FIG. 8 is a second perspective view thereof;

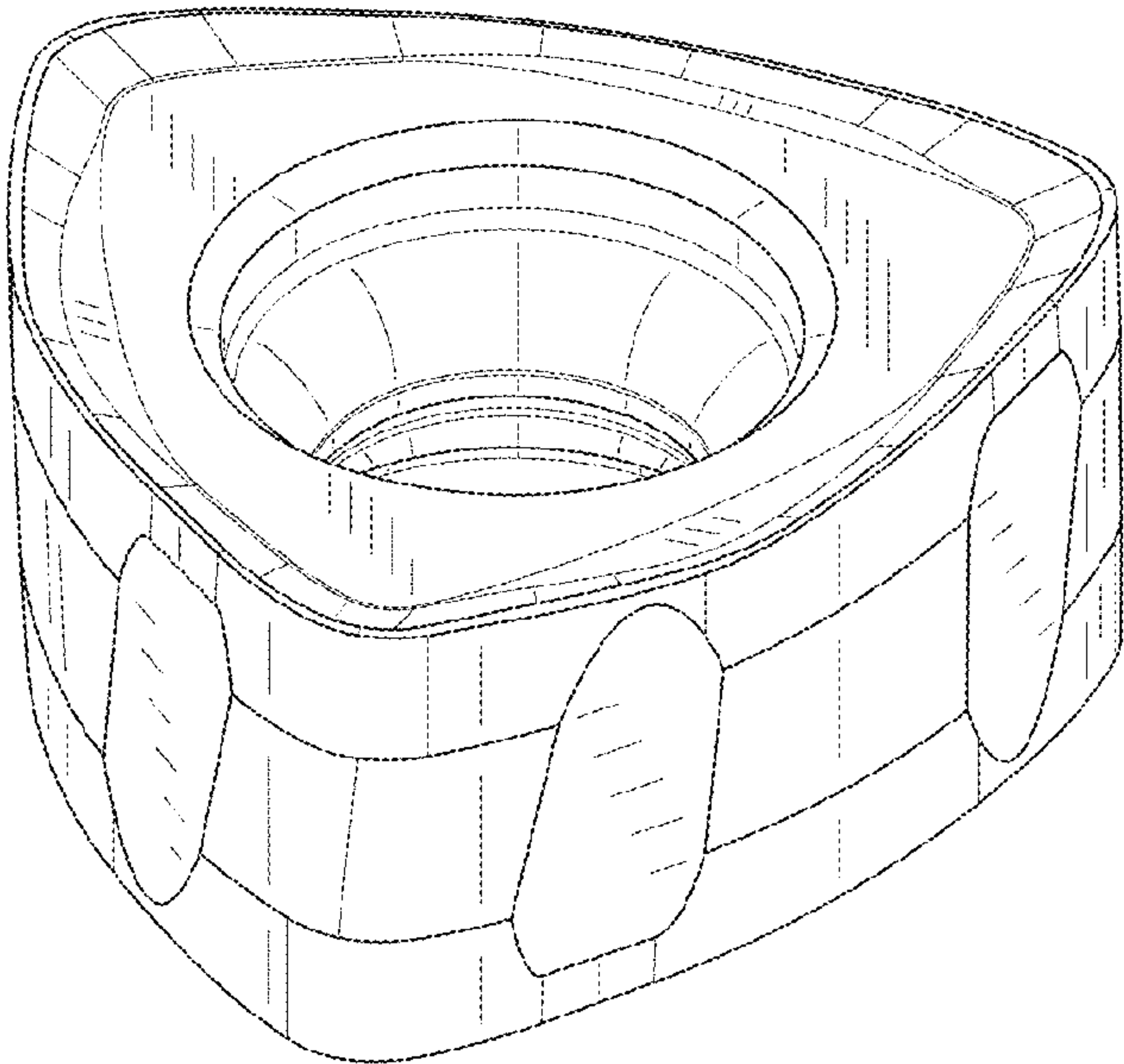
FIG. 9 is a cross sectional view taken along line 9-9 of FIG.

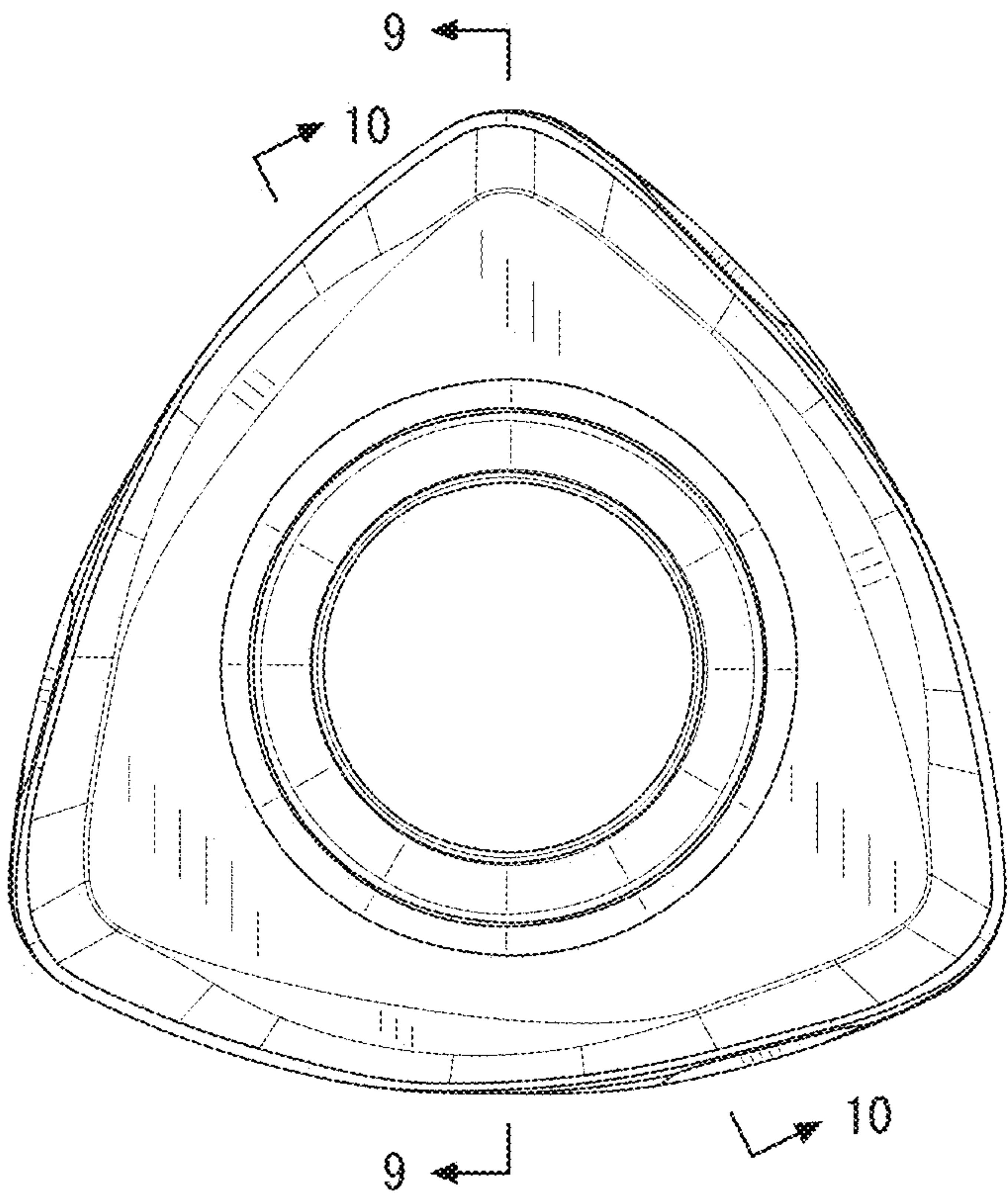

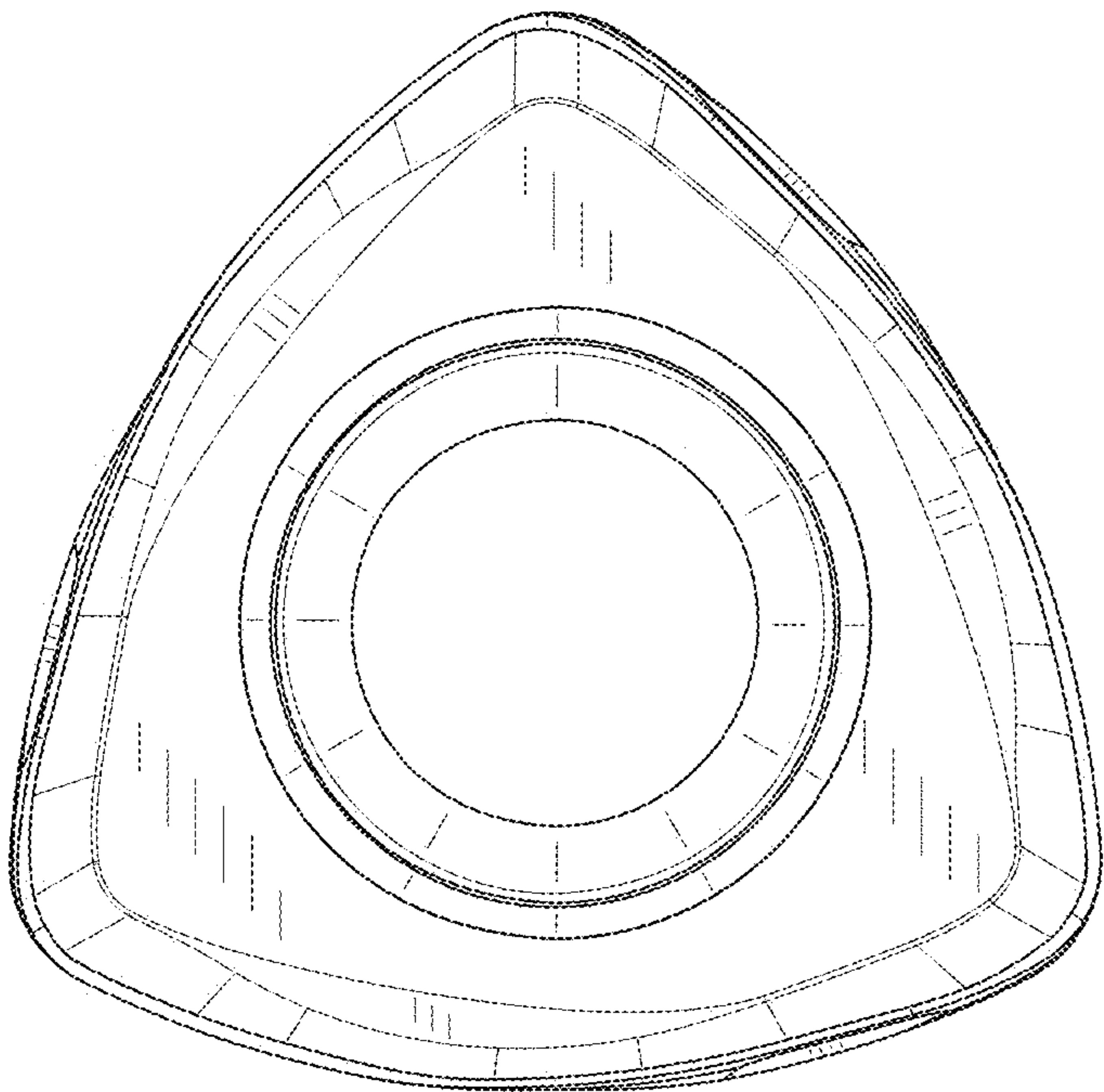

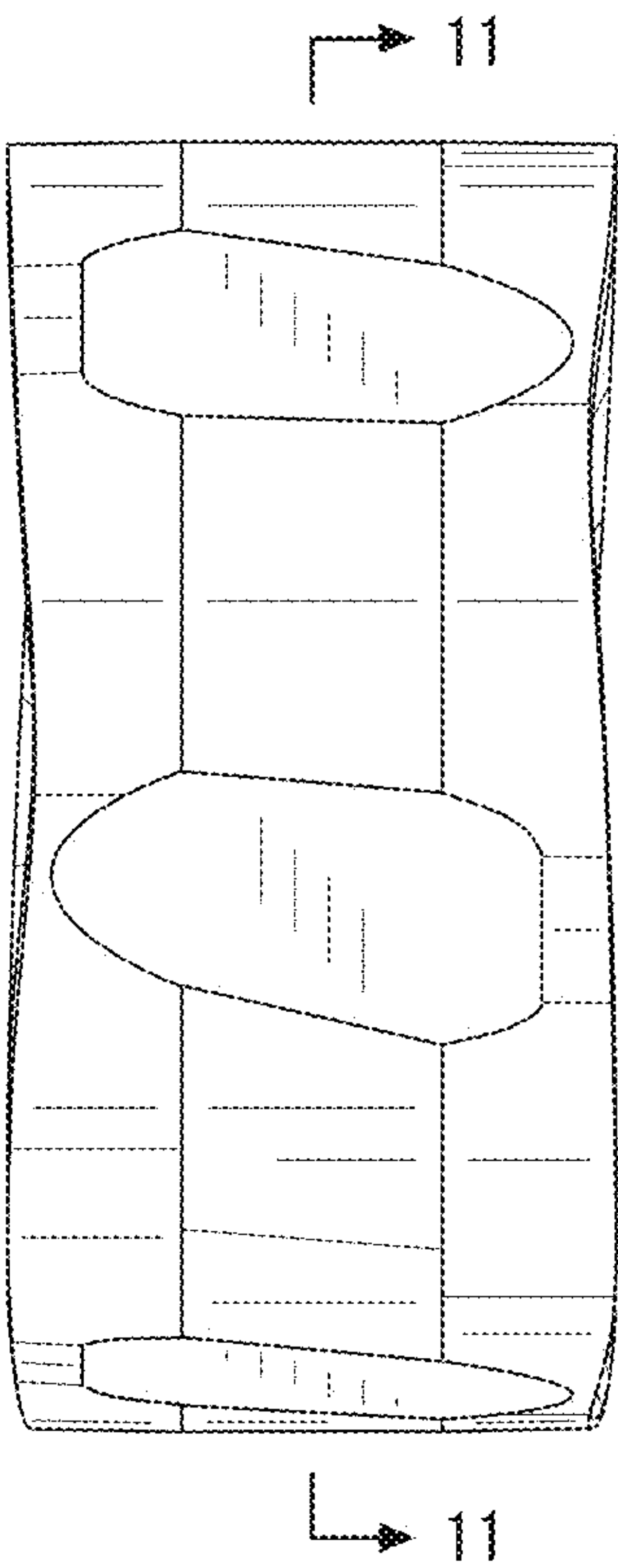

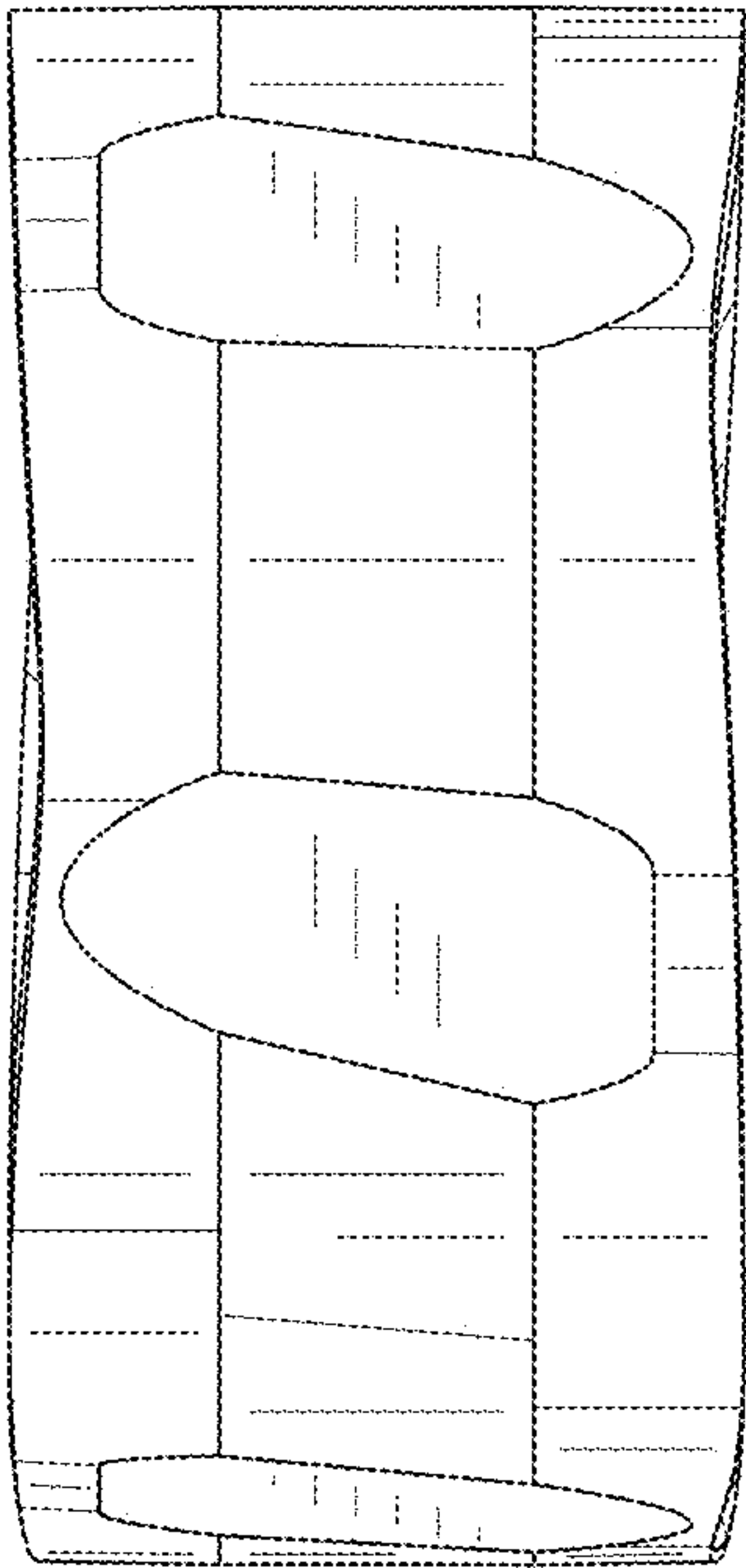

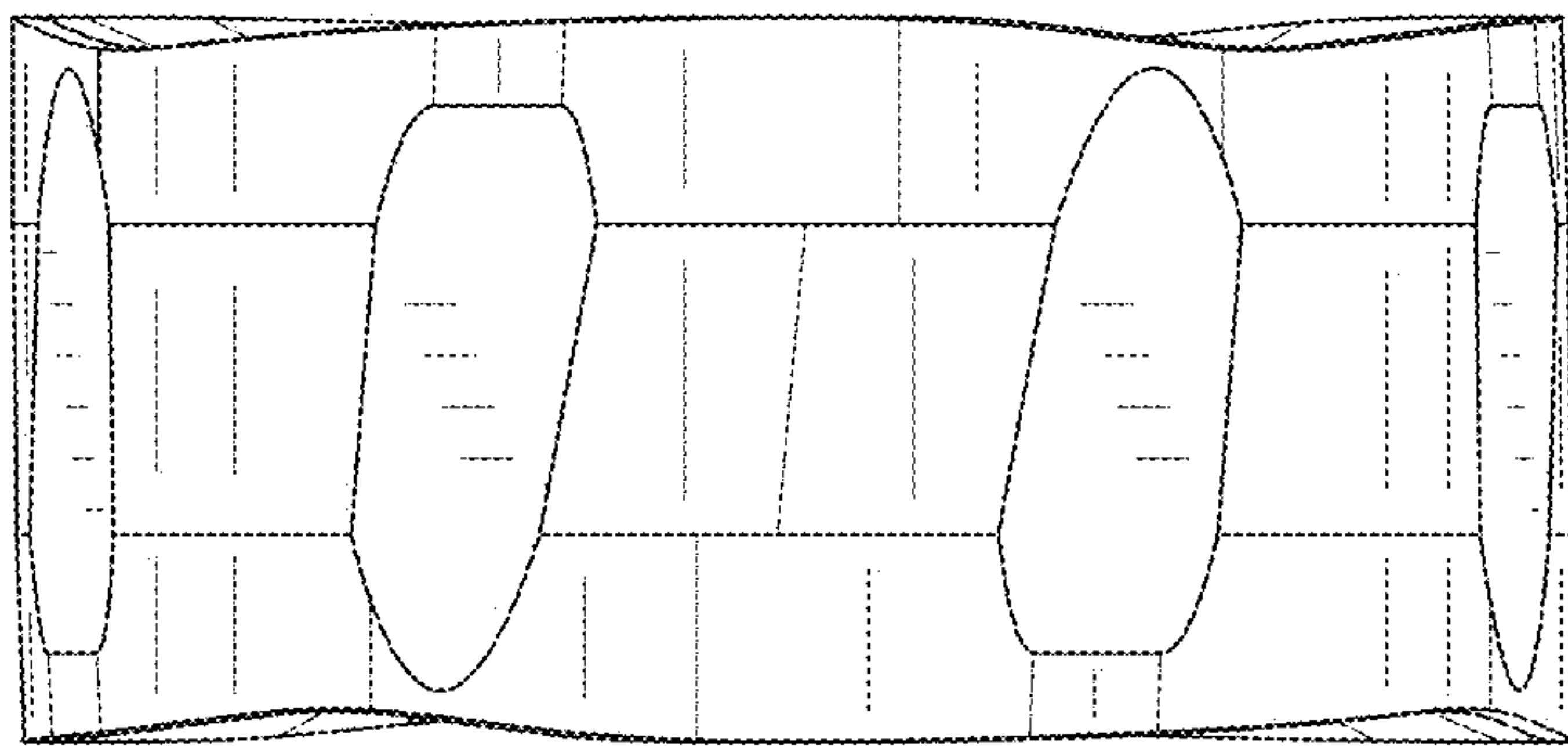

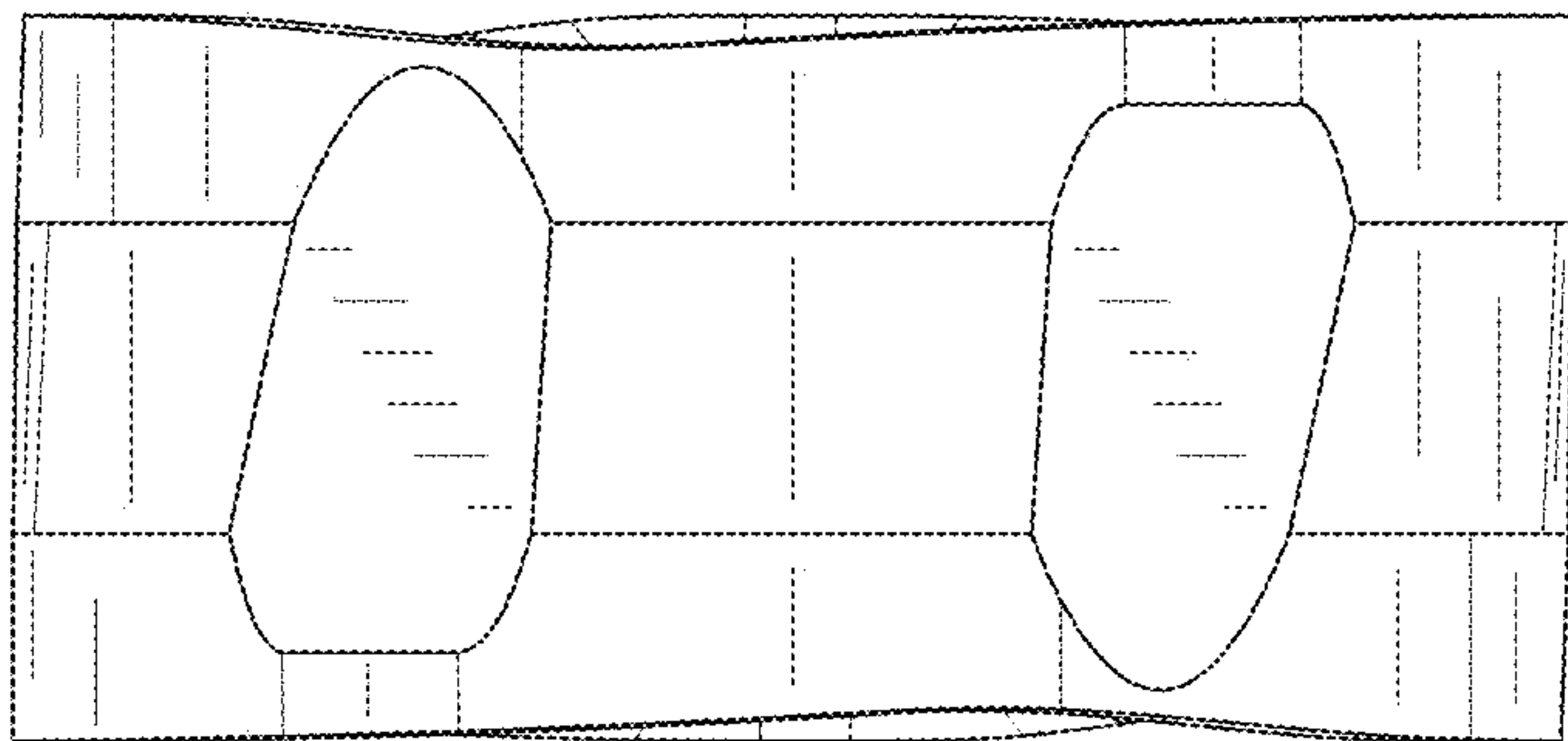

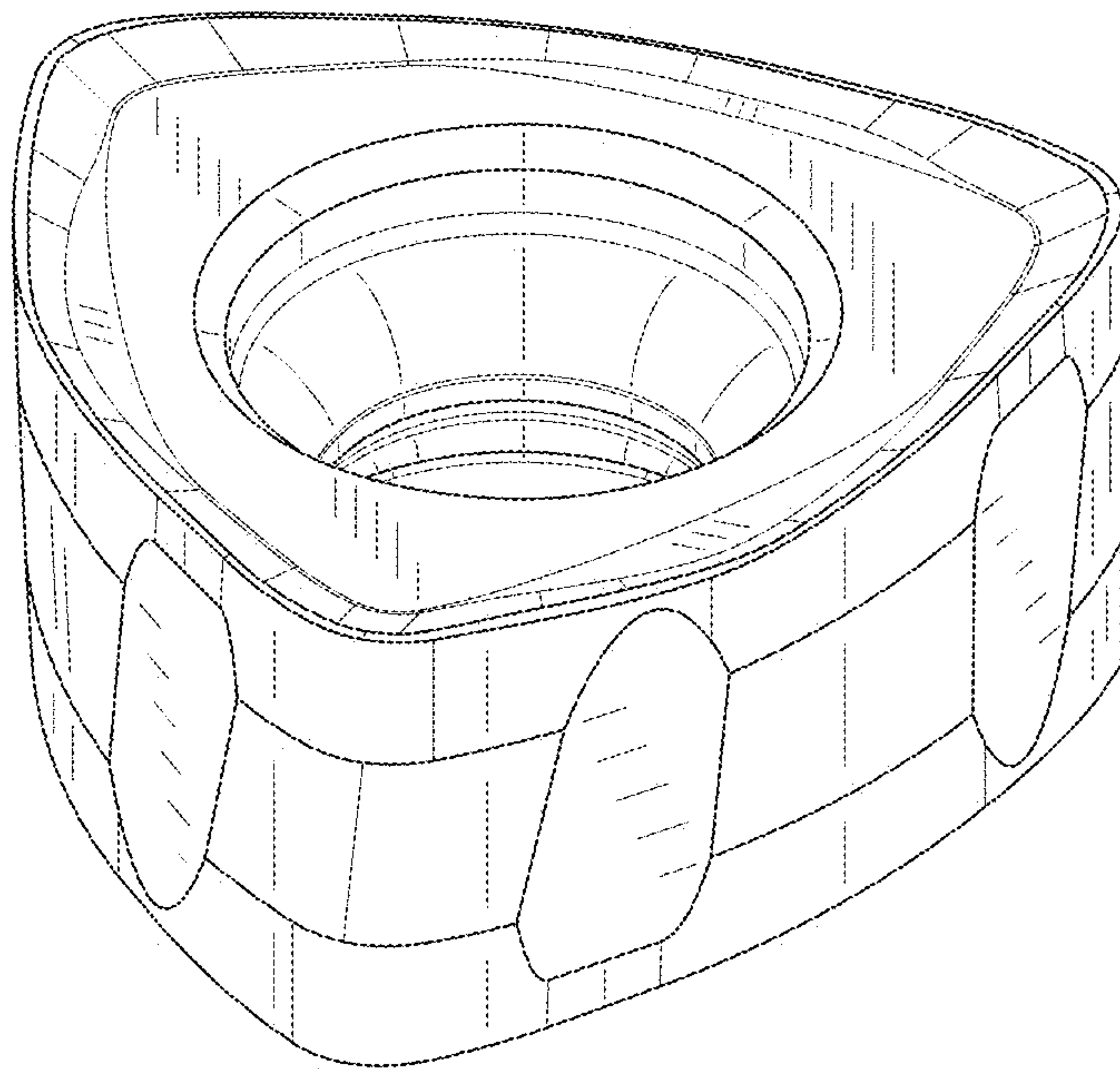

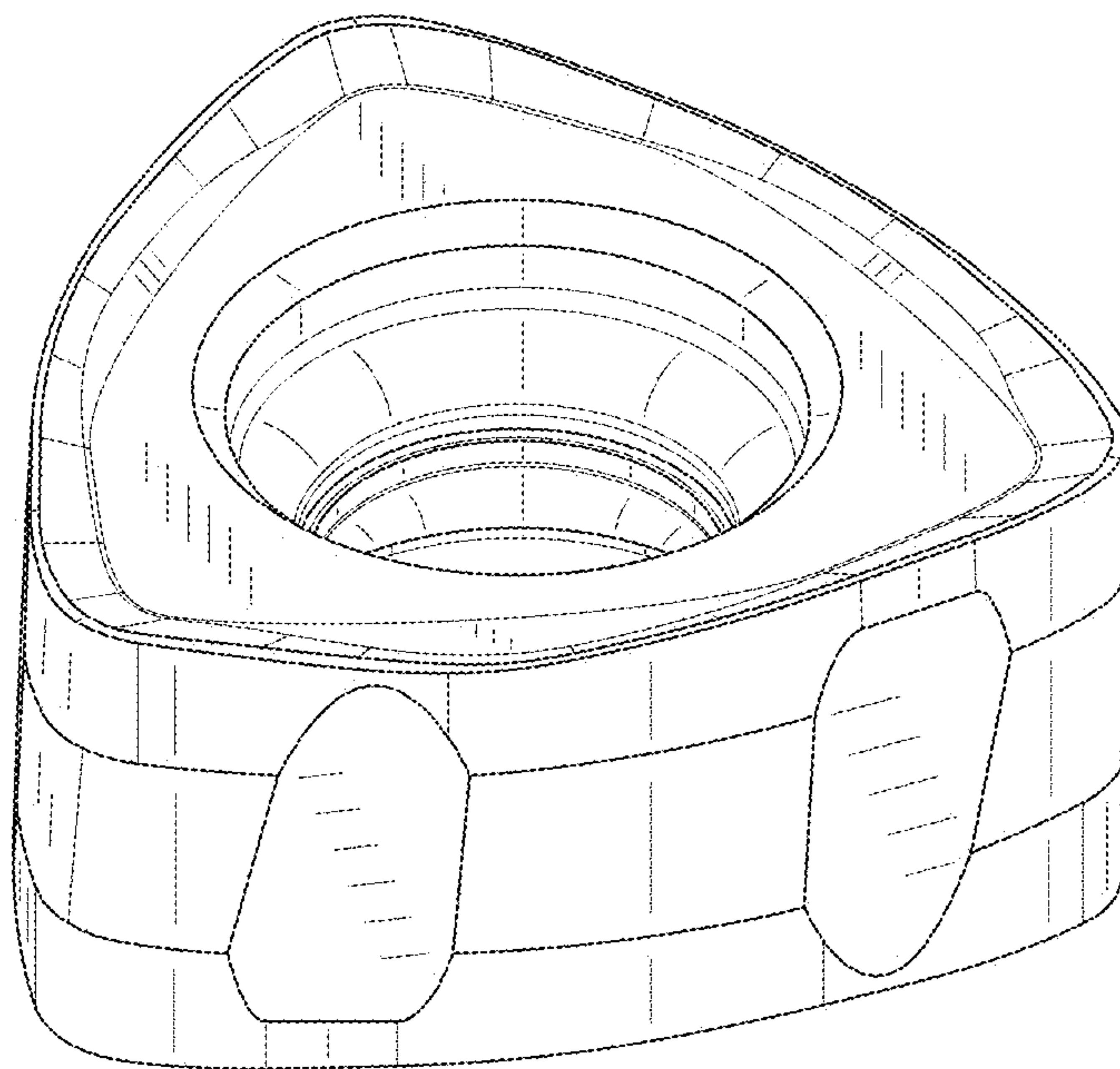

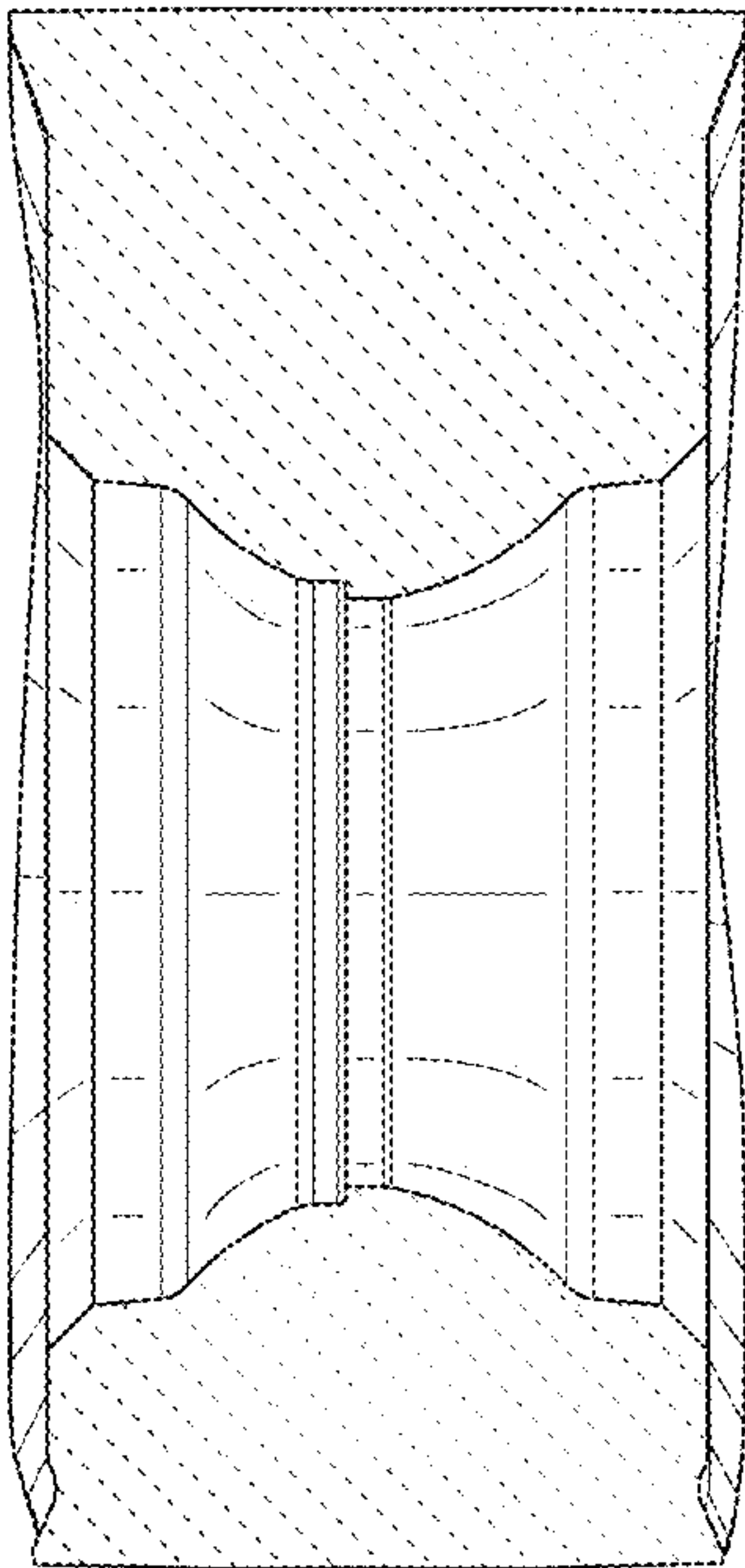

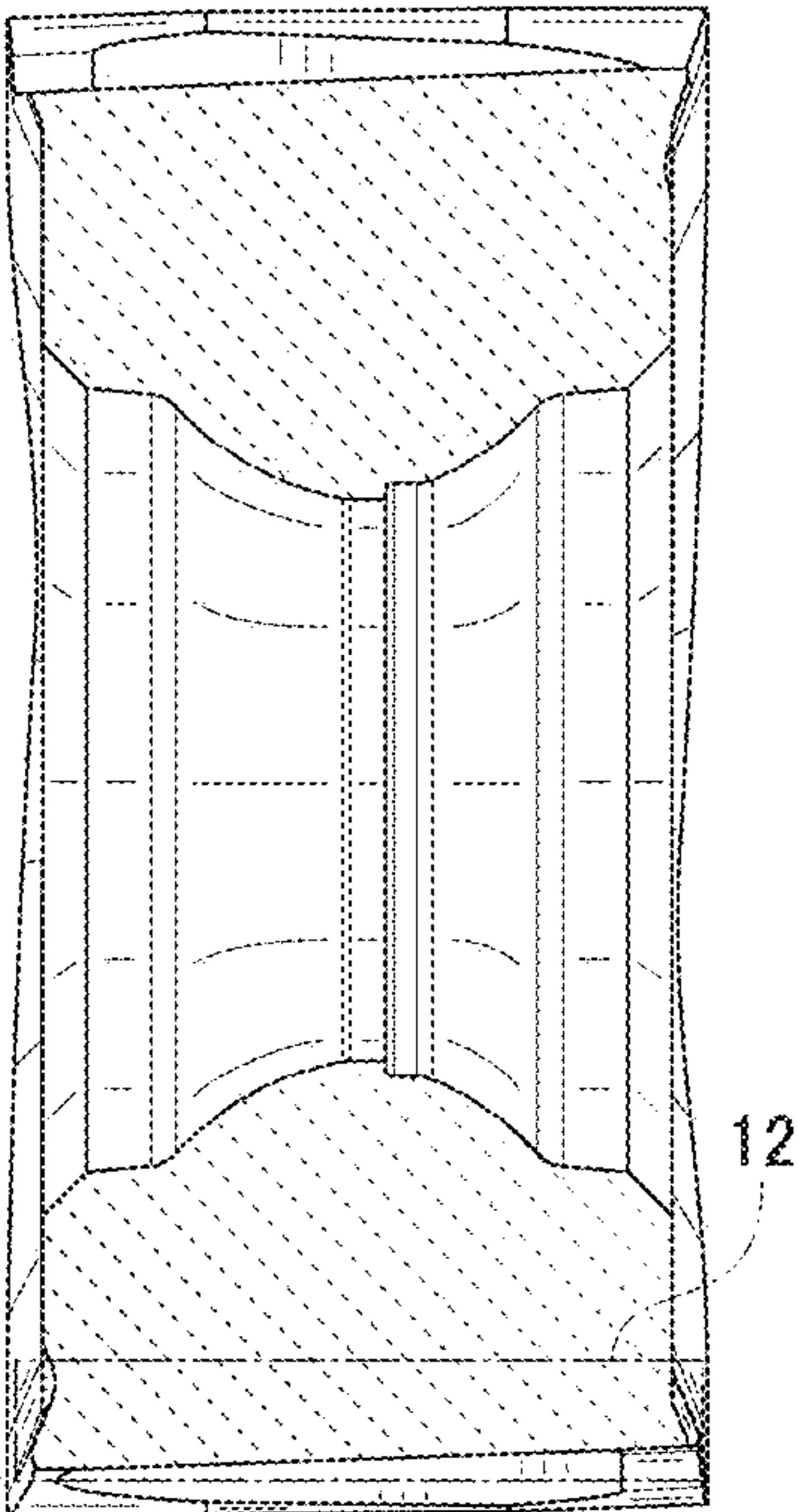

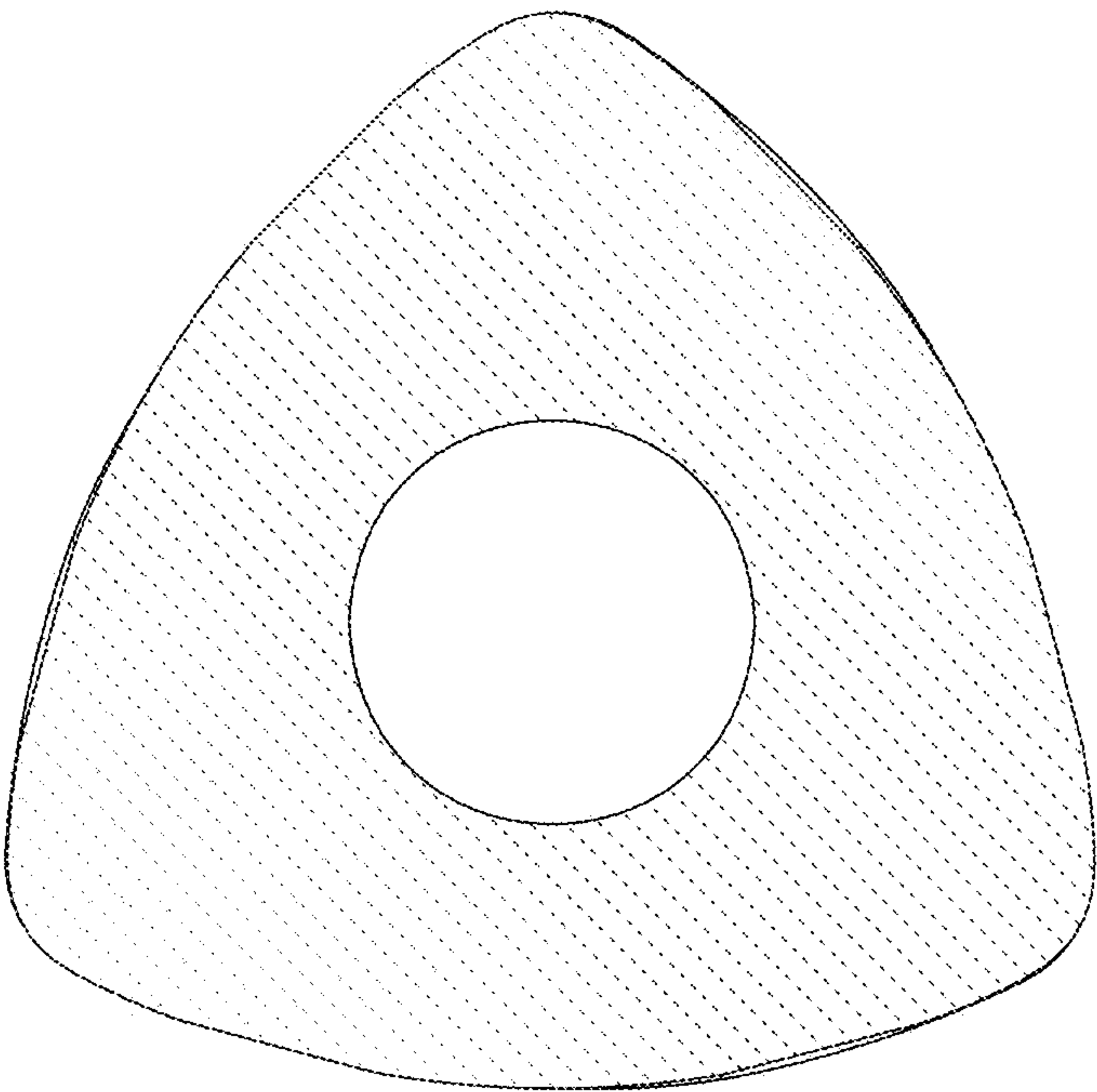

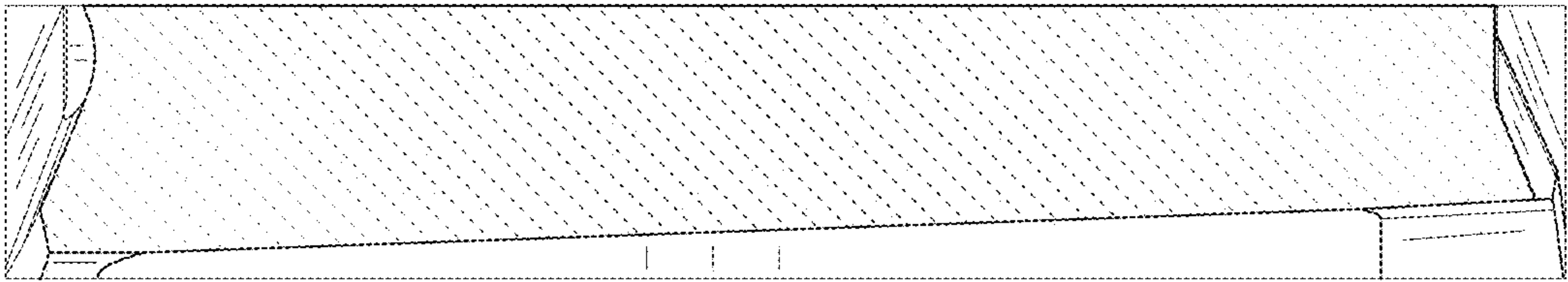
