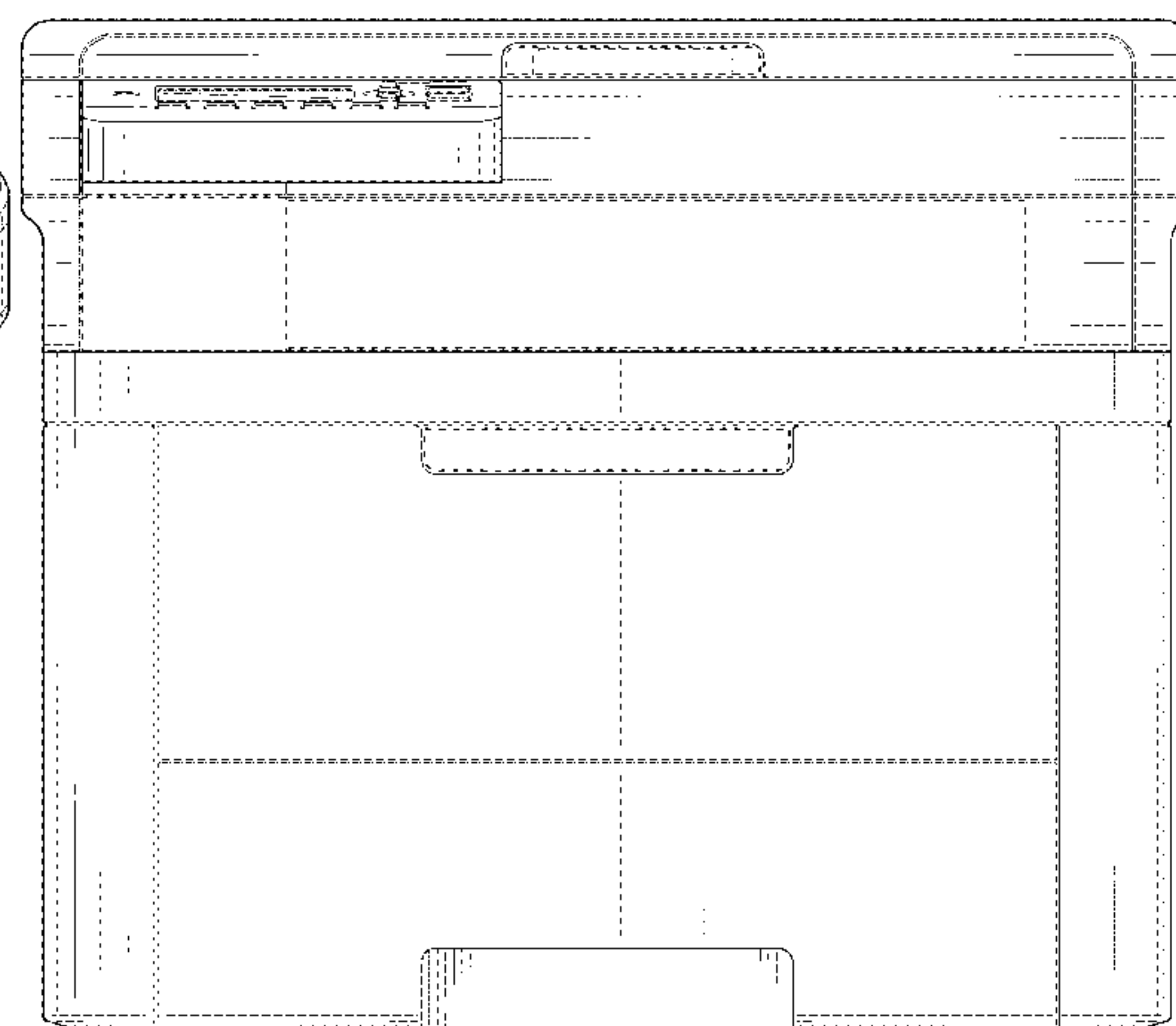
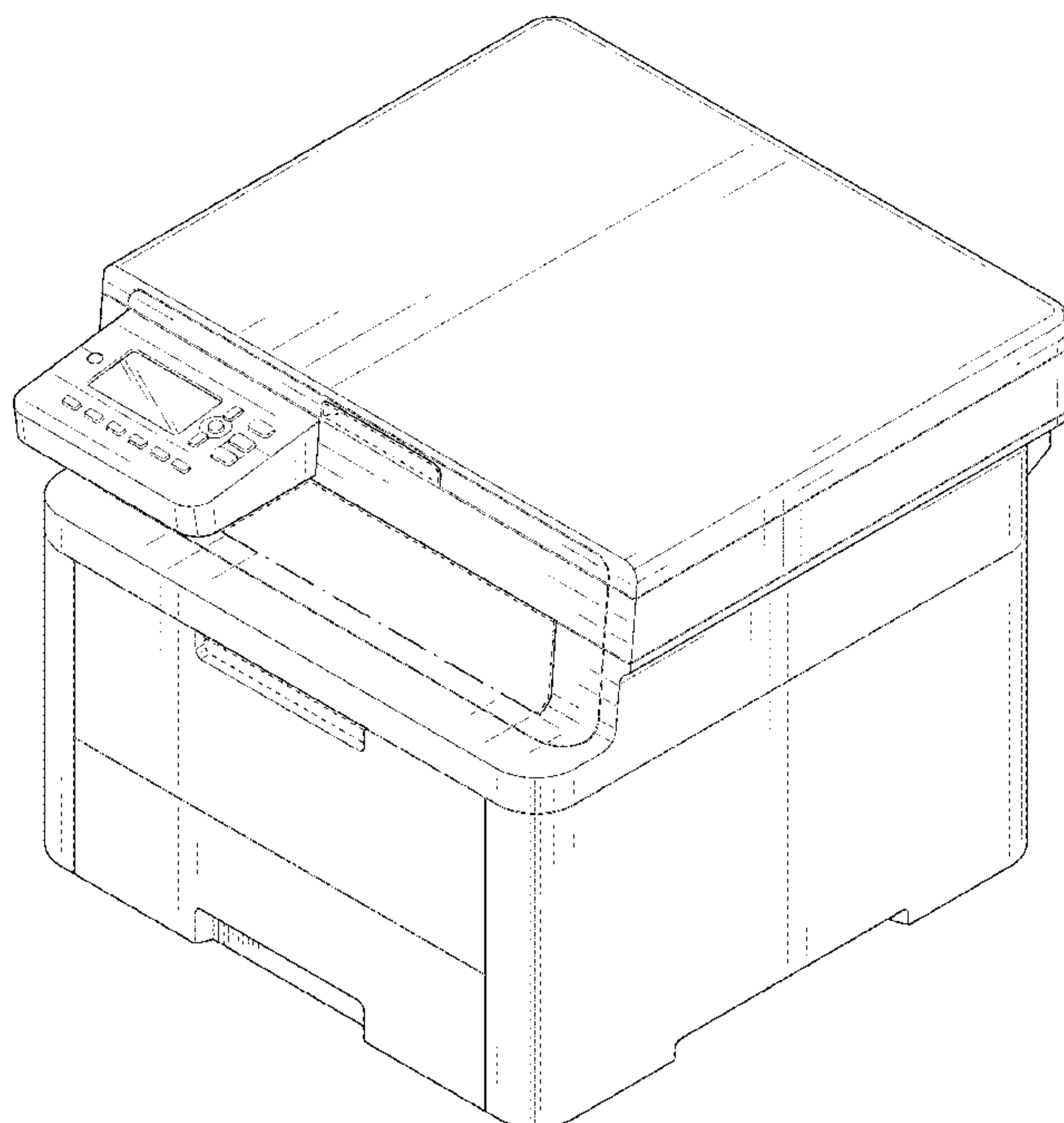
The ornamental design for a printer, as shown and described.

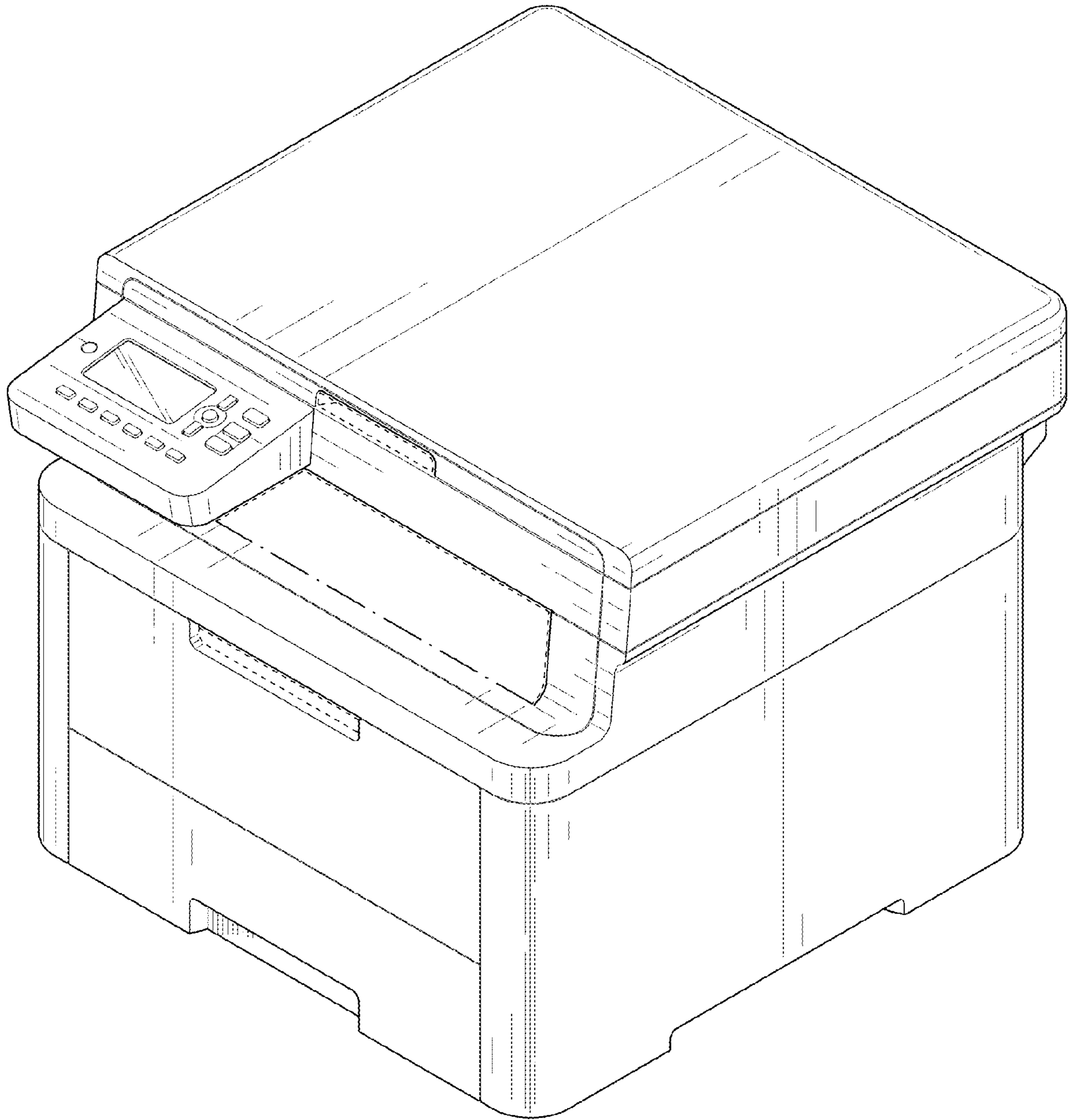

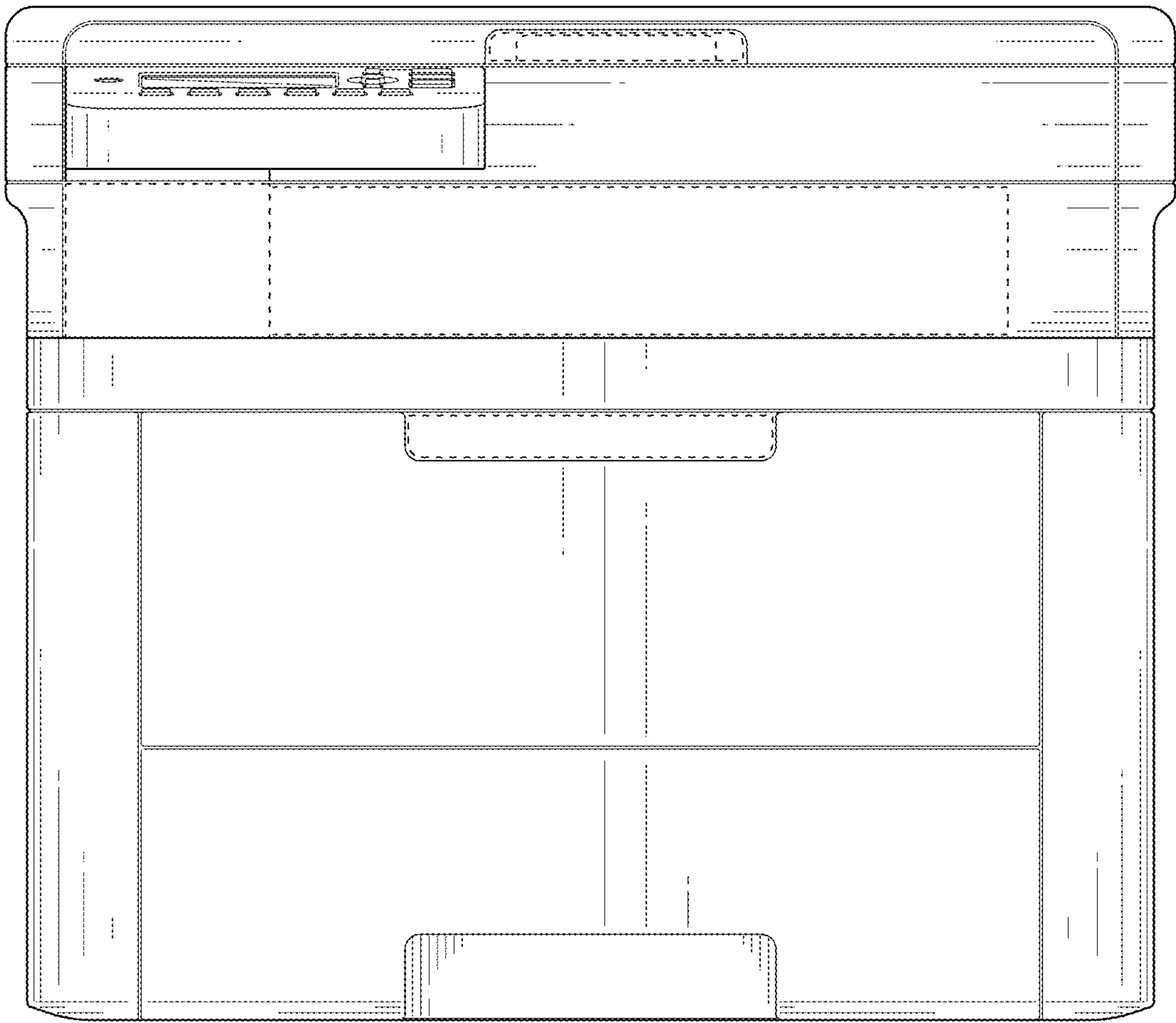

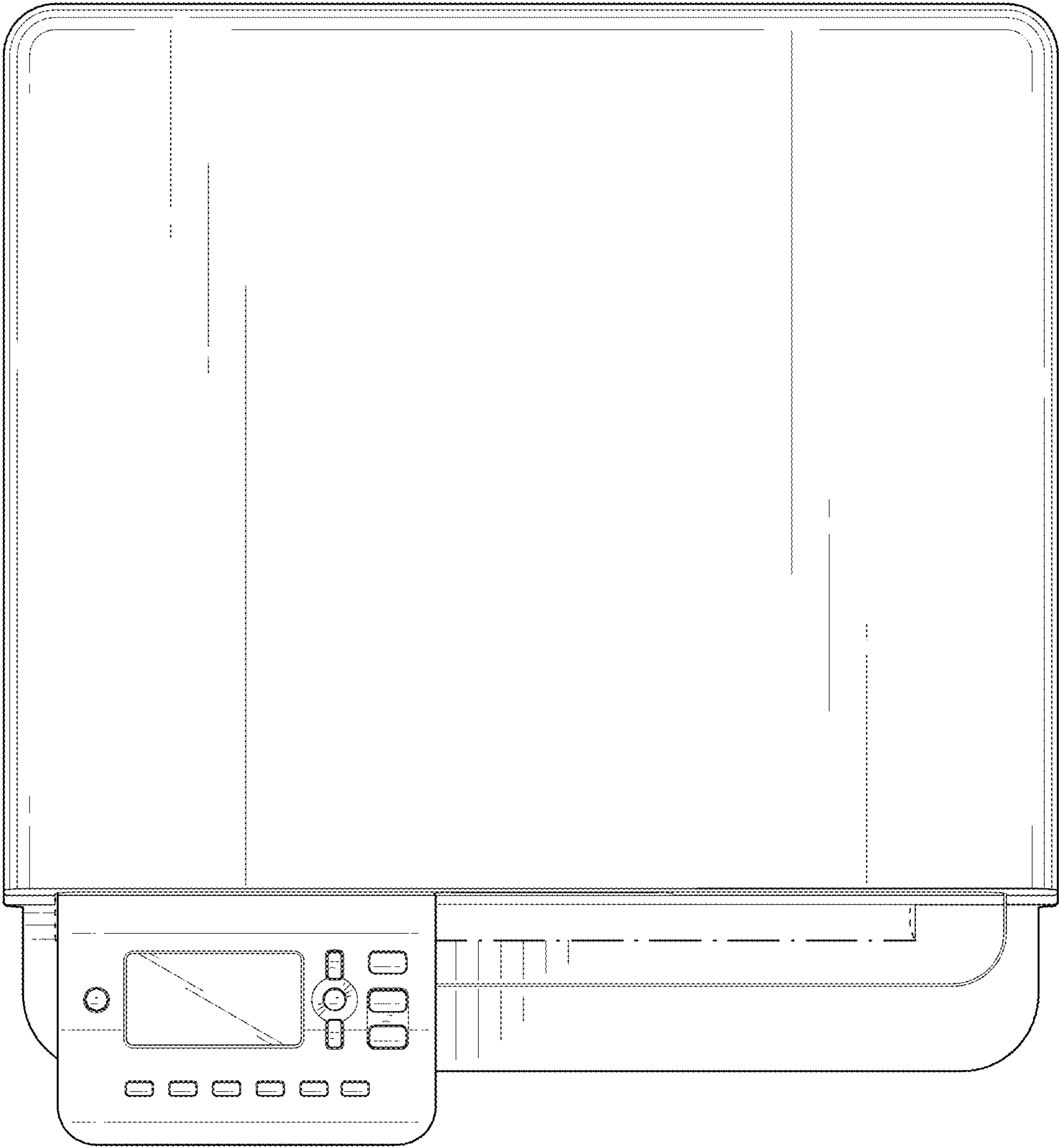

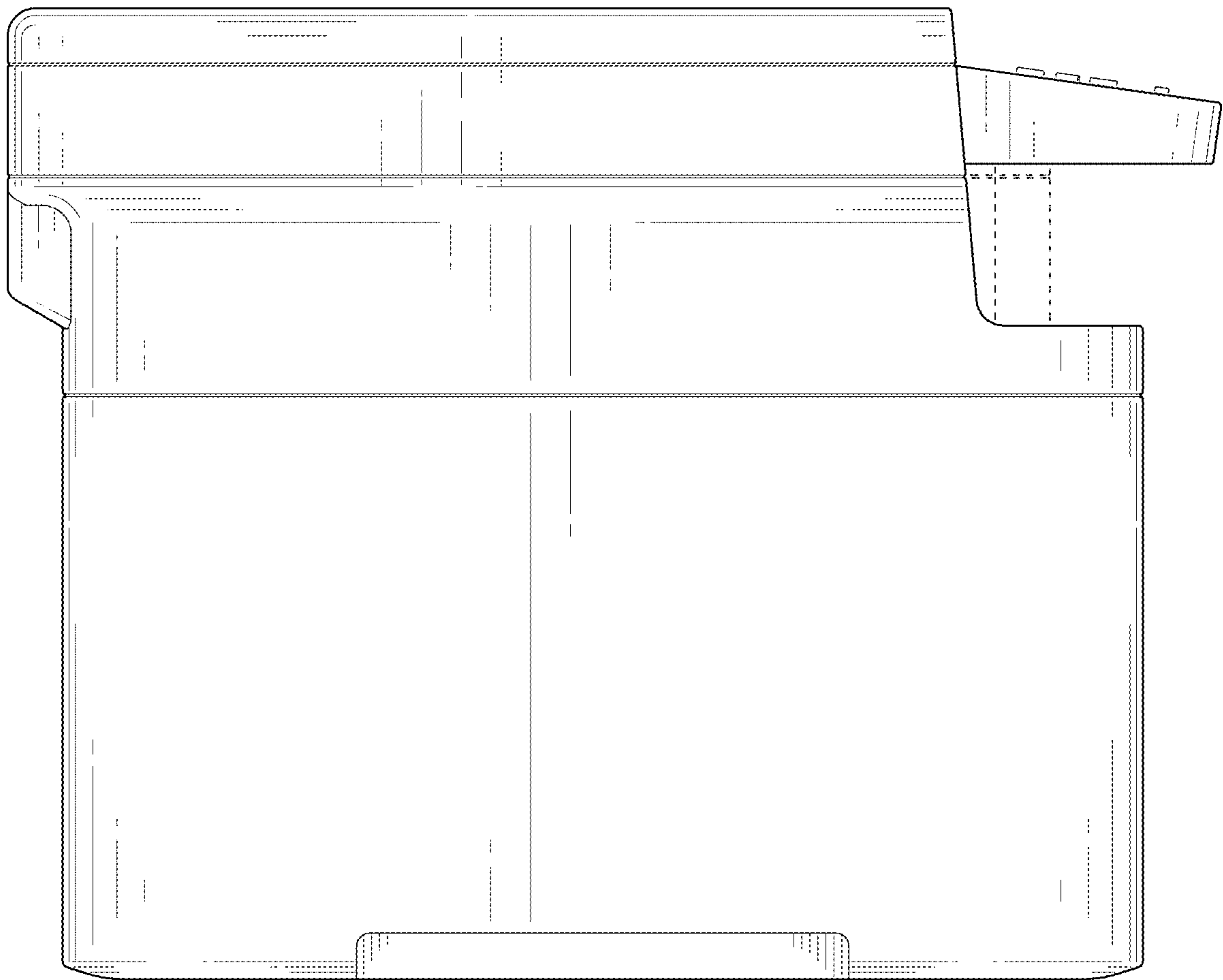

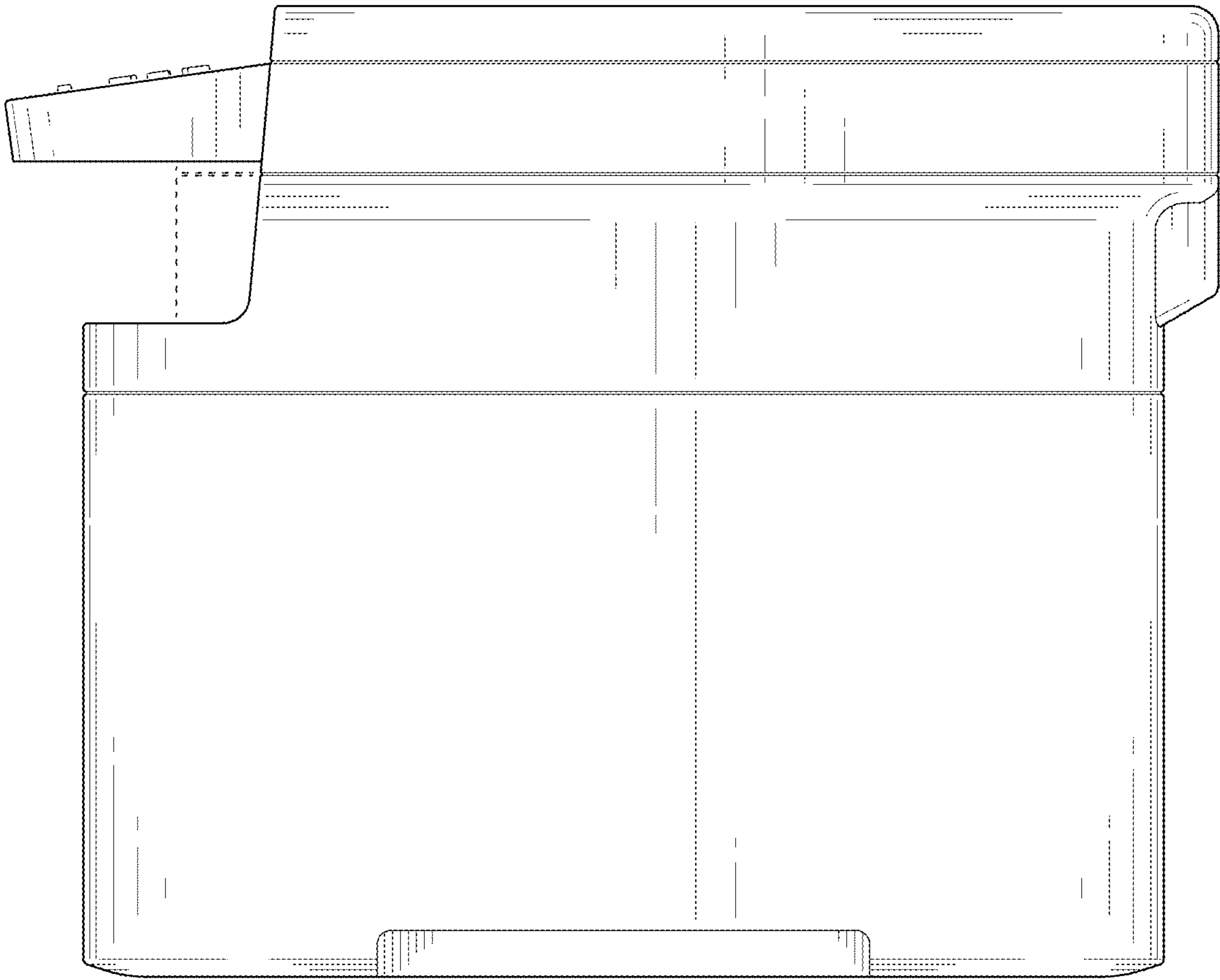

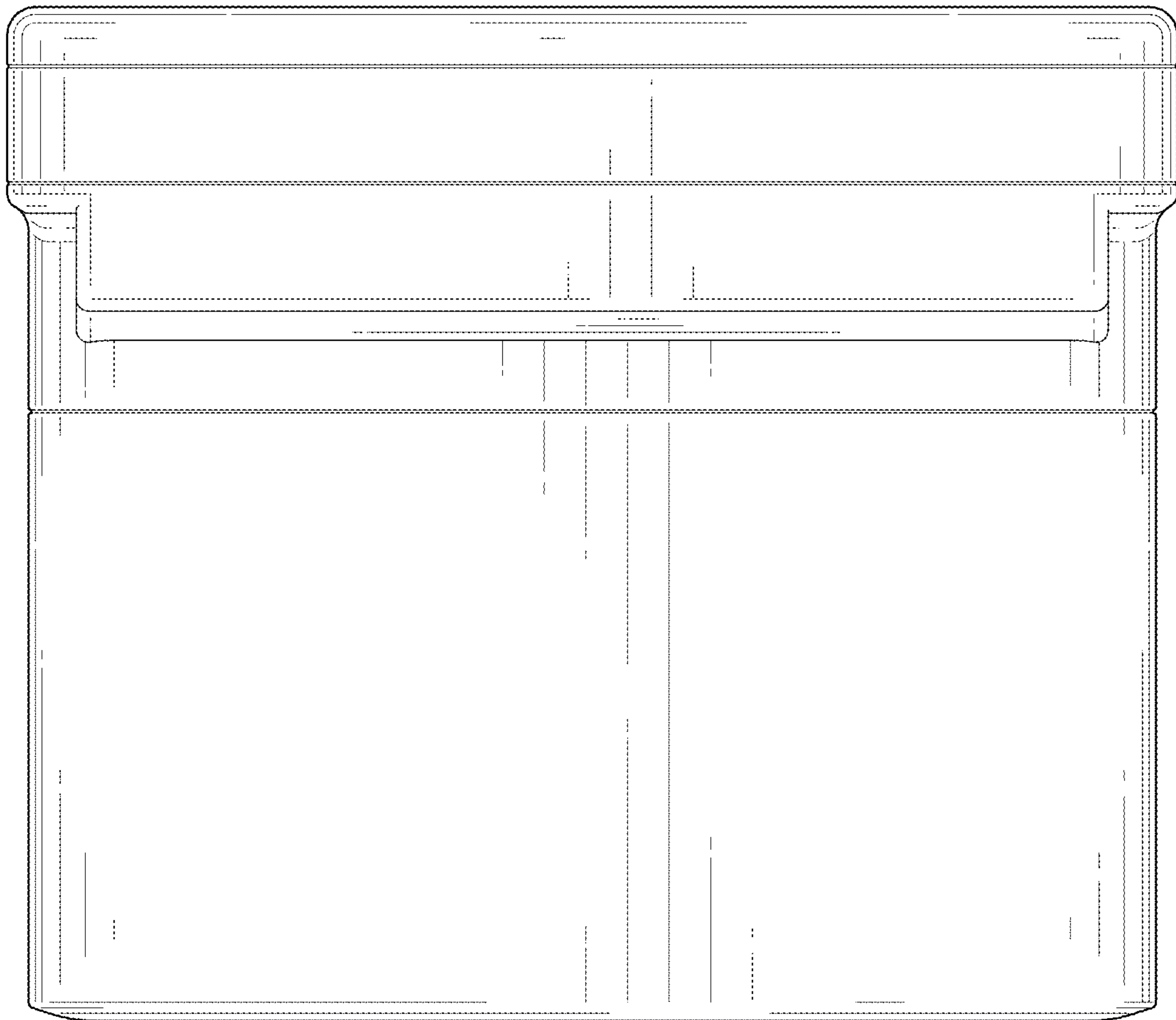

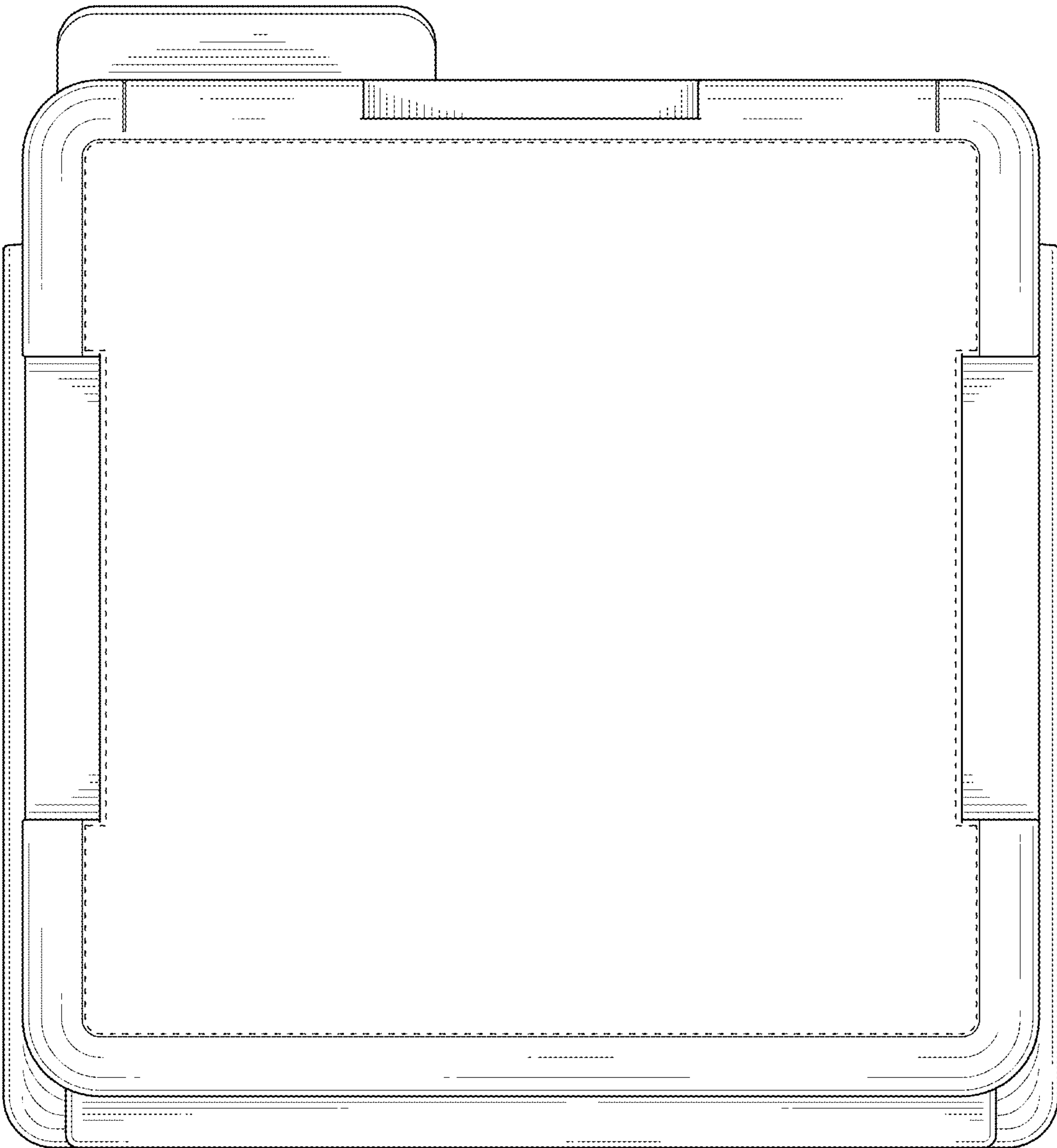
