(57) **CLAIM**

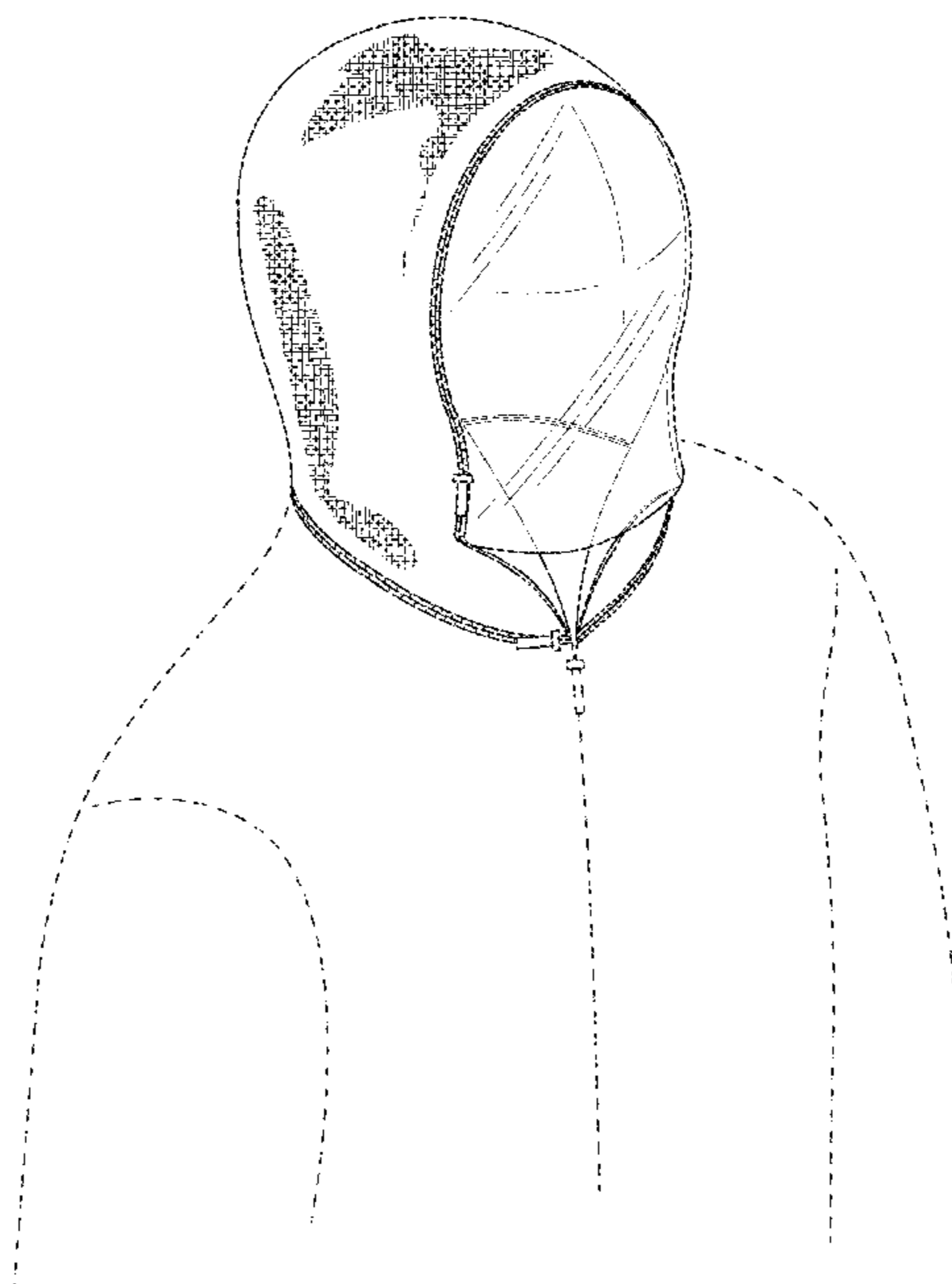
The ornamental design for a hood with a detachable transparent face shield, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the hood with a detachable transparent face shield, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, showing the transparent face shield detached from the hood.

The jacket outlined by broken lines assist to illustrate the environment of the claimed design and forms no part of the claimed design. The zipper pulls of the hood with detachable transparent face shield outlined by broken lines depict features of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

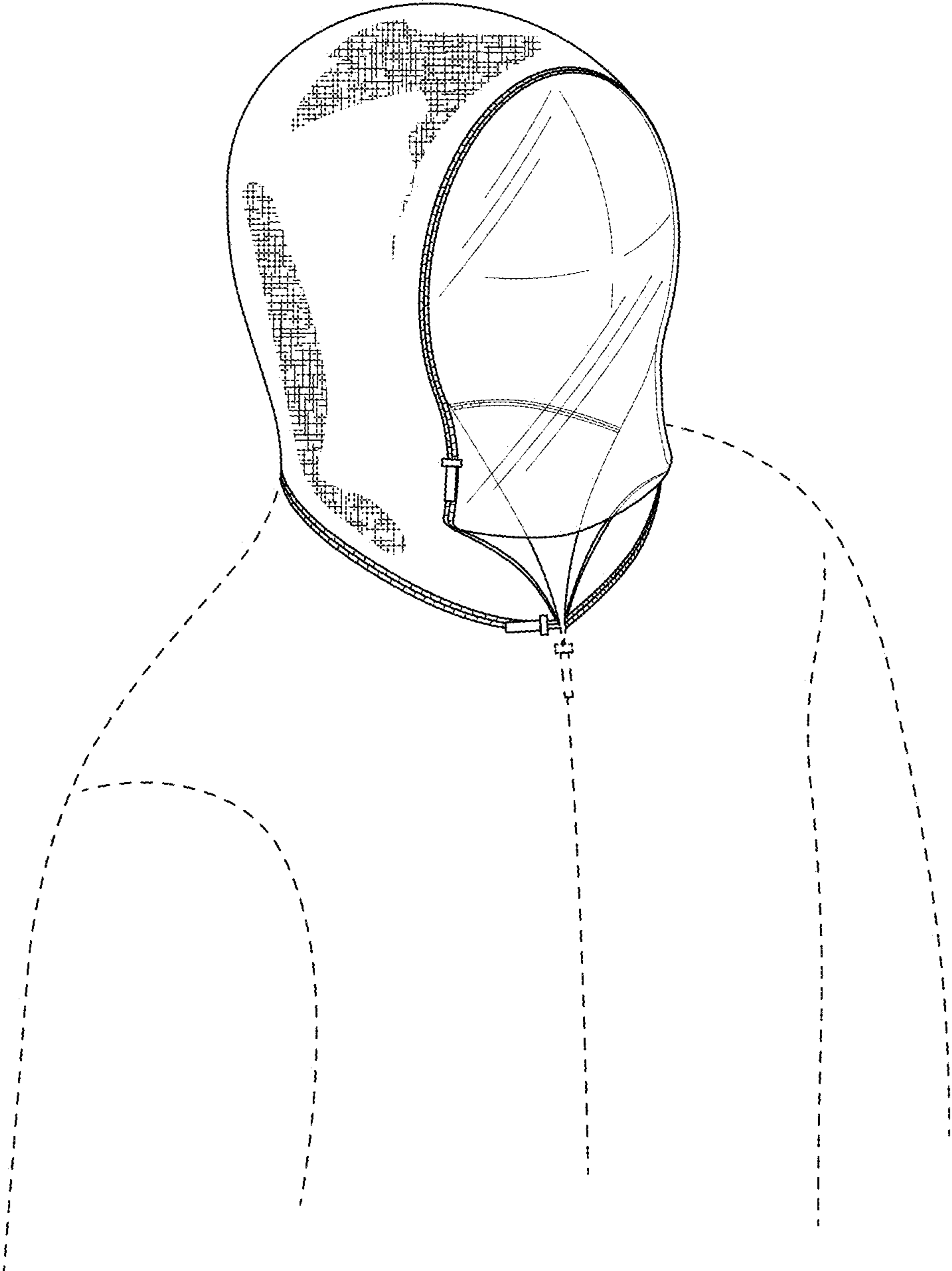

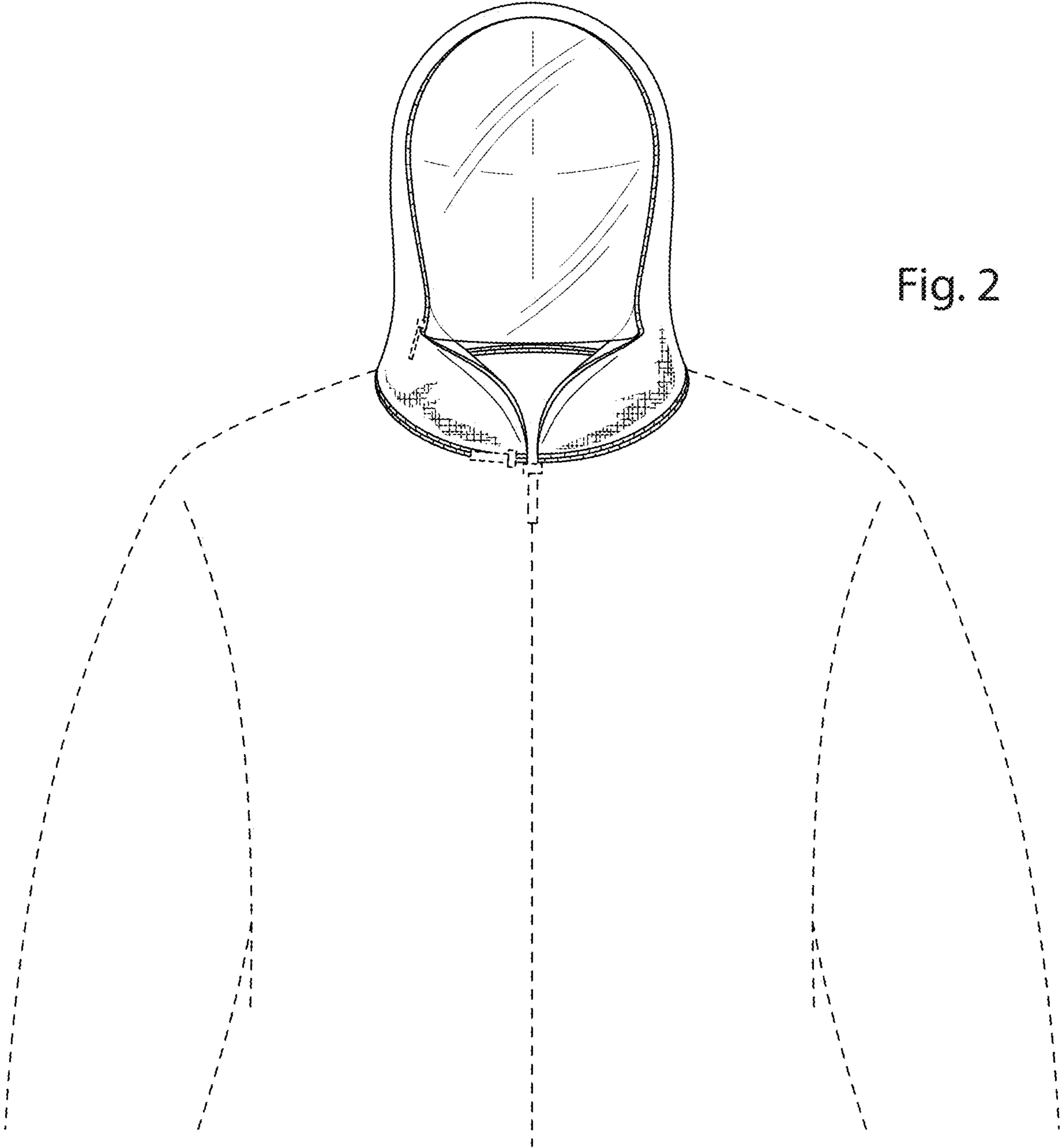
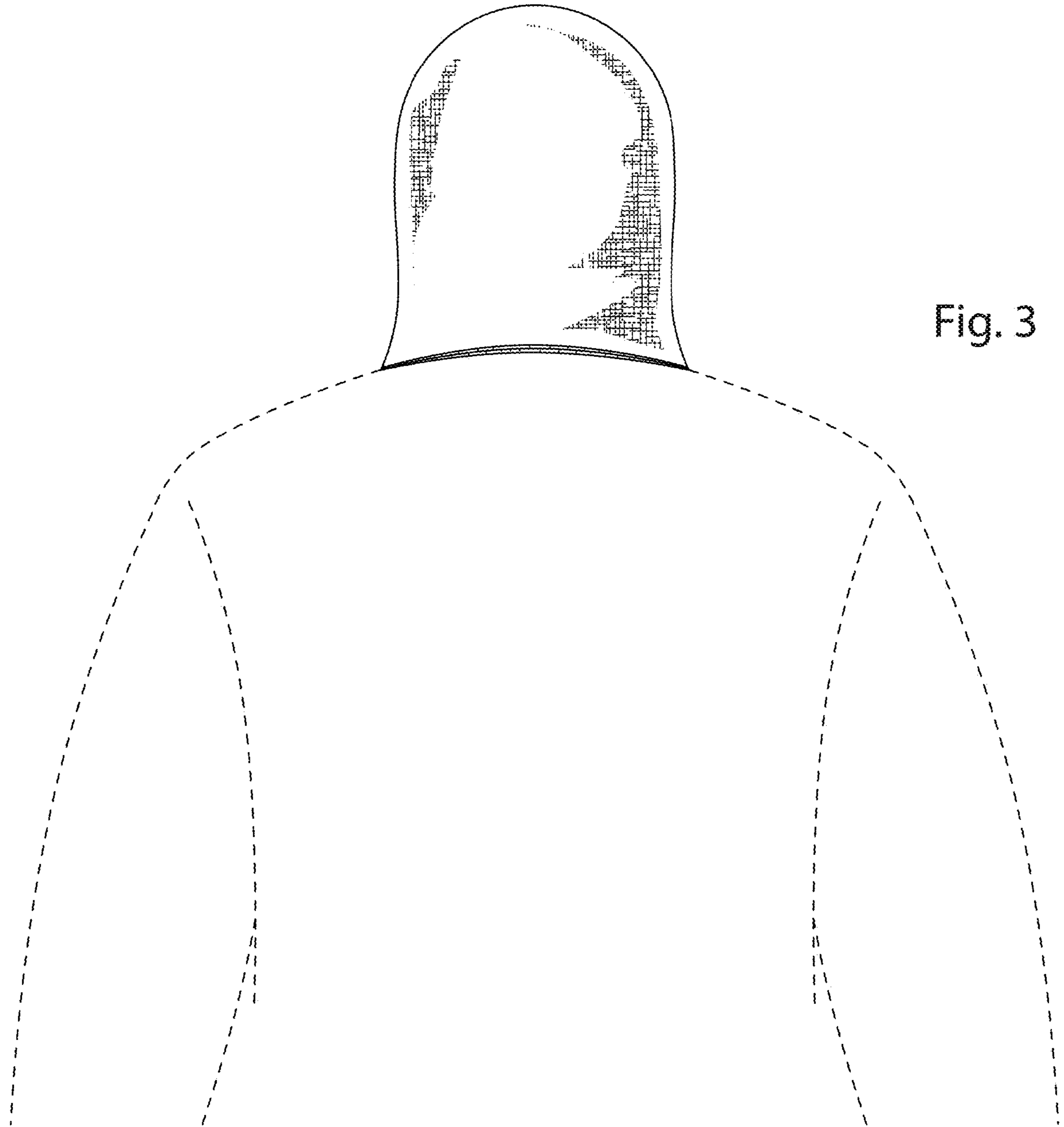

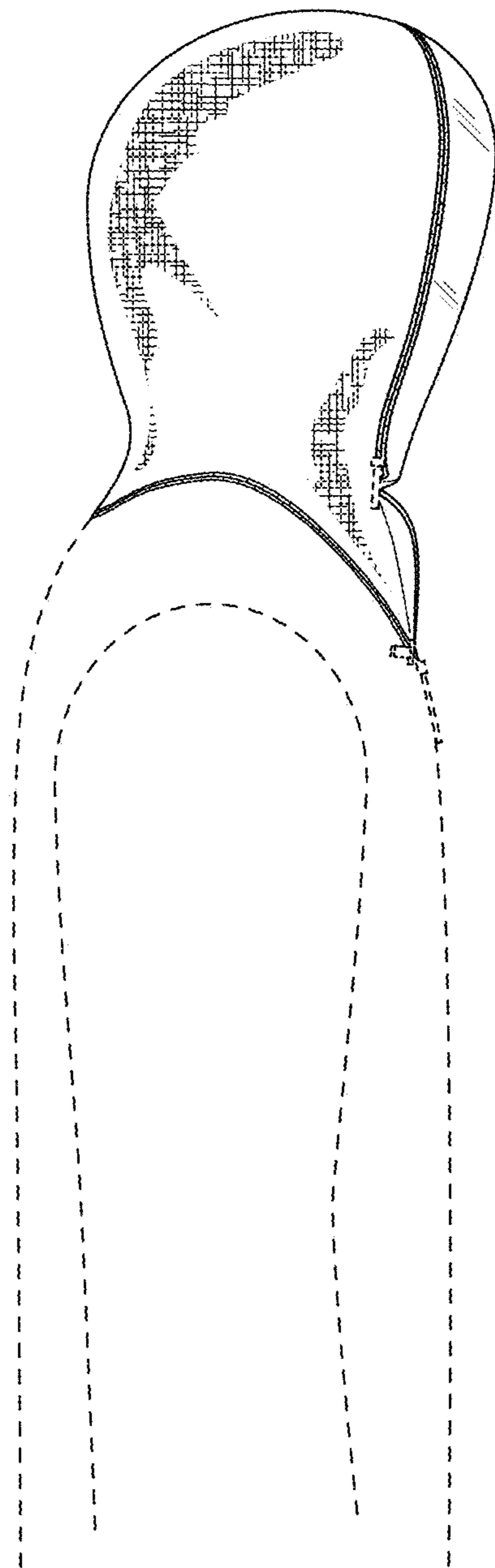

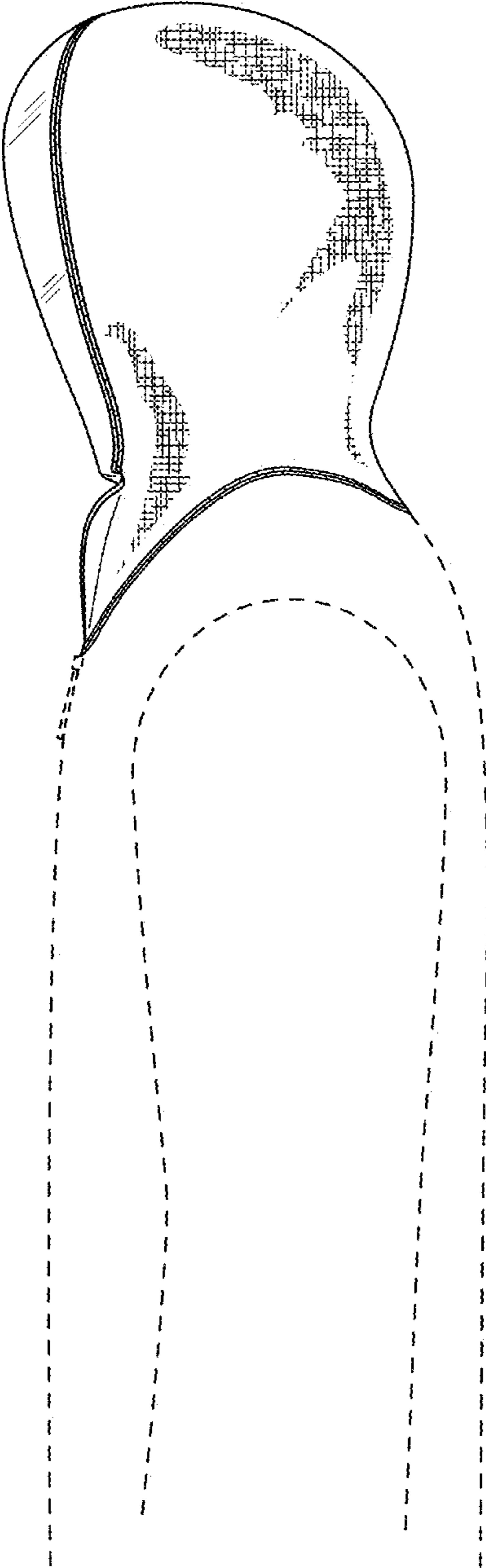

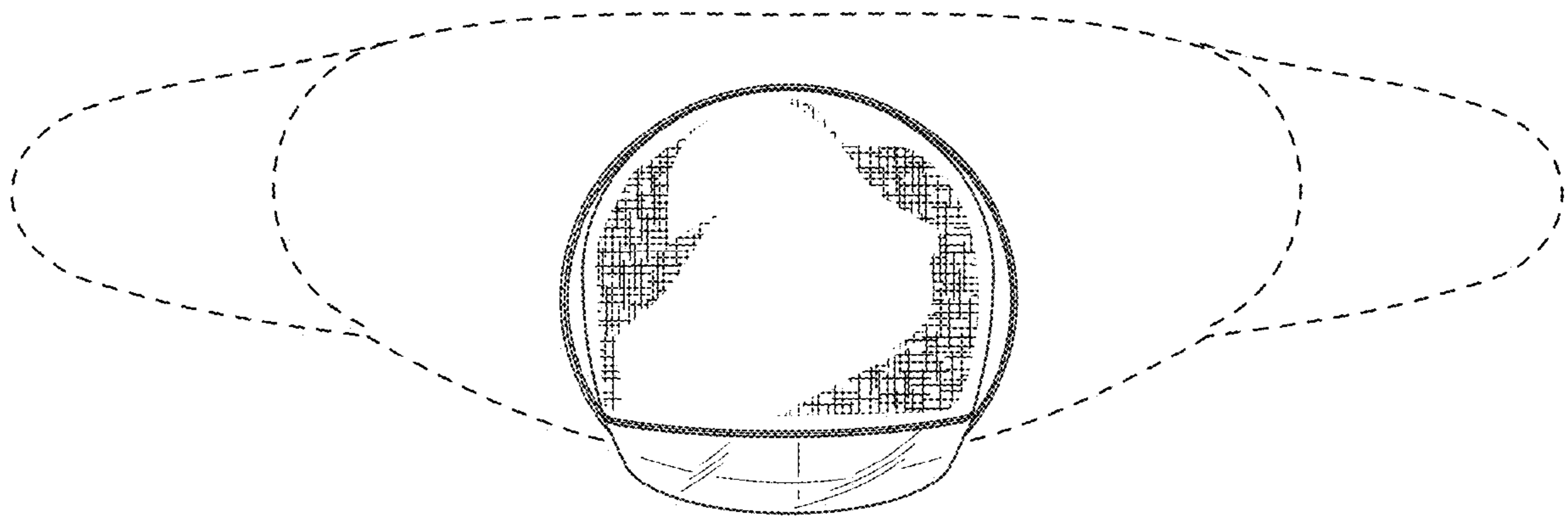

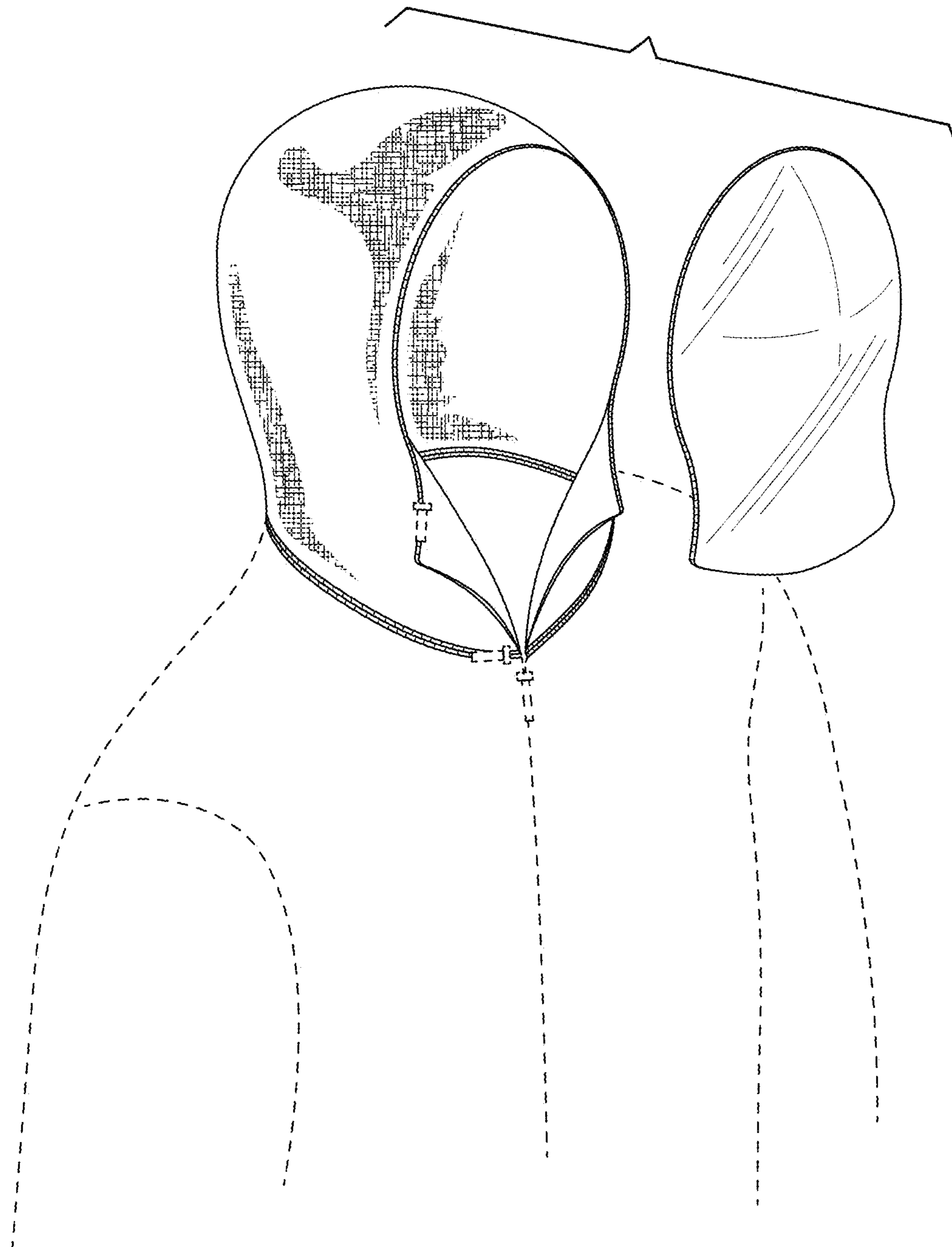
