FIG. 10 is a bottom view of my new design shown in FIG. 6.

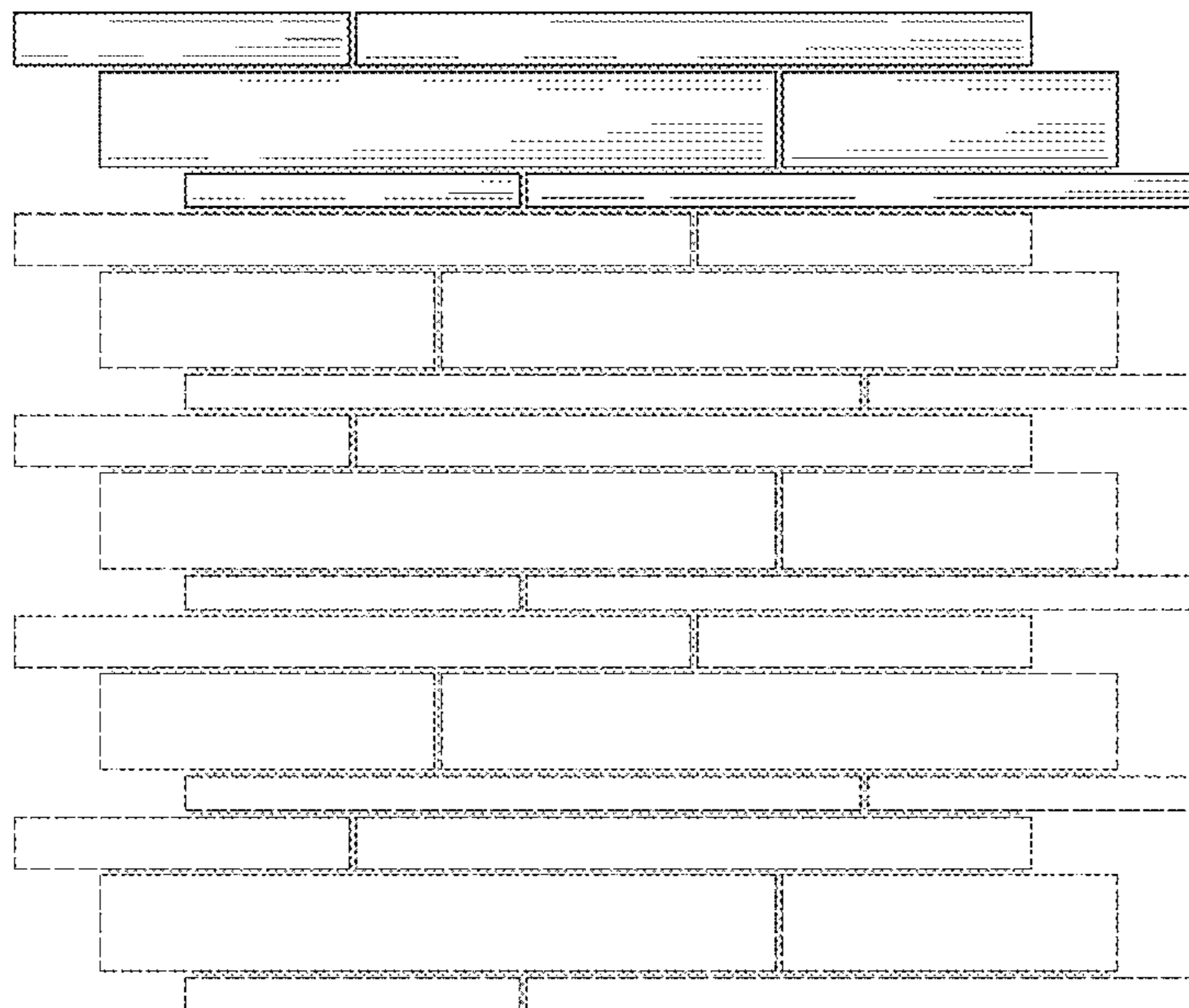
The broken lines showing the diagonal webbing connecting the individual tiles and the non-front surfaces of the tiles are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

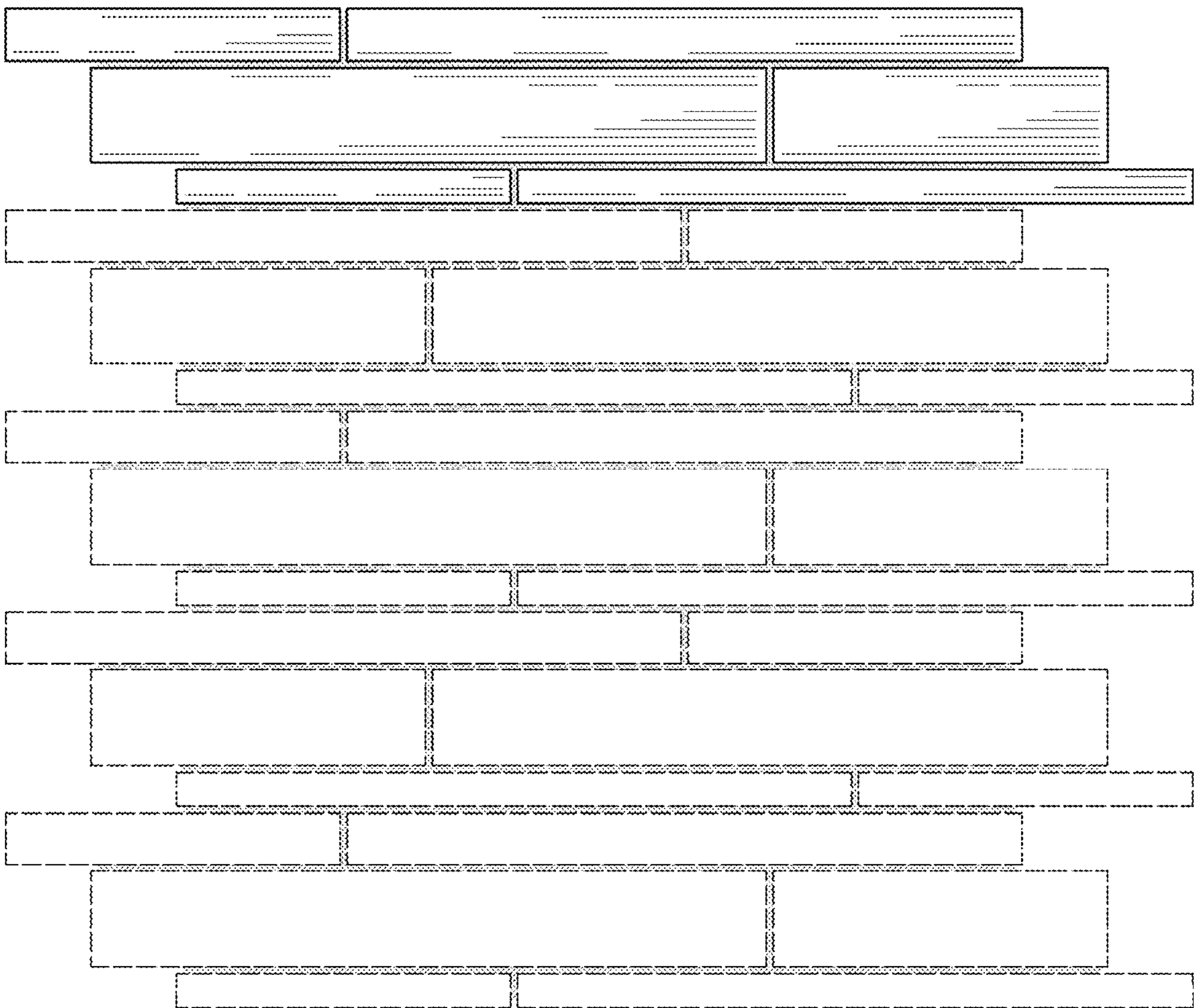

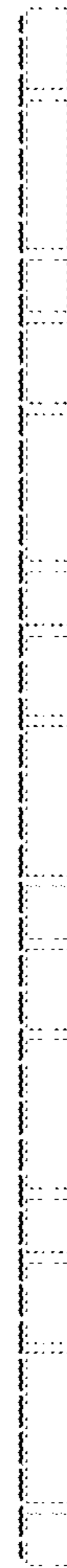

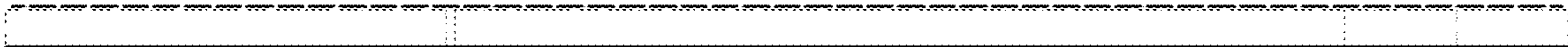

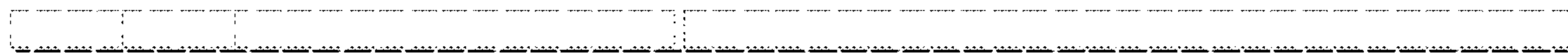

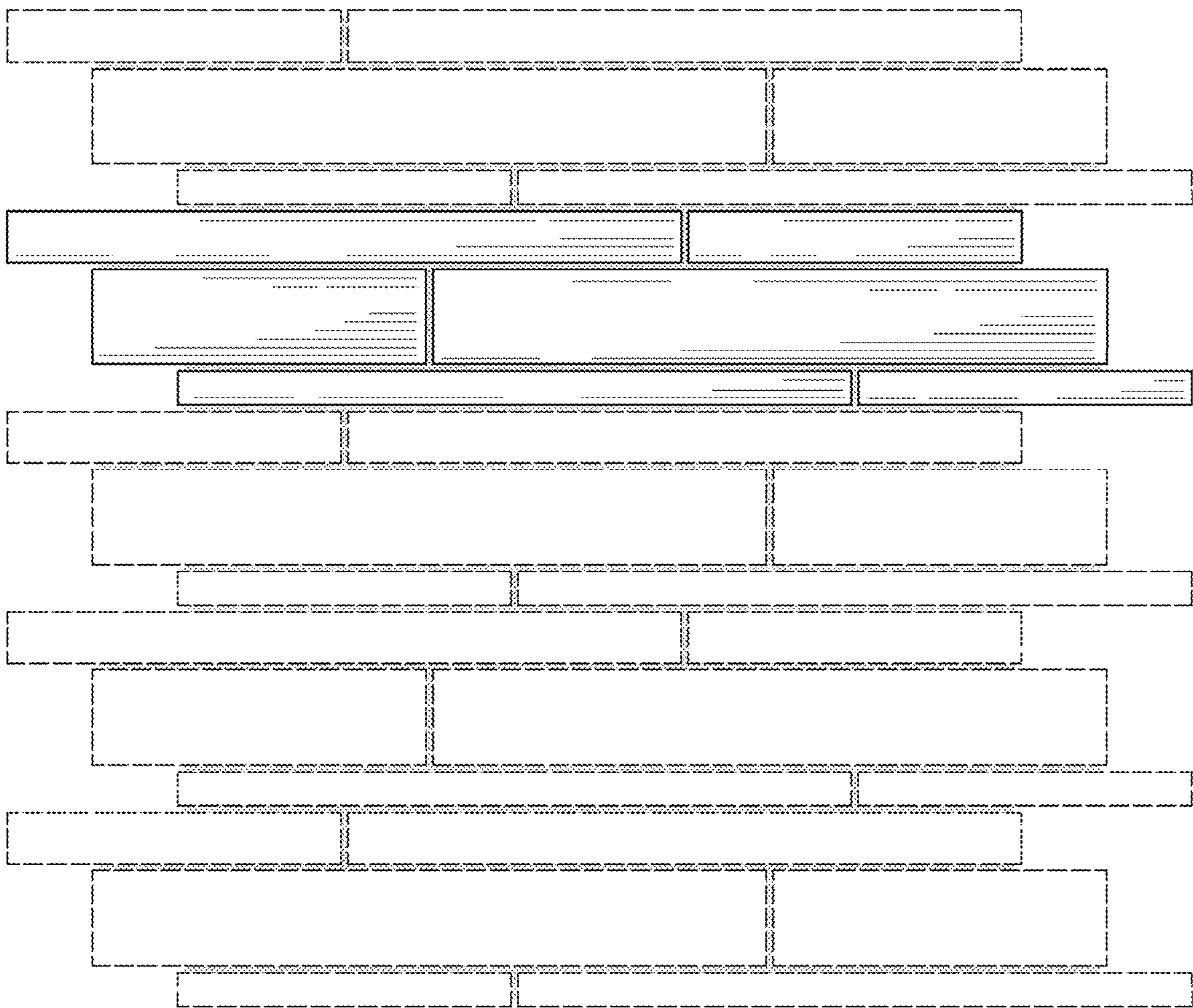

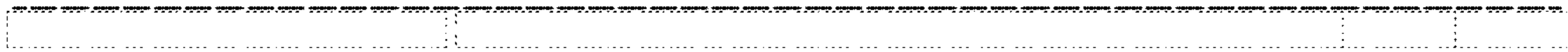

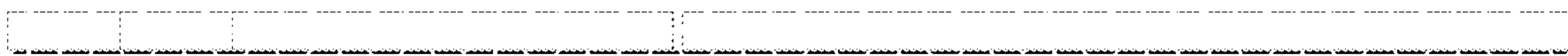
