FIG. 4 is a fourth view thereof;

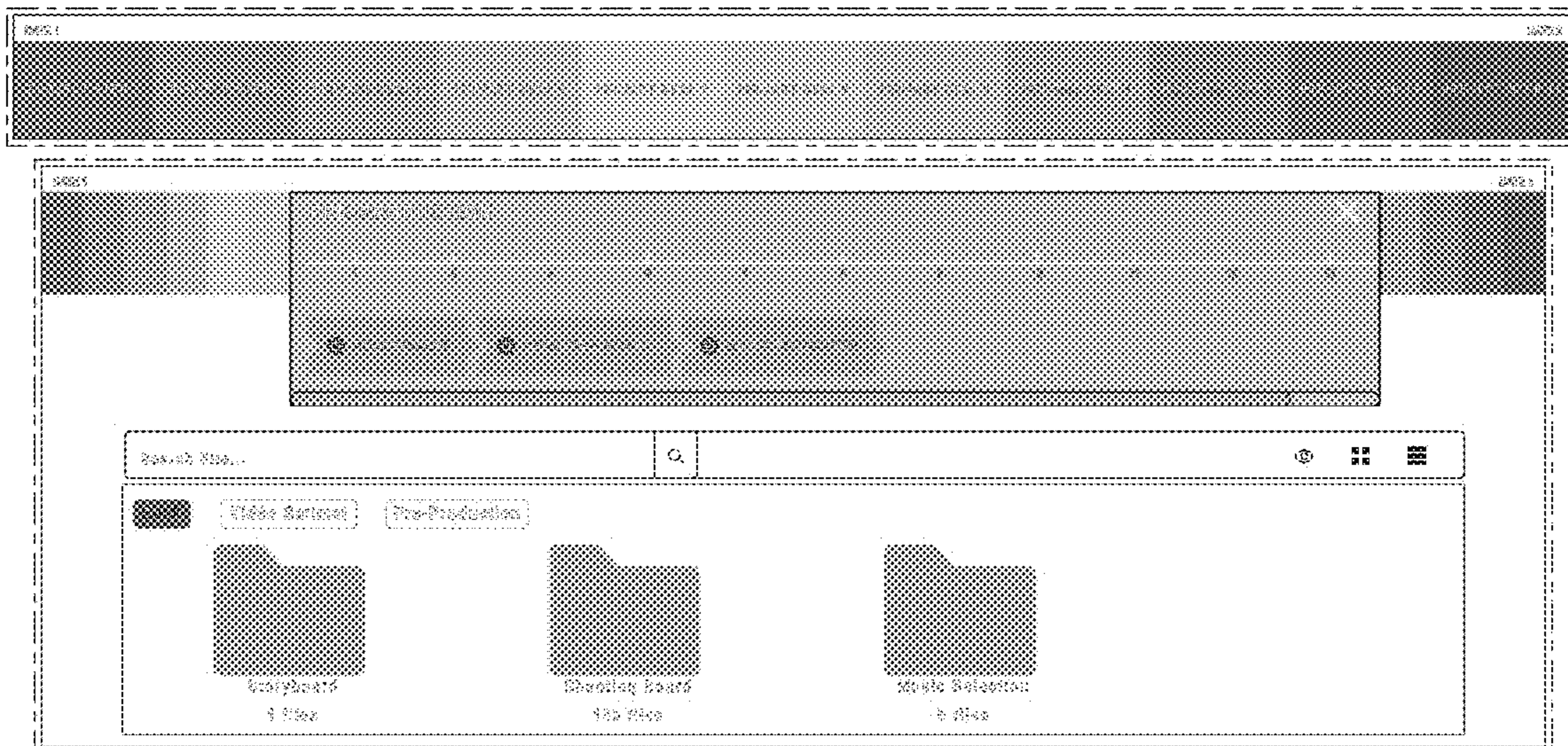
FIG. 5 is a fifth view thereof; and,

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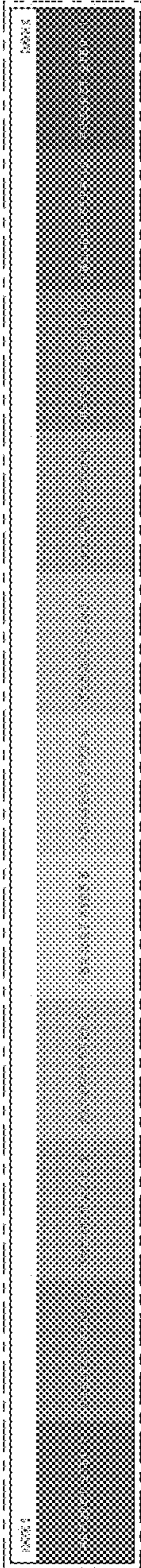

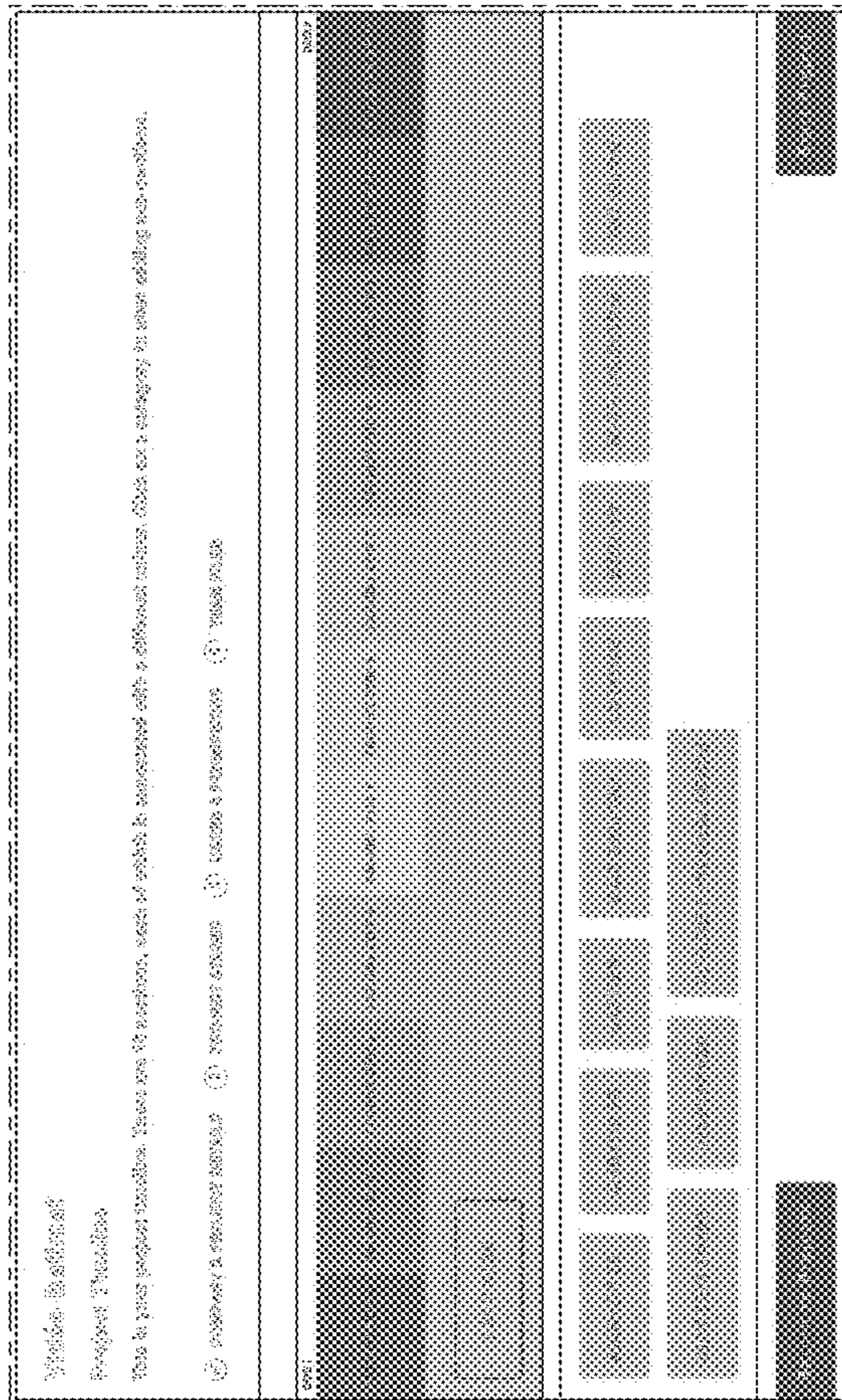

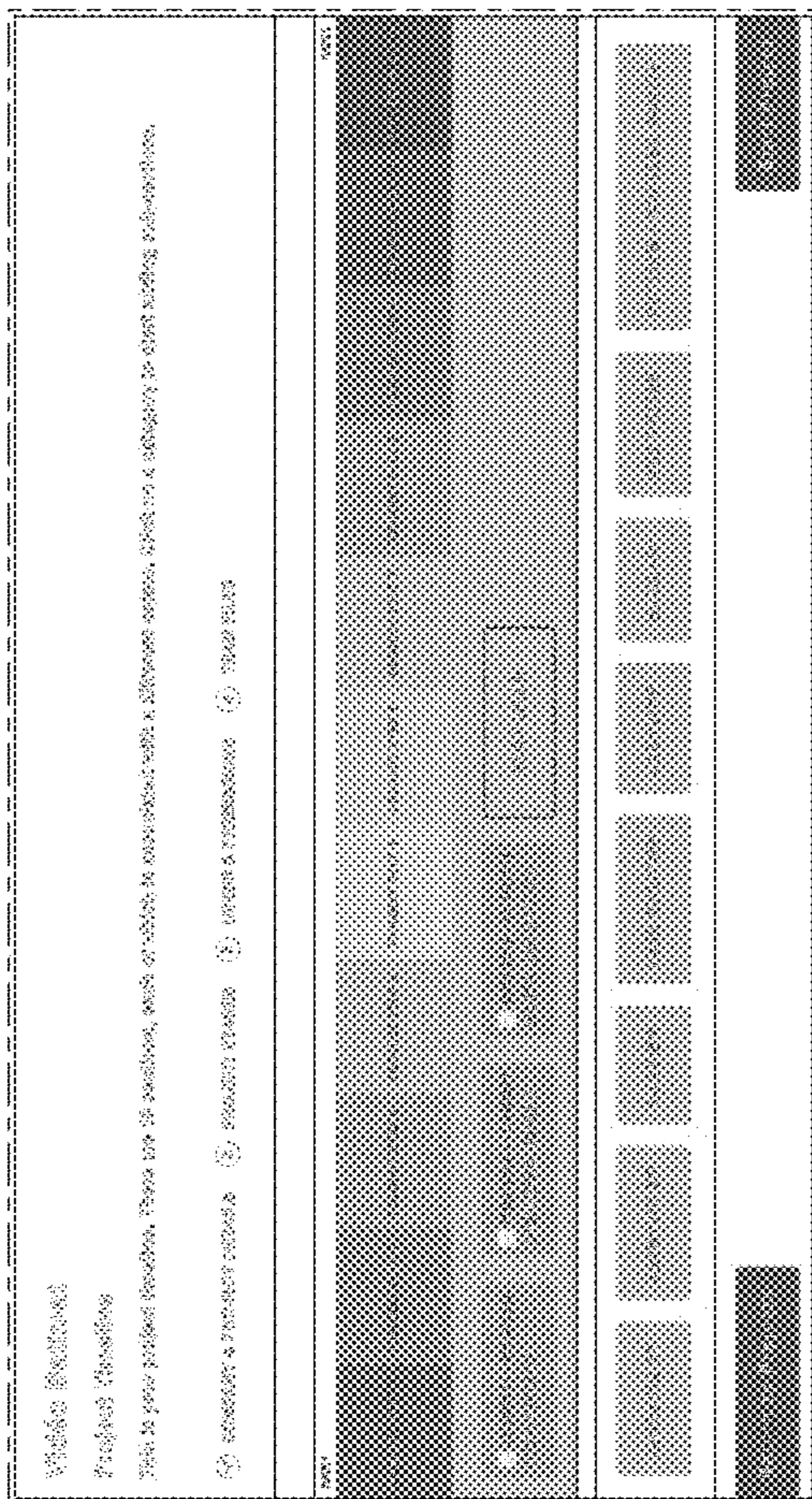

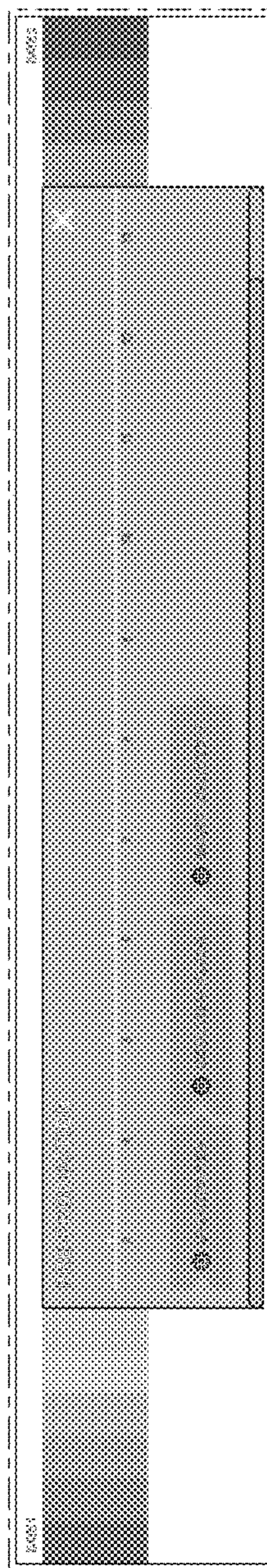

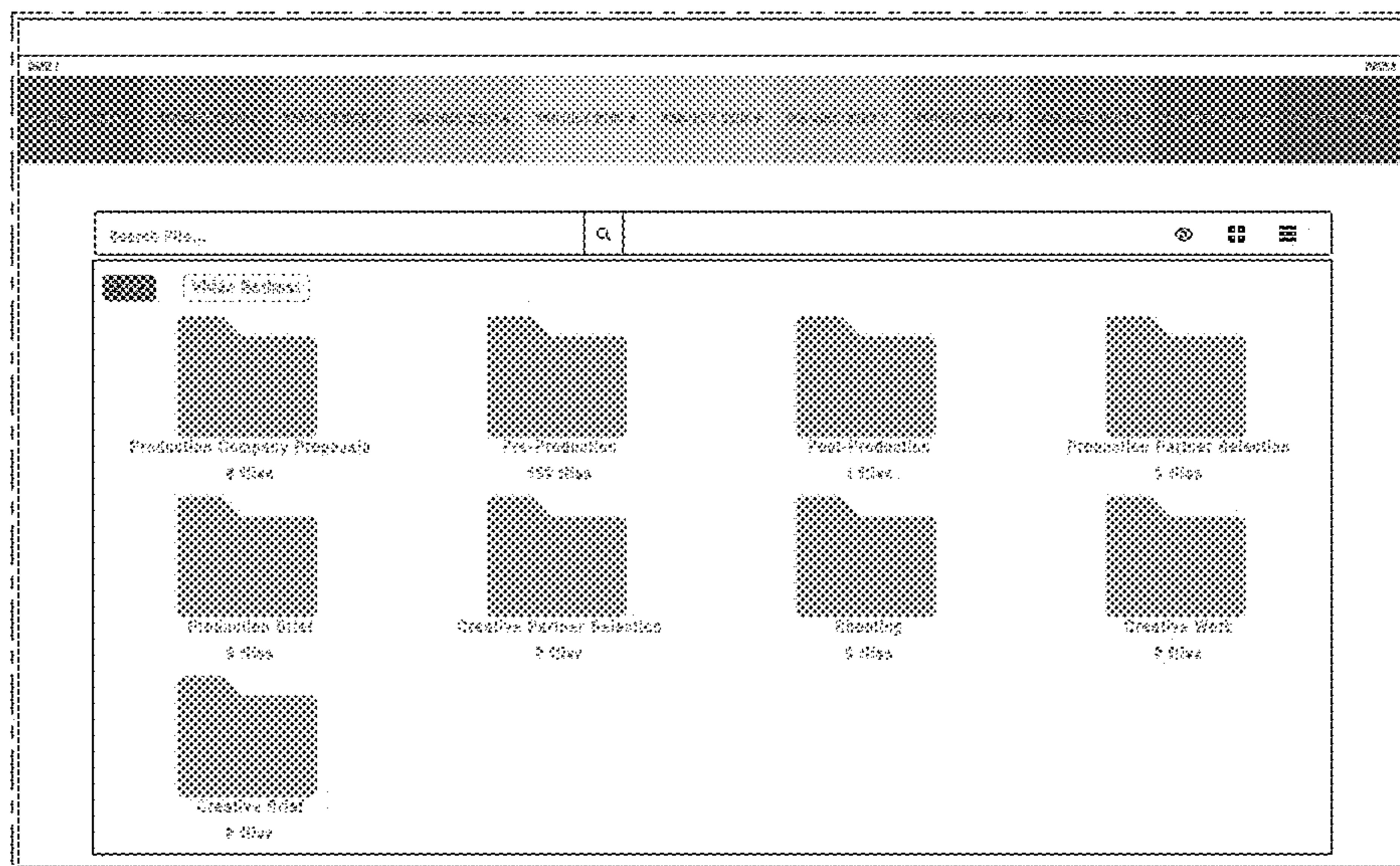

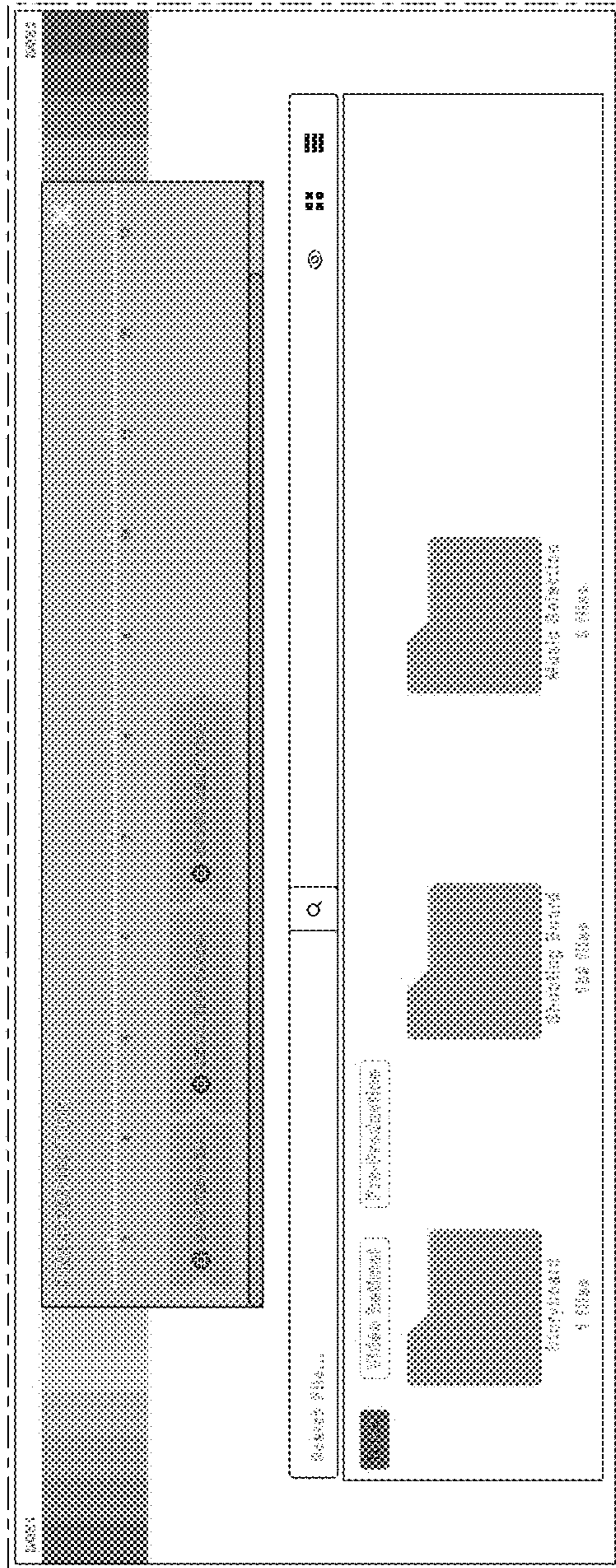
