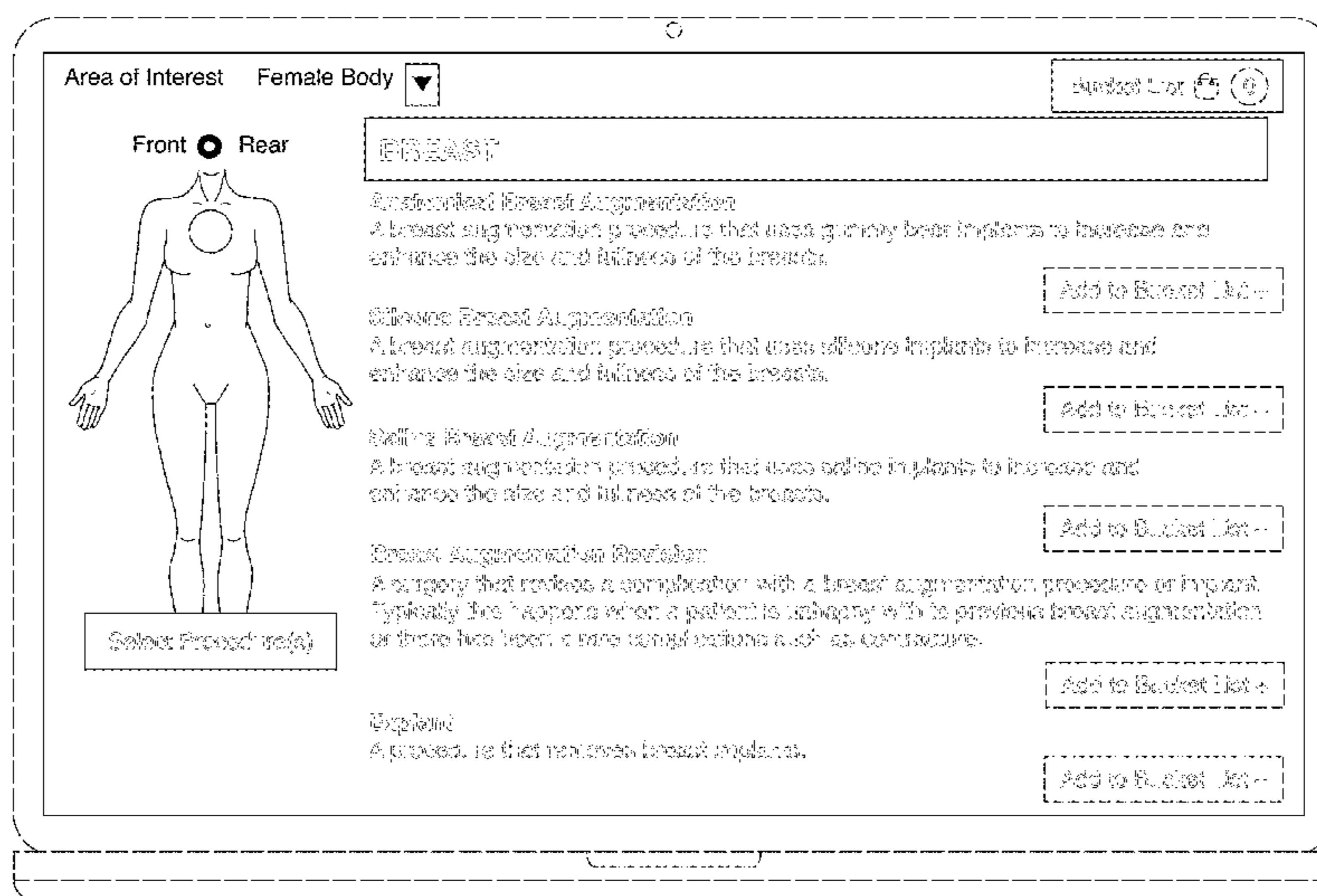




A surgical procedure that can accompany a rhinoplasty where the nose is broken to manually reshape or shorten the bone.



ABDOMEN

Liposuction Areas: Upper Abdomen, Lower Abdomen, Hips, Waist
A surgical procedure that removes stubborn fat deposits from the target areas.

Vaser Assisted Liposuction
Another form of liposuction that is less invasive and removes stubborn fat deposits from the target areas.


