for a vehicle.

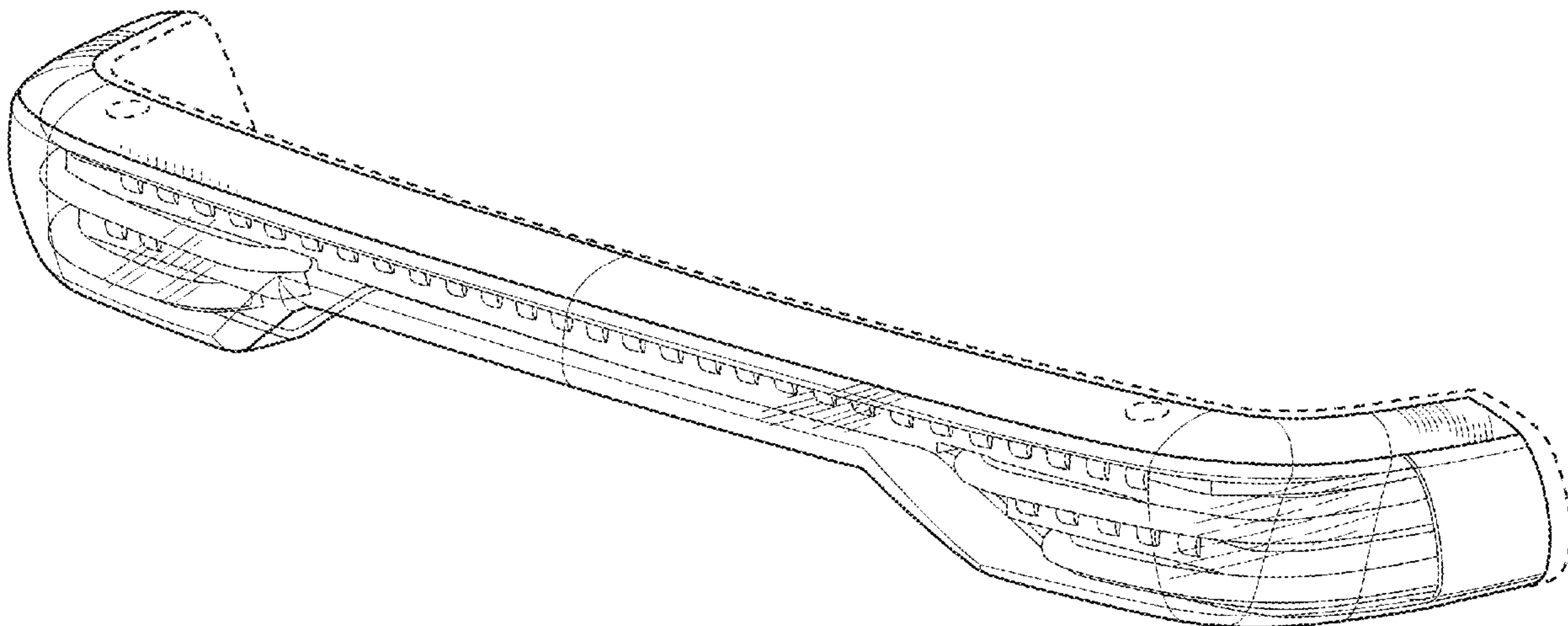
FIG. 4 is a bottom plane view of the bottom plane of the tail

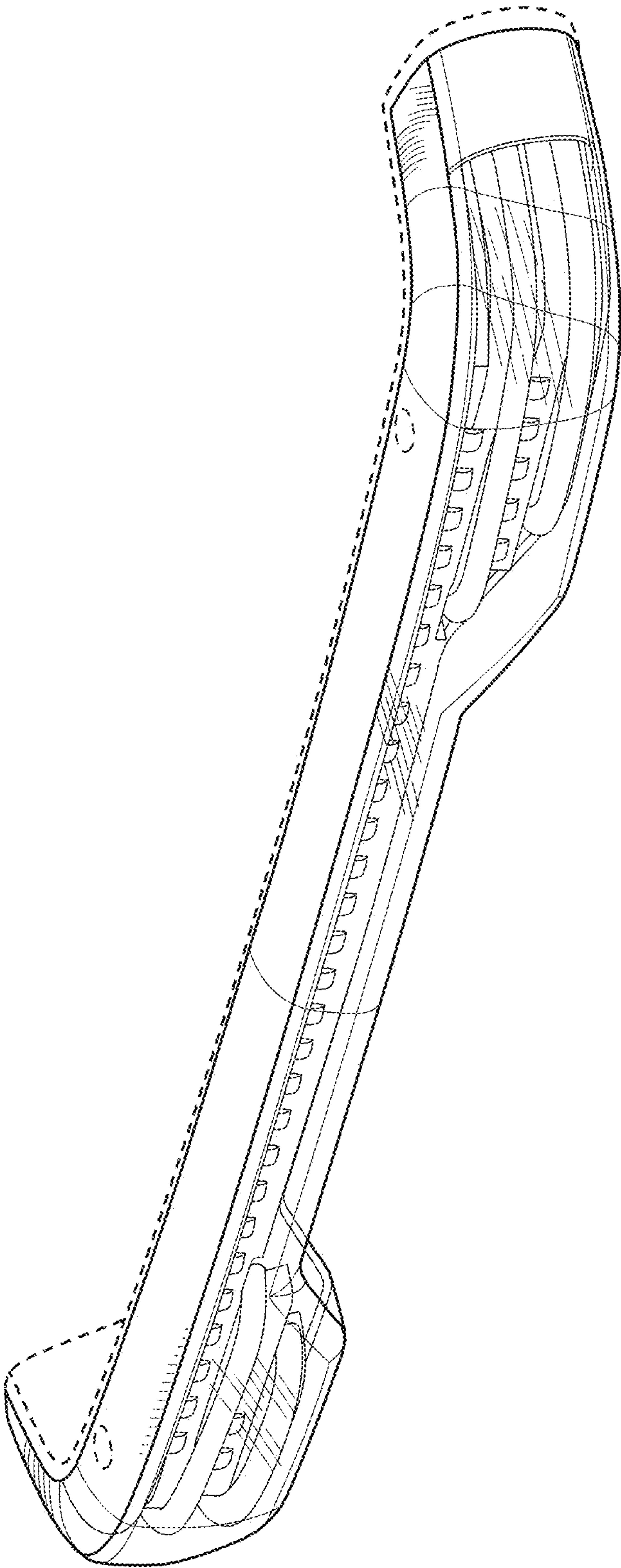

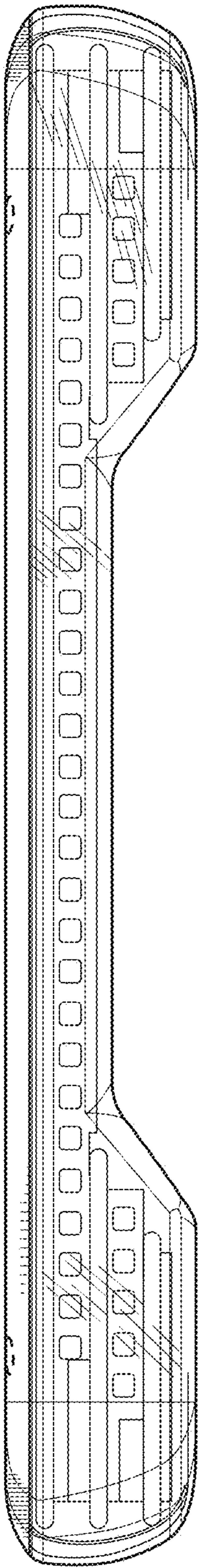

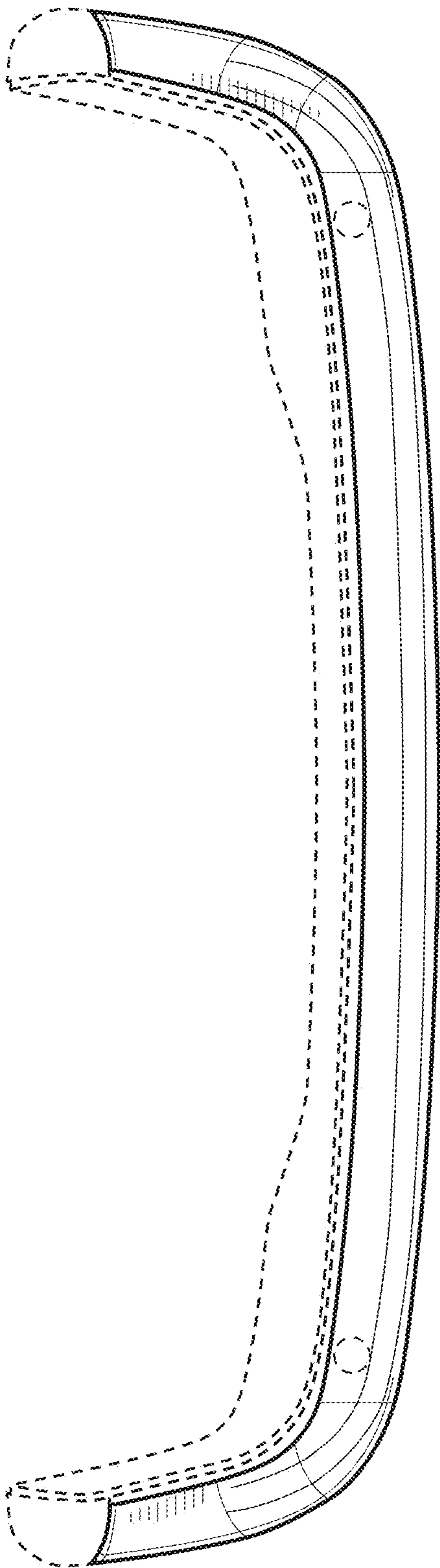

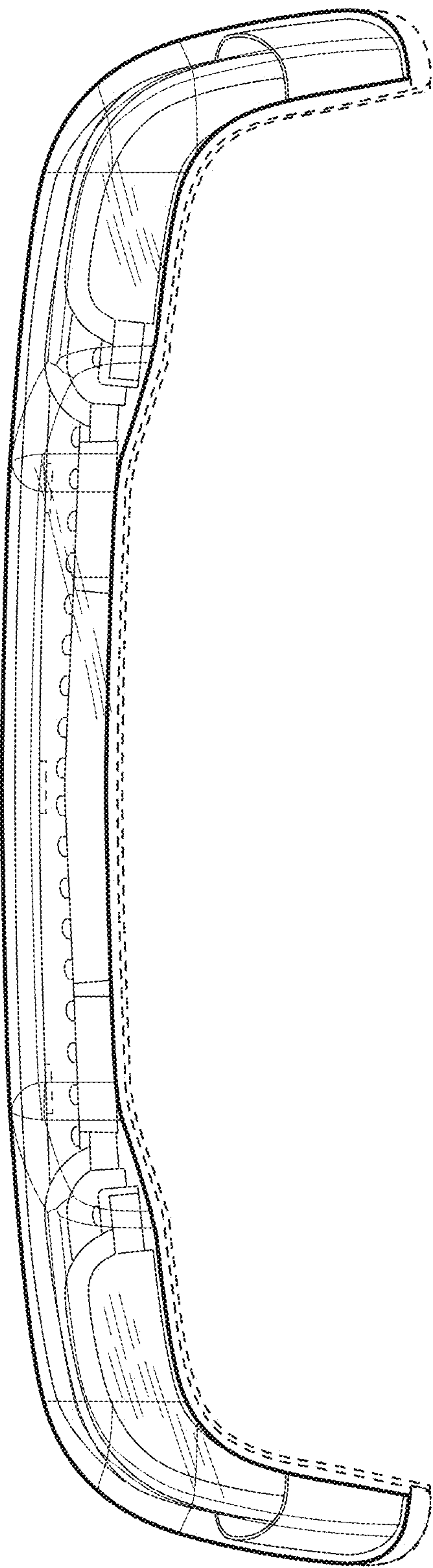

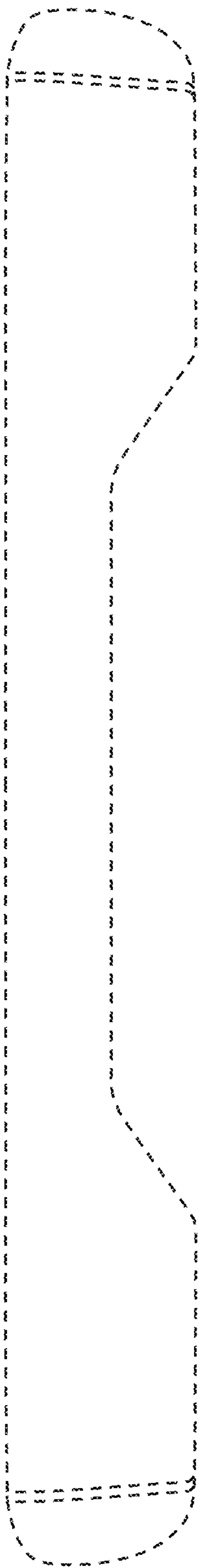

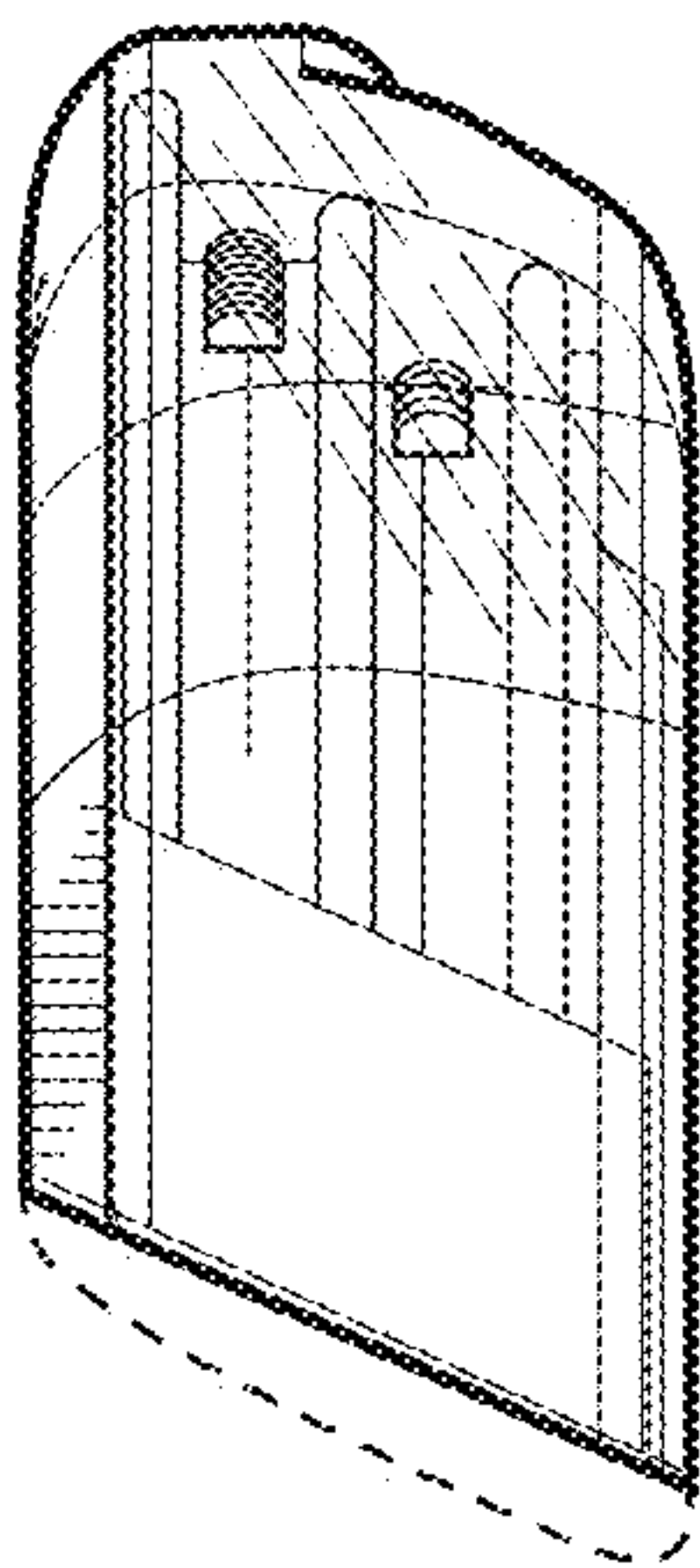

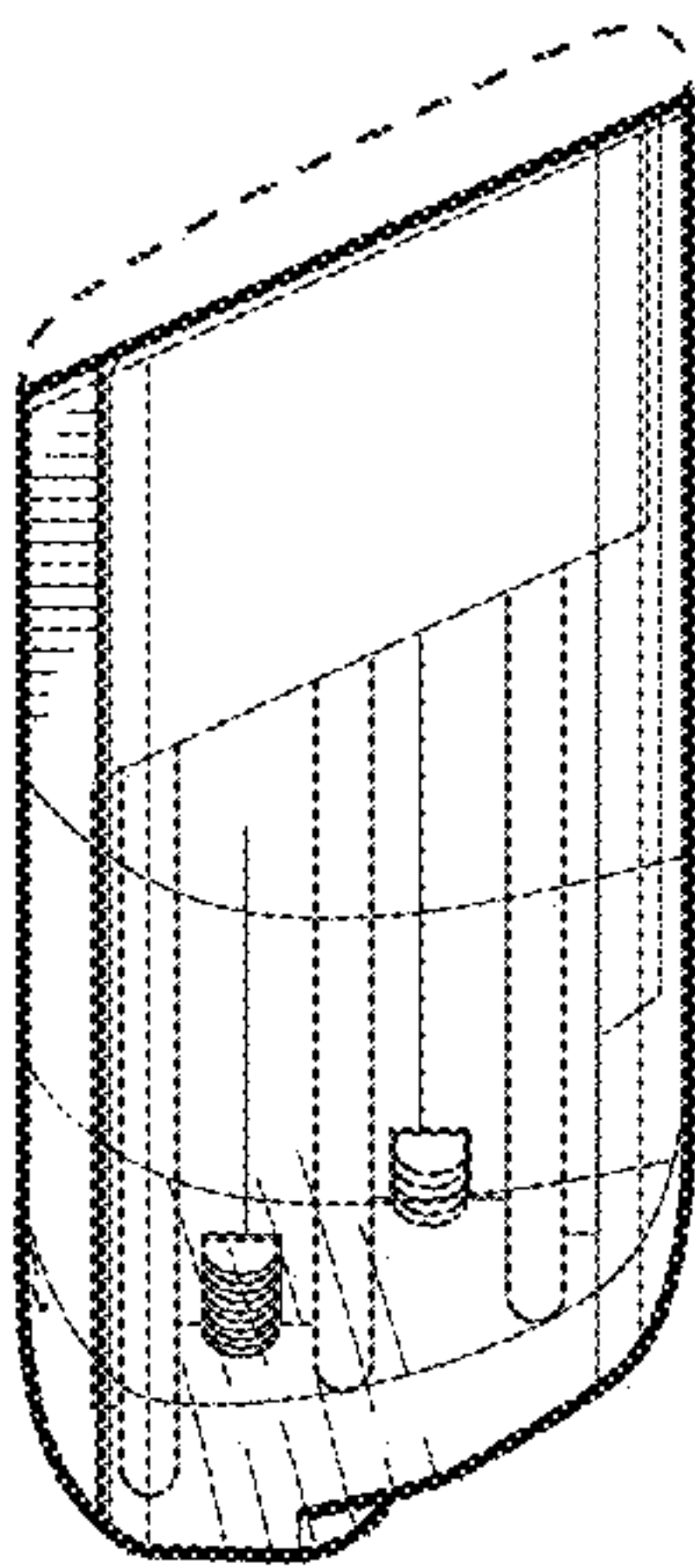
