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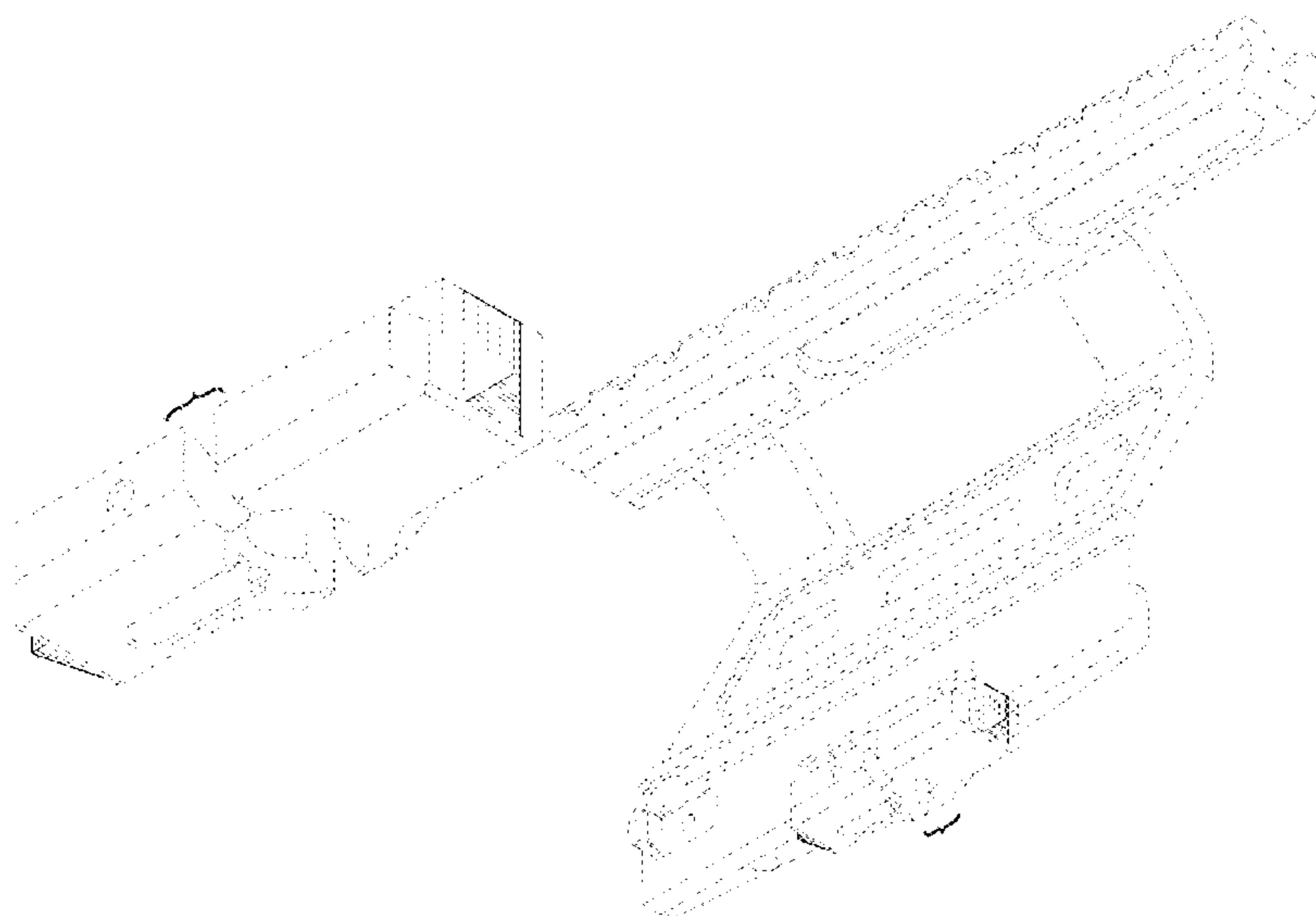
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a firearm rail mount, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the firearm rail mount
embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the firearm rail mount
being inserted in a mount body.
FIGS. 1-8 show features of a firearm rail mount in broken
lines. These features do not form any part of the claimed
design. The broken lines immediately adjacent the solid line
portions of the design form the boundary of the design, with
the broken lines forming no part of the claimed design. The
firearm rail mount is shown with a symbolic break in its
length. The appearance of any portion of the firearm rail
mount between the break lines forms no part of the claimed
design.

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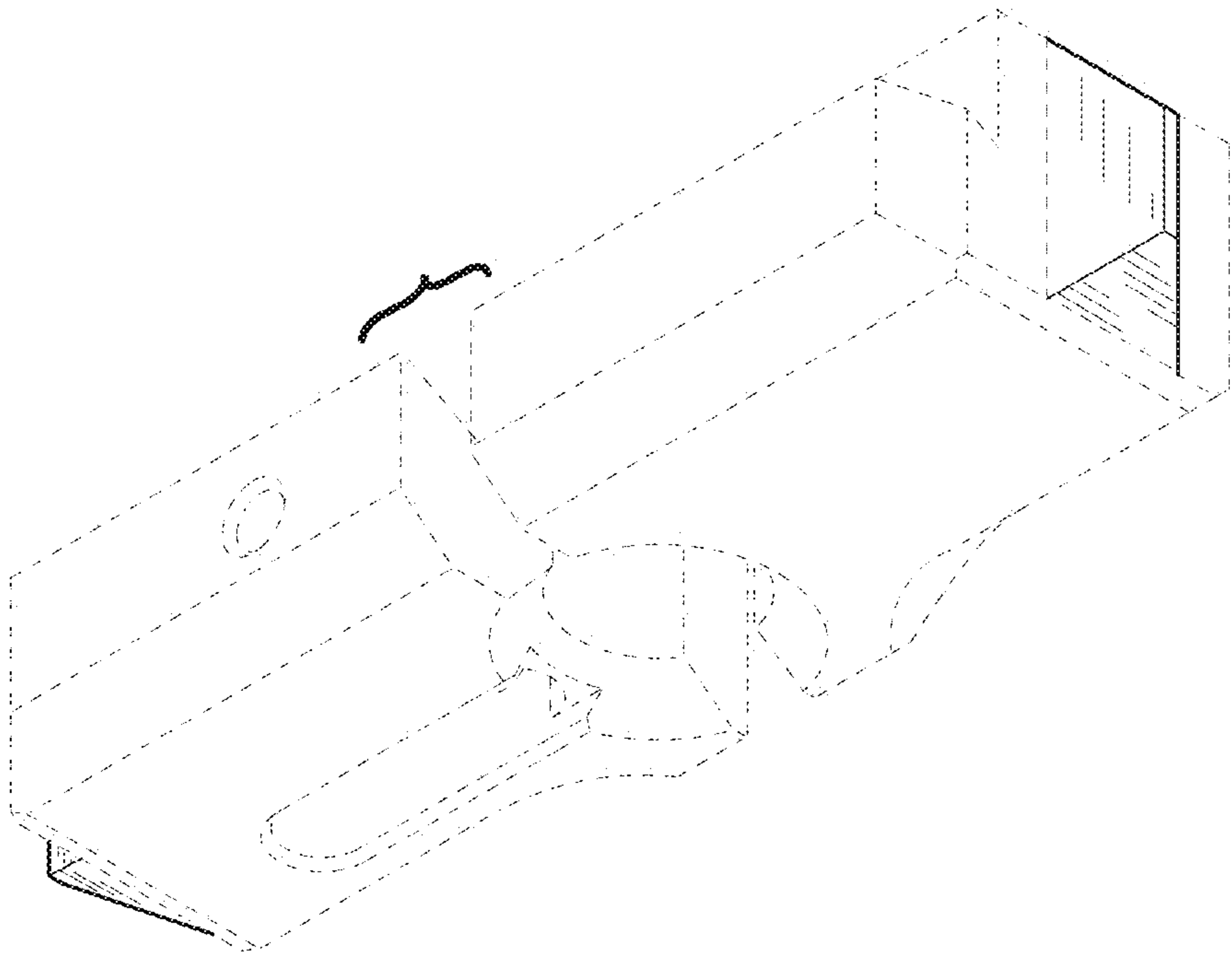

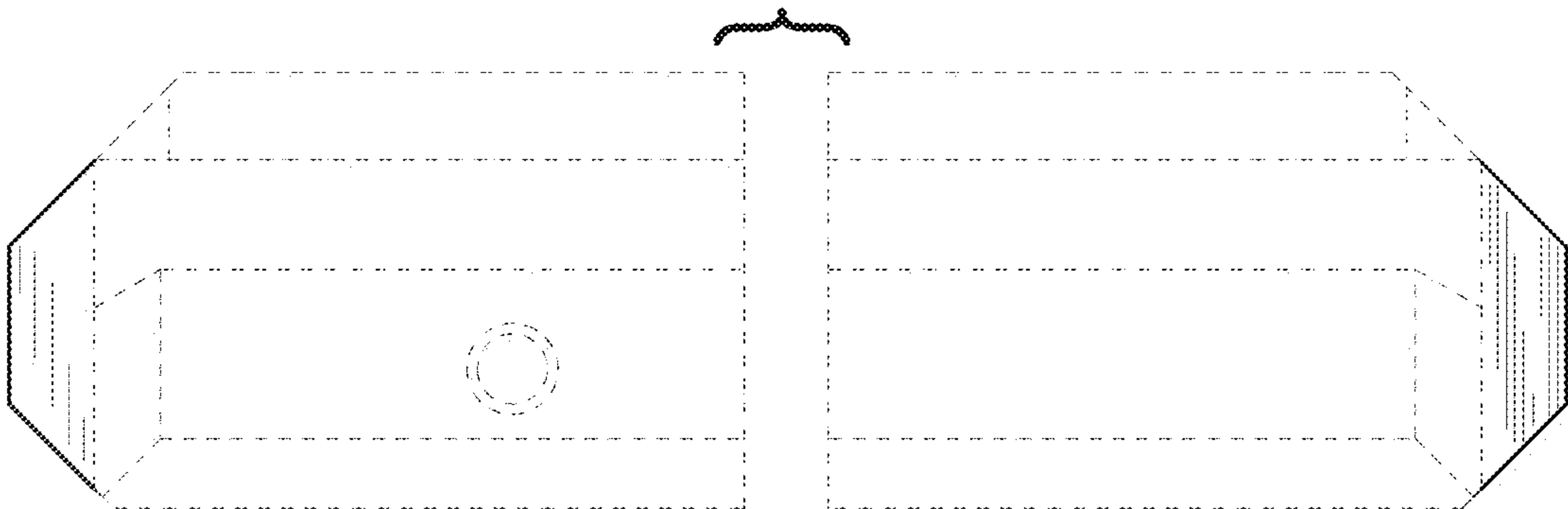

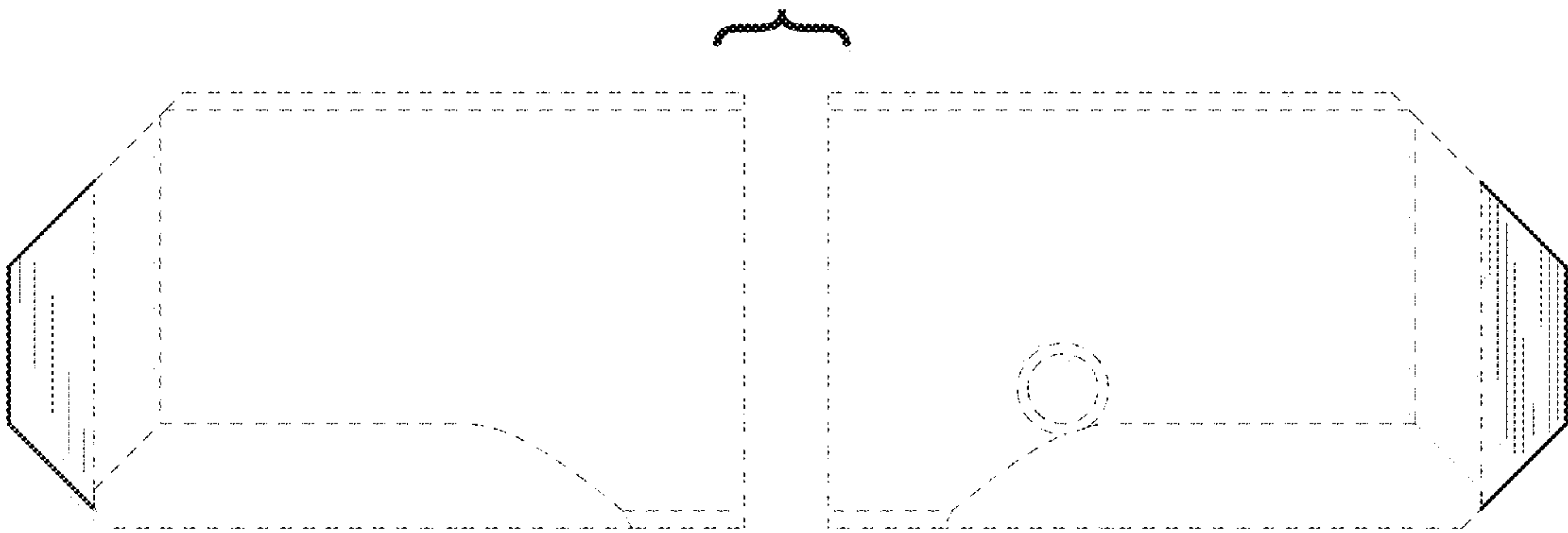

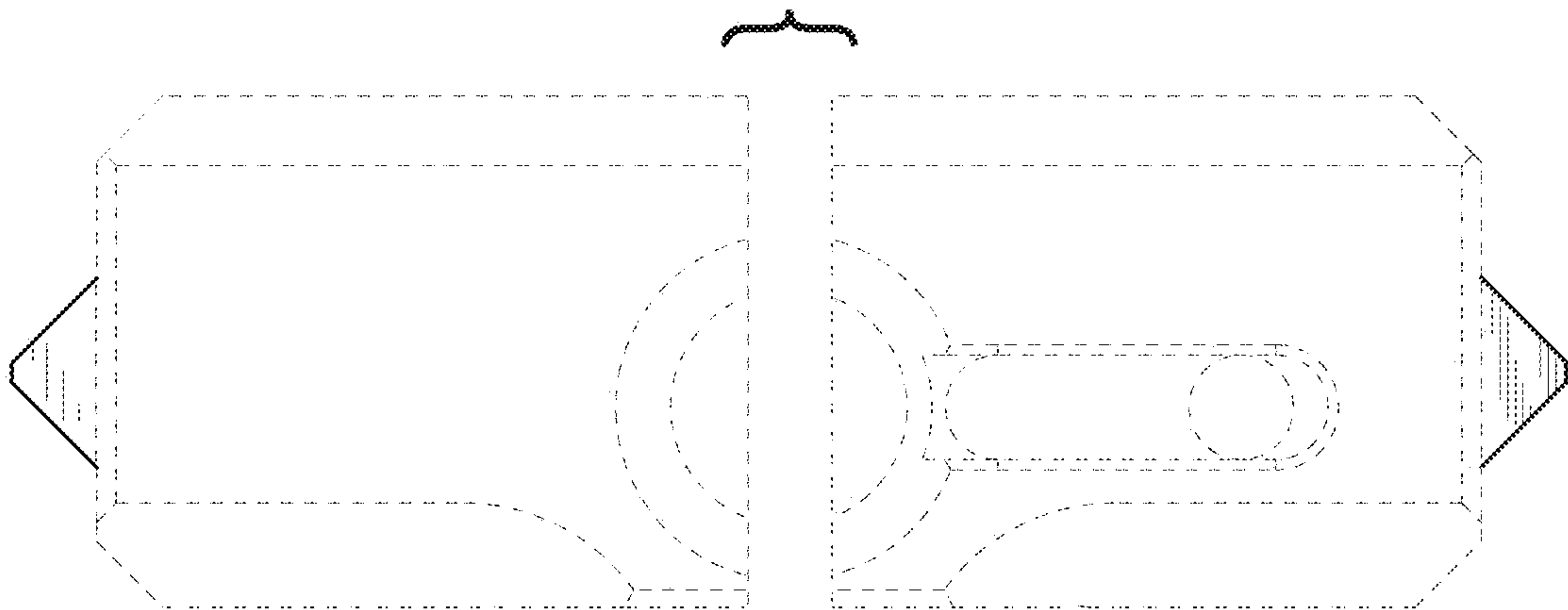

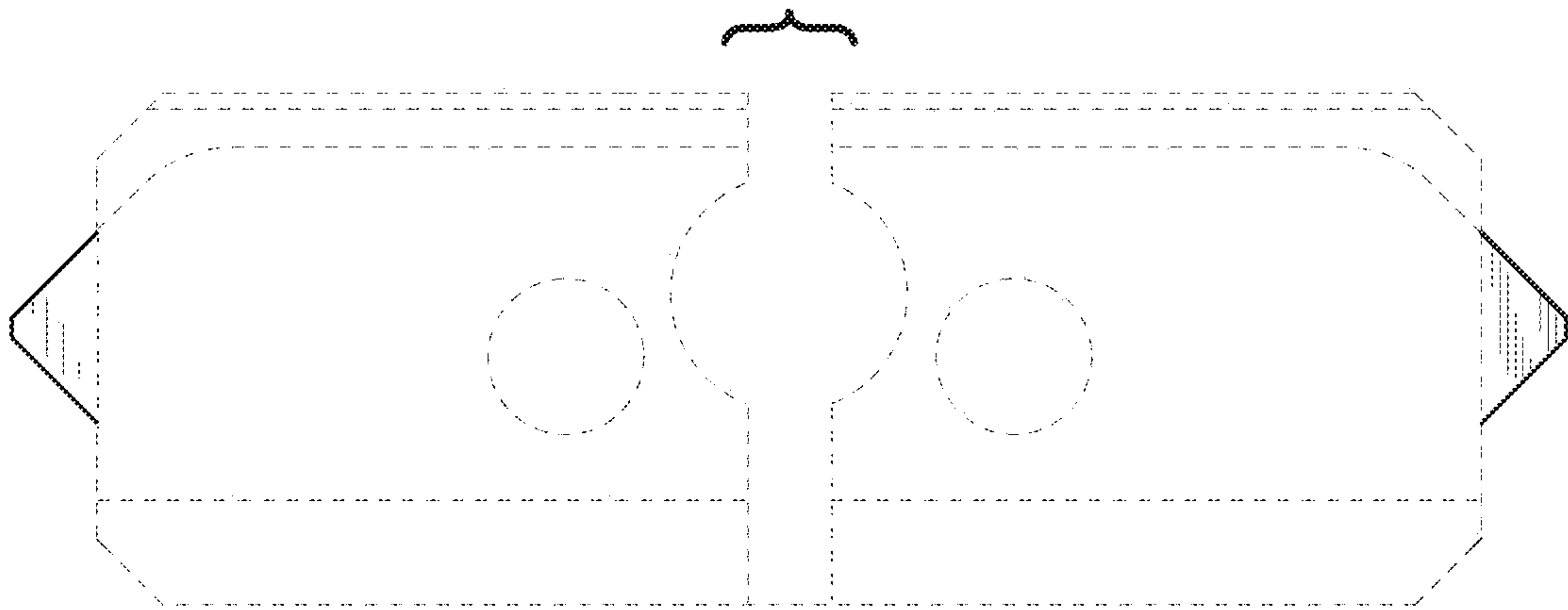

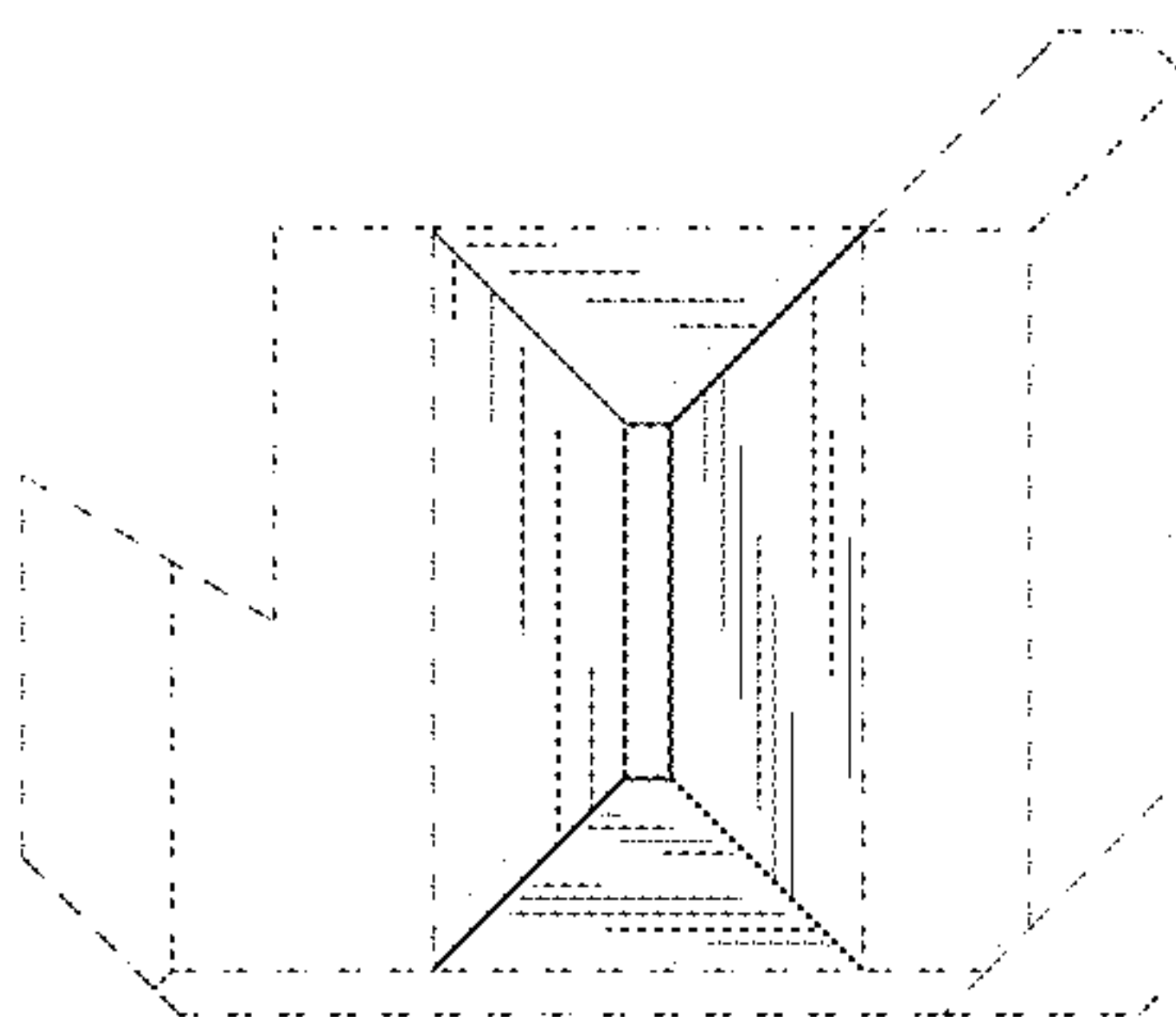

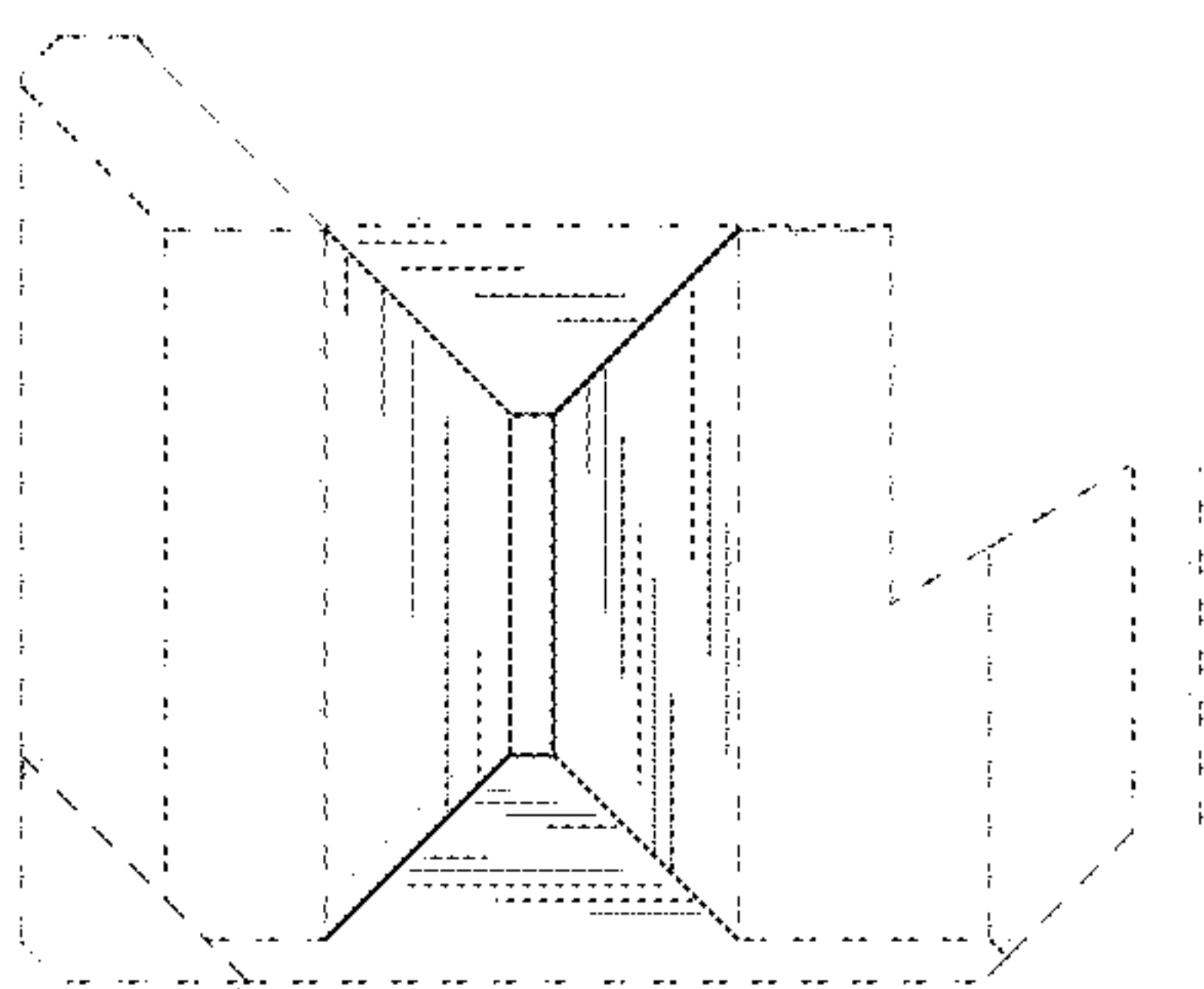

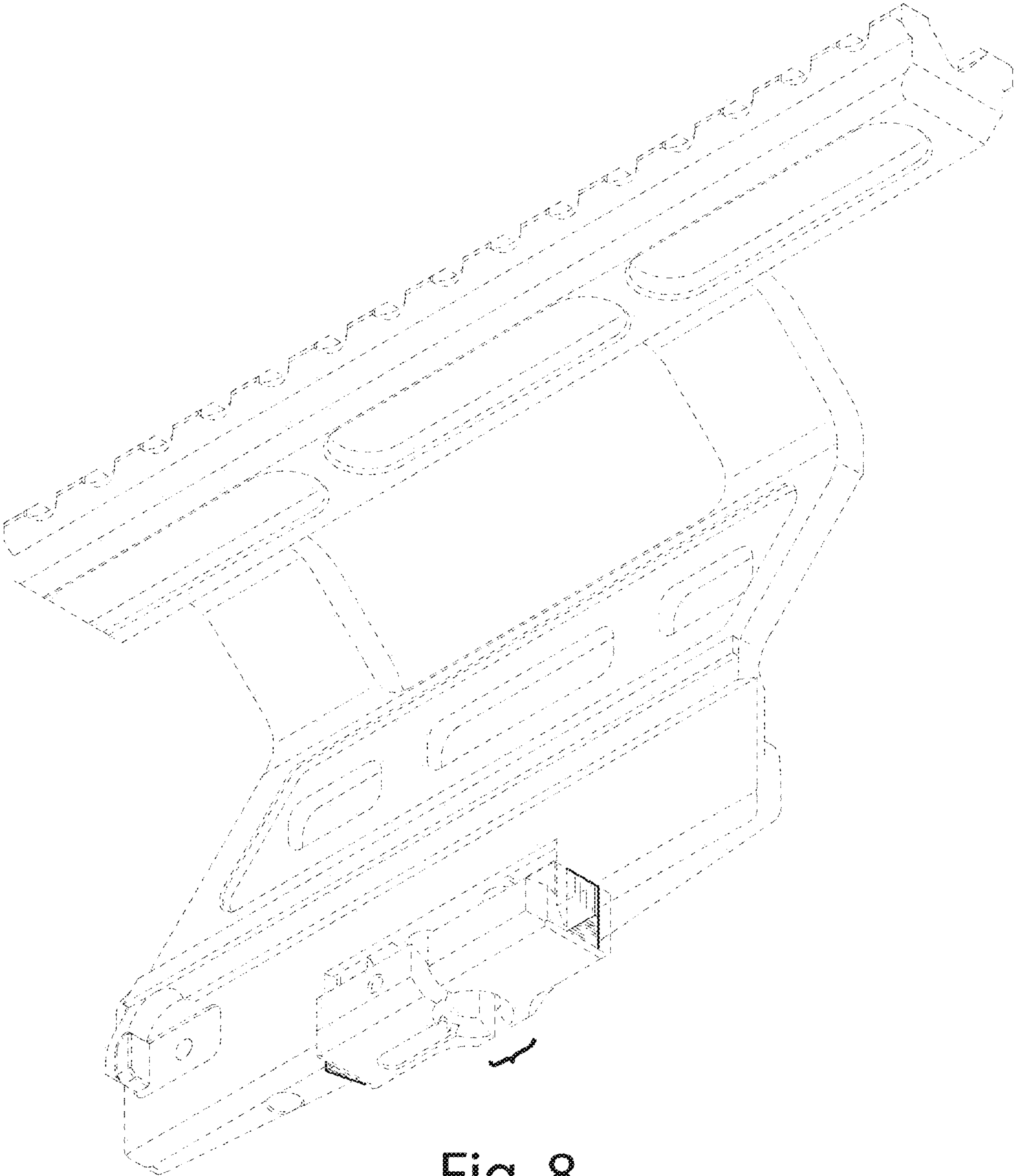
