FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;

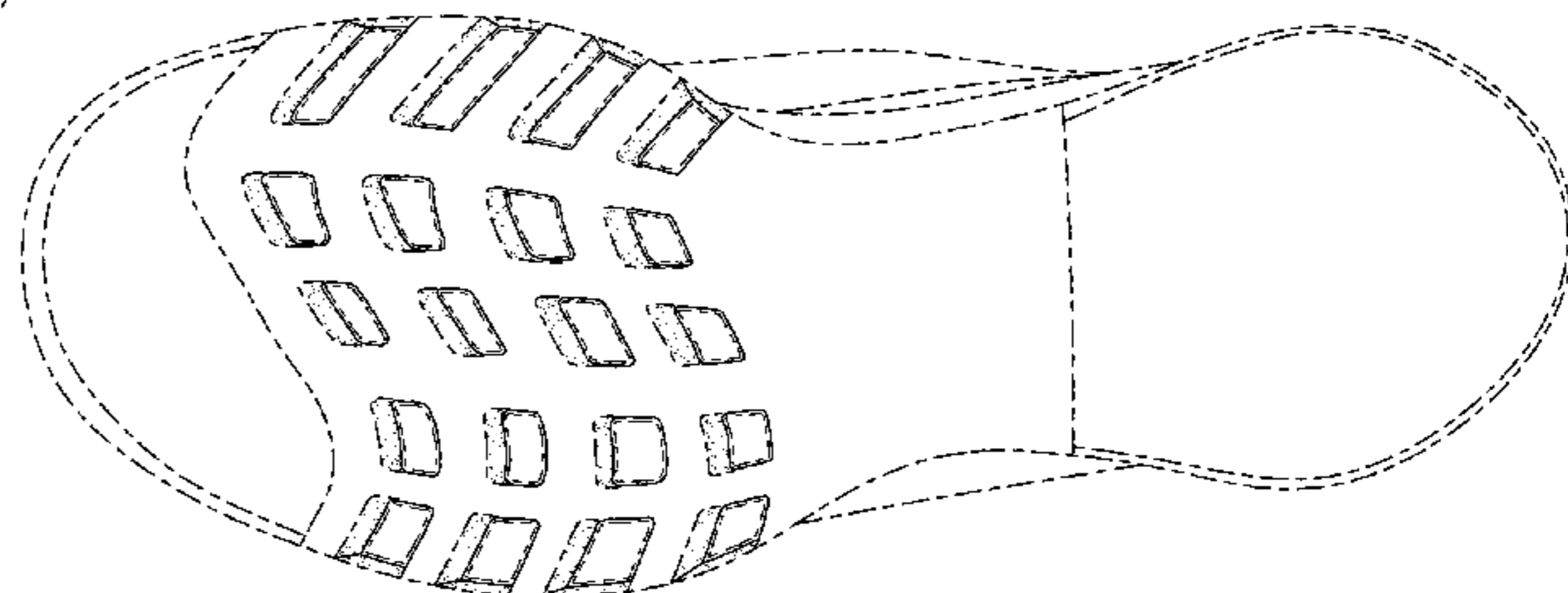
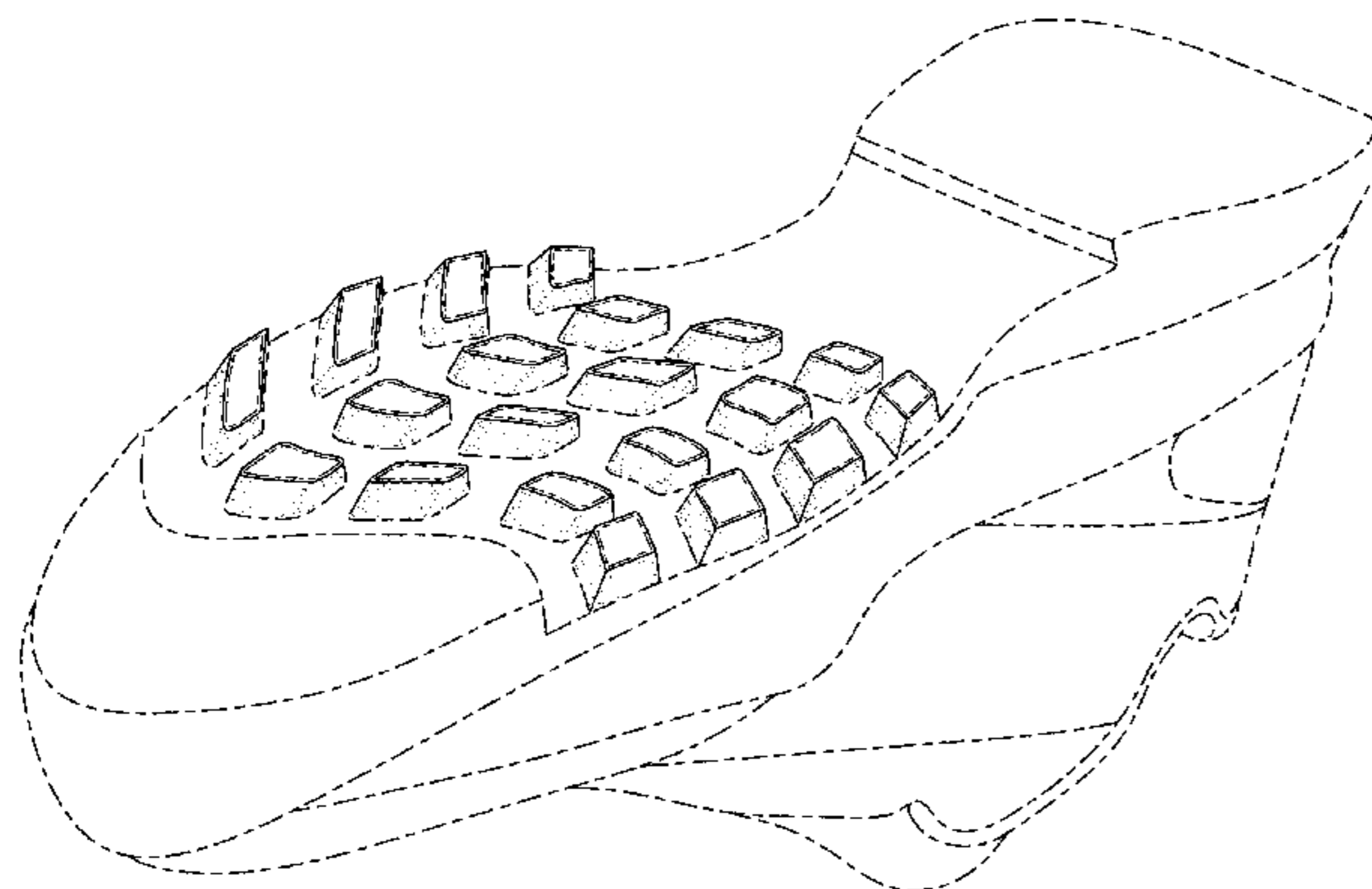
FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof; and,

The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

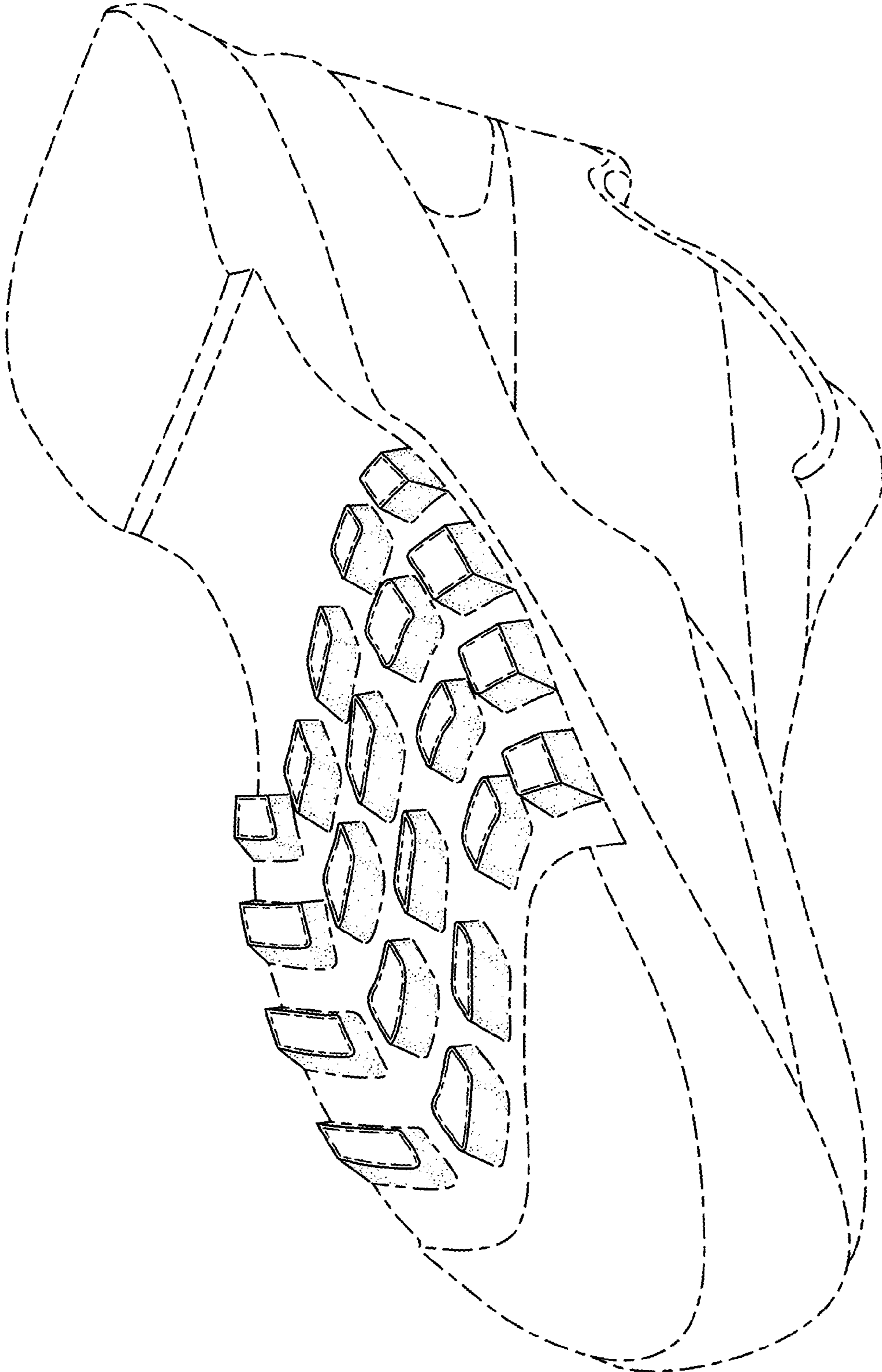

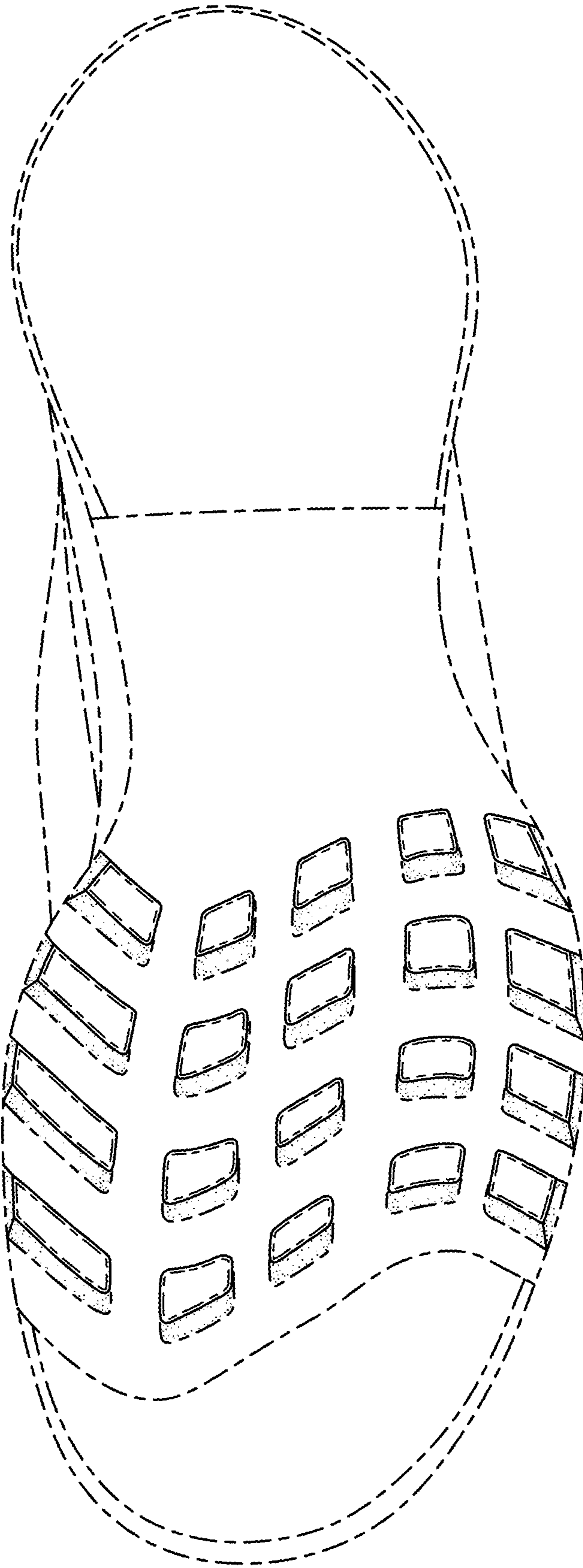

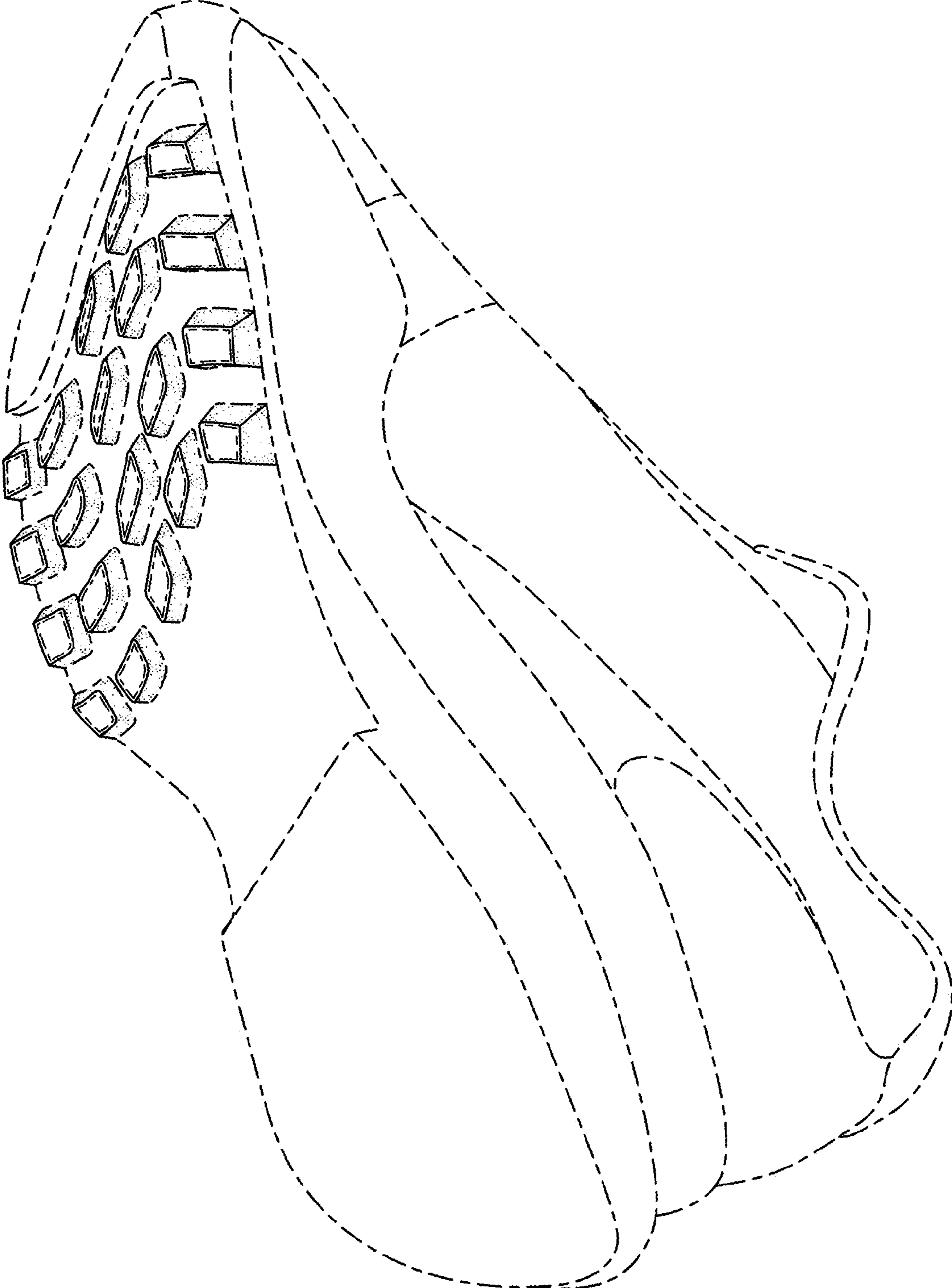
