FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof.

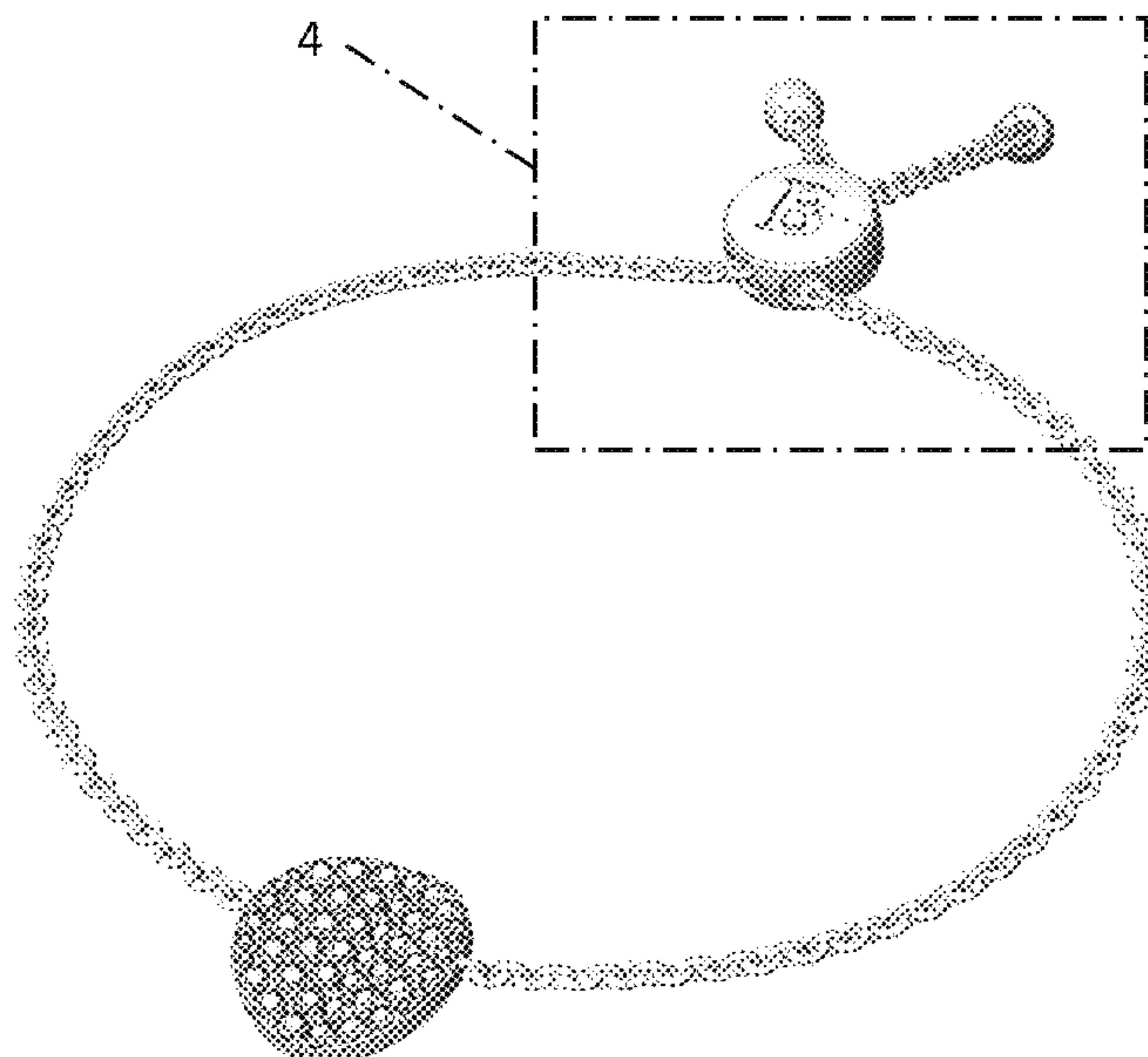
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

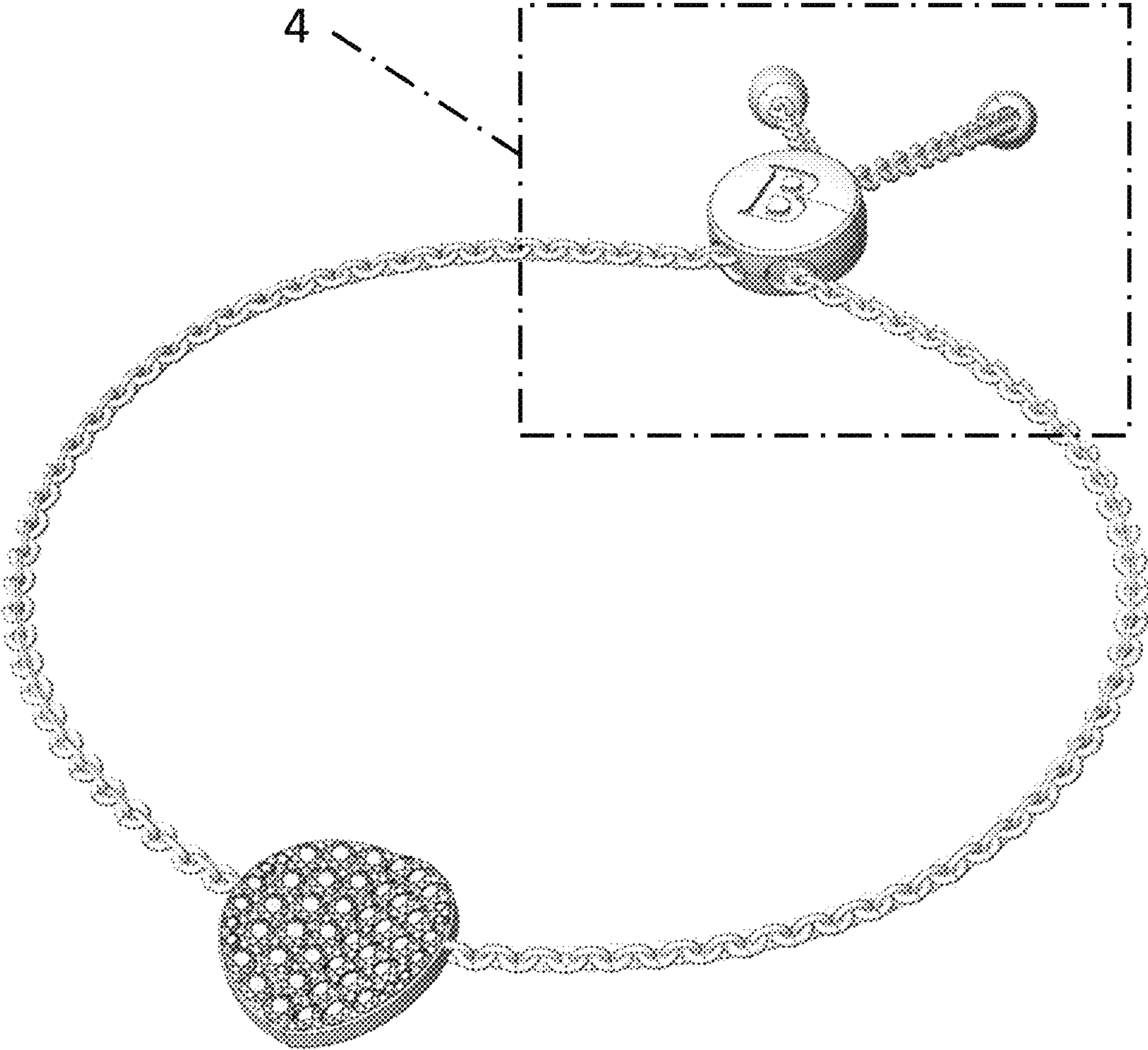

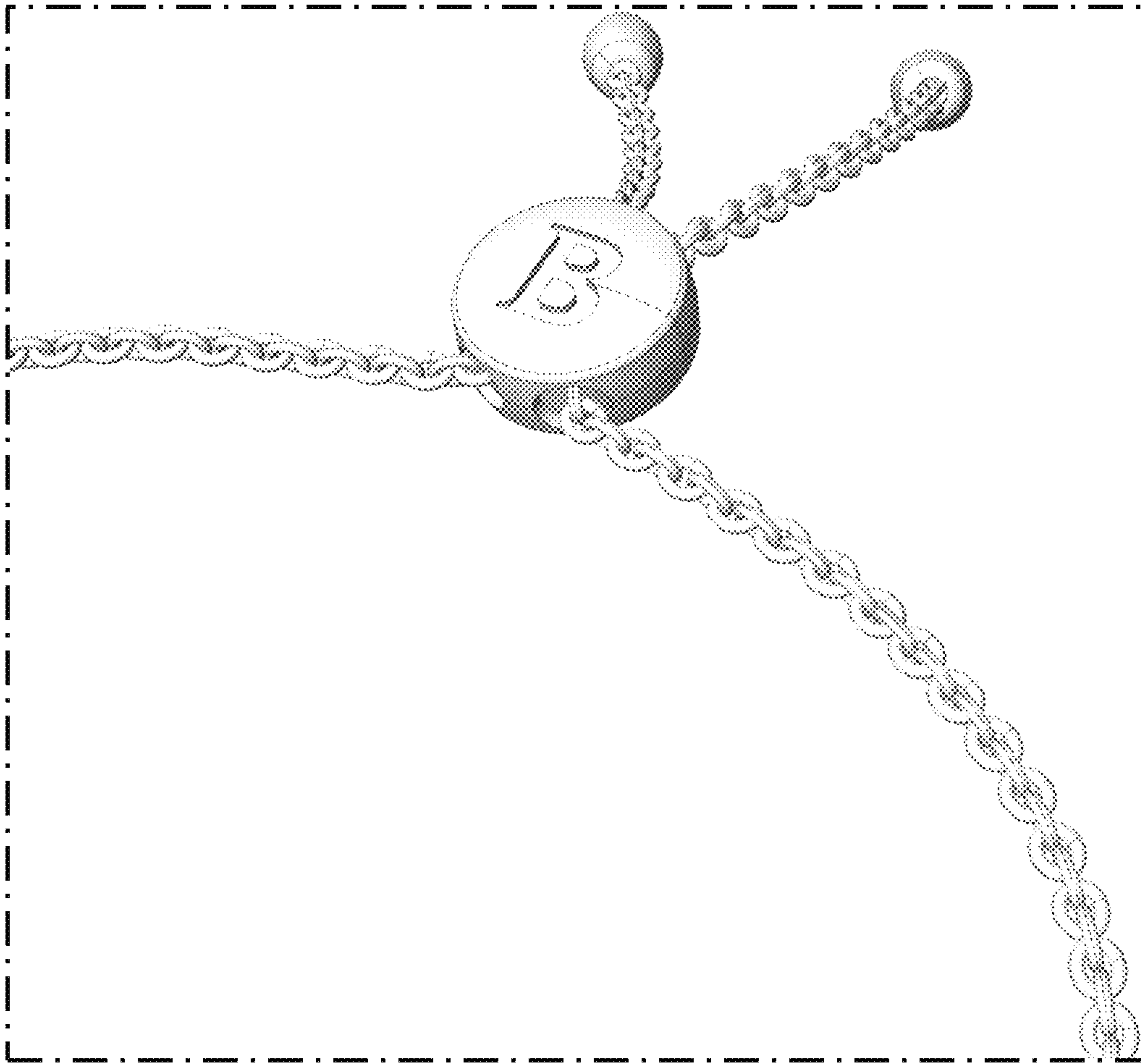

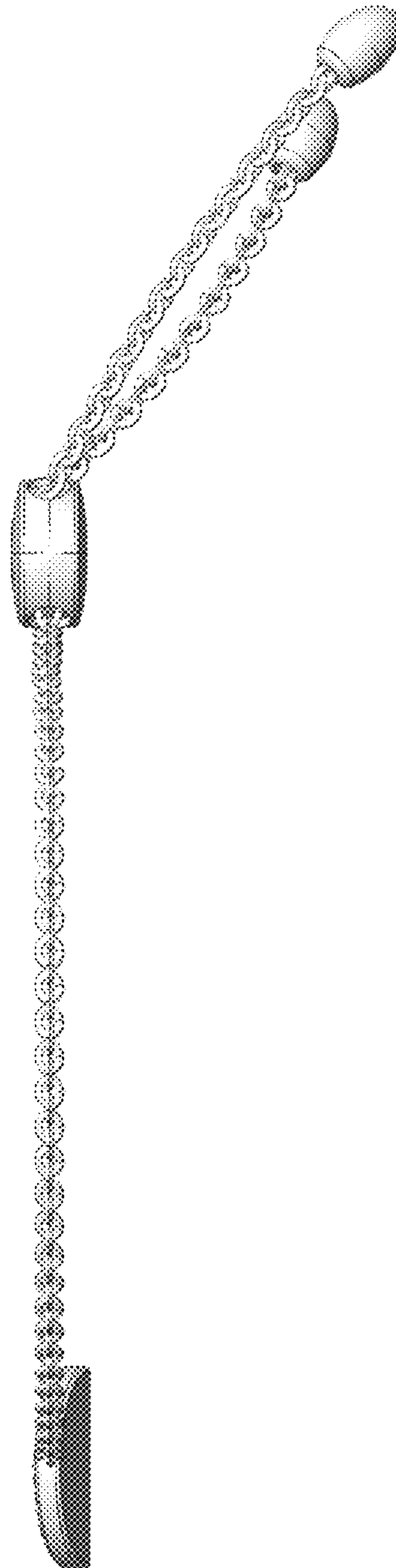
