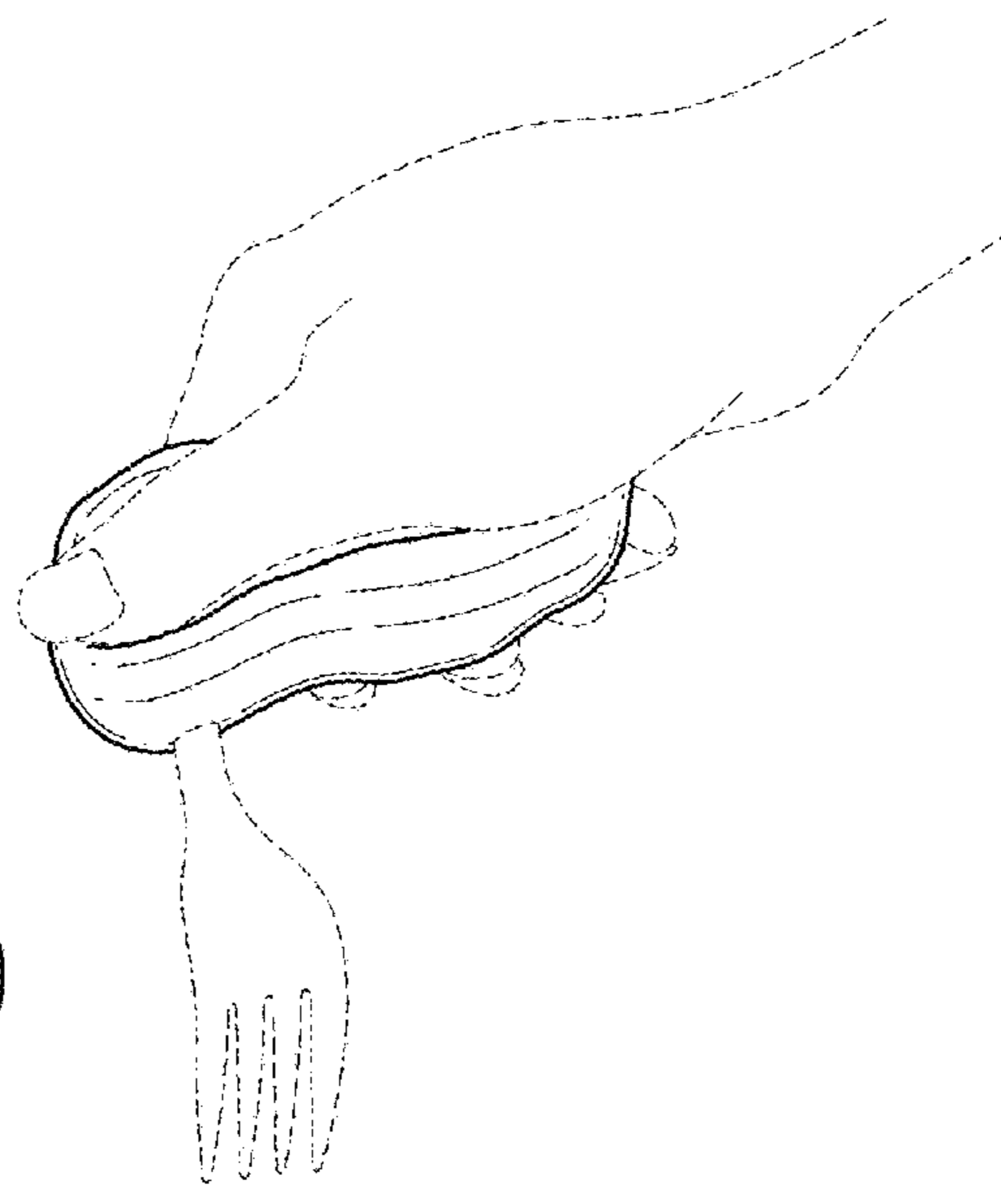
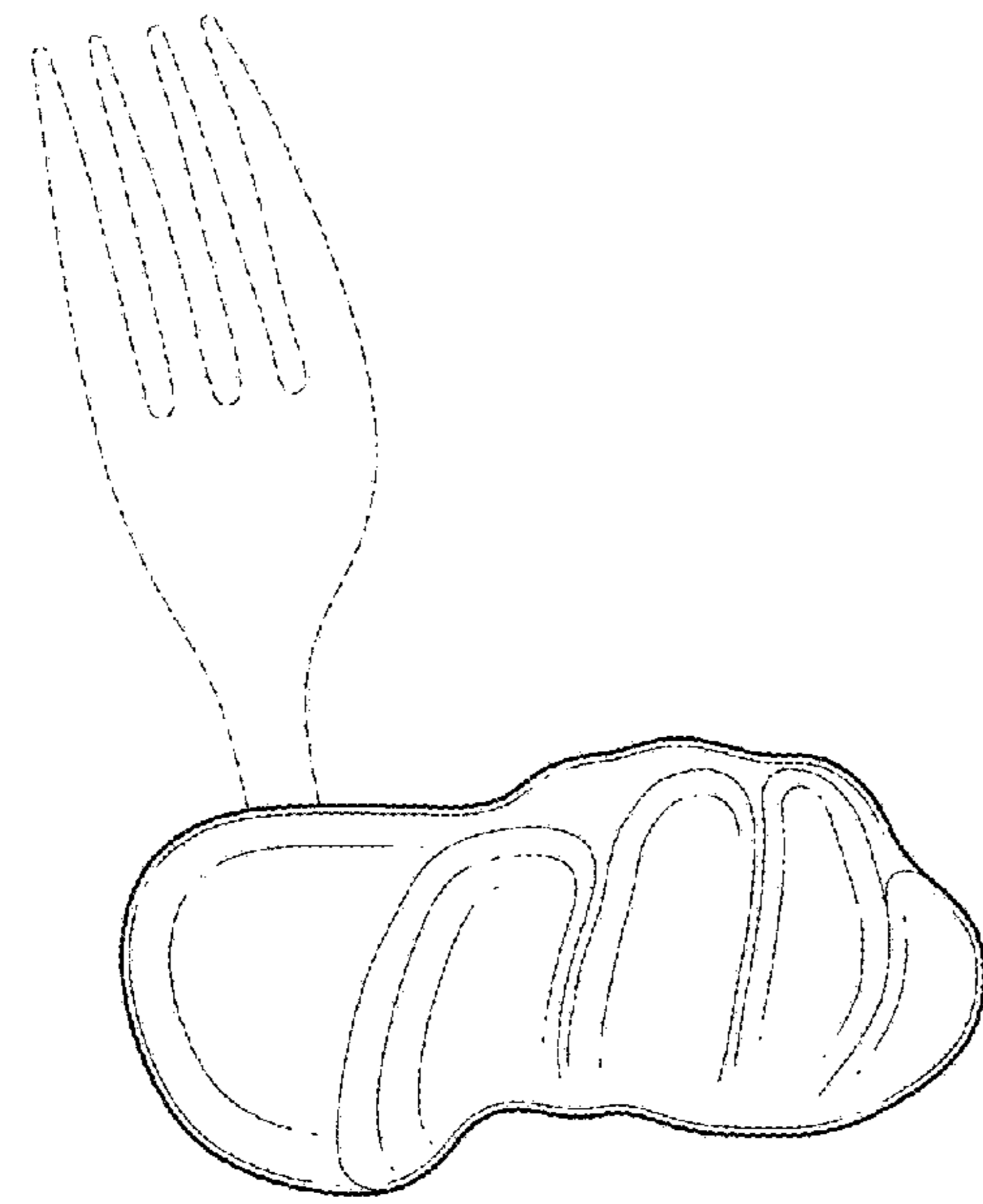
The ornamental design for a handle for utensil, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 6 is a right, side elevation view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 7 is a left, perspective view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of the handle for utensil; FIG. 9 is a top, front perspective view of the handle for utensil in use; and, FIG. 10 is a bottom, front perspective view of the handle for utensil in use.

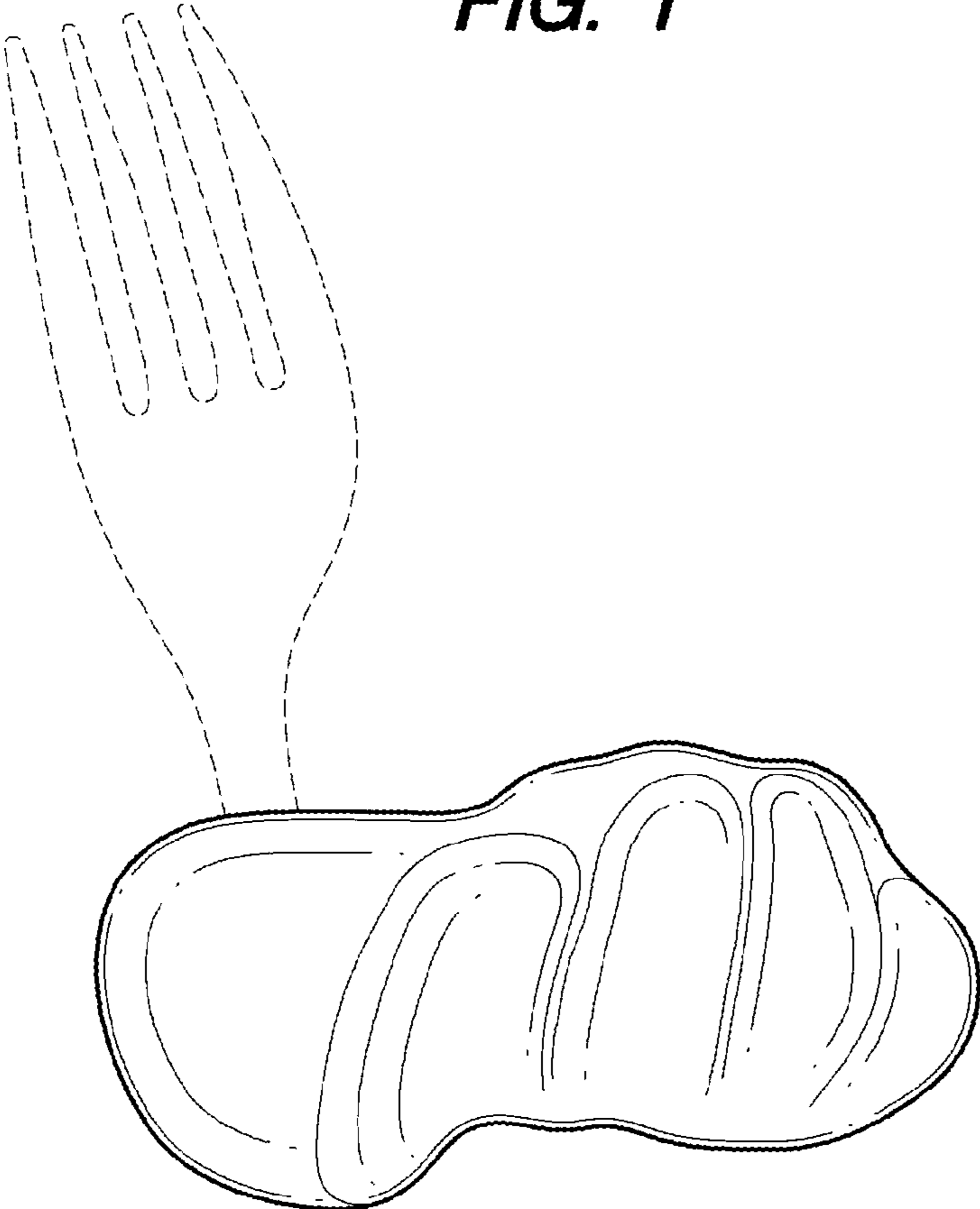
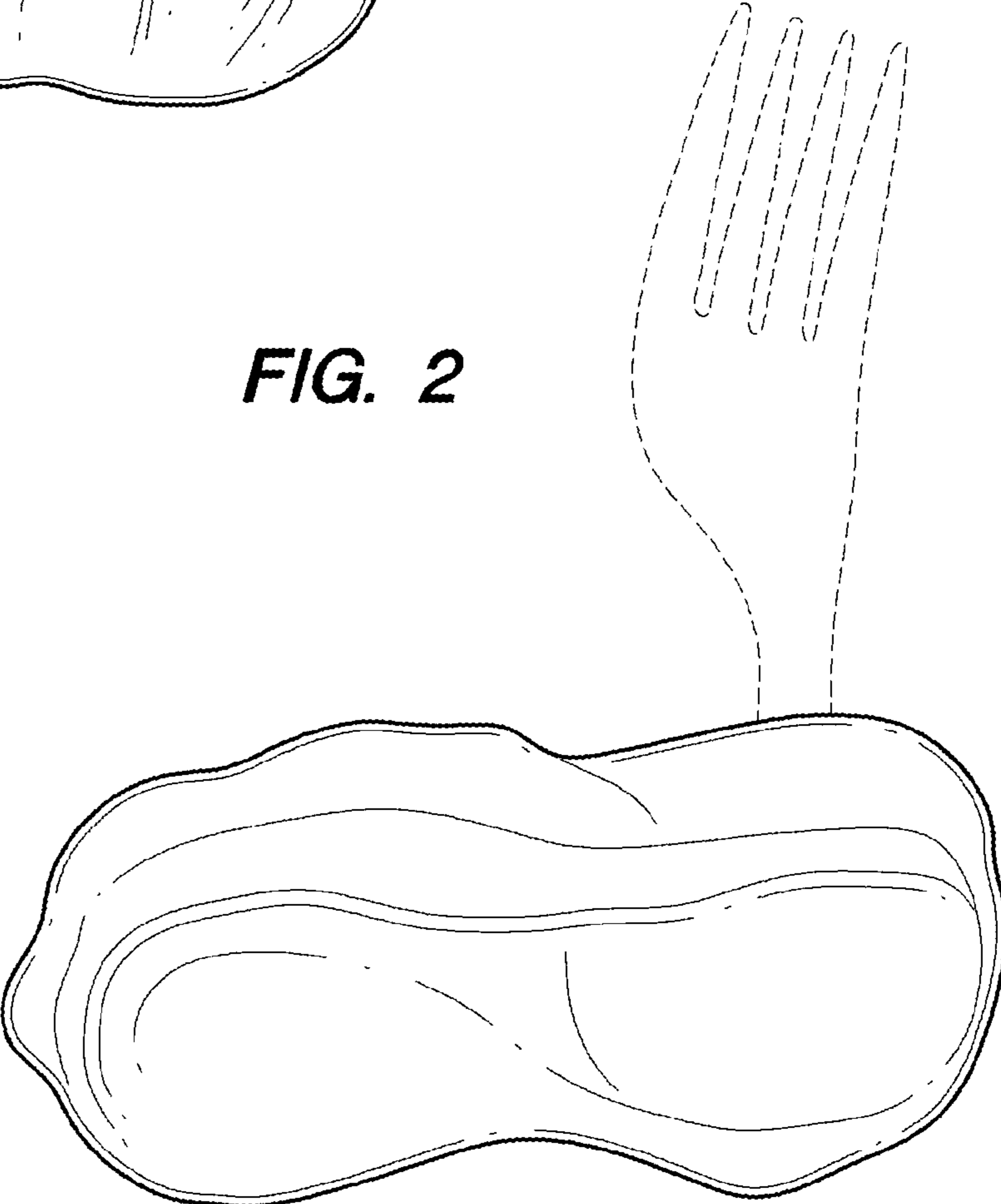

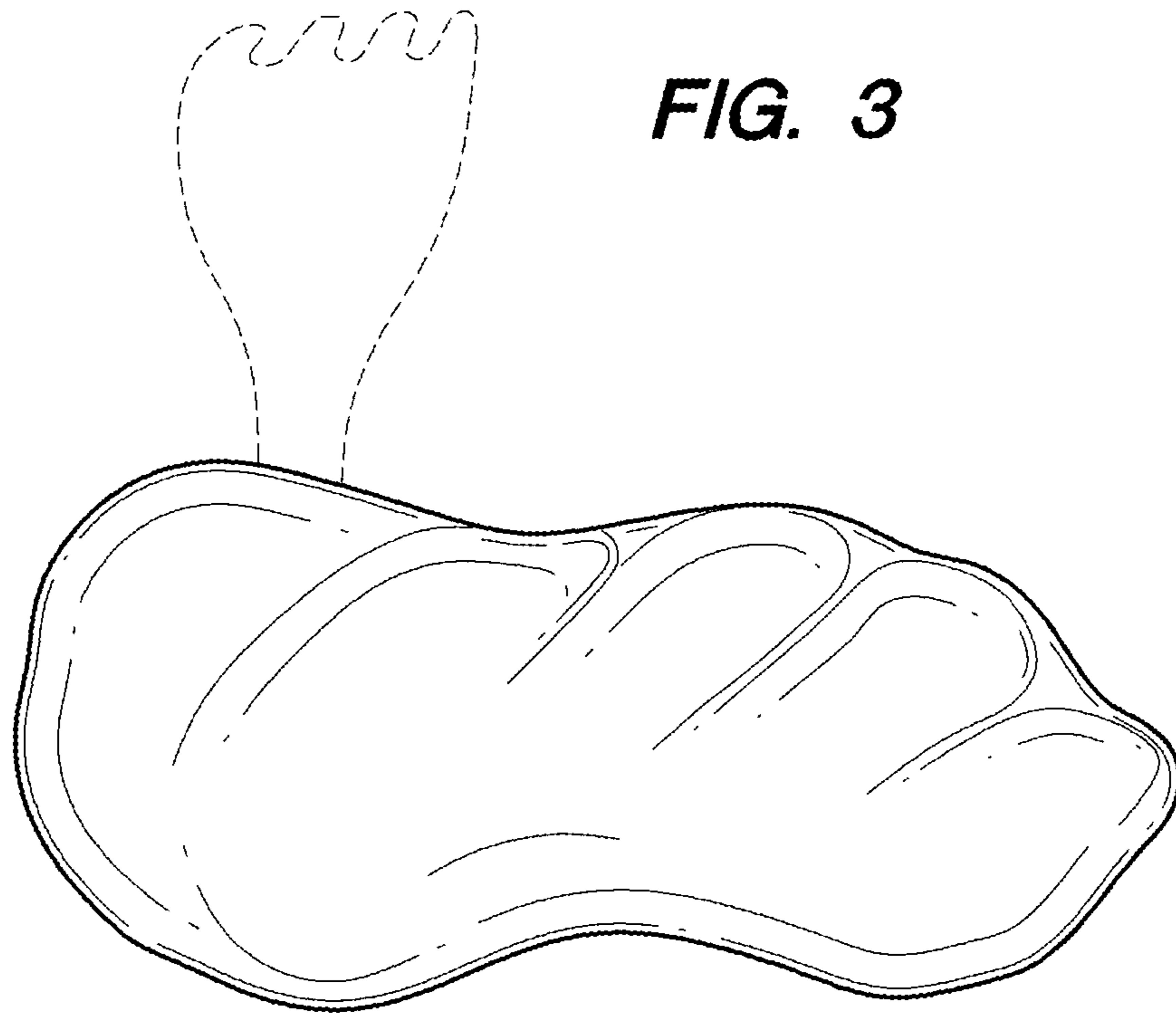

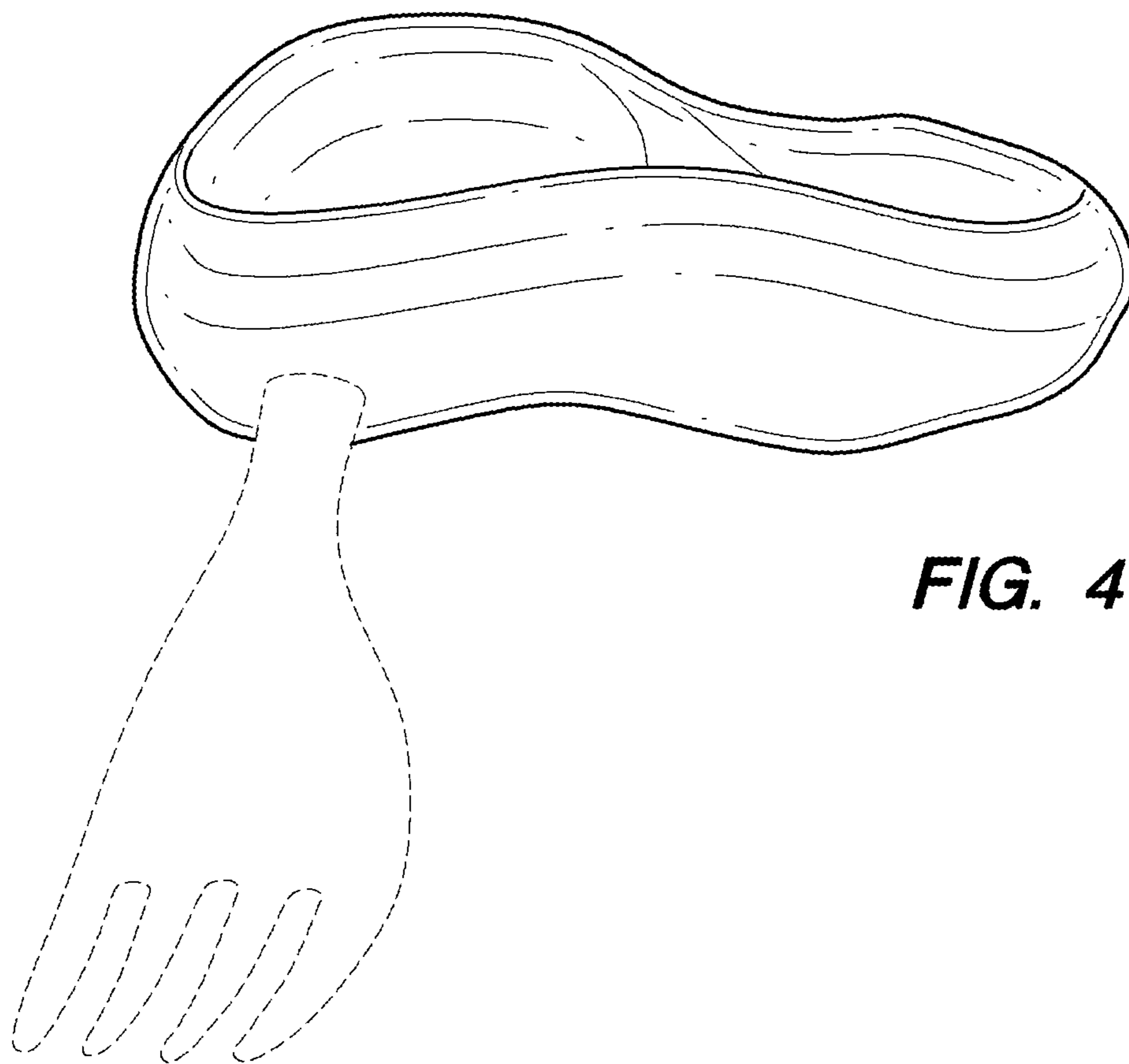

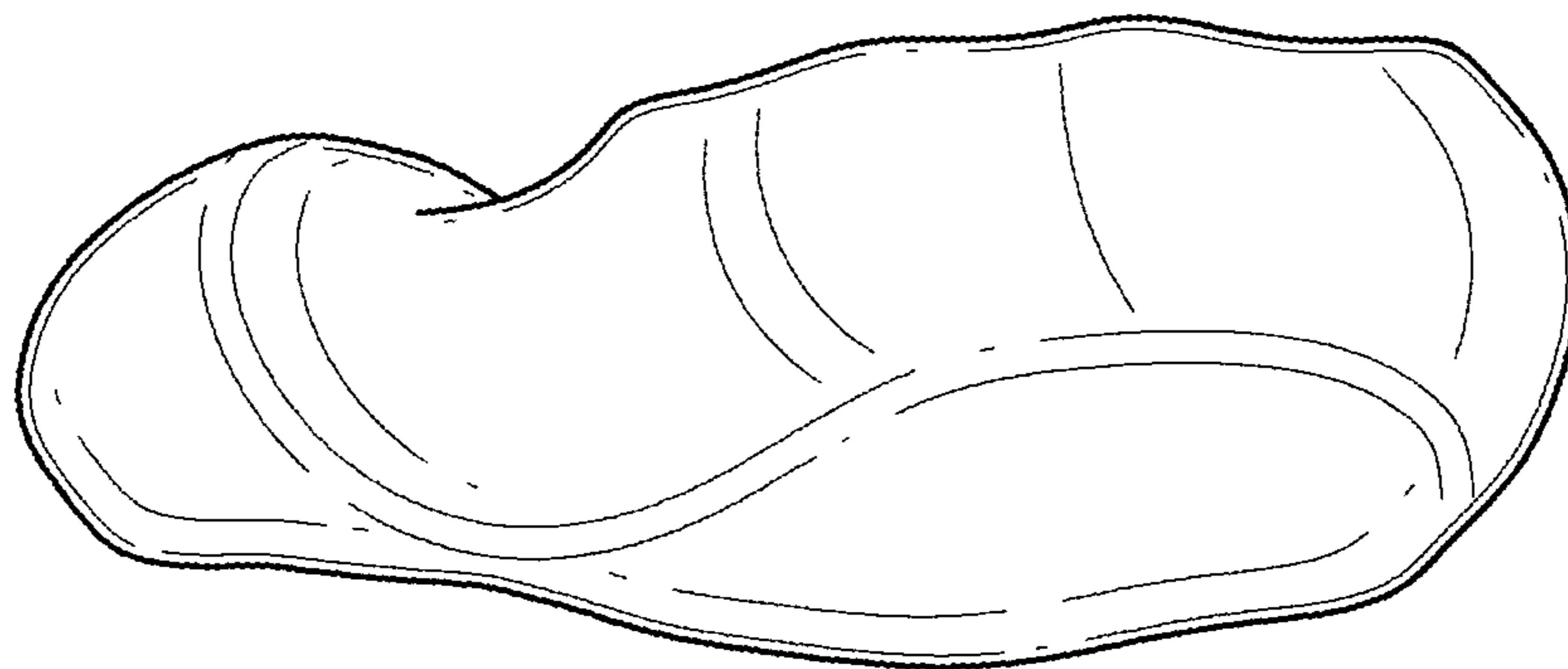

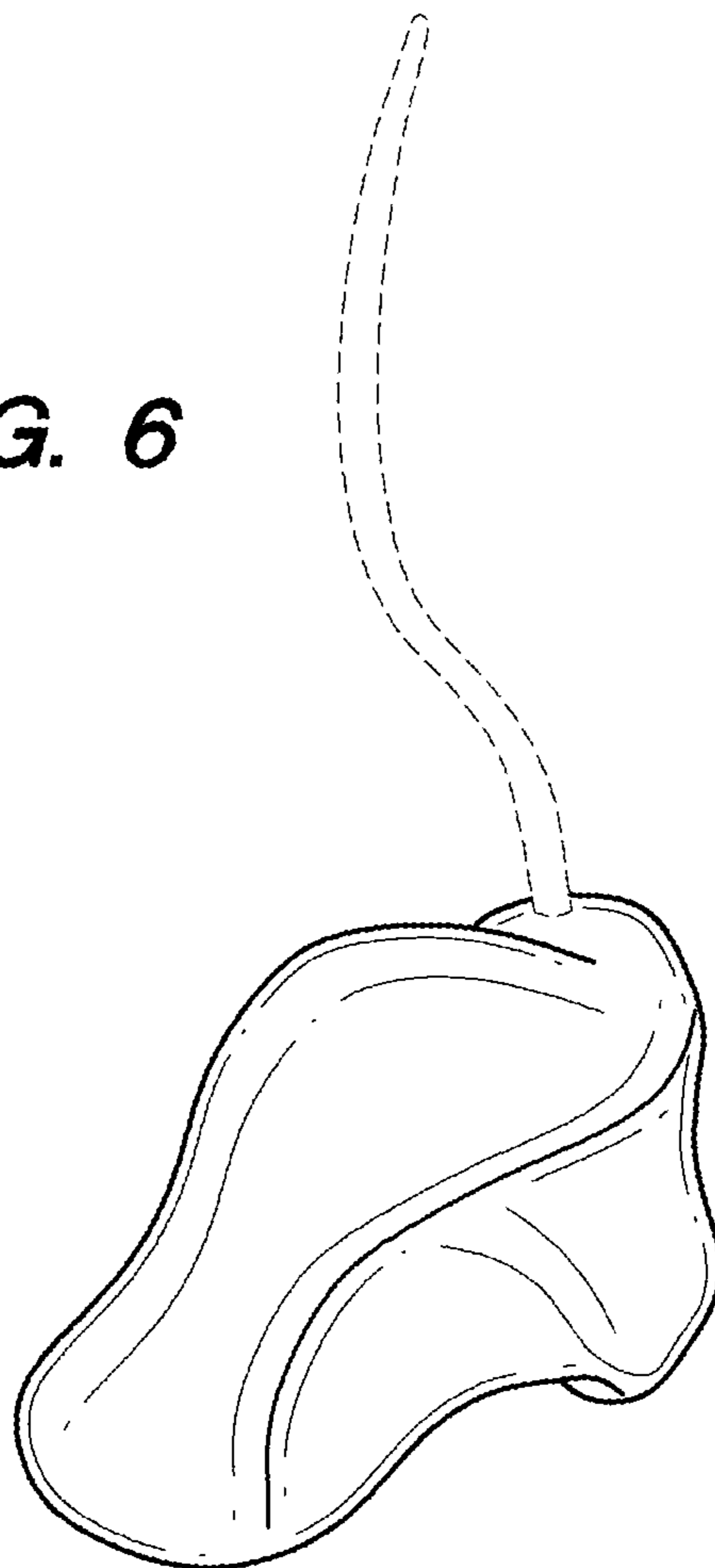

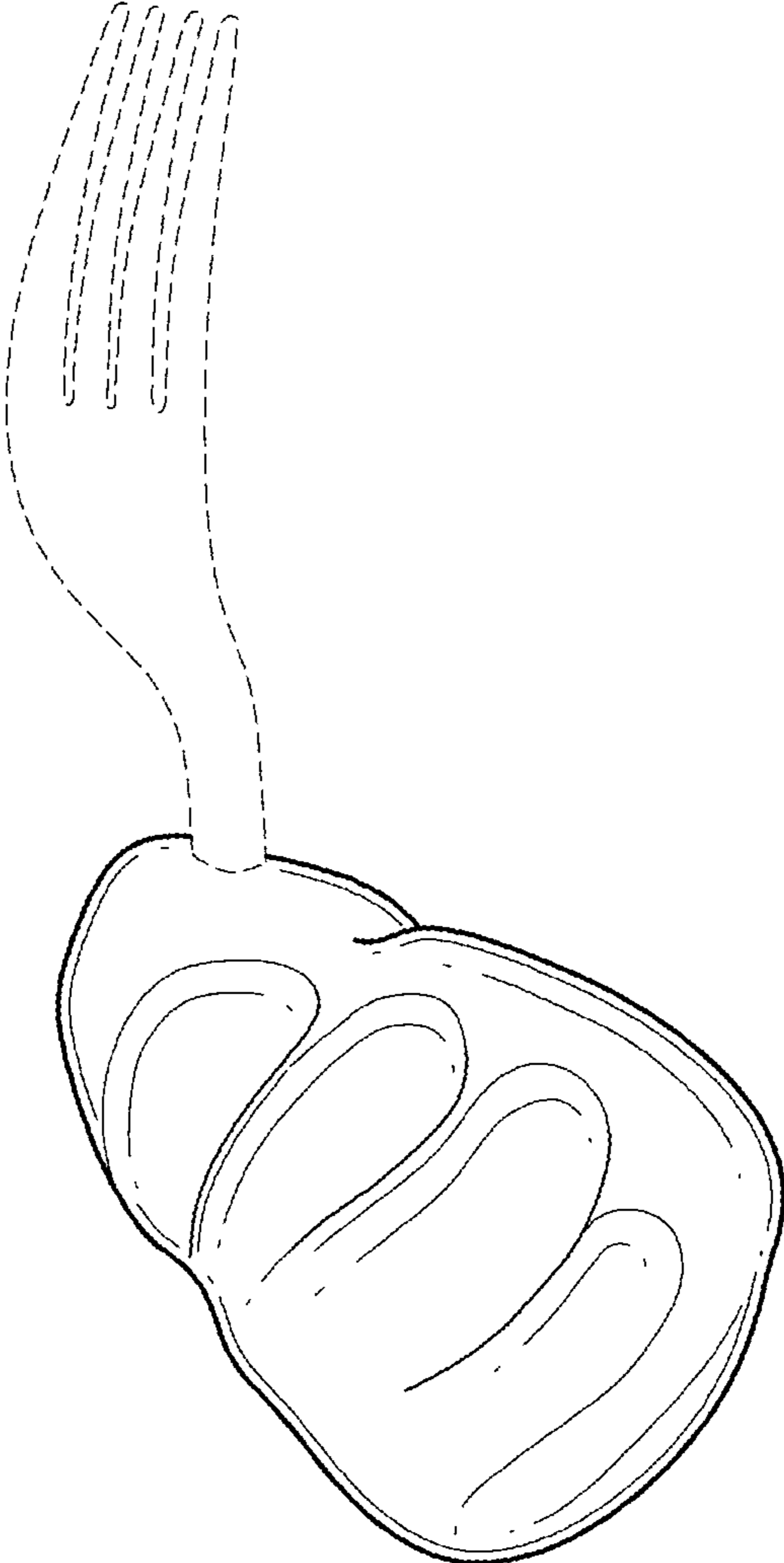

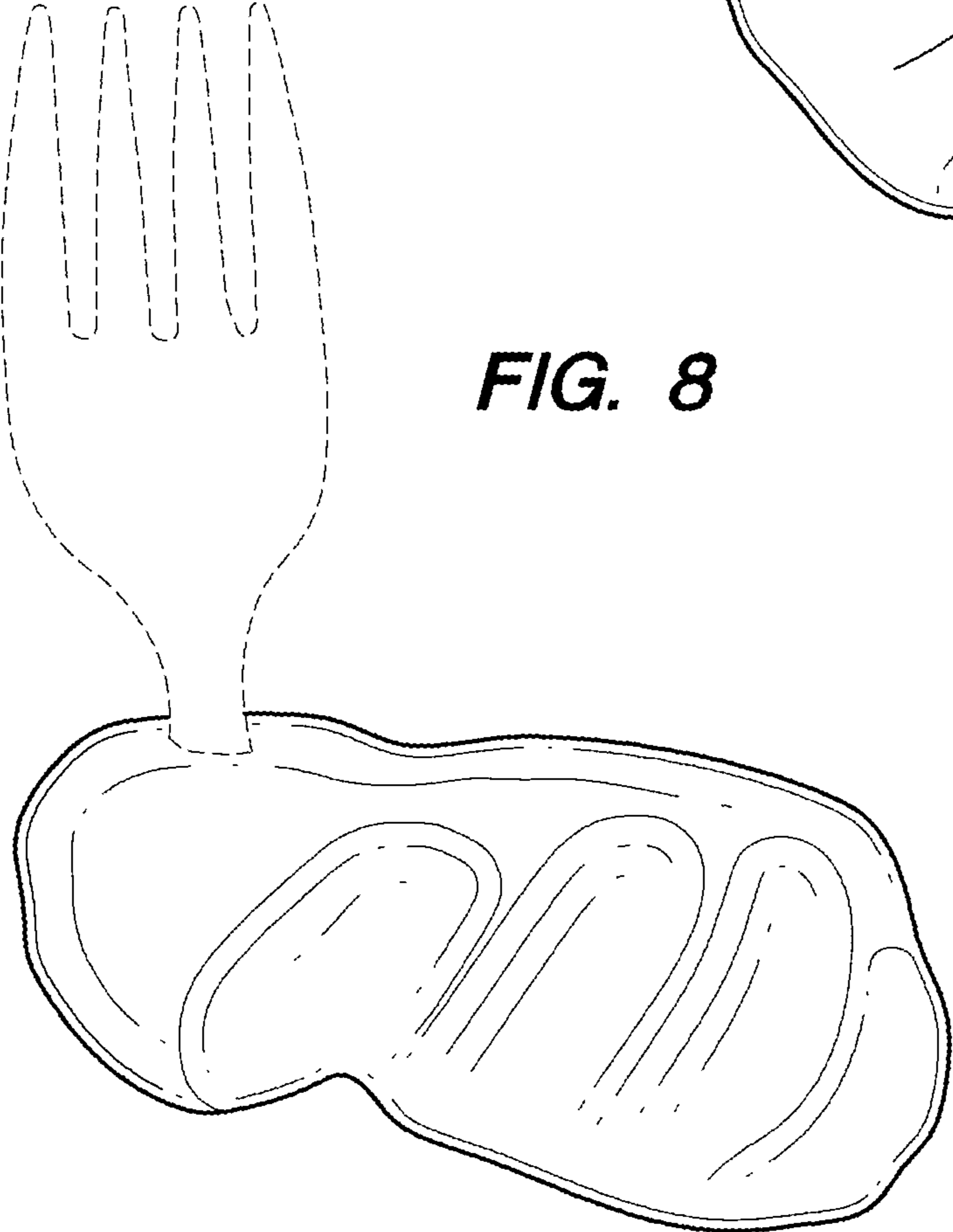

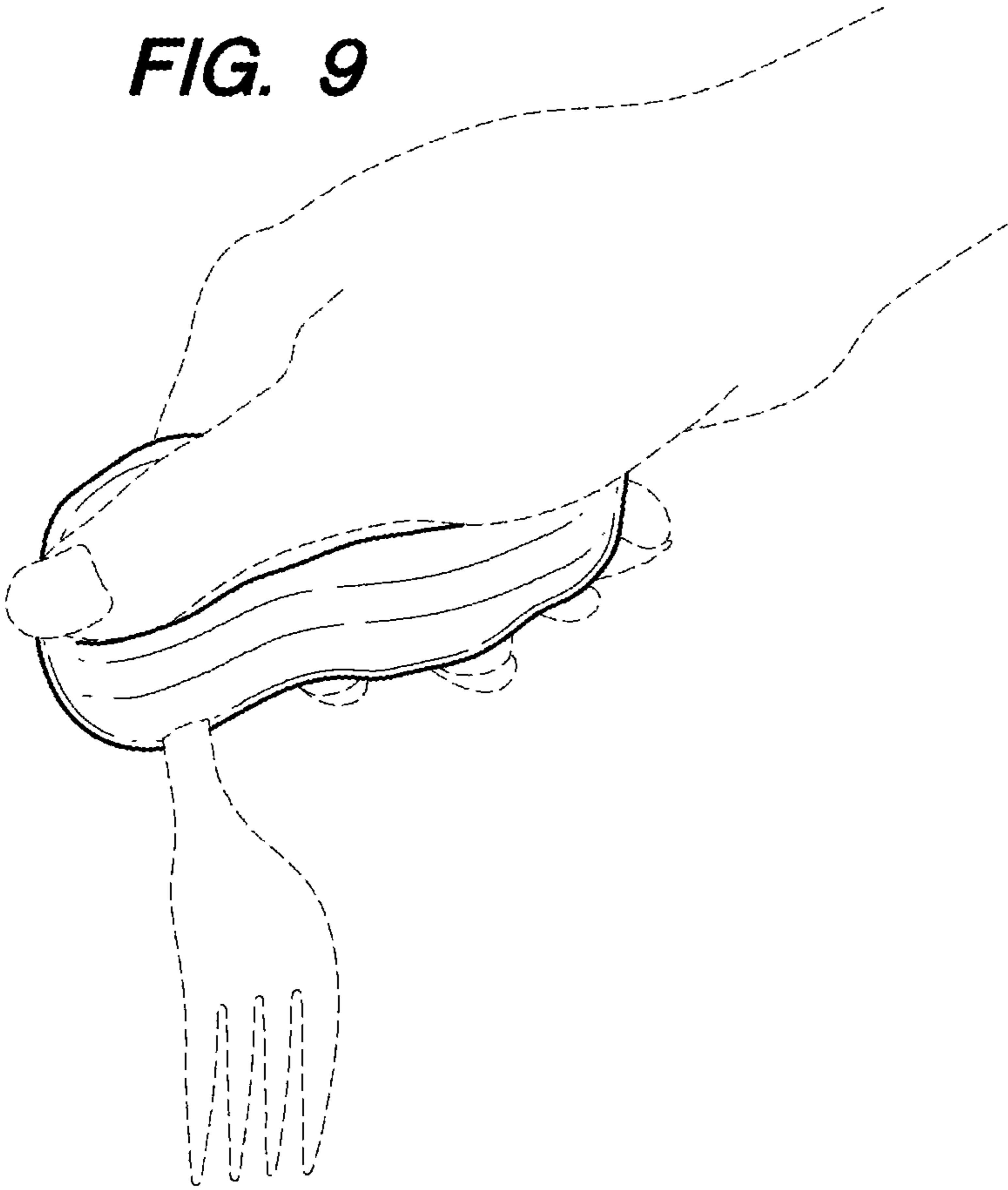
