The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

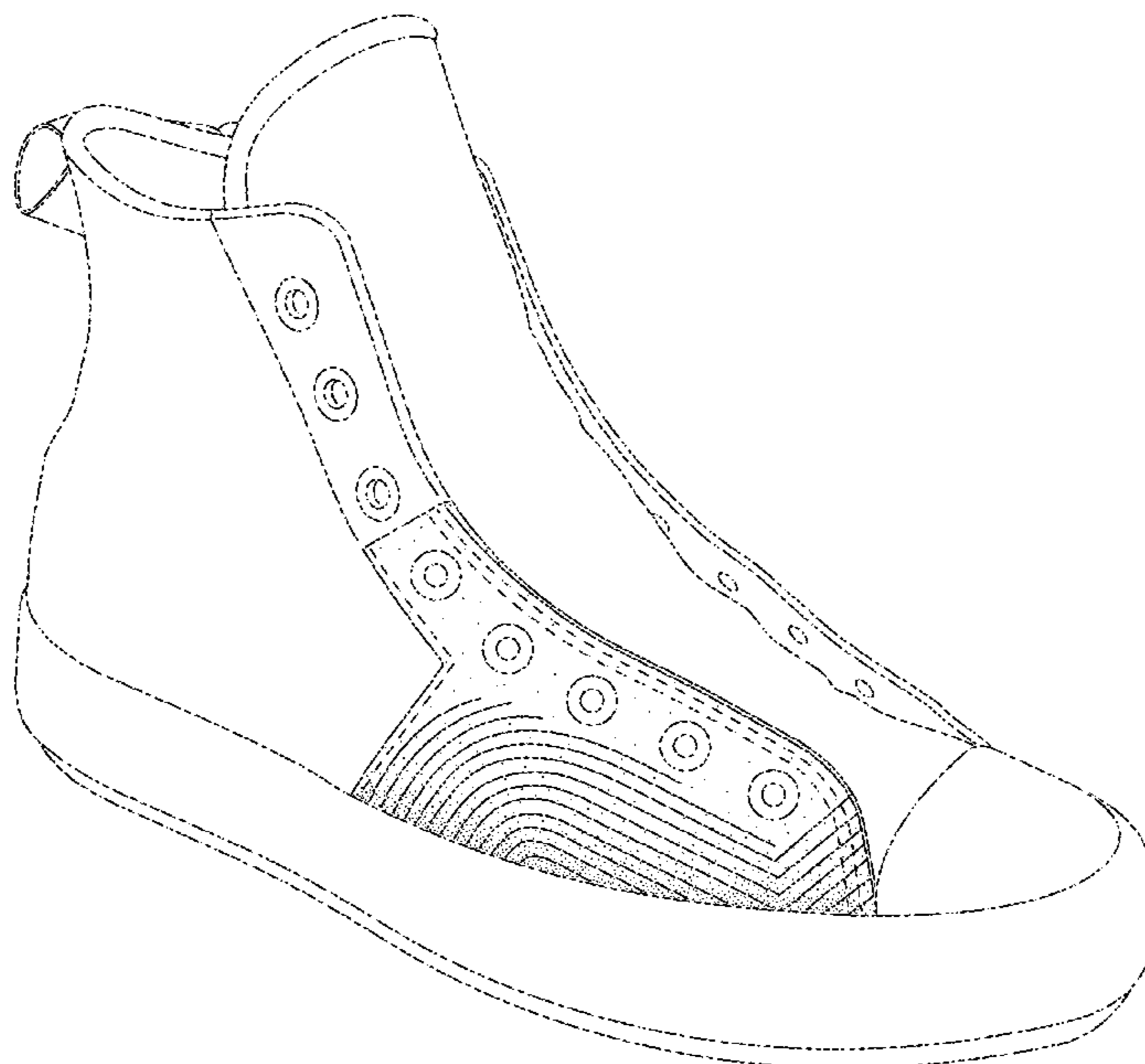
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

The even-length broken lines within the shaded area represent stitching that forms no part of the claimed design. The five uneven-length broken line circular regions within the shaded area represent eyelets that form no part of the claimed design. The uneven-length broken line immediately adjacent to the shaded area defines the bounds of the claimed design and forms no part thereof. The uneven-length broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

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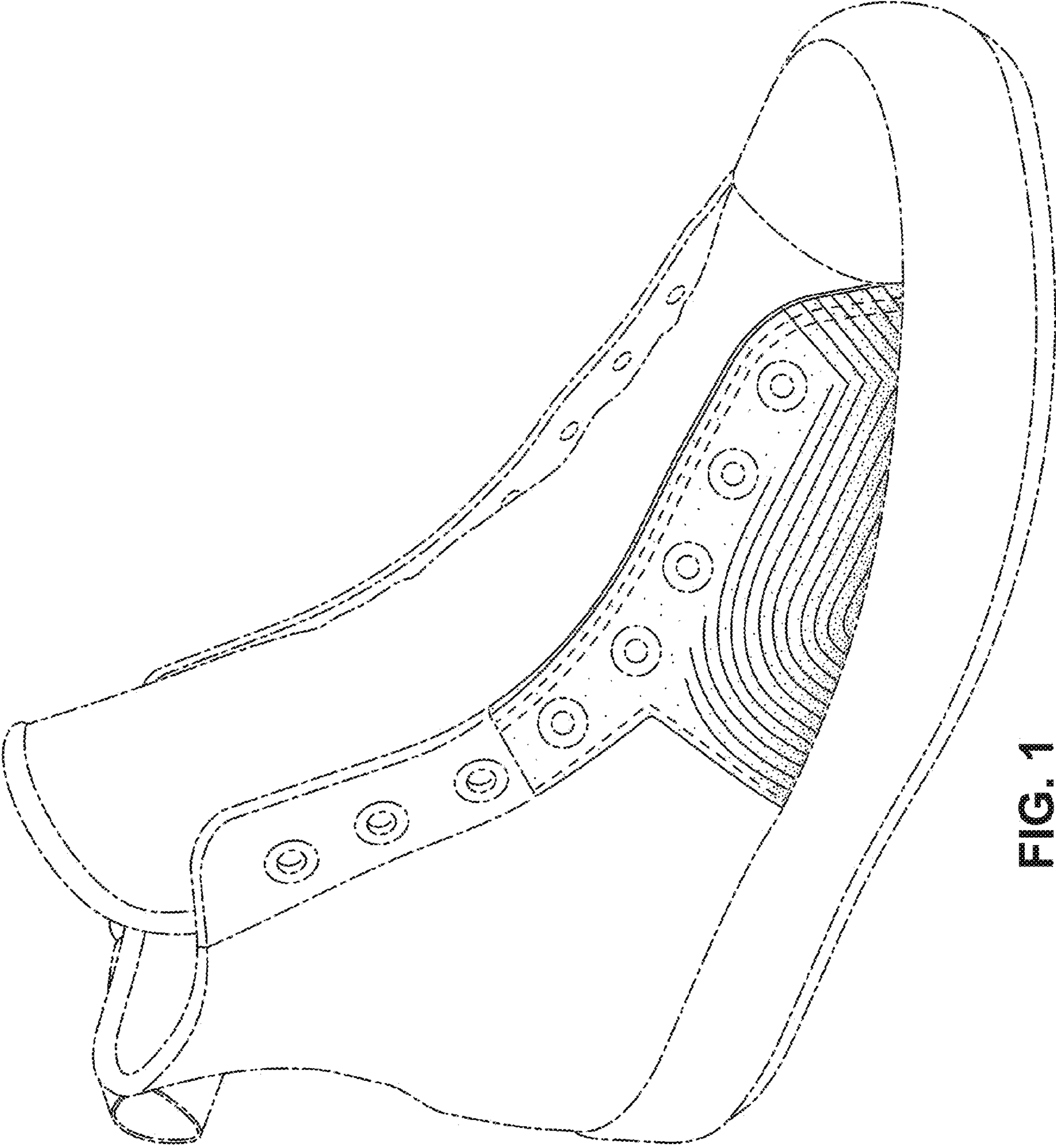

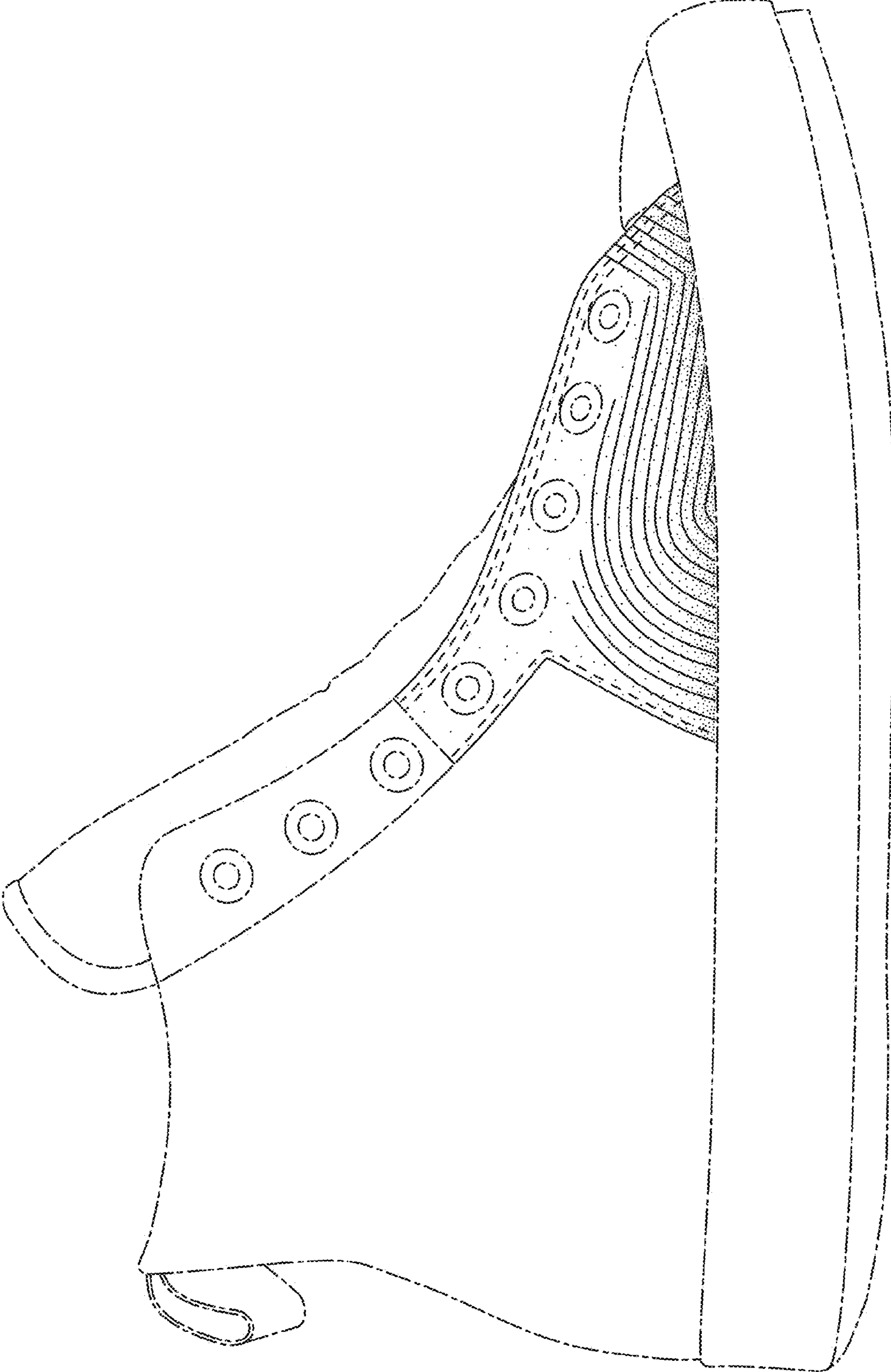

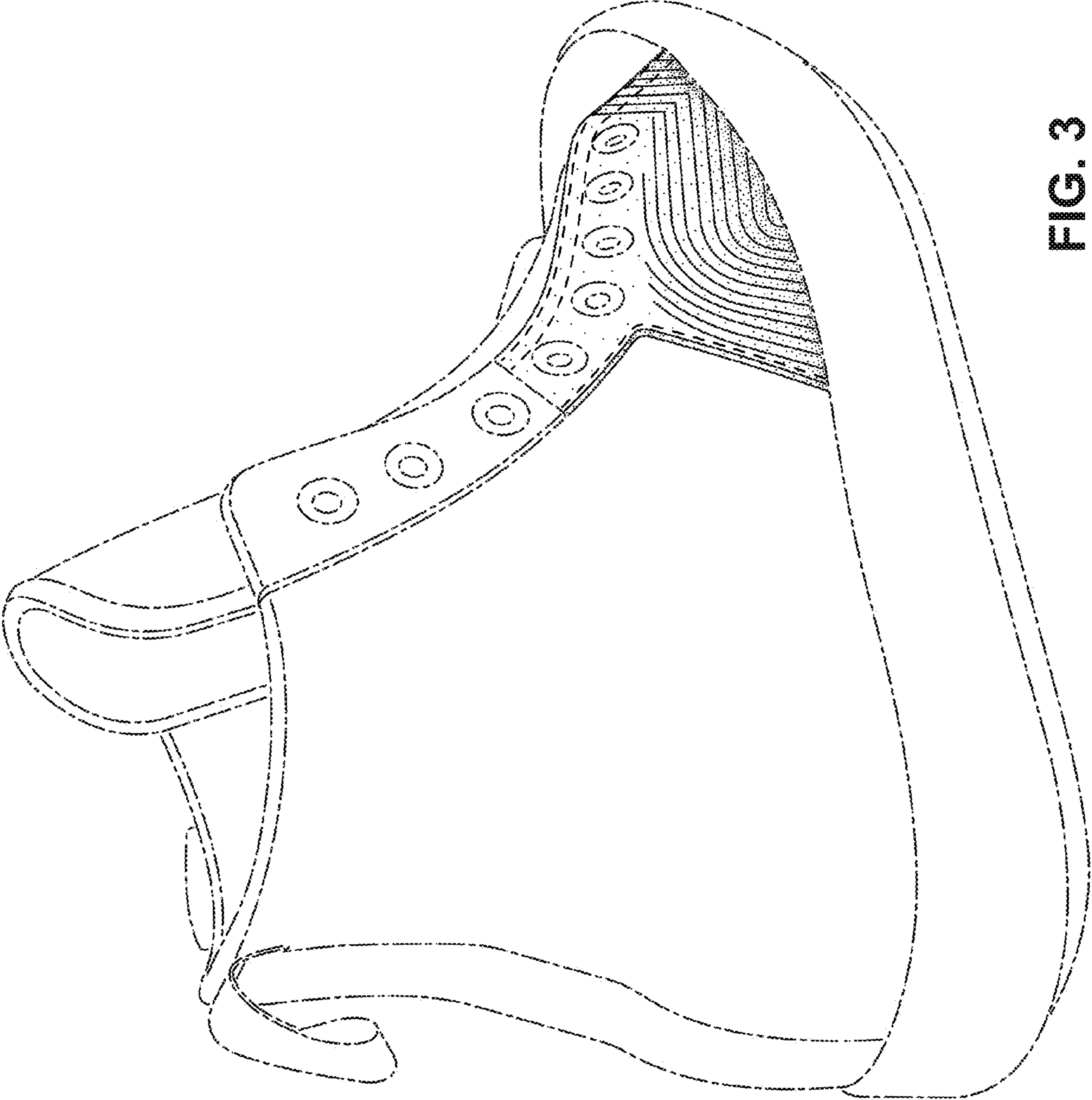
