We claim the ornamental design for a sink leg, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left perspective view of an embodiment of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being a mirror of the front elevation view;

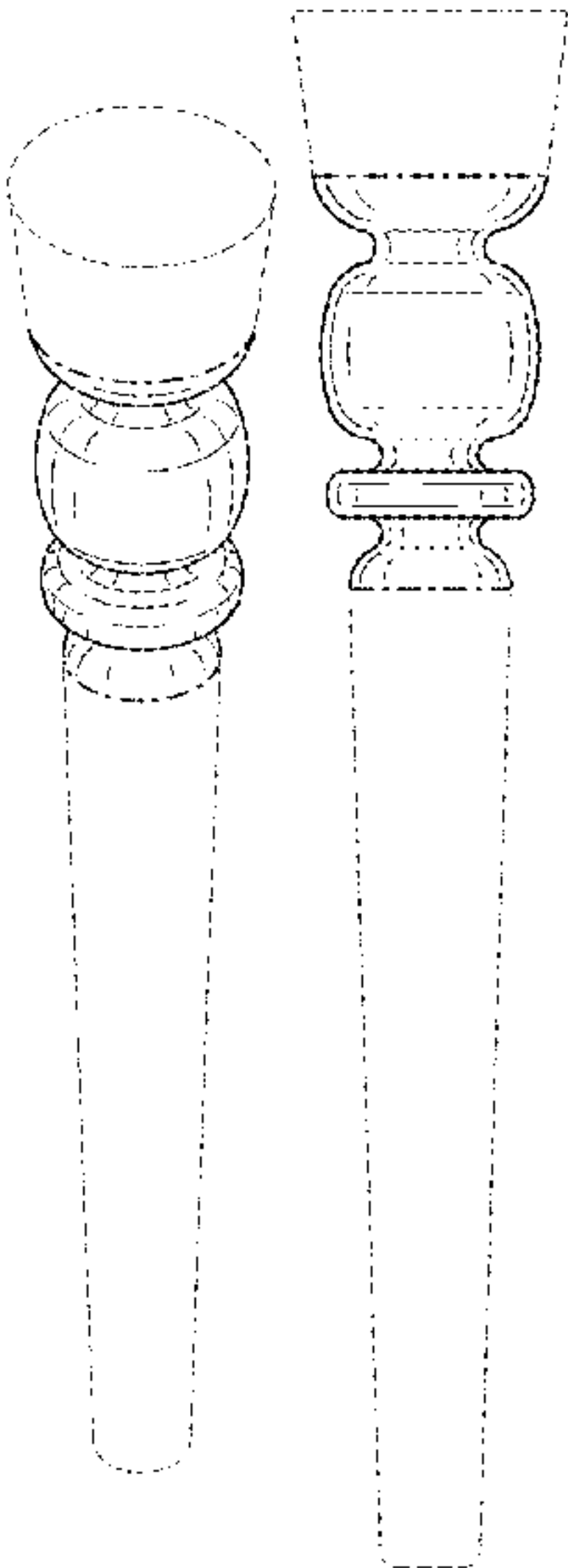
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror of the left side elevation view;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

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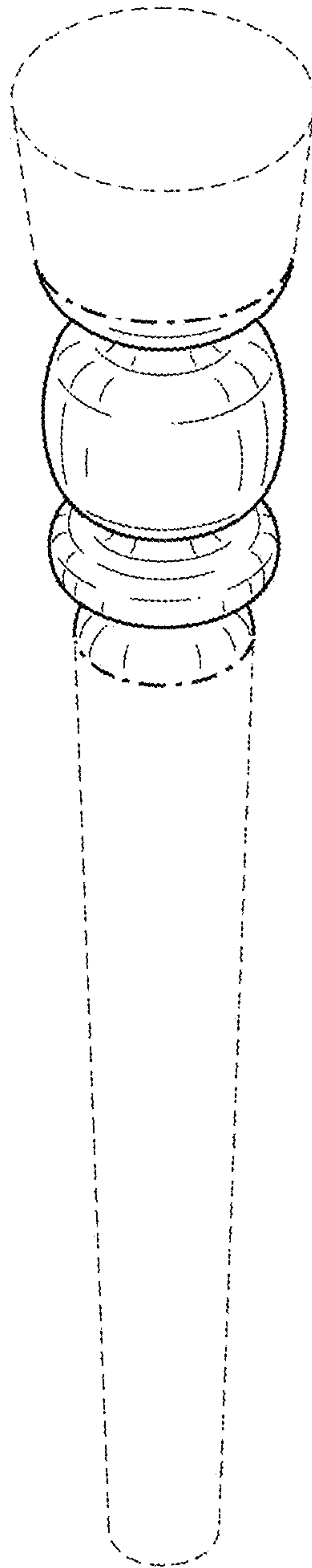

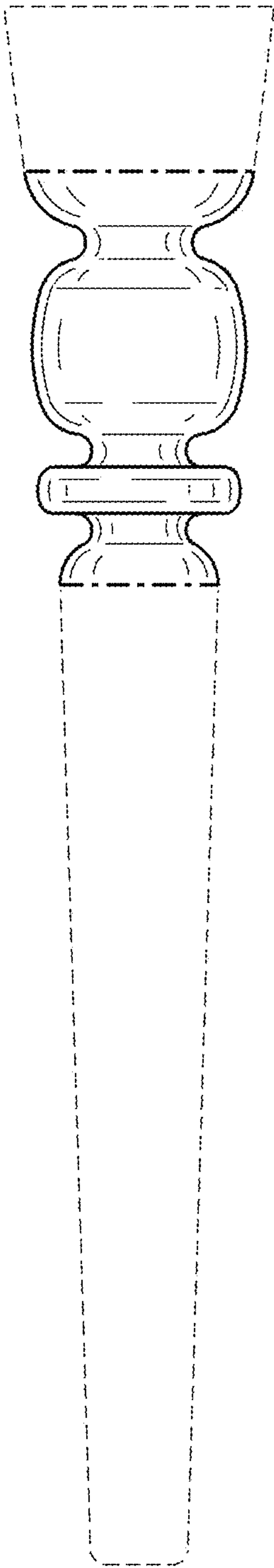

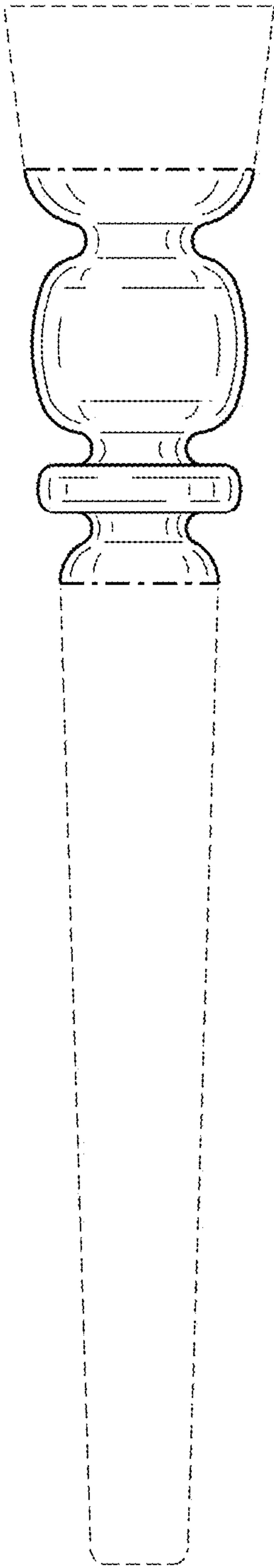

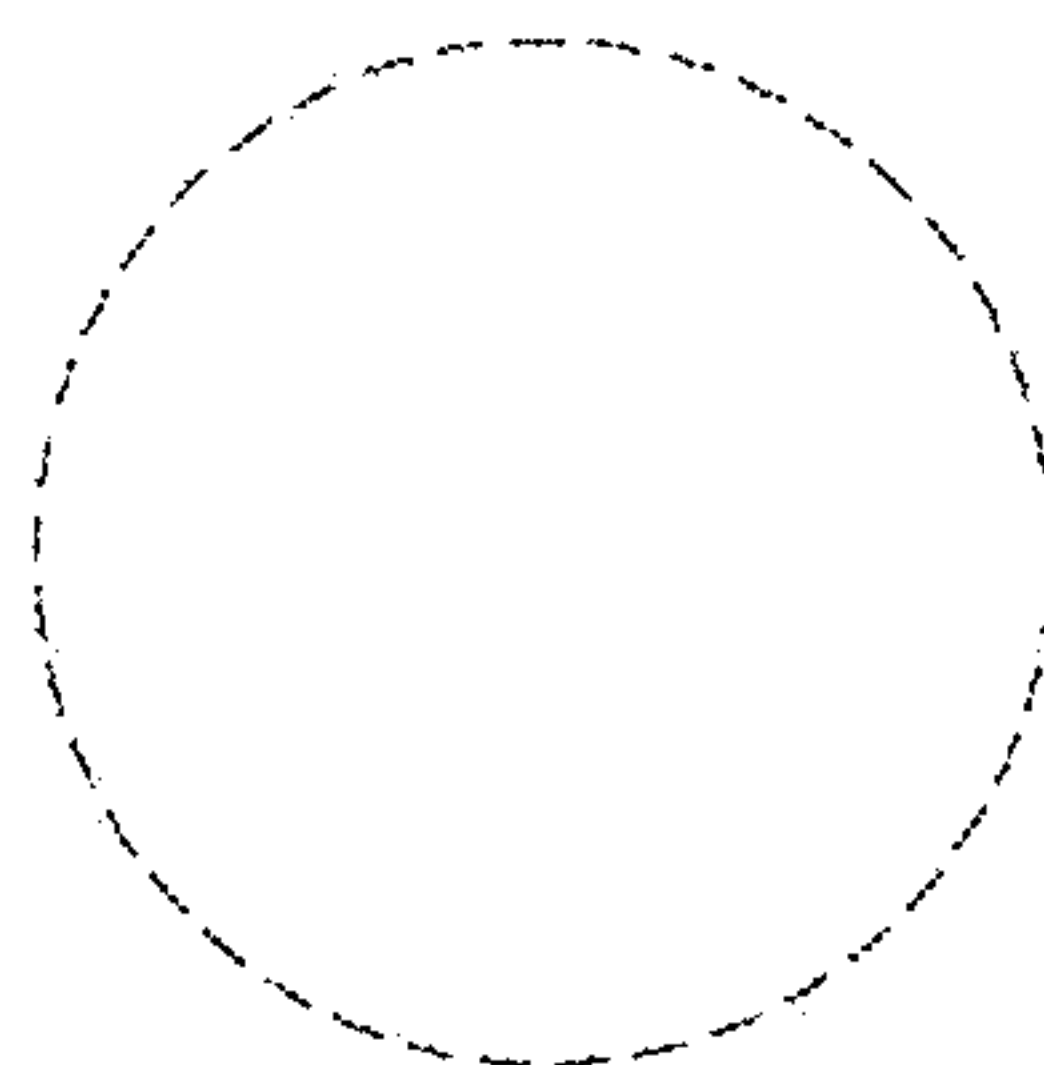

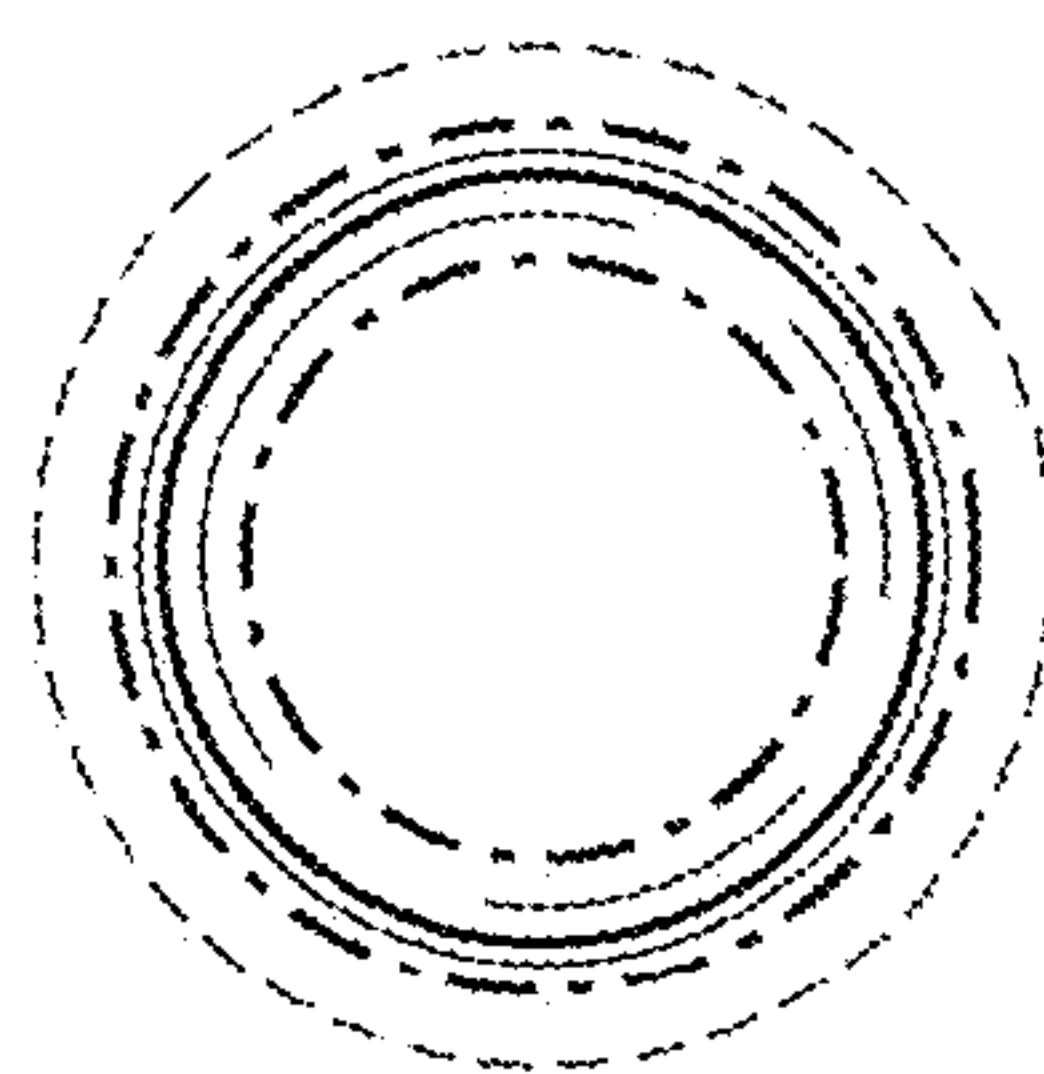
