(57) **CLAIM**

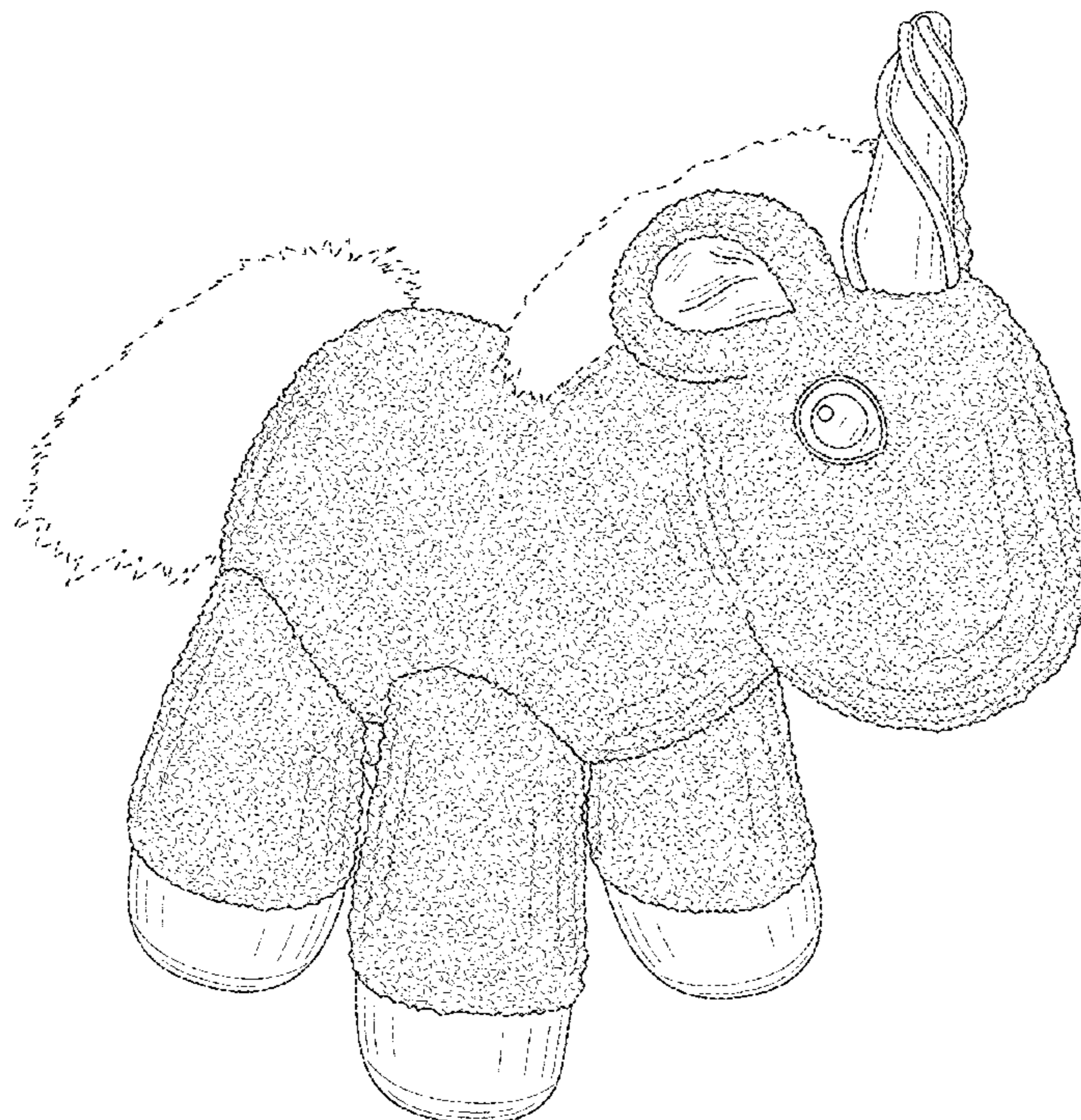
The ornamental design for a plush unicorn toy, as shown and

**DESCRIPTION**

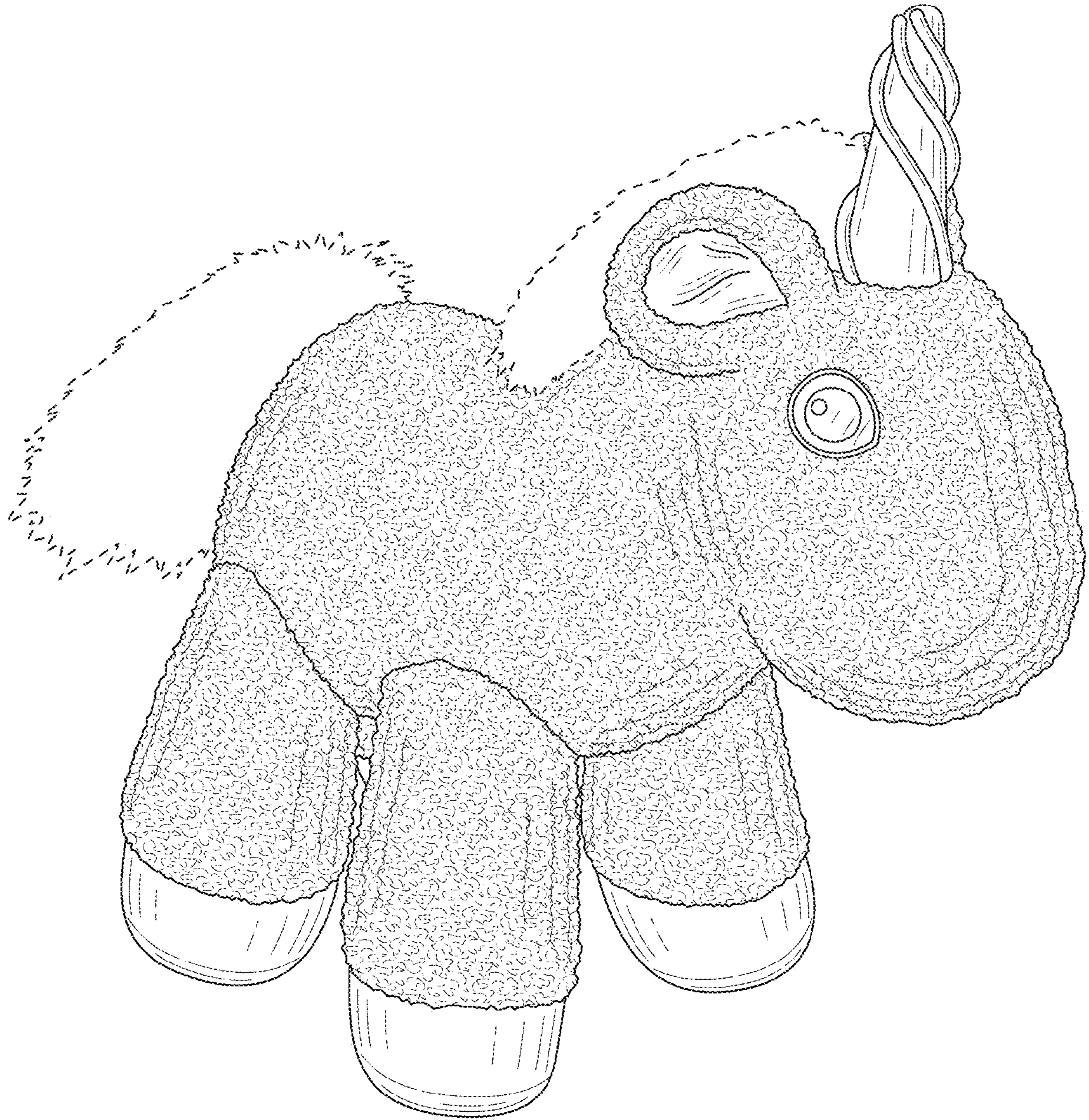

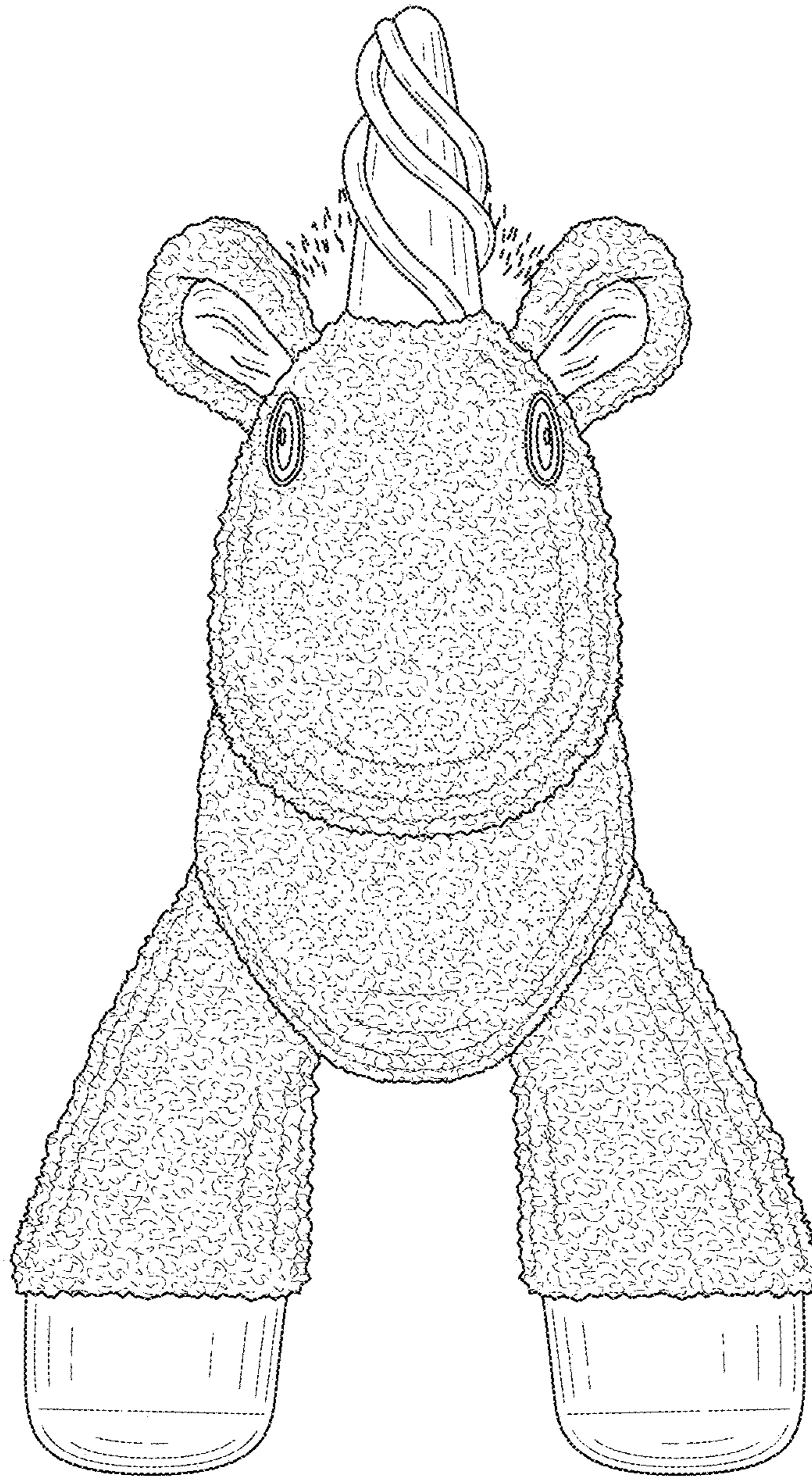

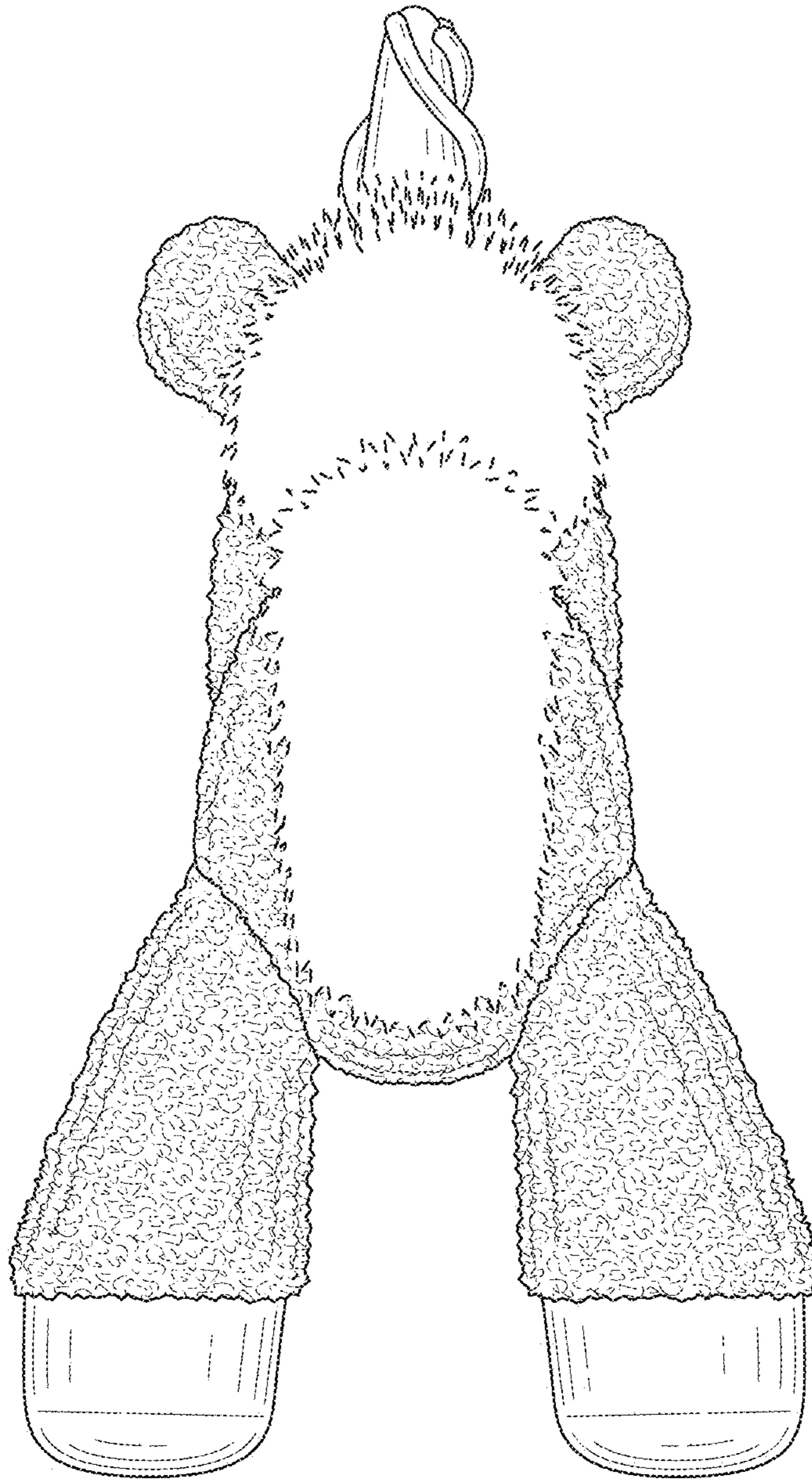

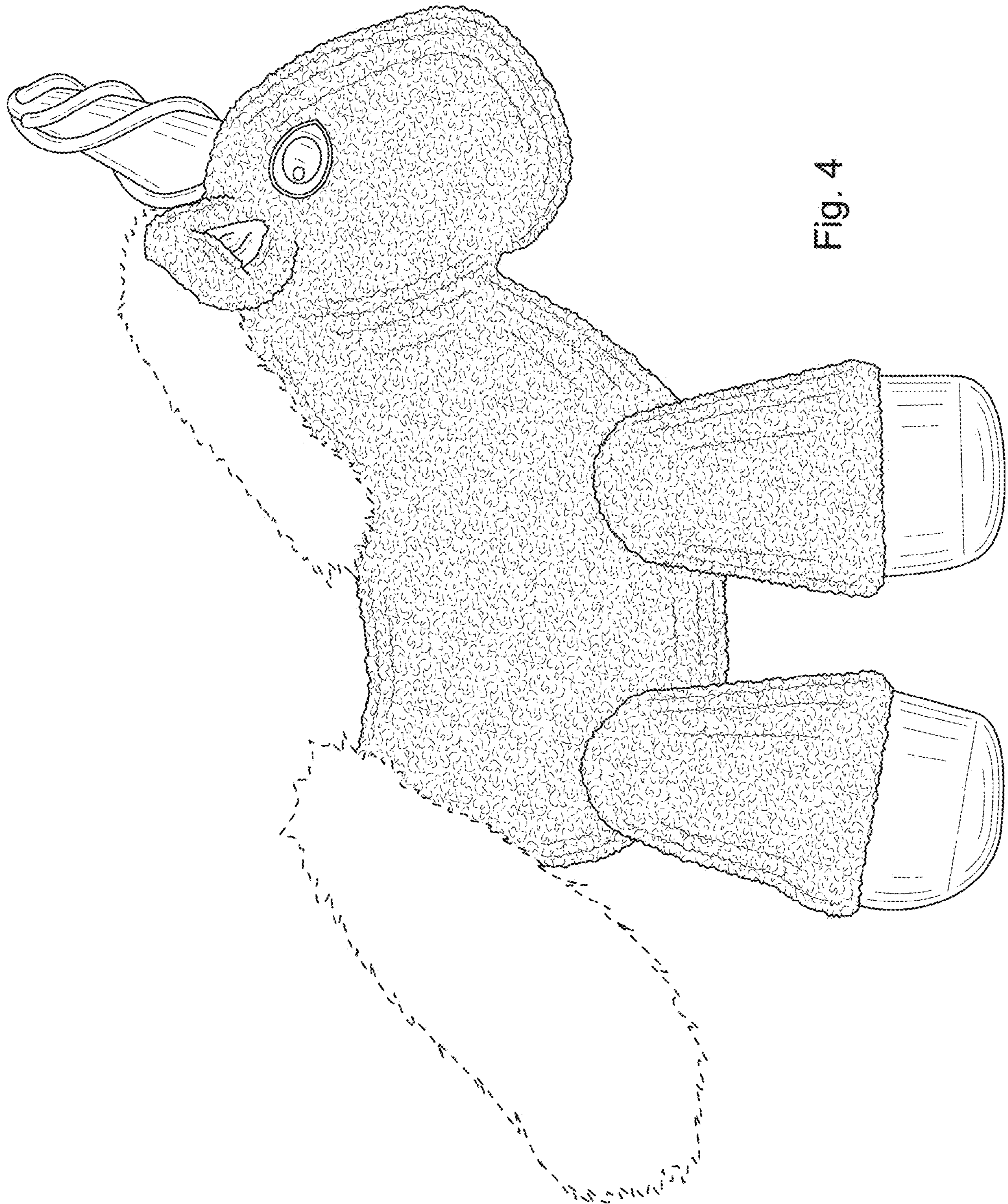

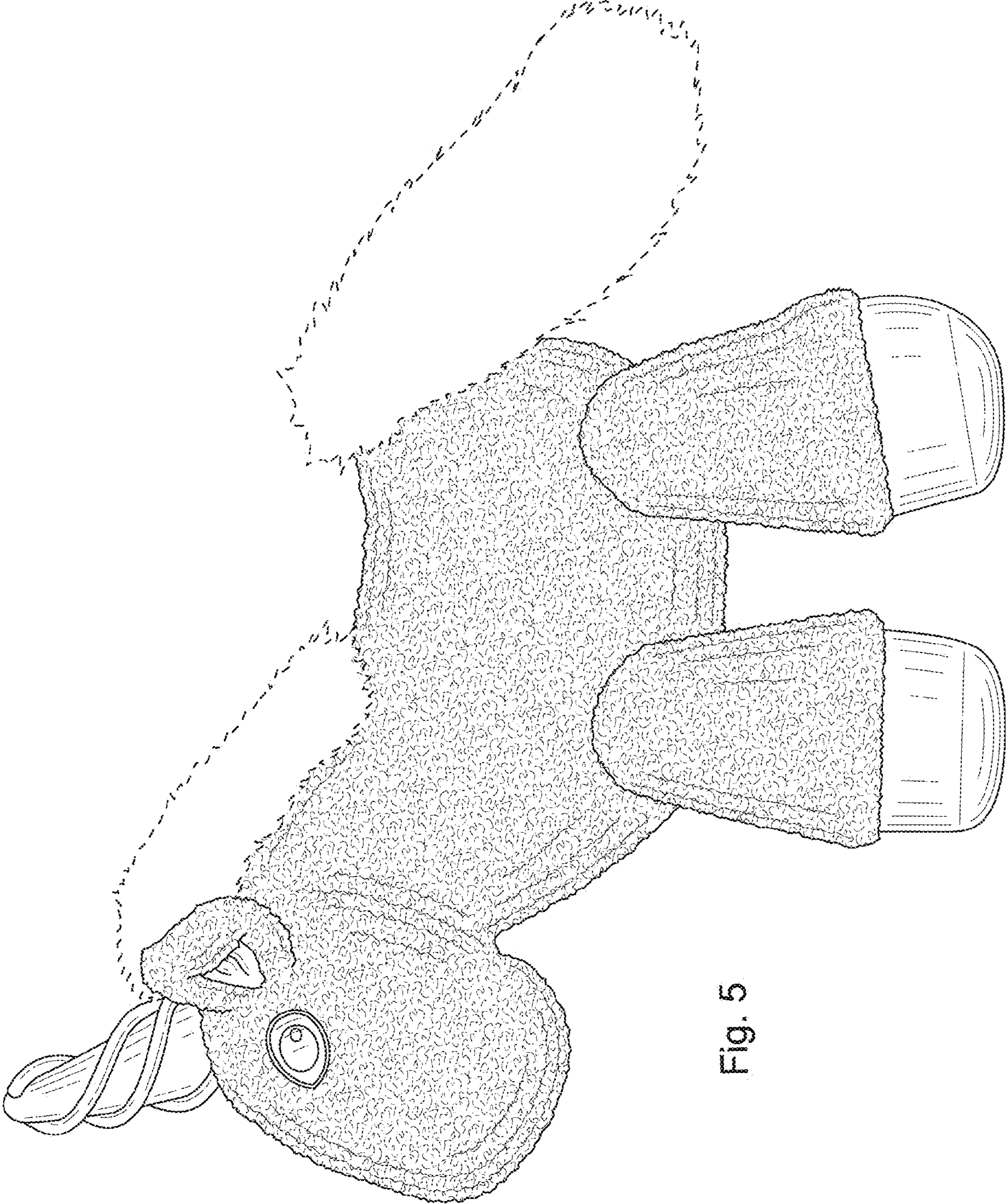

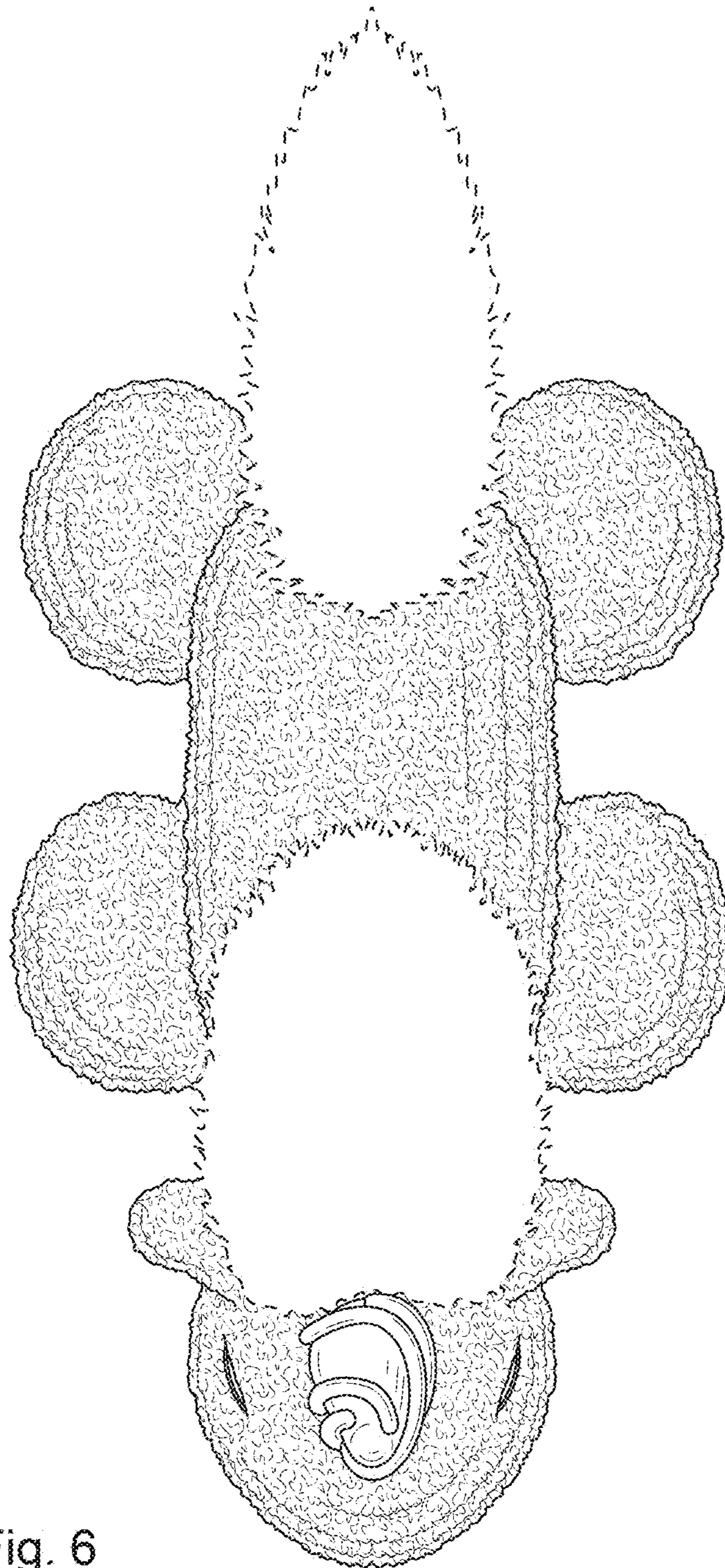

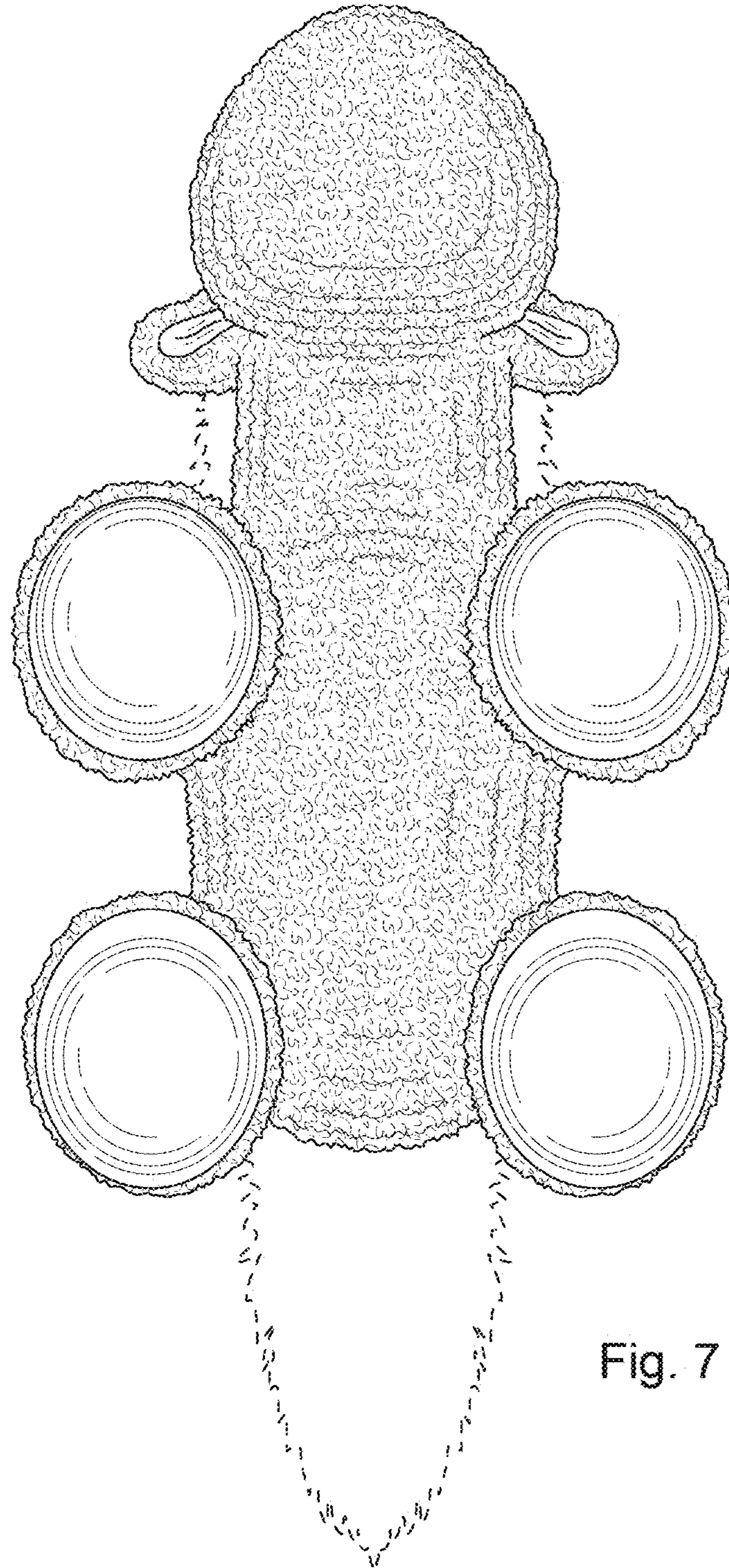
