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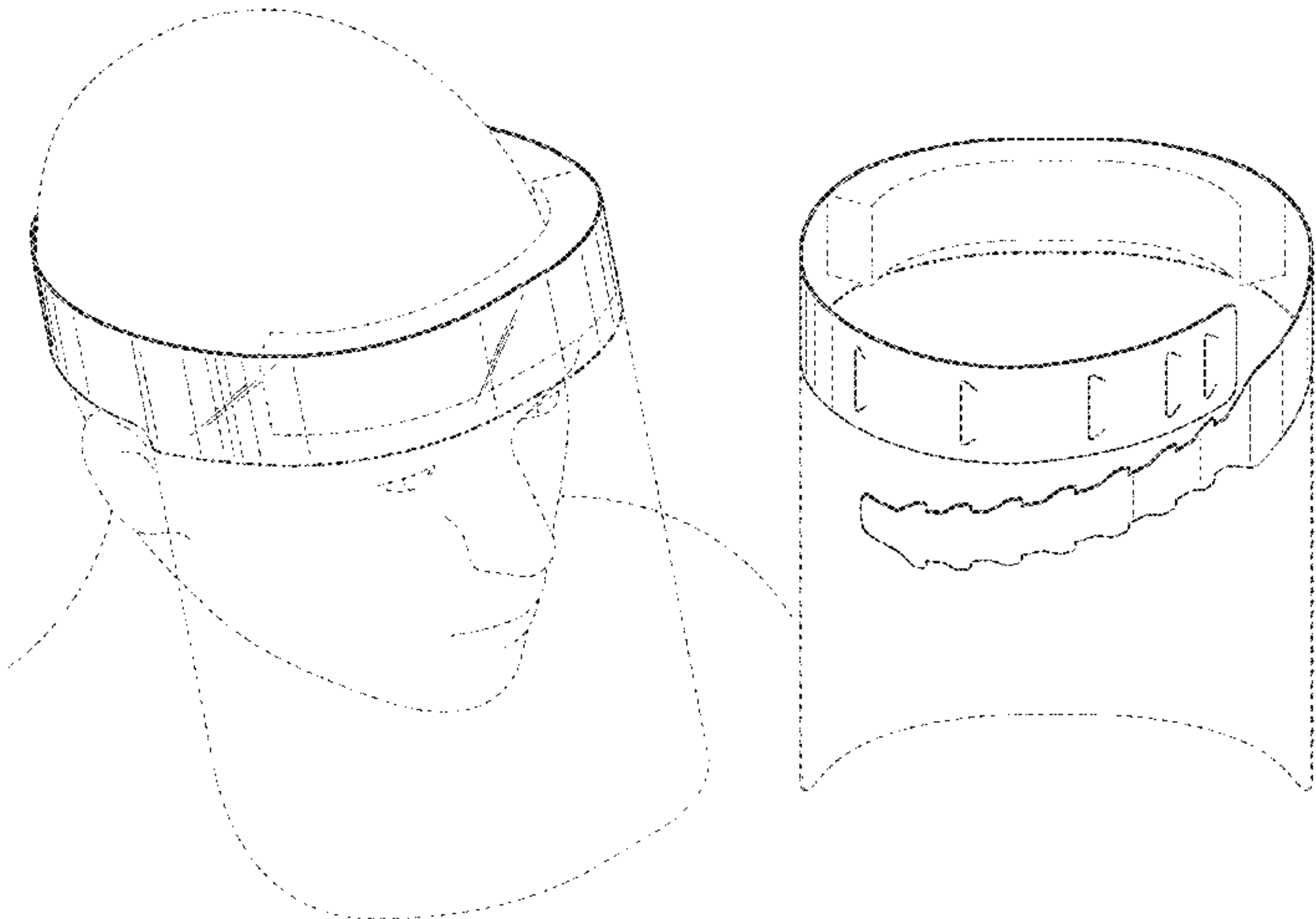
(57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a protective face shield, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a protective face shield showing the claimed design.
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the protective face shield thereof.
FIG. 3 is a back elevational view of the protective face shield thereof.
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the protective face shield thereof.
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the protective face shield thereof.
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the protective face shield thereof.
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the protective face shield thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view of protective face shield shown in an unfastened position.

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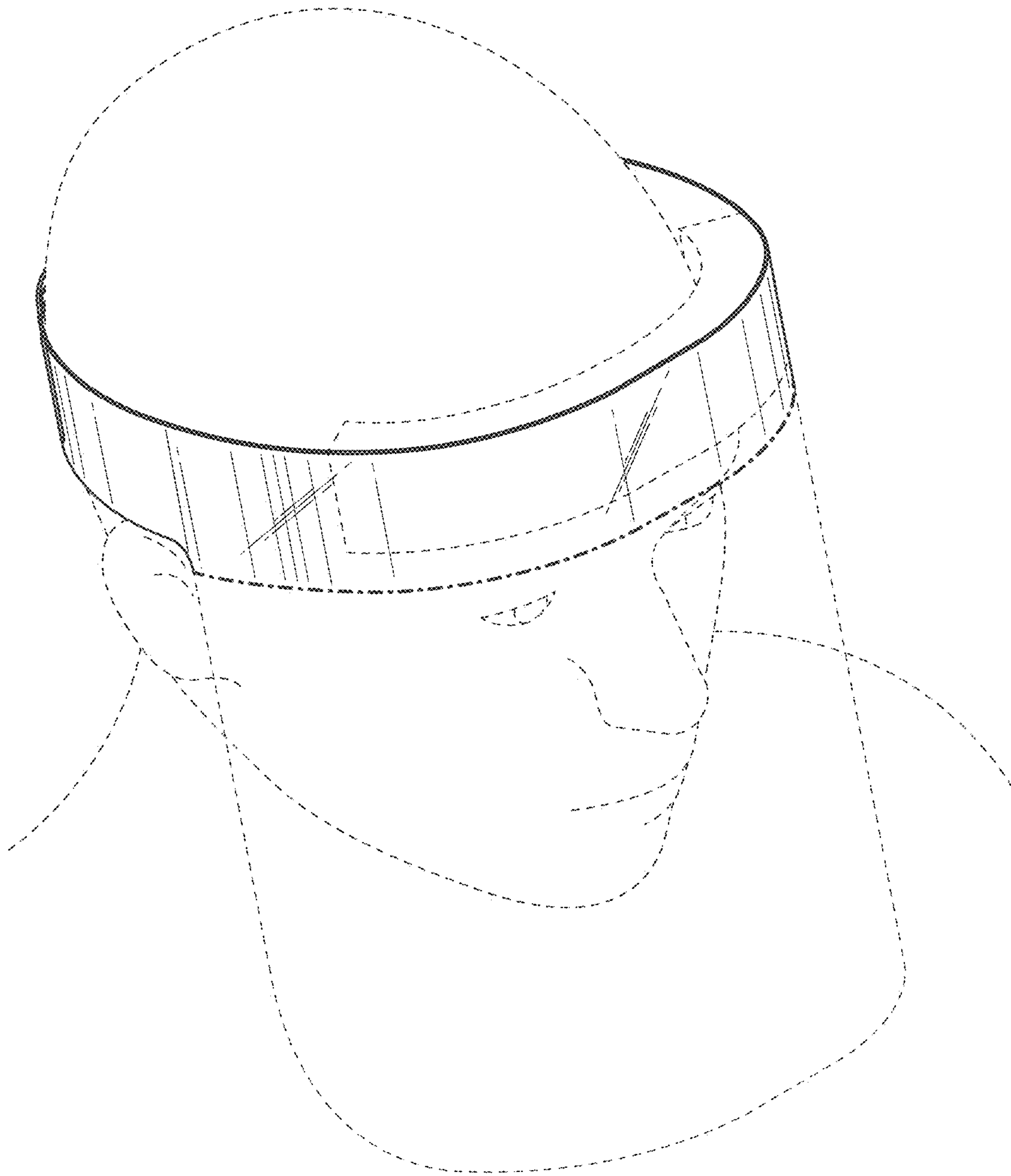

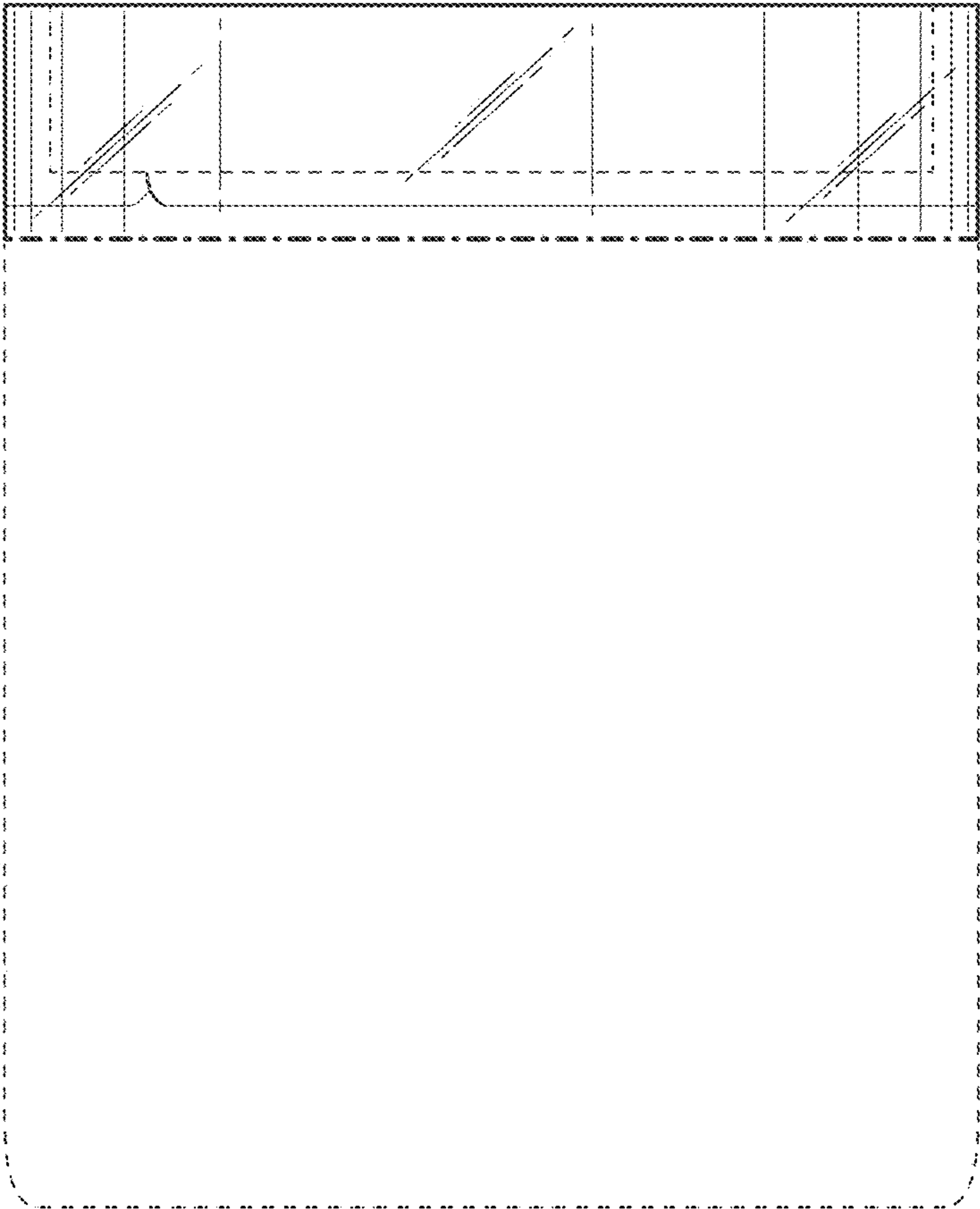

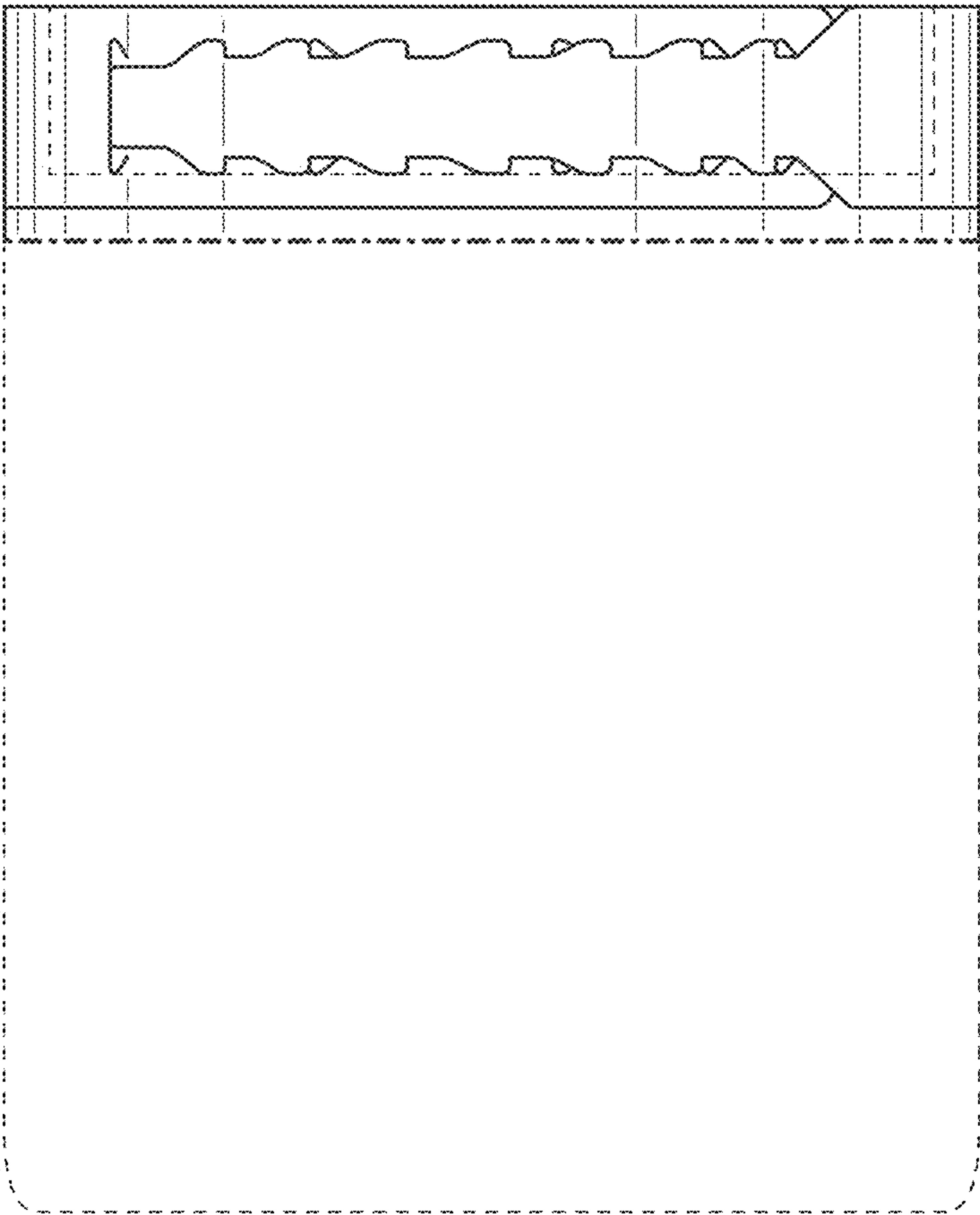

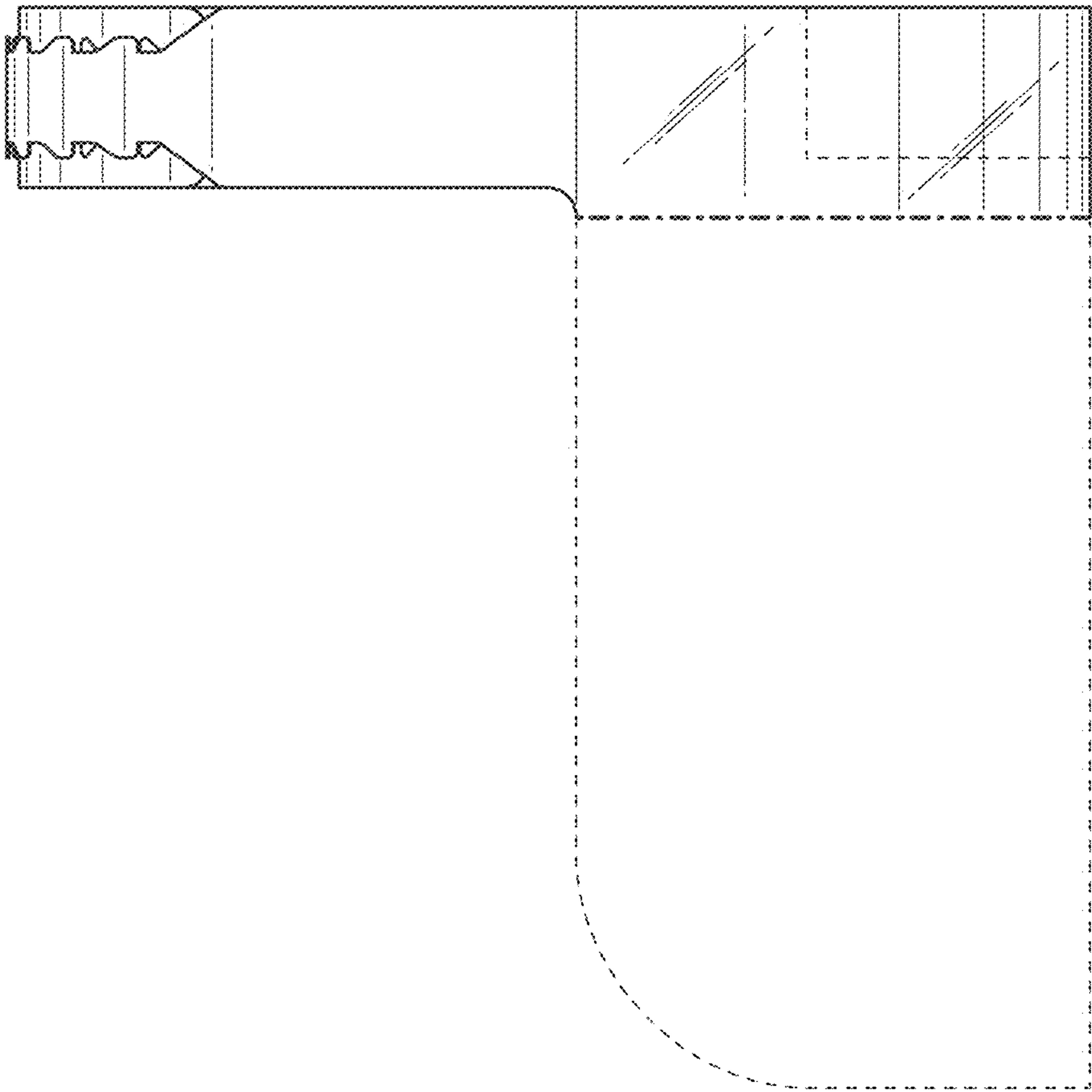

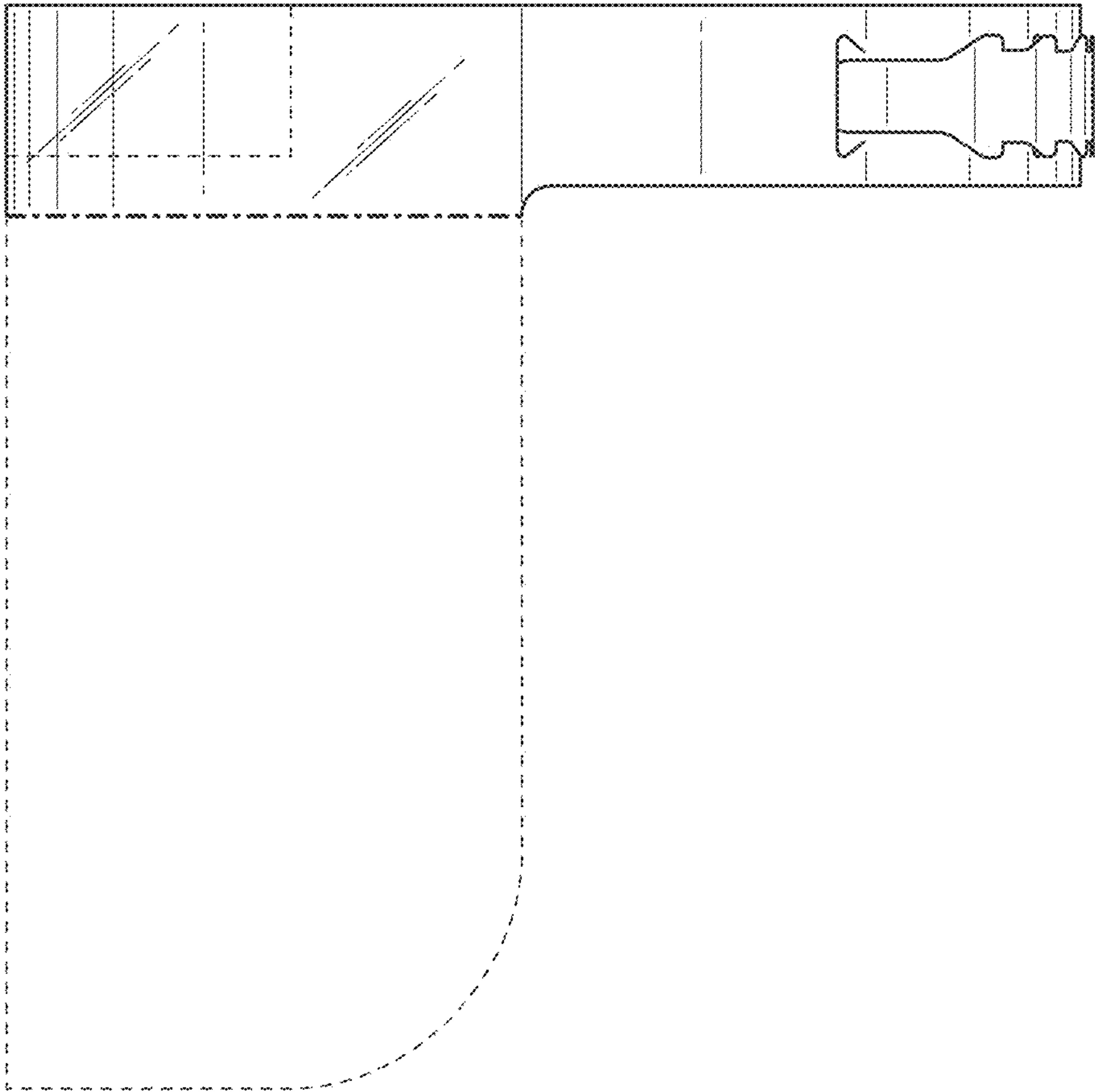

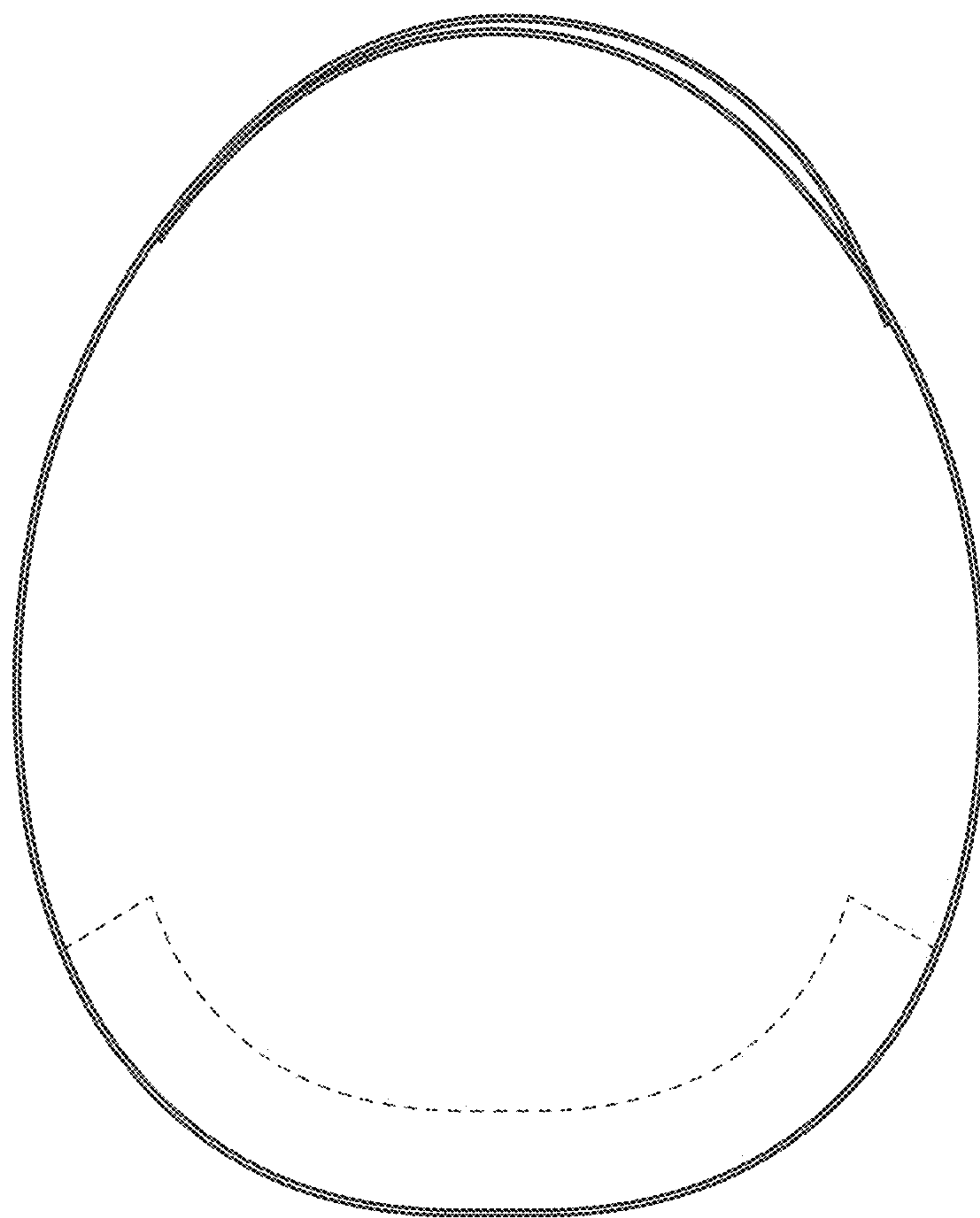

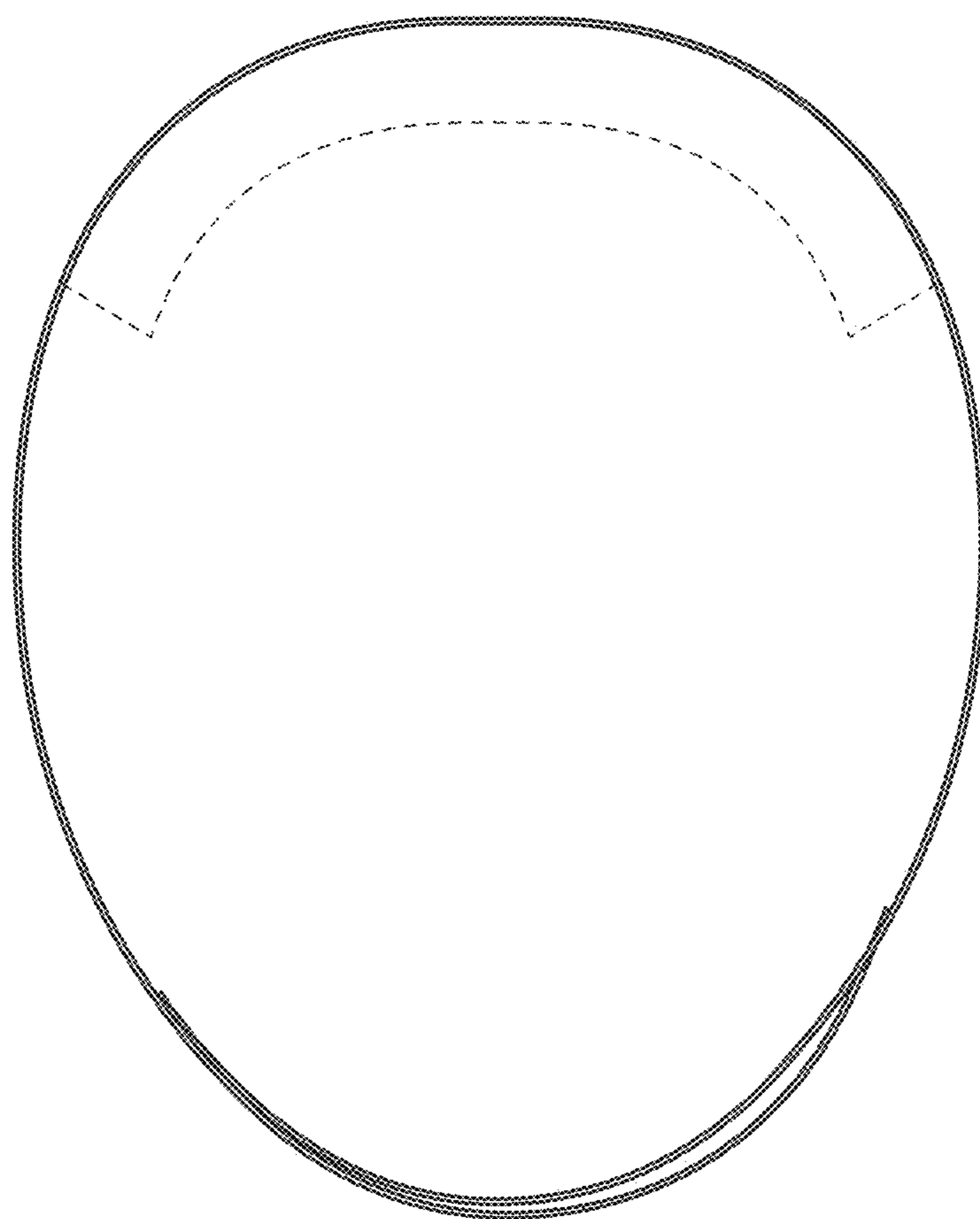

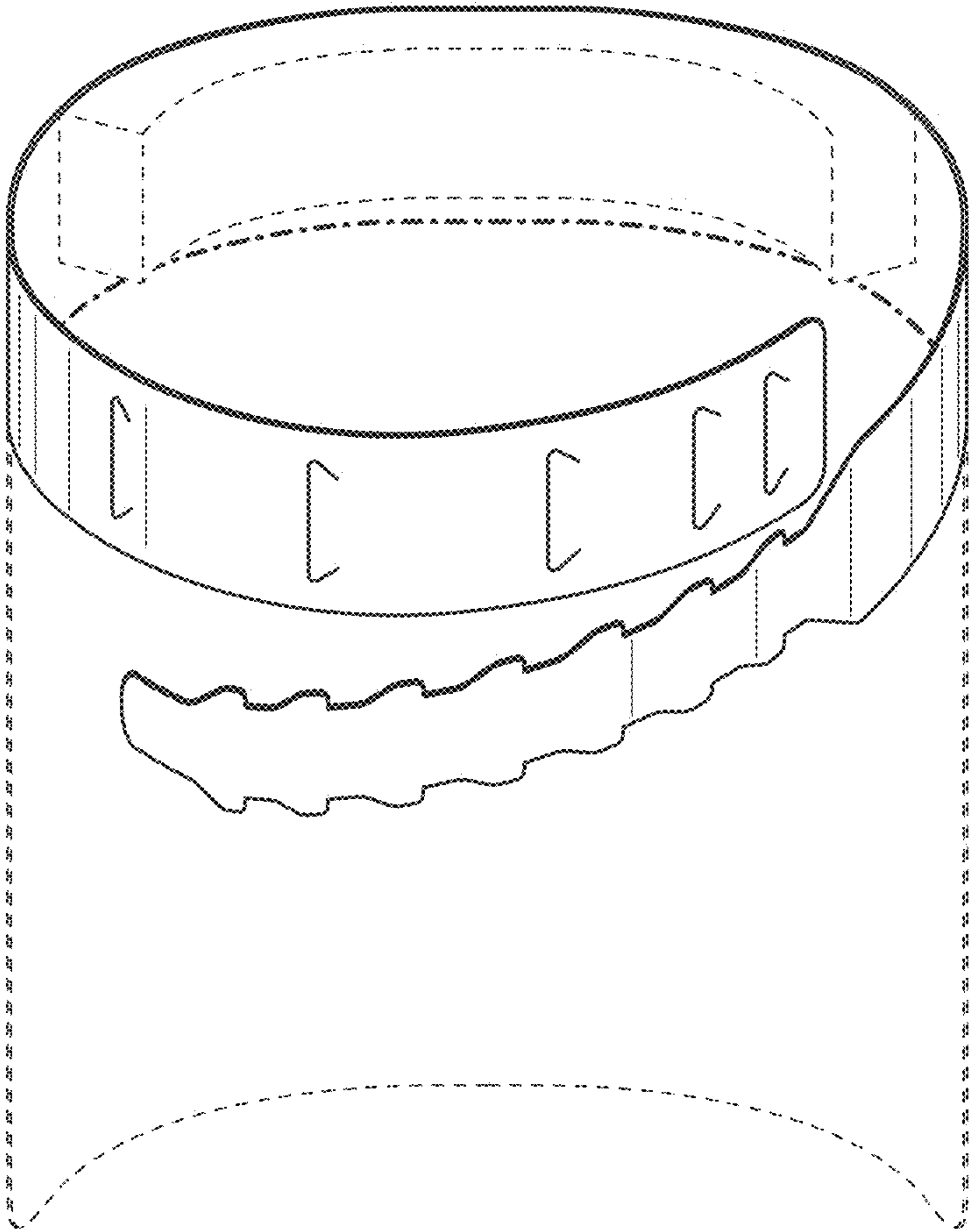
