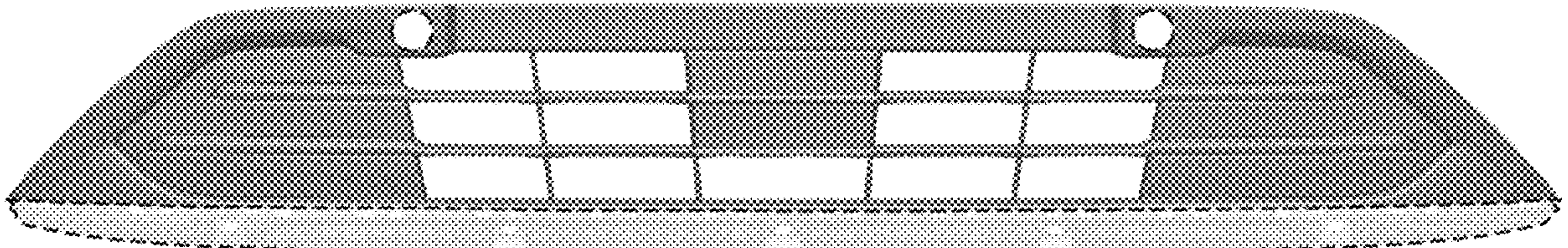
The ornamental design for a vehicle front lower grille, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vehicle front lower grille, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof;

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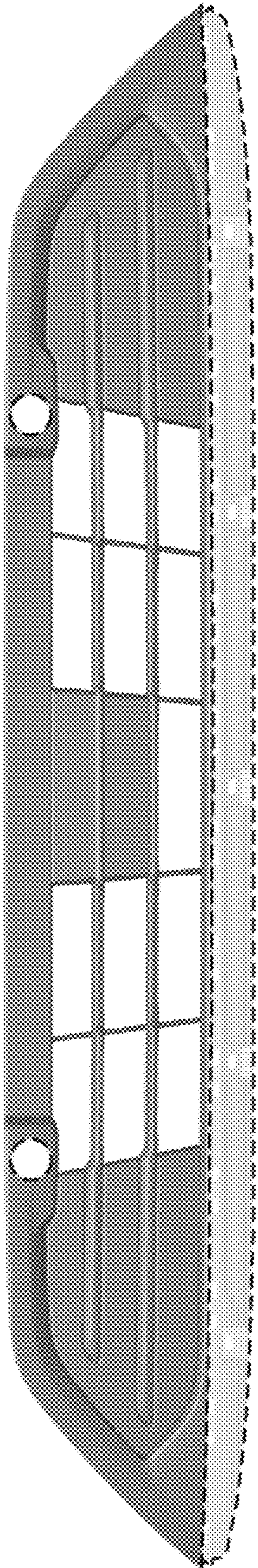

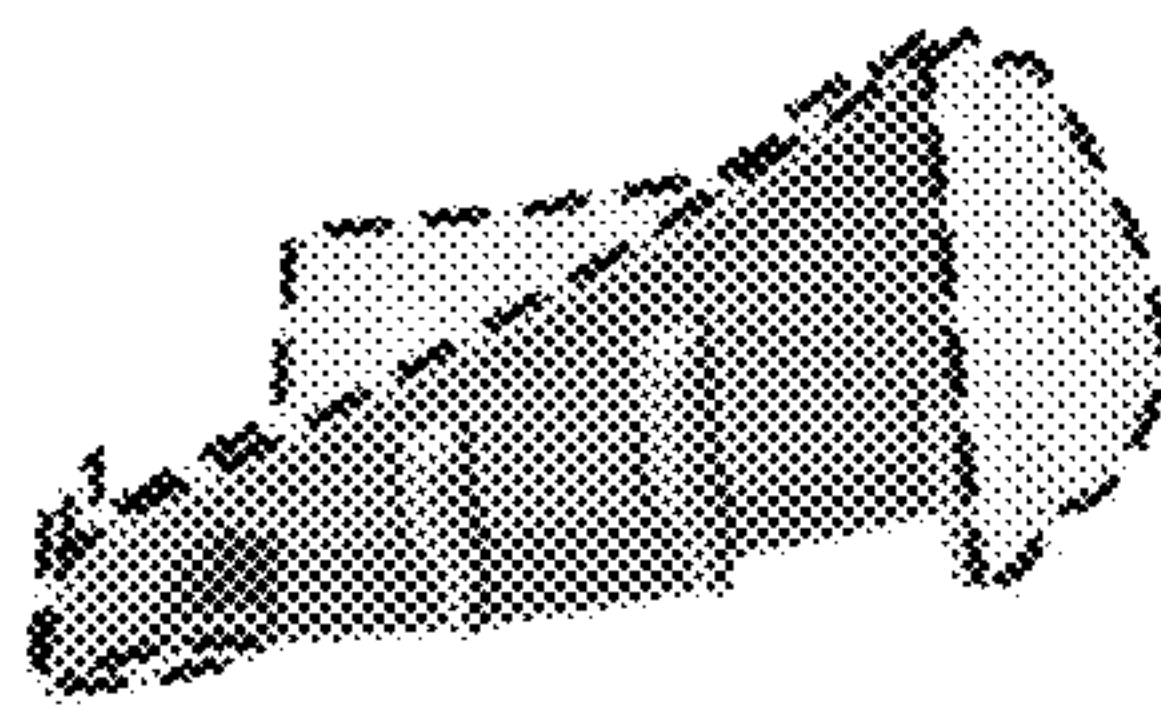

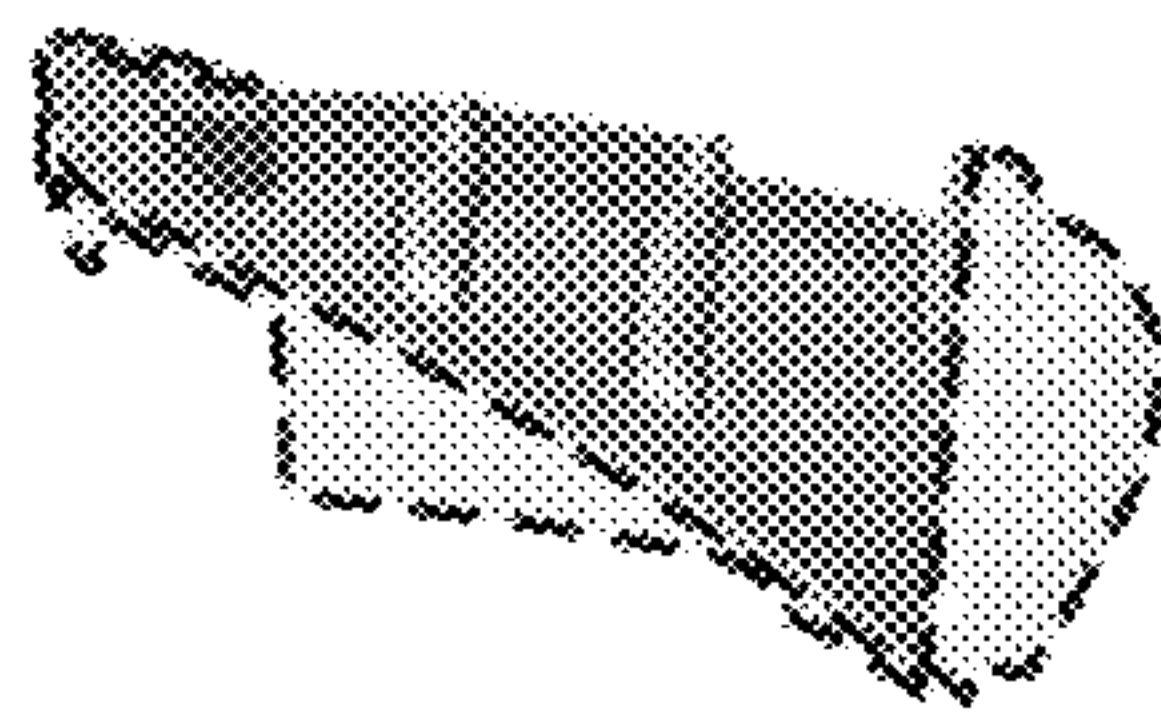

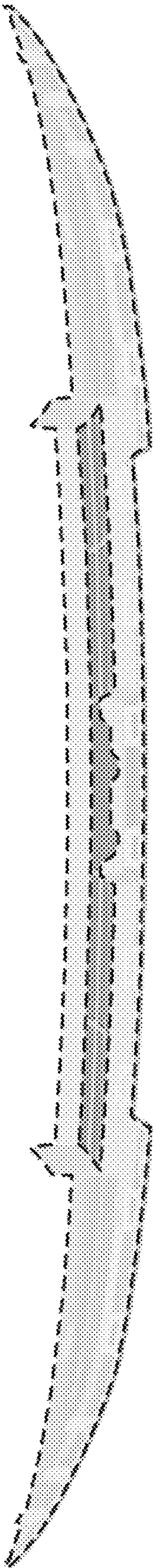

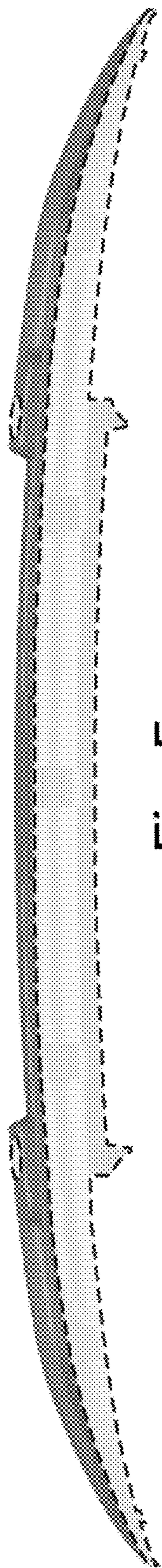

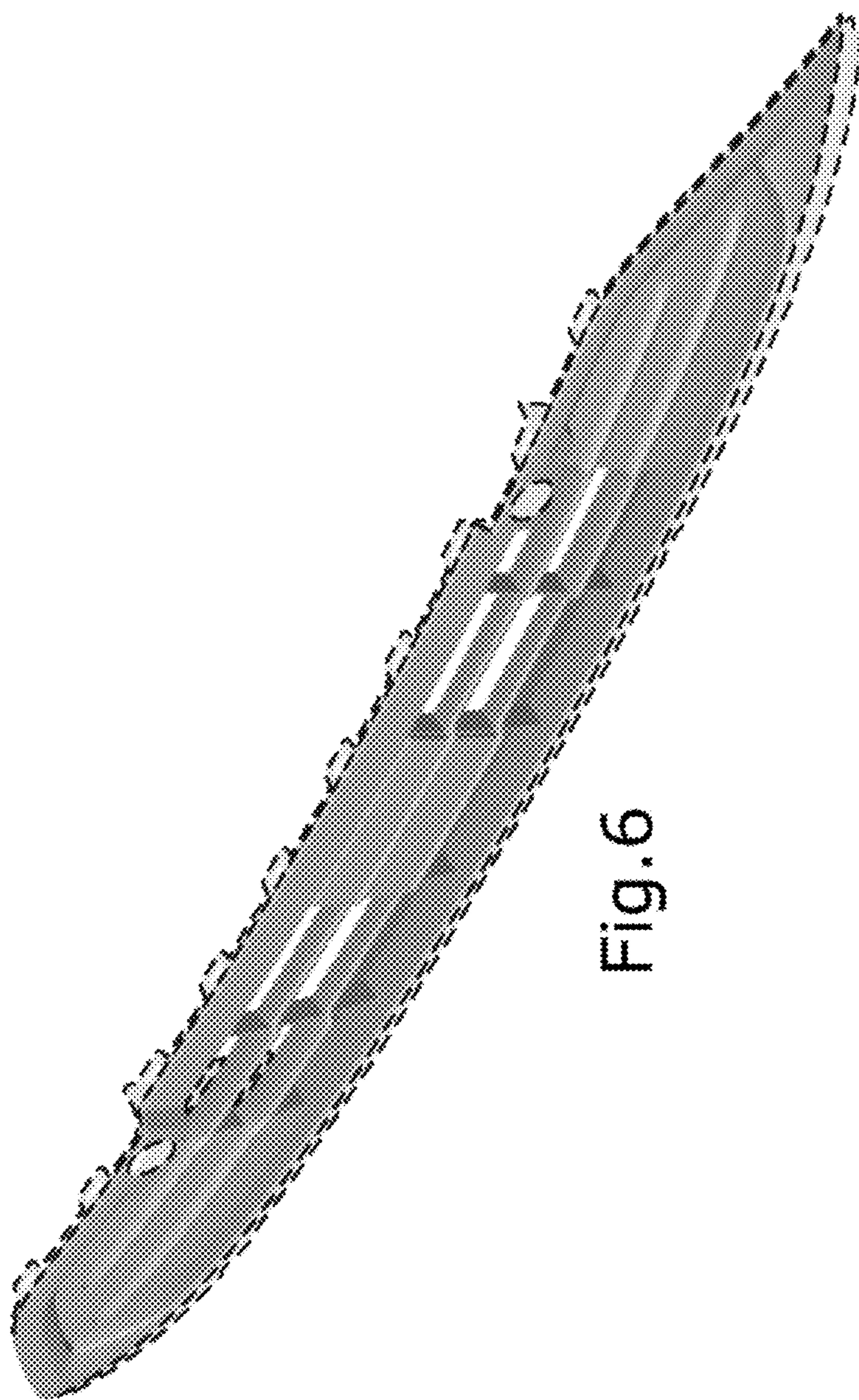

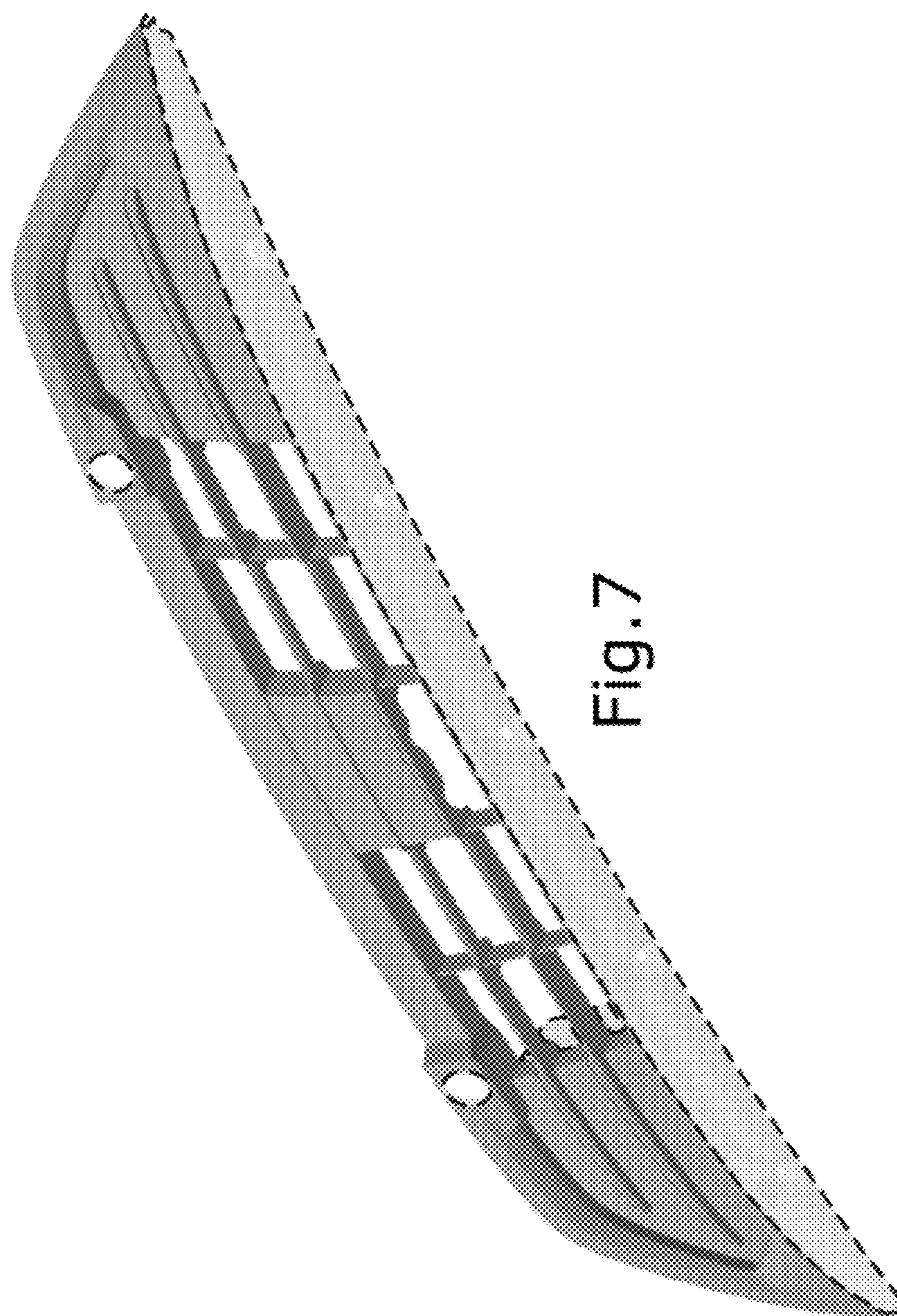
