(57) **CLAIM**

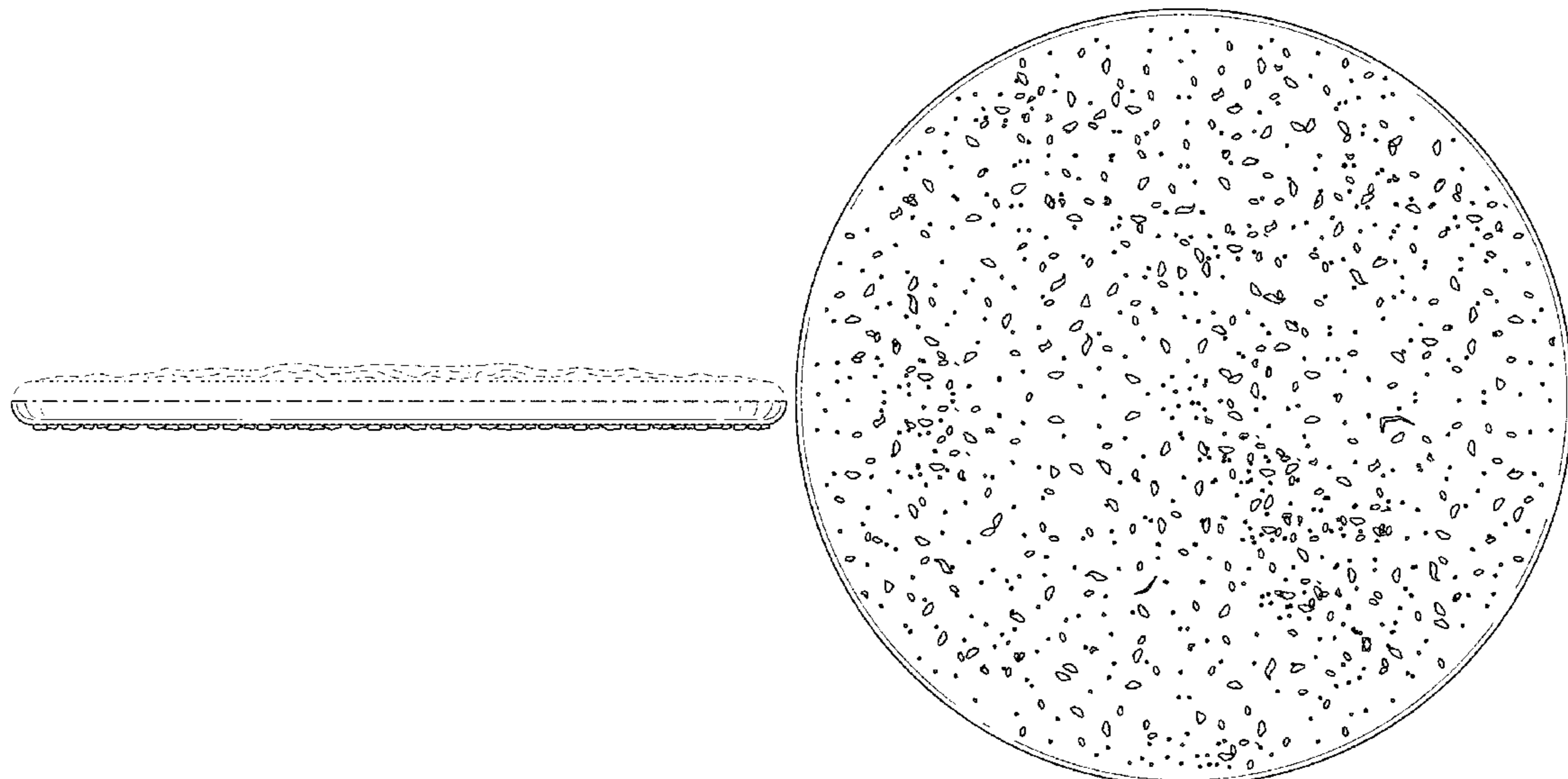
The ornamental design for a pizza product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pizza product, shown in an environment of use;
 FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The dash-dot-dot-dash broken lines shown in FIG. 1 illustrate environment that forms no part of the claimed design. The evenly-spaced broken lines shown in FIGS. 1-5 illustrate portions of the pizza product that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot-dash broken lines in FIGS. 1-3 and 5 illustrate the boundary of the claimed design which forms no part thereof.

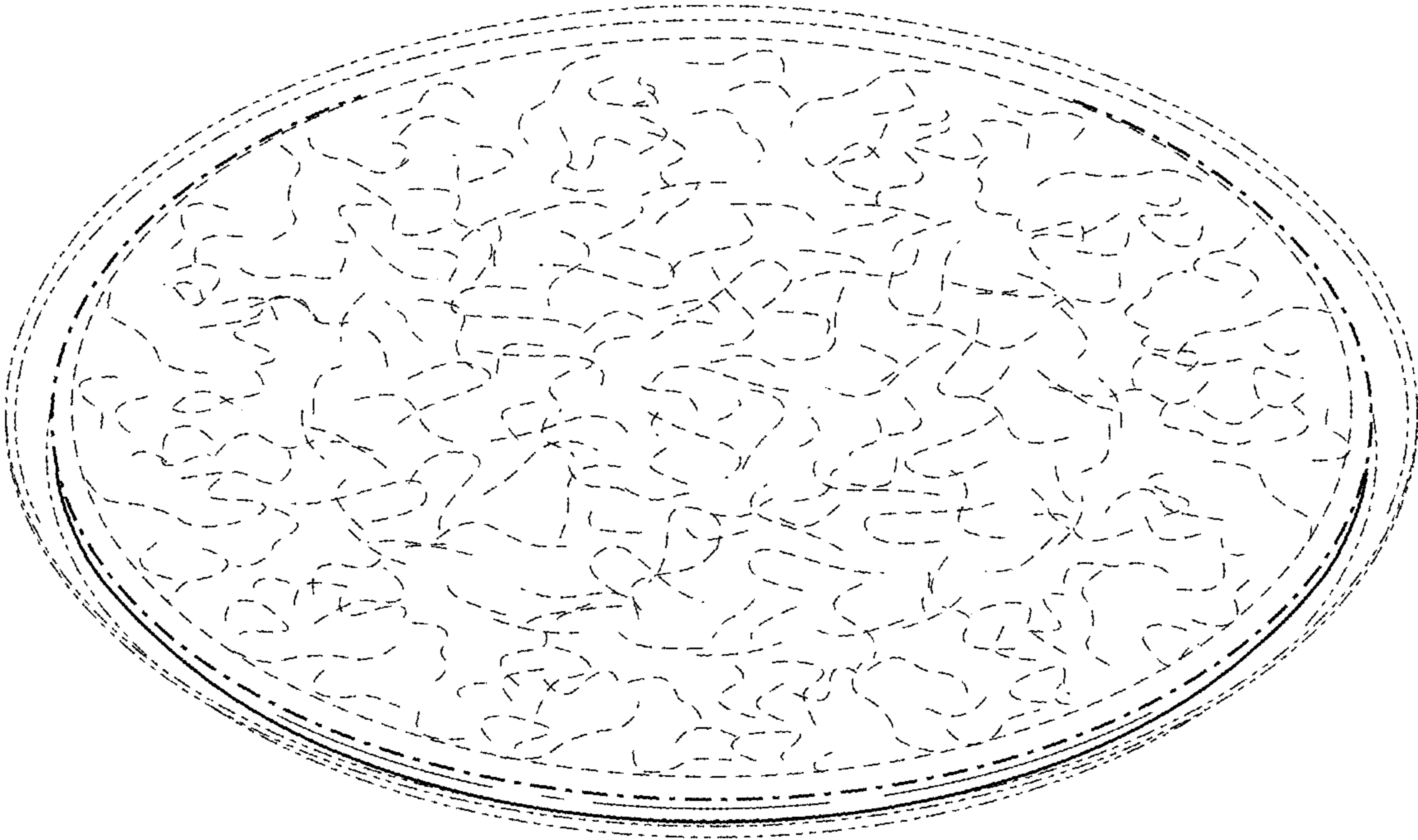

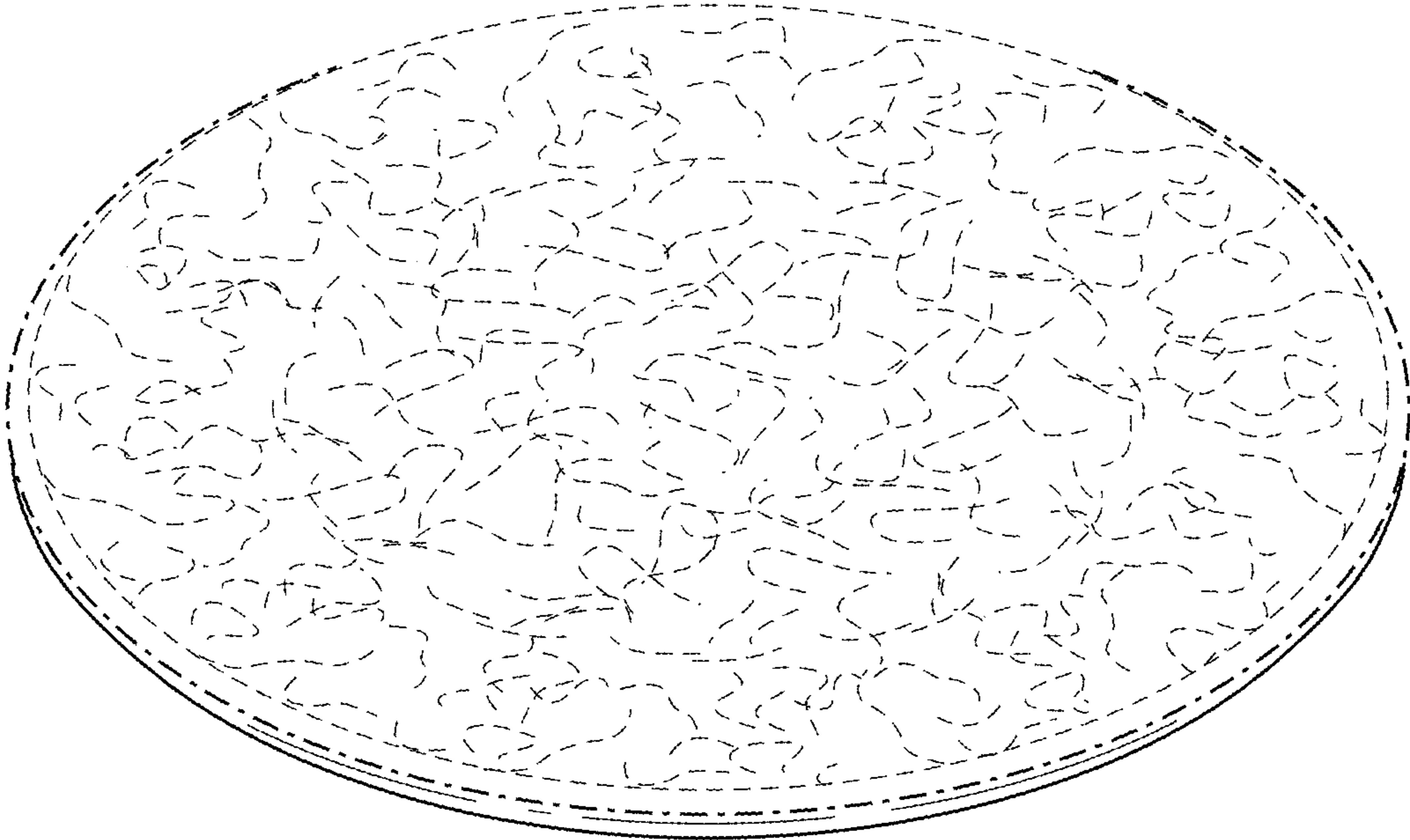

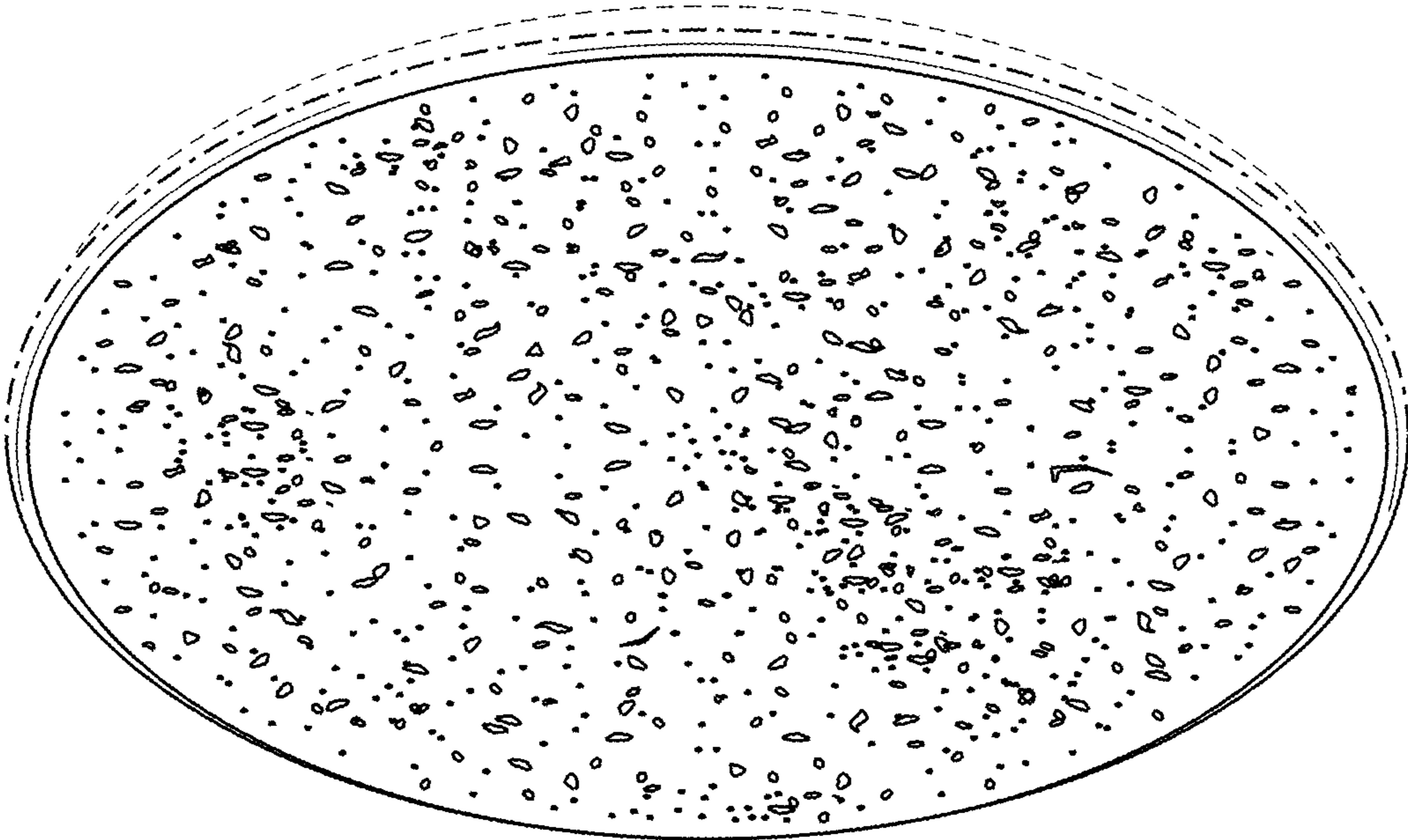

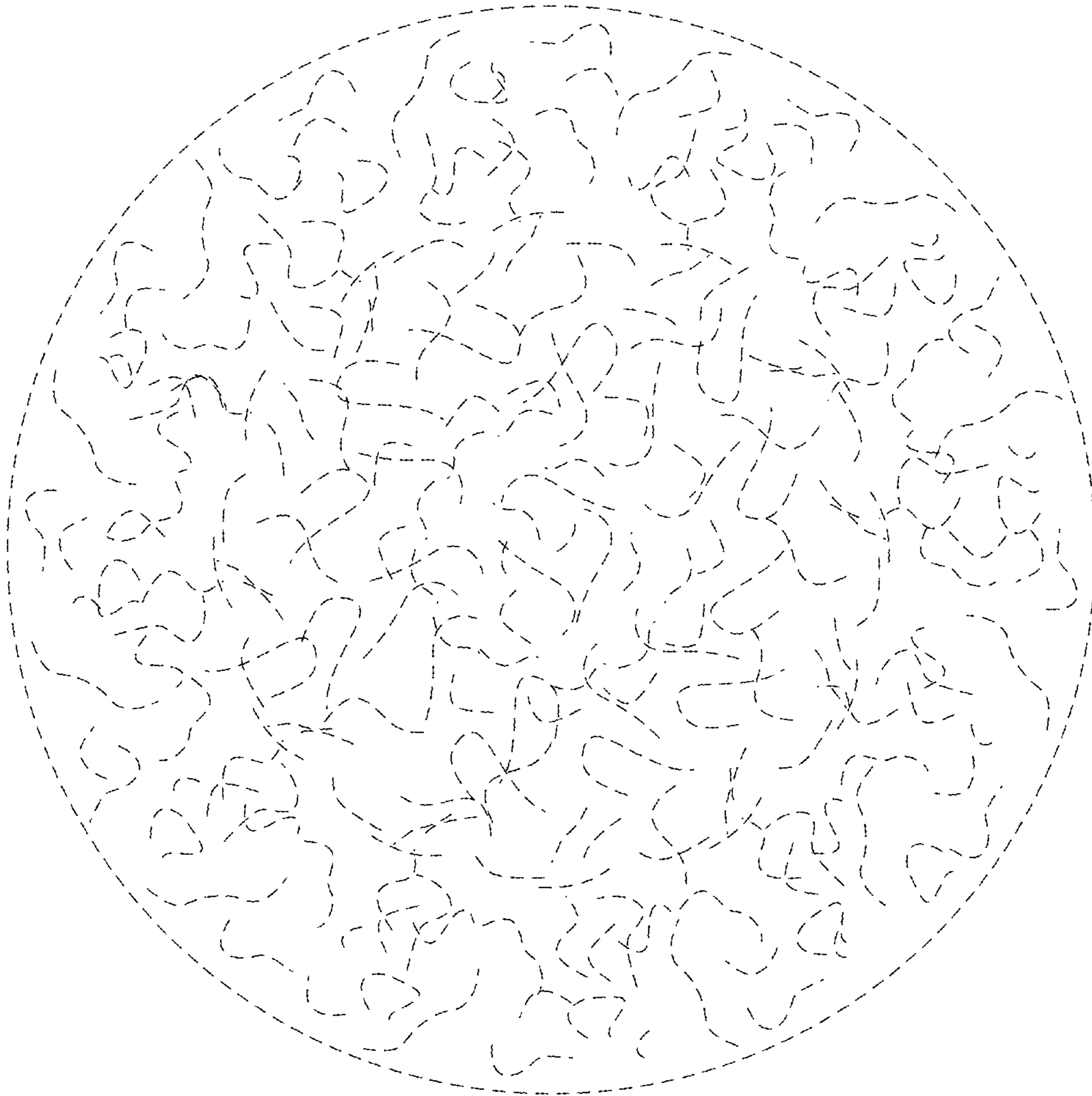

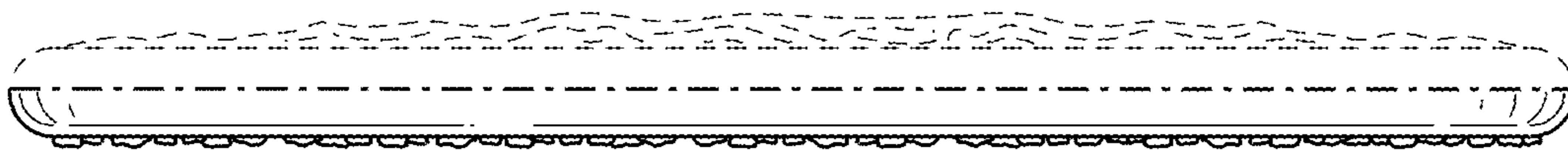

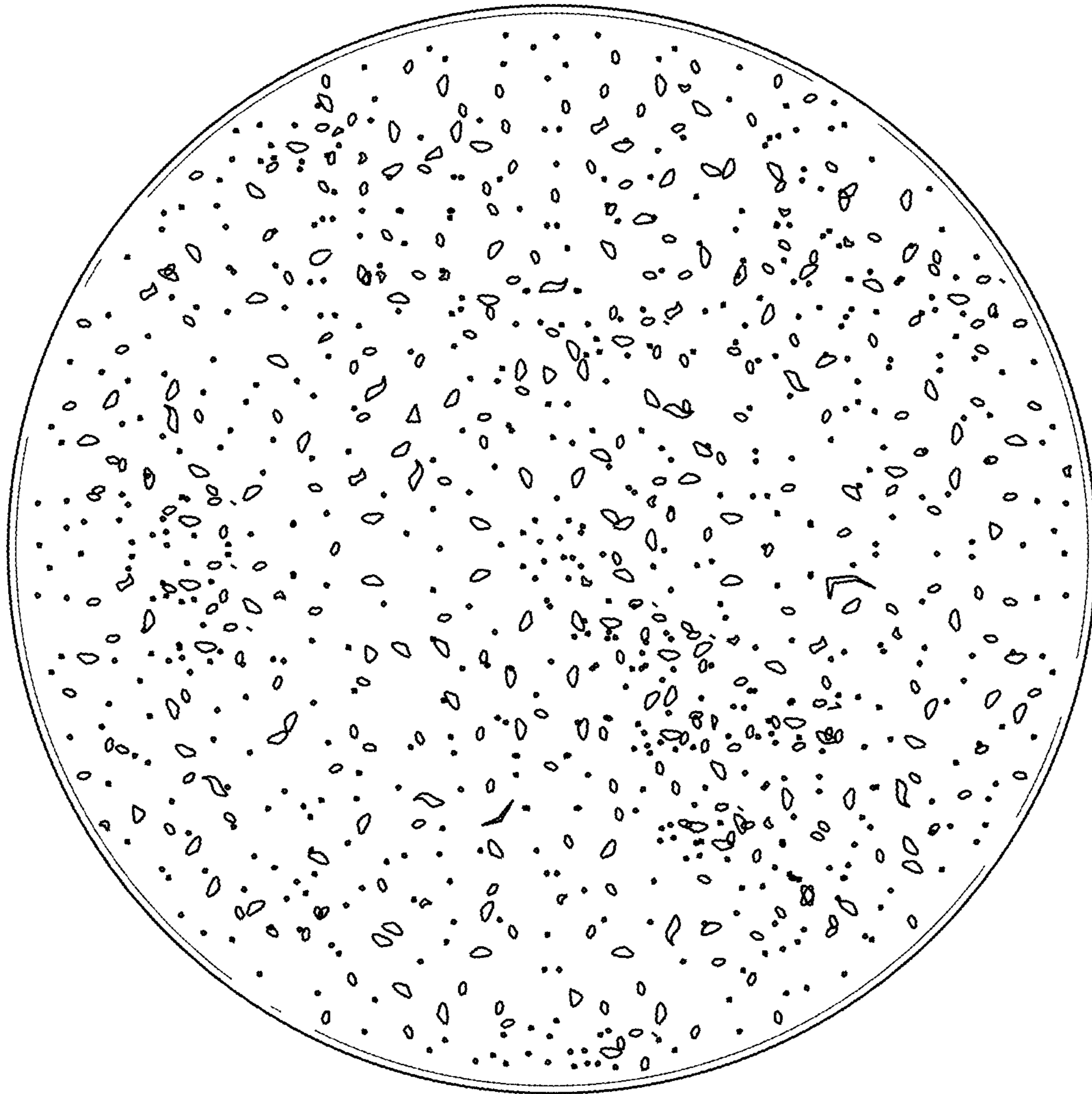
