DESCRIPTION

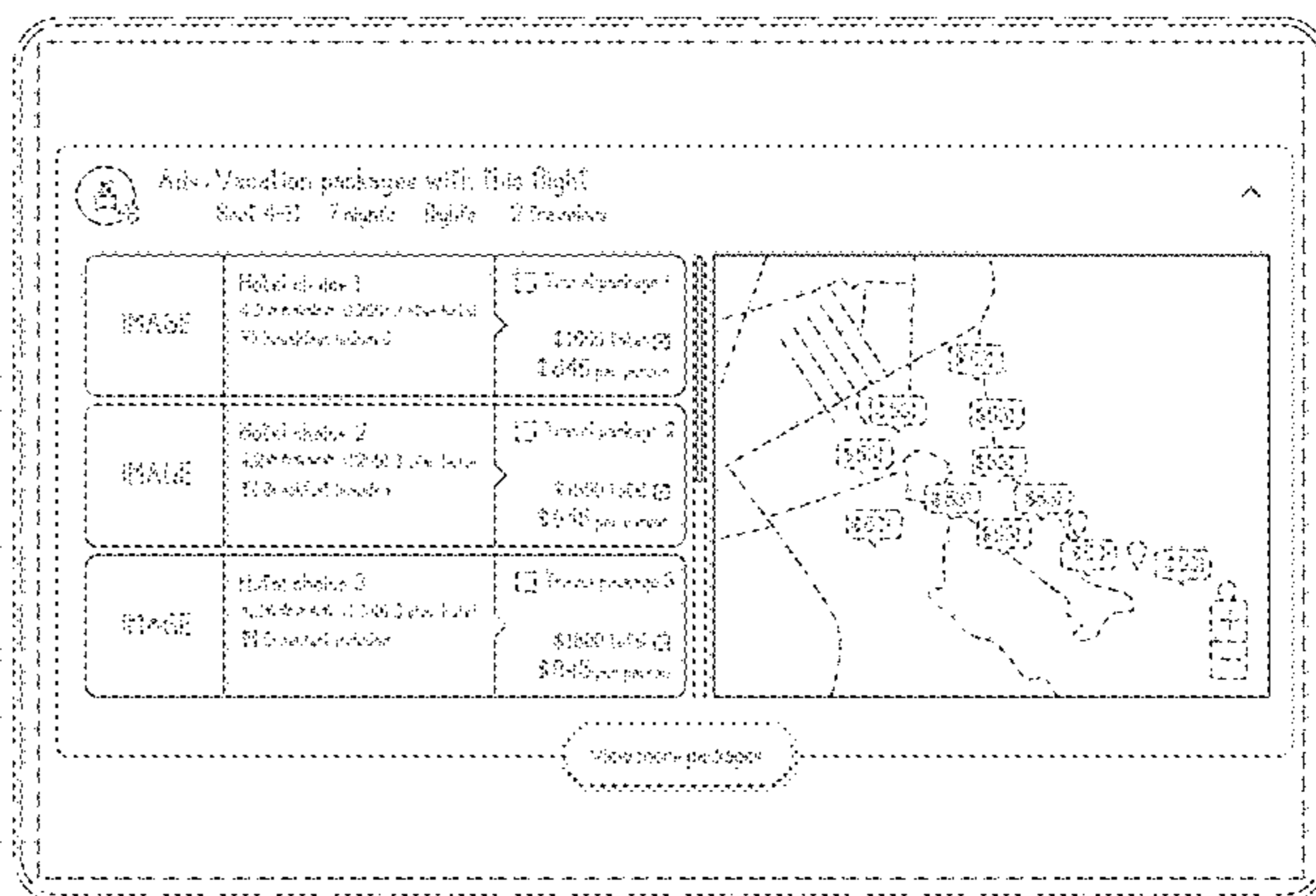
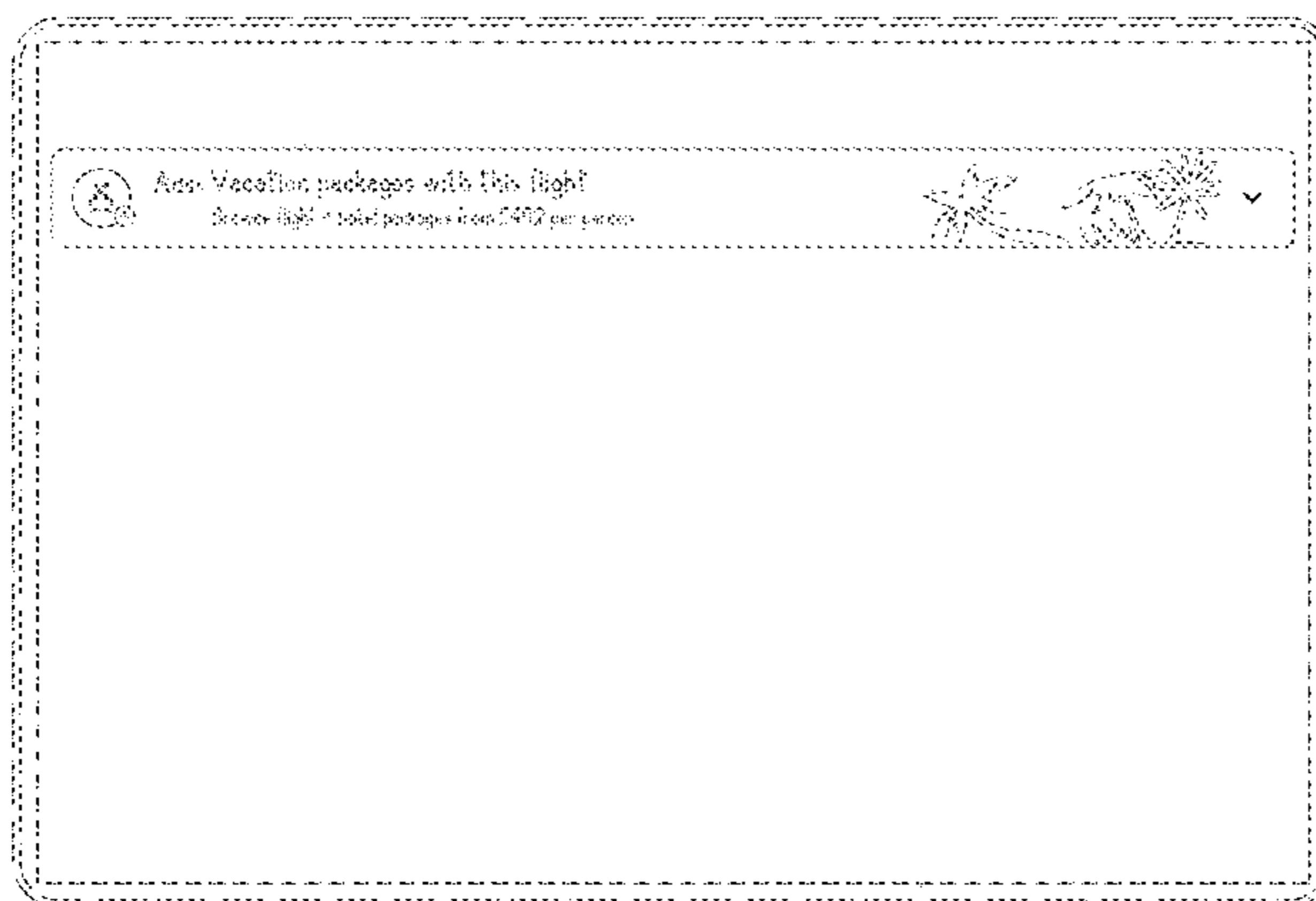
FIG. 1 is a front view of a first image in a sequence according to a first embodiment; and FIG. 2 is a front view of a second image in the sequence thereof.

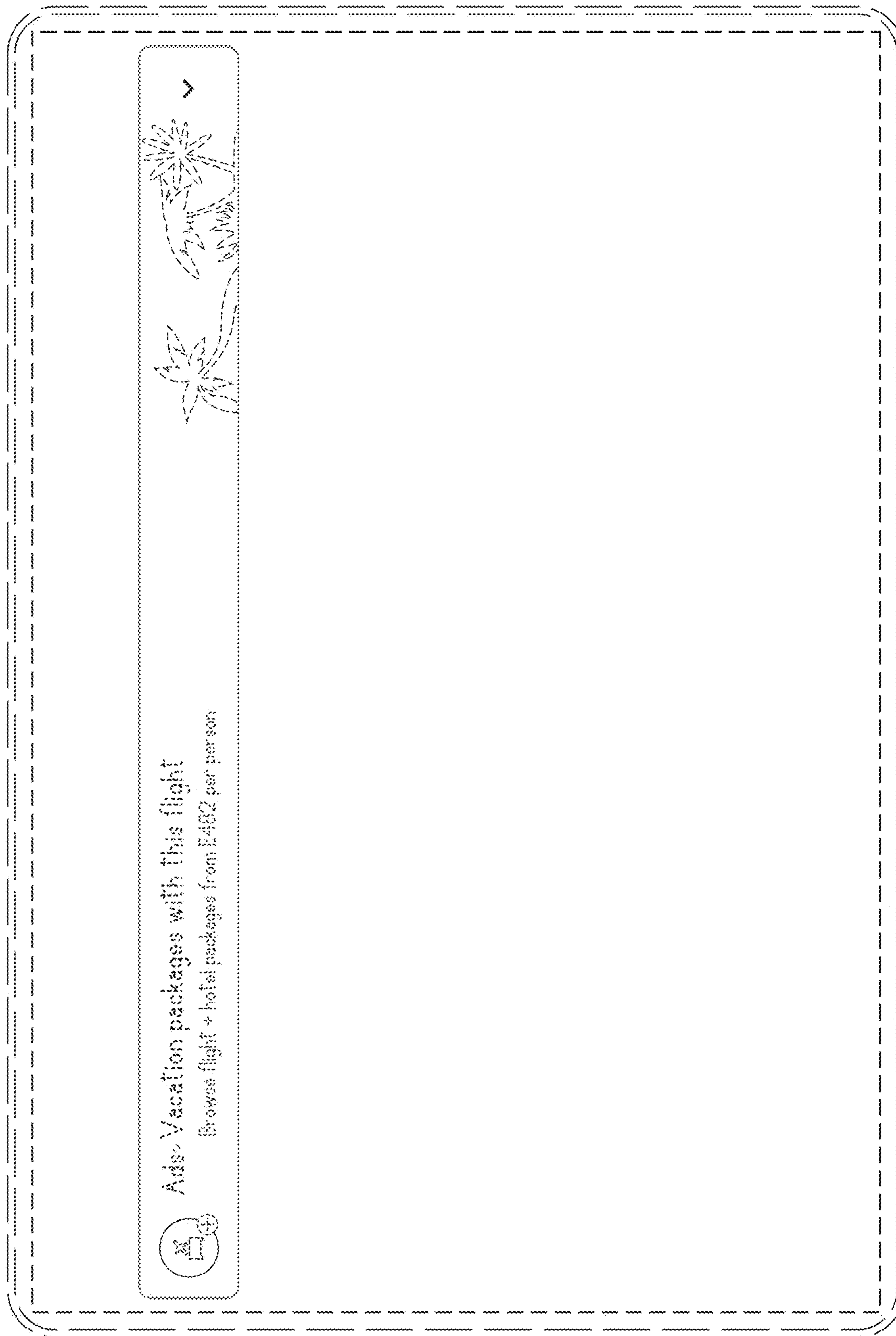





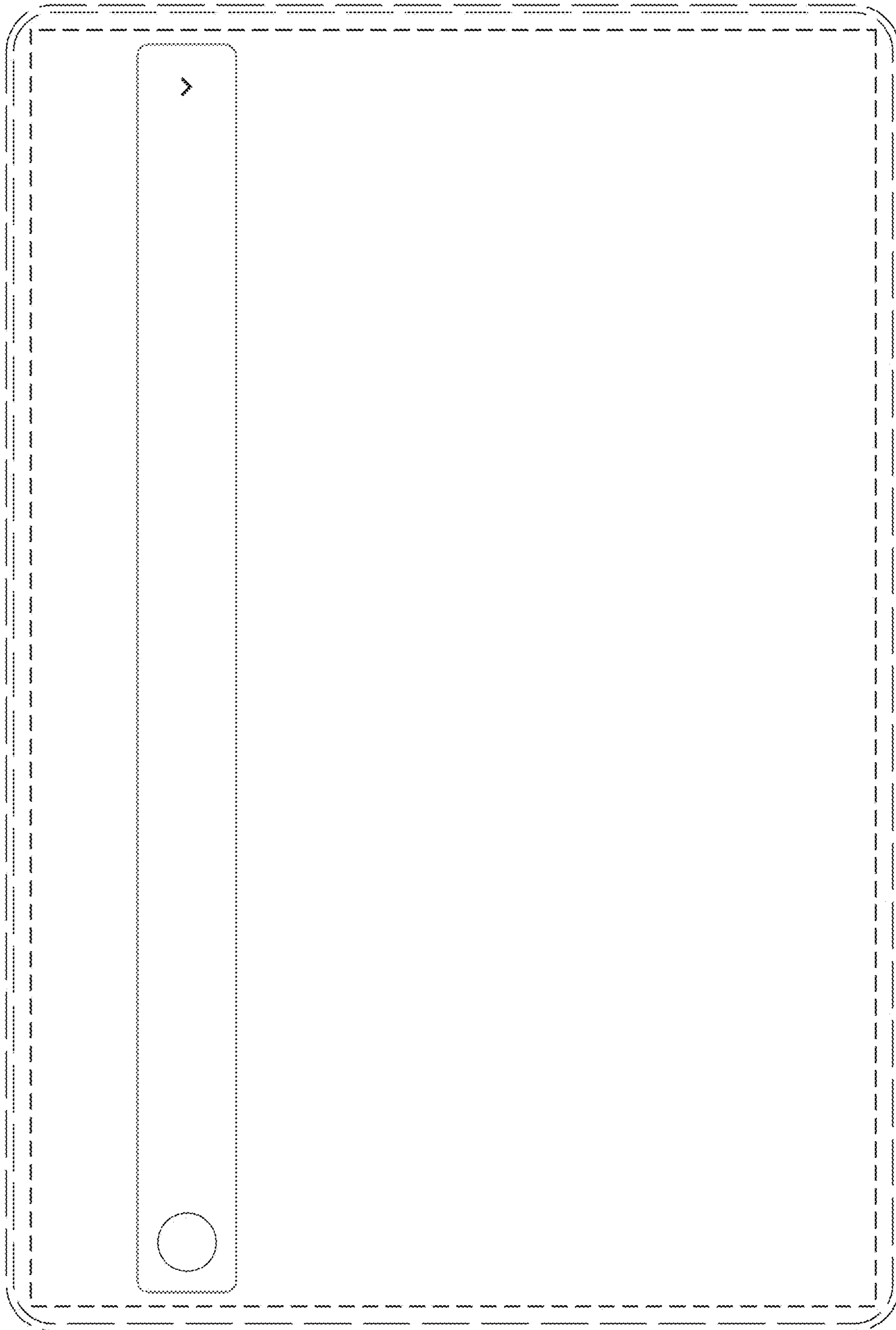

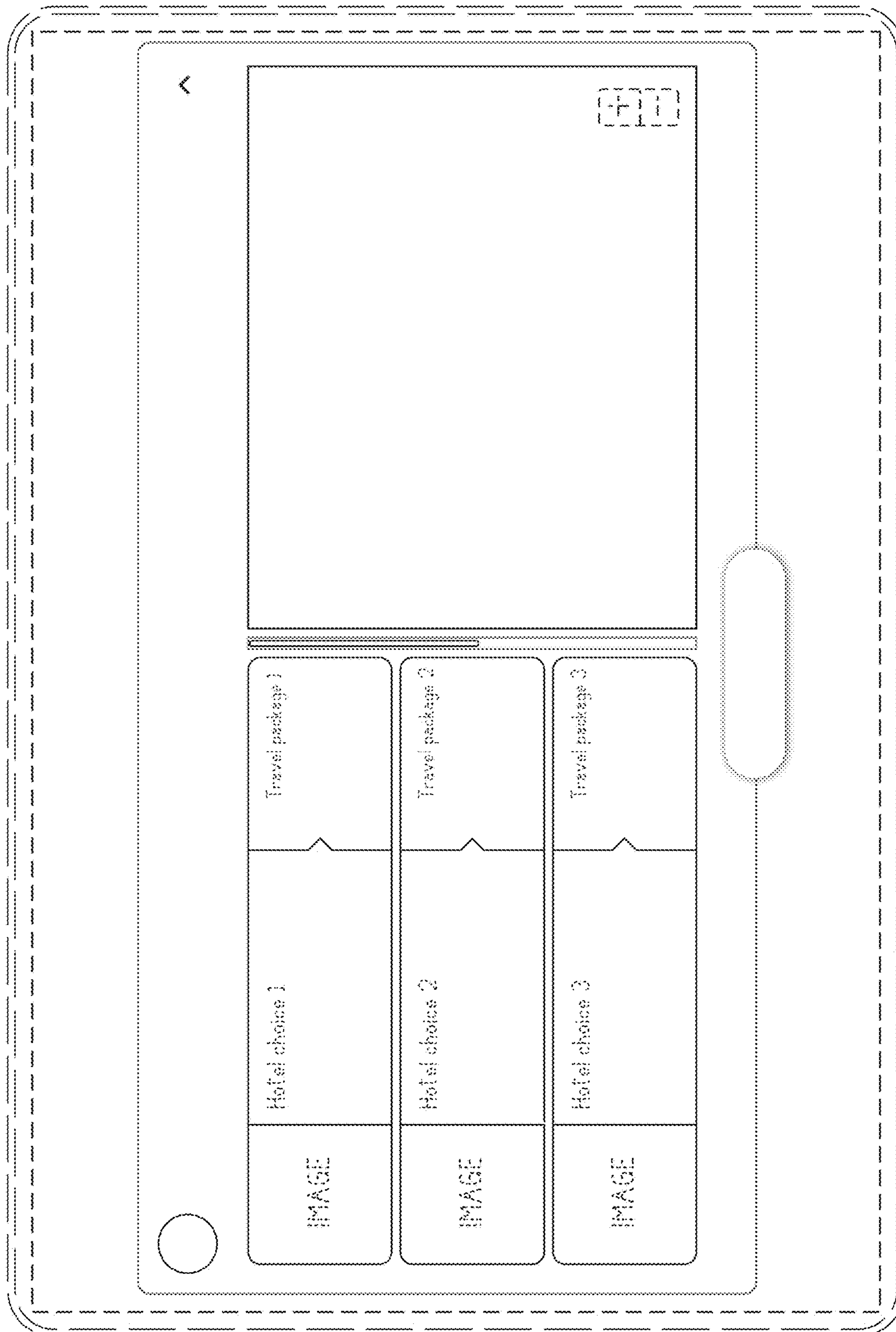
