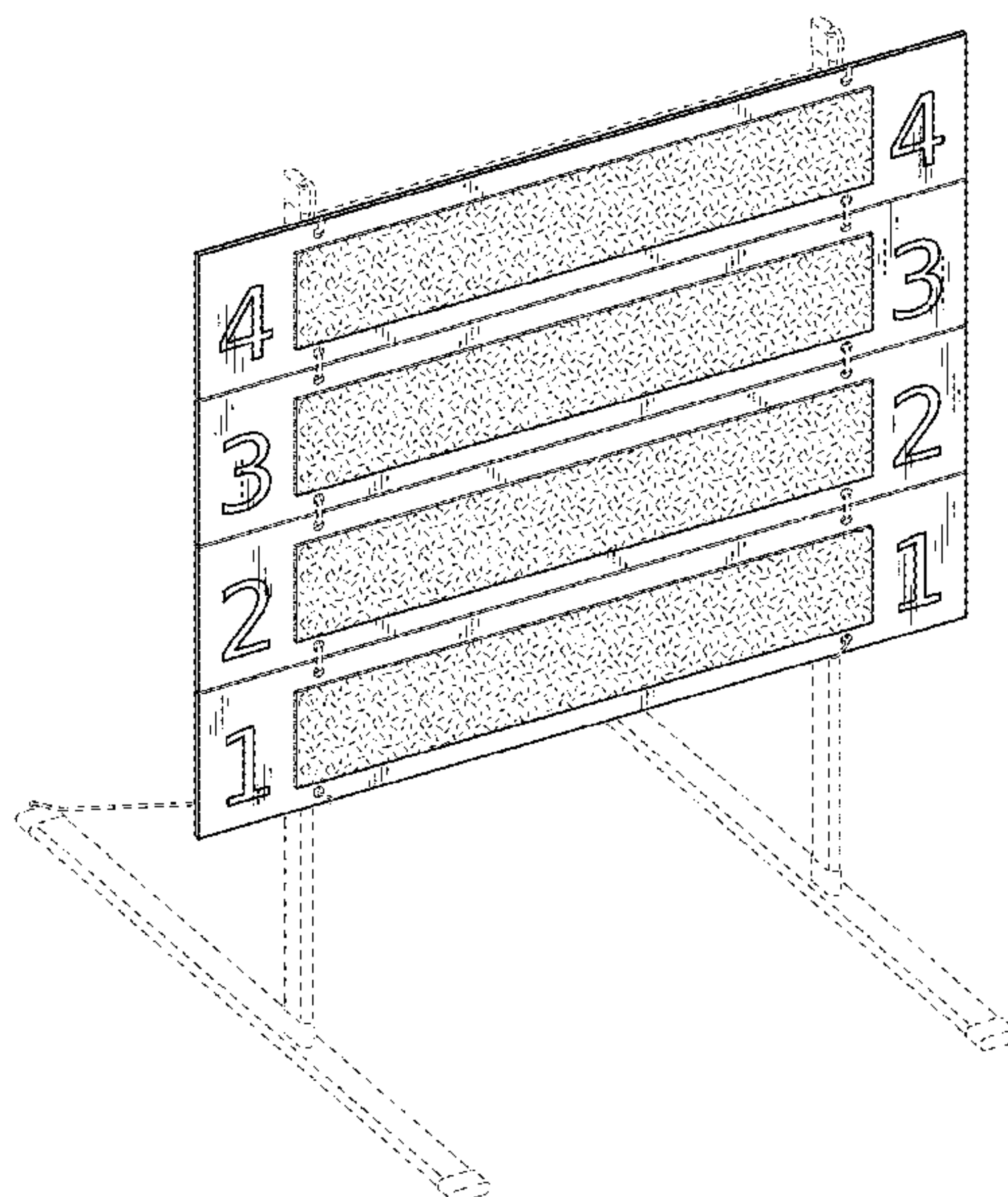
The ornamental design for a collapsible ball toss game, as

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a collapsible ball toss game,  
showing my new design in its environmental structure;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 8 is an exploded perspective view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof, illustrated in a col-  
lapsed configuration; and,  
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of FIG. 1 showing the claimed  
design in condition of use.

The broken lines showing a stand and the balls depict  
environmental structure that form no part of the claimed  
design. The small broken lines on the surface of the rect-  
angular features represent texture and form part of the  
claimed design. The remaining broken lines in the drawings,  
depict portions of the collapsible ball toss game that form no  
part of the claimed design.

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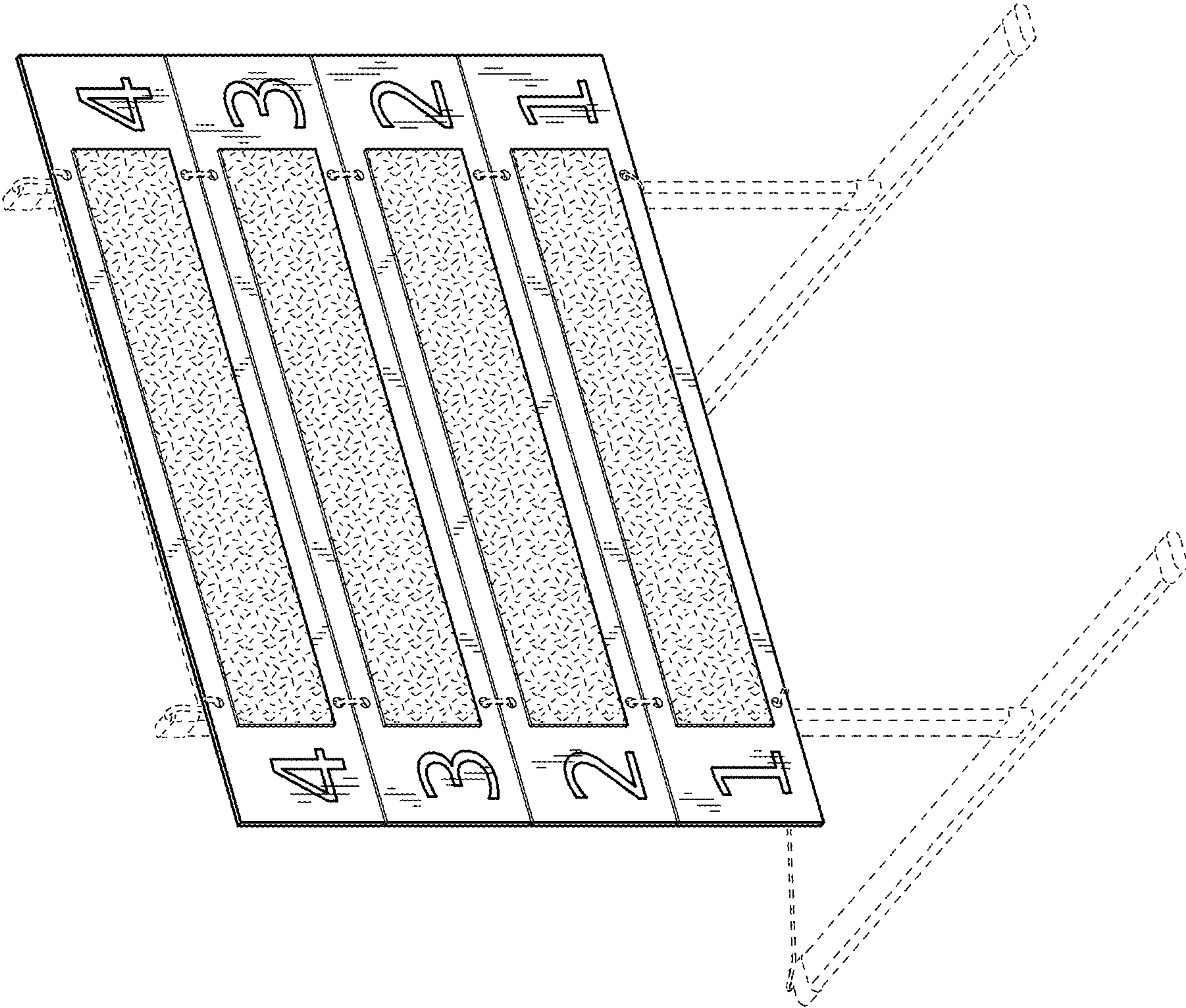

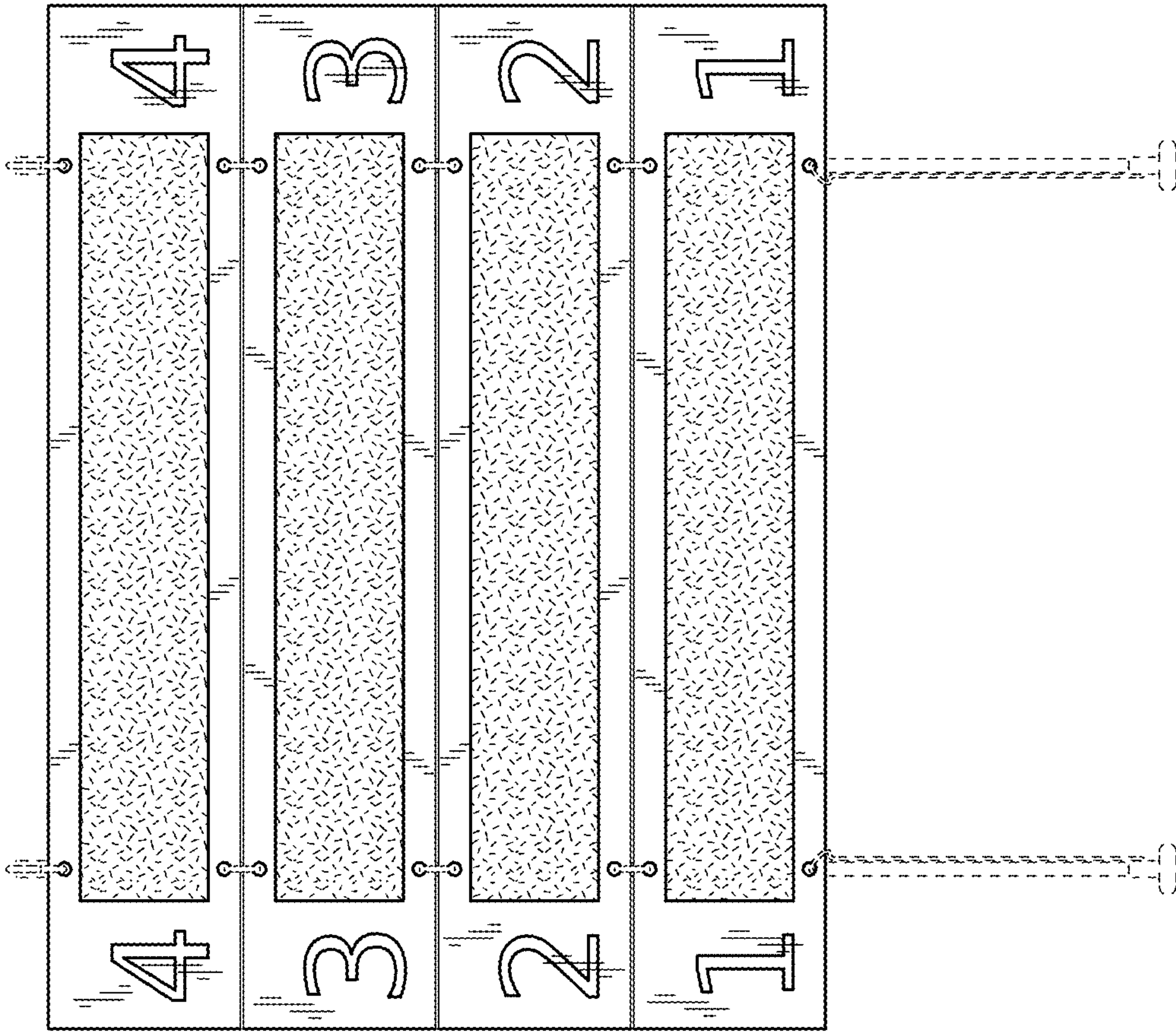

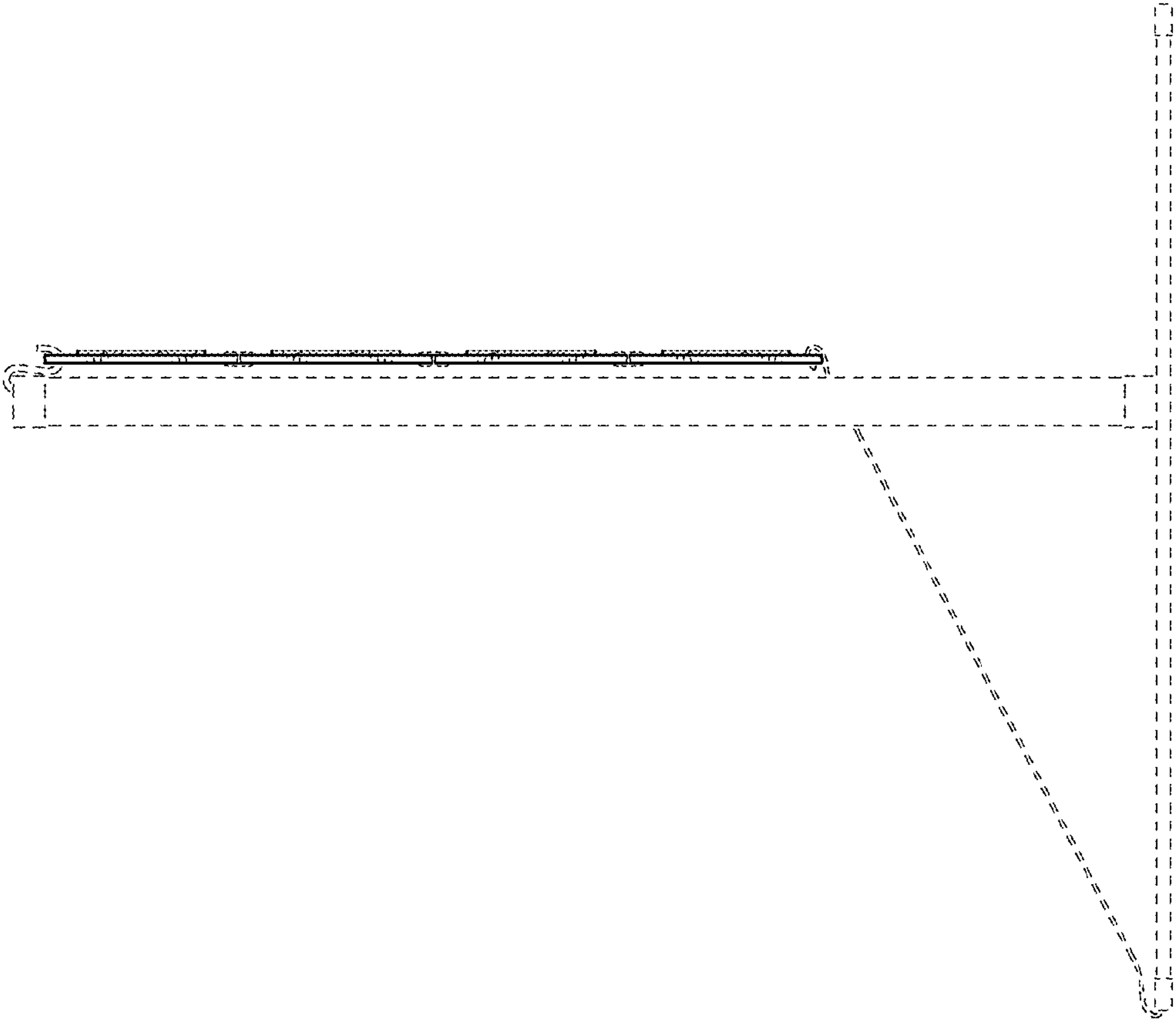

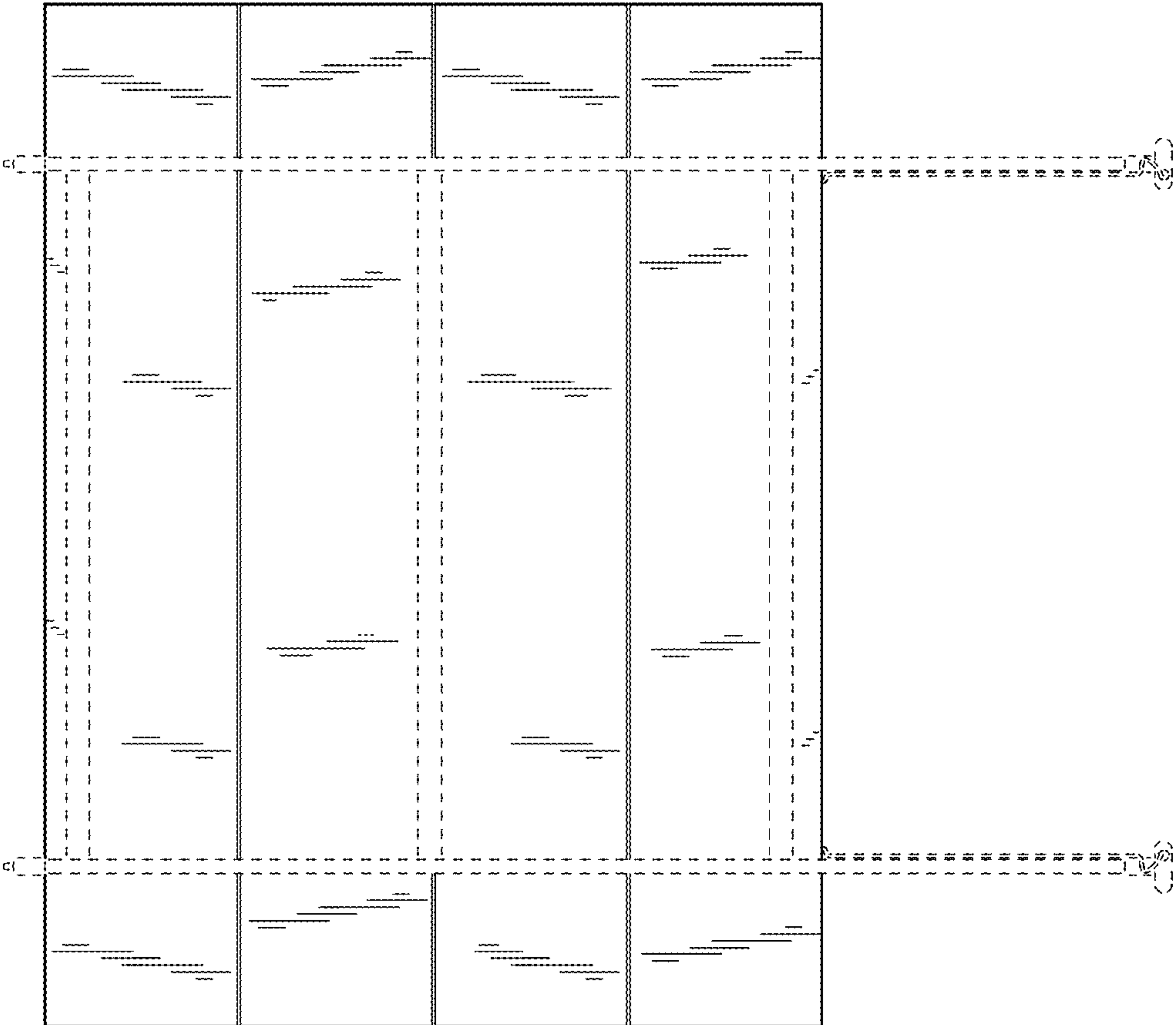
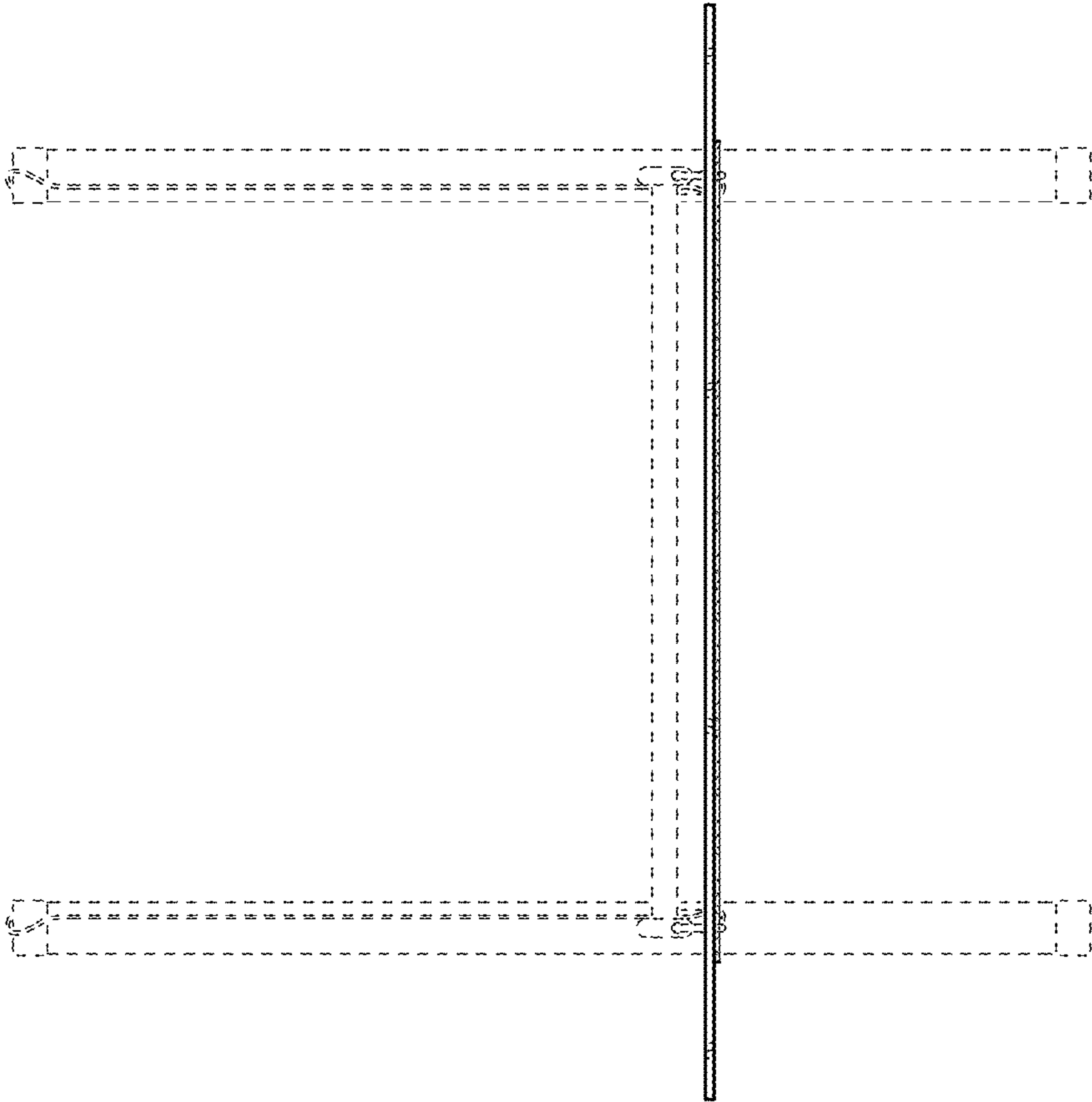
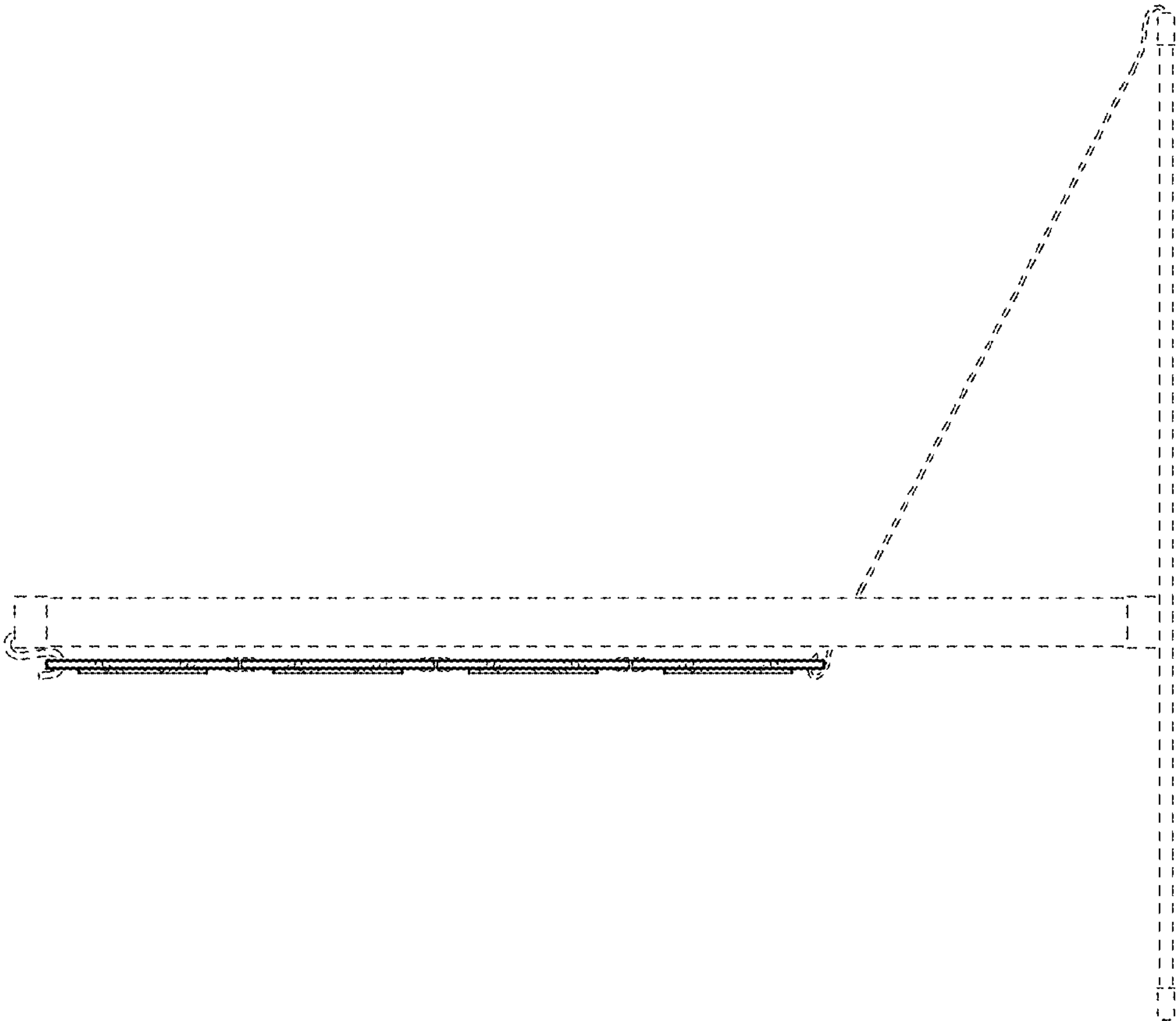

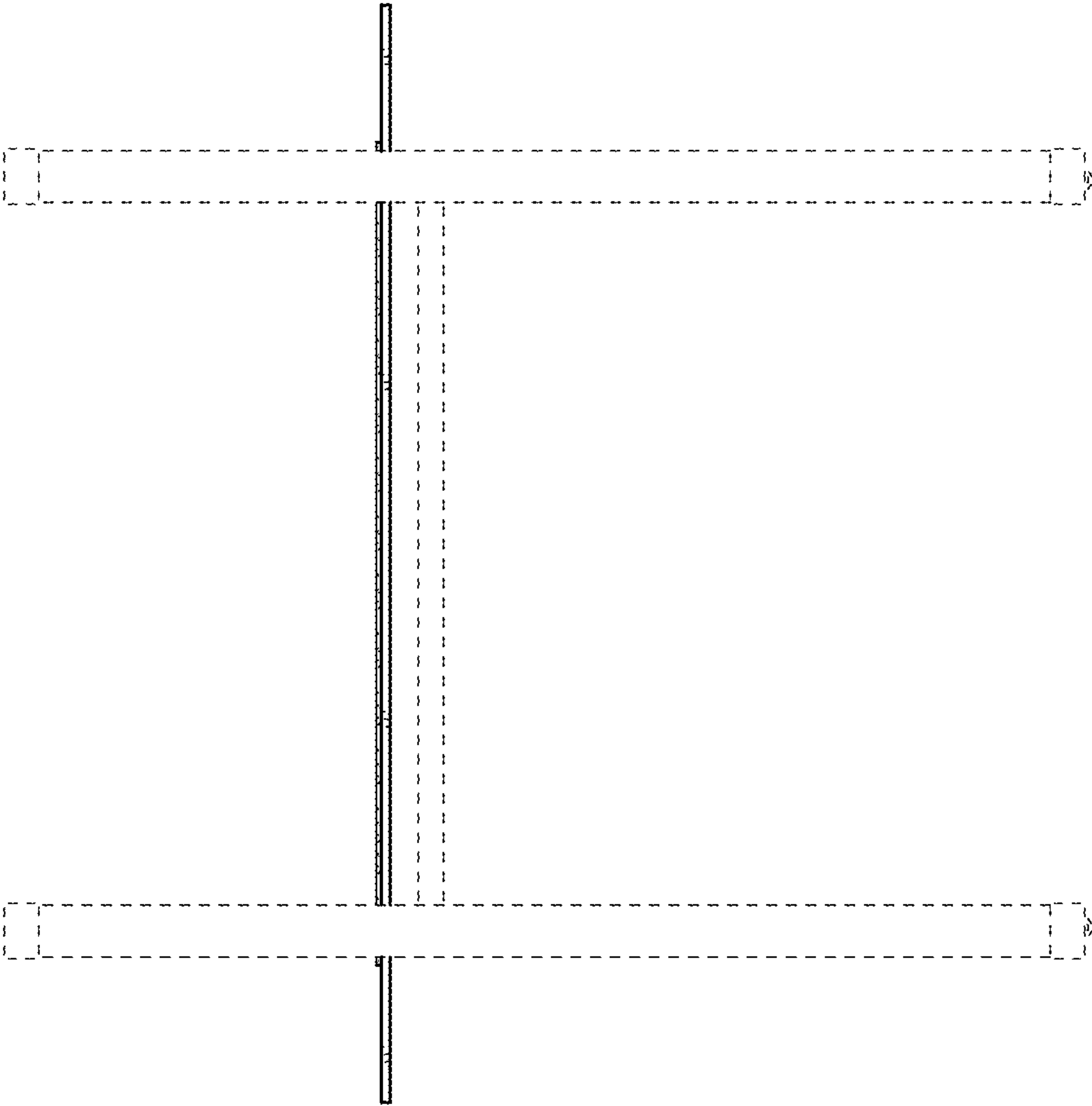
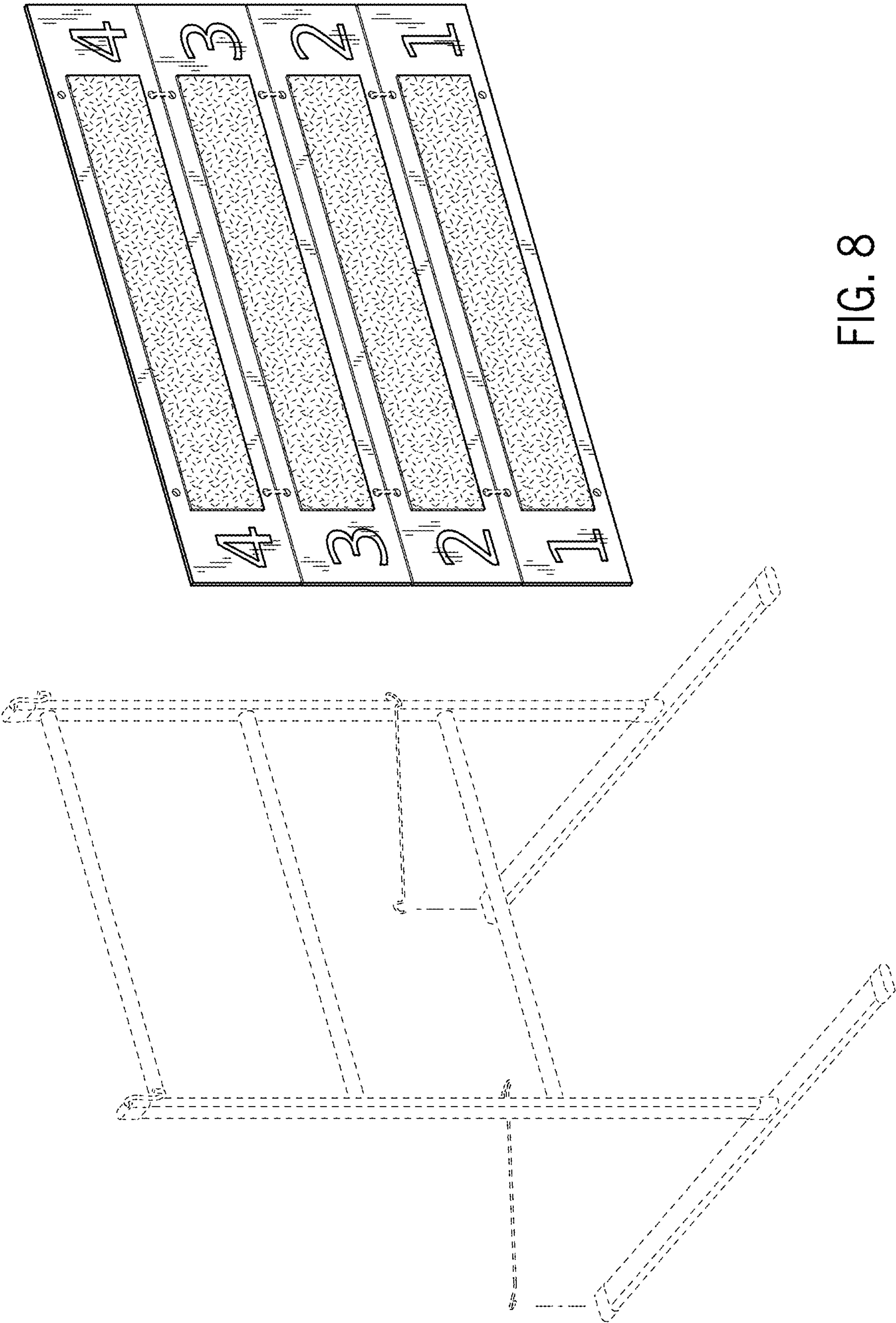

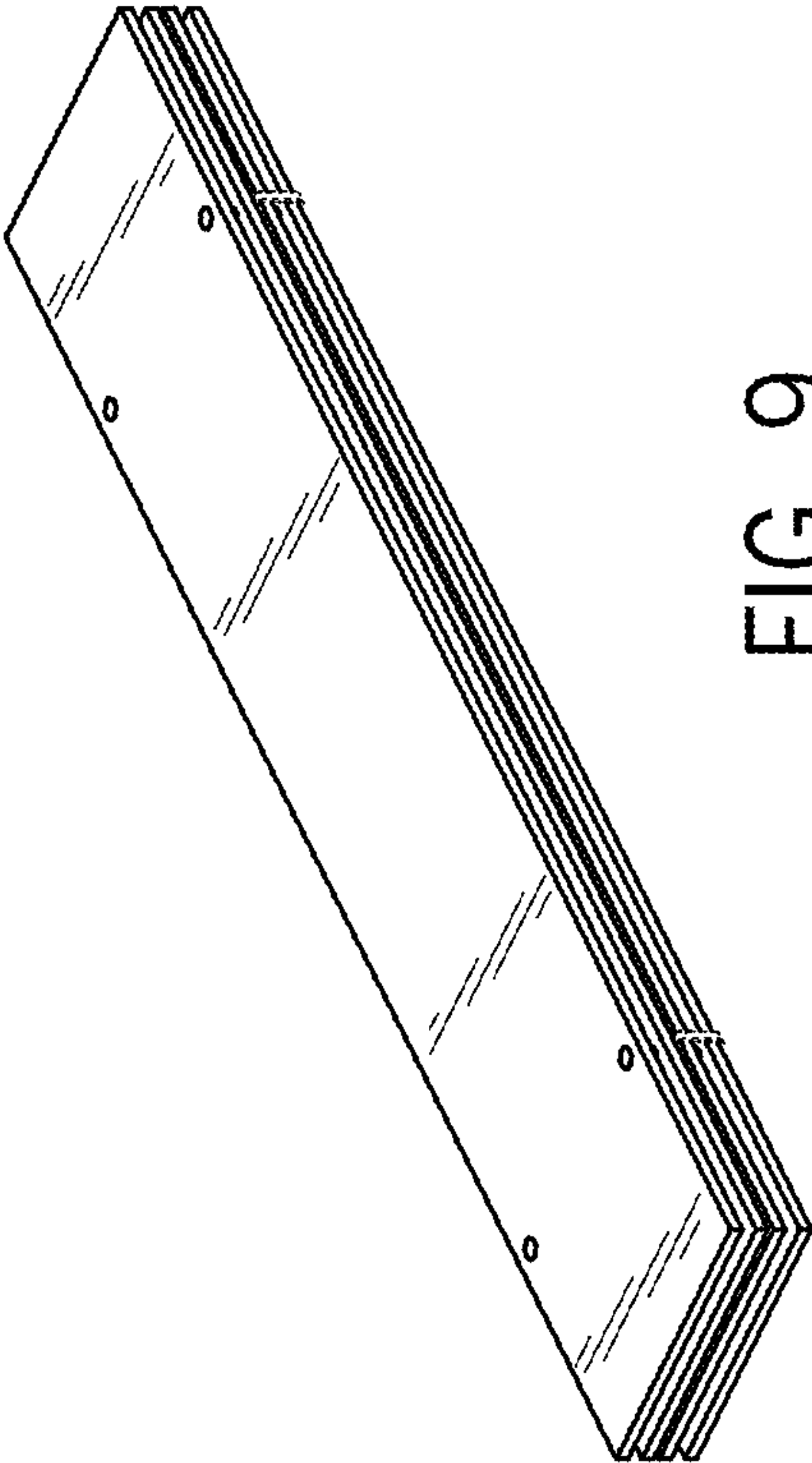

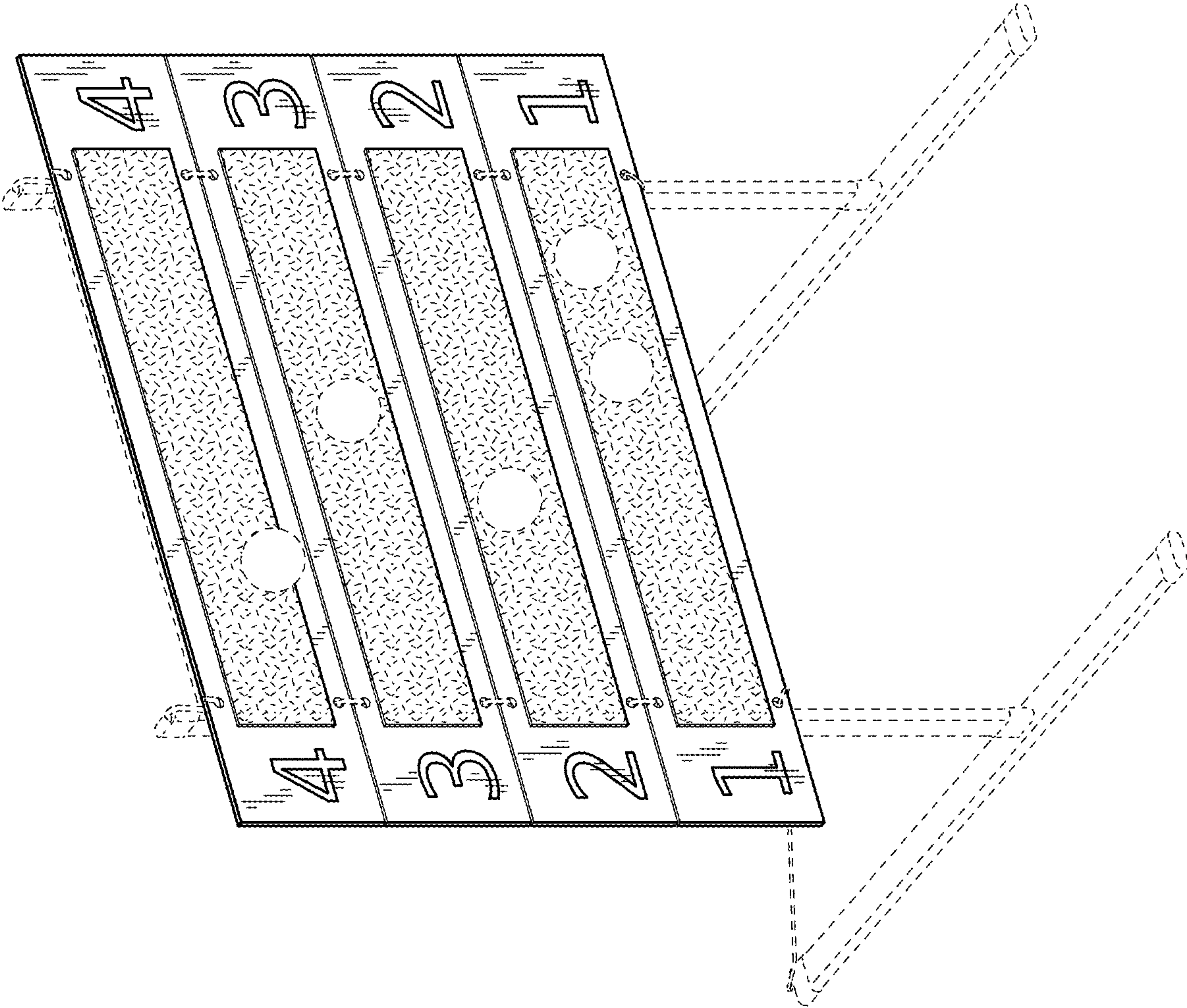
