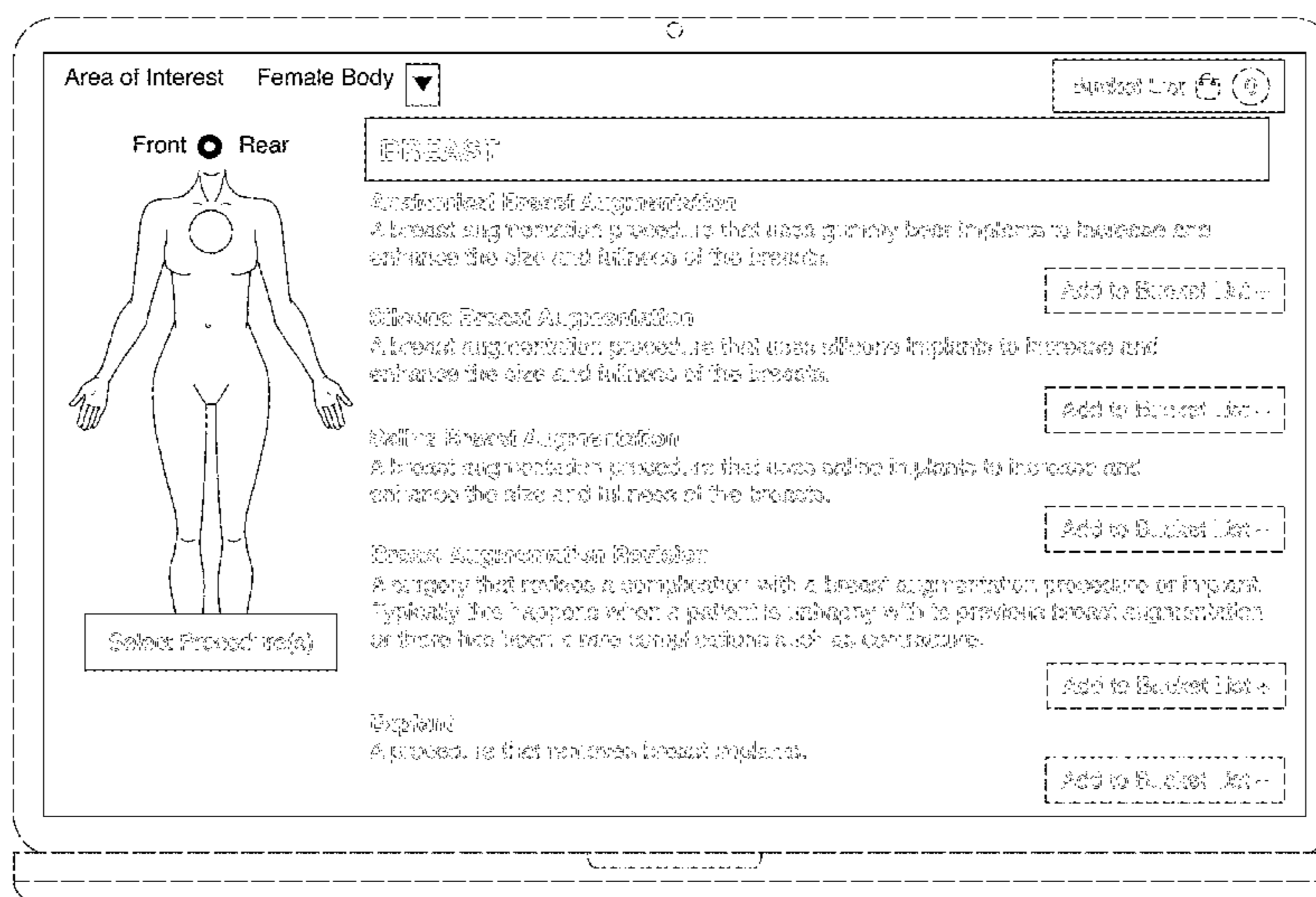





ABDOMEN

**Liposuction Areas: Upper Abdomen, Lower Abdomen, Hips, Waist**  
 A surgical procedure that removes stubborn fat deposits from the target areas.

**Vaser Assisted Liposuction**  
 Another form of liposuction that is less invasive and removes stubborn fat deposits from the target areas.


