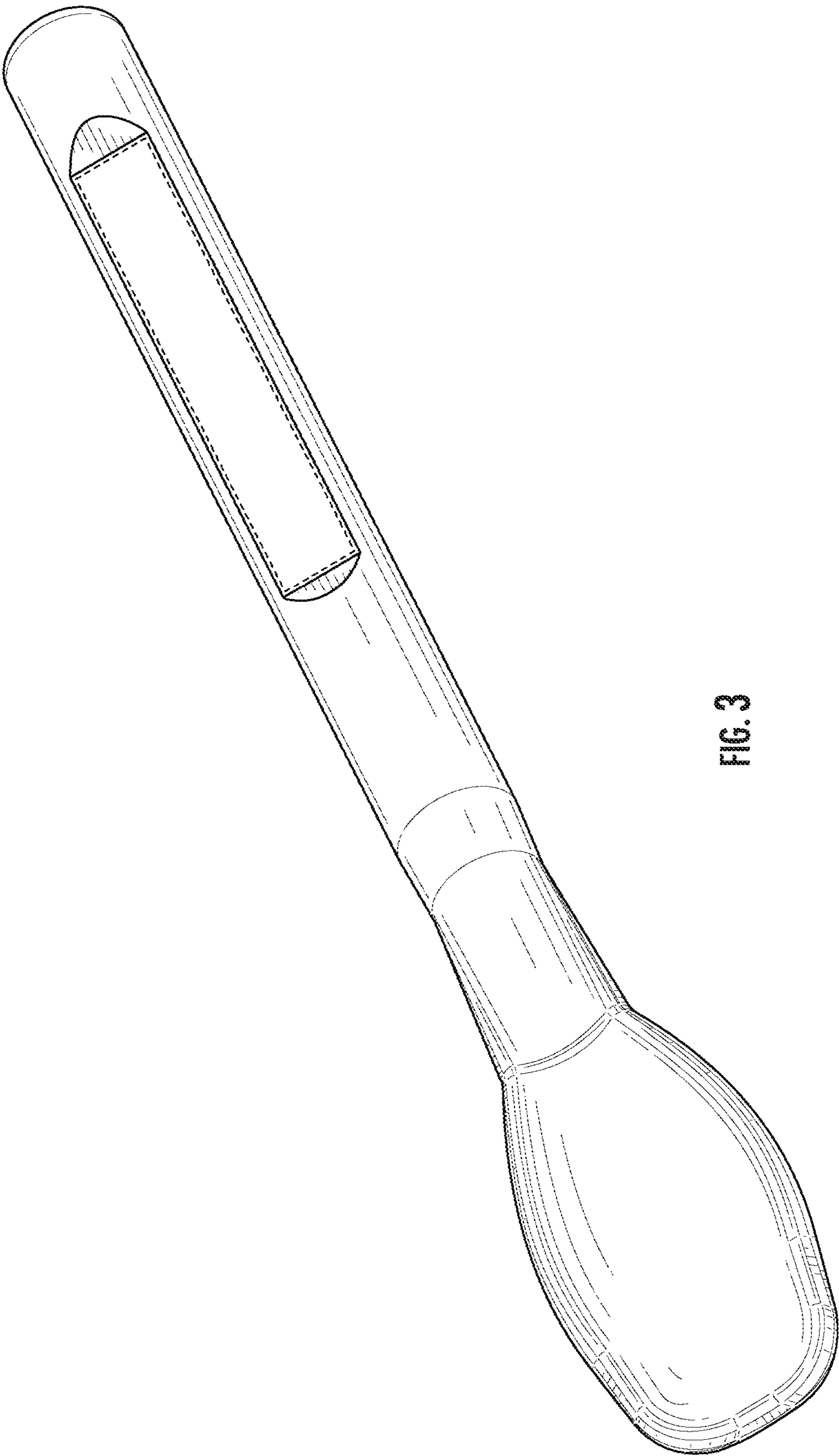

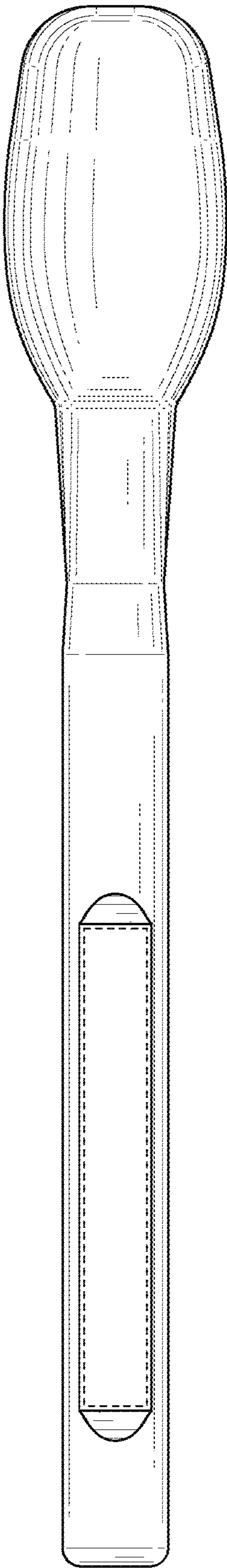

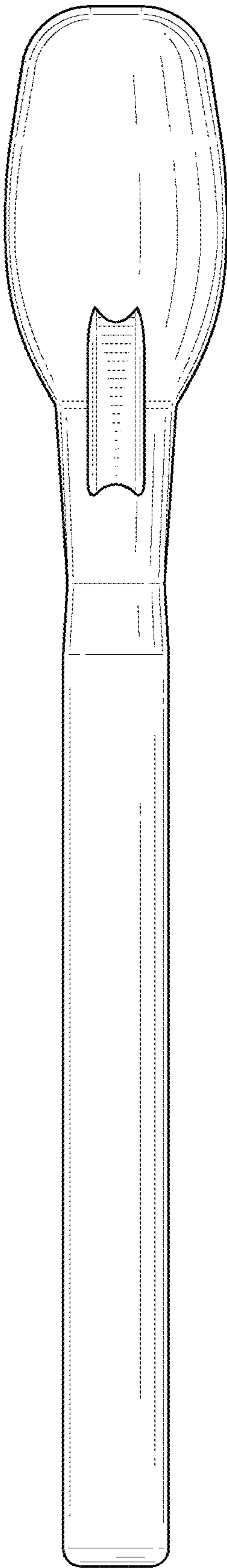

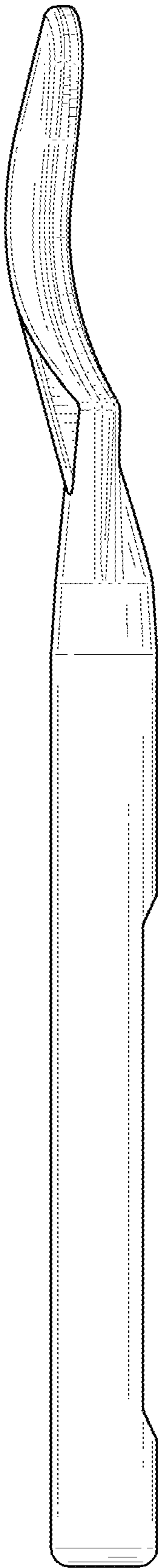

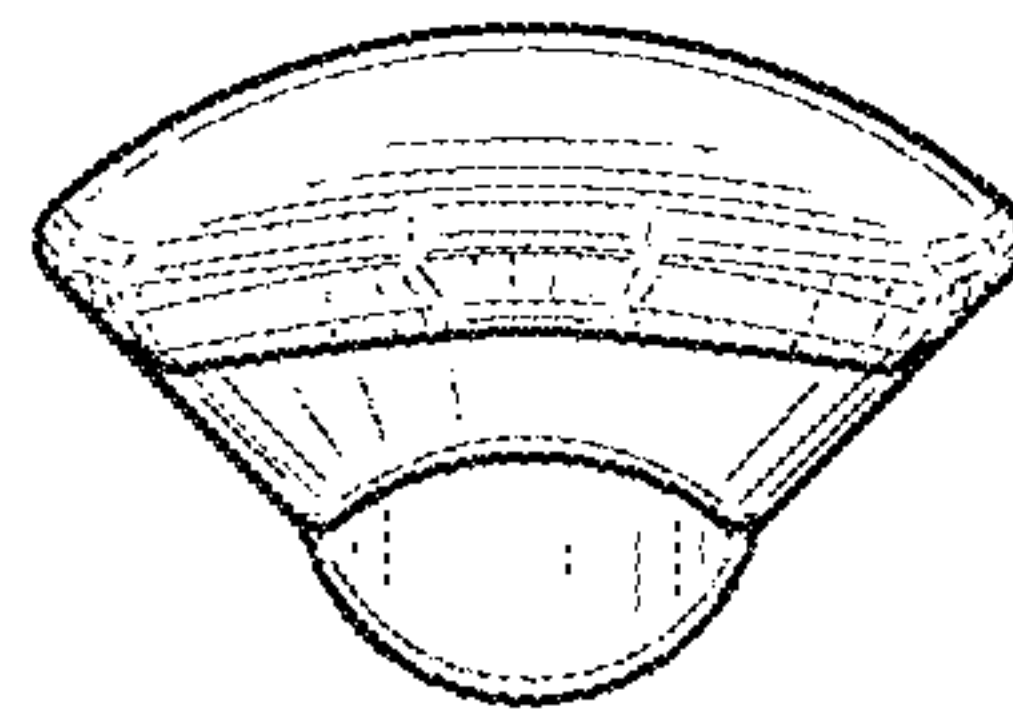

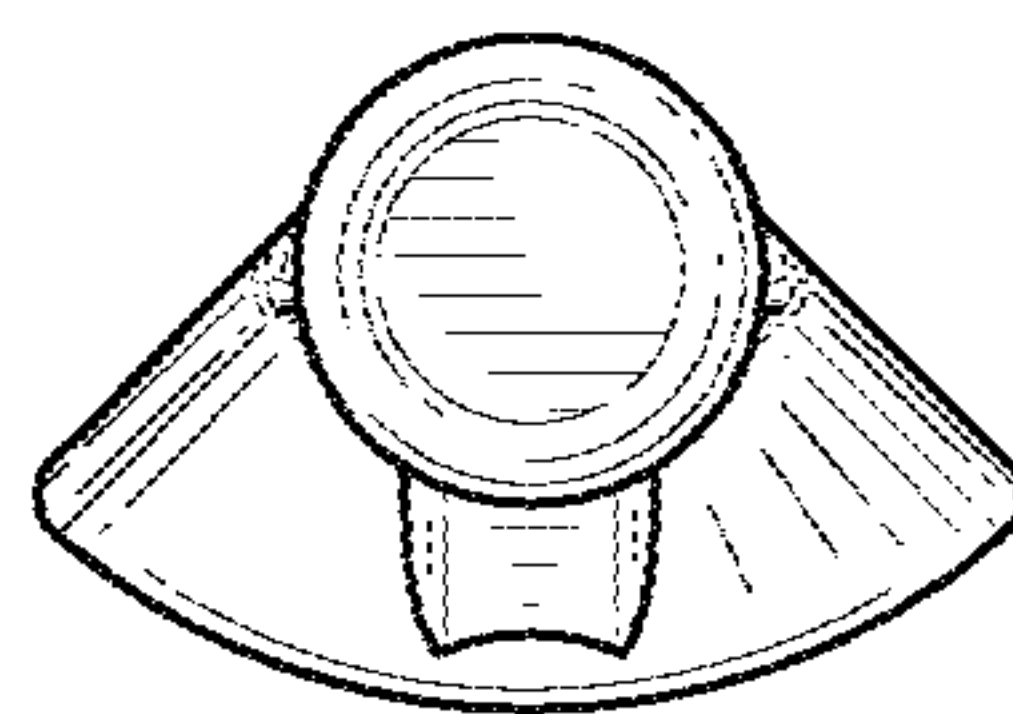
