(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1: is a perspective view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 2: is a front view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 3: is a back view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 4: is a right side view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 5: is a left front view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 6: is a top view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 7: is a bottom view of a chair with a cushion;
FIG. 8: is a disarticulated perspective view of an isolated chair frame; and,
FIG. 9: is a perspective view of an isolated cushion thereof.
The design is embodied in a chair. The broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
FIGS. 8 and 9 are shown separately for ease of illustration.

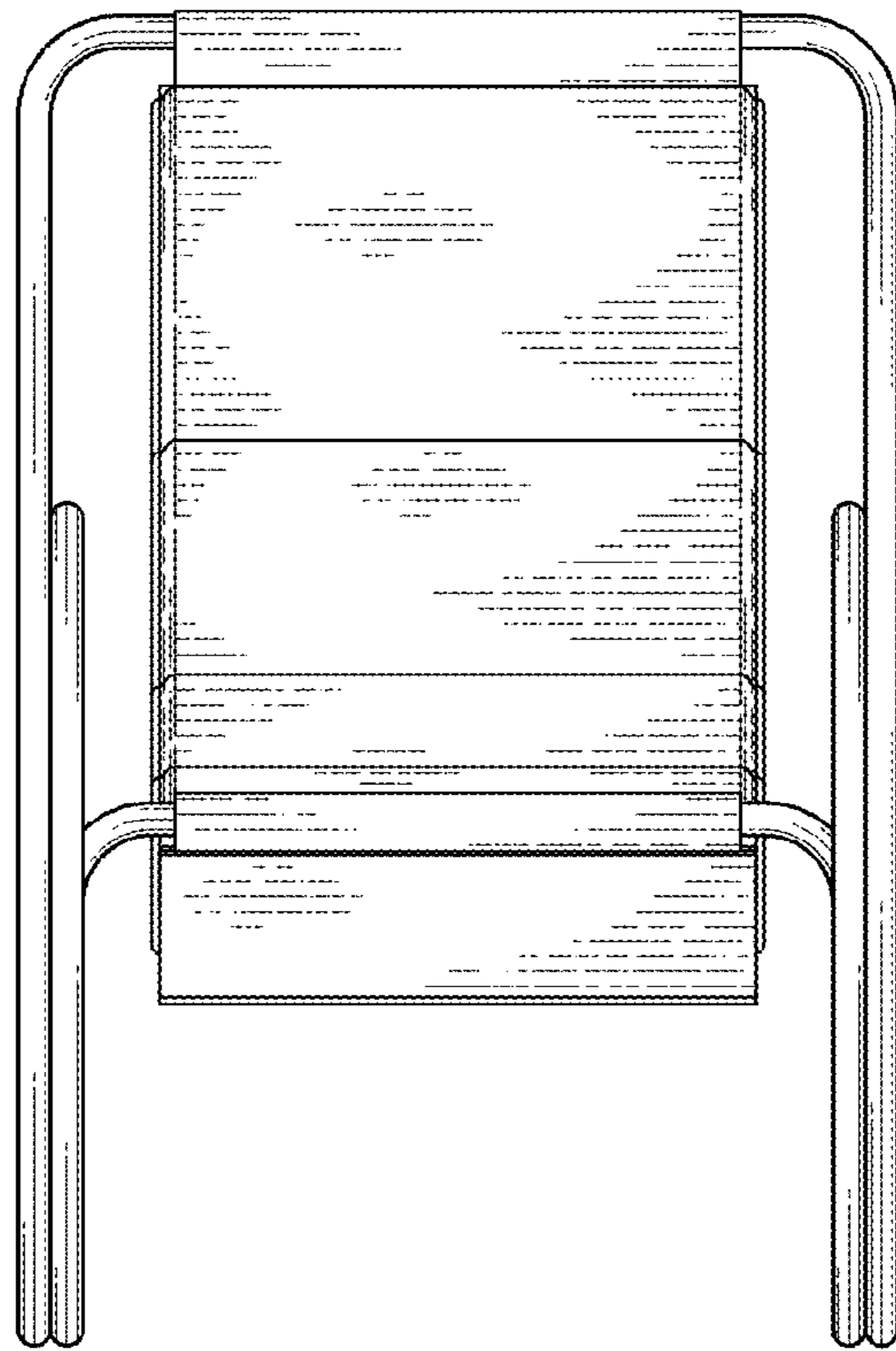

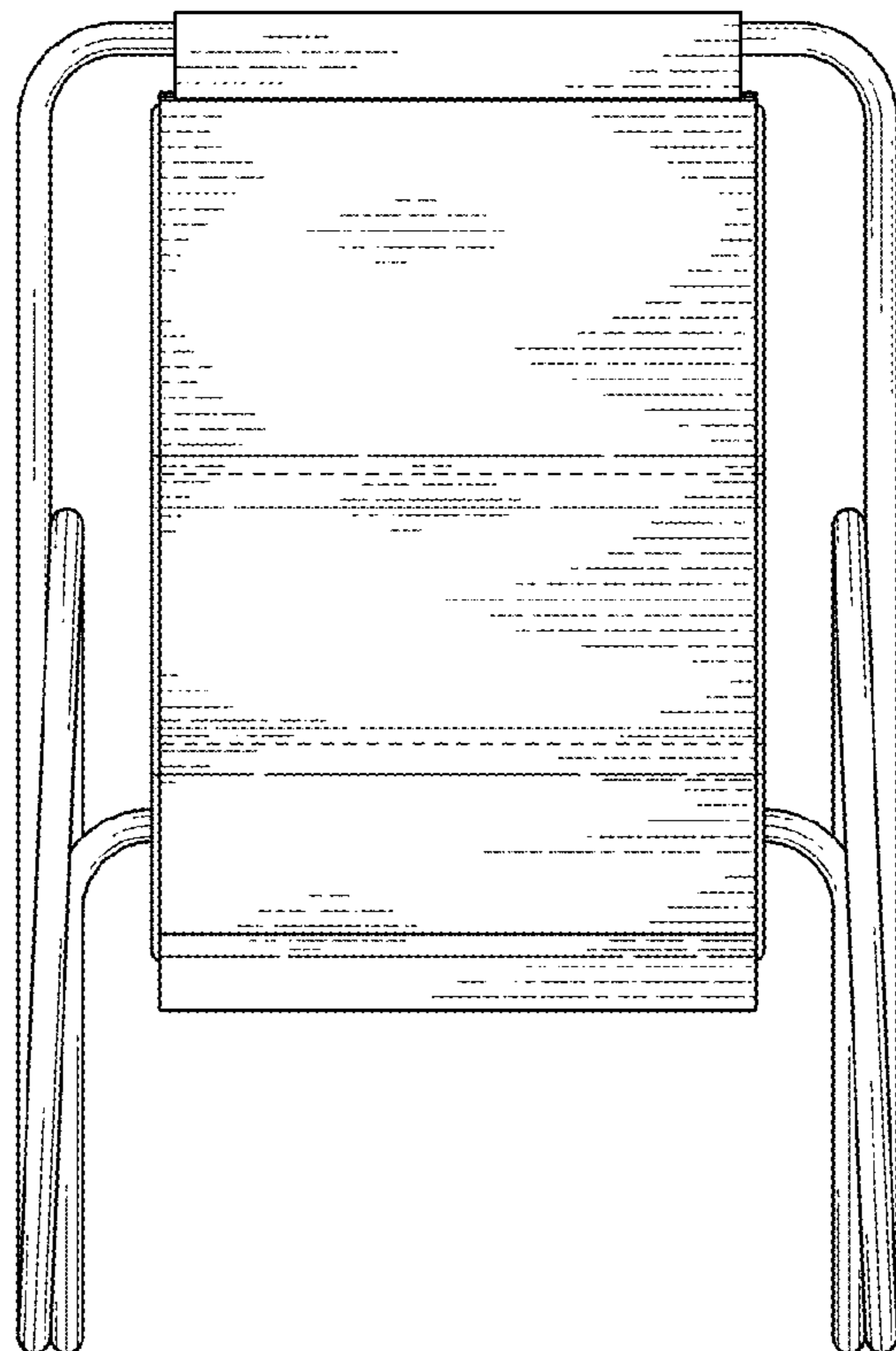

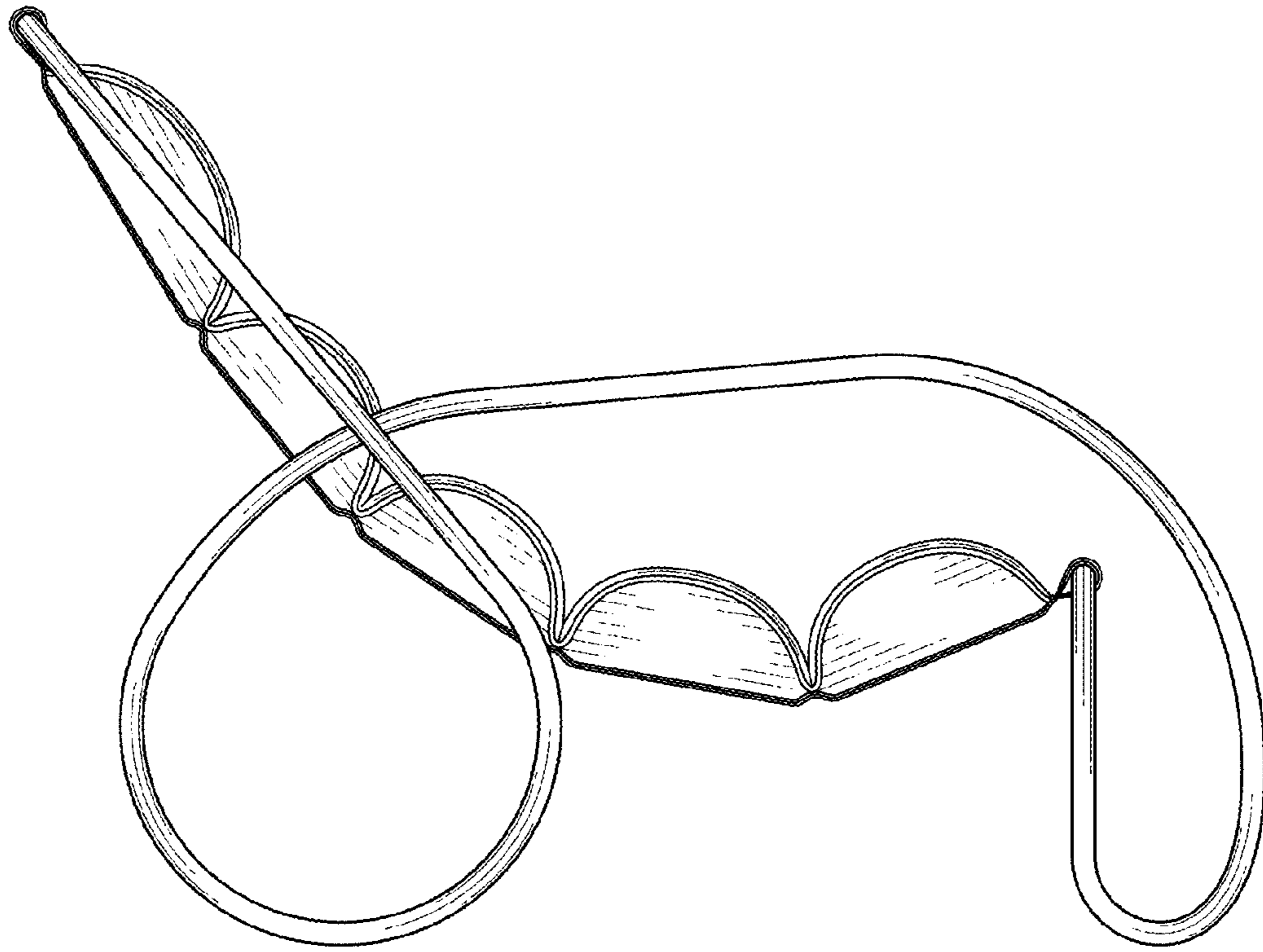

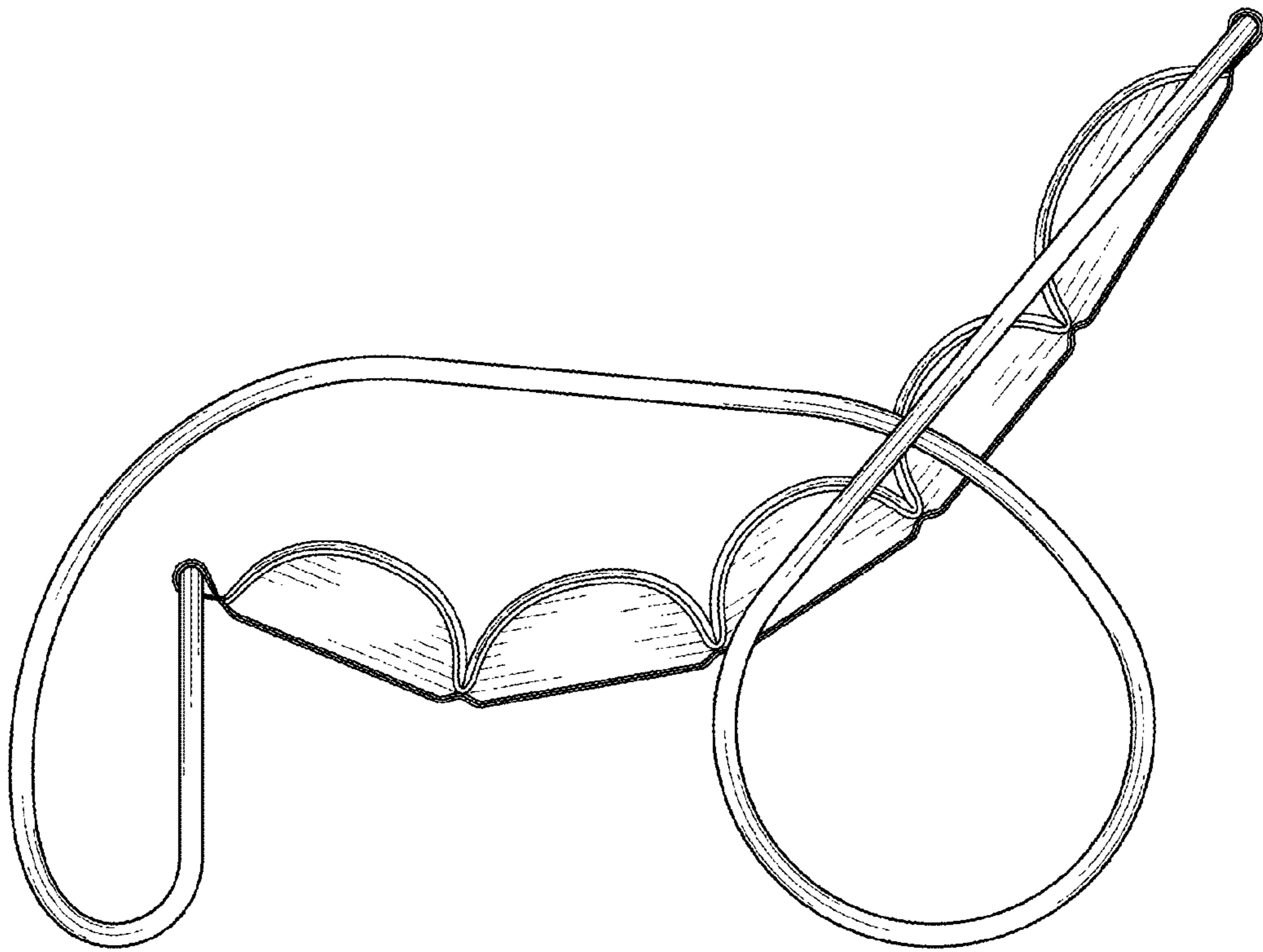

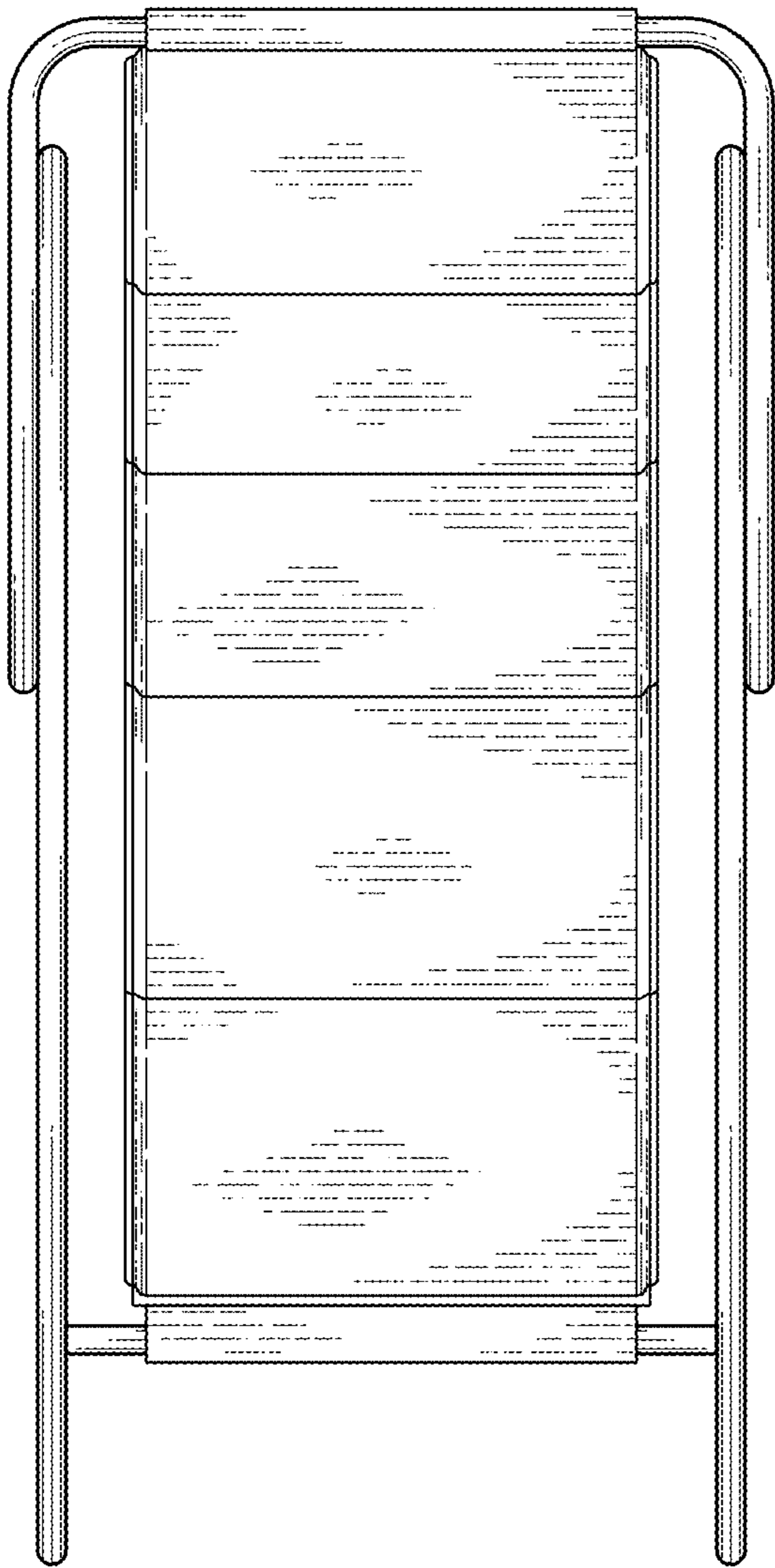

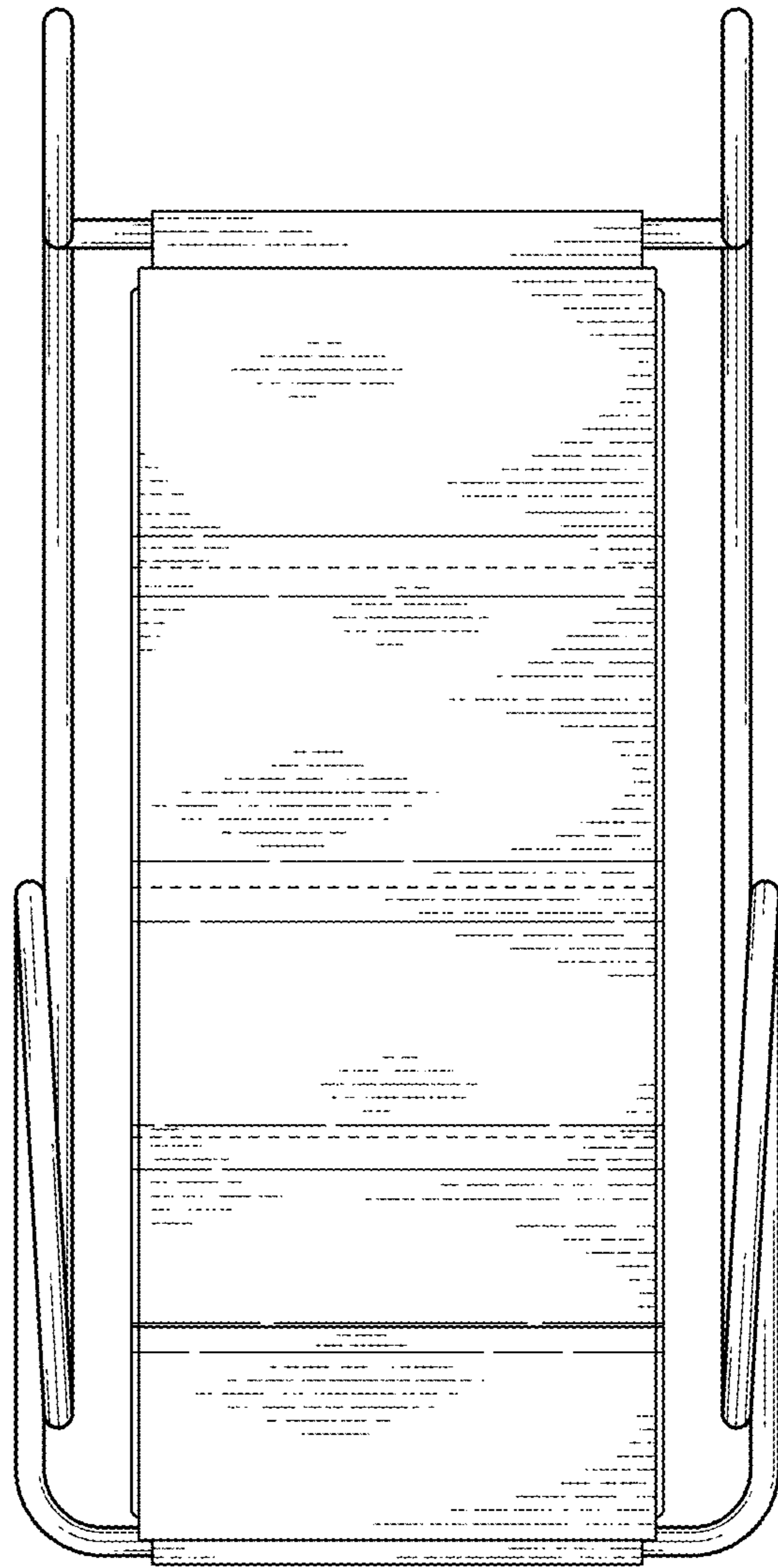

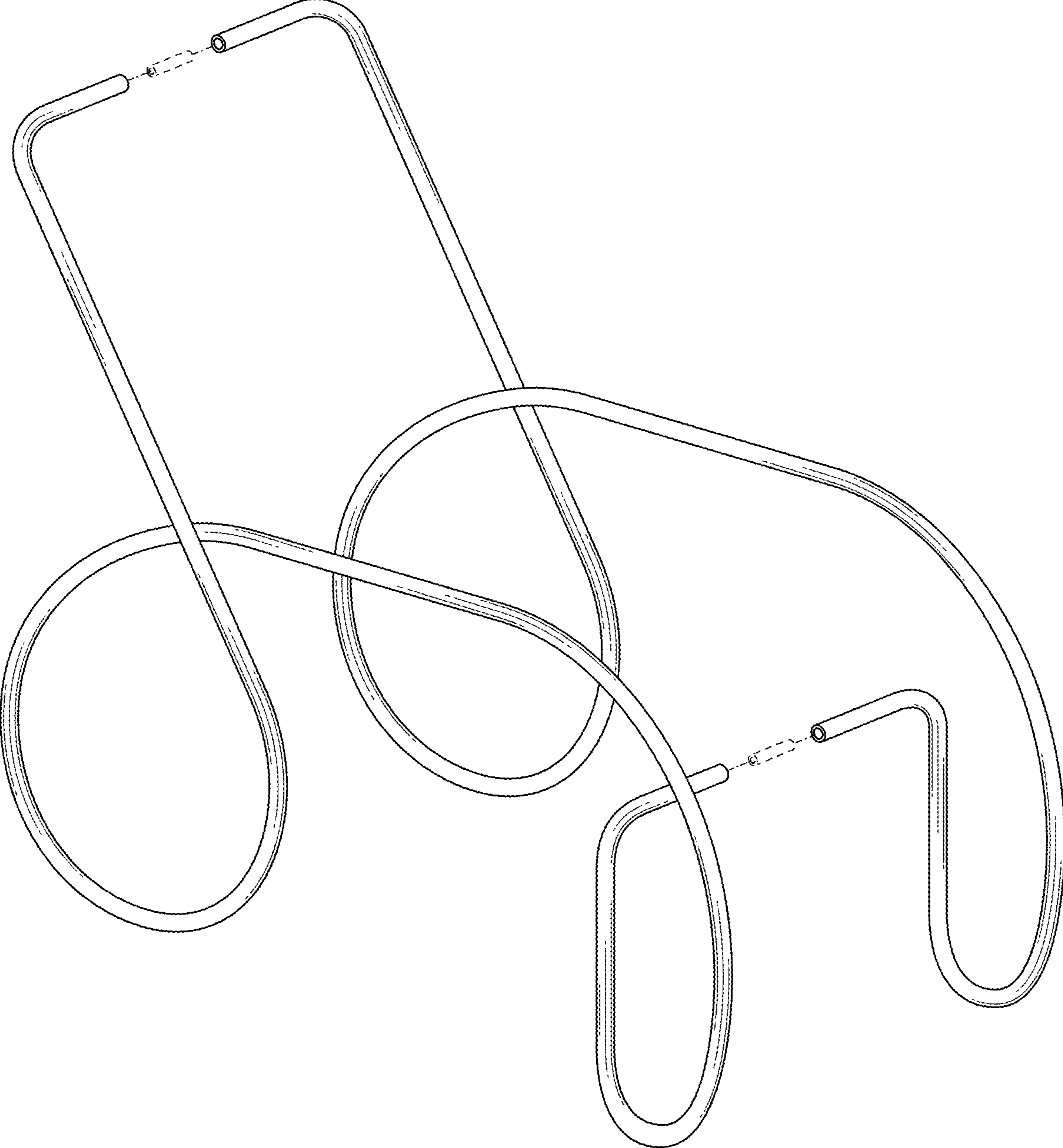

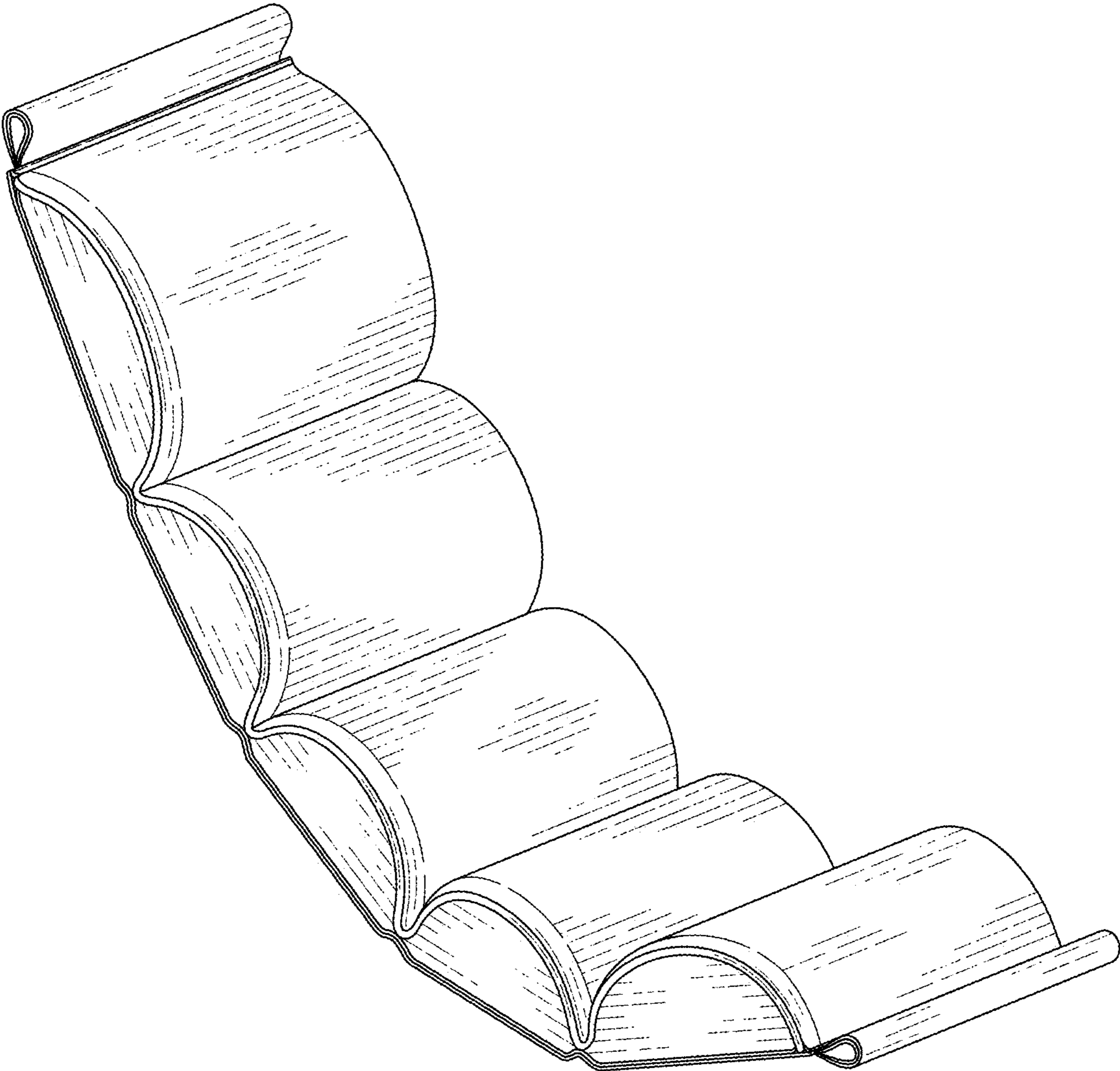
