DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a charging device
showing our design;

FIG. 2 is a back isometric view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof, the left side view being
a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view thereof, shown in an
environment of use;

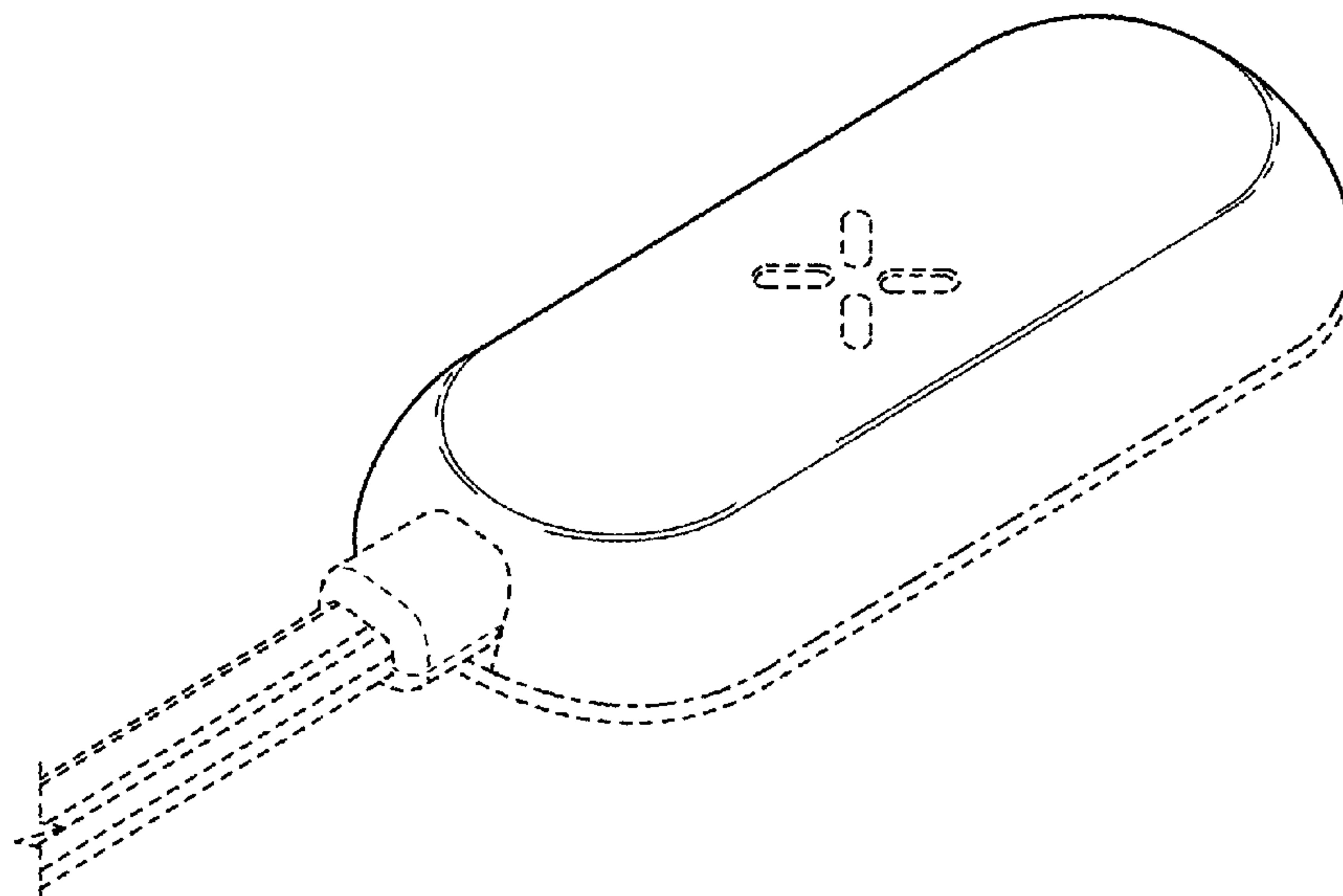
FIG. 9 is another front perspective view thereof, shown in a

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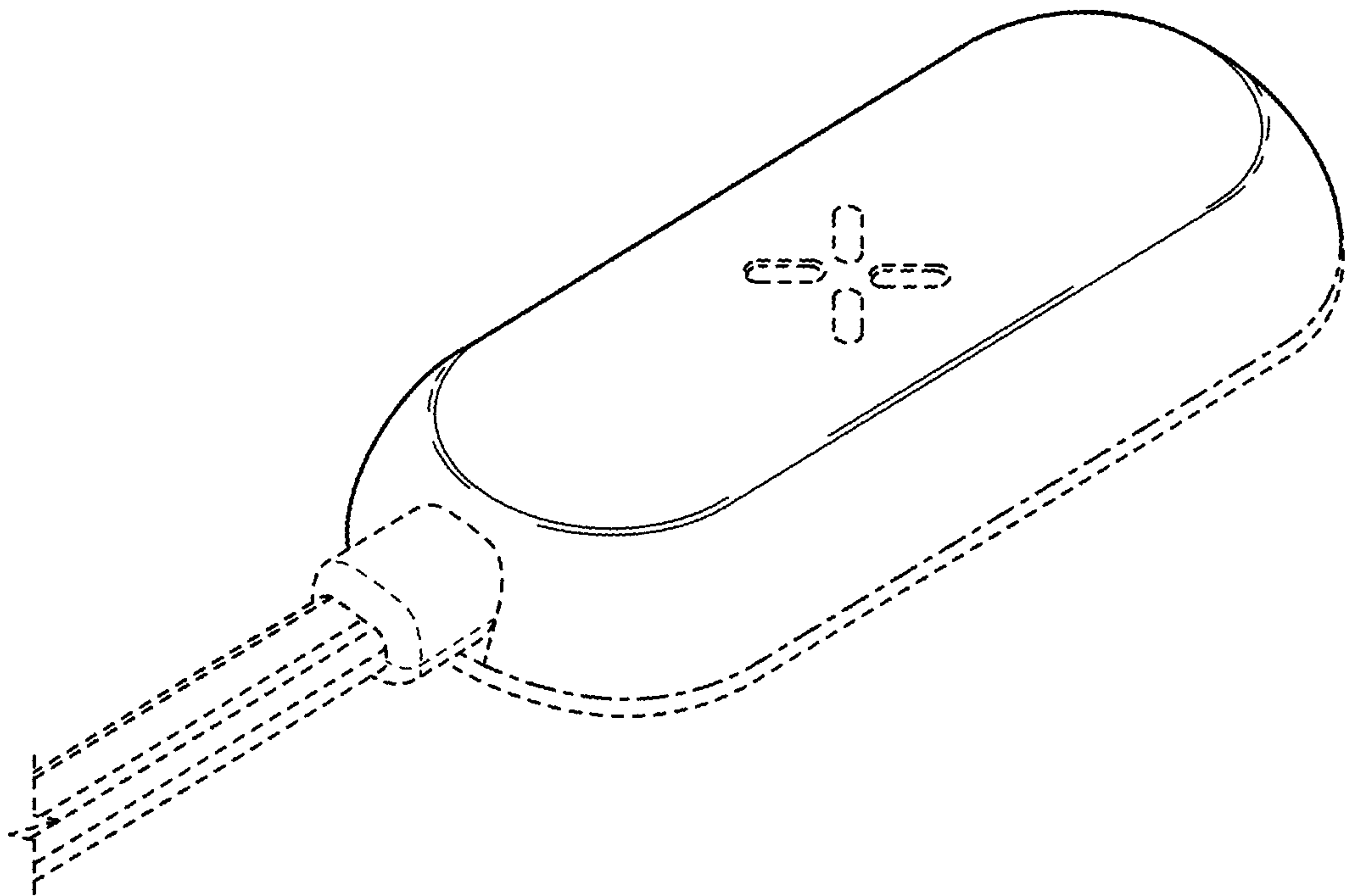

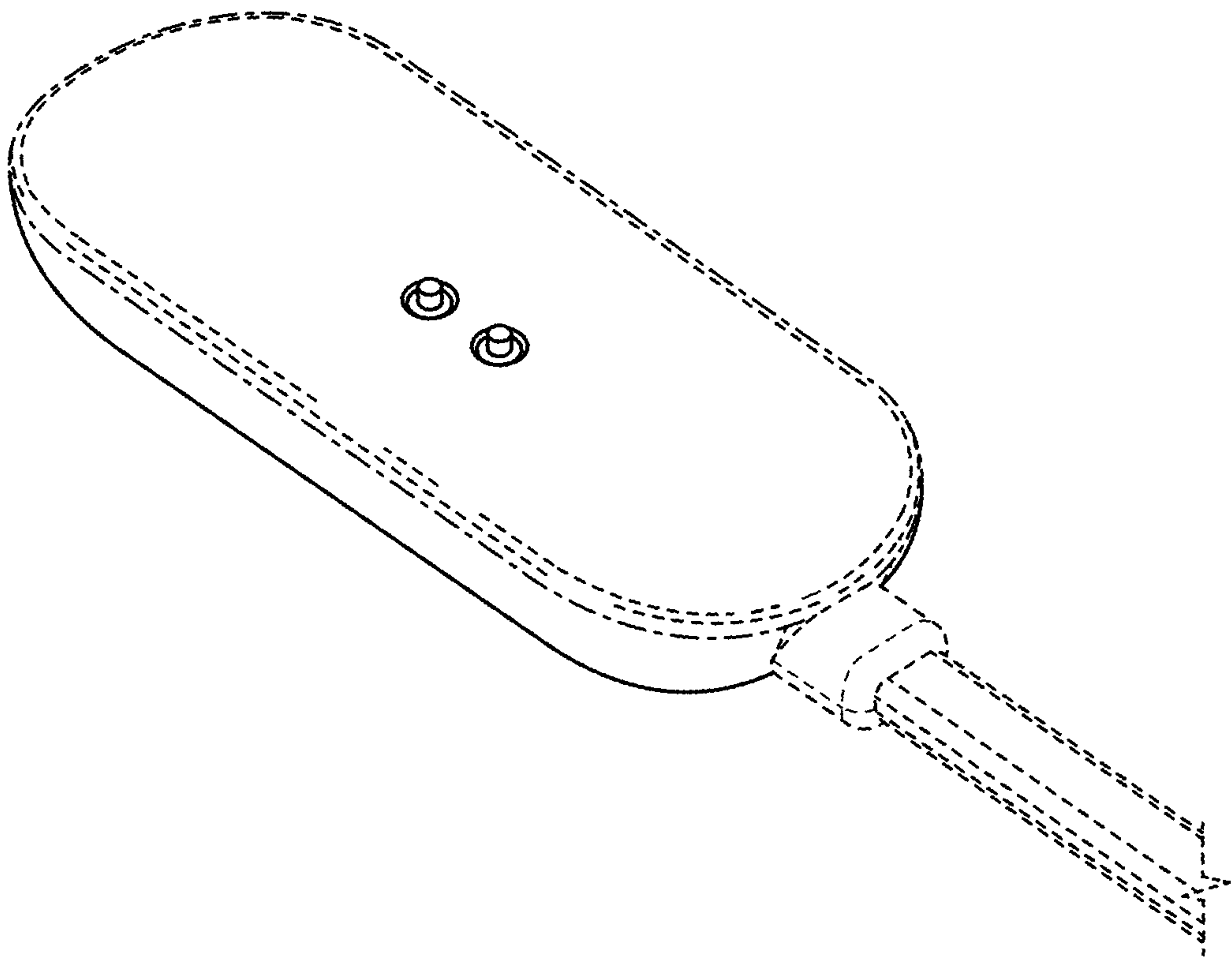

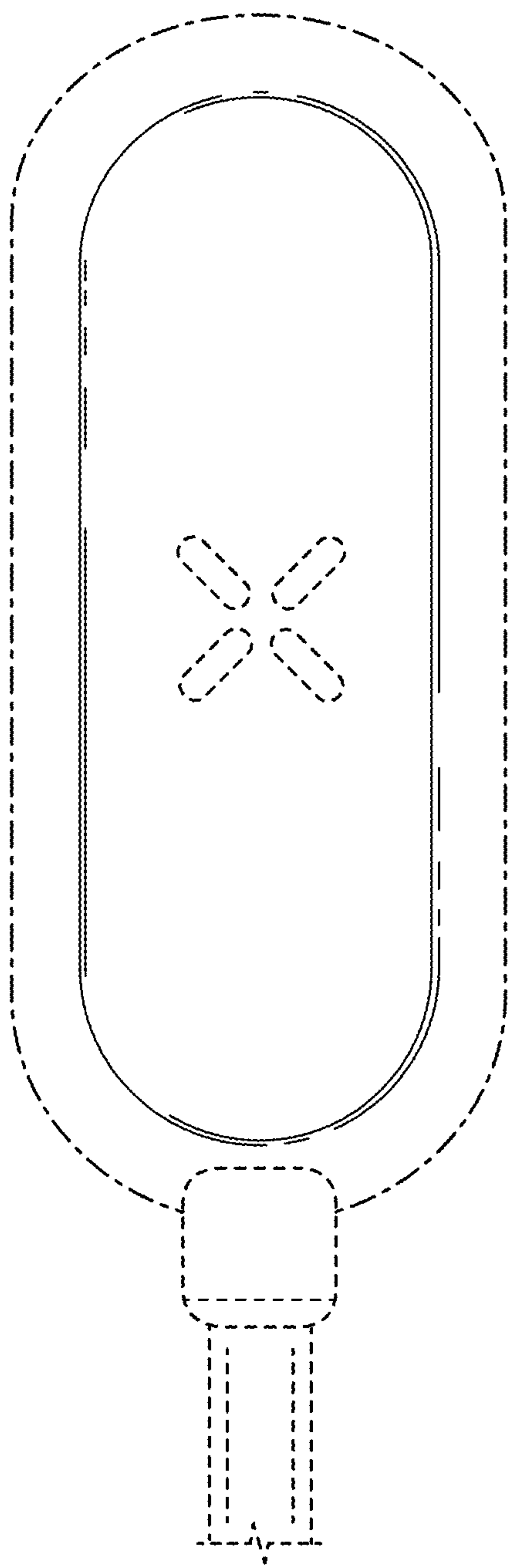

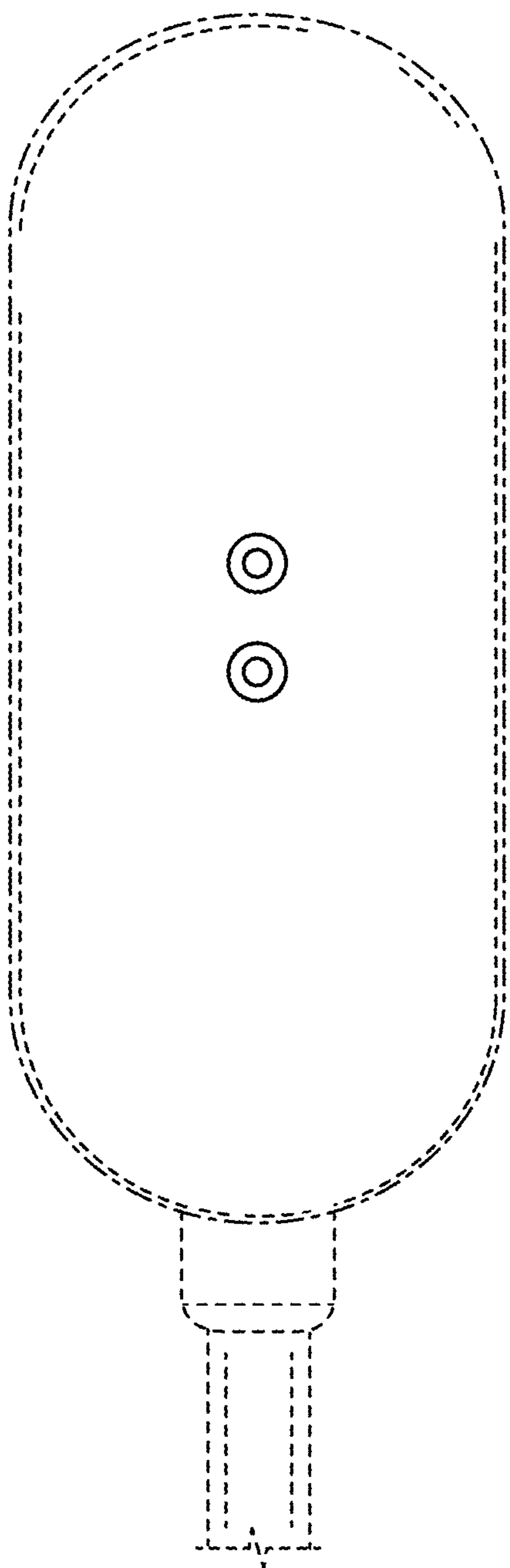

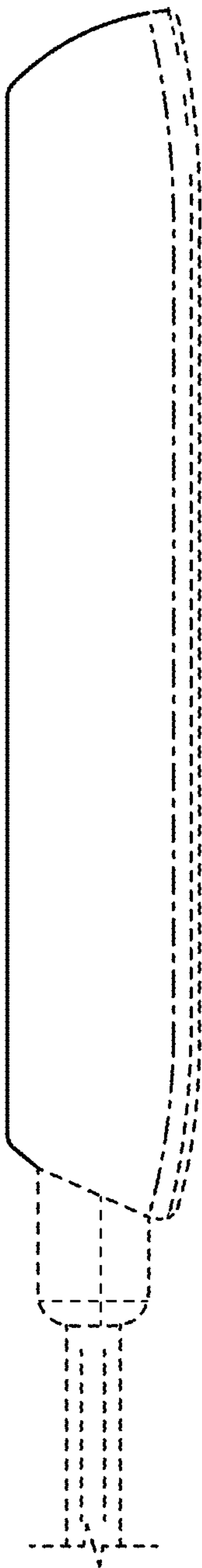

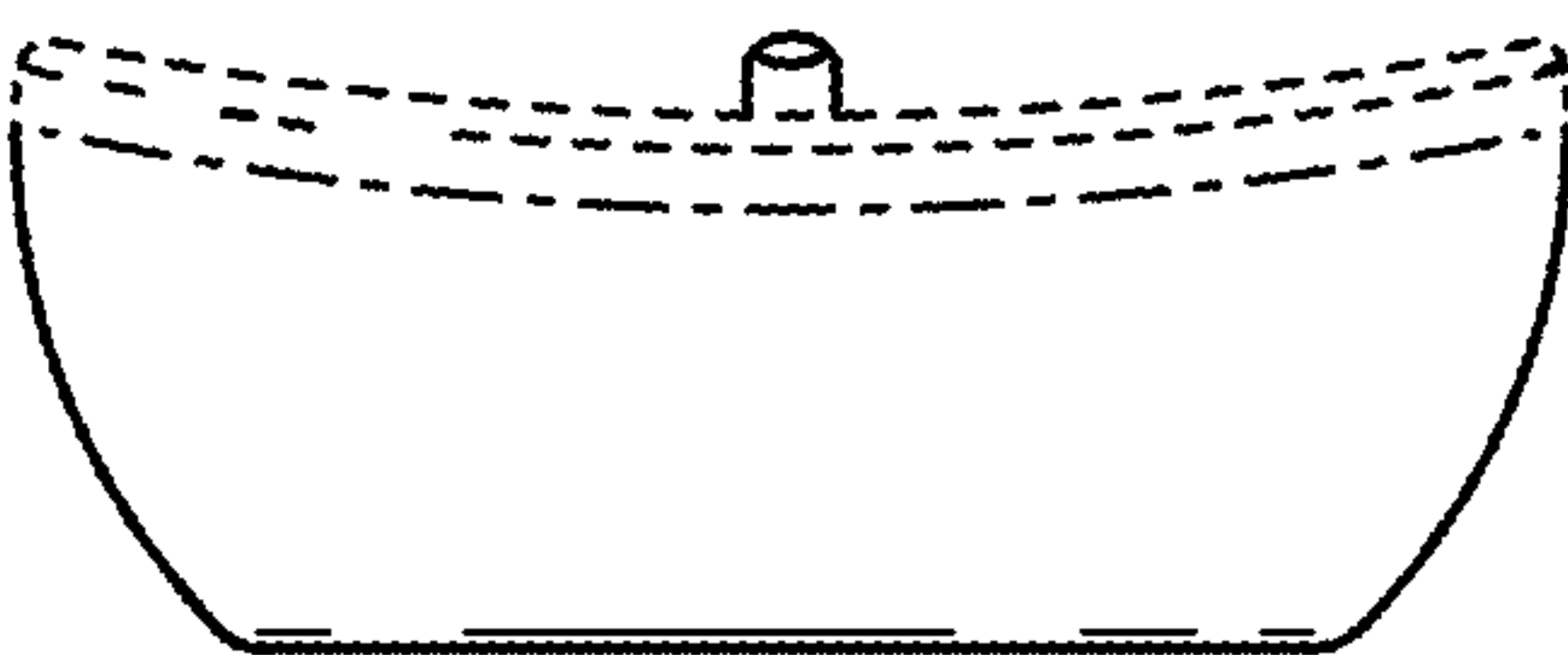

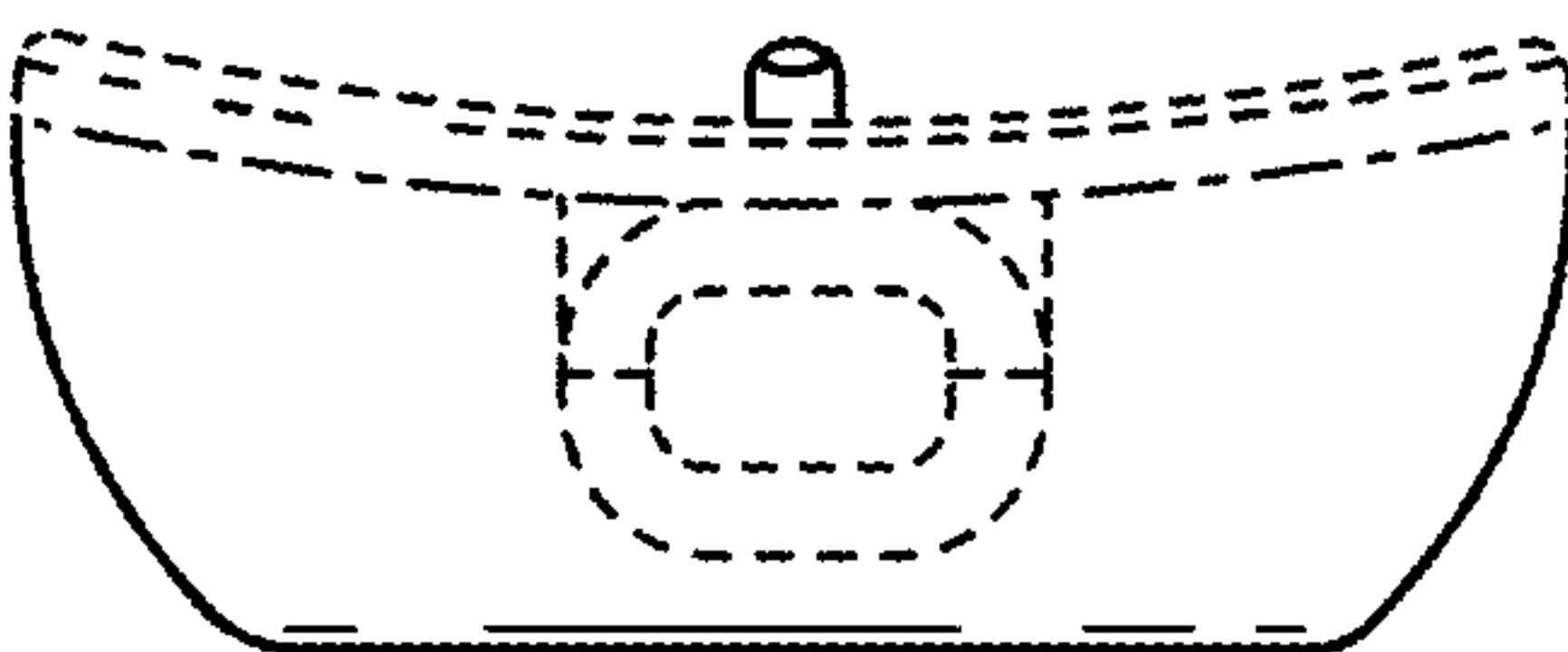

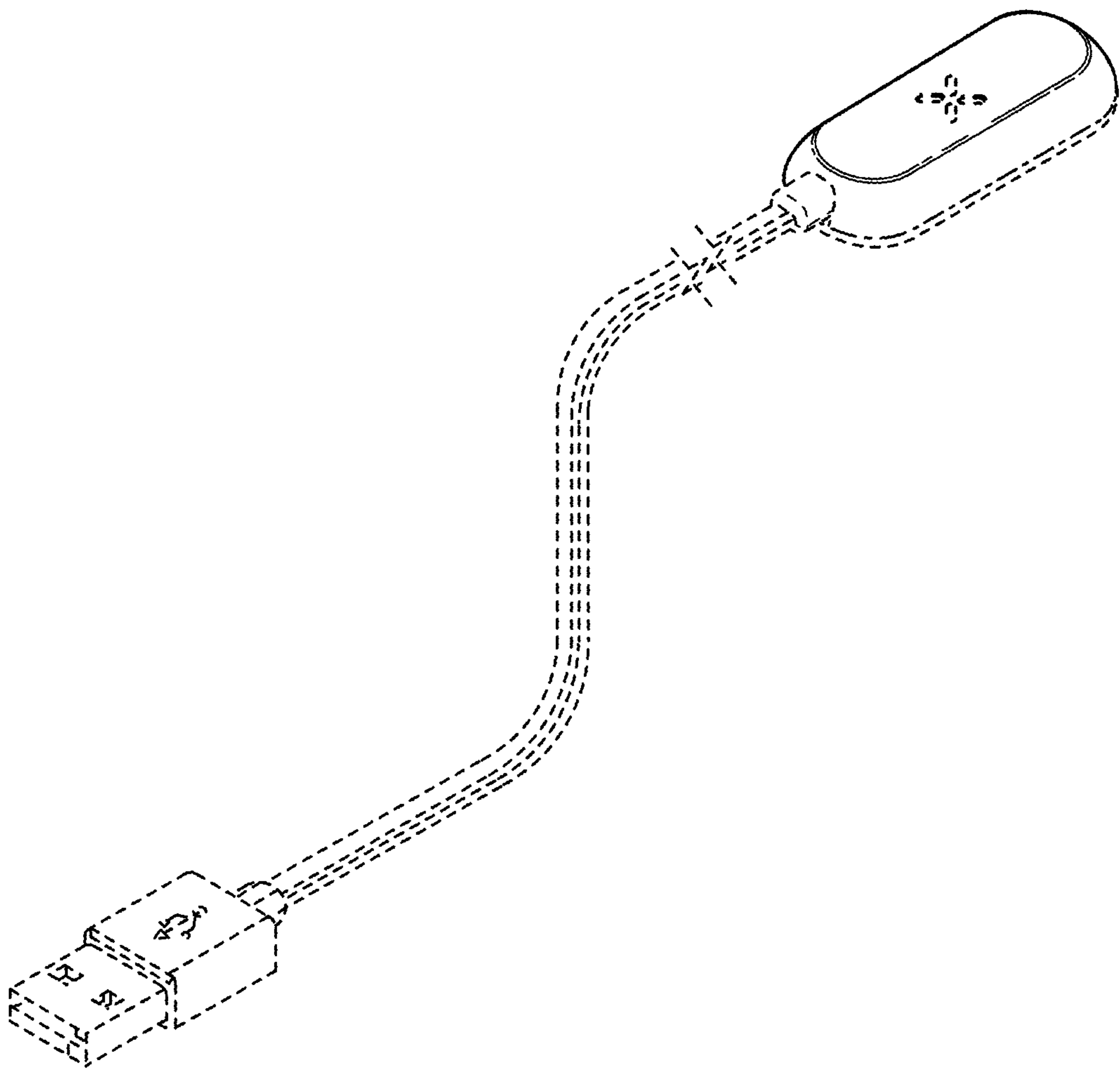

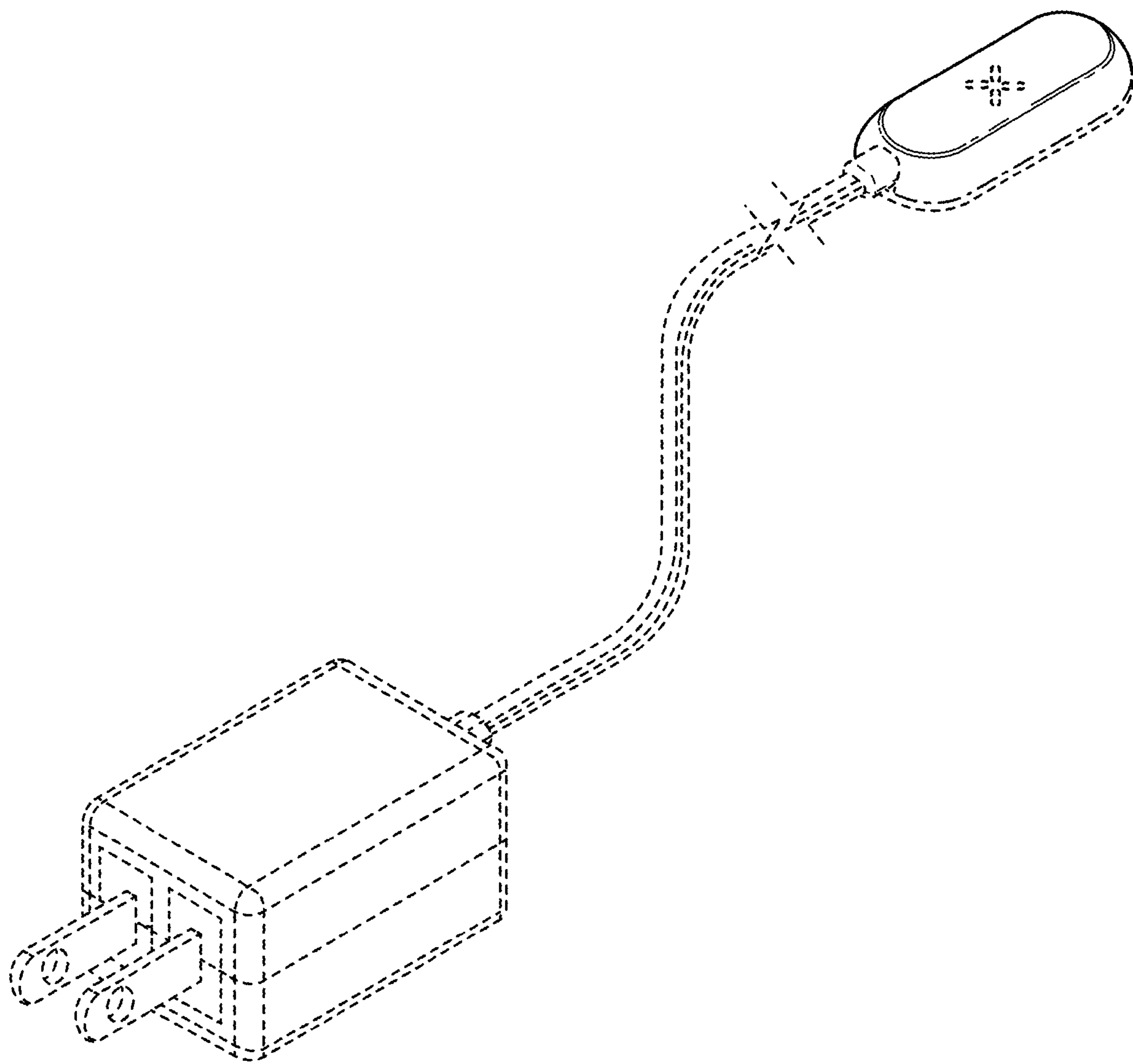

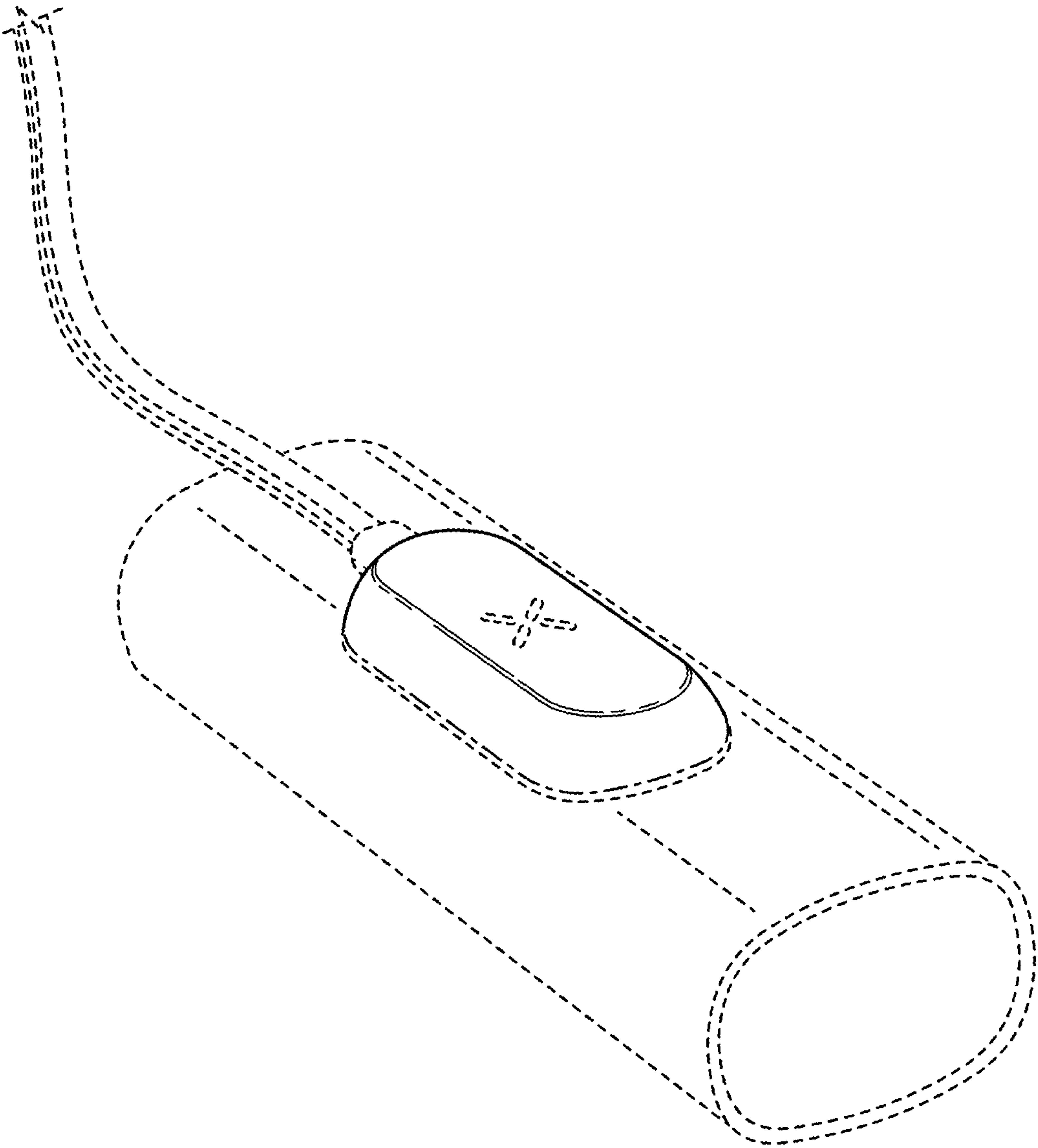
