DESCRIPTION

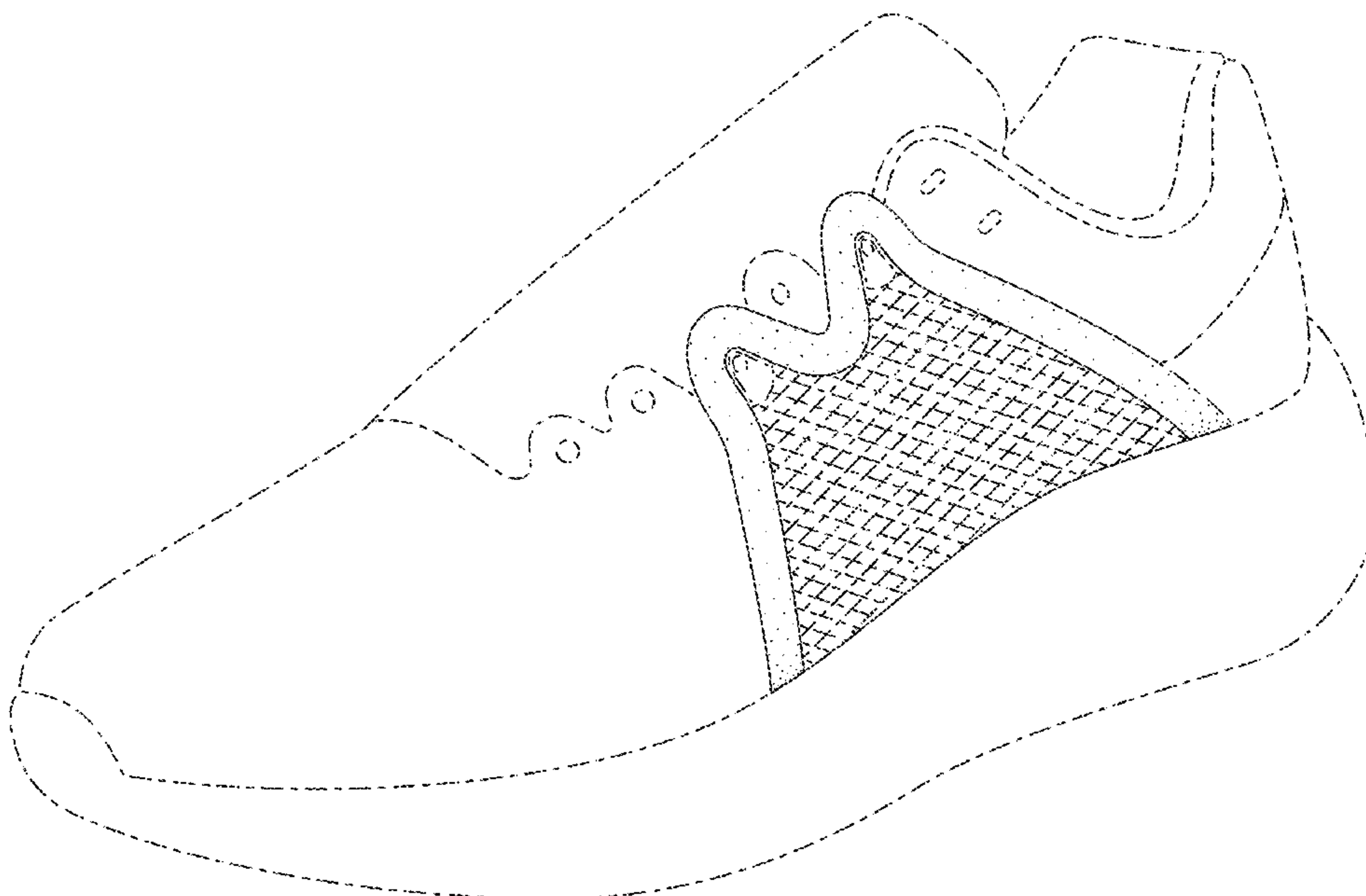
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

The even-length crossed broken lines represent a mesh panel that forms no part of the claimed design. The two wedge shaped elements at the top of the disclaimed mesh panel represent lacing elements that form no part of the claimed design. The broken line immediately adjacent to the lower rear edge of the shaded area defines a boundary of the claimed design and forms no part thereof. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

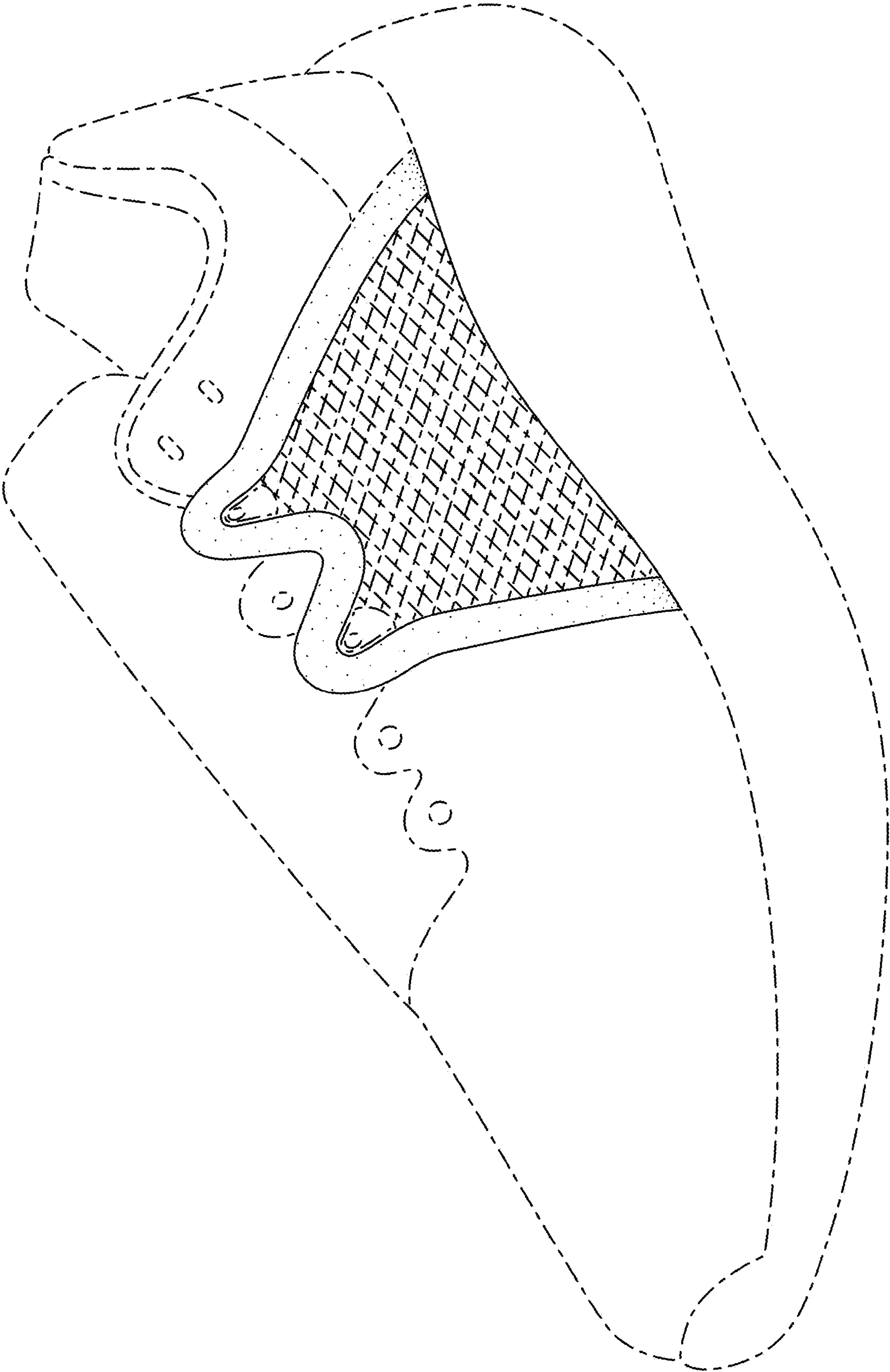

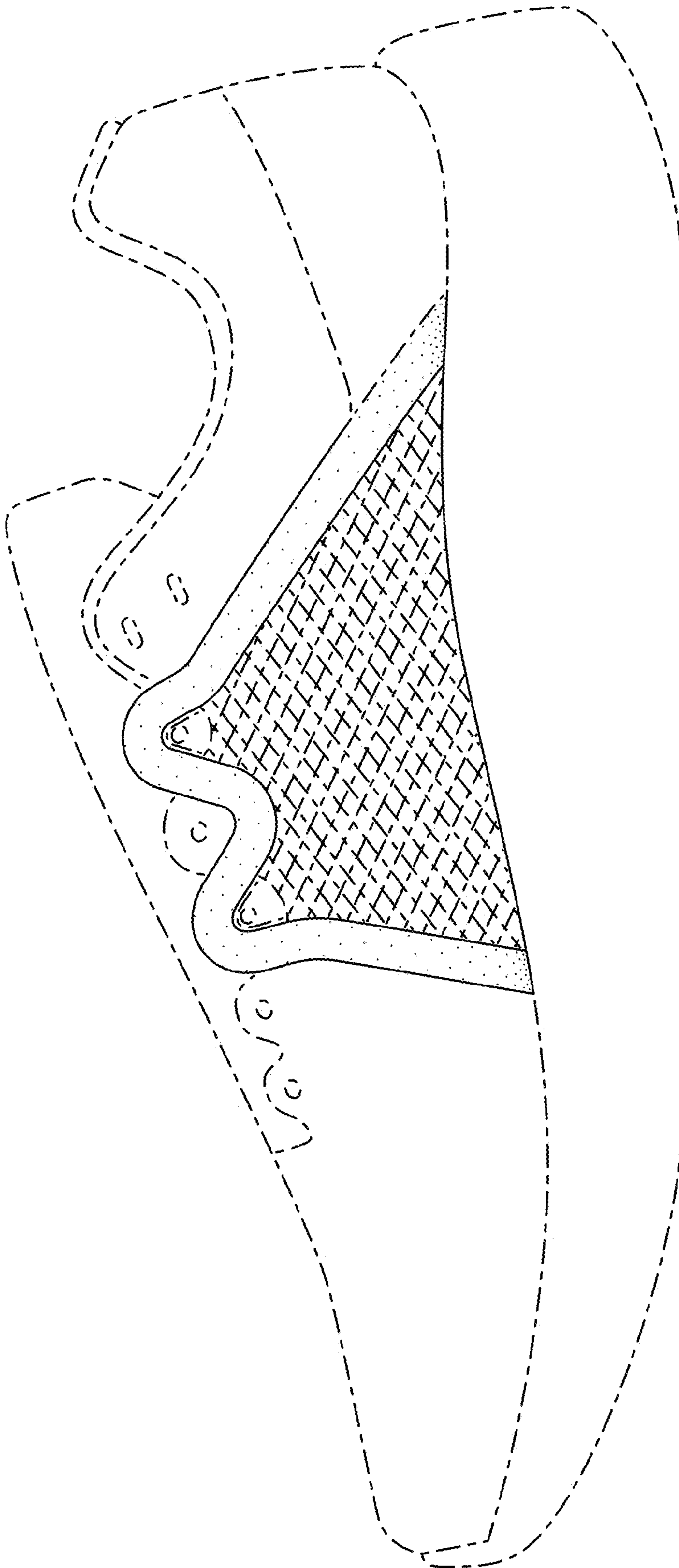

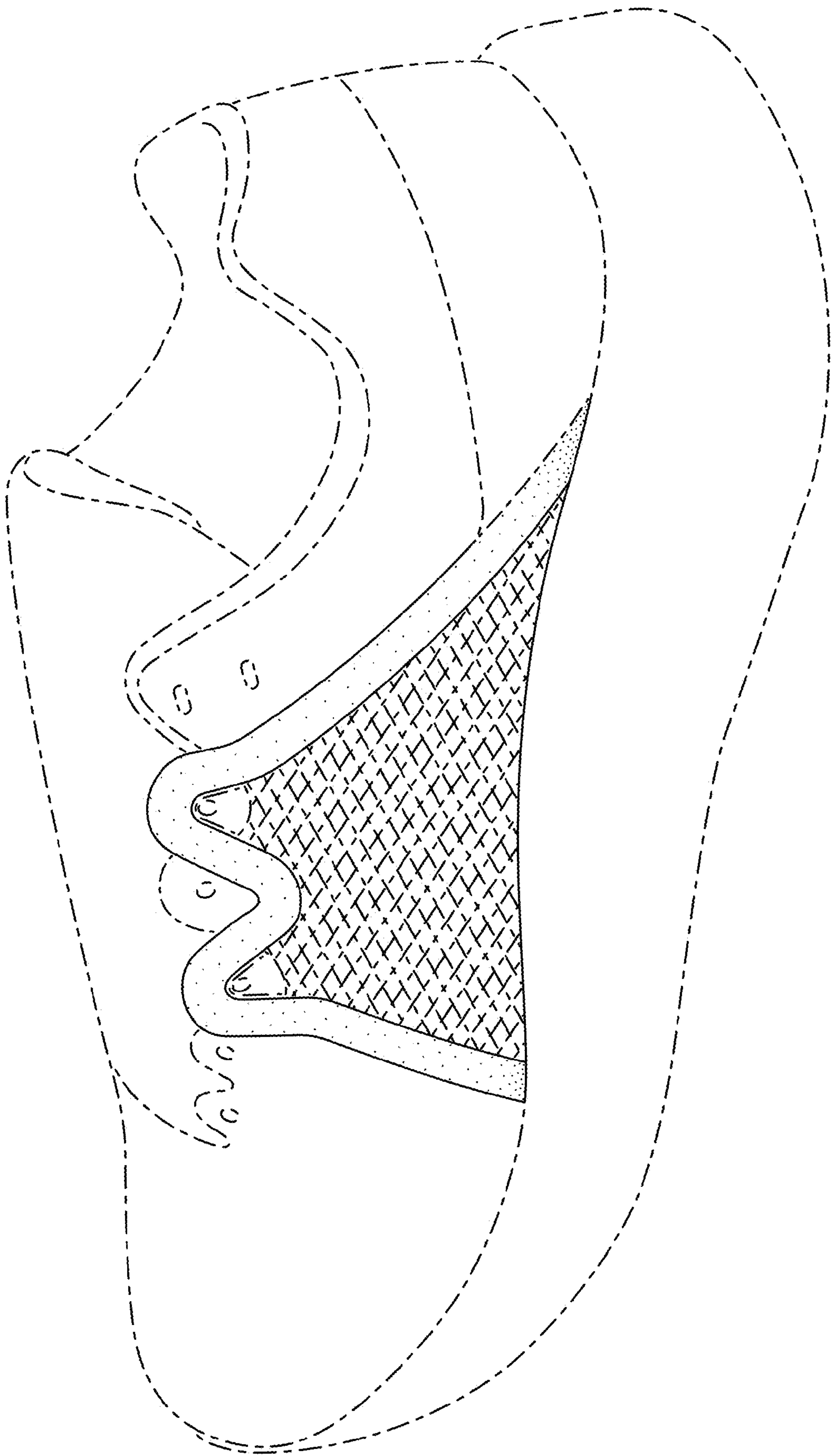
