I claim the ornamental design for a slim vanity mirror with embedded protruding lights, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a slim vanity mirror with embedded protruding lights, showing a first embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 24 is a left side view of the fourth alternative embodiment;  
FIG. 25 is a right side view of the fourth alternative embodiment;

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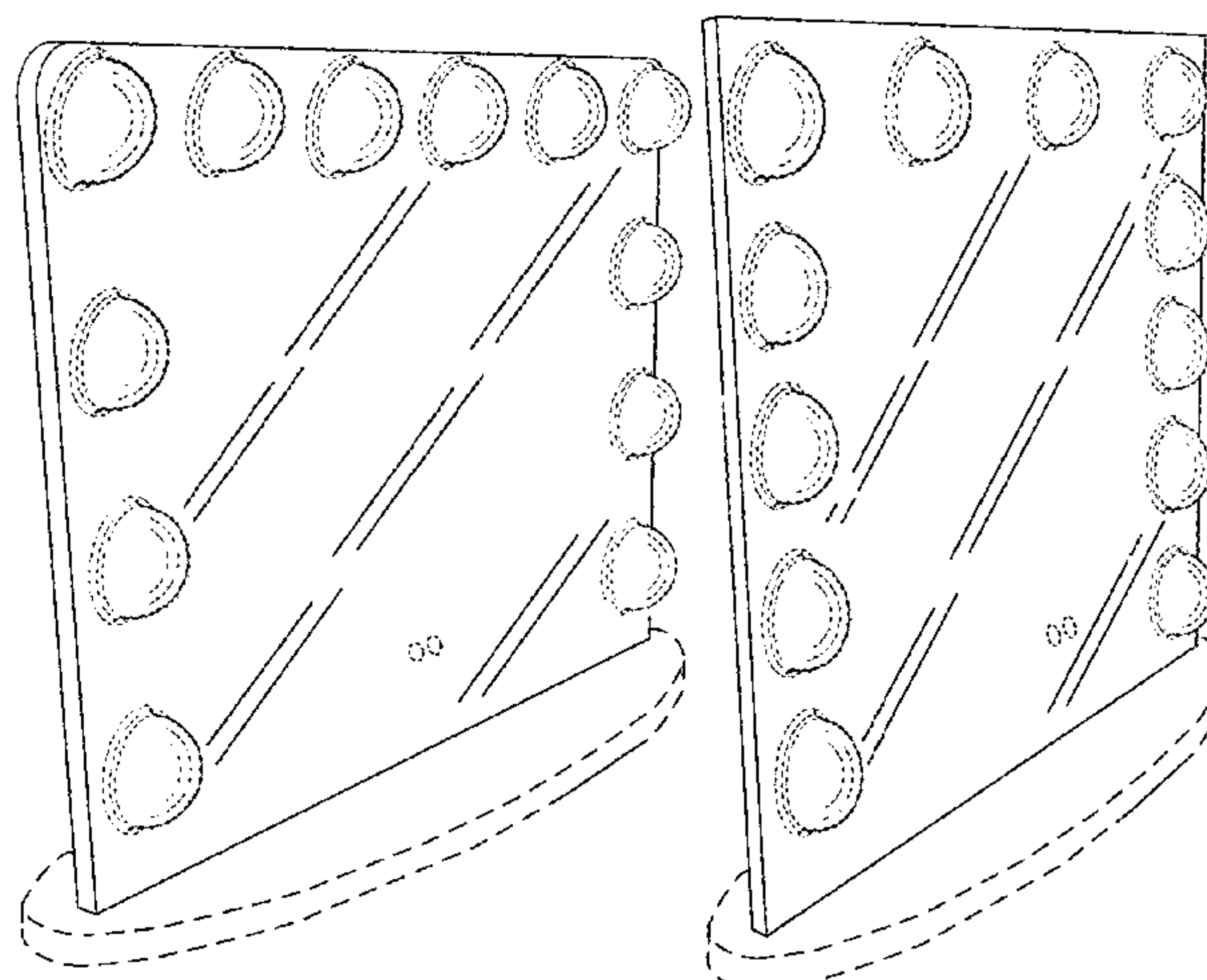


FIG. 26 is a front view of a fifth alternative embodiment of a slim vanity mirror with embedded protruding lights;

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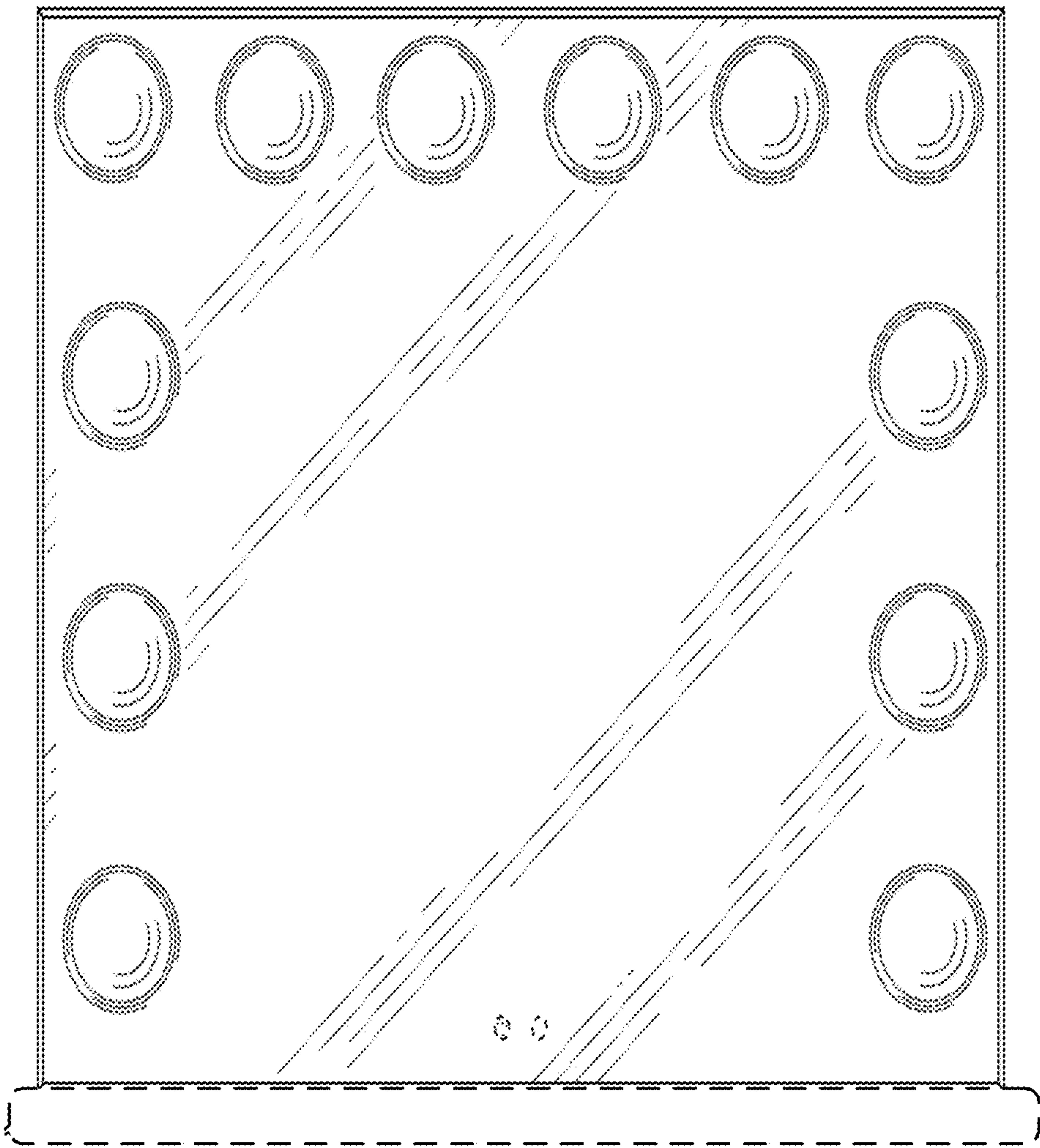
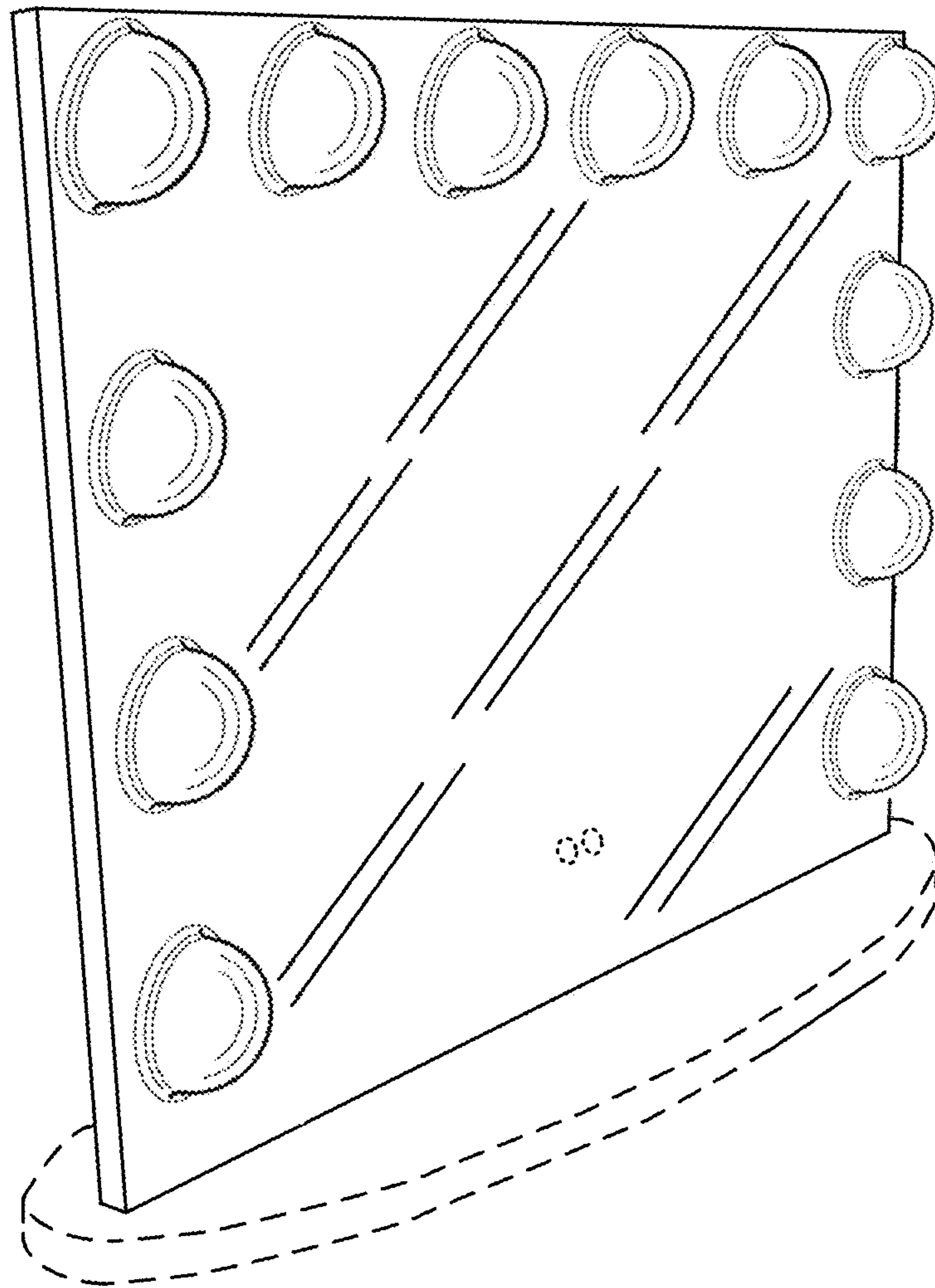

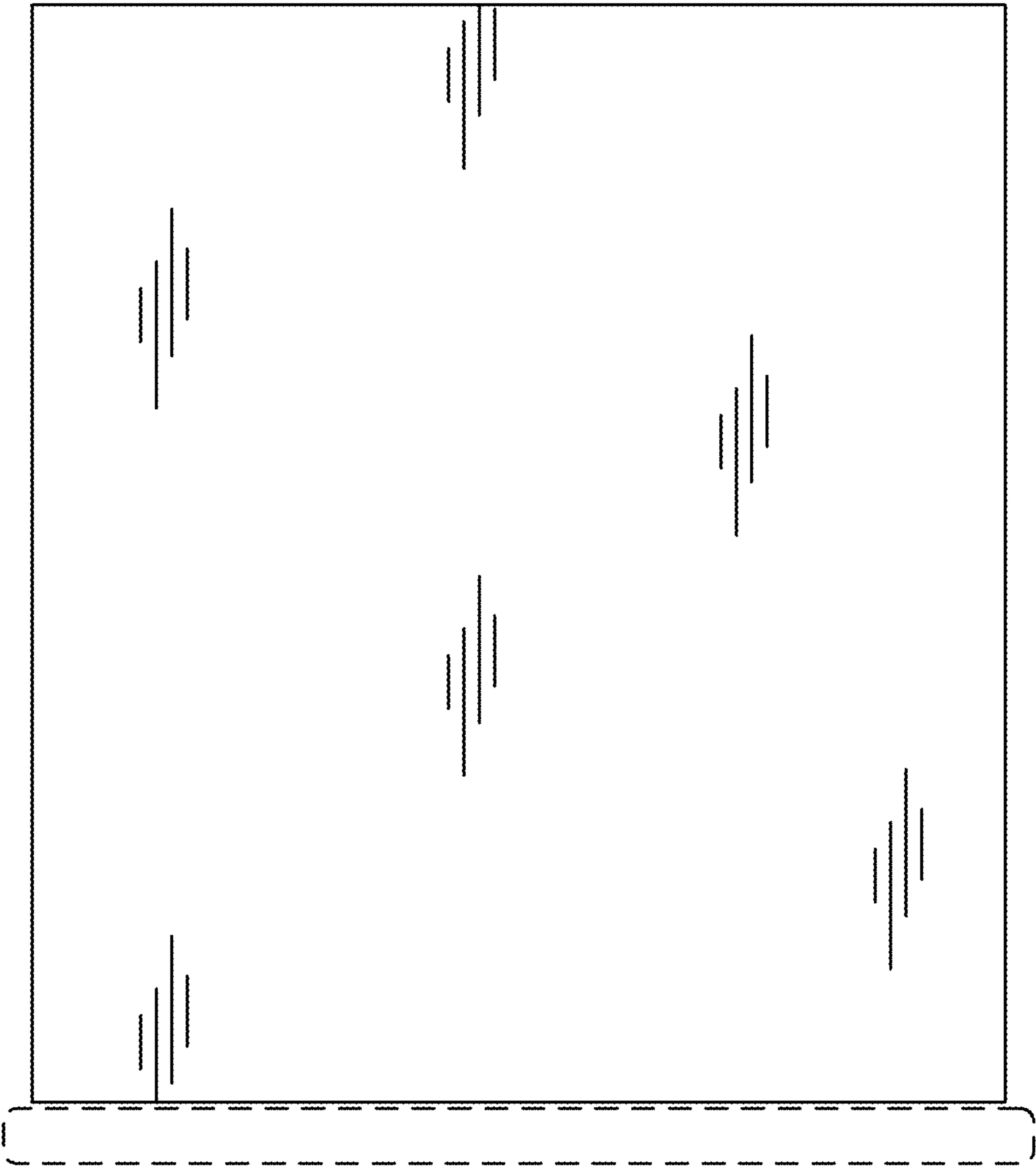

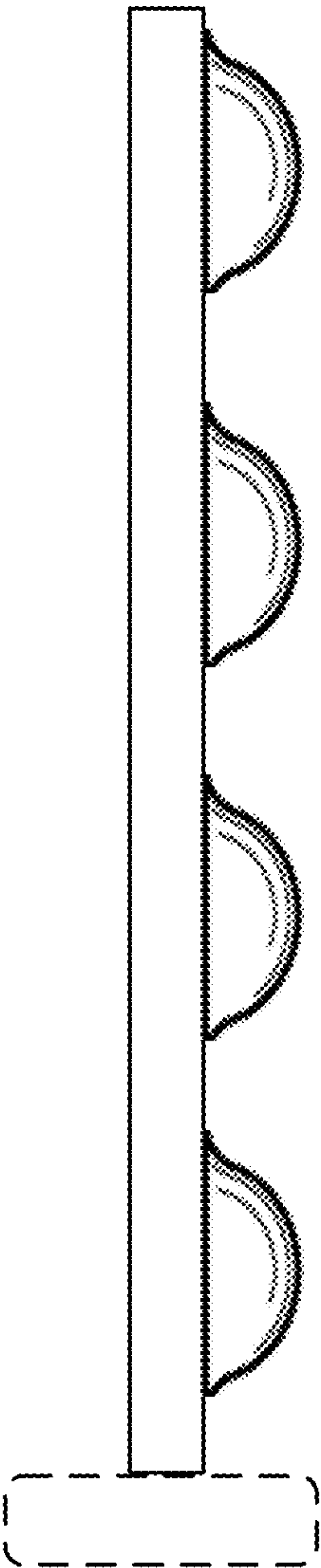

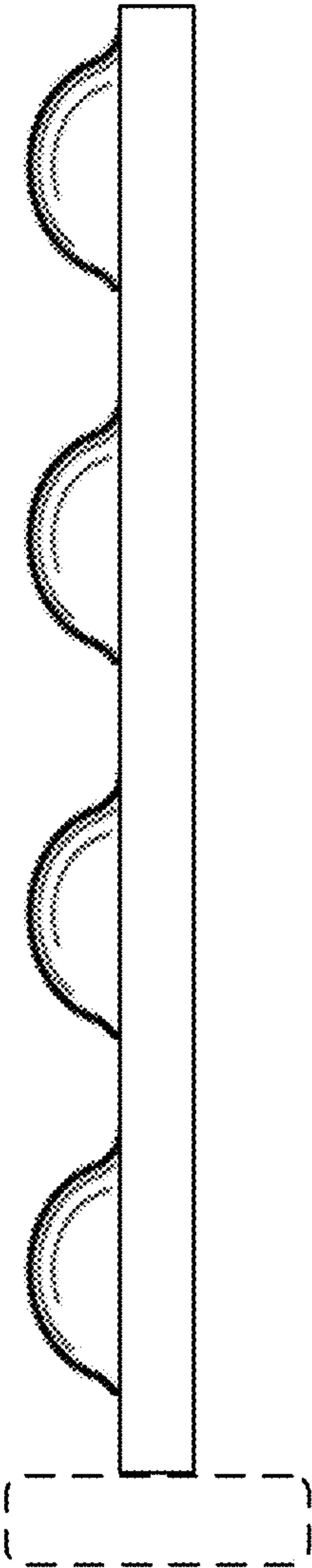

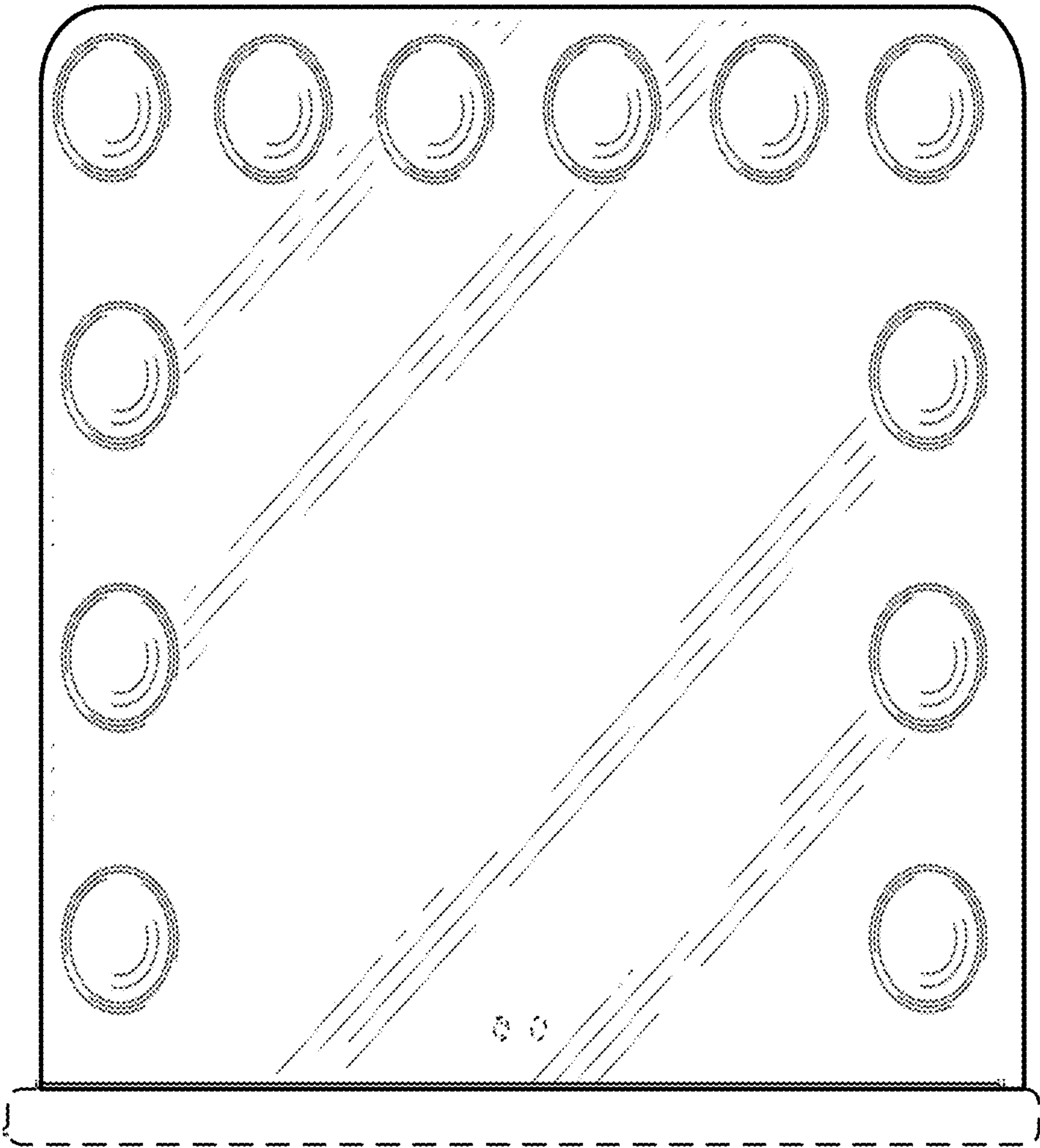
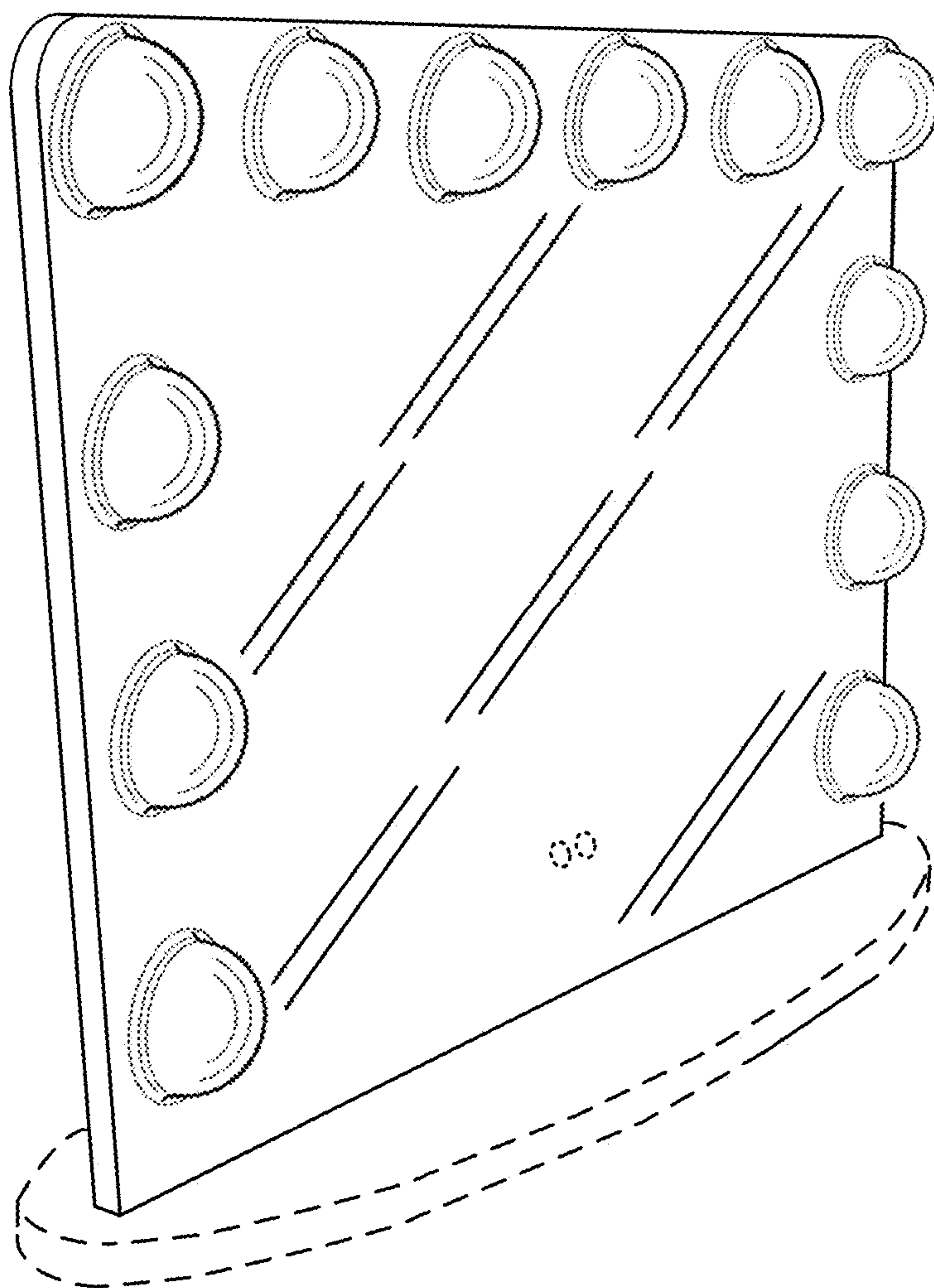

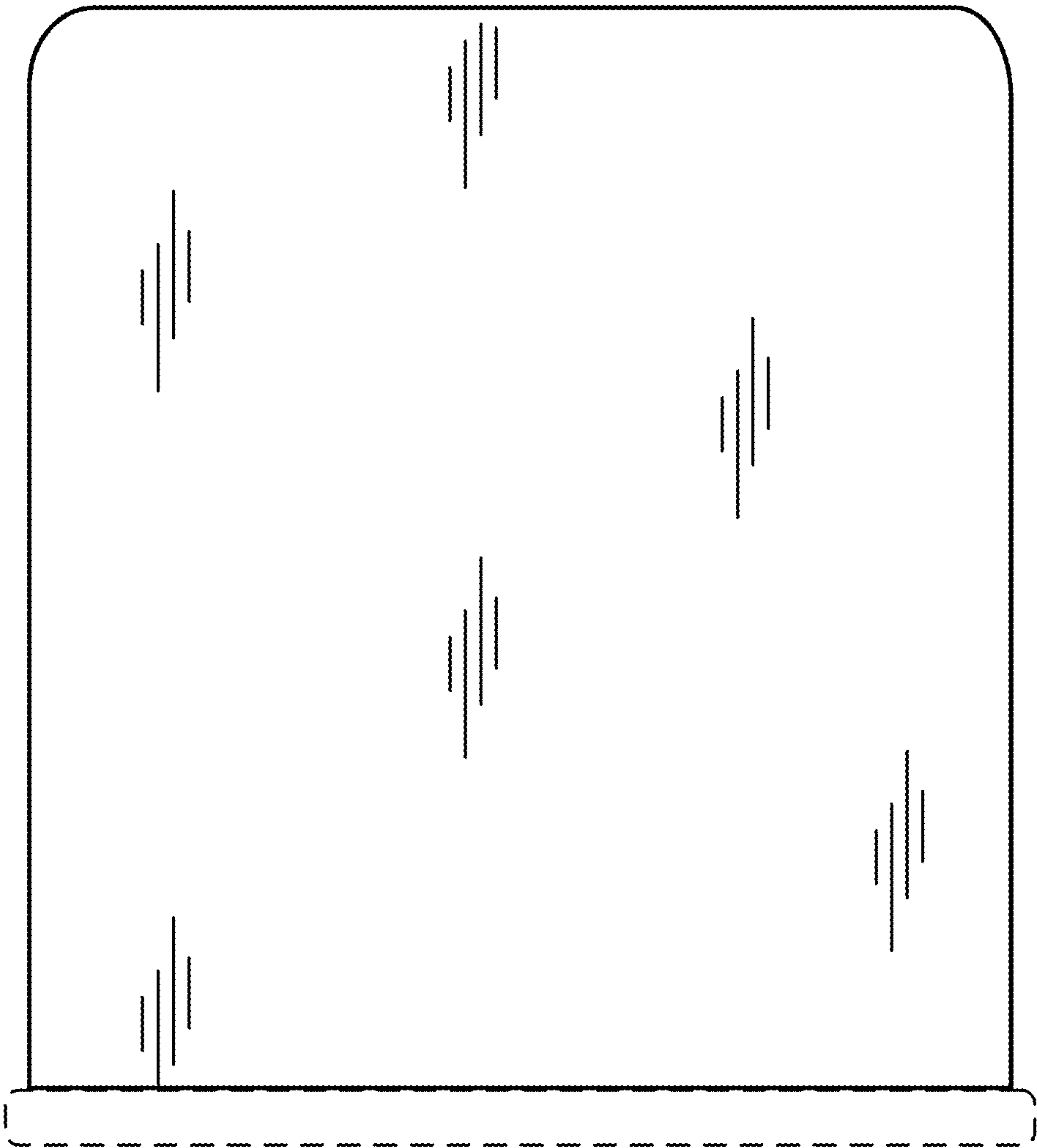

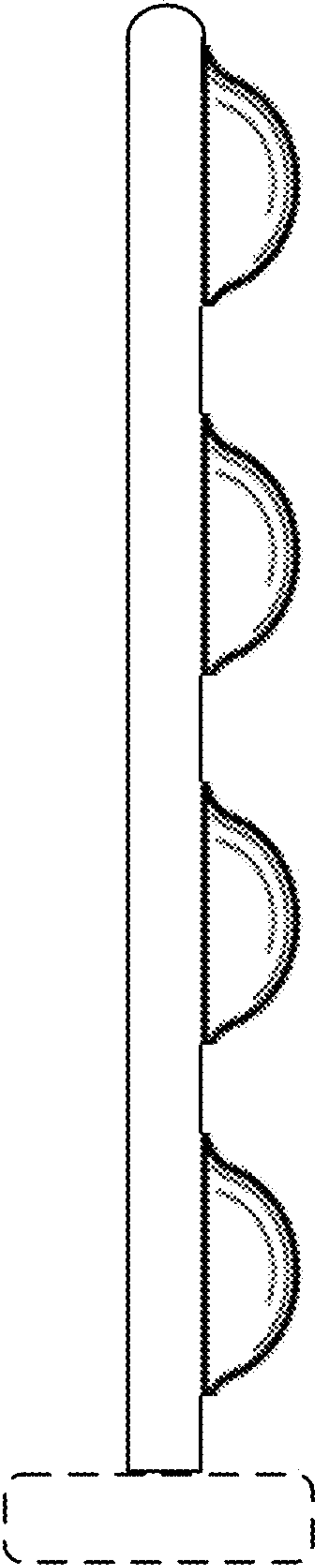

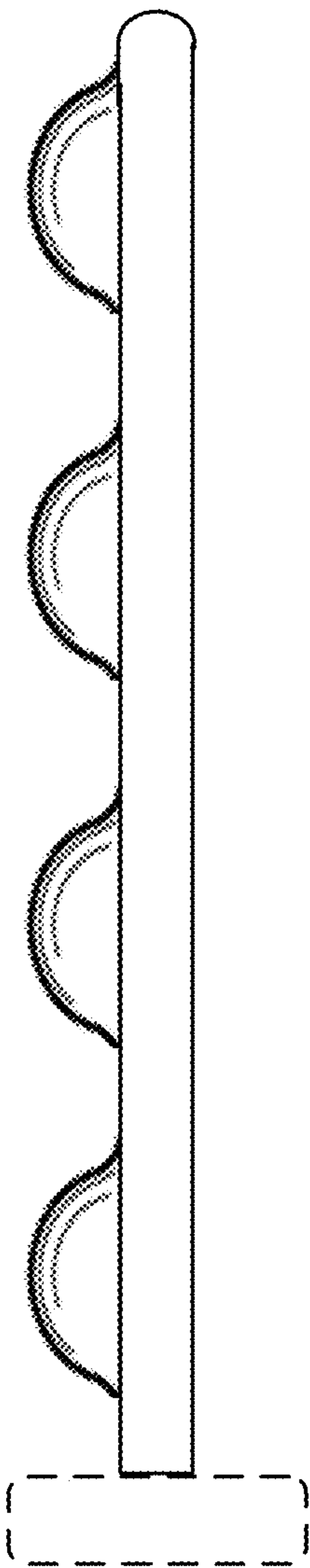
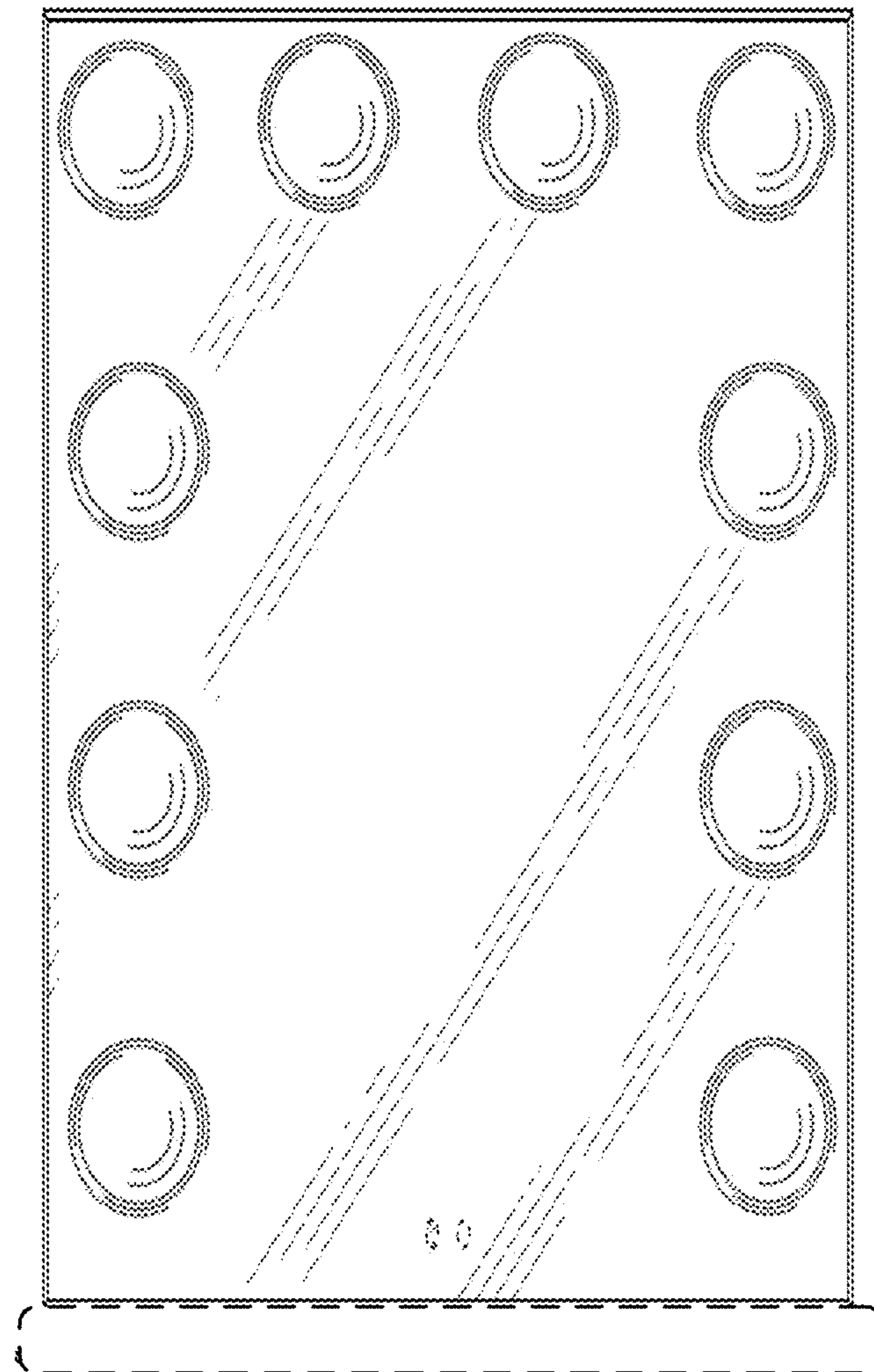
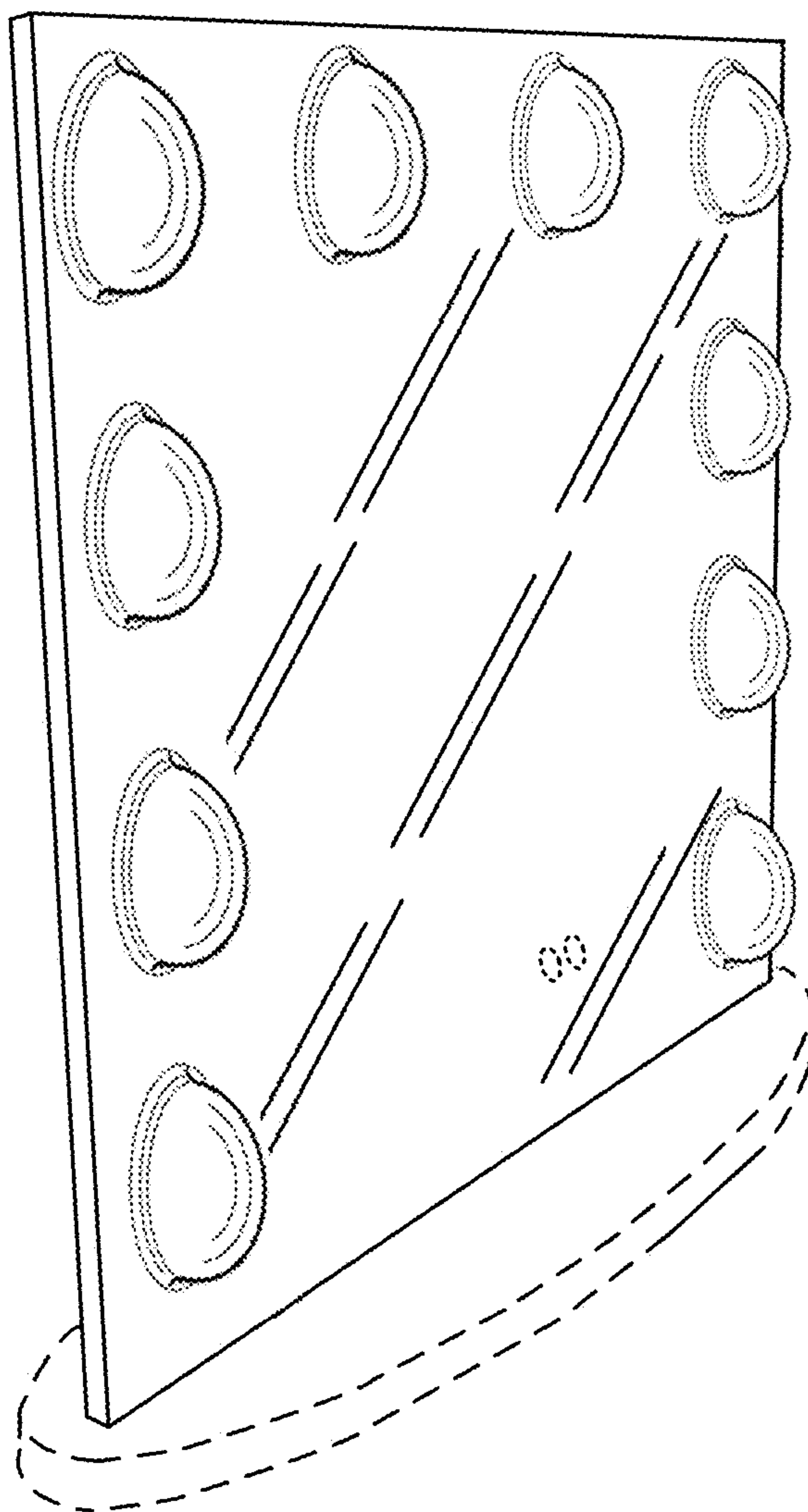

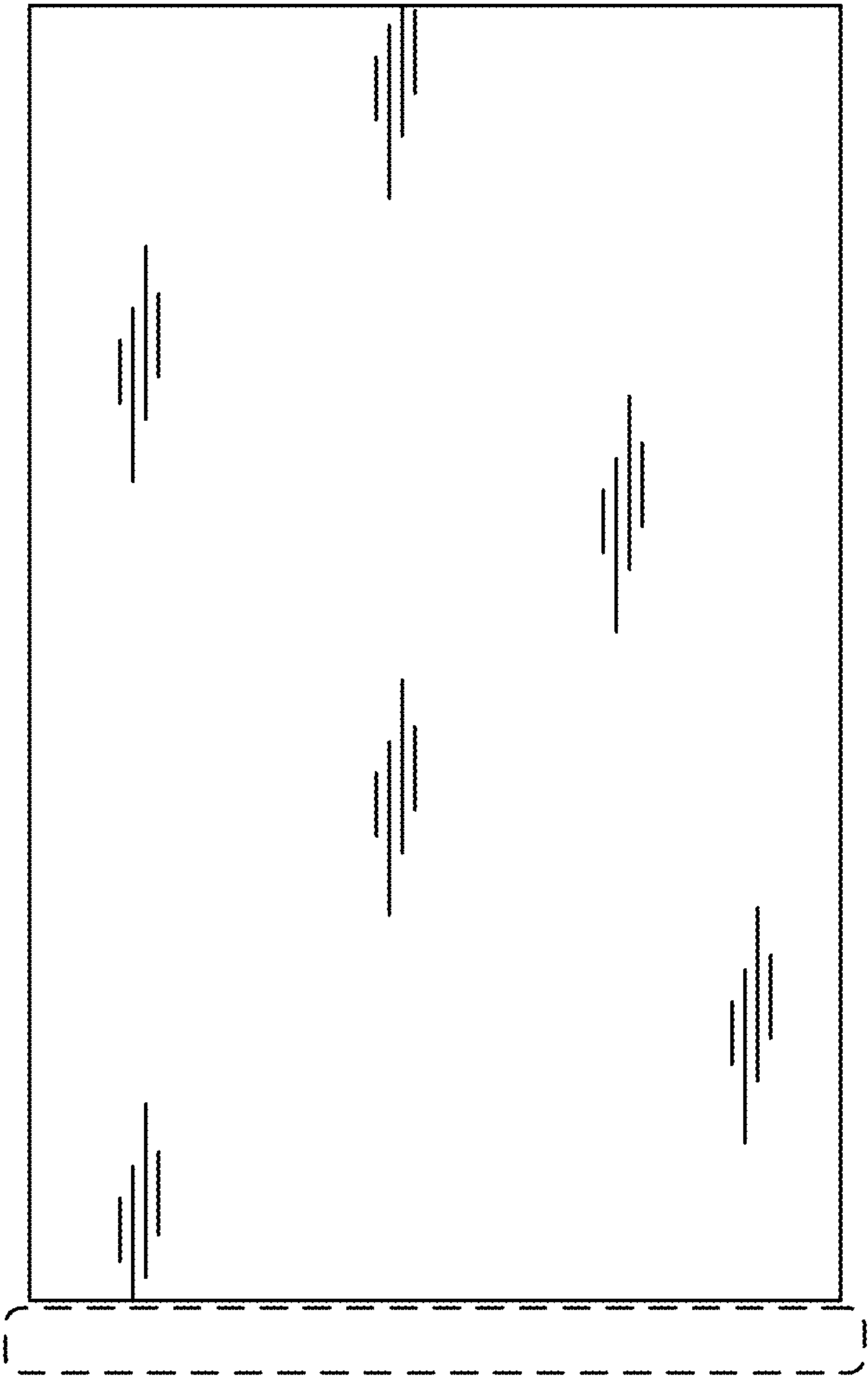

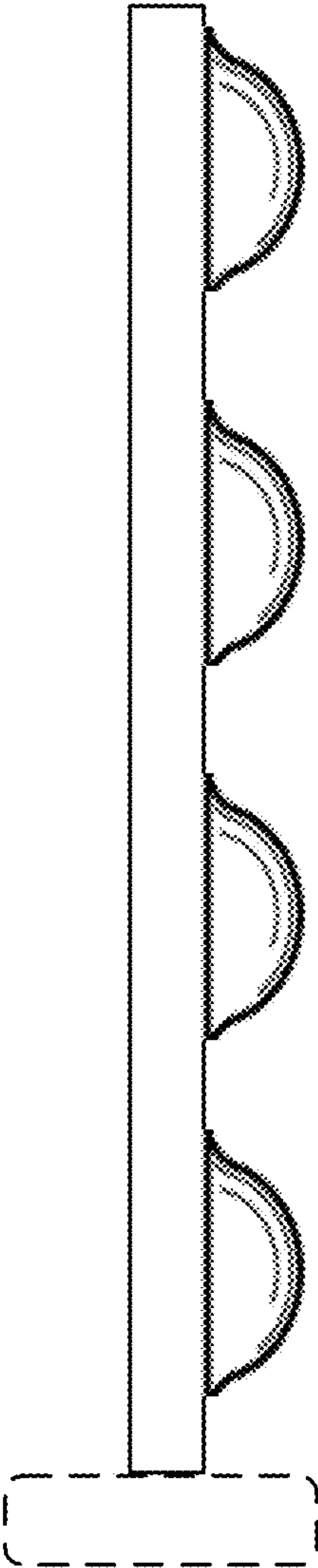

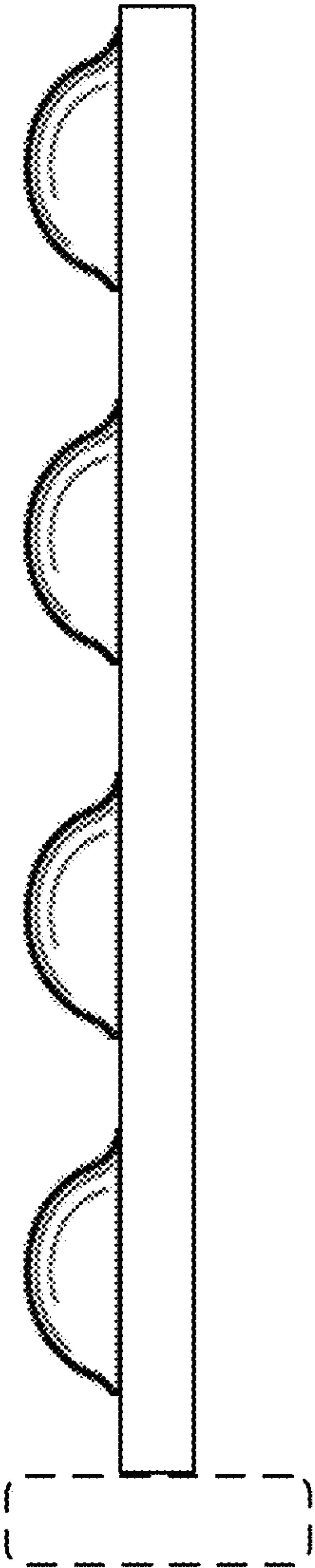
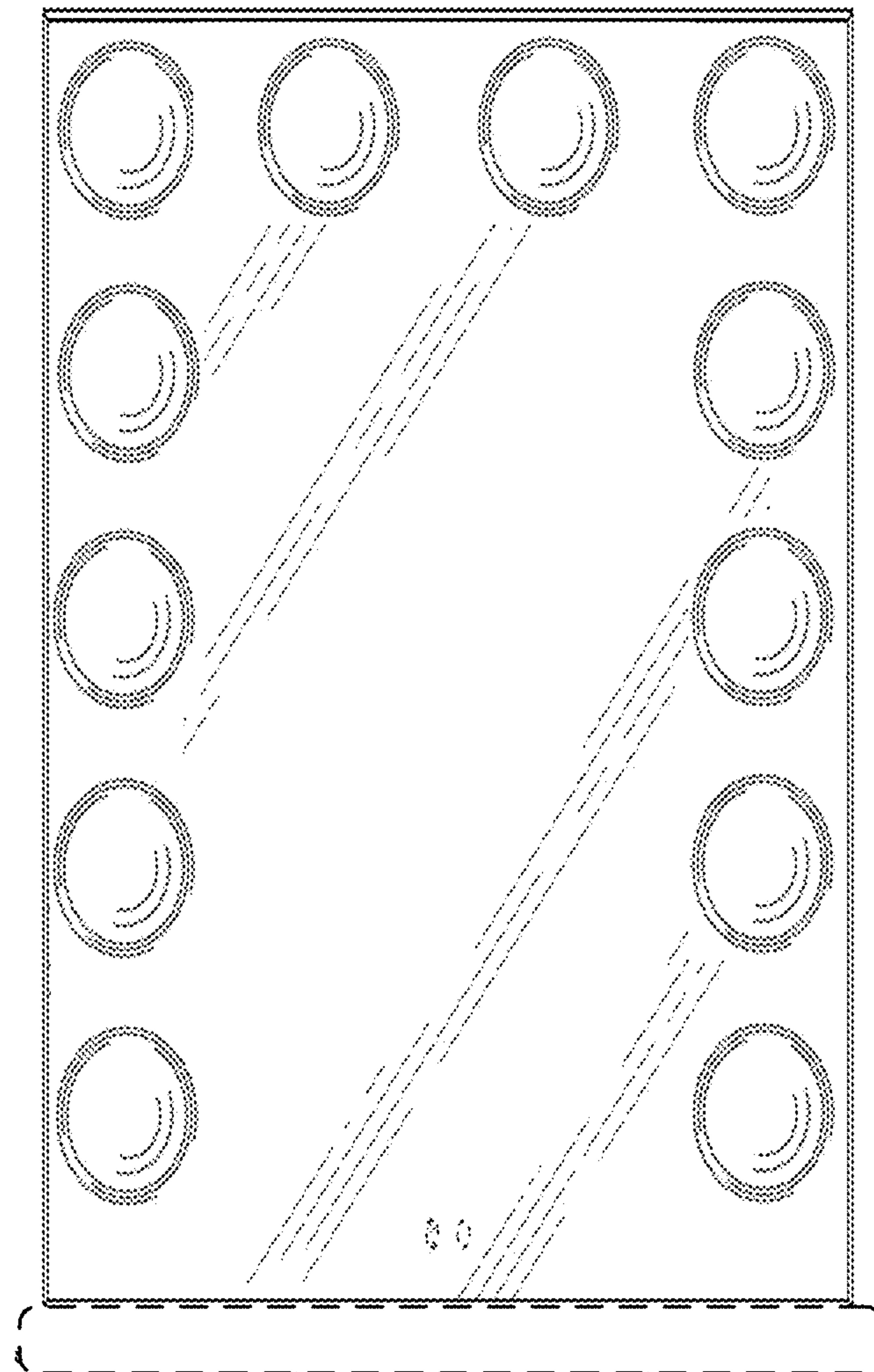
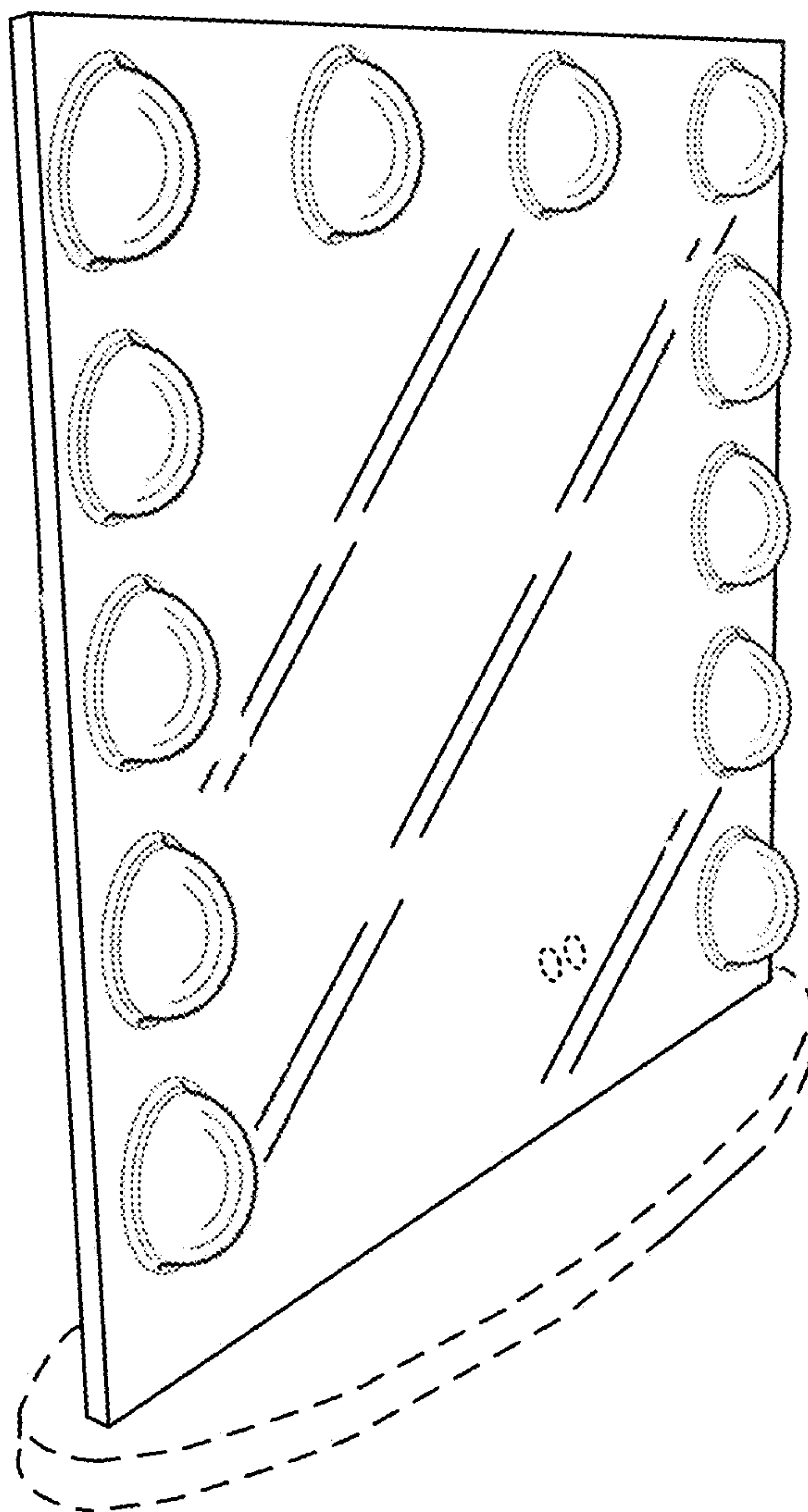

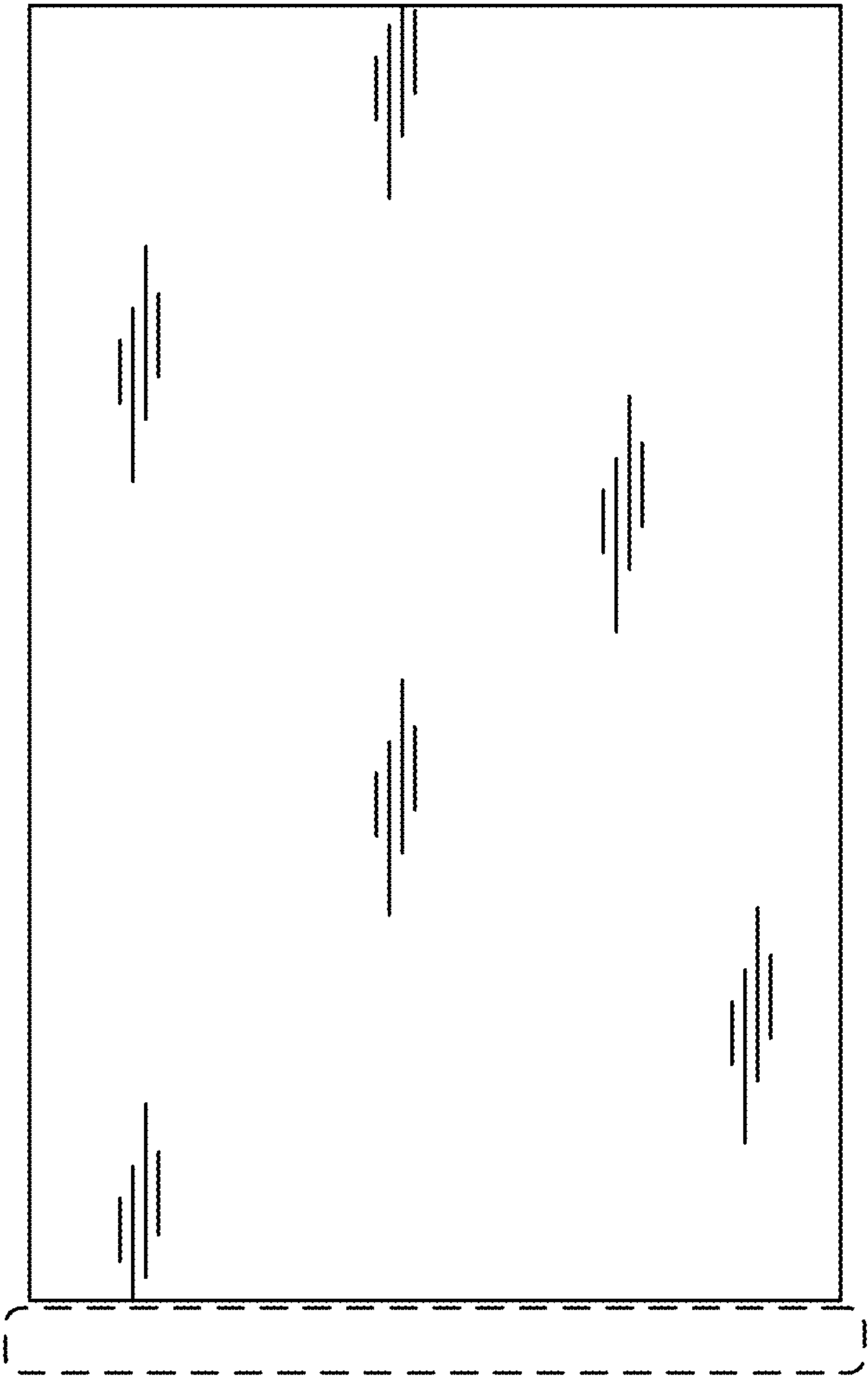

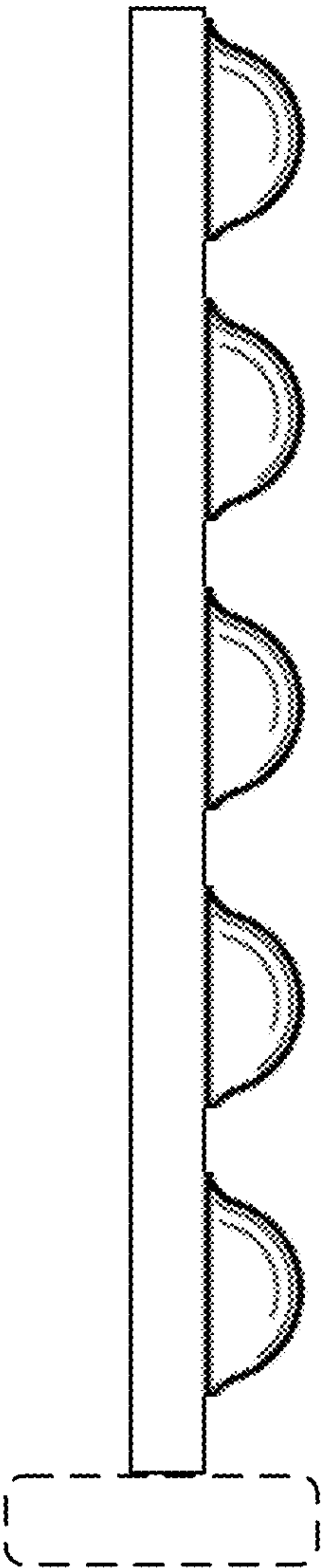

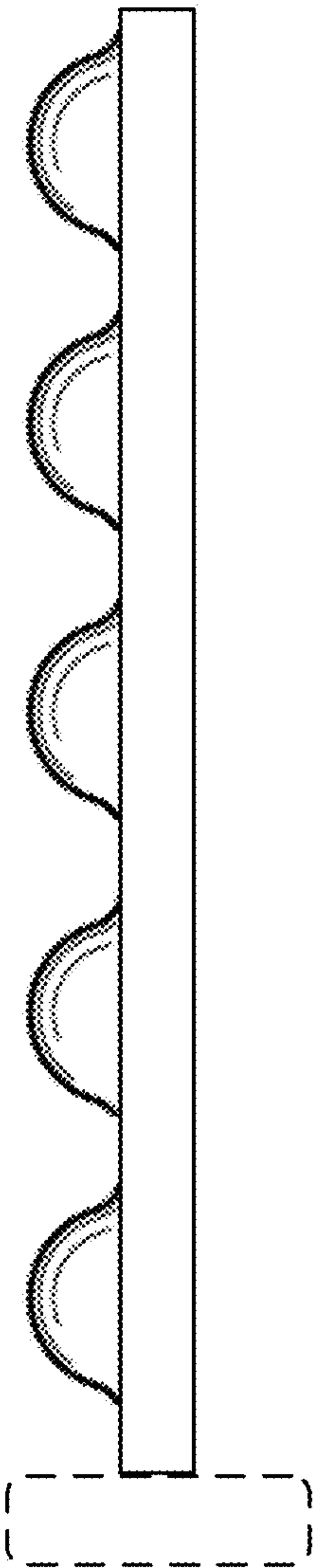

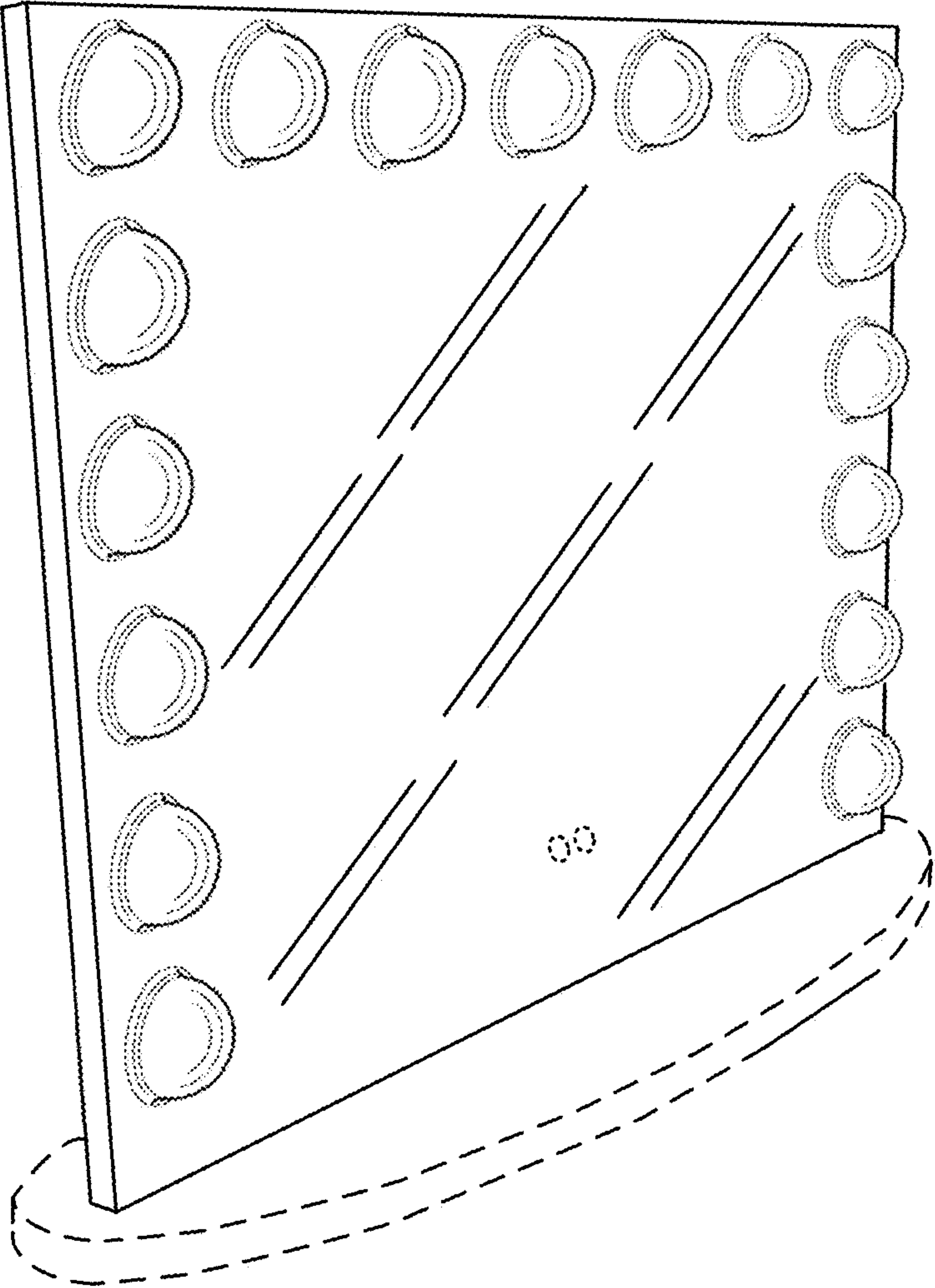

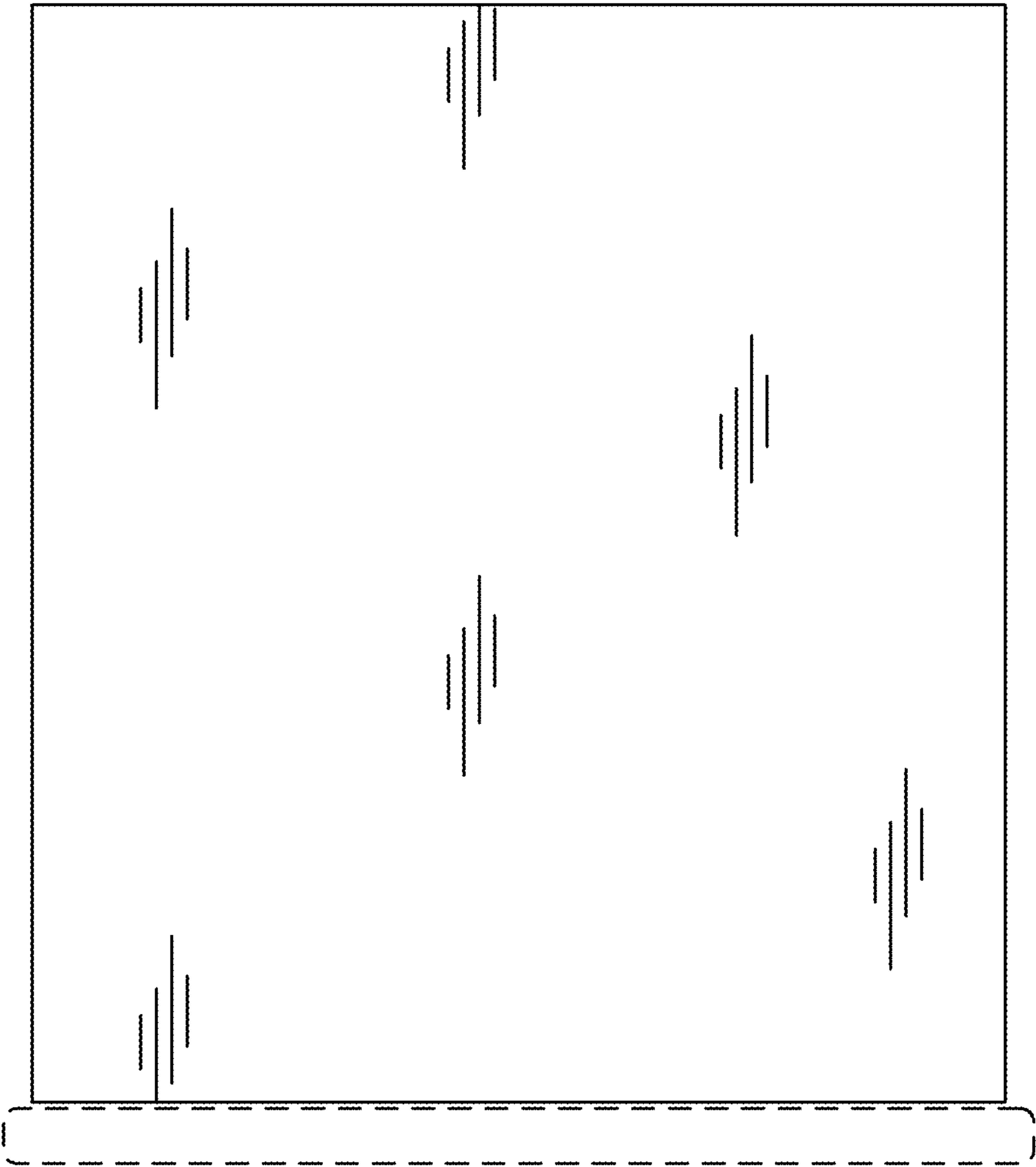

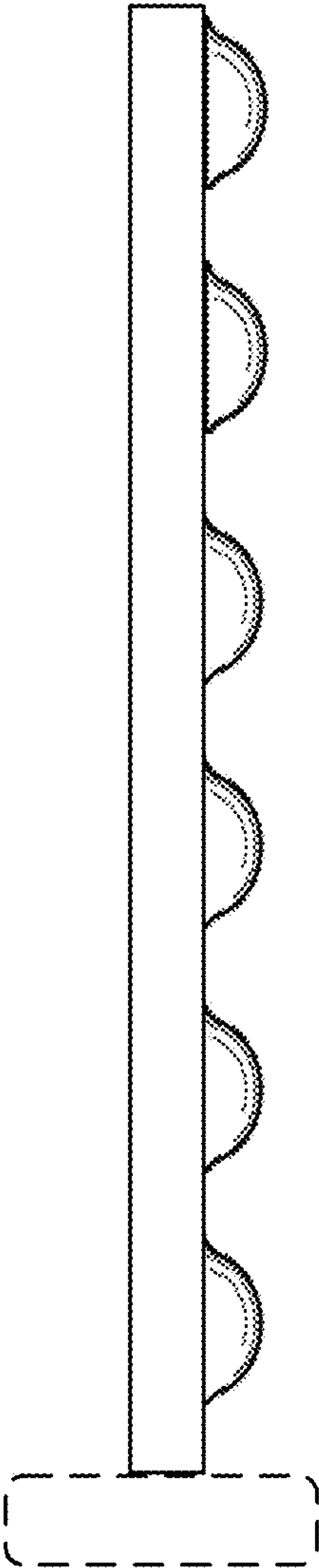

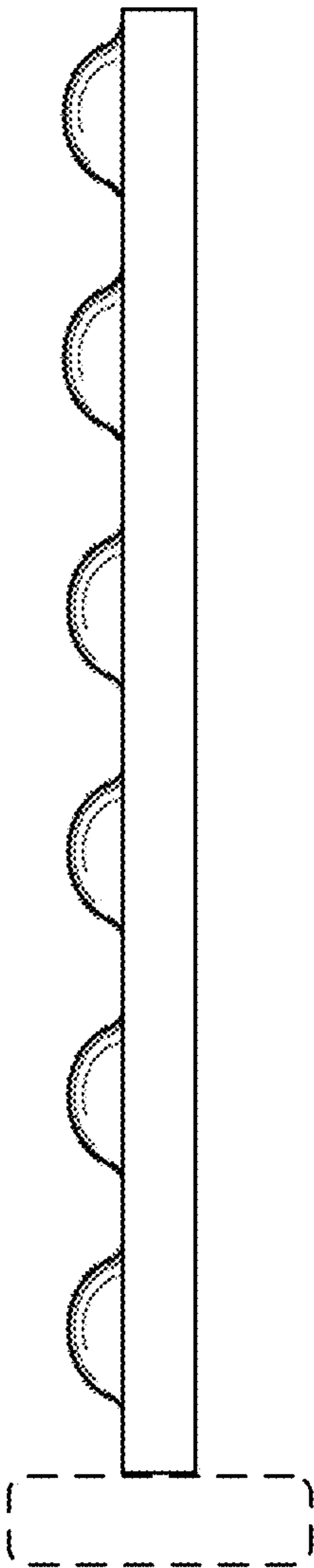

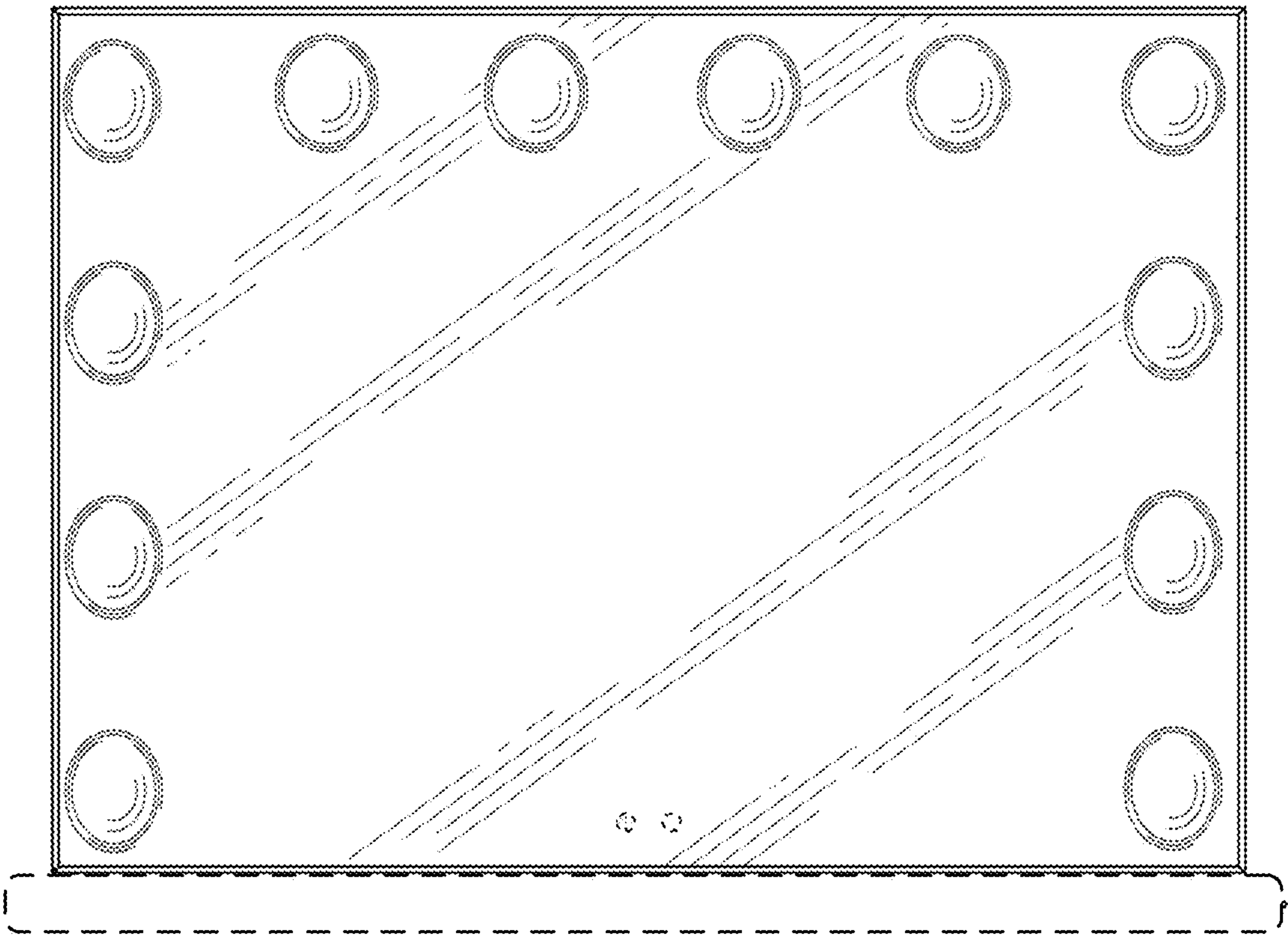
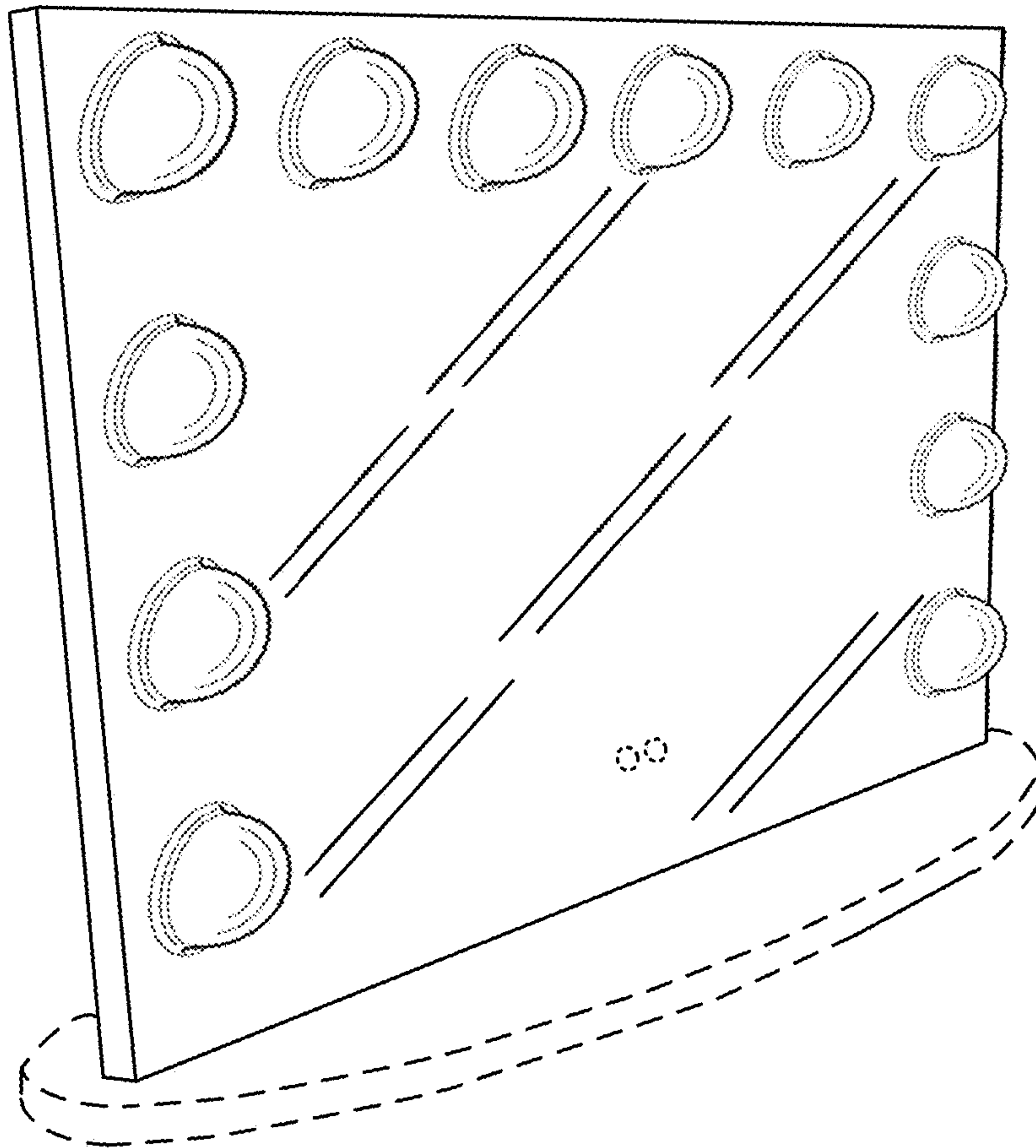

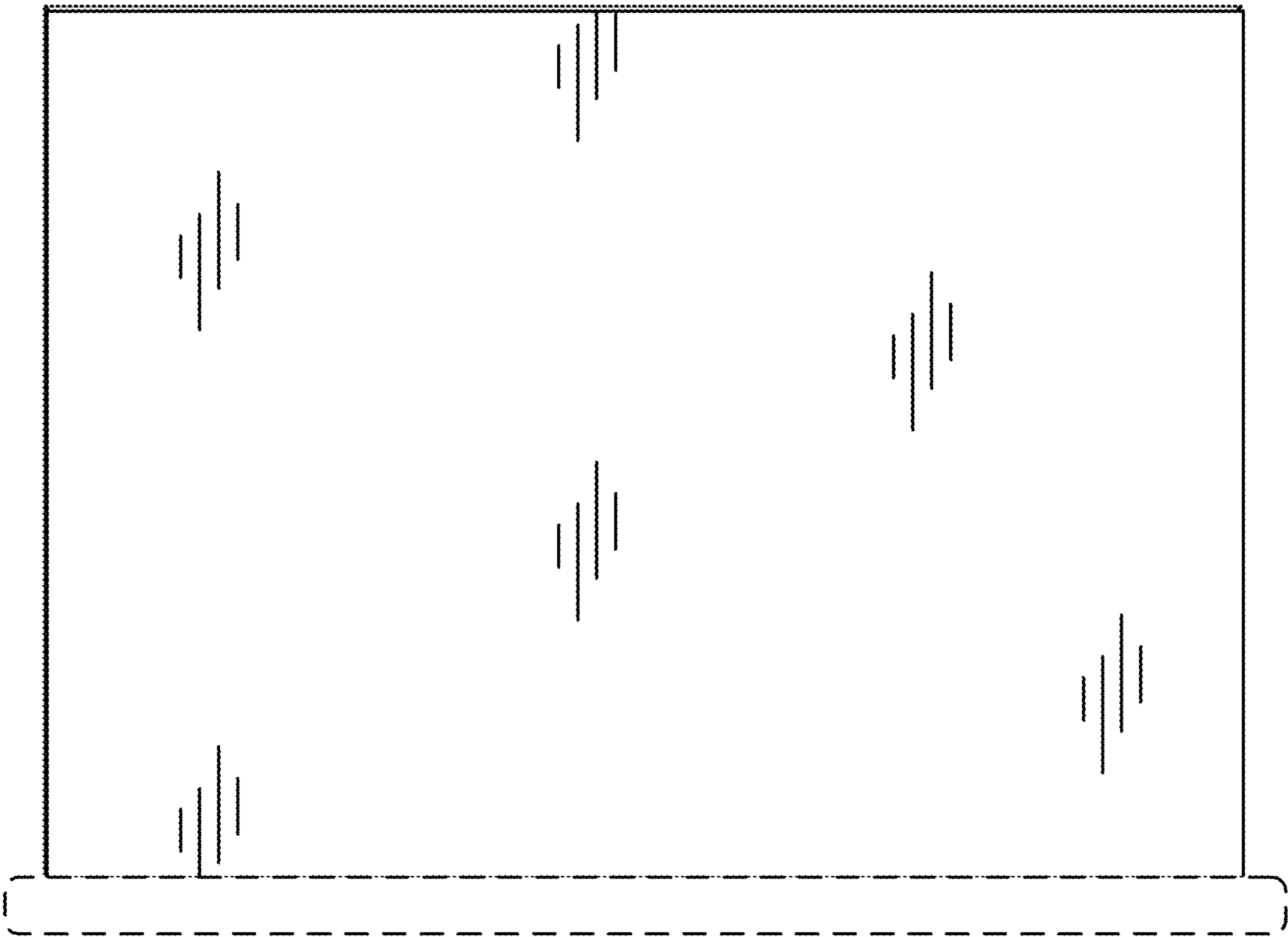

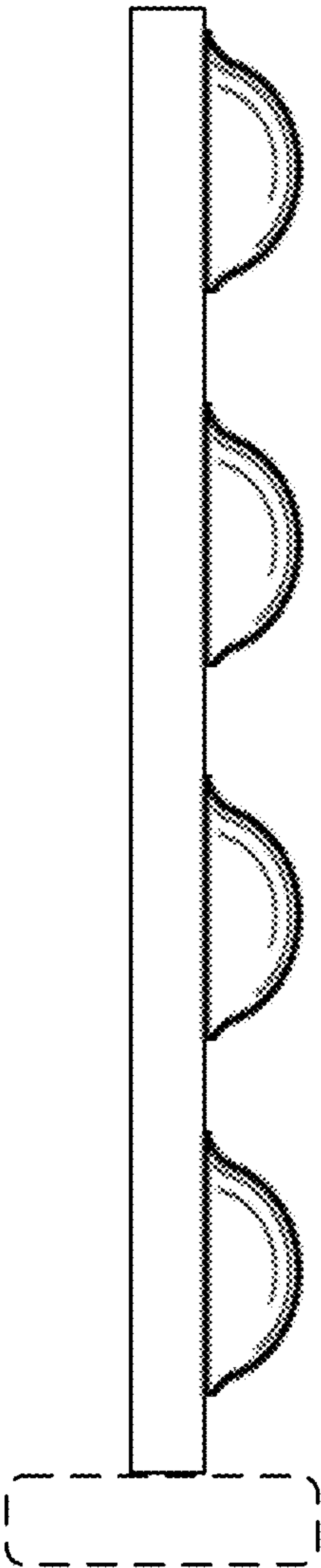

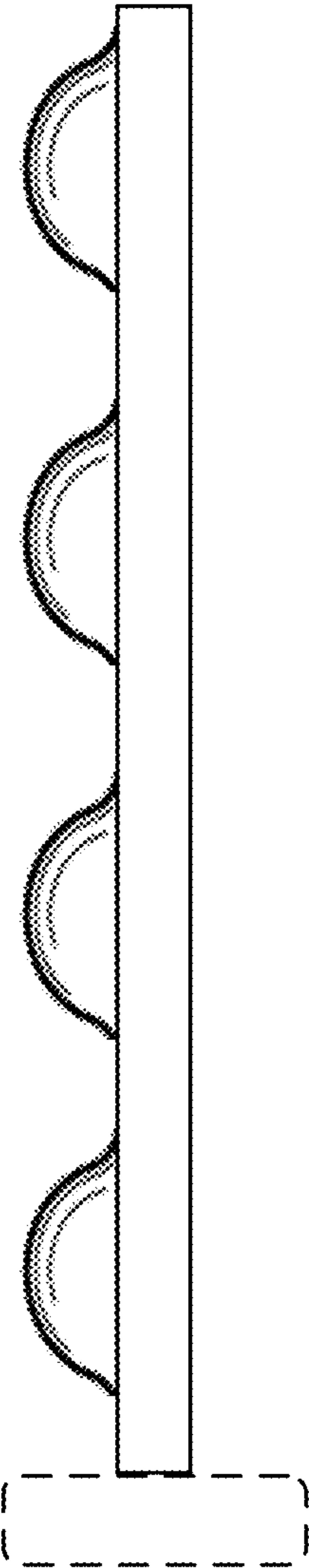
