(57) **CLAIM**

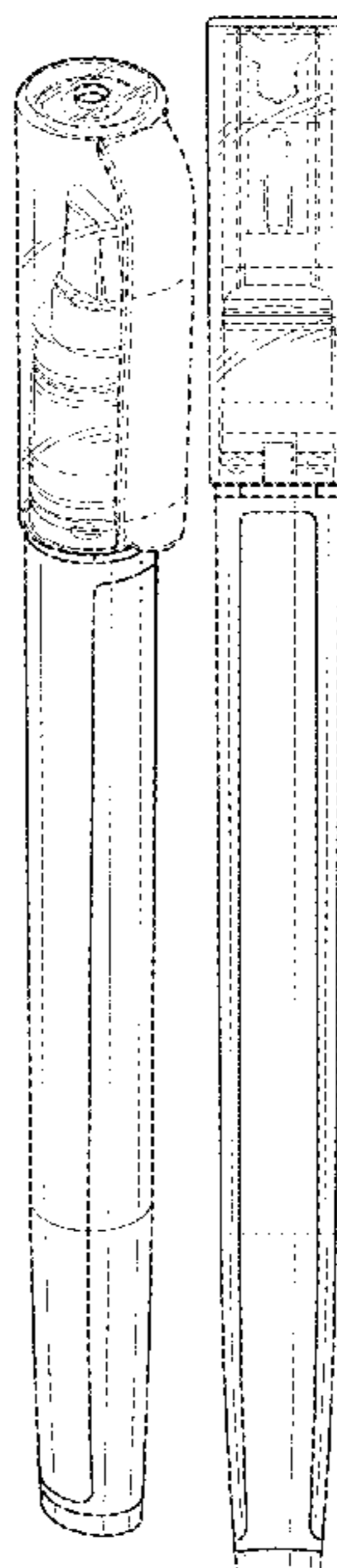
The ornamental design for writing instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a writing instrument showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the writing instrument shown by itself without the cap for convenience;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof with the cap;

FIG. 5 is a right view thereof;

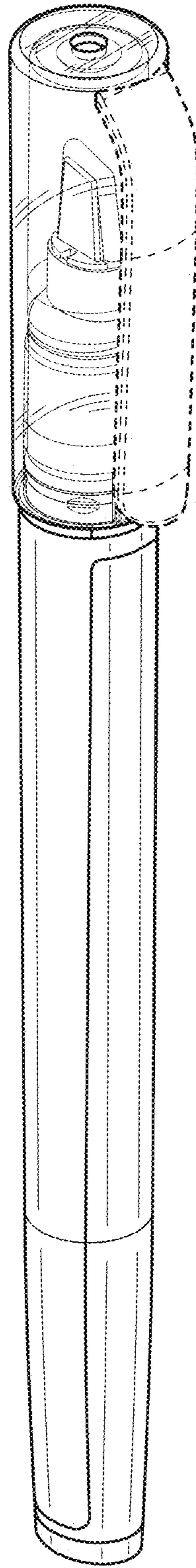

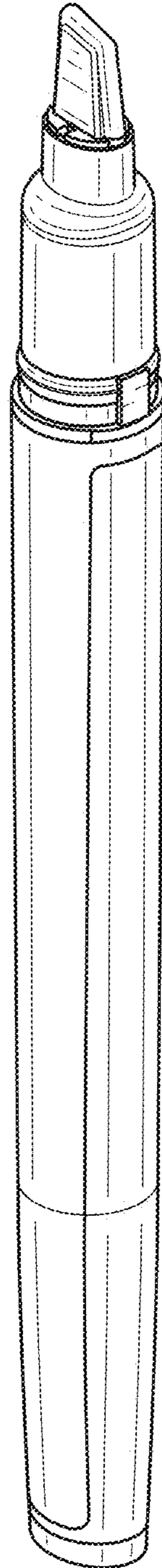

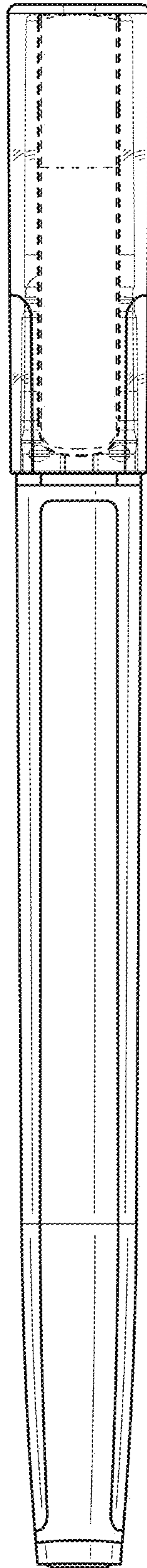

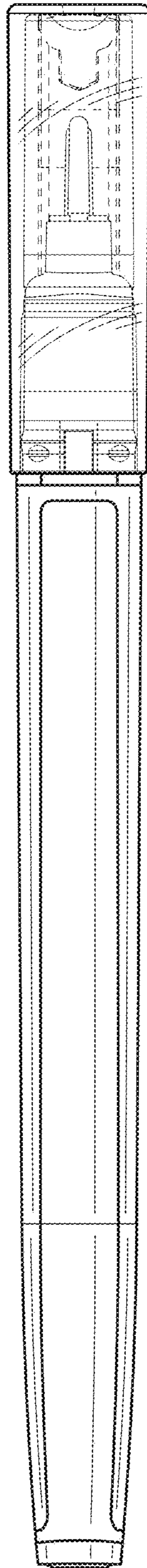

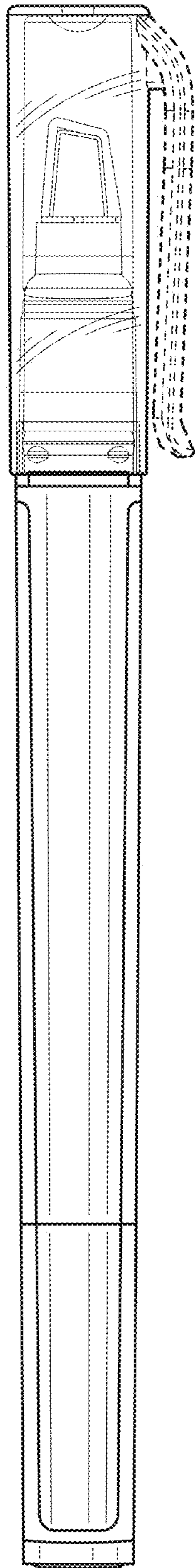

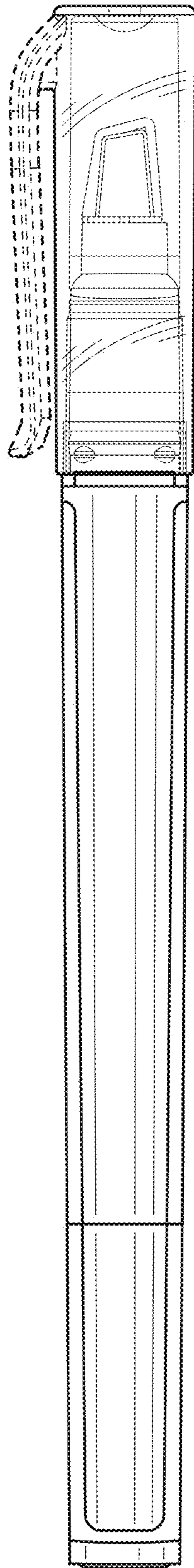

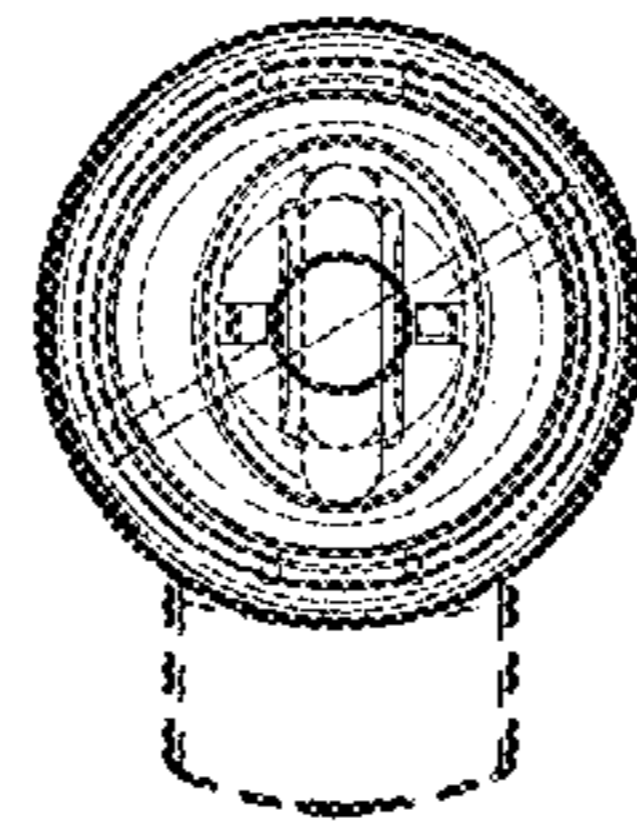

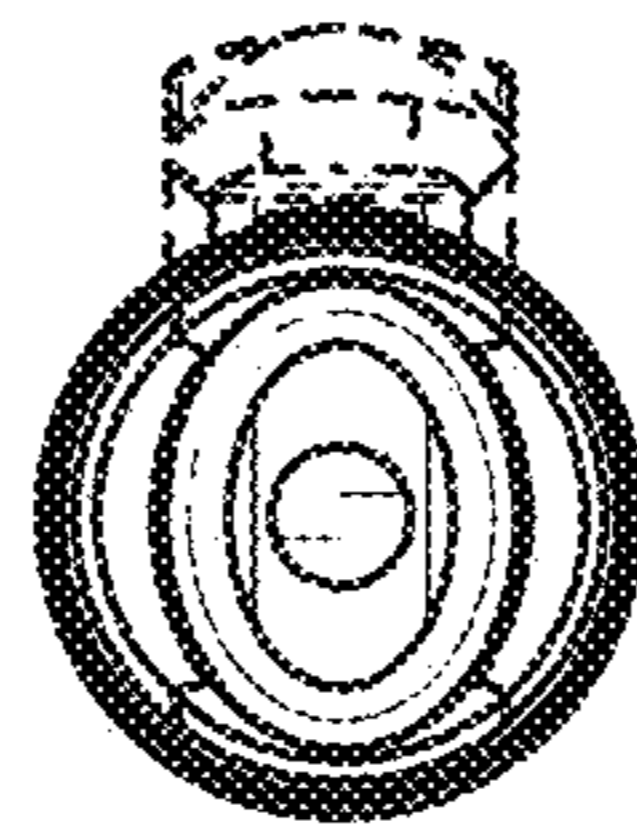
