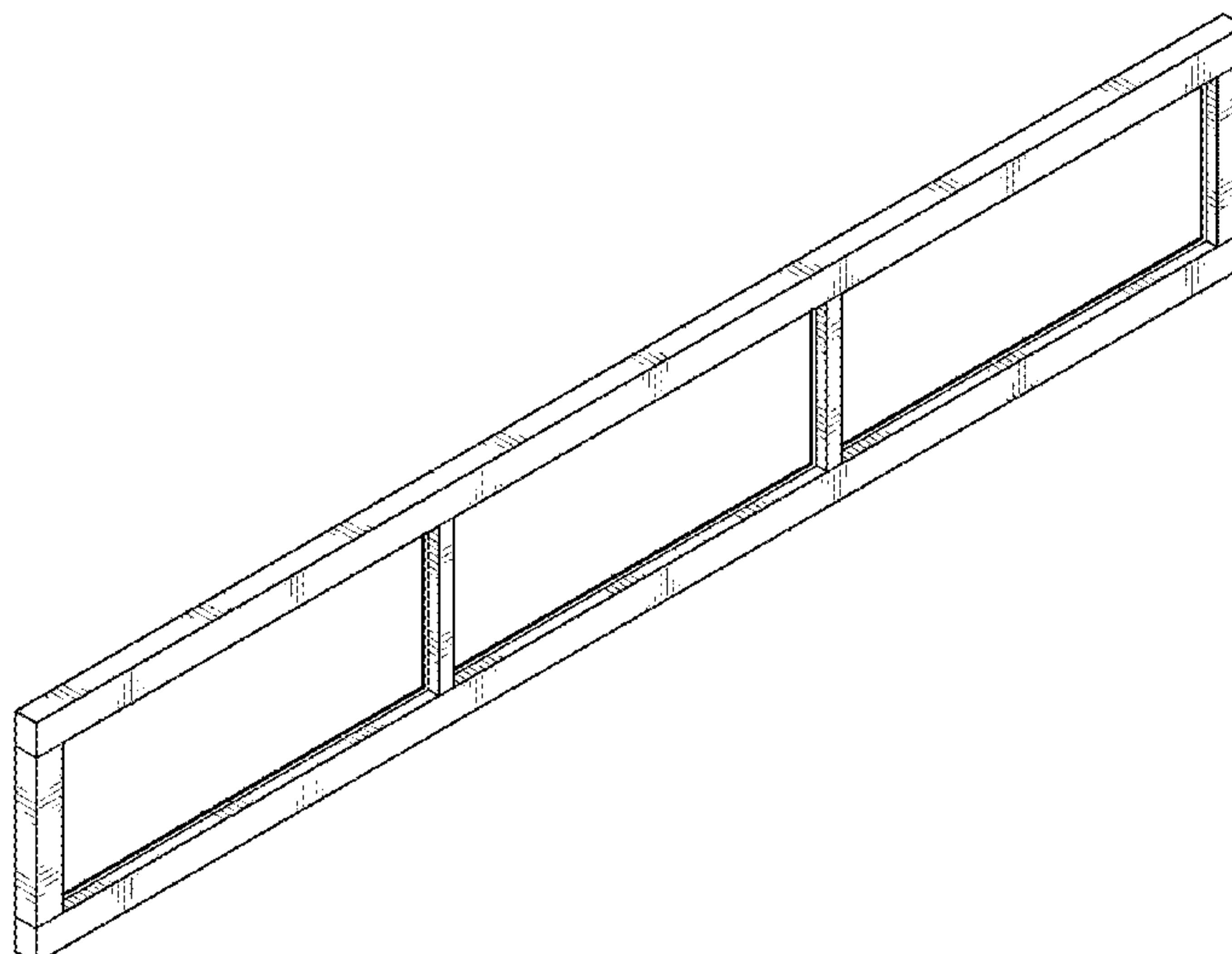
The ornamental design for a safety gate, as shown and described.

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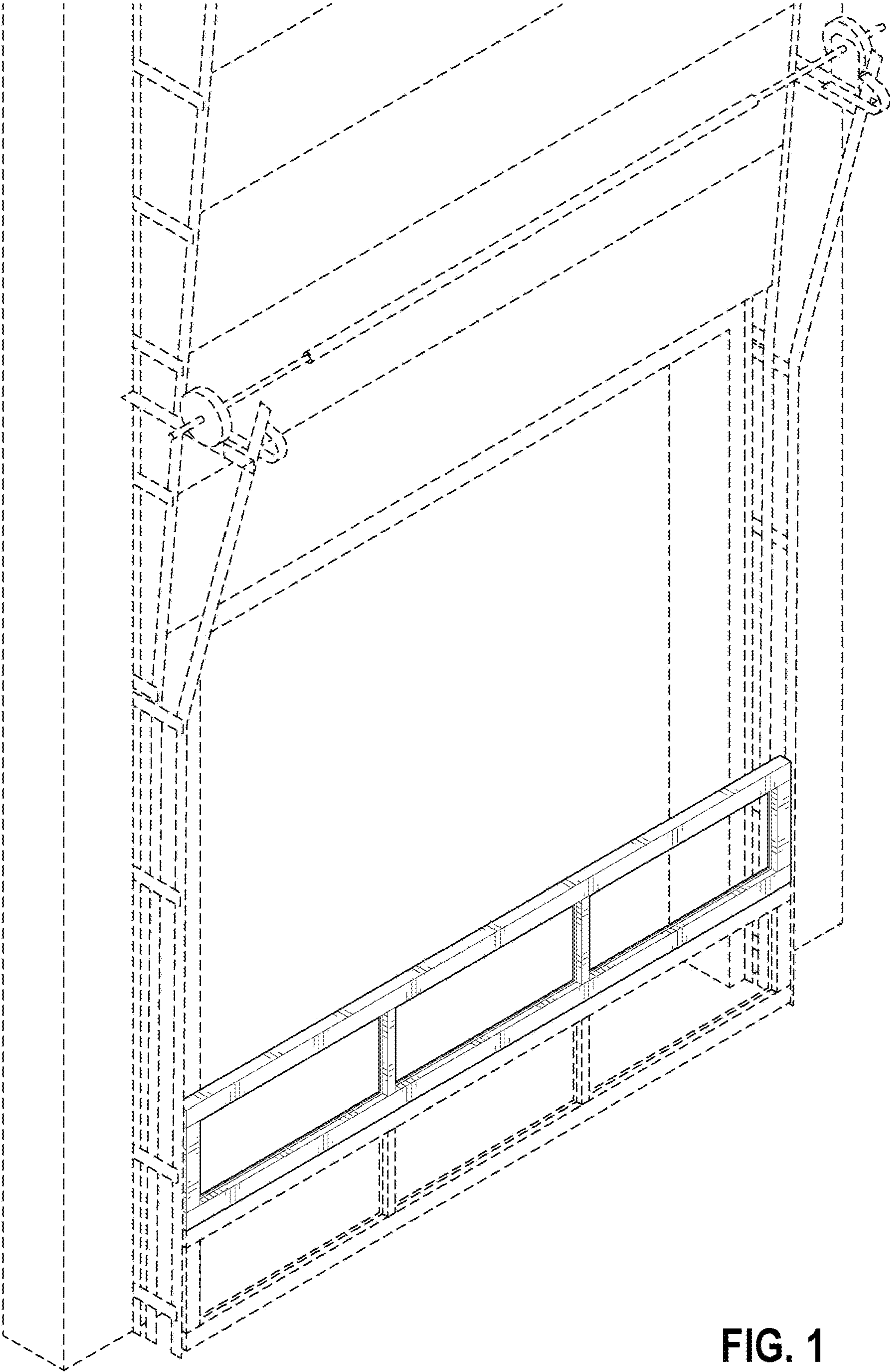

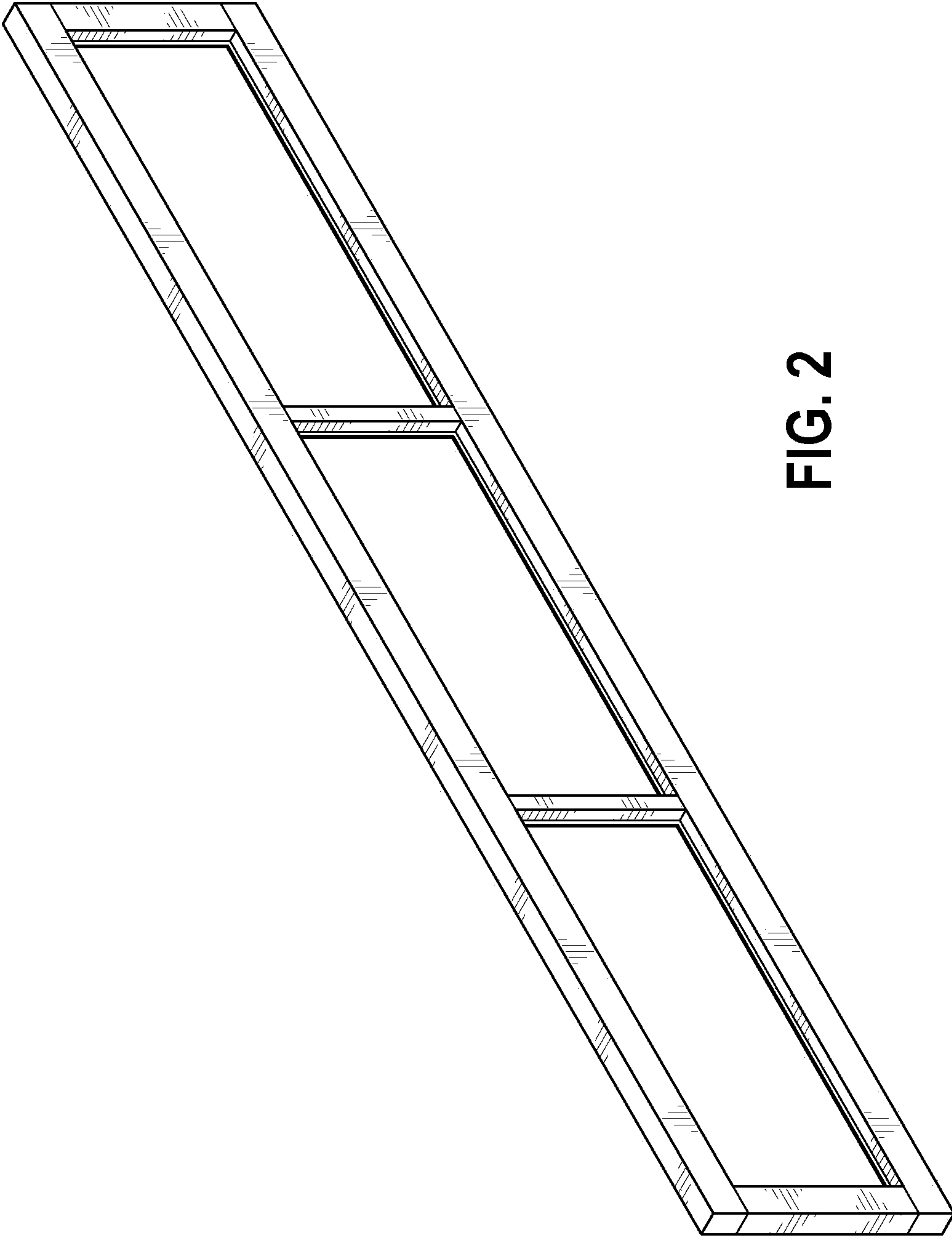

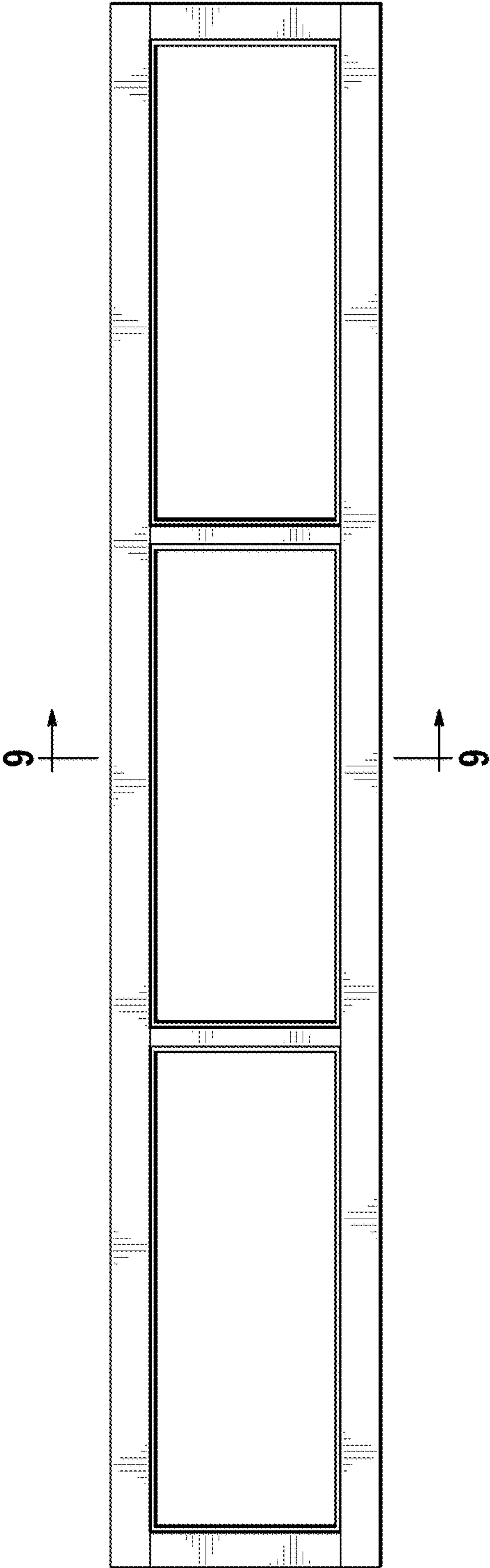

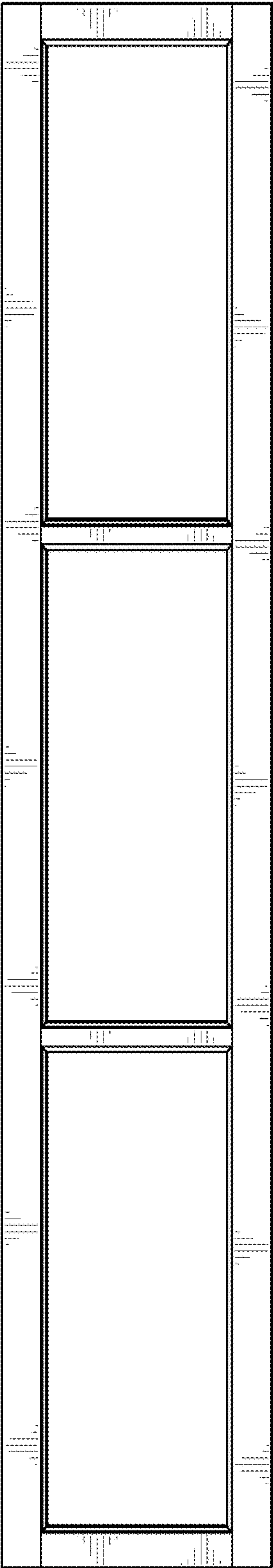

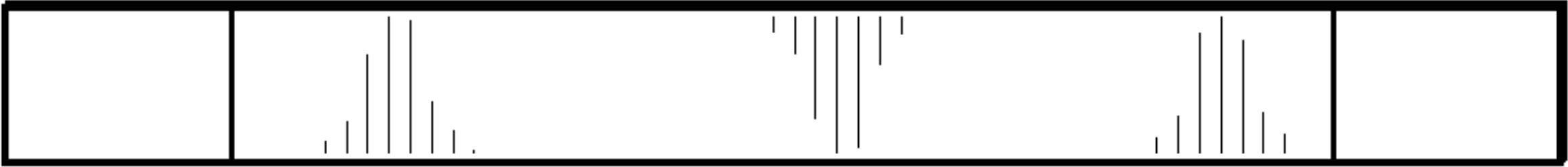

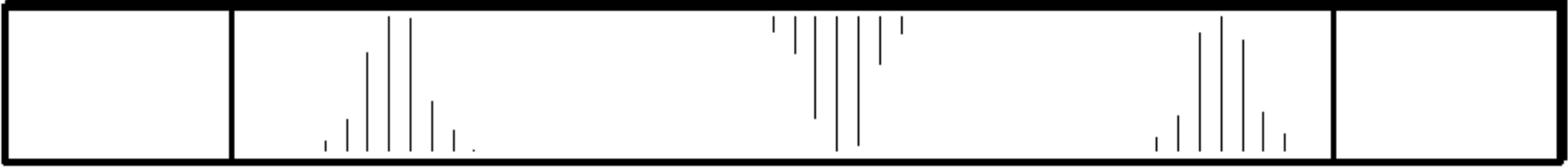
