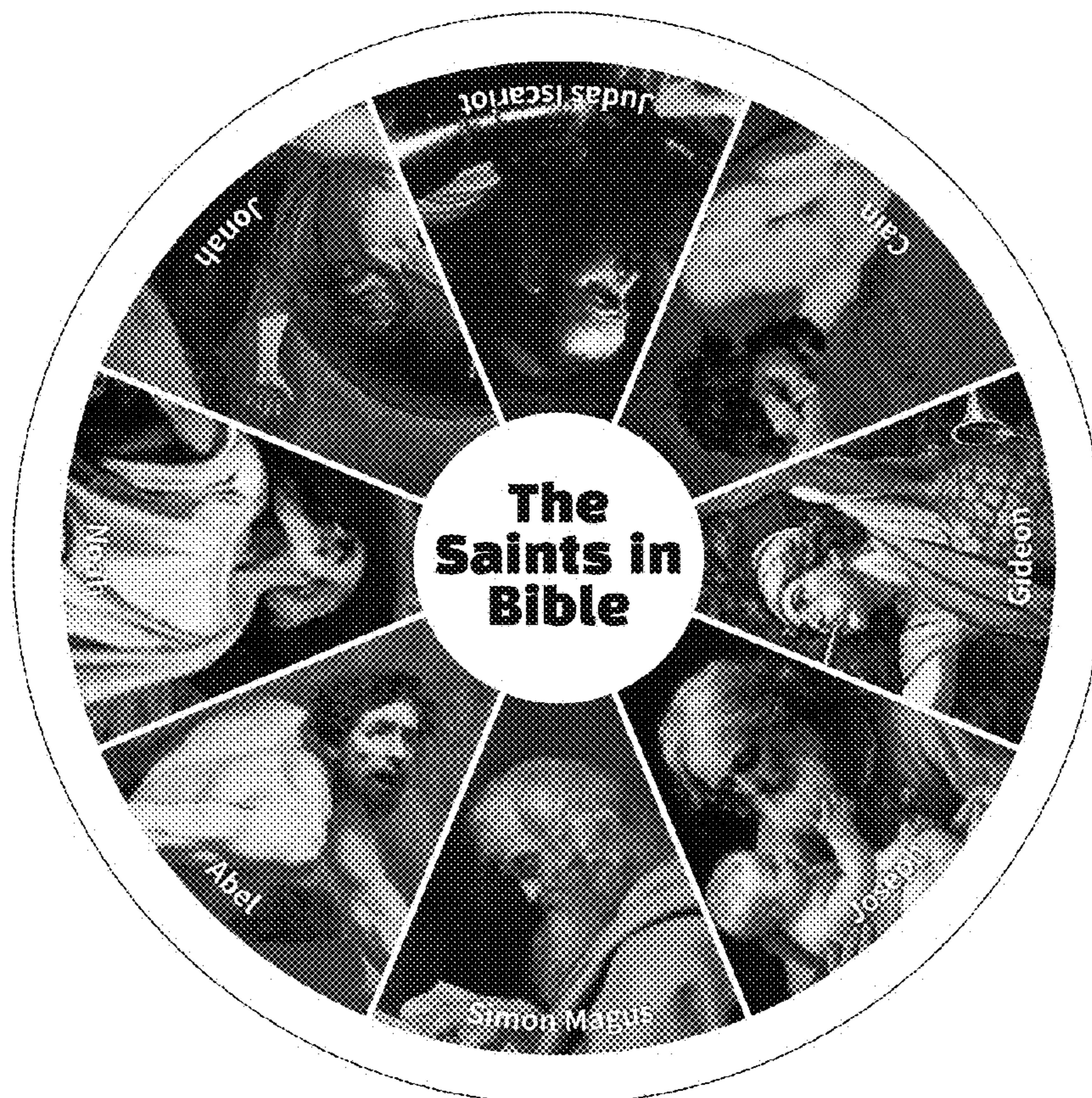

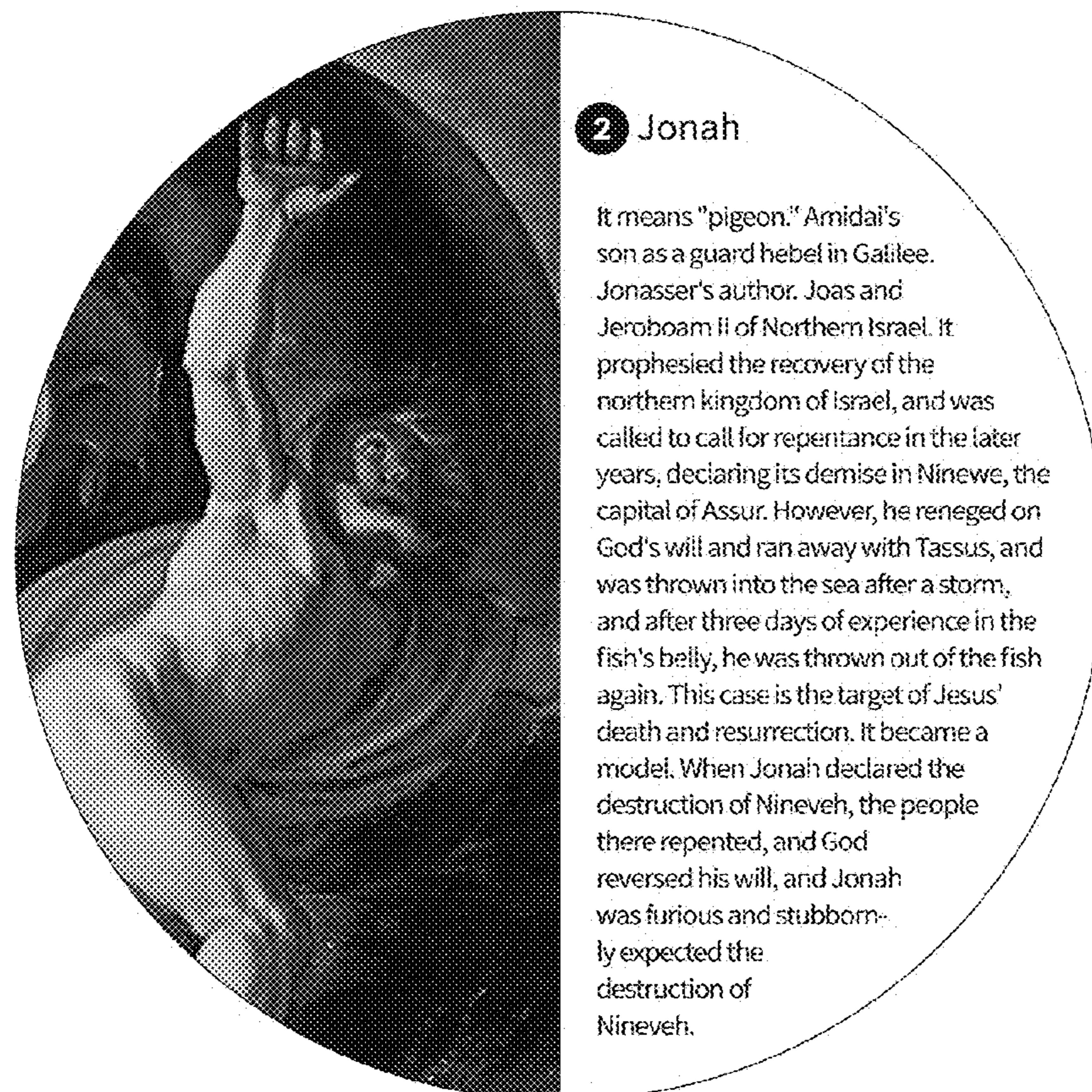

She was a foreign woman, but she was blessed with the birth of David and Jesus Christ through her descendants as a filial, hardworking, and obedient woman. Luigi was written to shed light on his life and the genealogy of Jesus Christ, which is also a technique of peaceful rural life during the Sasae Period. Goethe pointed to Rugi, saying, "The legend is the most favored cattle rural city that exists in us."

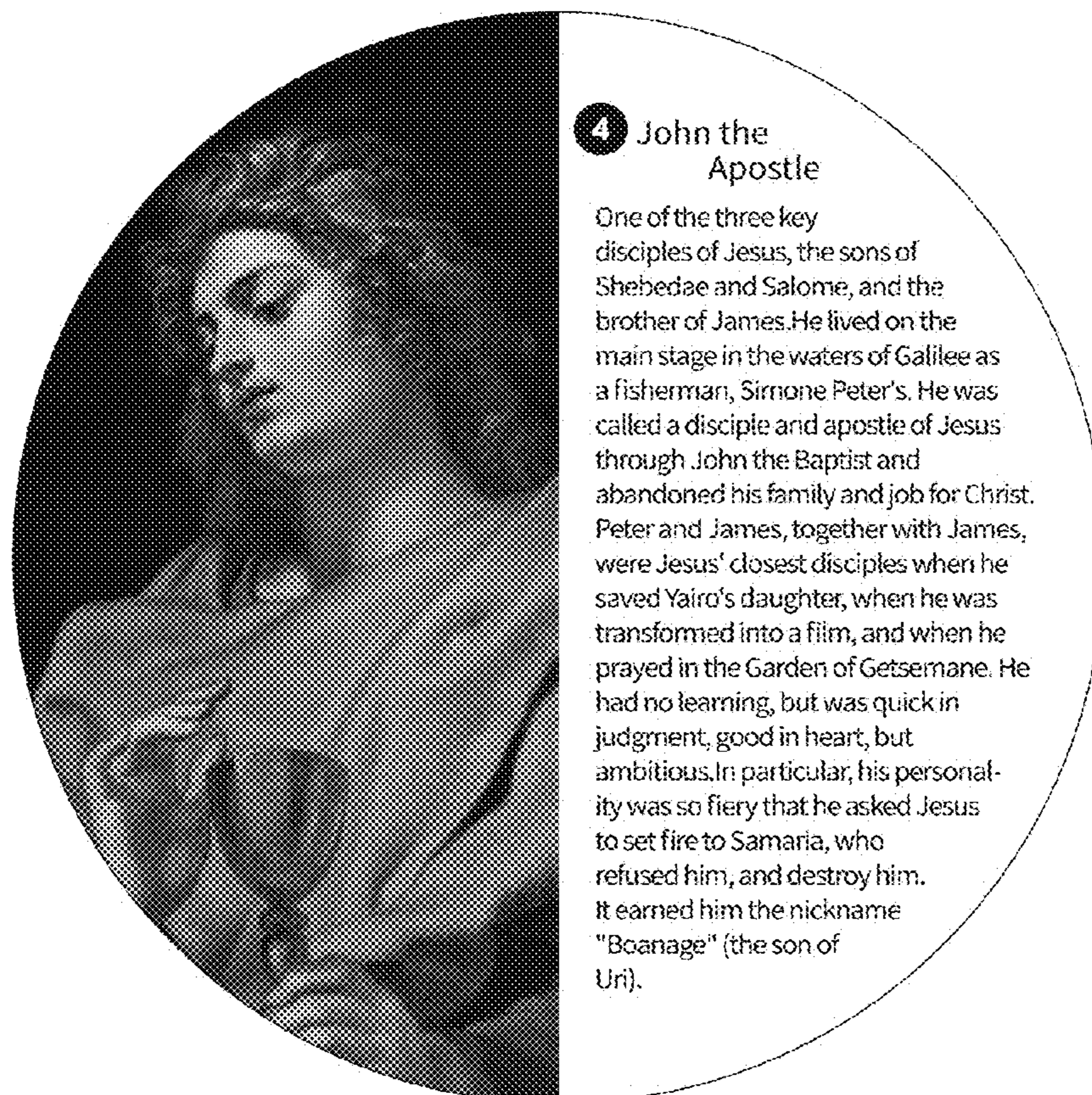

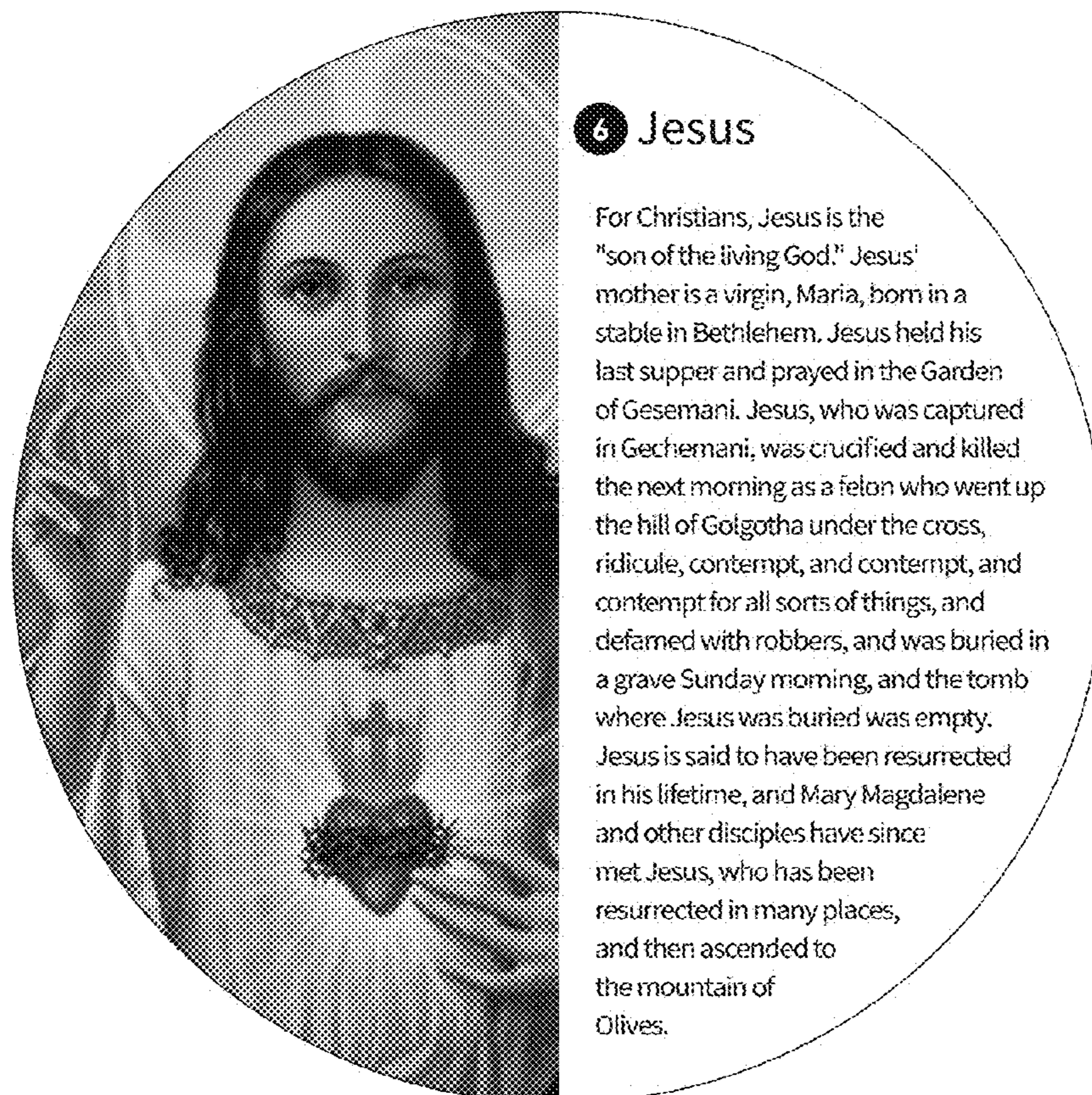

He was the wife of Uriah, a Hittite, but she was pregnant through affection with David, who had fallen in love with her beauty. Later, in David's plot, his husband died in battle and became David's wife. The first son, who was born between David, died by God's punishment, and later gave birth to four sons: Shimea, Zobab, Nathan and Solomon. In David's later years, when Adonijah the prince aimed at the throne and planned a rebellion, he and Nathan, the prophet, stopped it and succeeded in making his son Solomon his successor. In the New Testament, it is introduced as Uriah's wife in the genealogy of Jesus Christ.

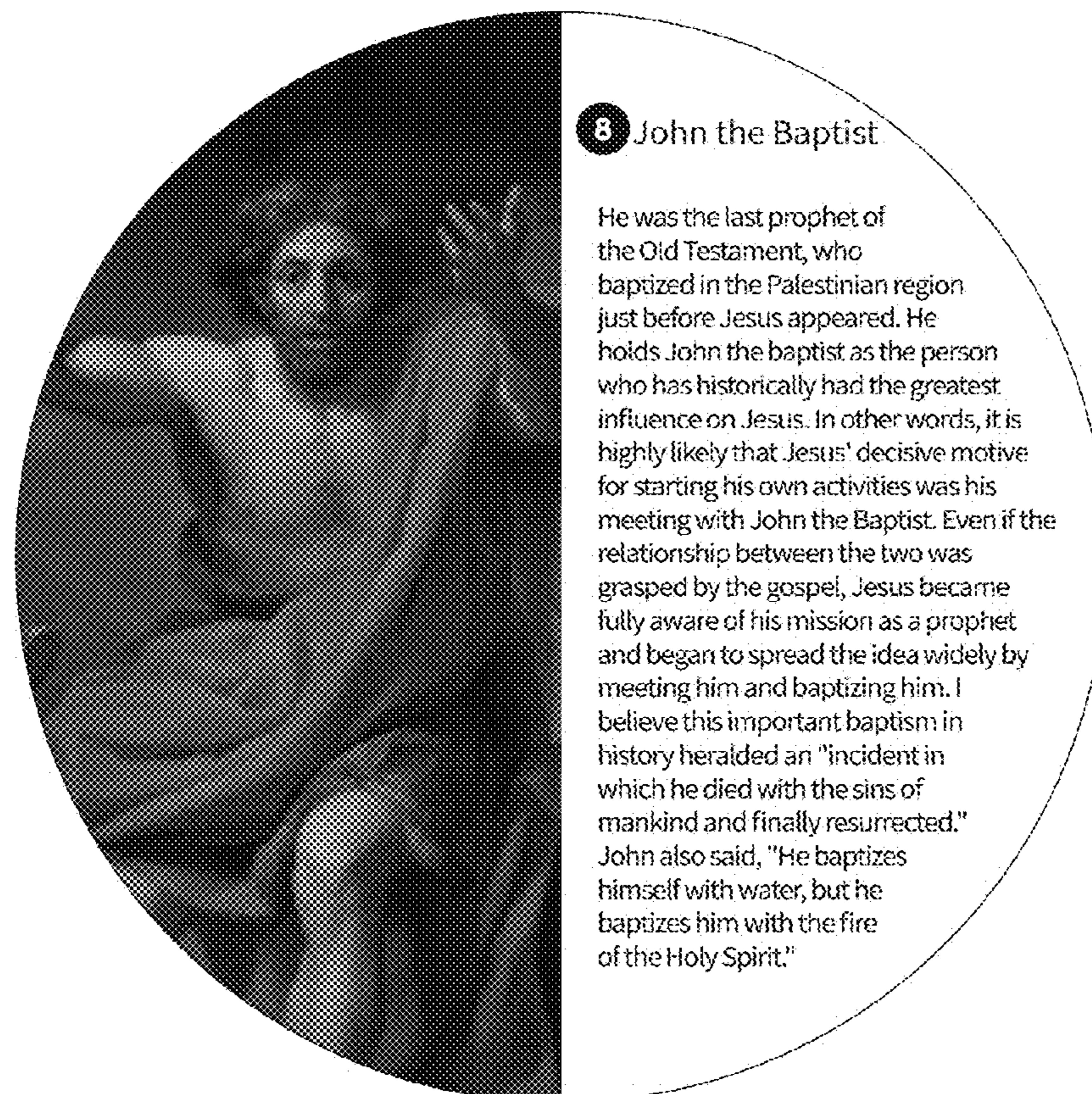

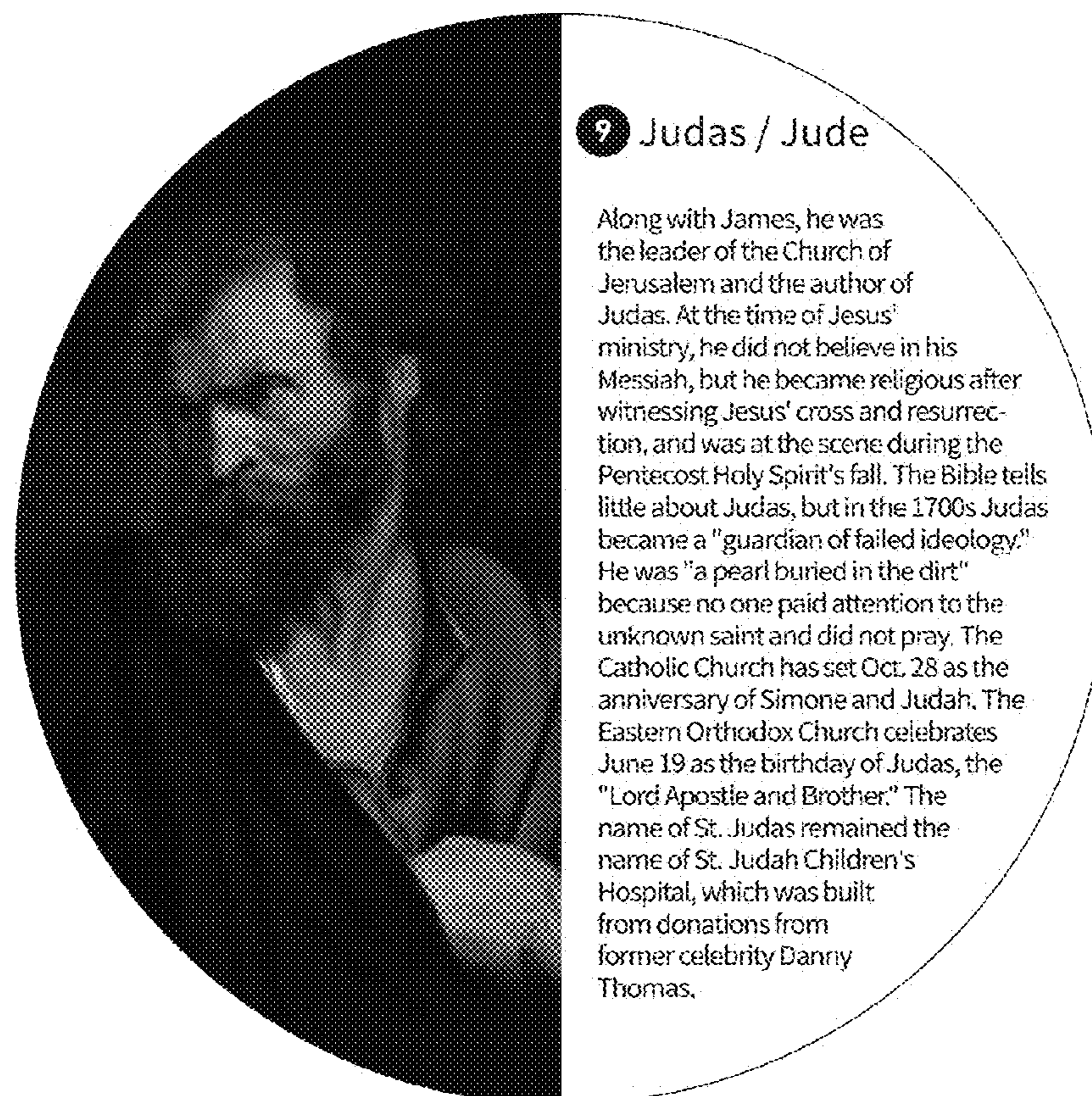
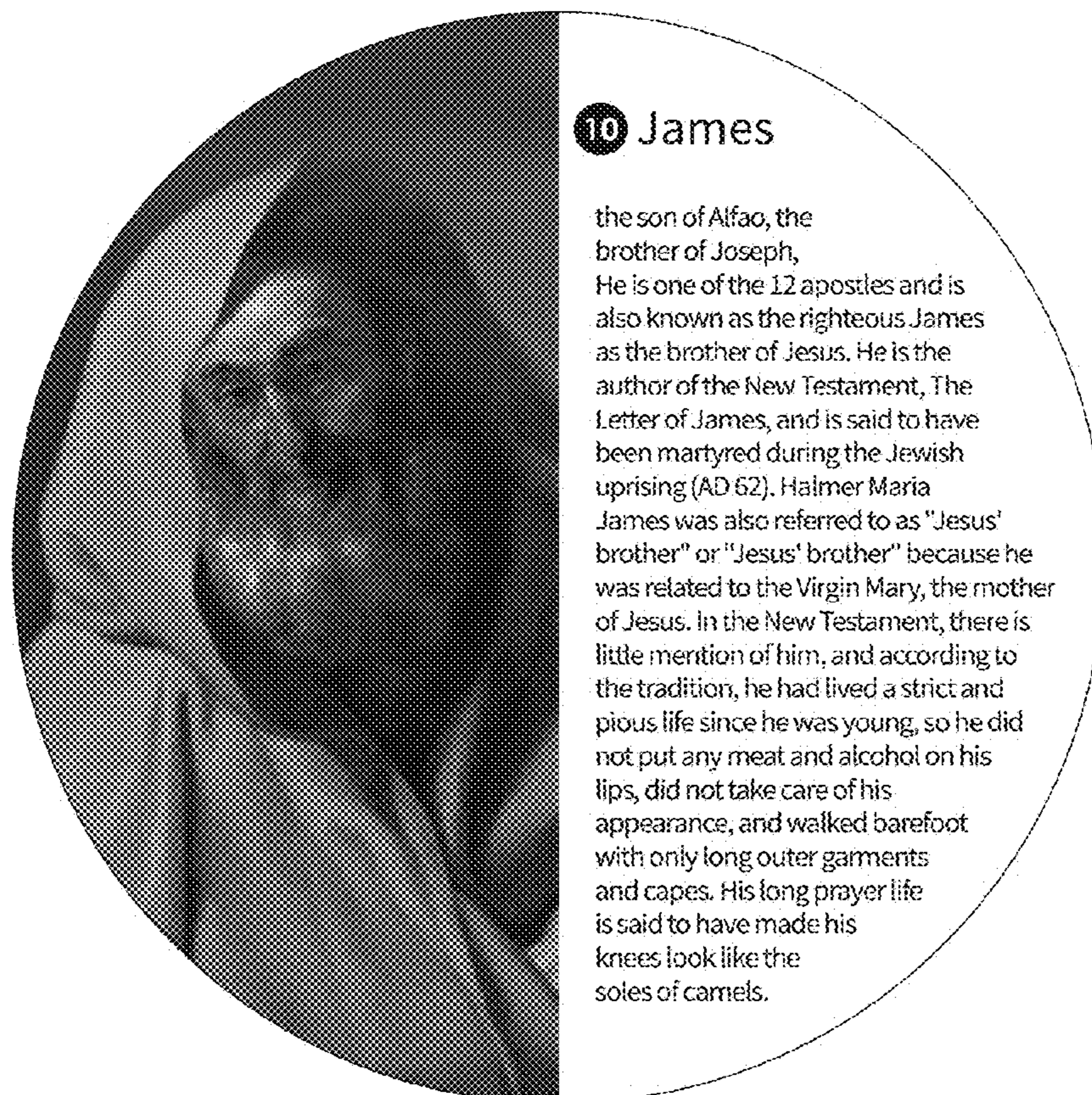

the son of Alfac, the brother of Joseph, He is one of the 12 apostles and is also known as the righteous James as the brother of Jesus. Halmer Maria James was also referred to as "Jesus' brother" or "Jesus' brother" because he was related to the Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus. In the New Testament, there is little mention of him, and according to the tradition, he had lived a strict and pious life since he was young, so he did not put any meat and alcohol on his lips, did not take care of his appearance, and walked barefoot with only long outer garments and capes. His long prayer life is said to have made his knees look like the soles of camels.

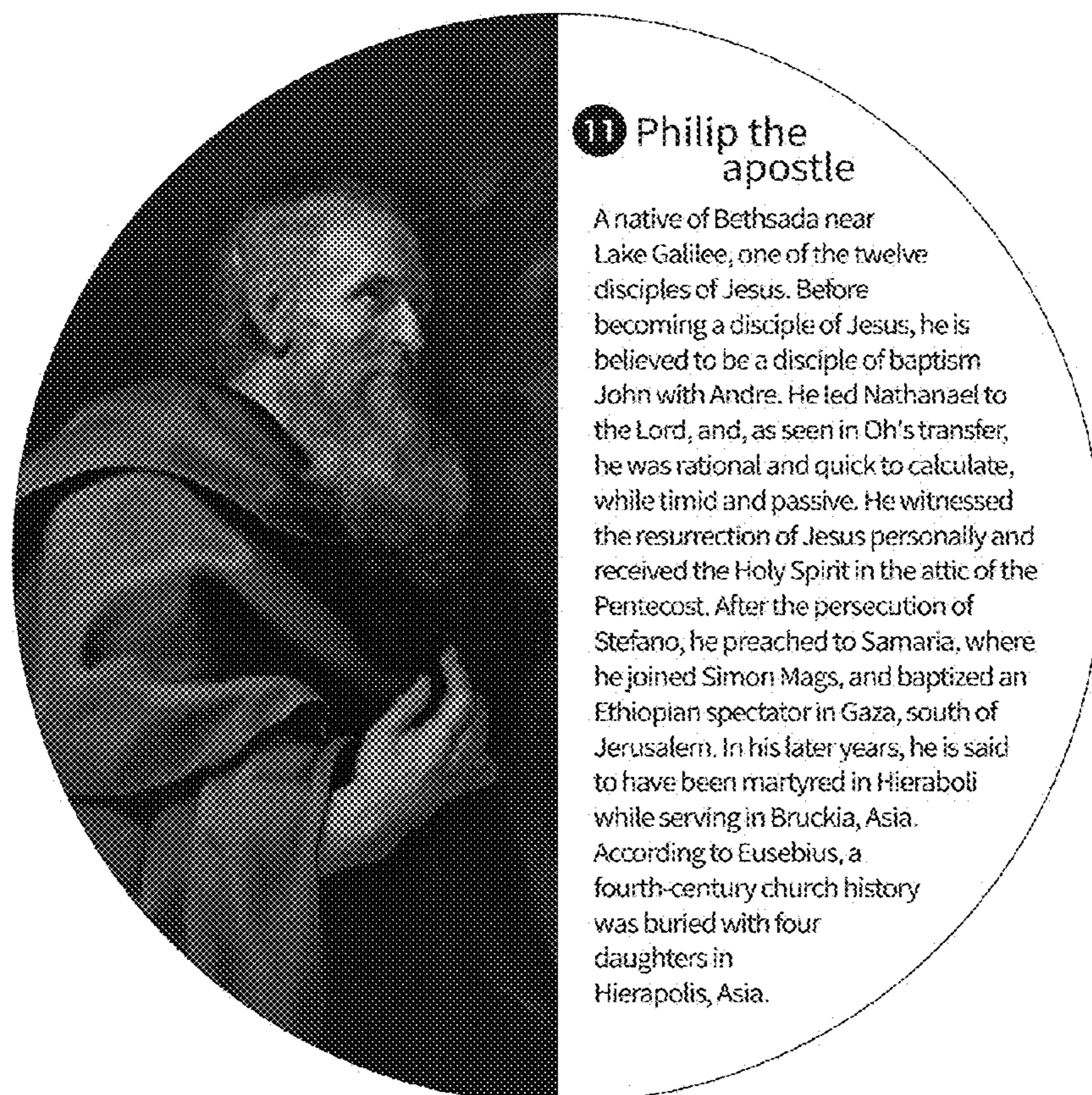

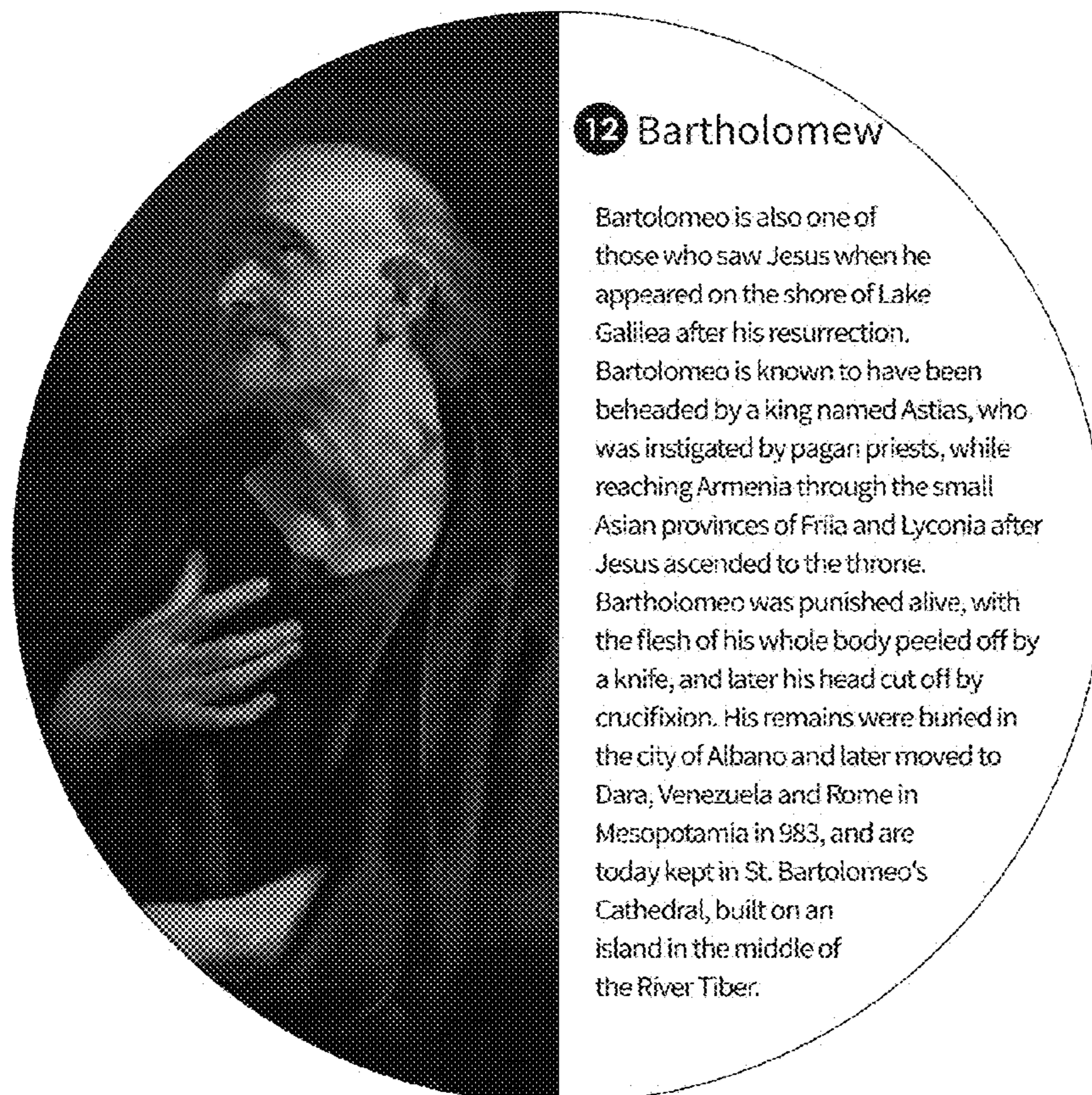

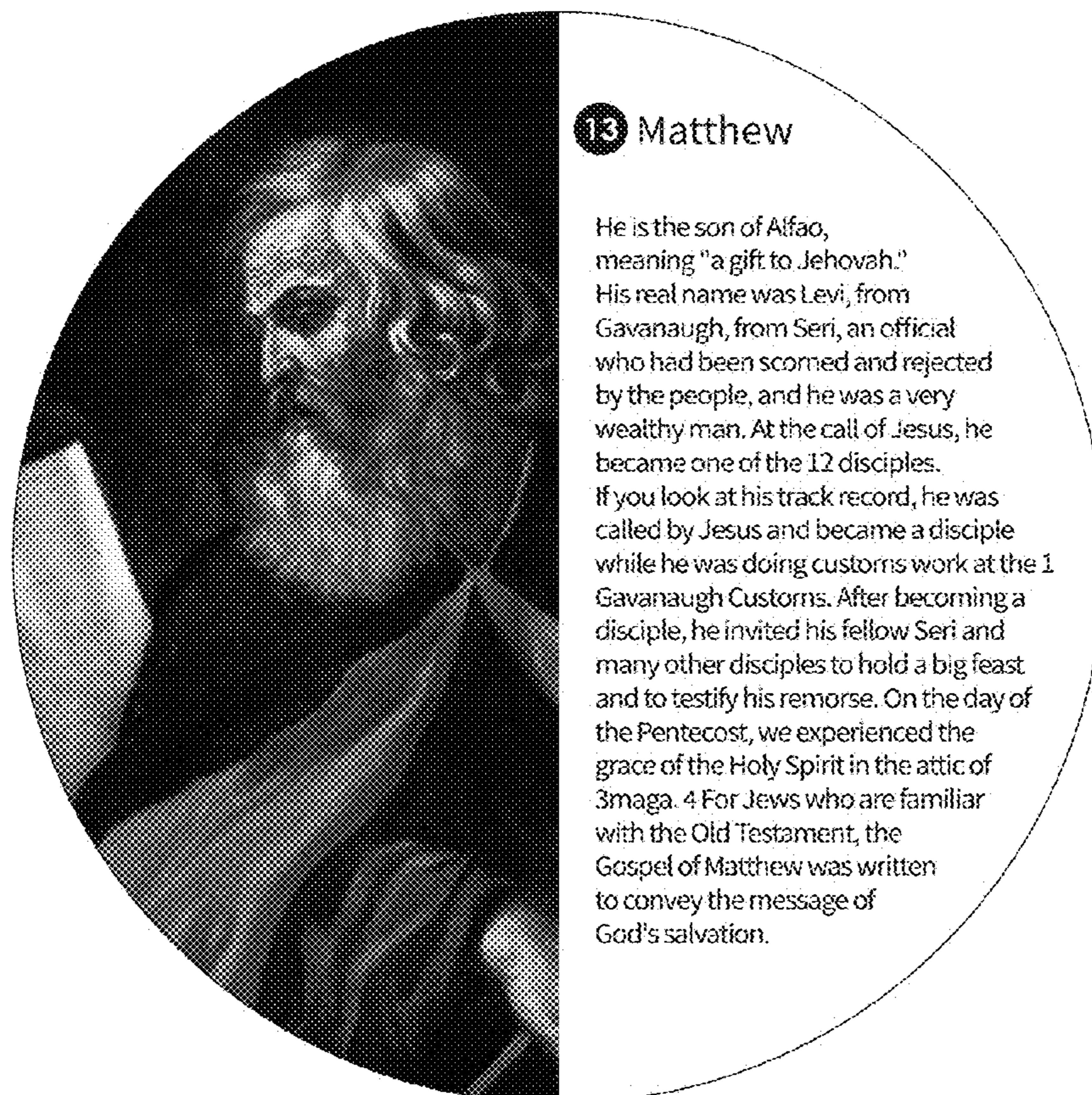

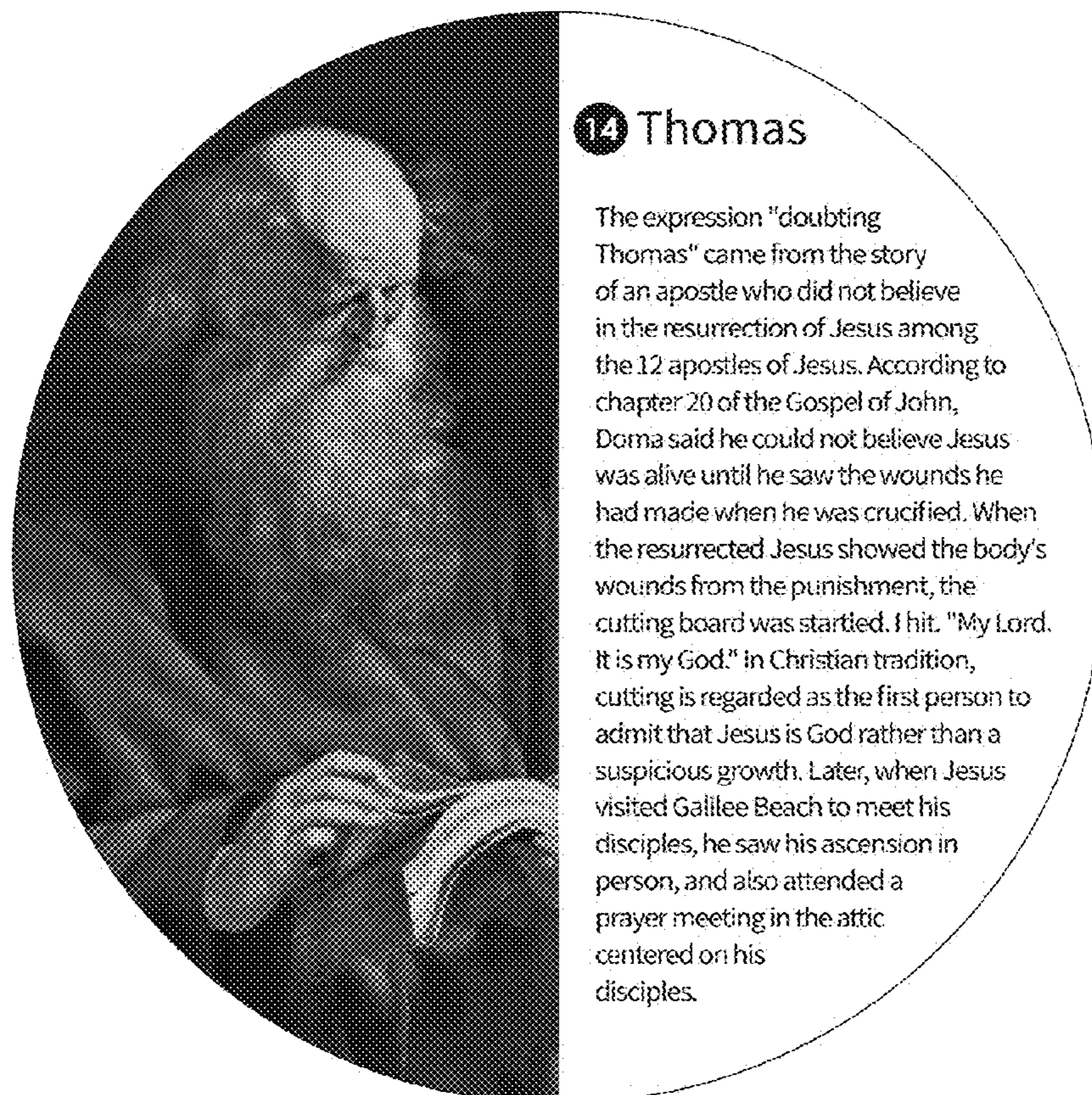

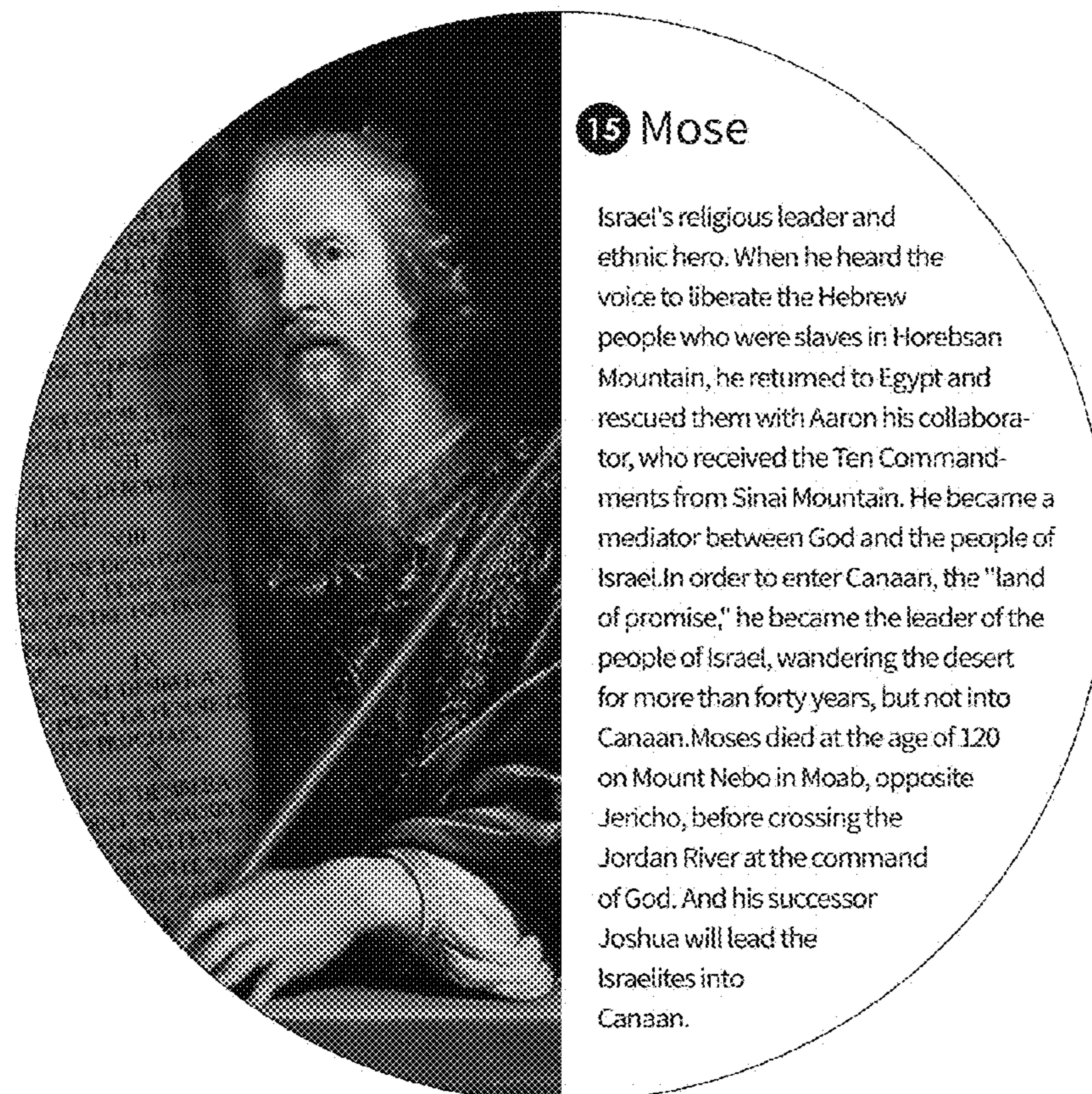

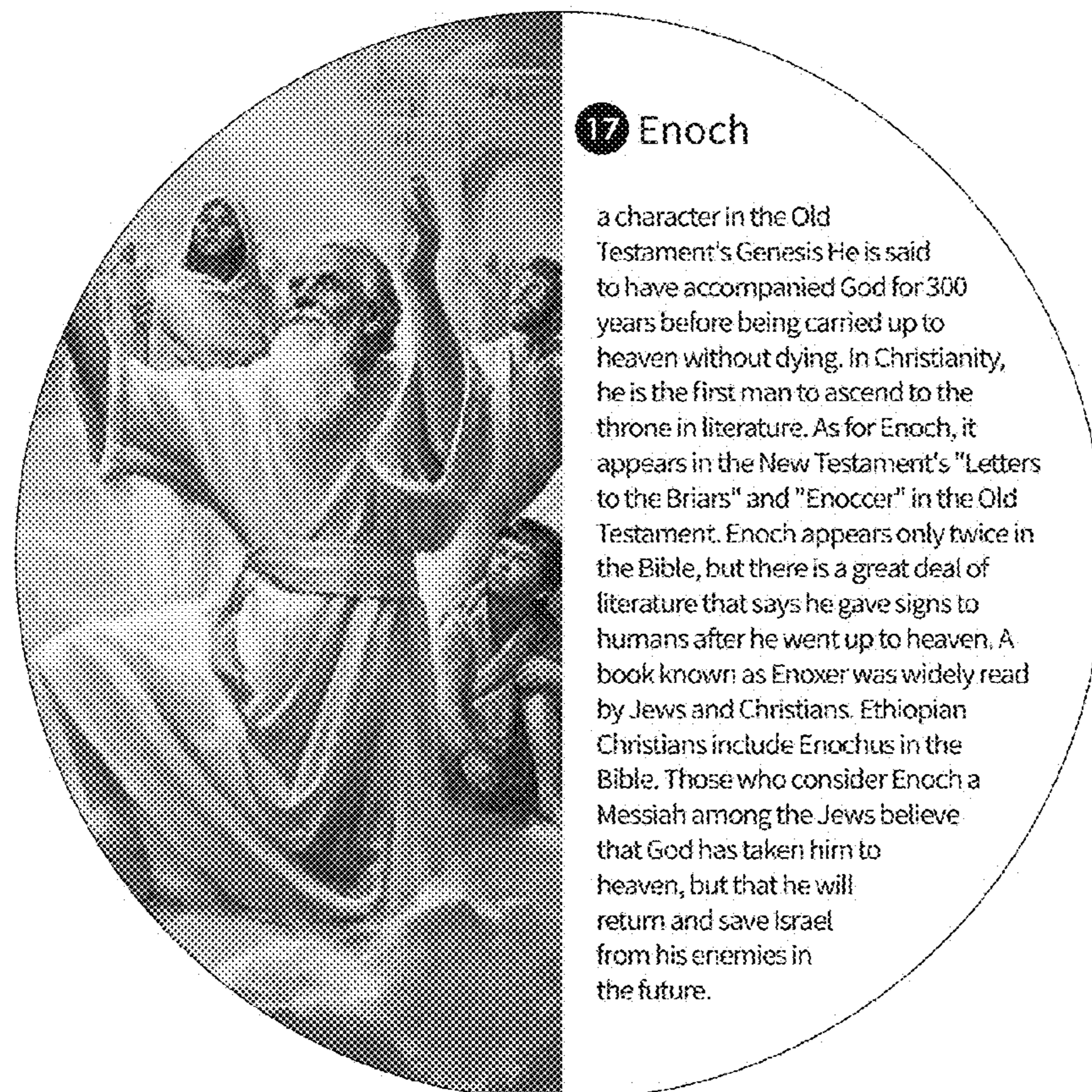

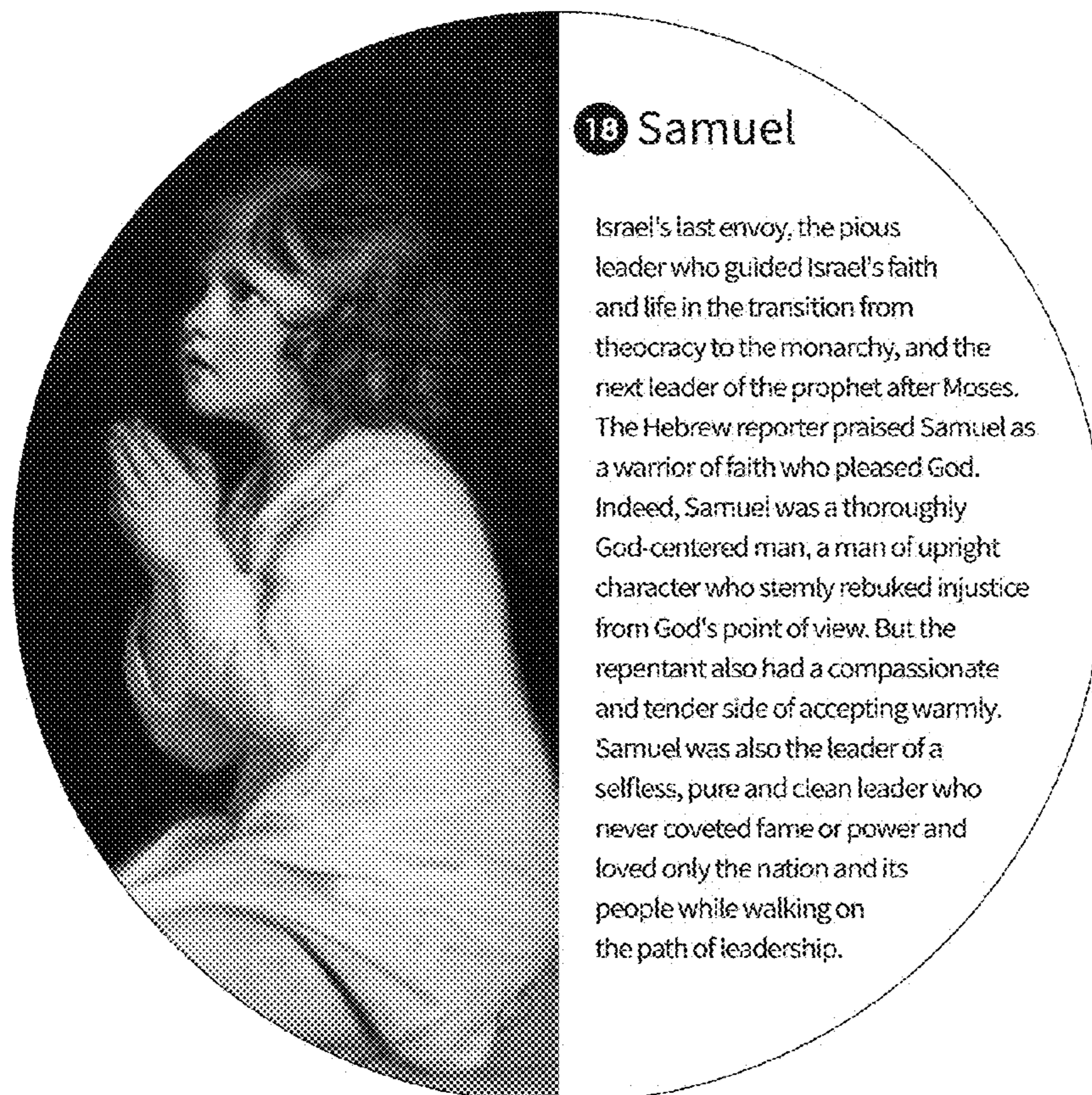

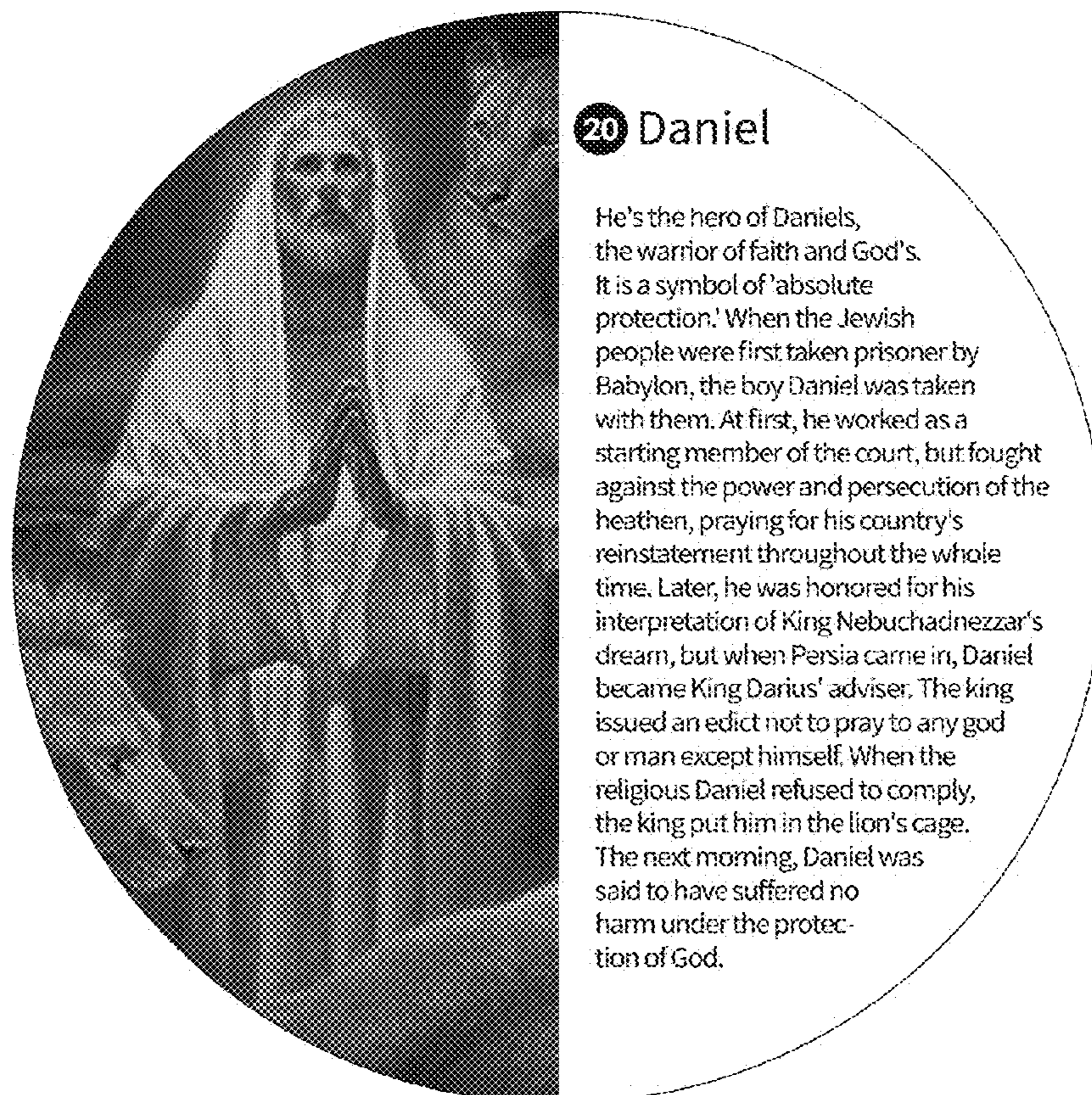

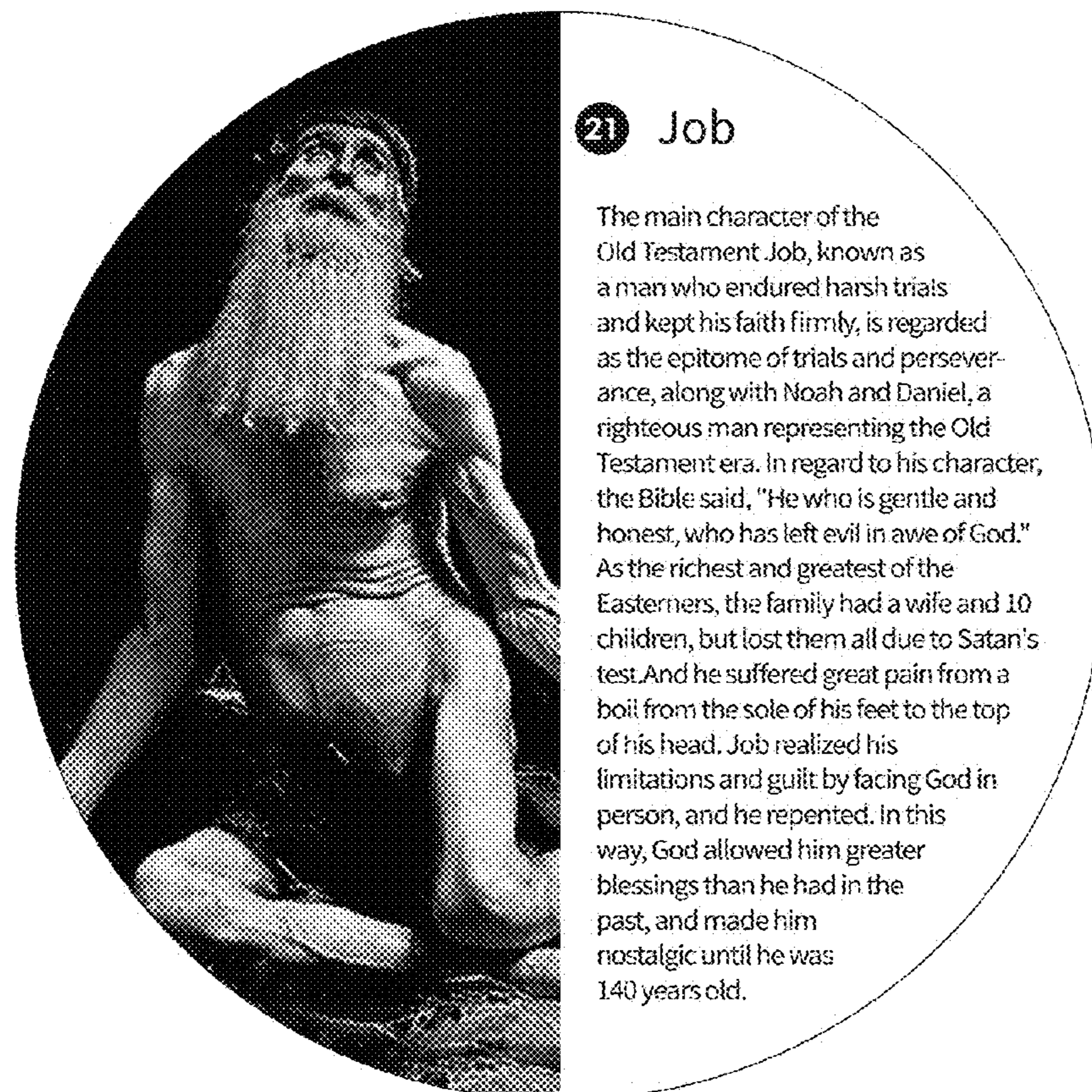

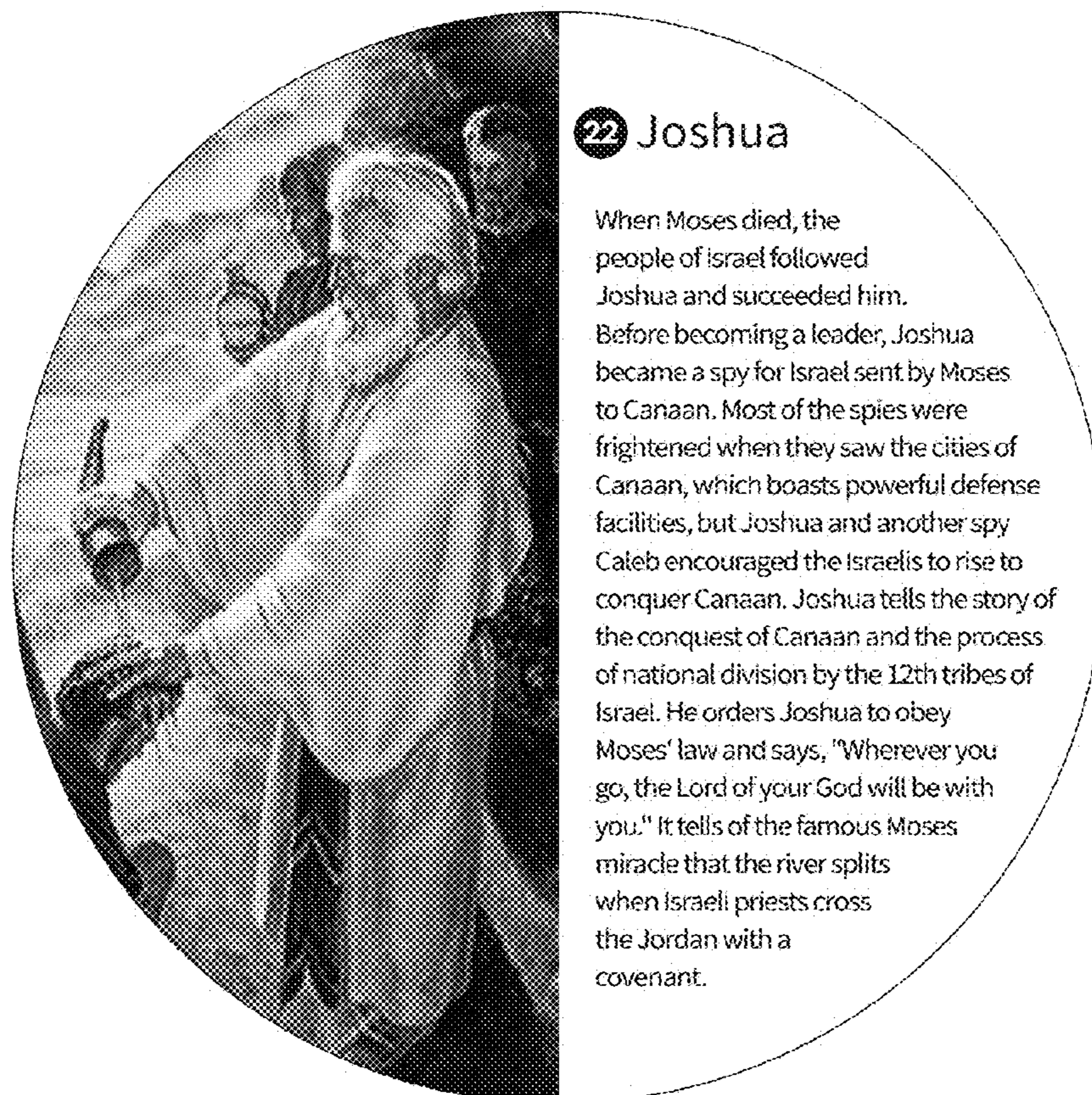

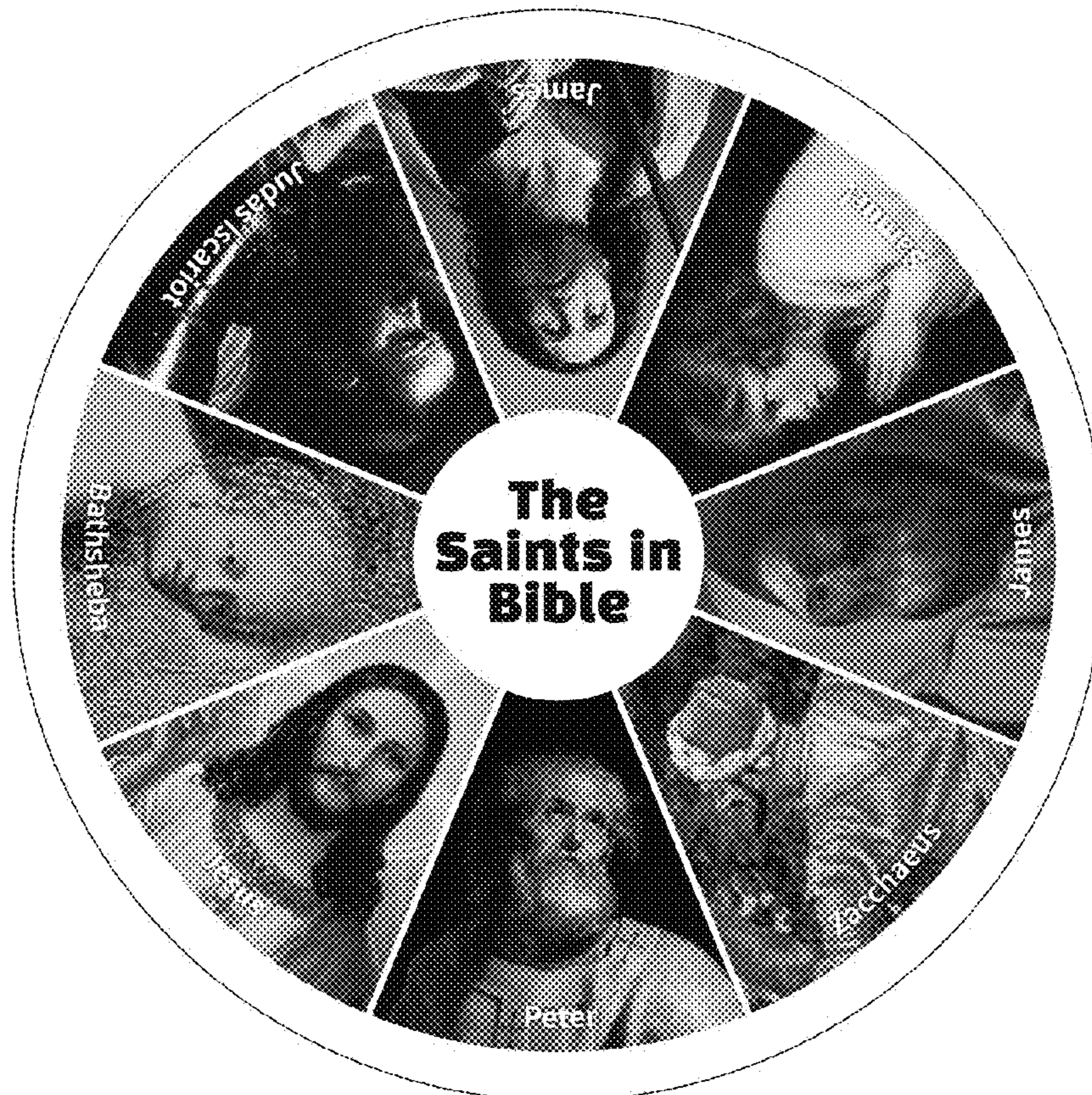

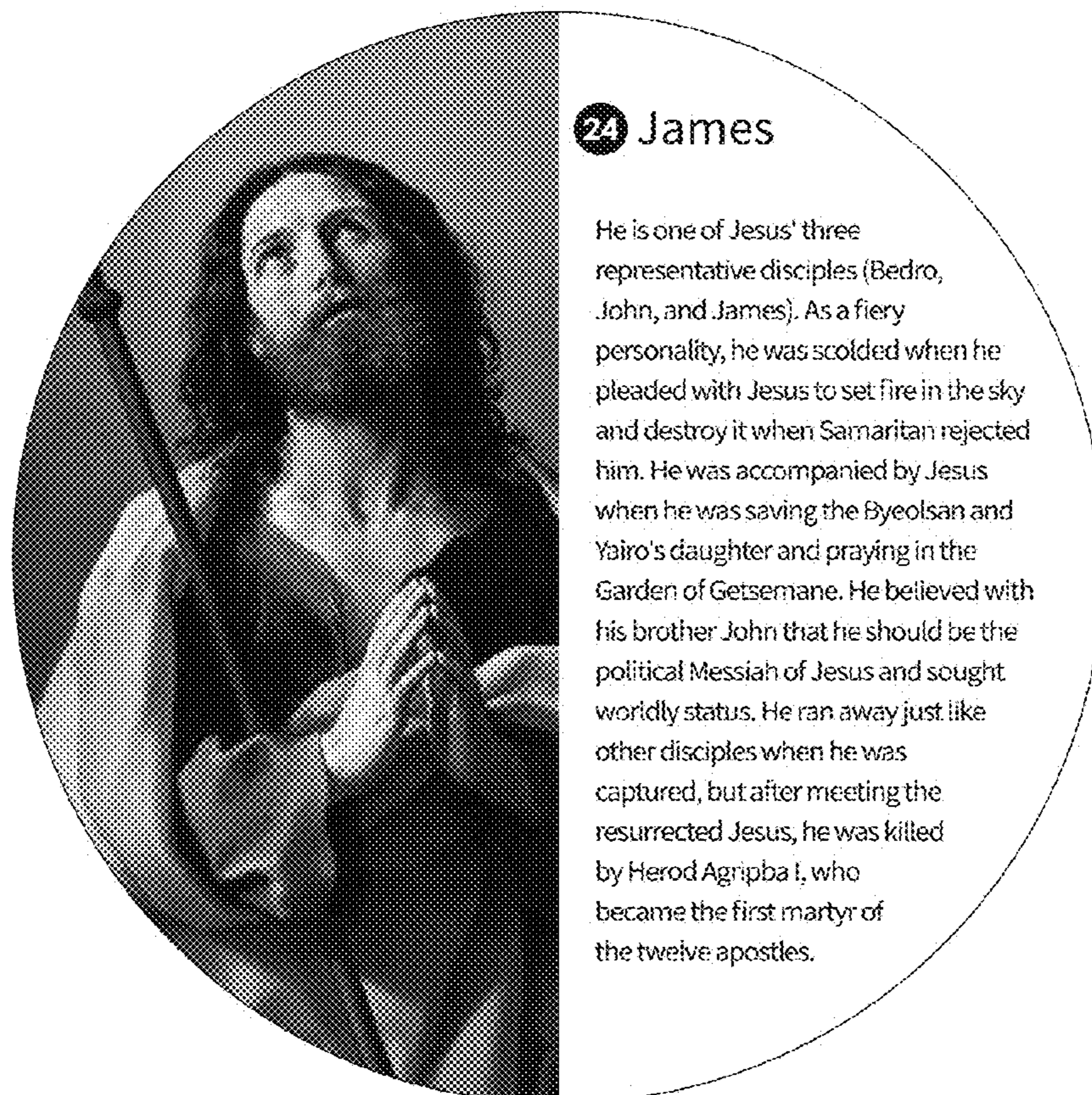

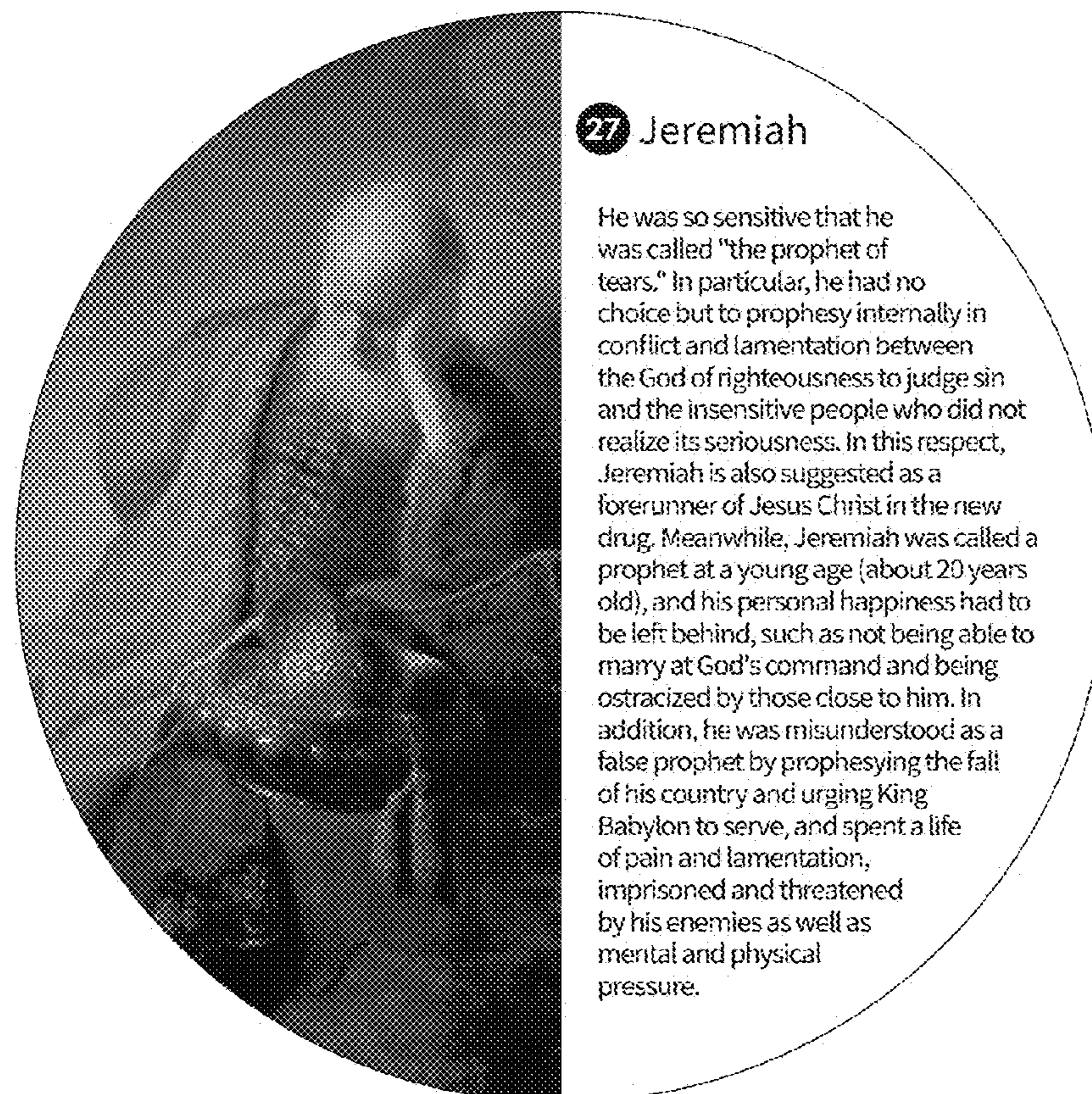

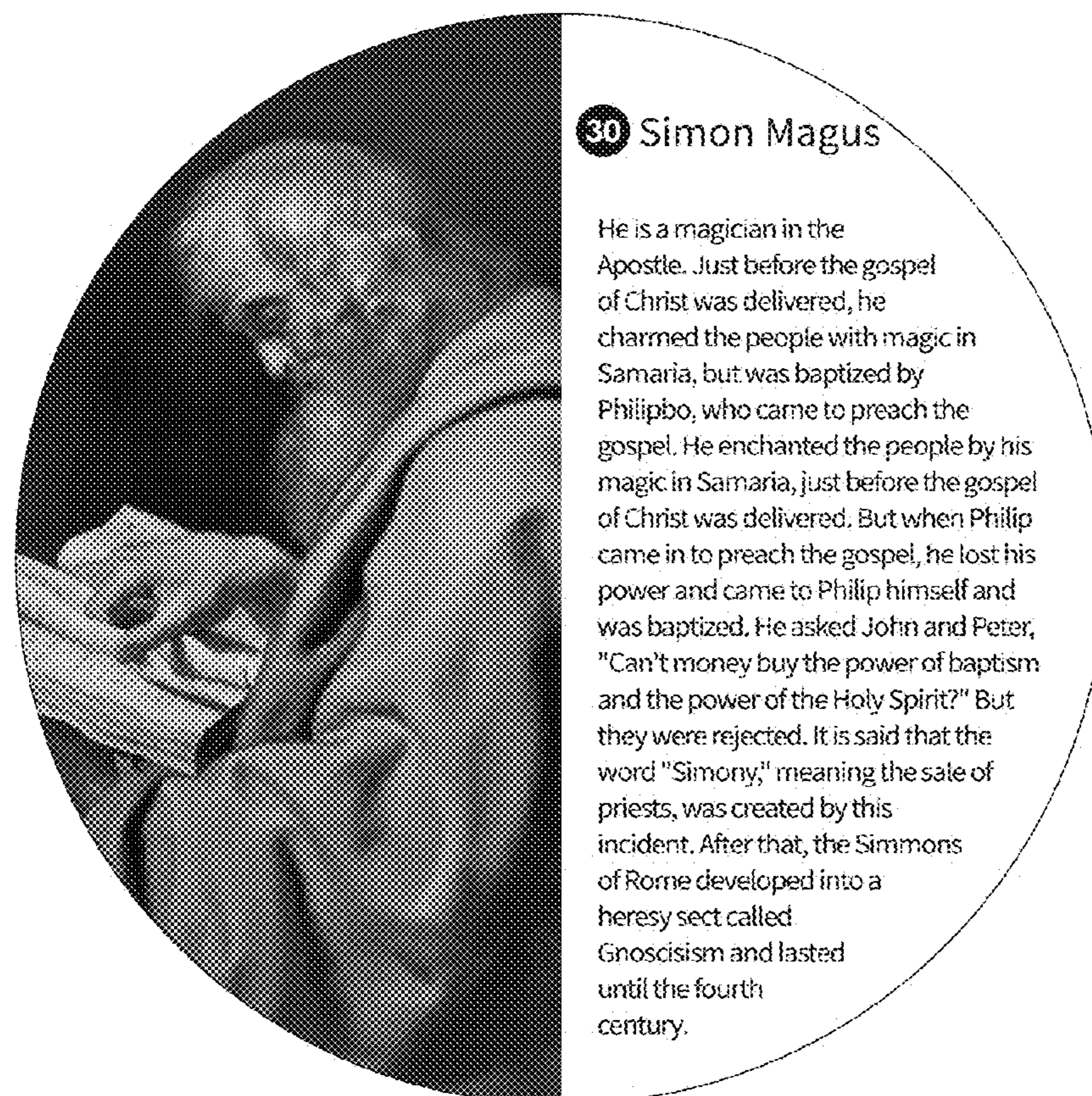

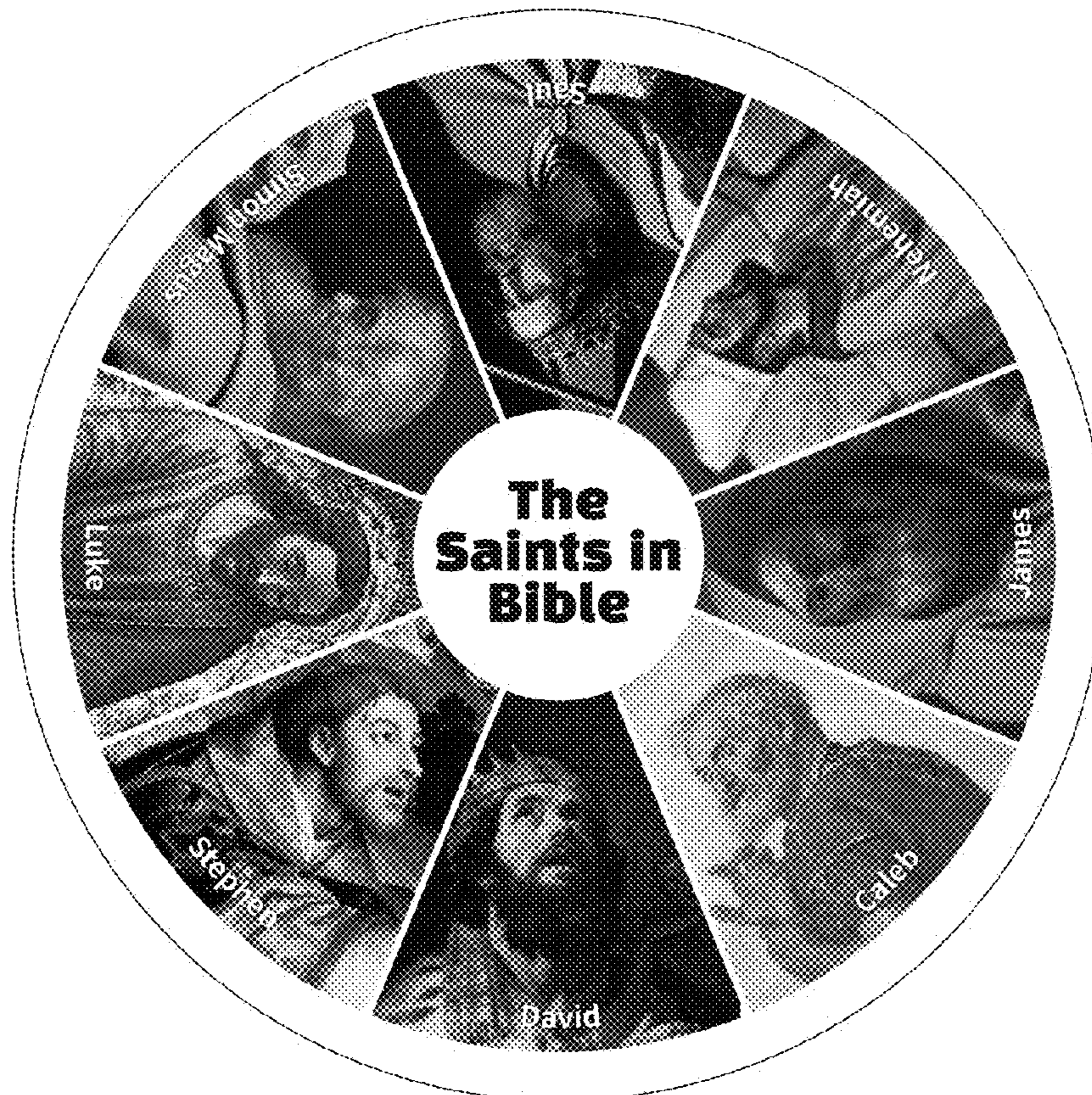

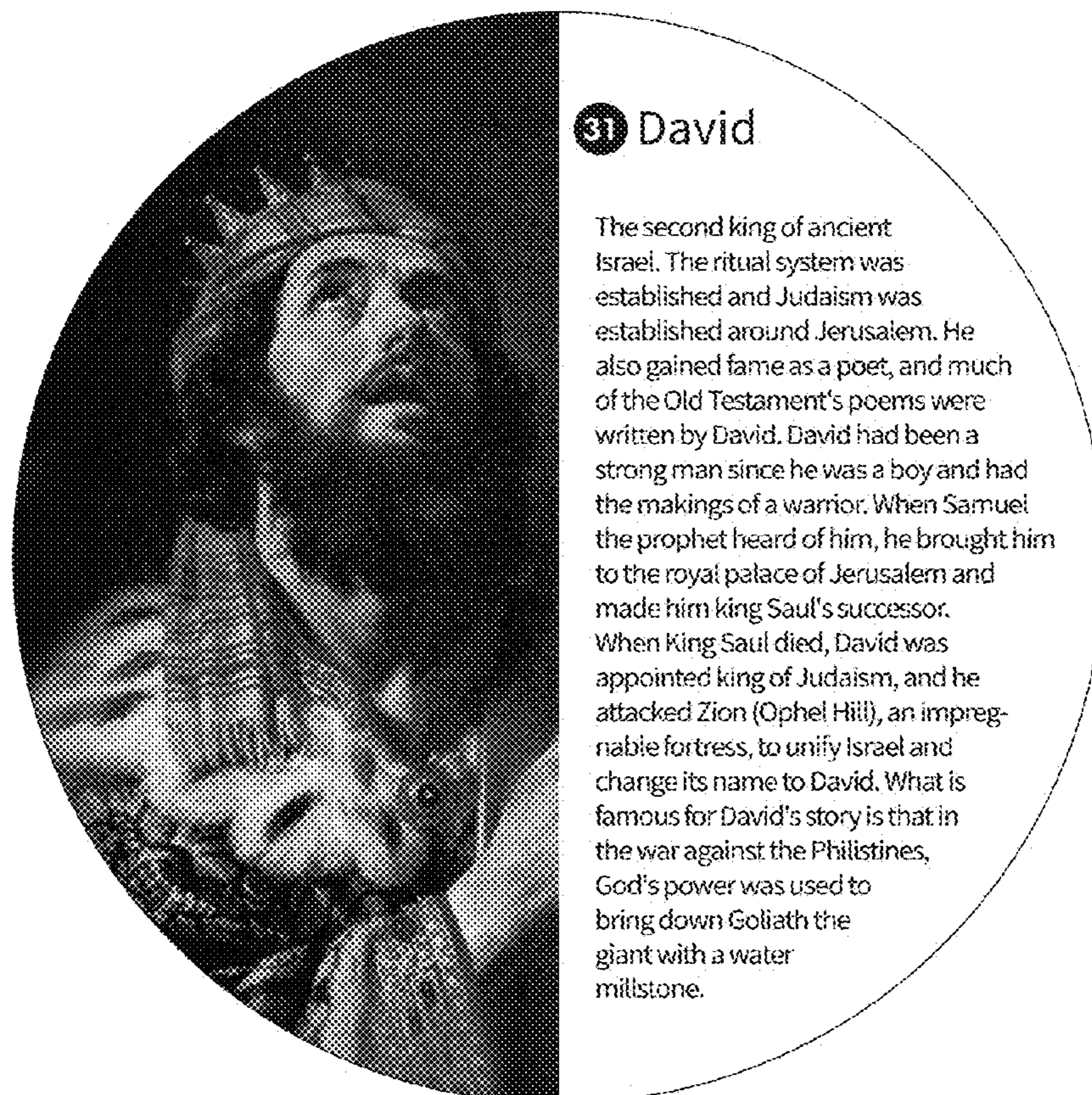

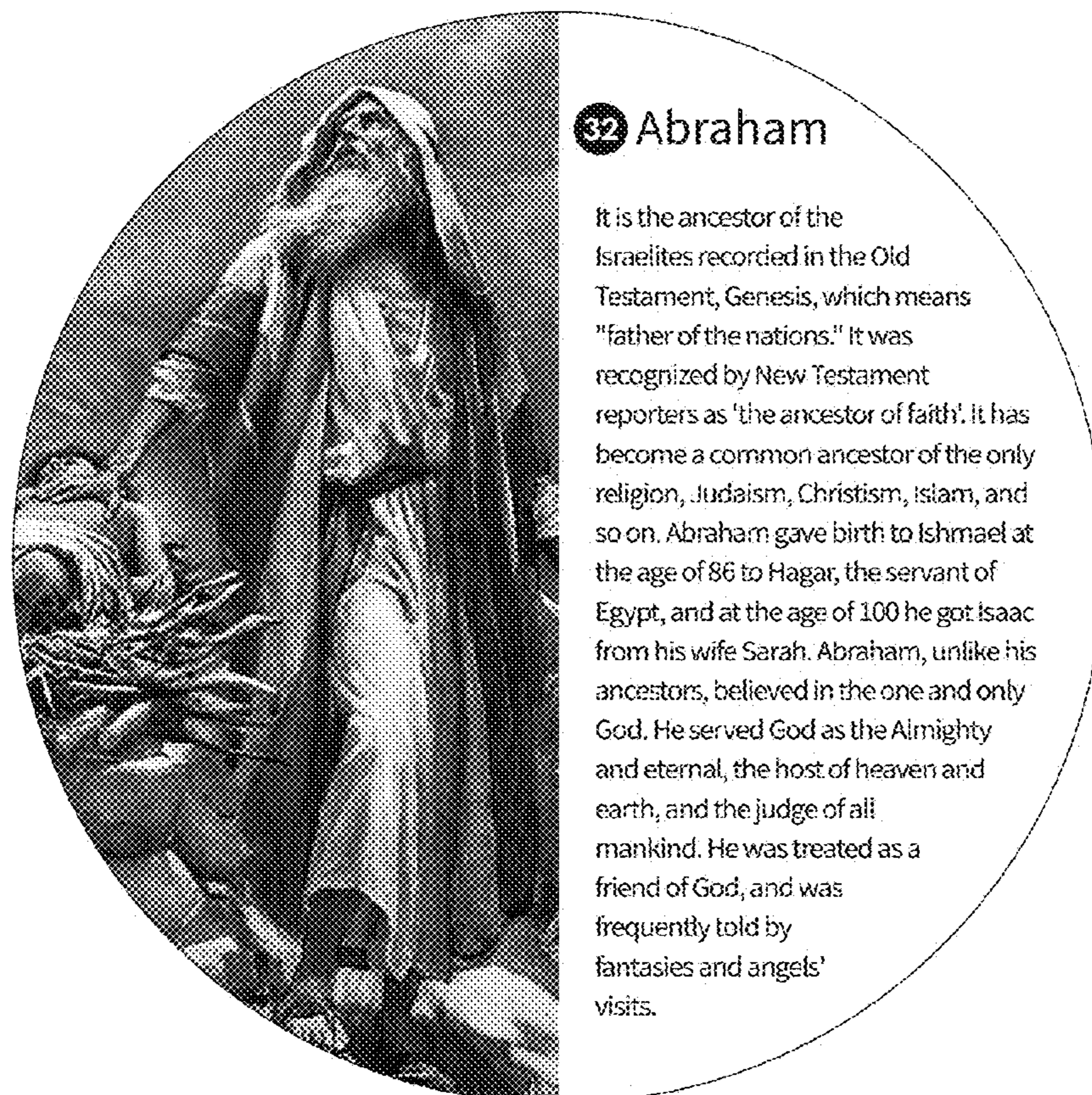

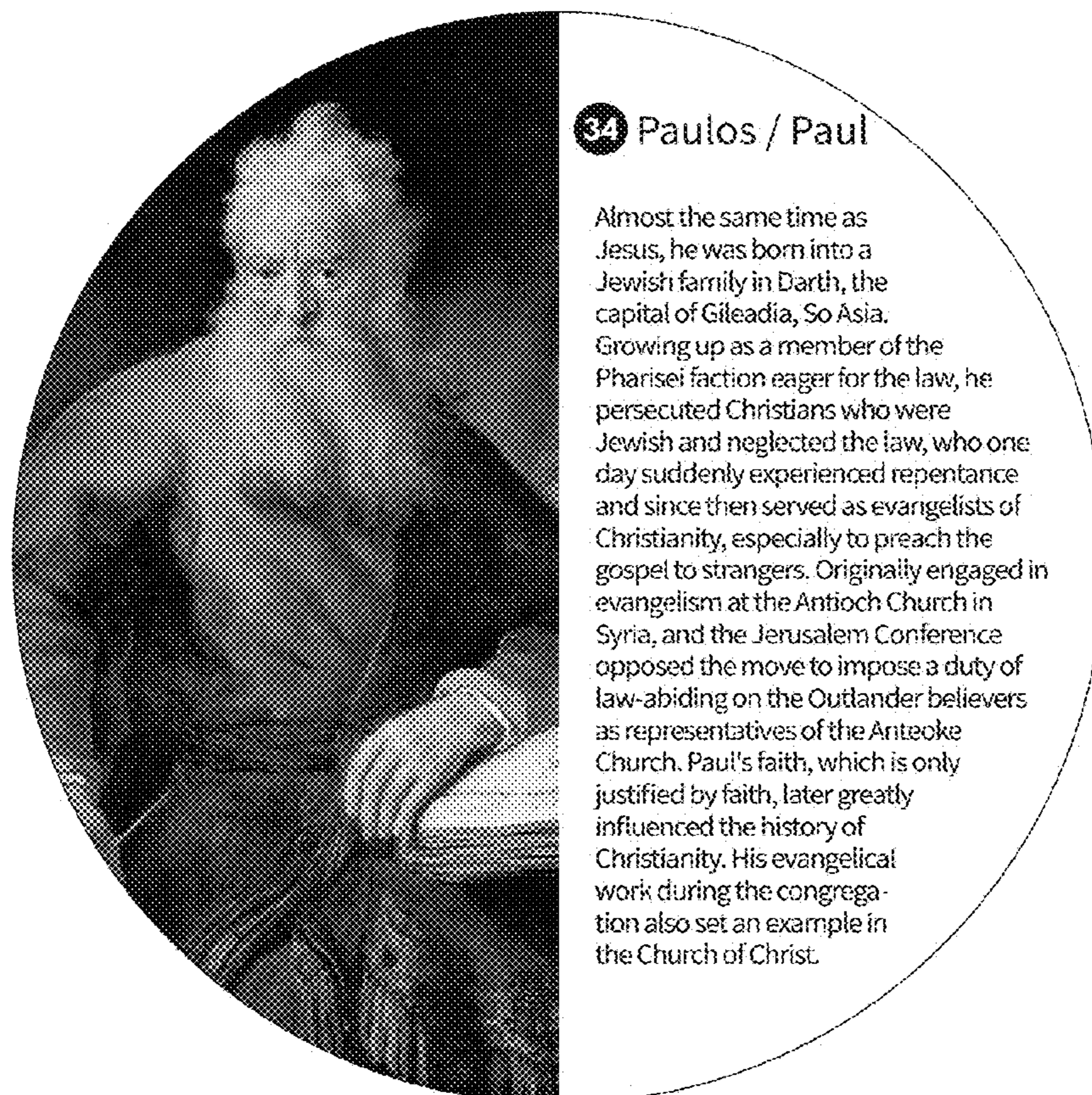

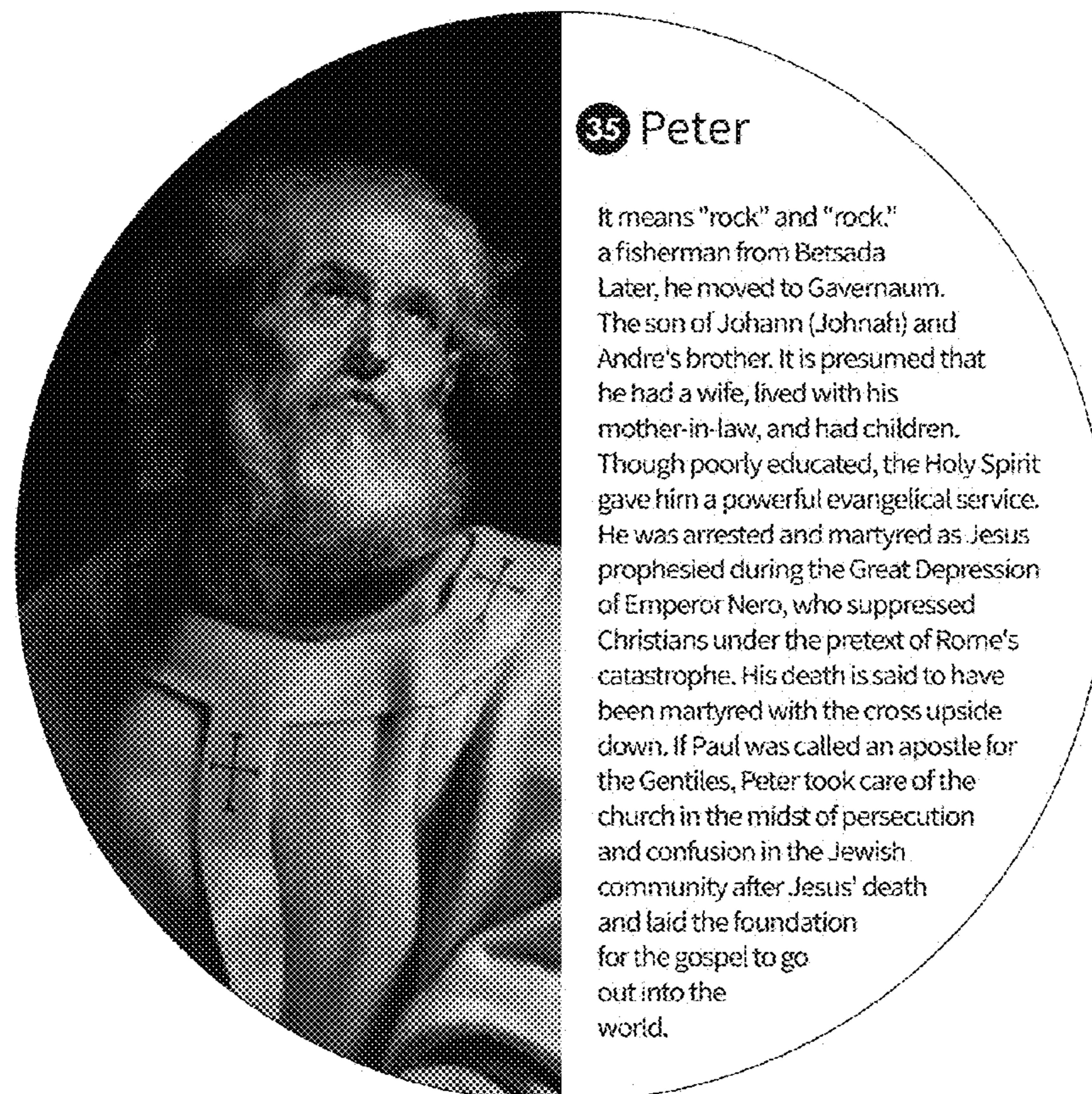

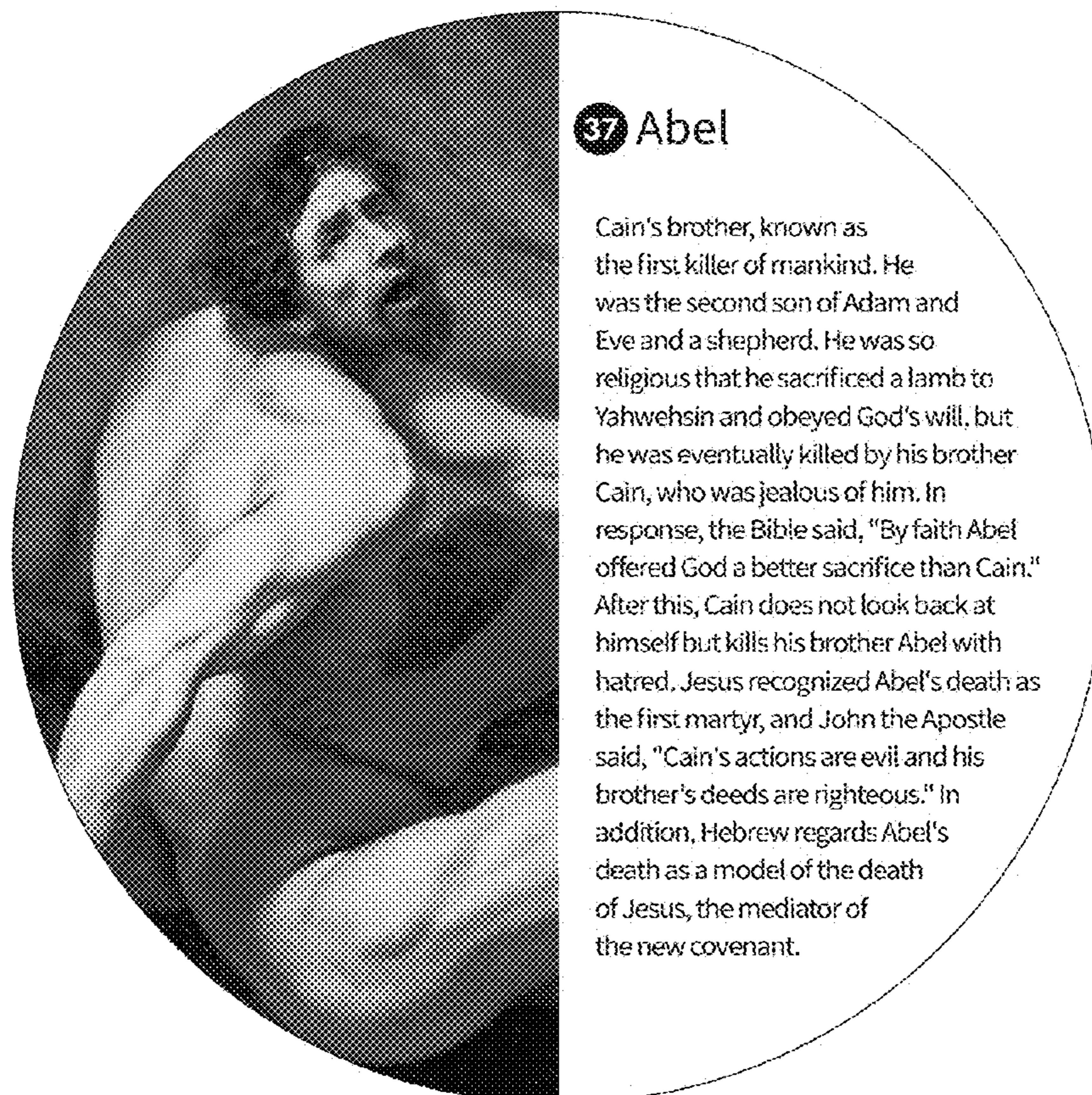

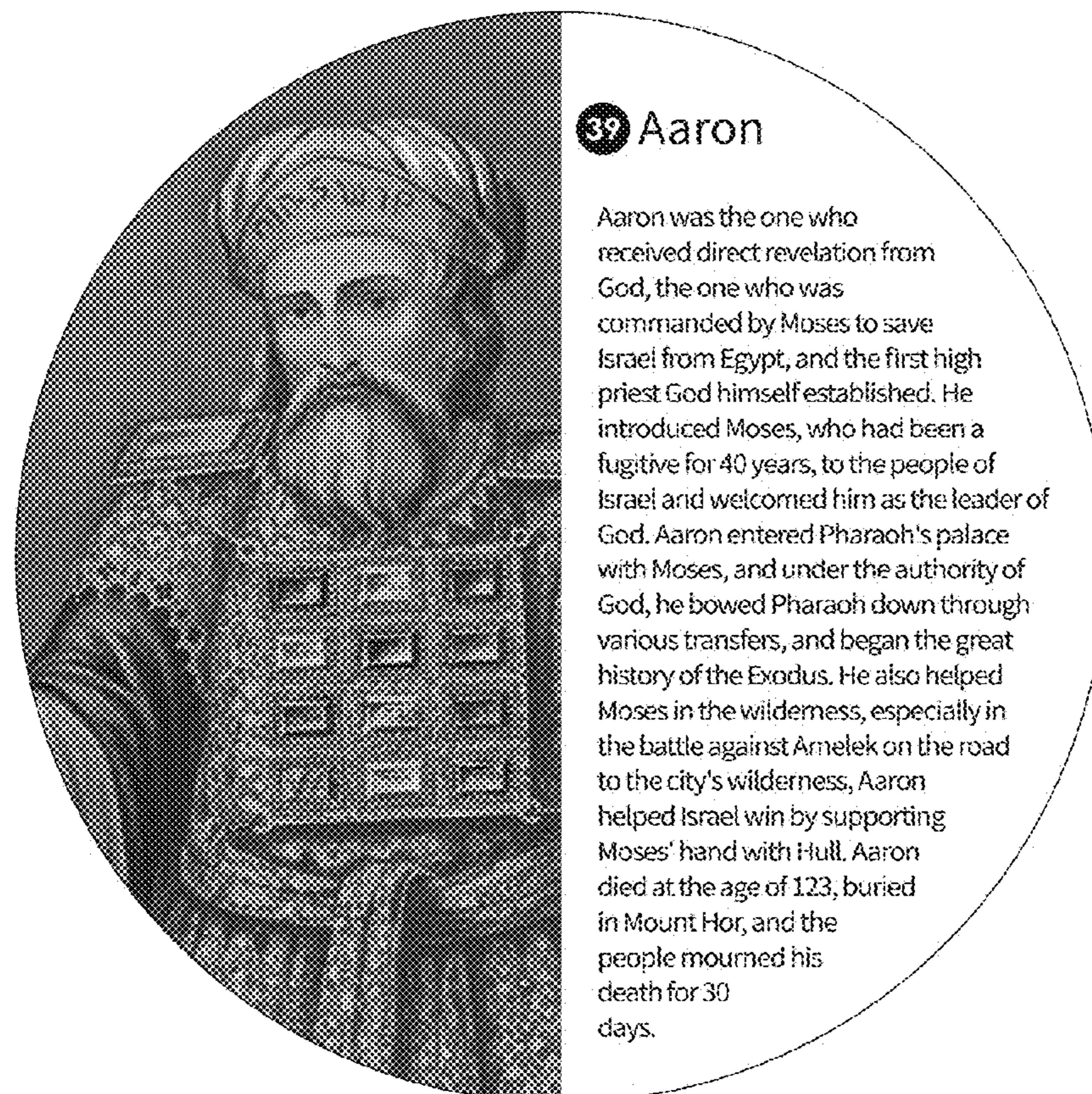

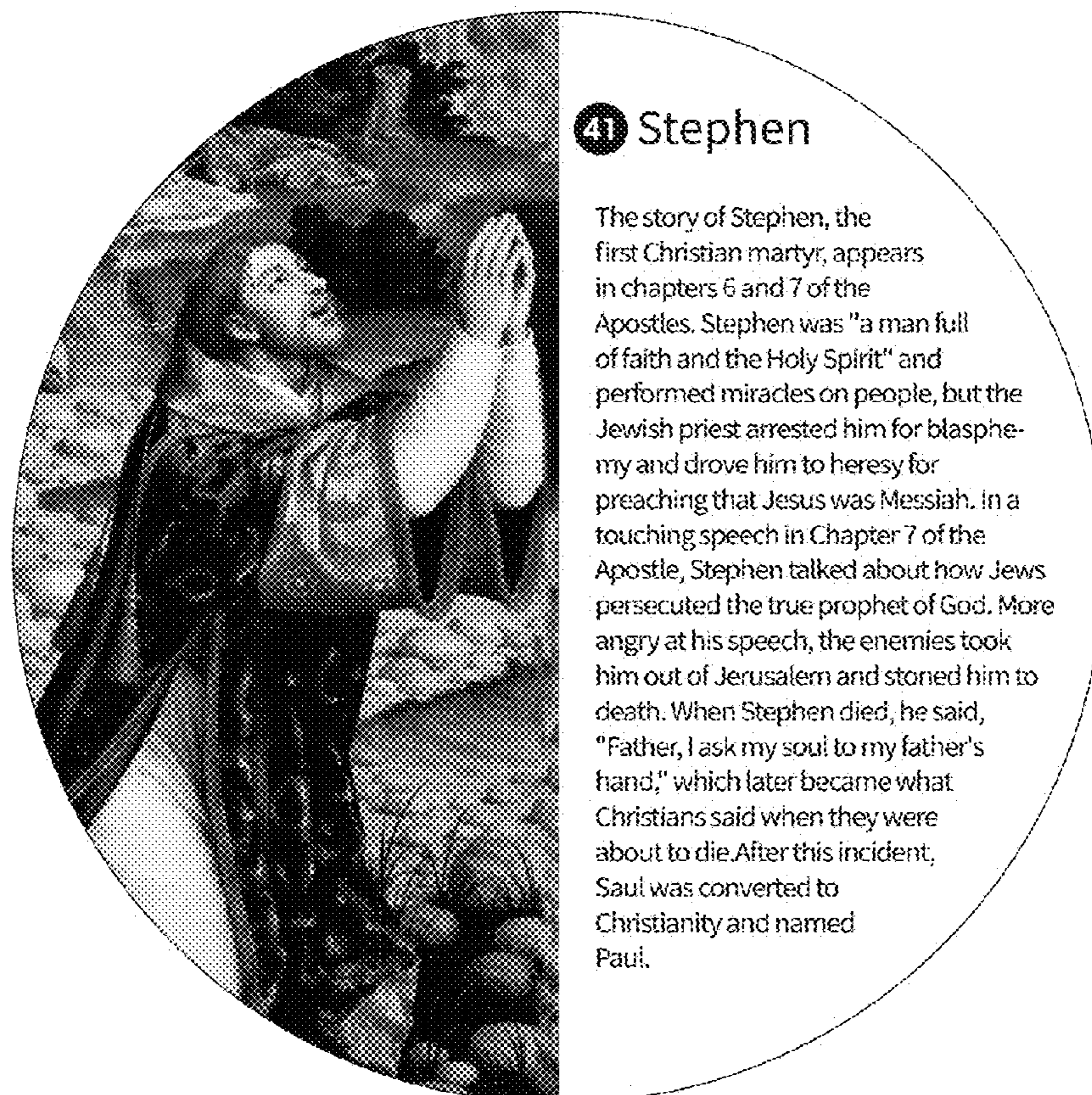

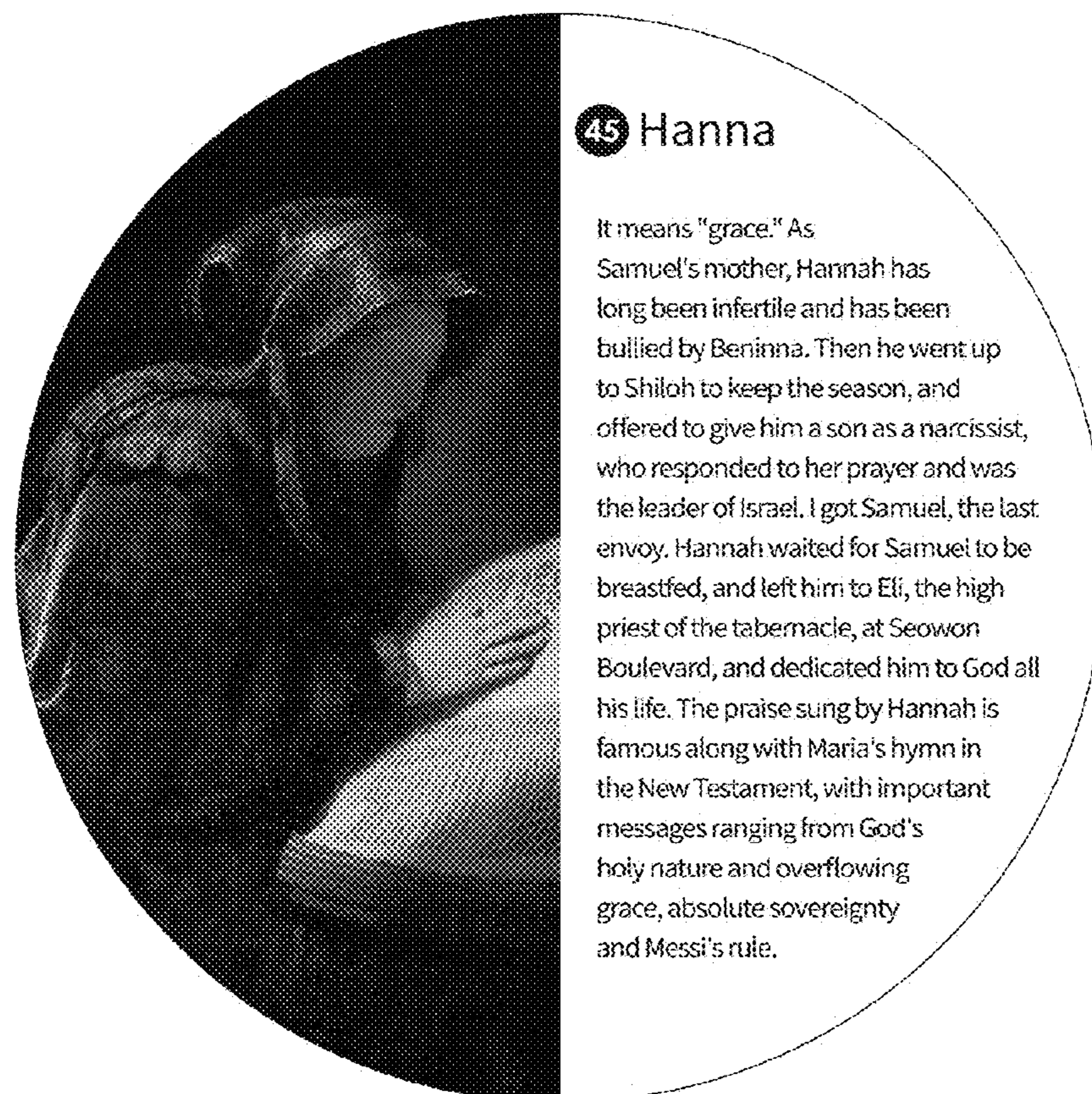

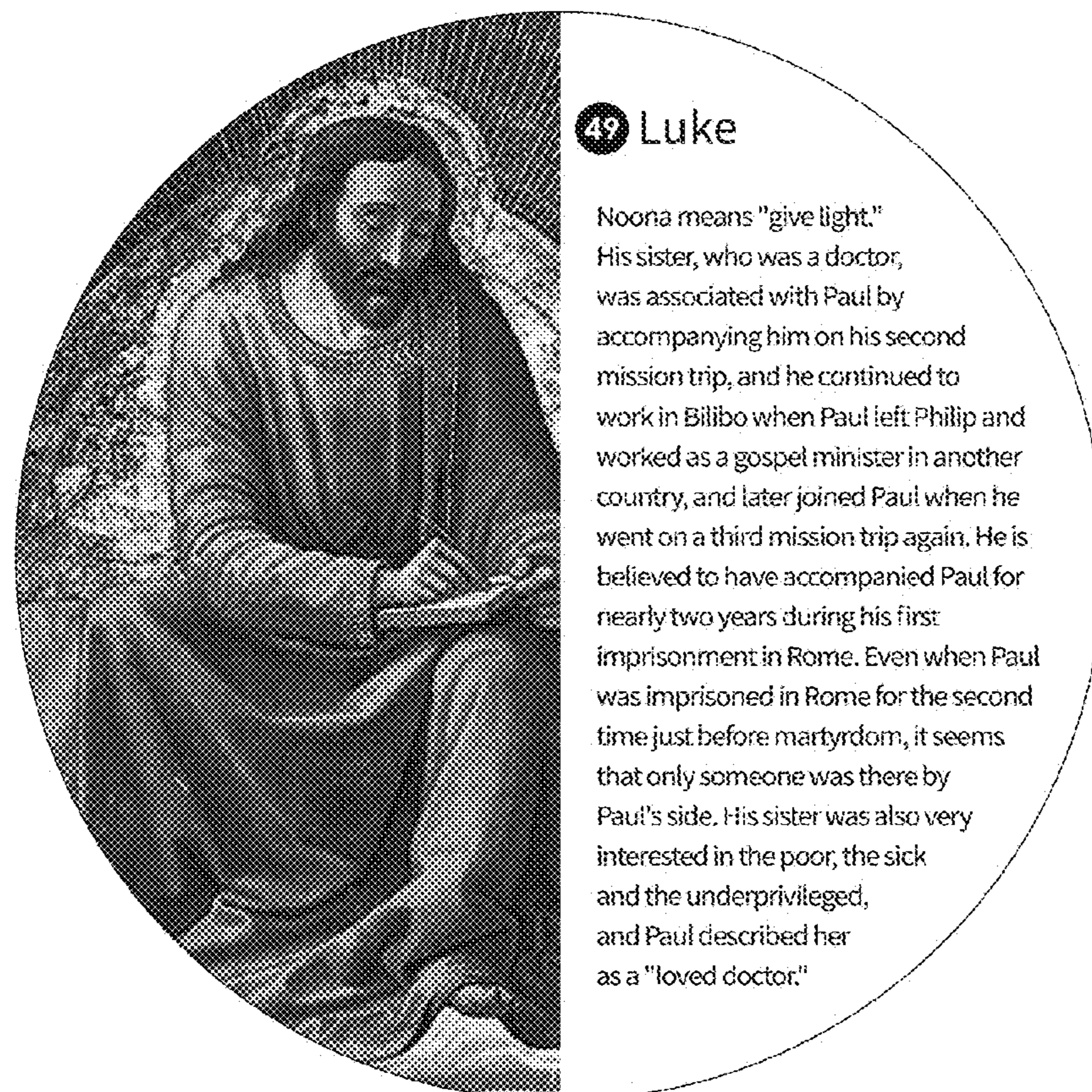

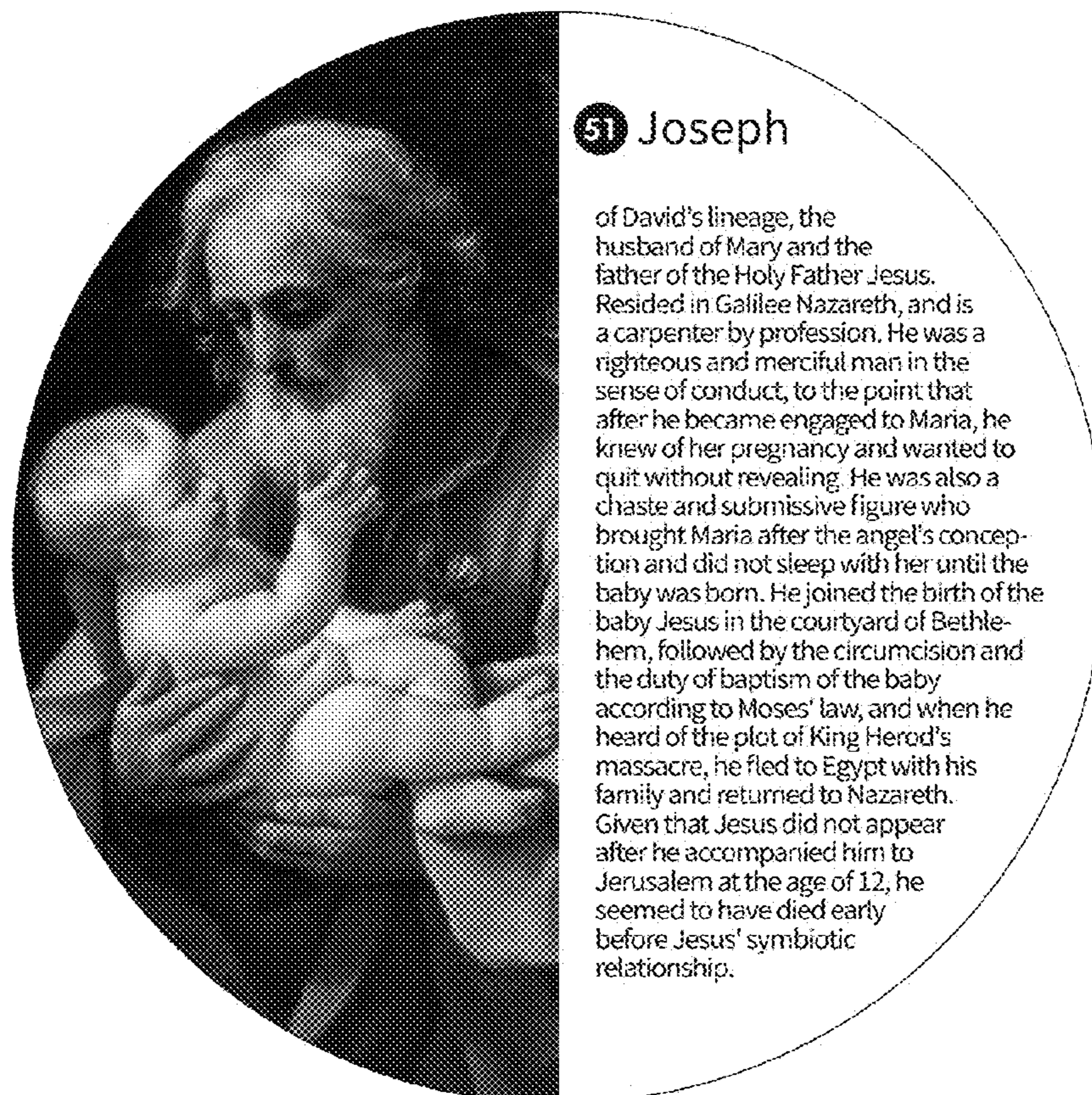

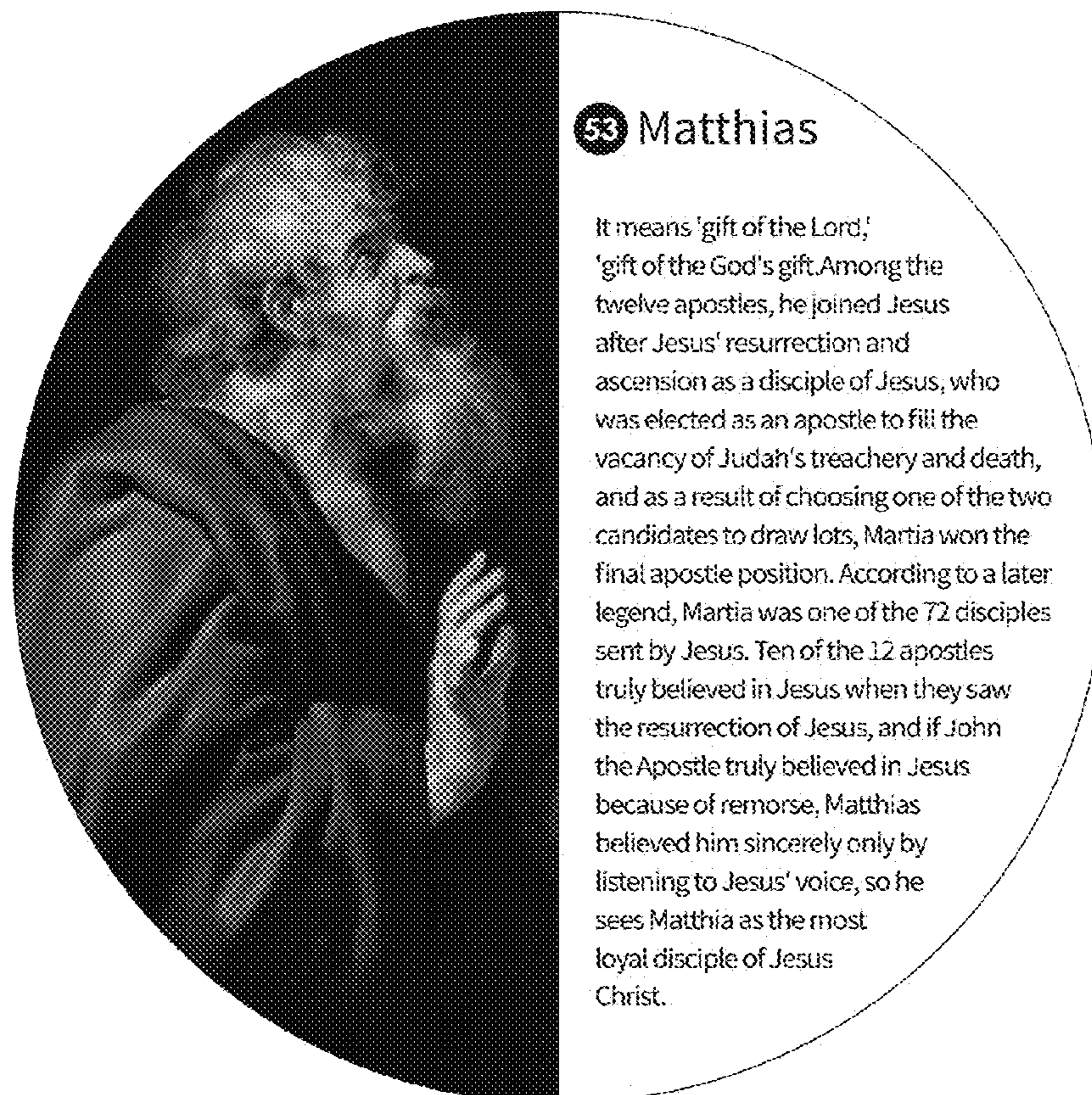

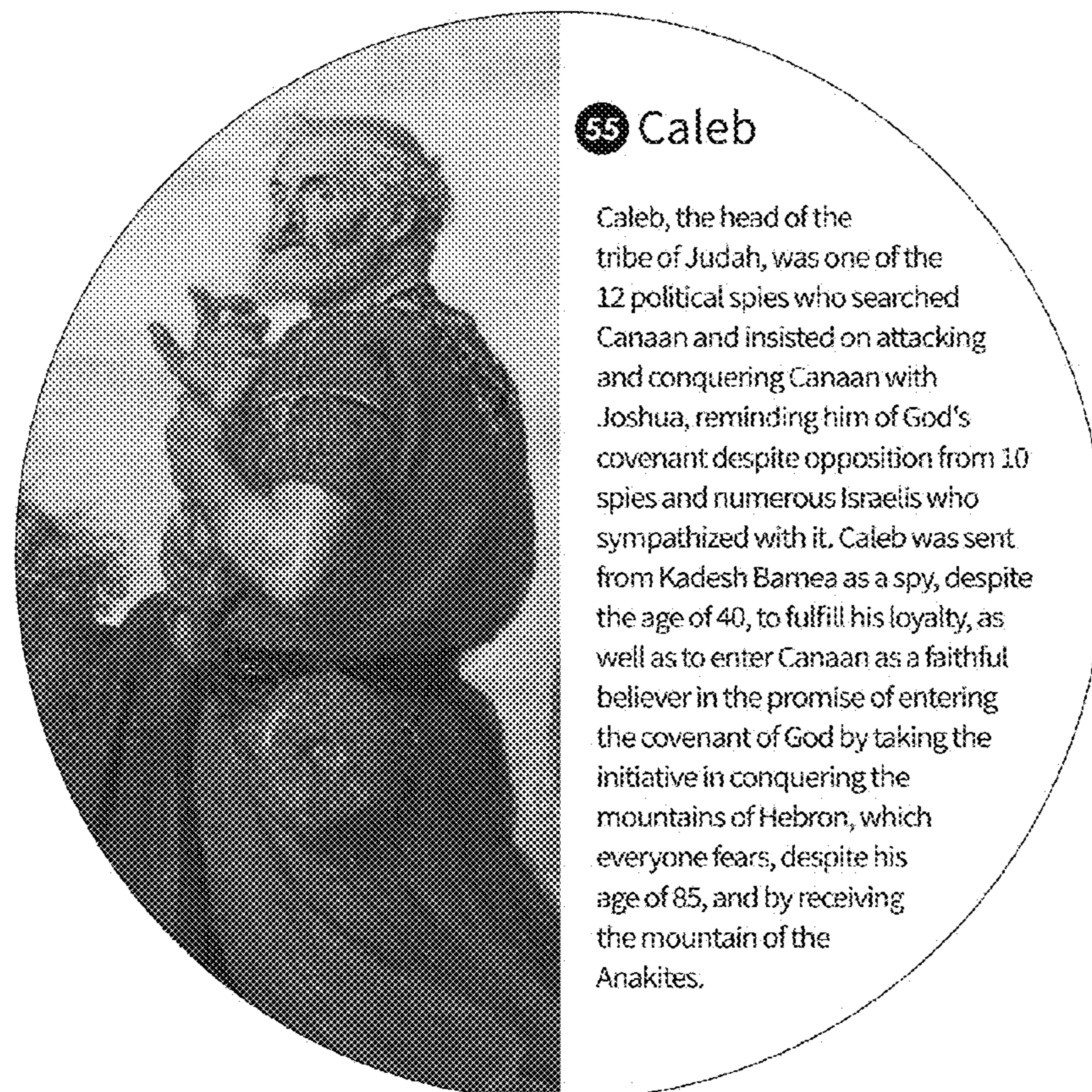

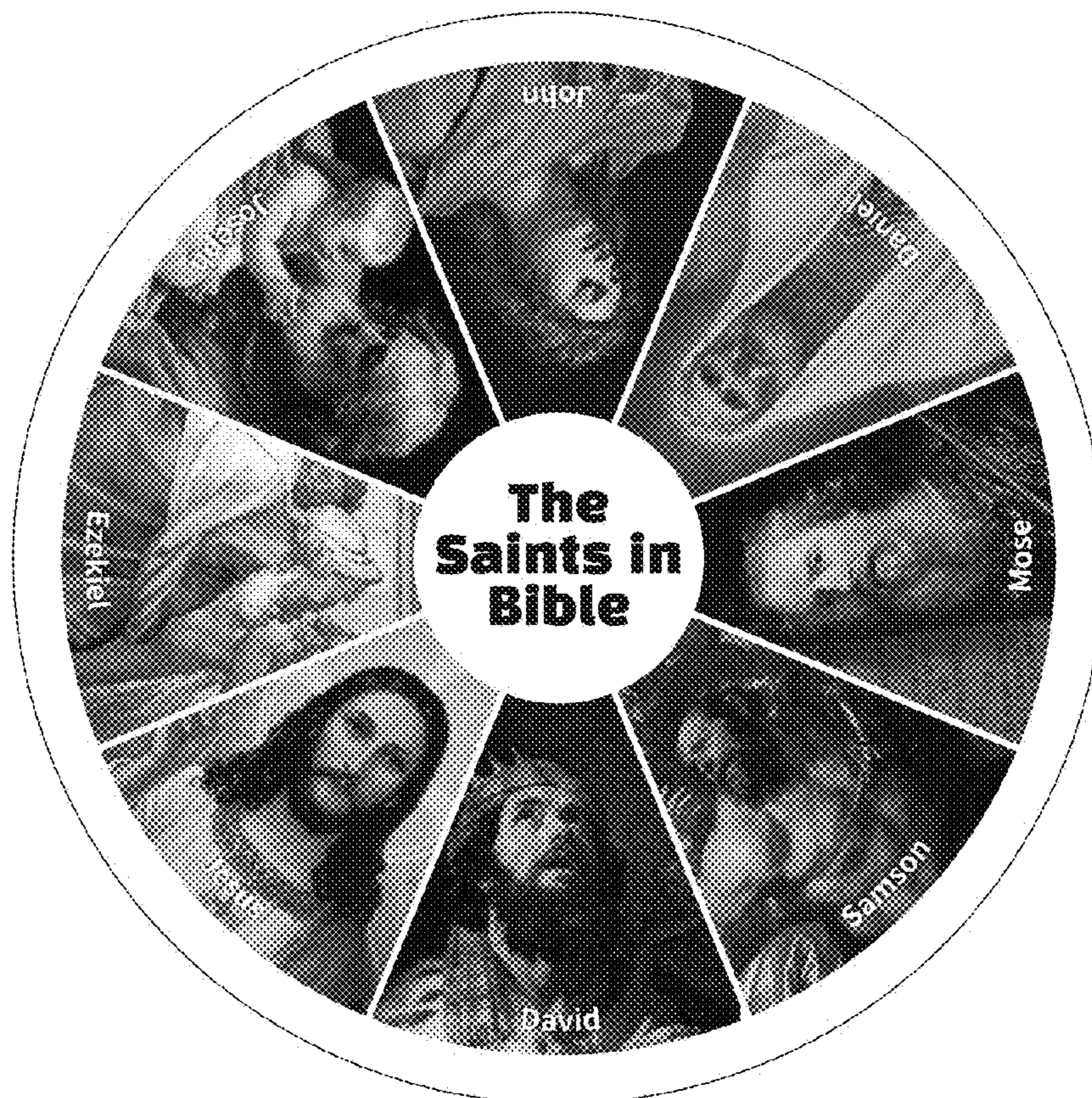

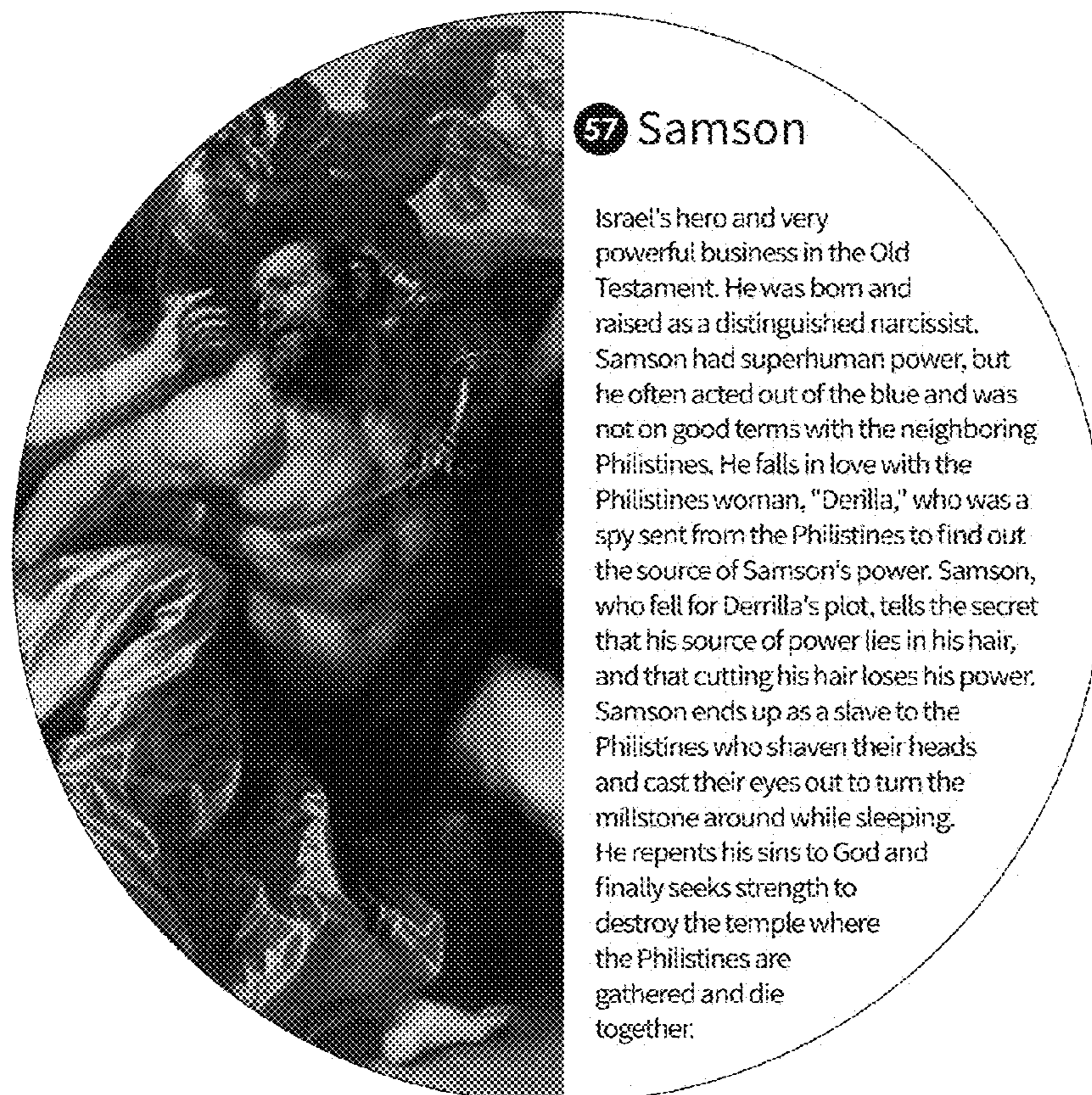
