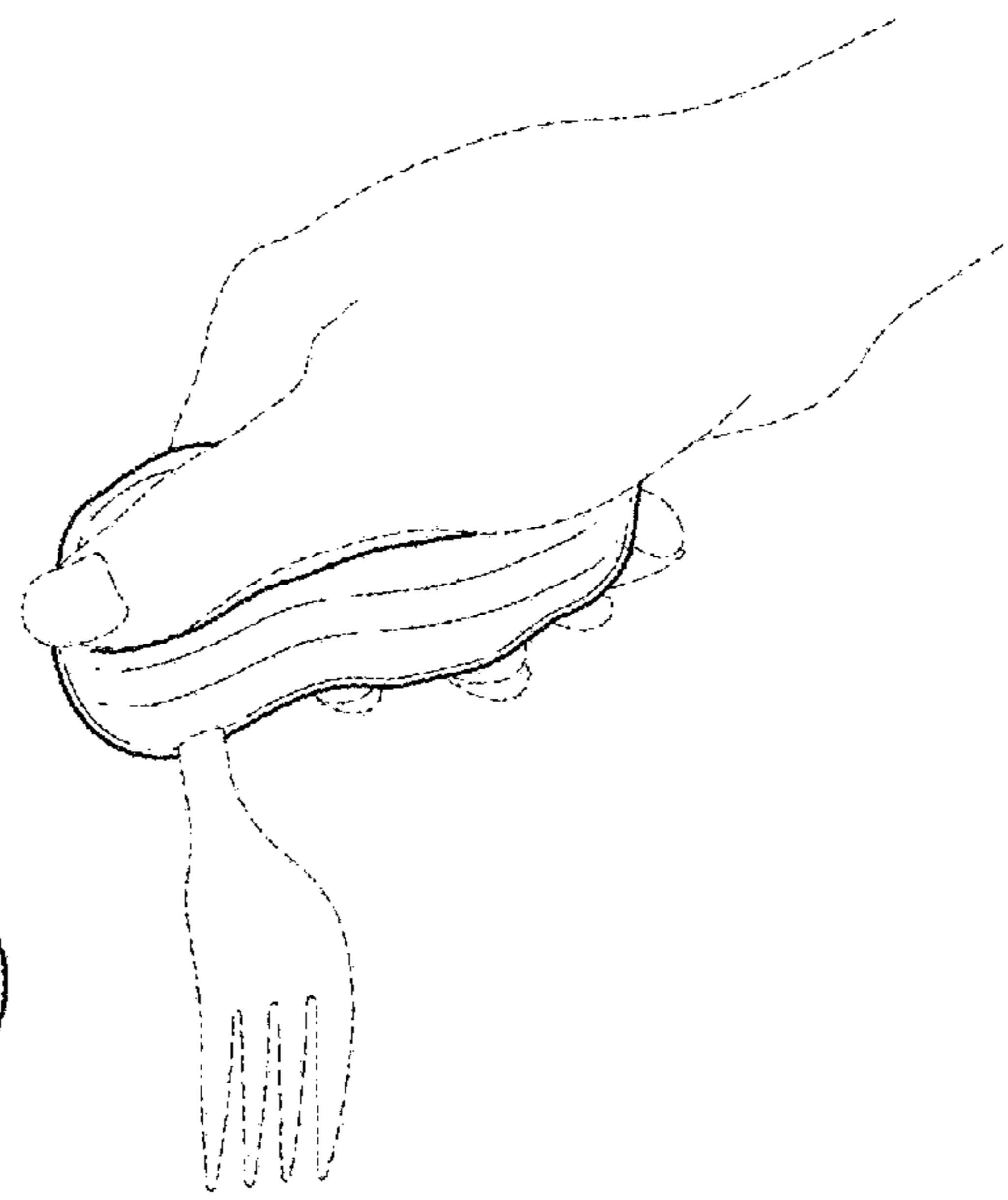
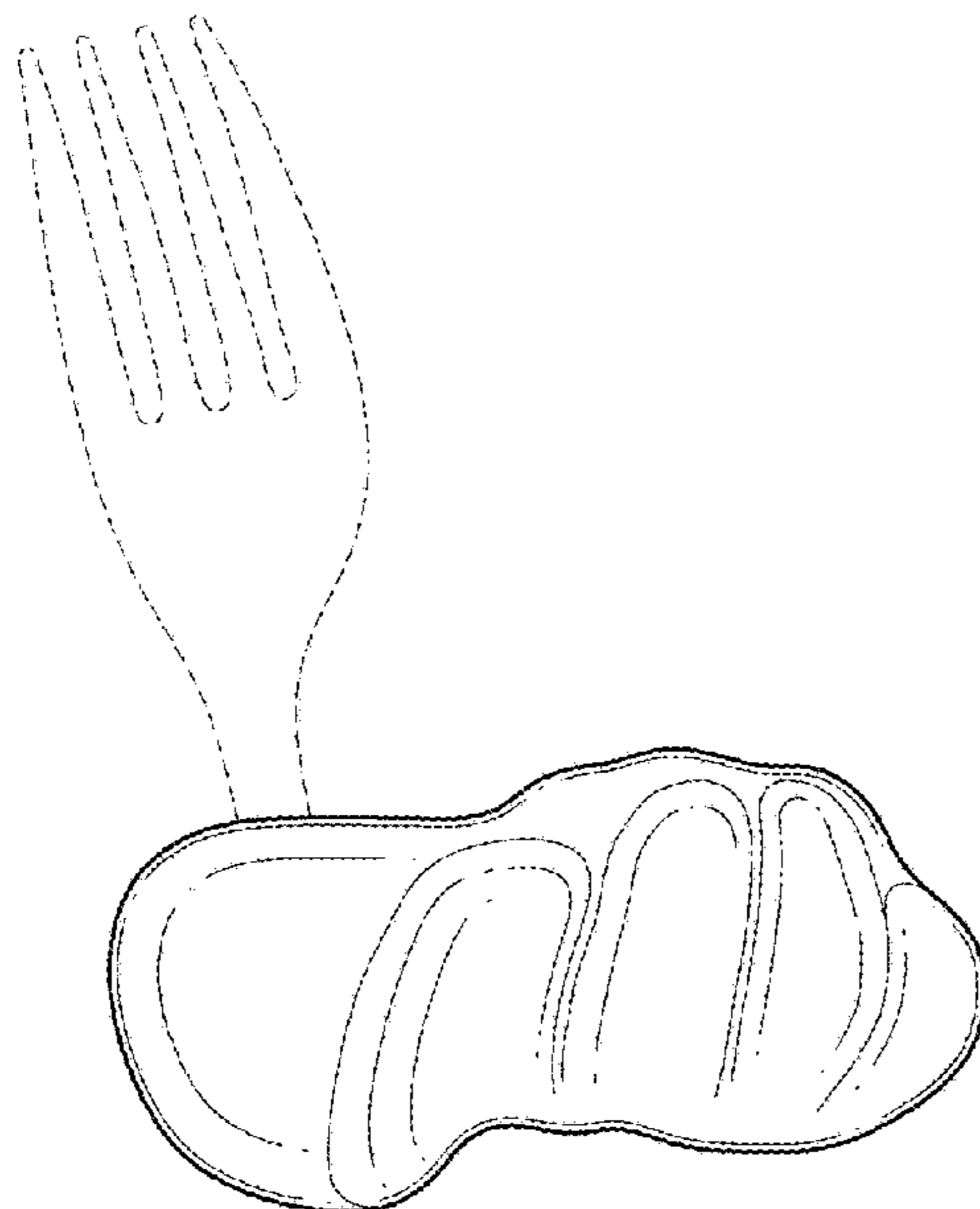
The ornamental design for a handle for utensil, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

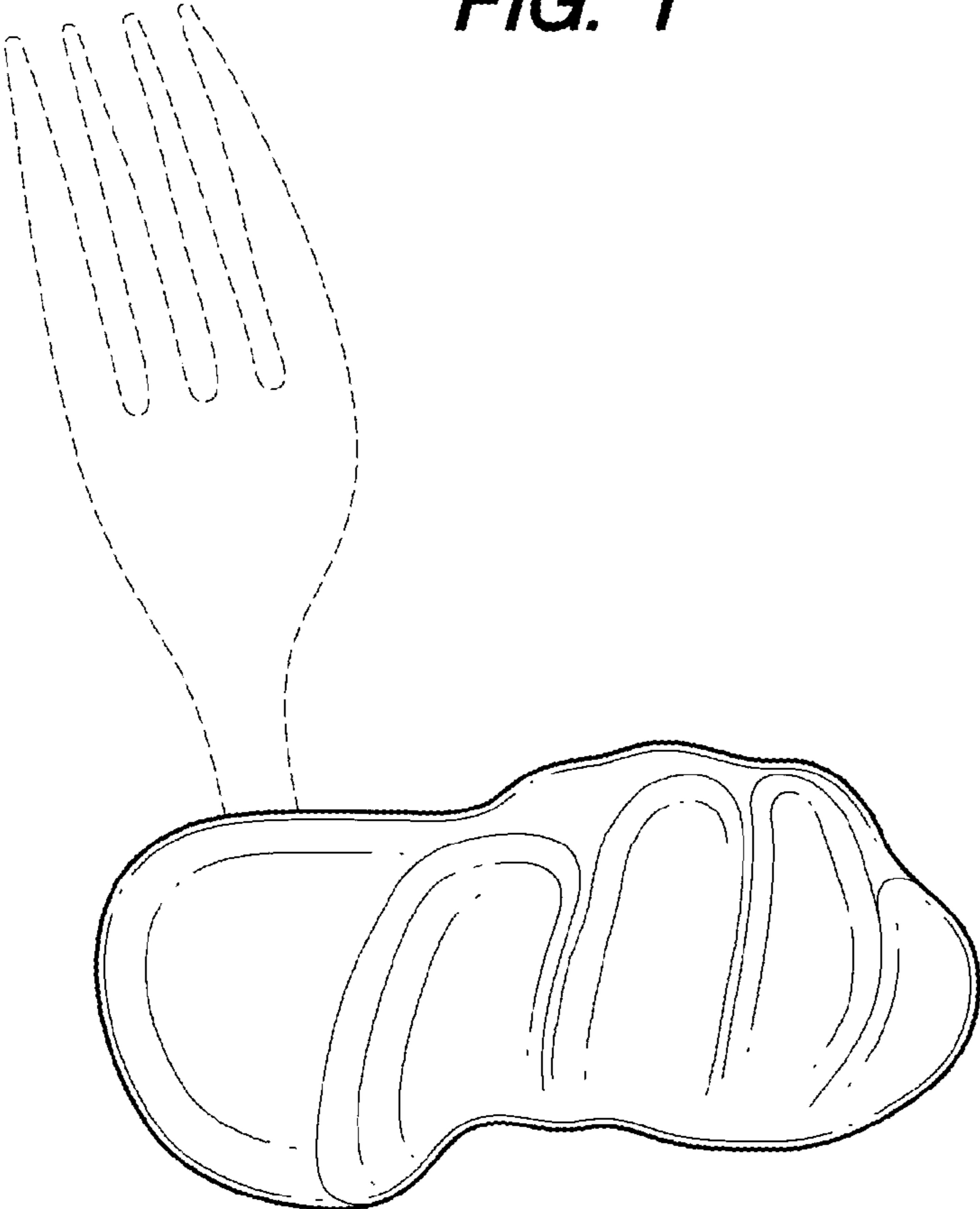

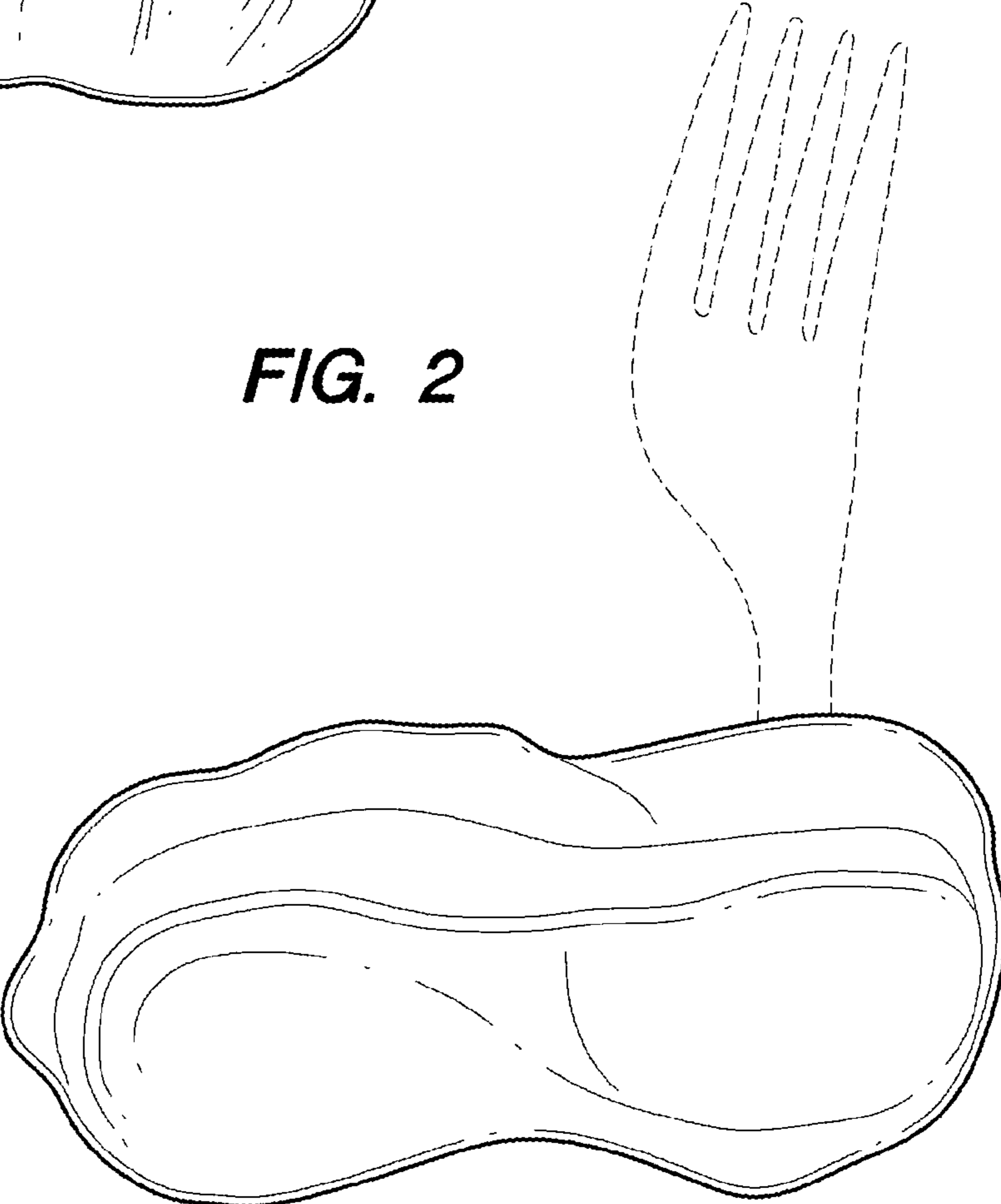

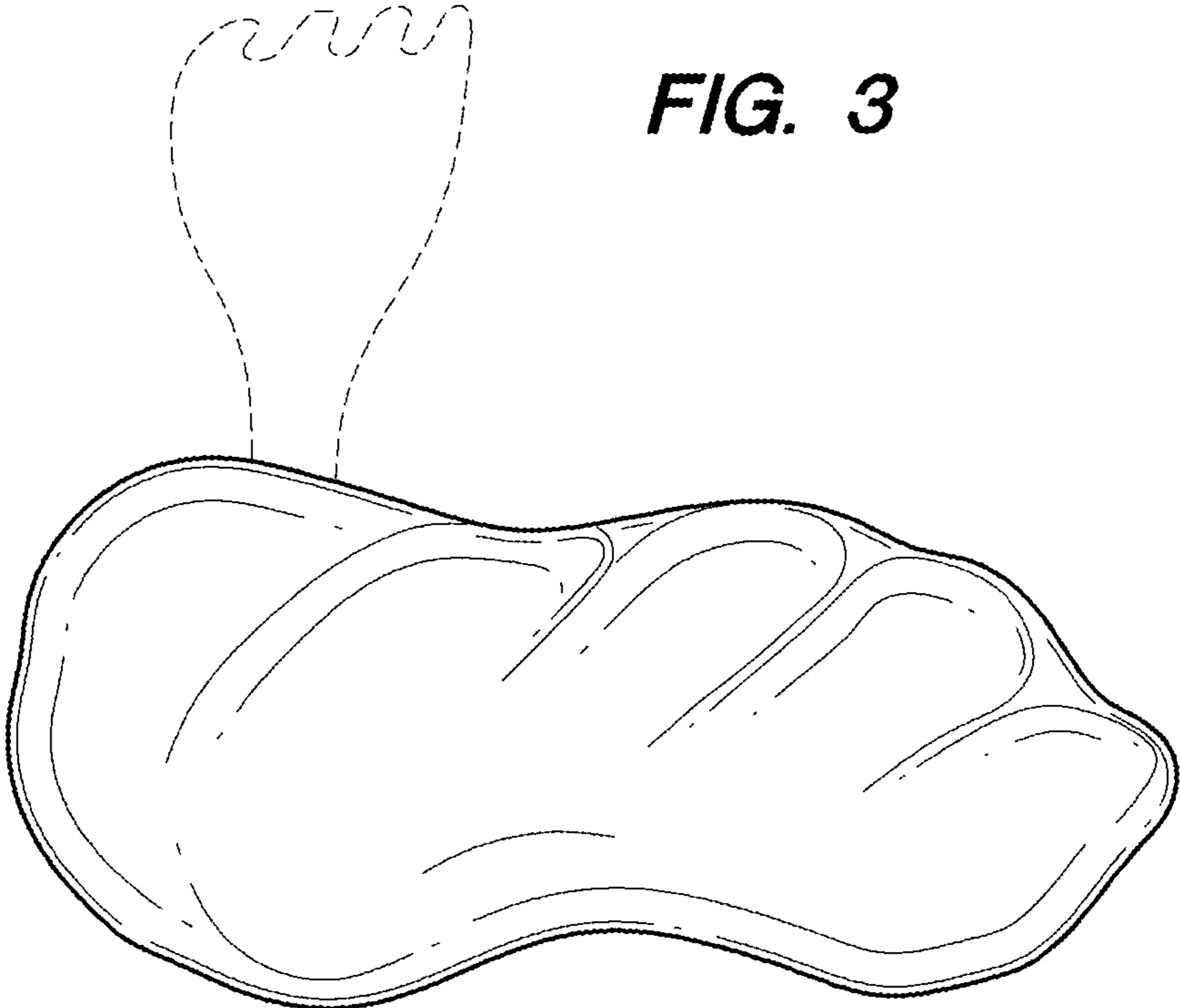

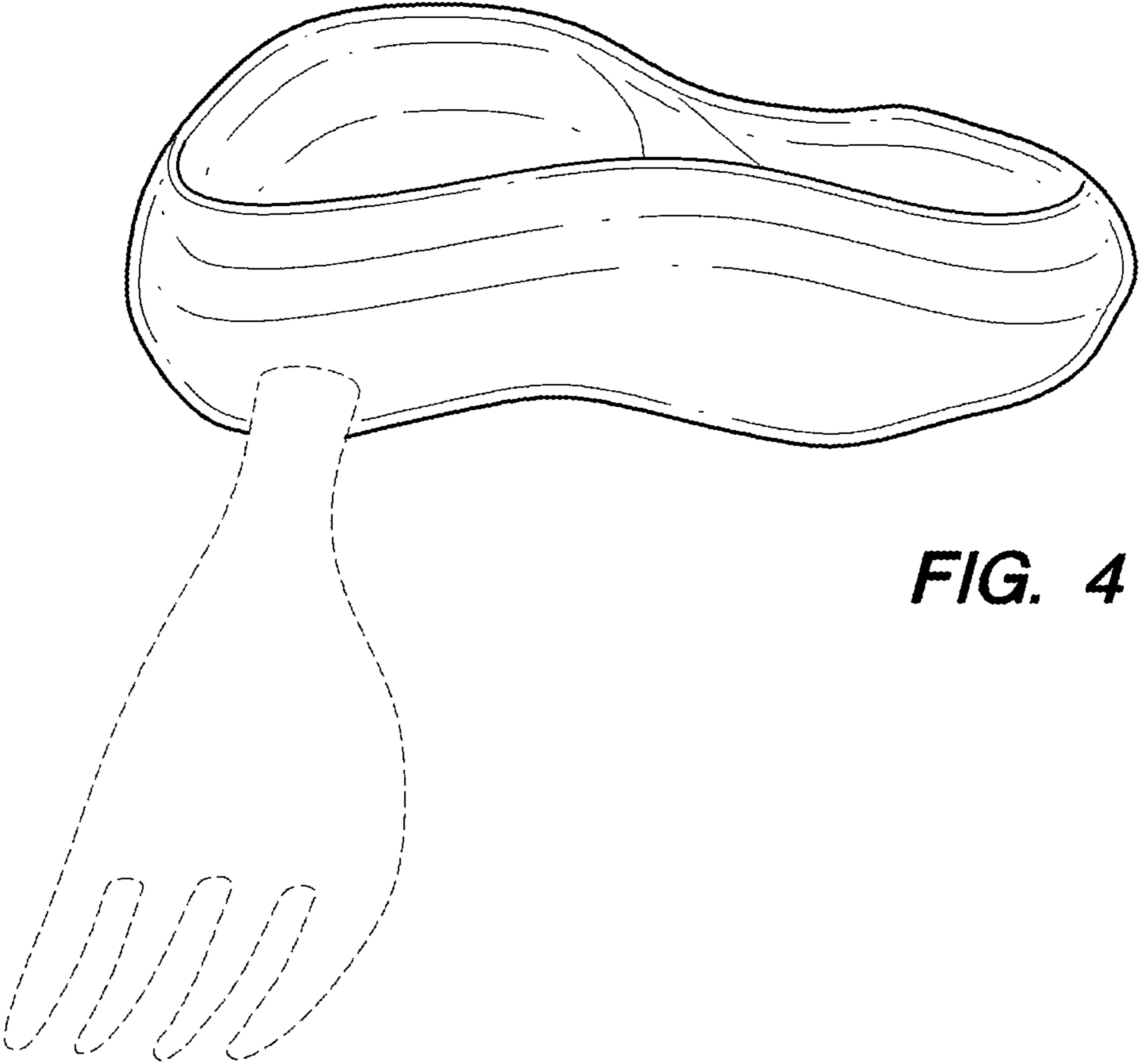

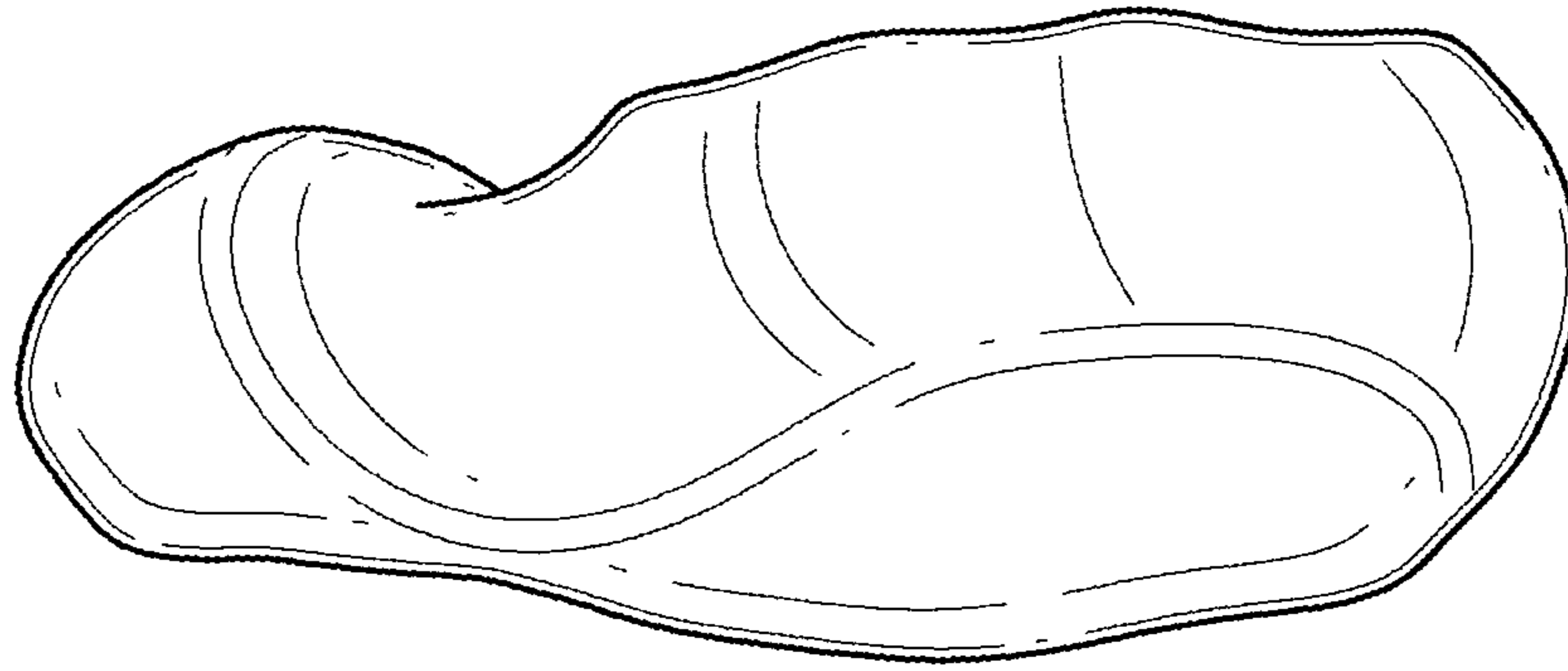

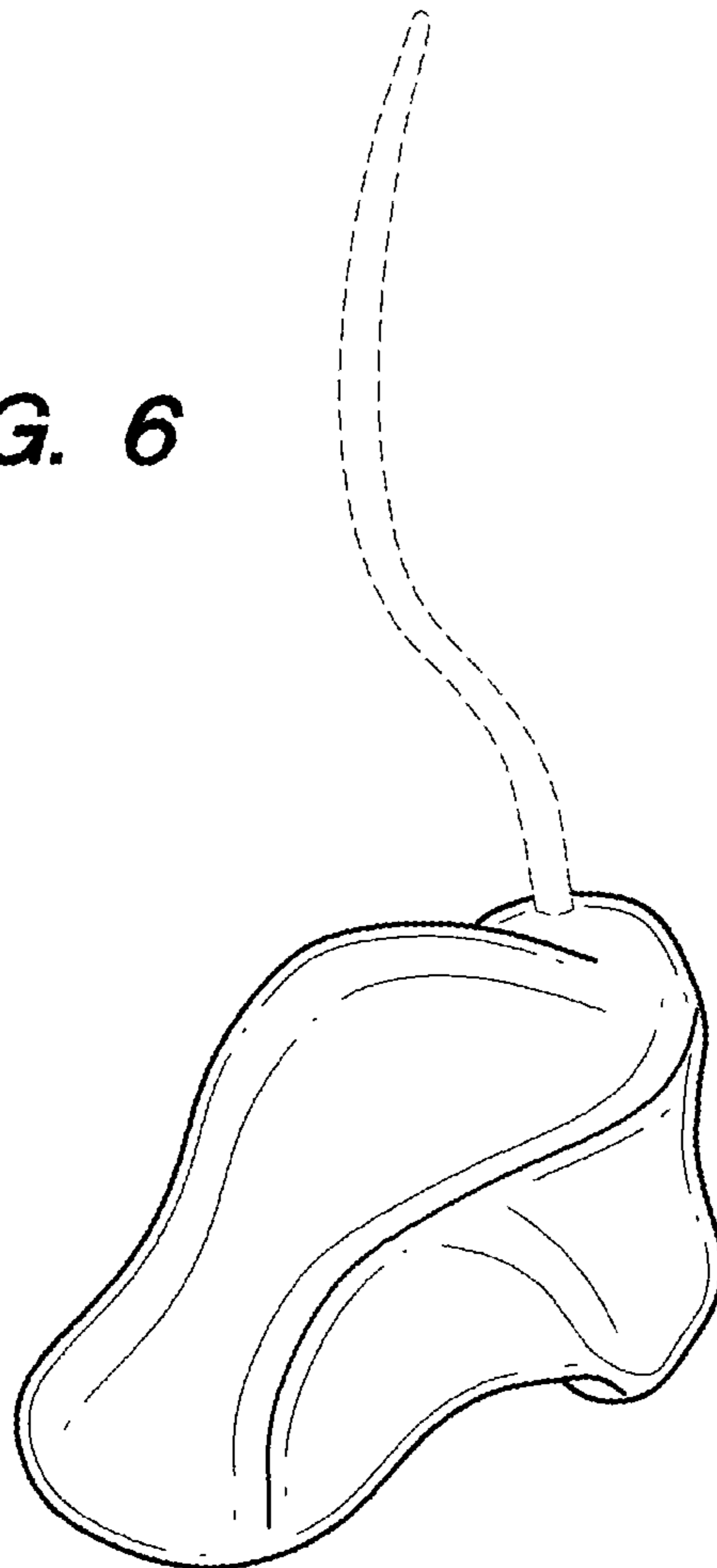

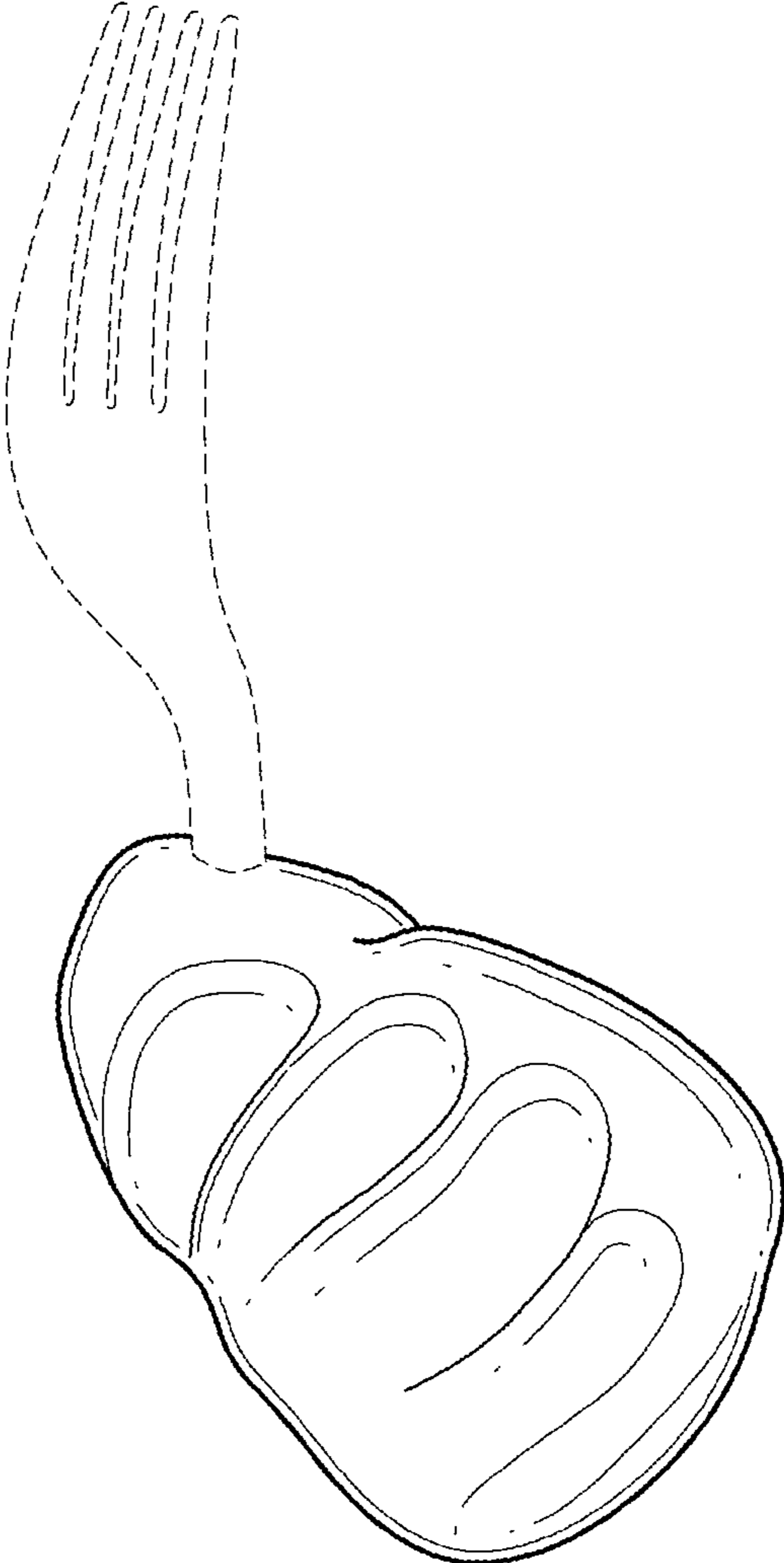

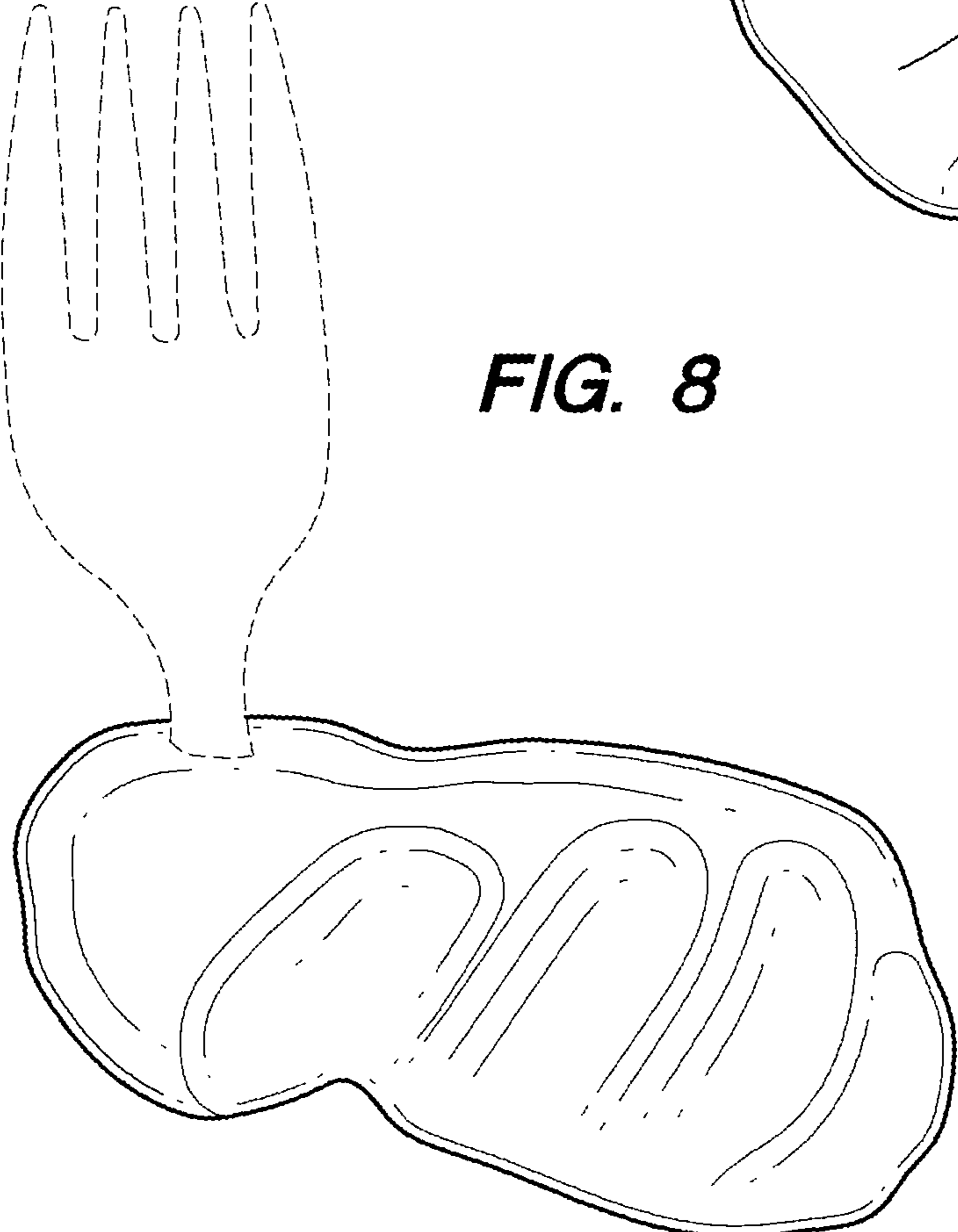

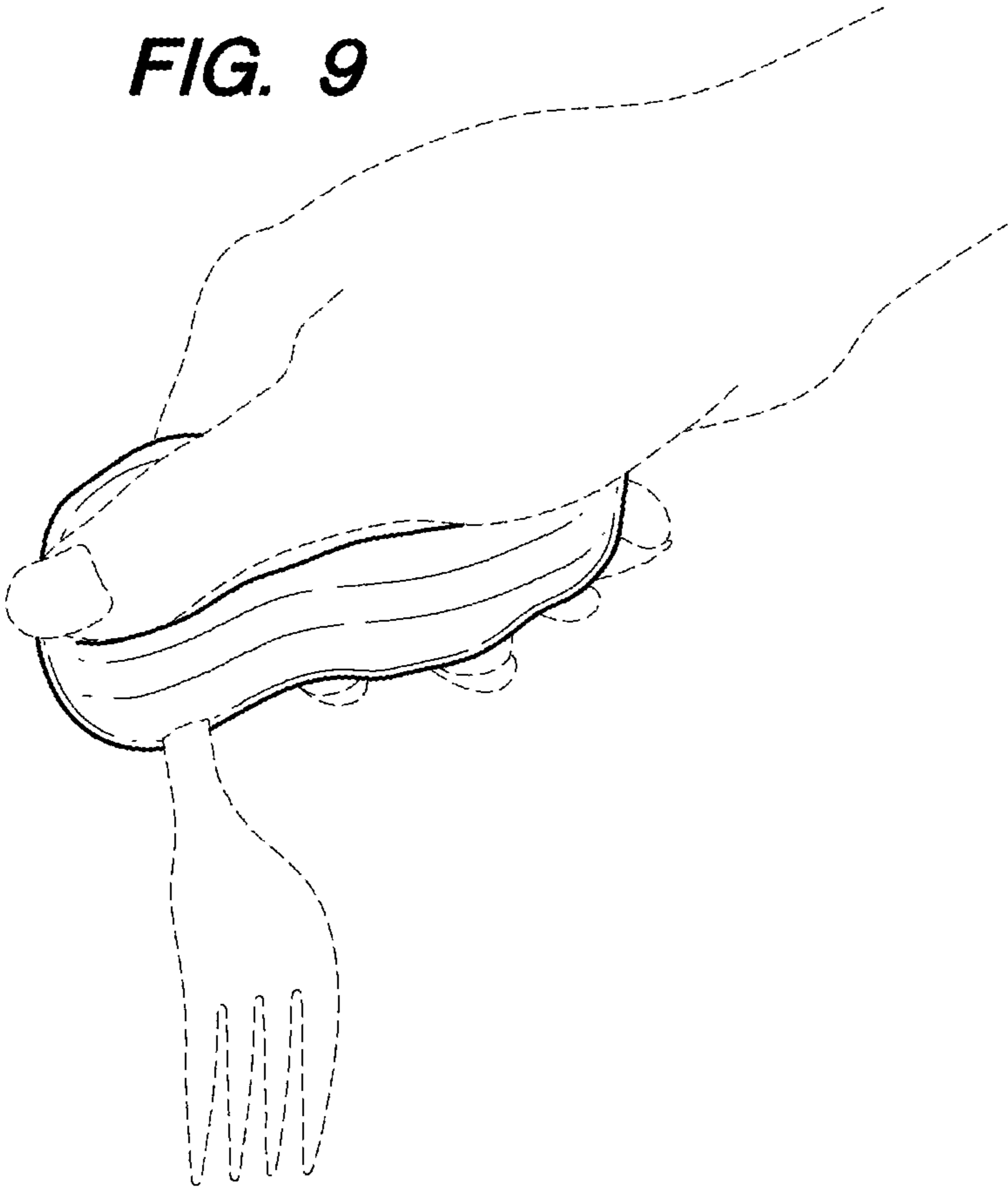
