FIG. 8 is a top view thereof;

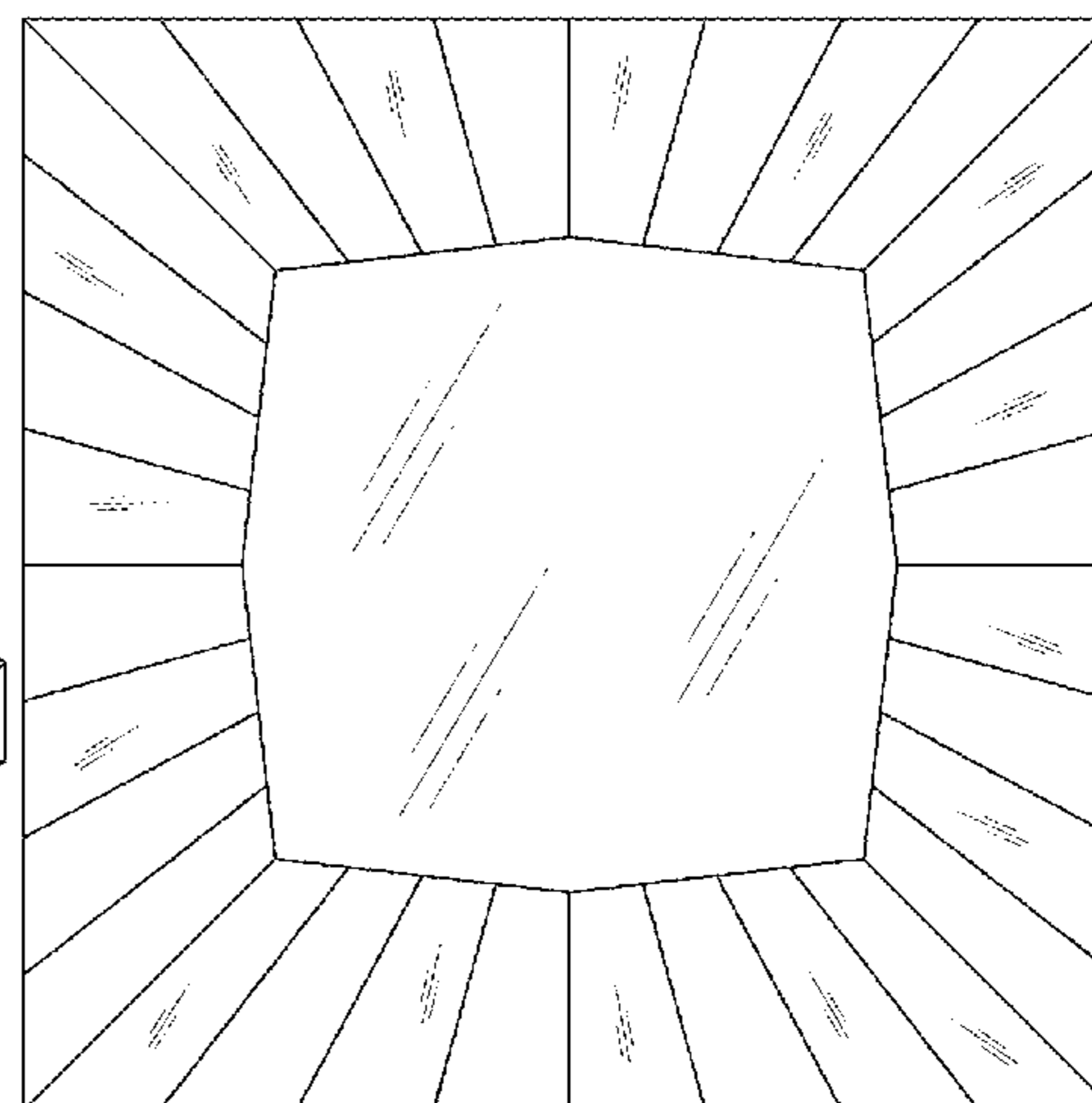
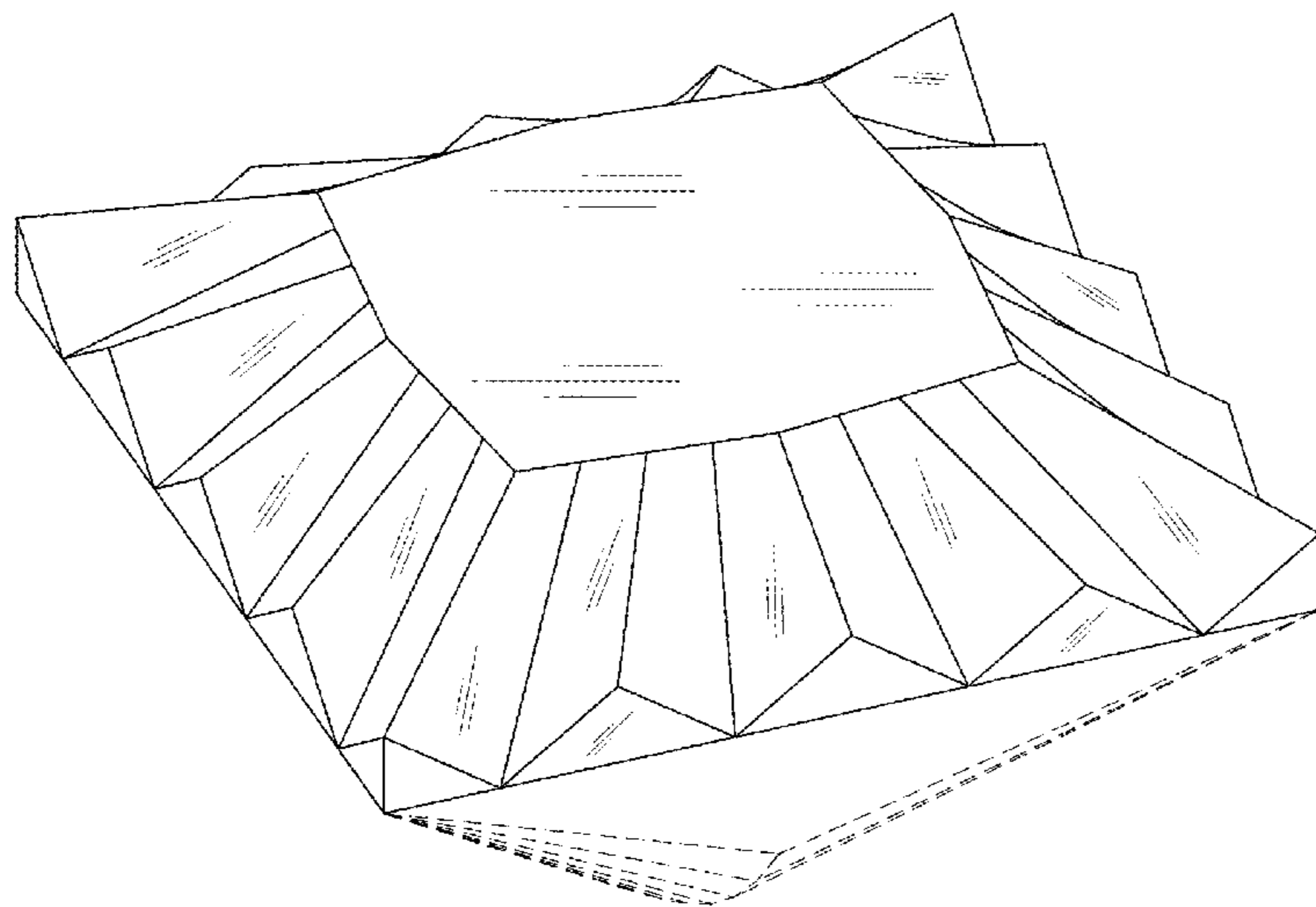
FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof; and,

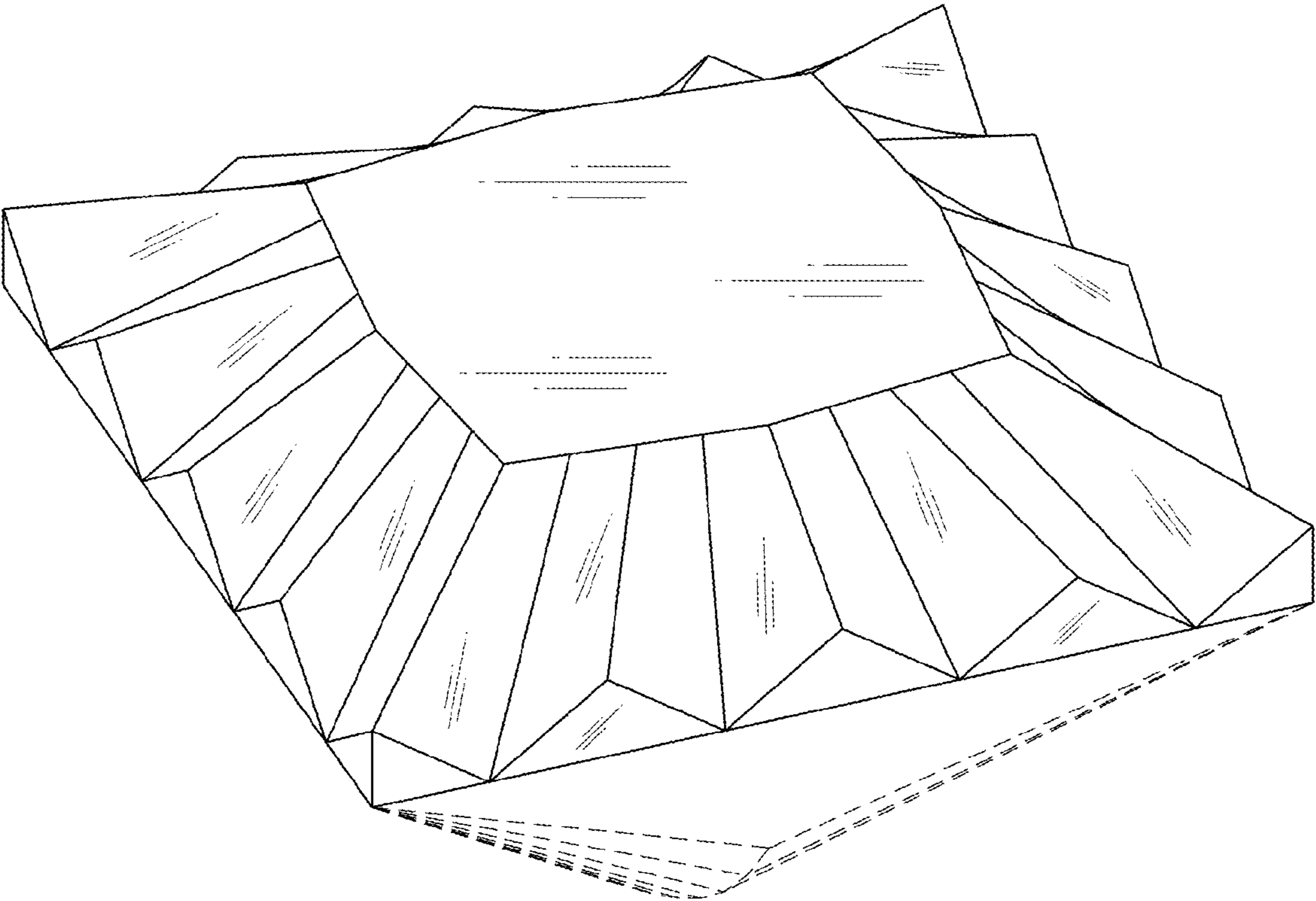

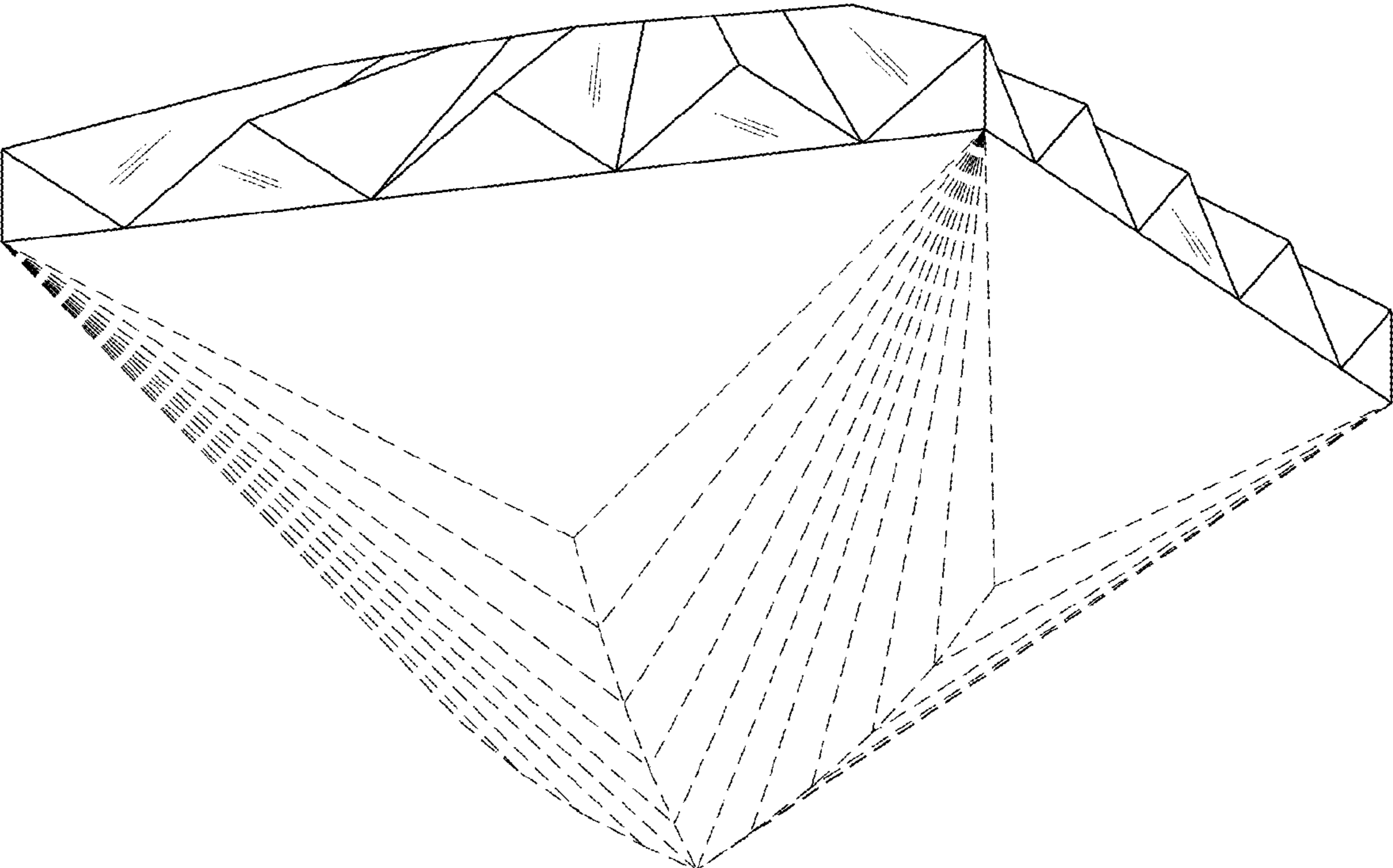

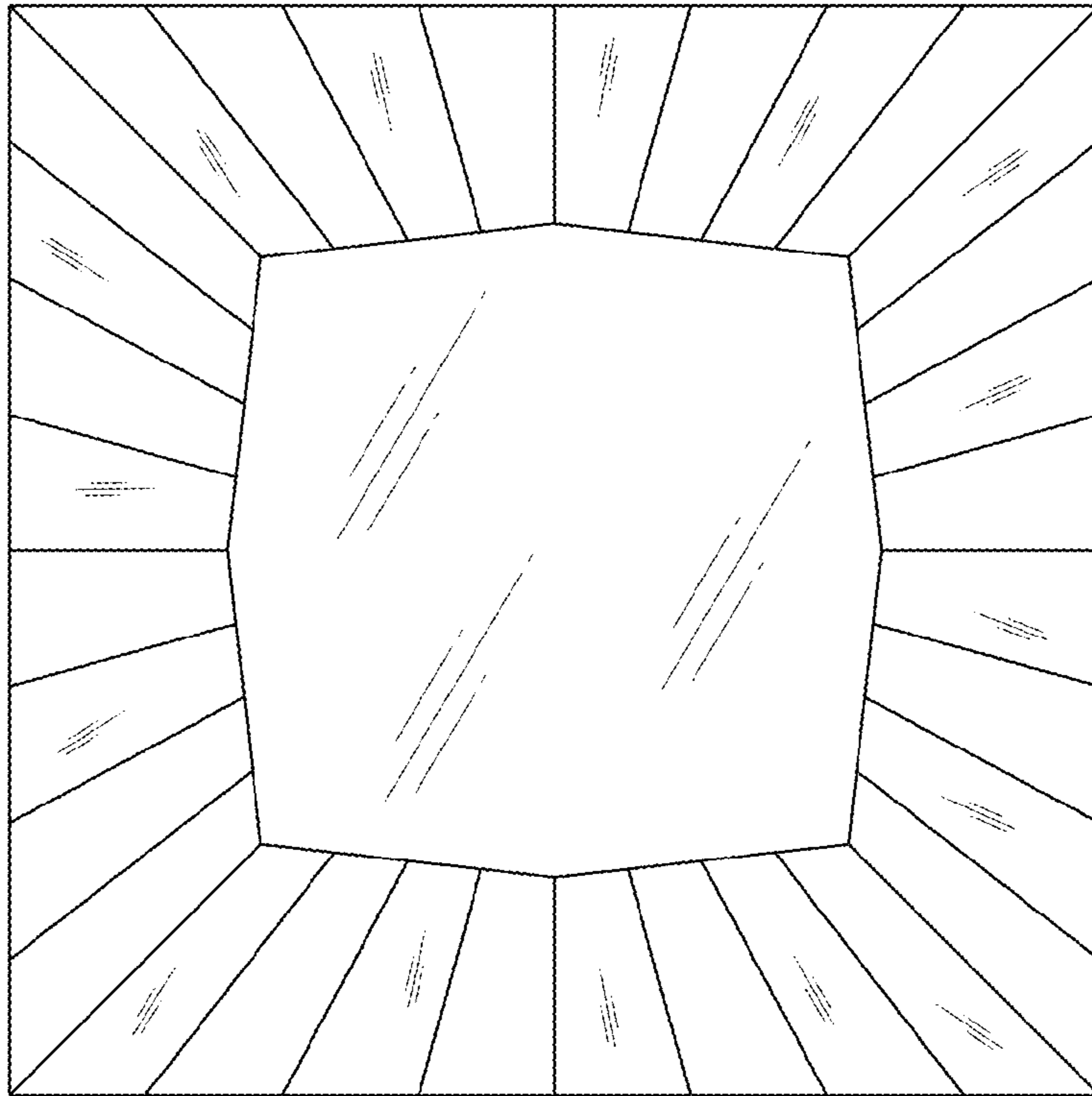

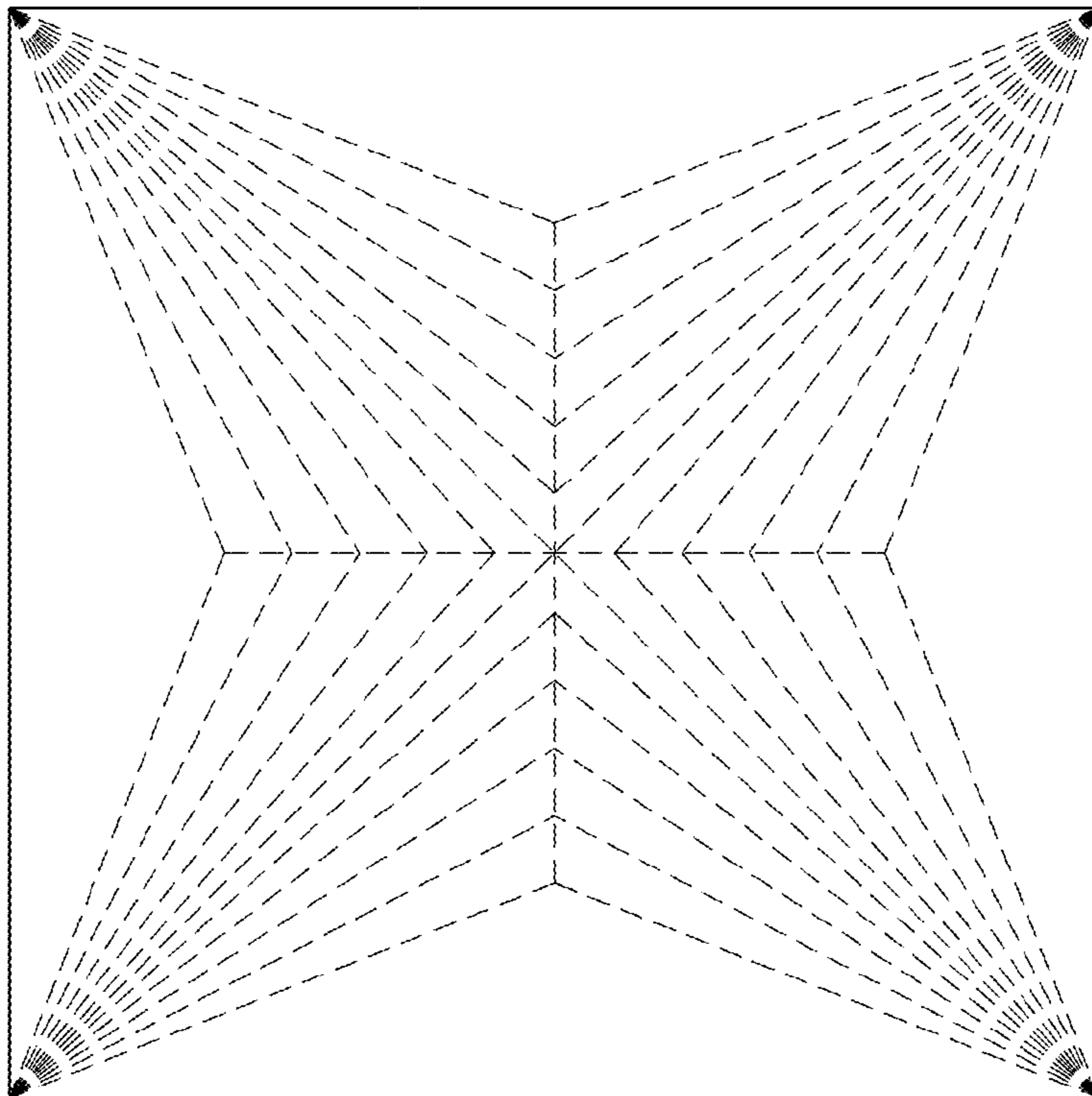

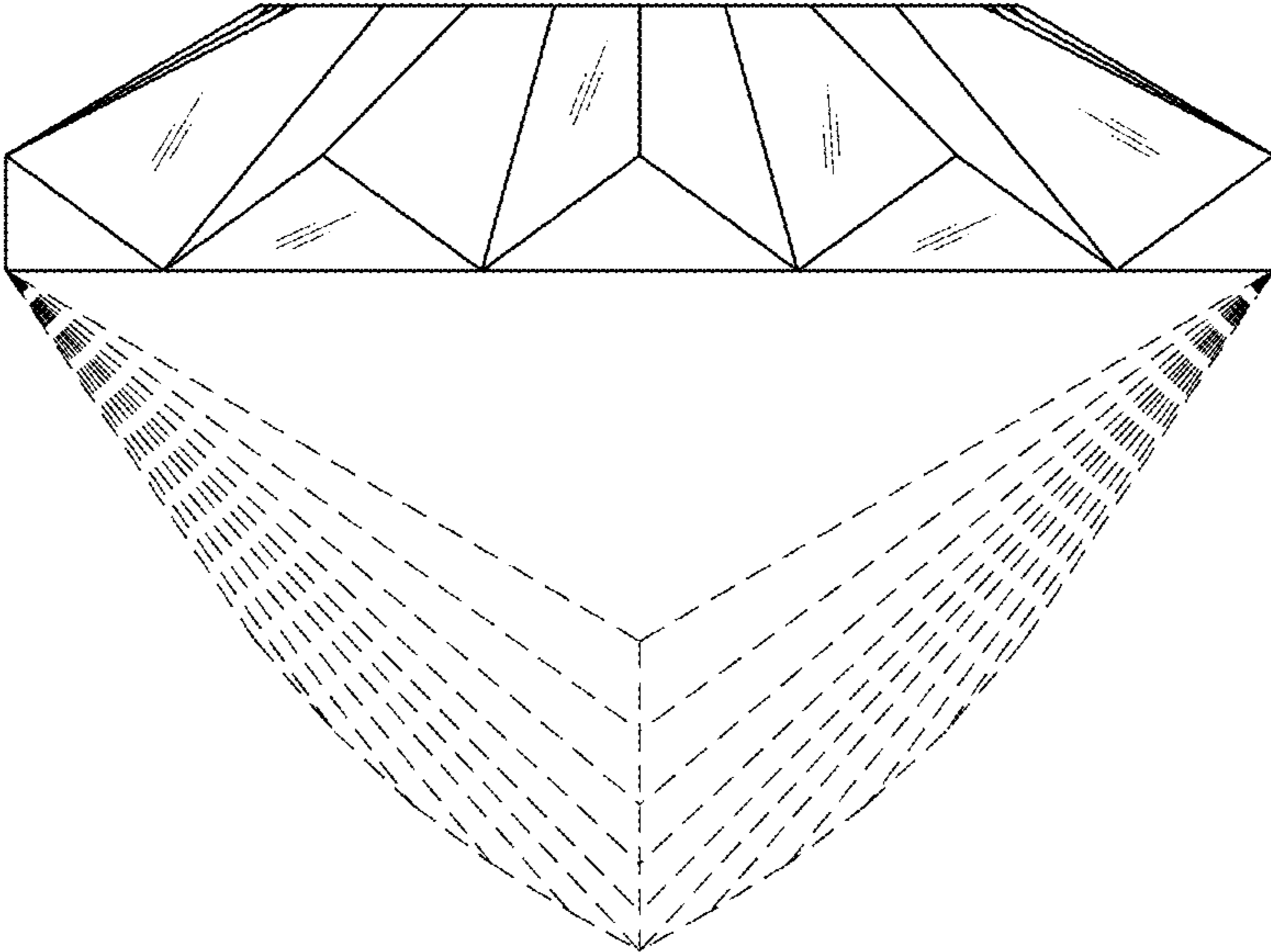

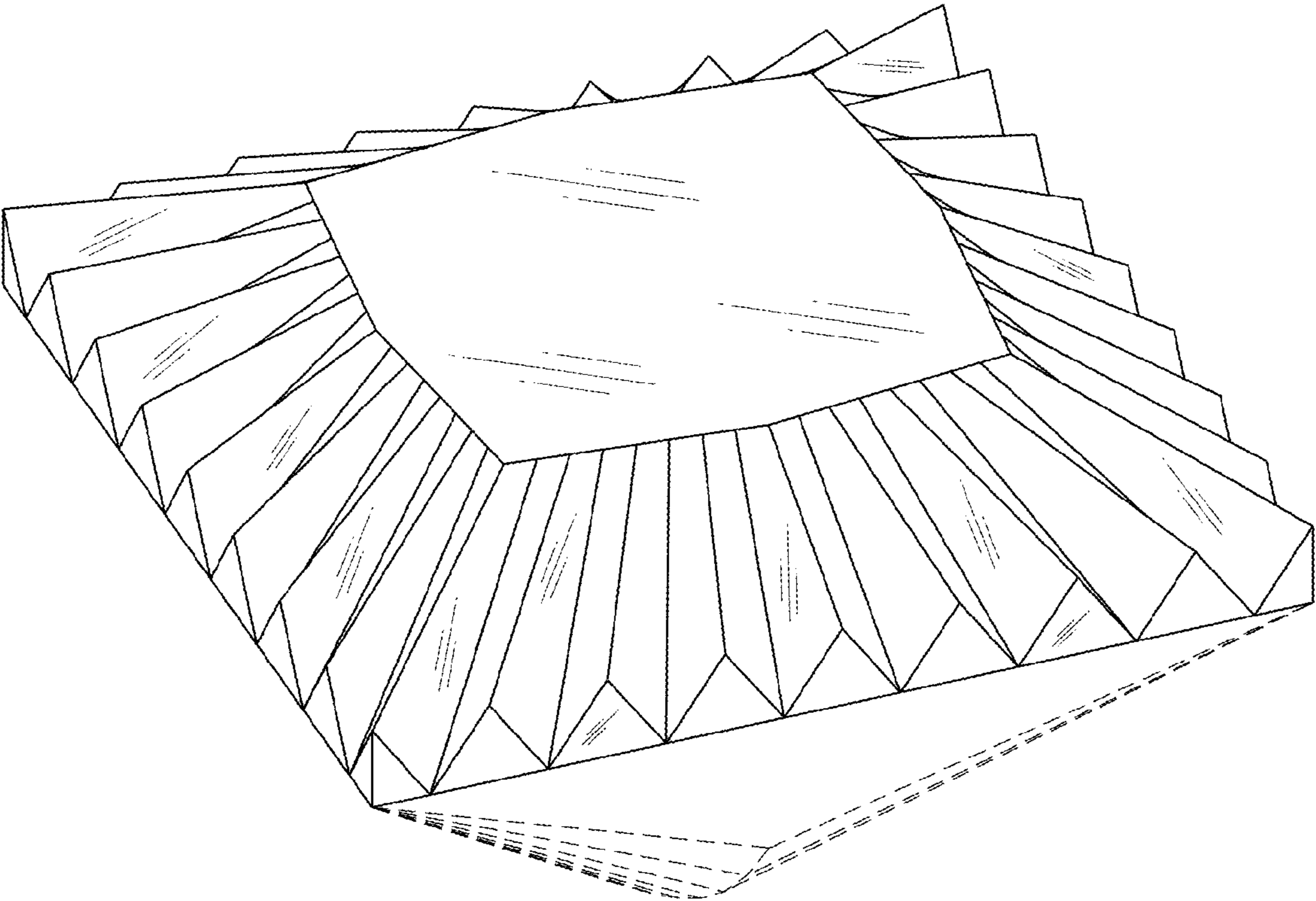

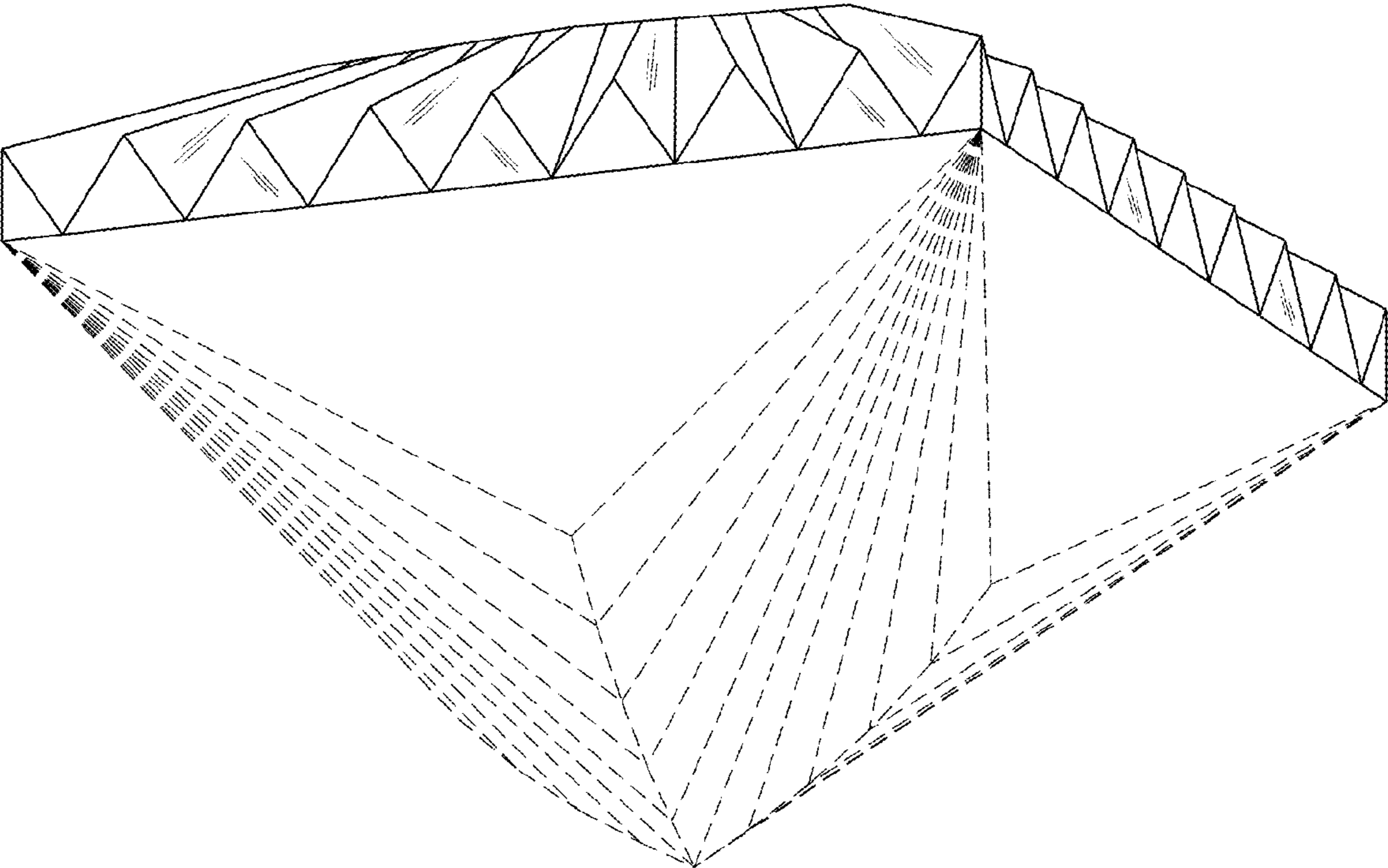

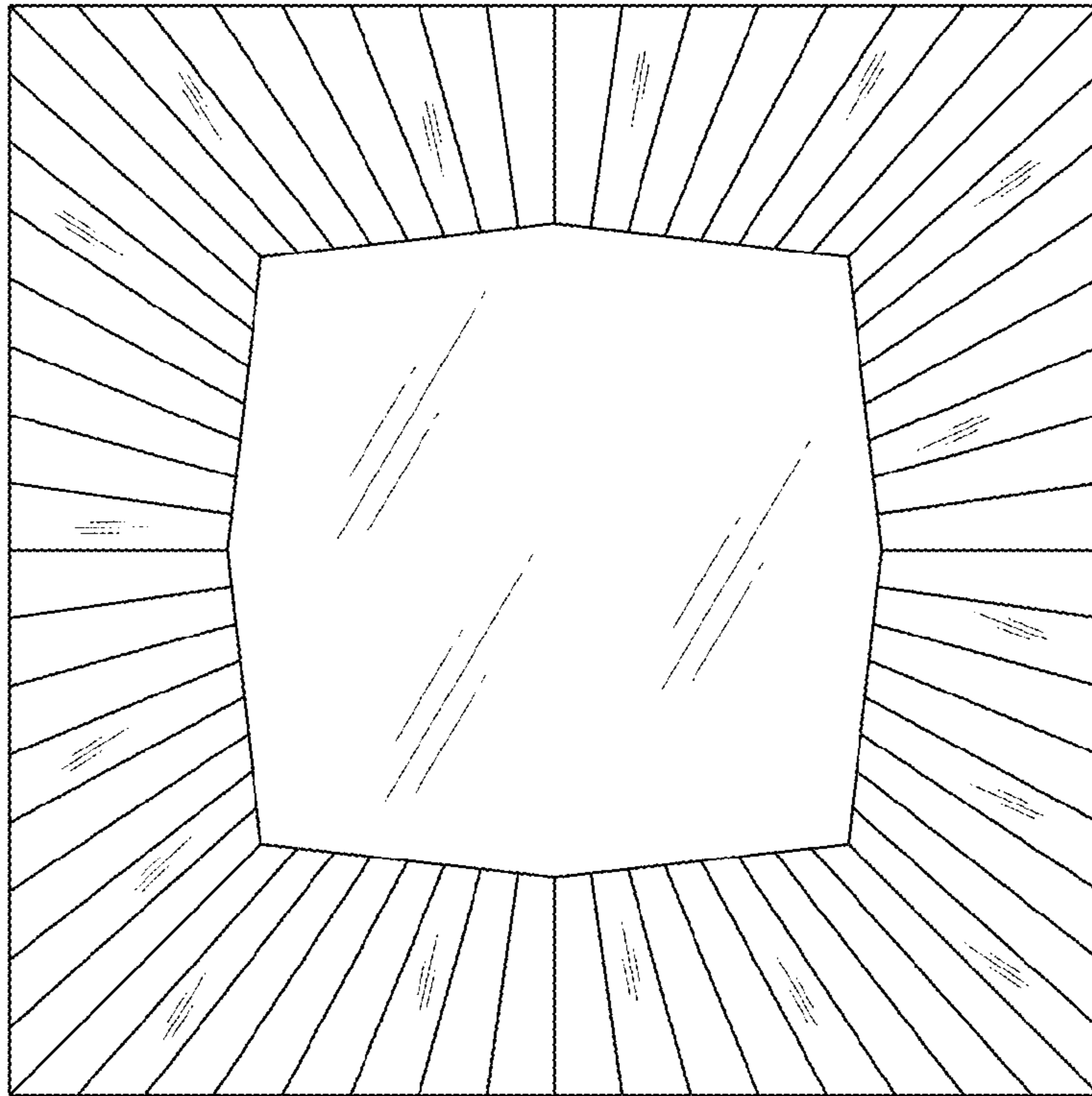

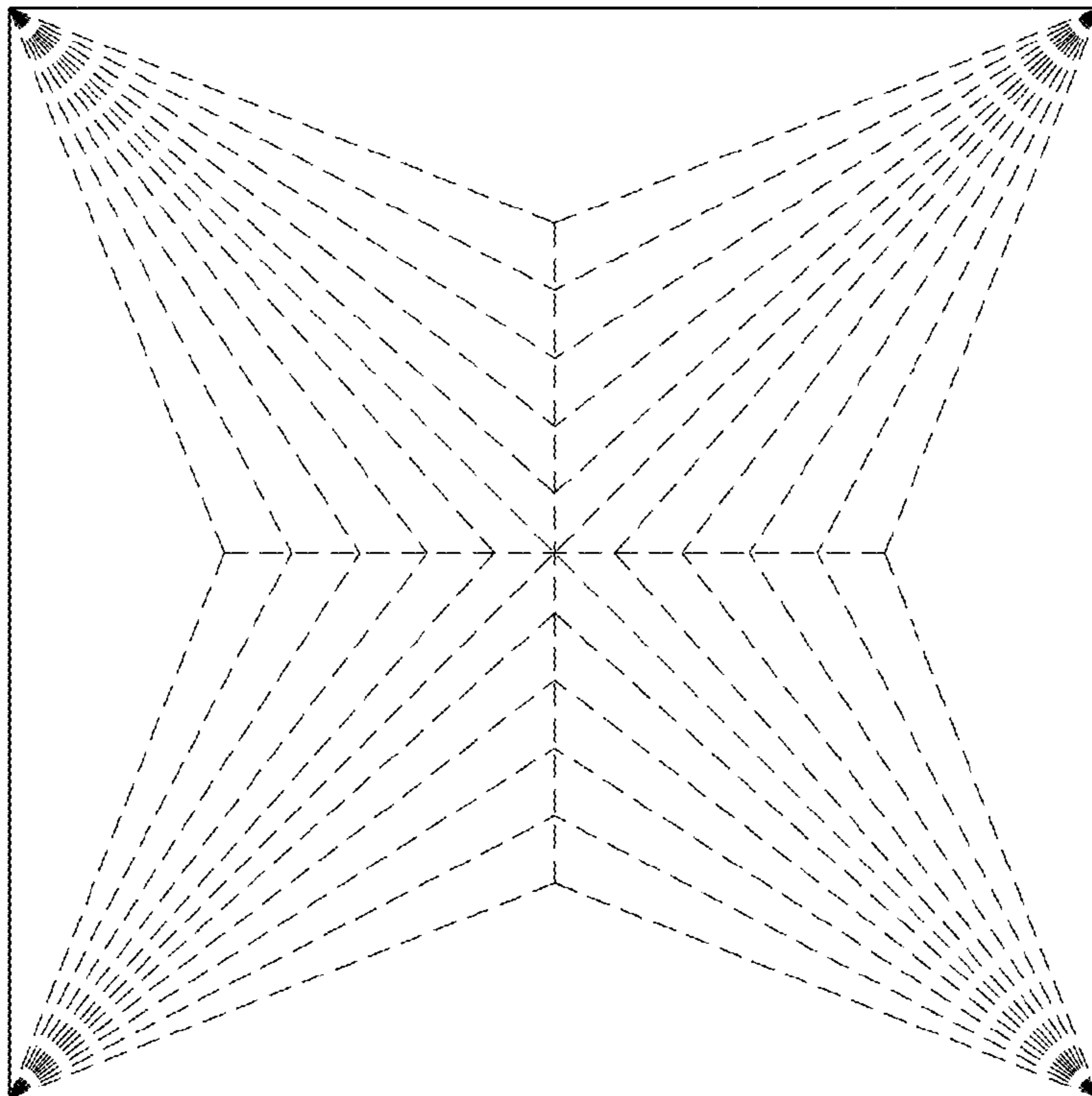

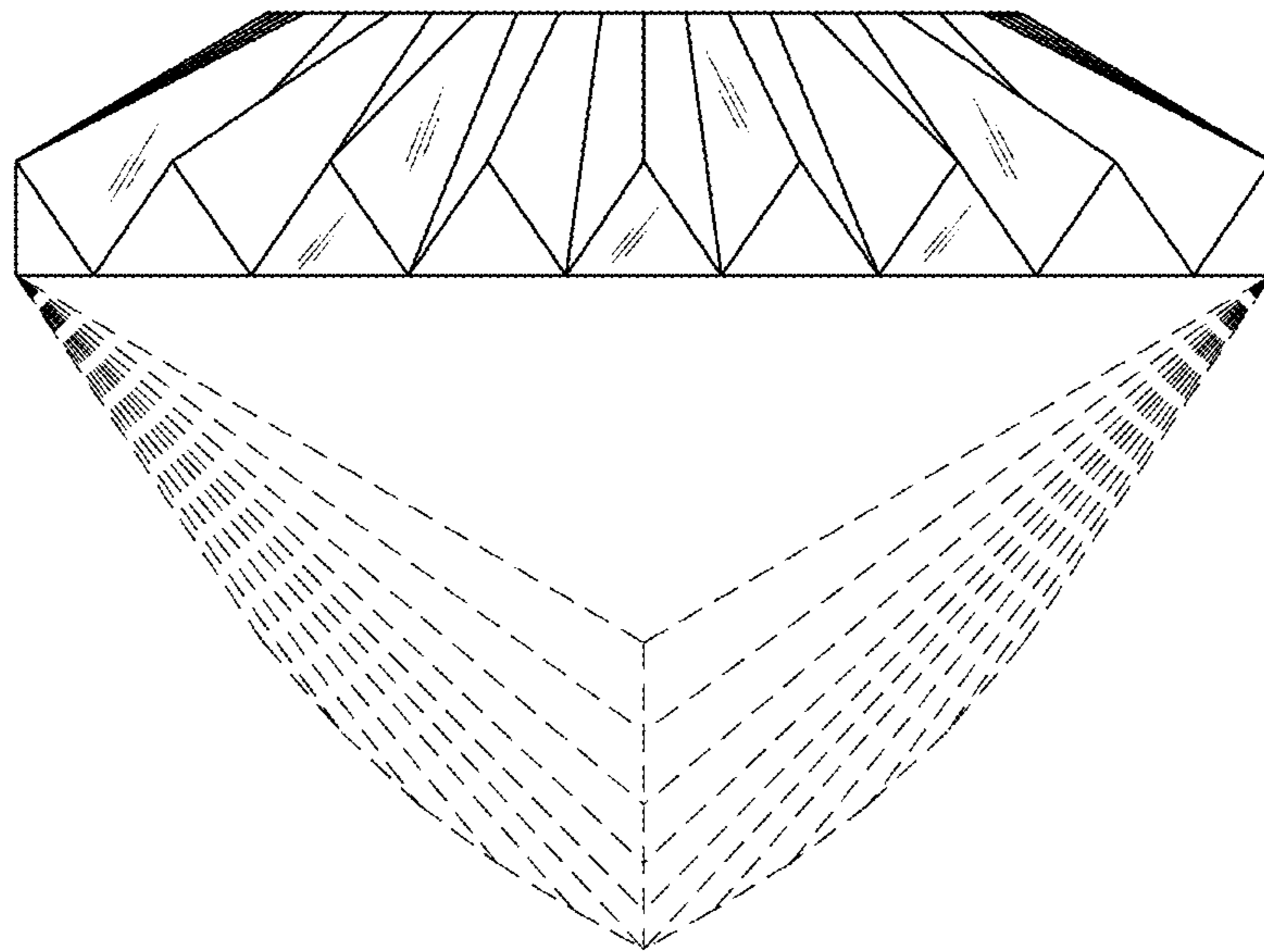
