FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

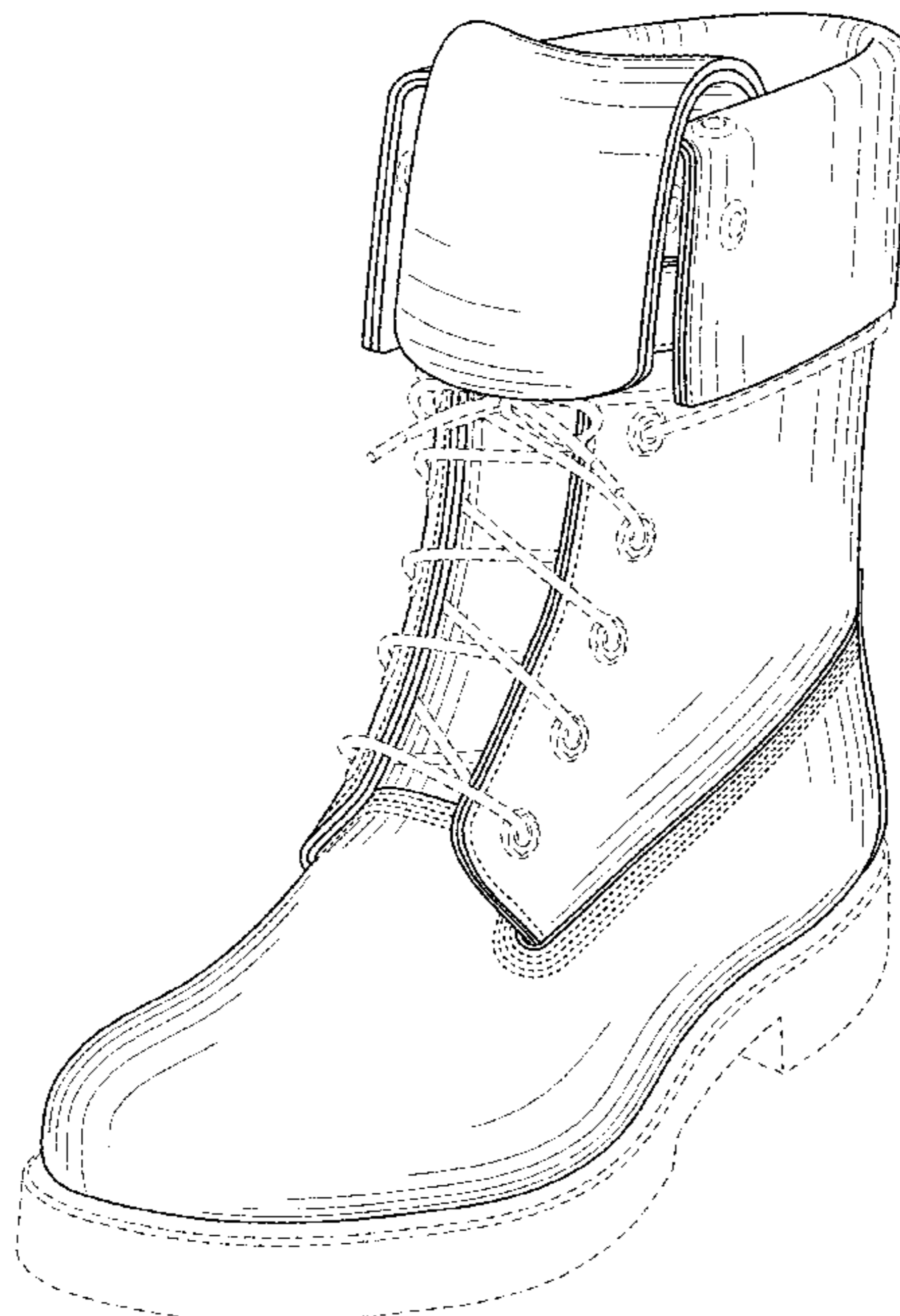

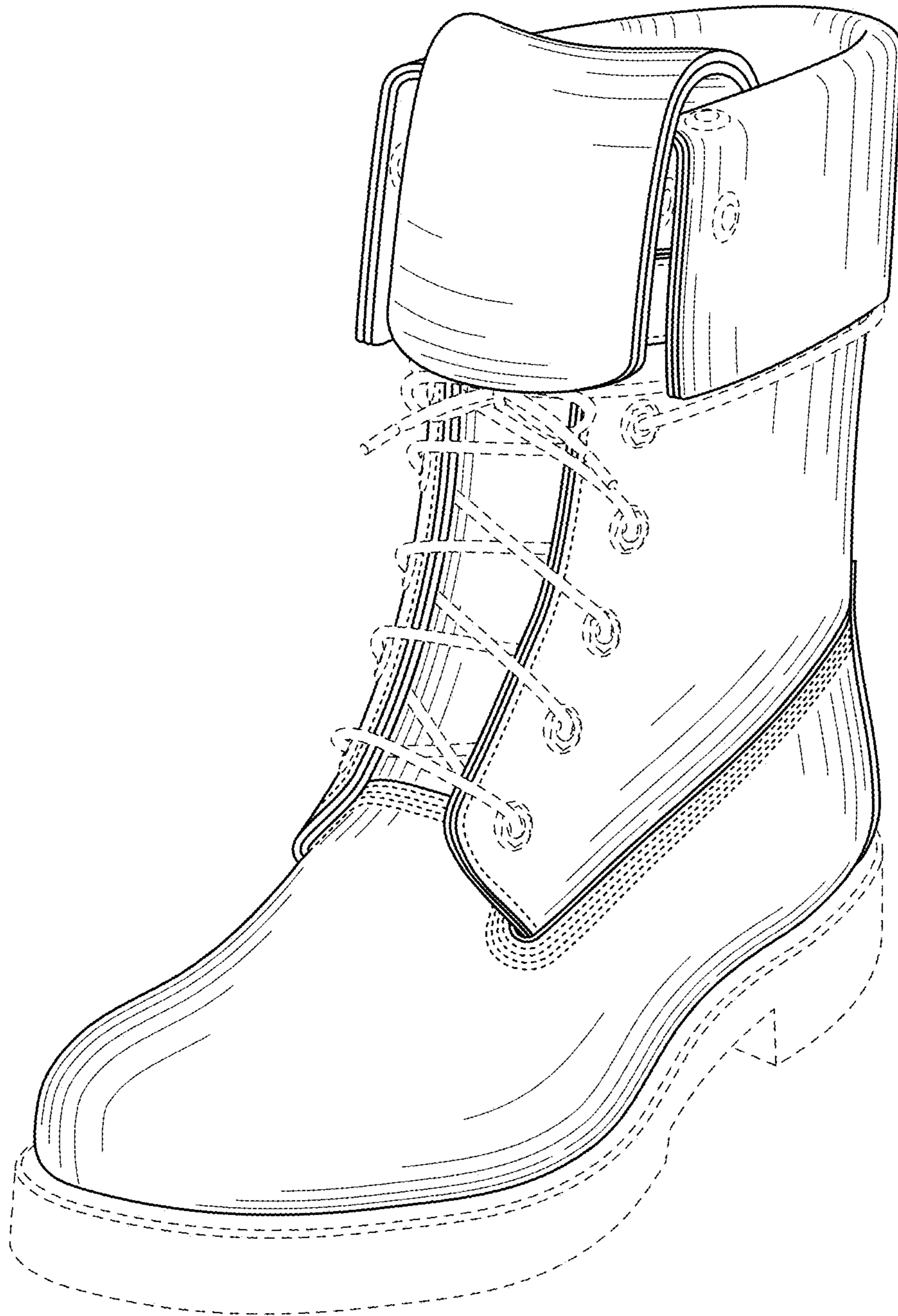

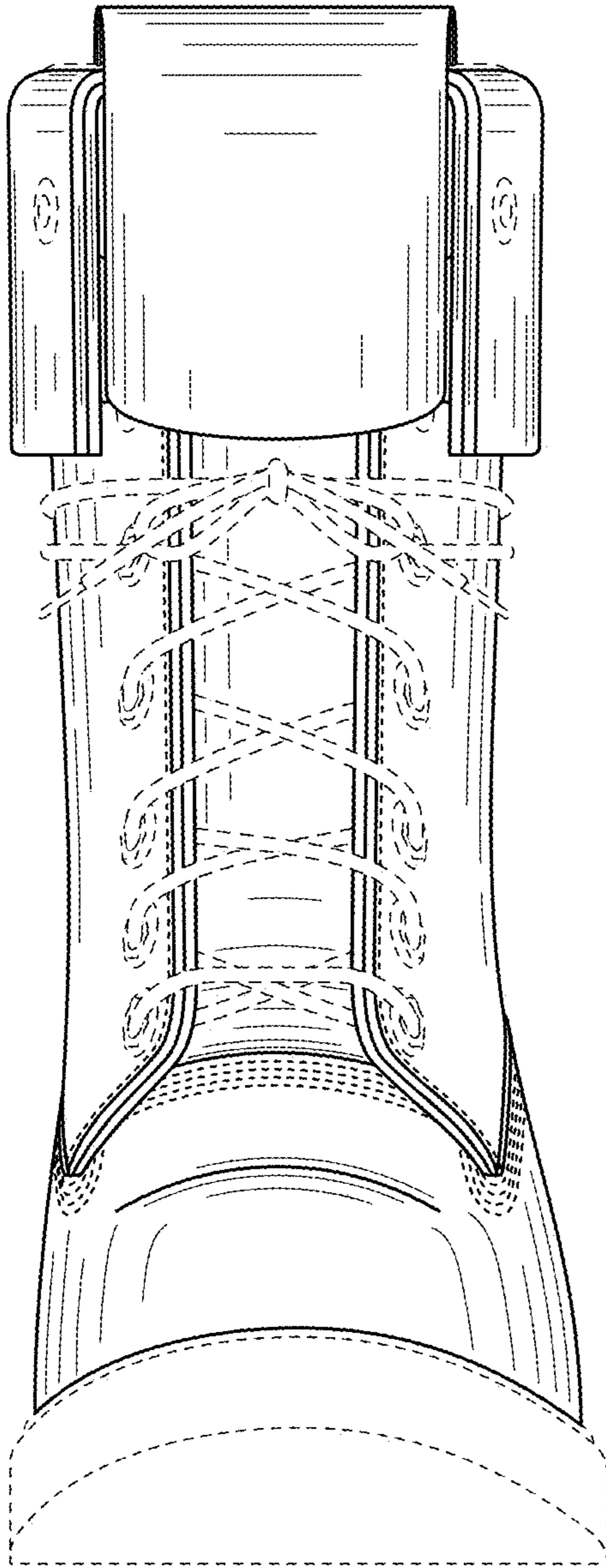

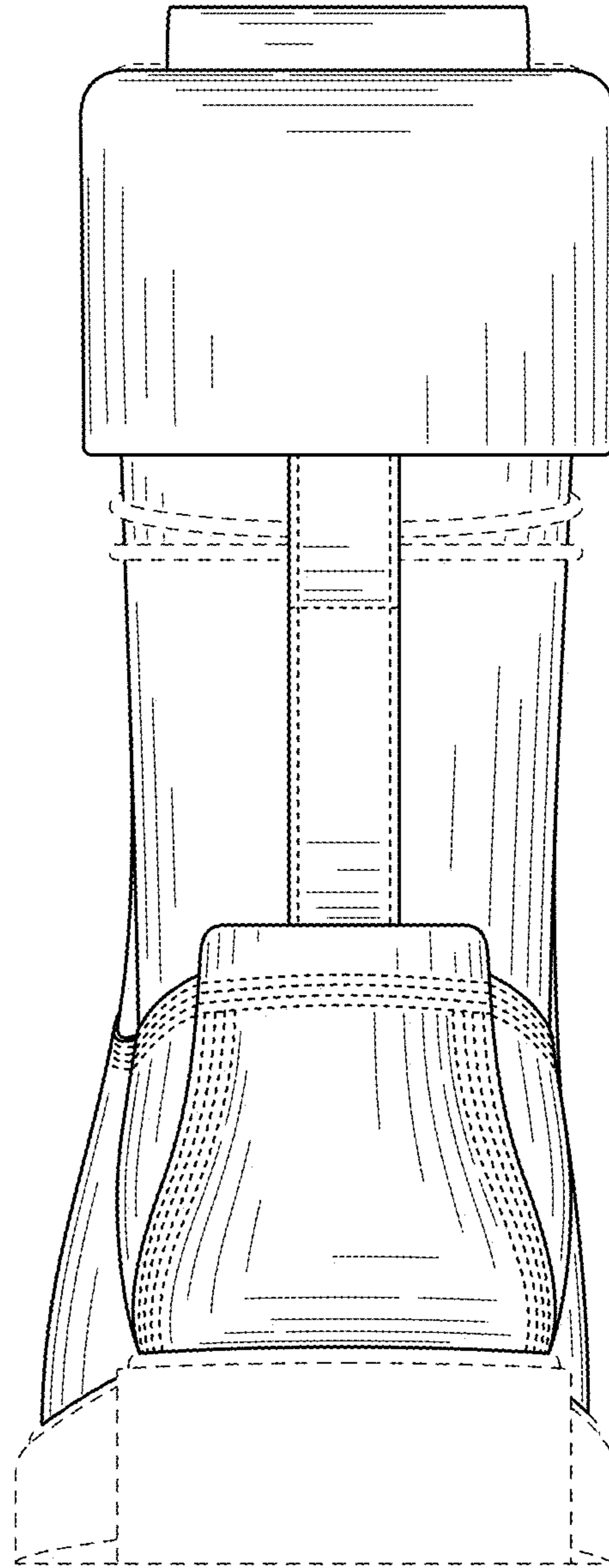

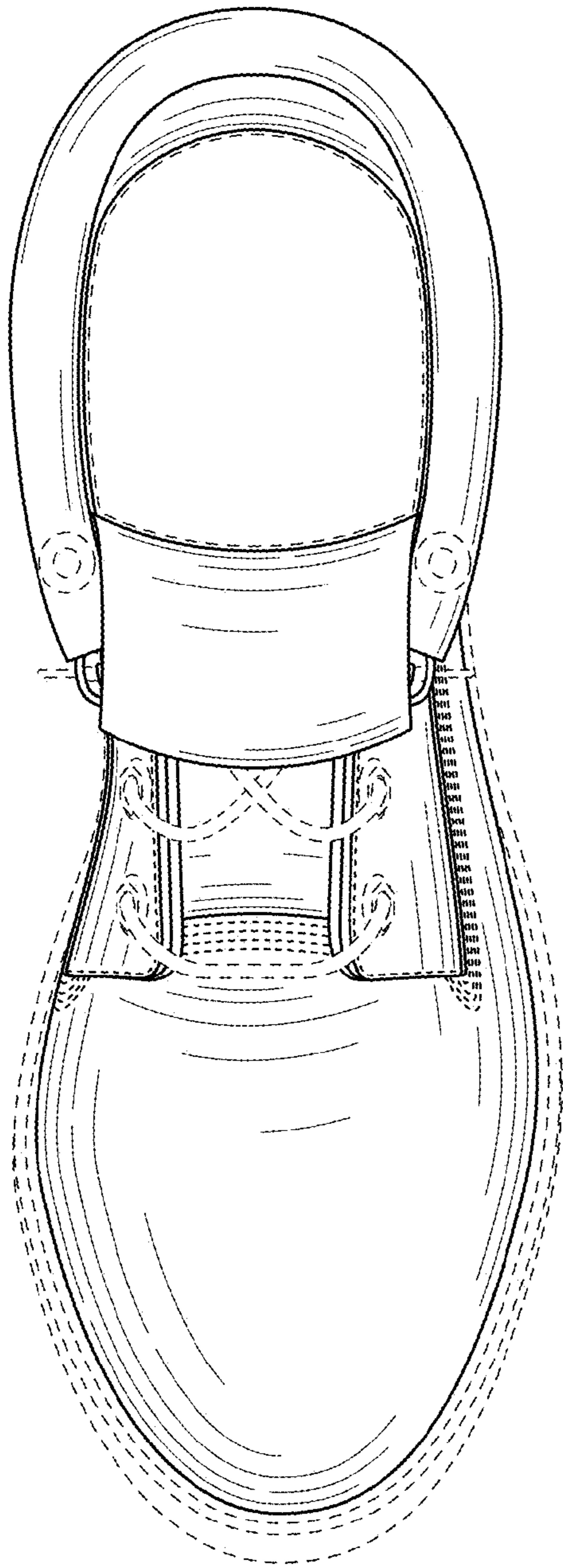

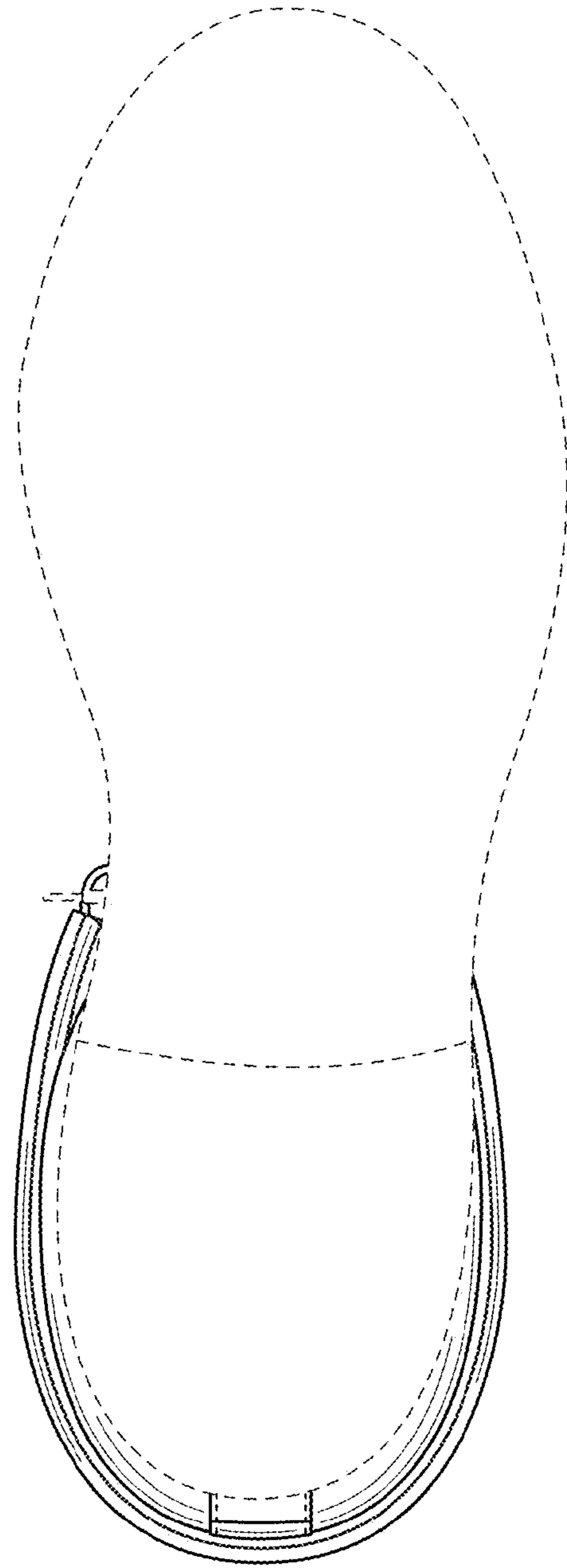
