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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hair retention device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present invention for a hair retention device;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 1, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 1, partially opened to facilitate retention, and securing in a wearer's hair;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the present invention for a hair retention device, similar to the hair retention device of FIG. 1 without the elastic bands;

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7;

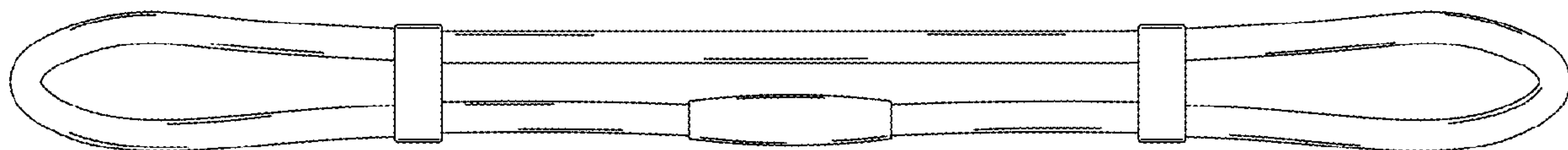
FIG. 11 is a left side view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7, partially opened to facilitate retention, and securing in a wearer's hair; and,

FIG. 13 is a front elevation view of the hair retention device shown in FIG. 7, closed to facilitate retention, and securing in a wearer's hair.

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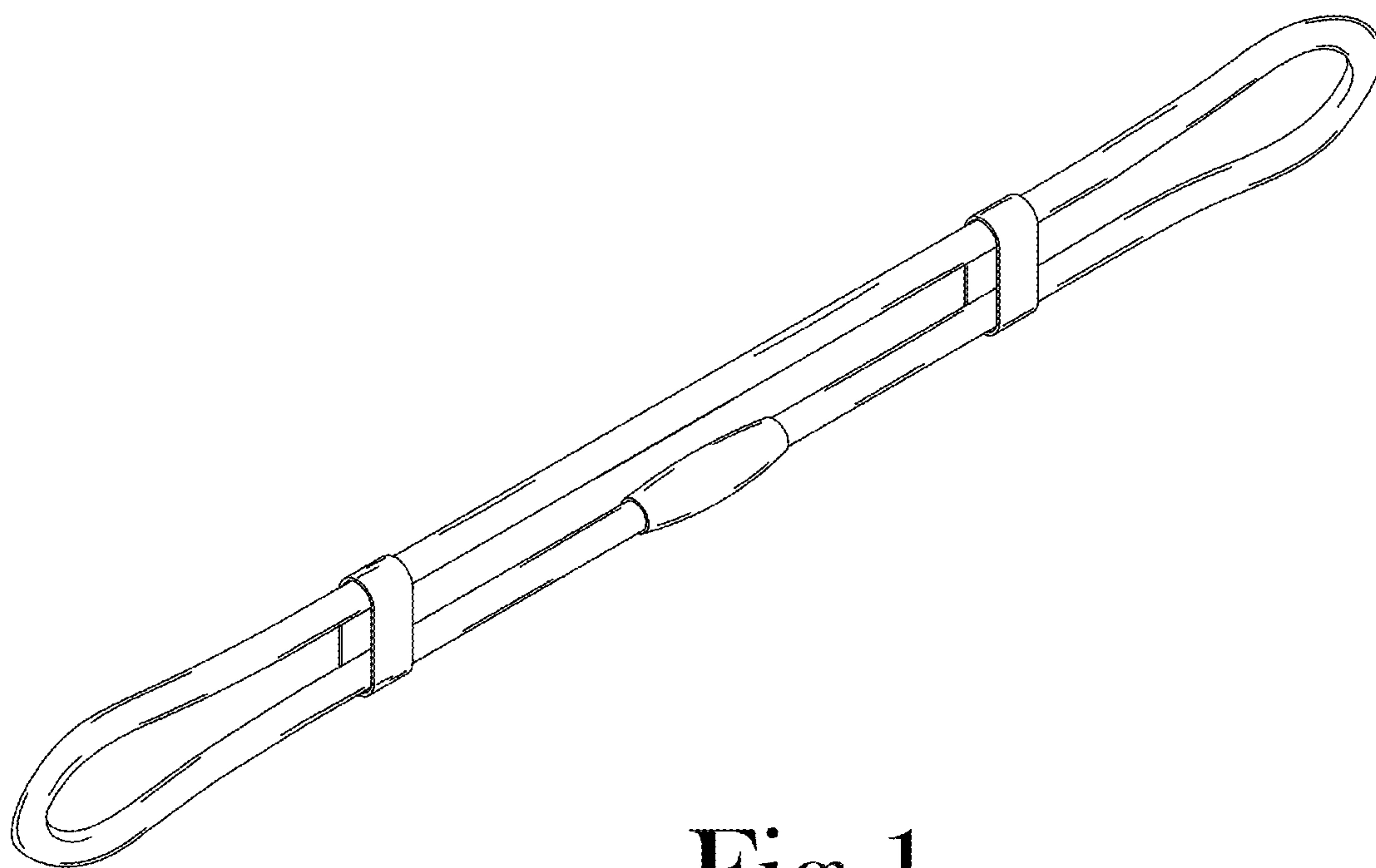

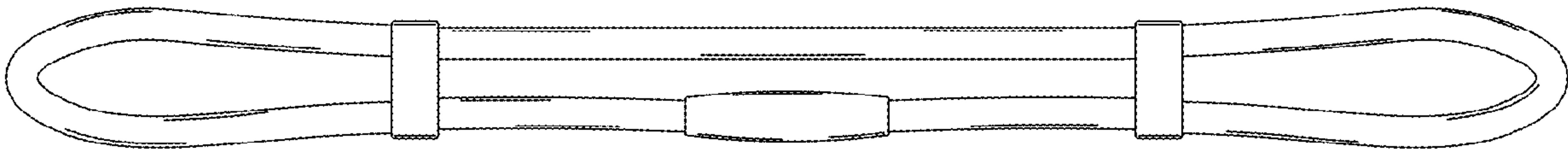

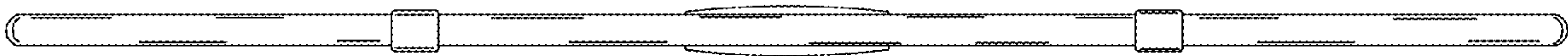

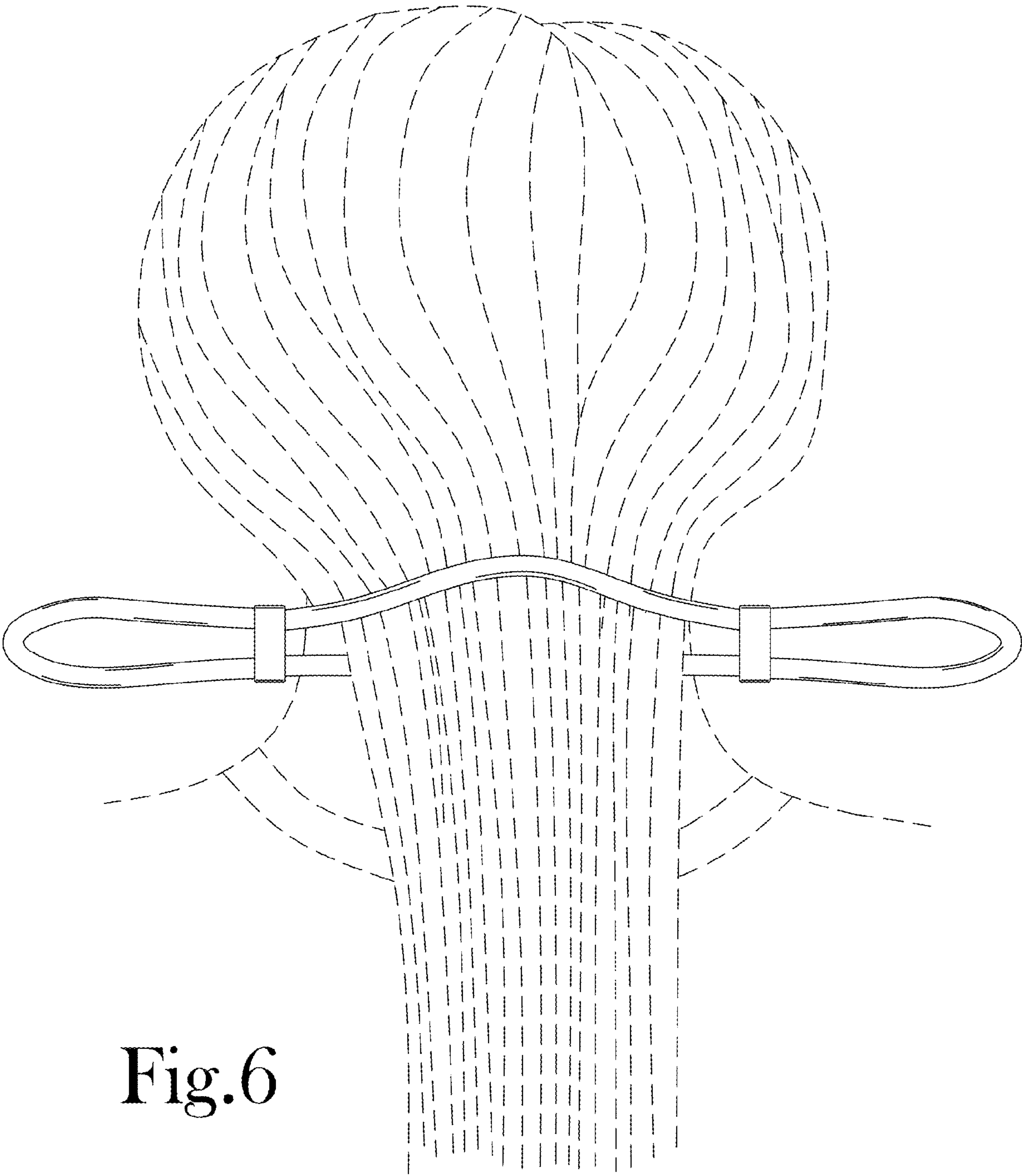

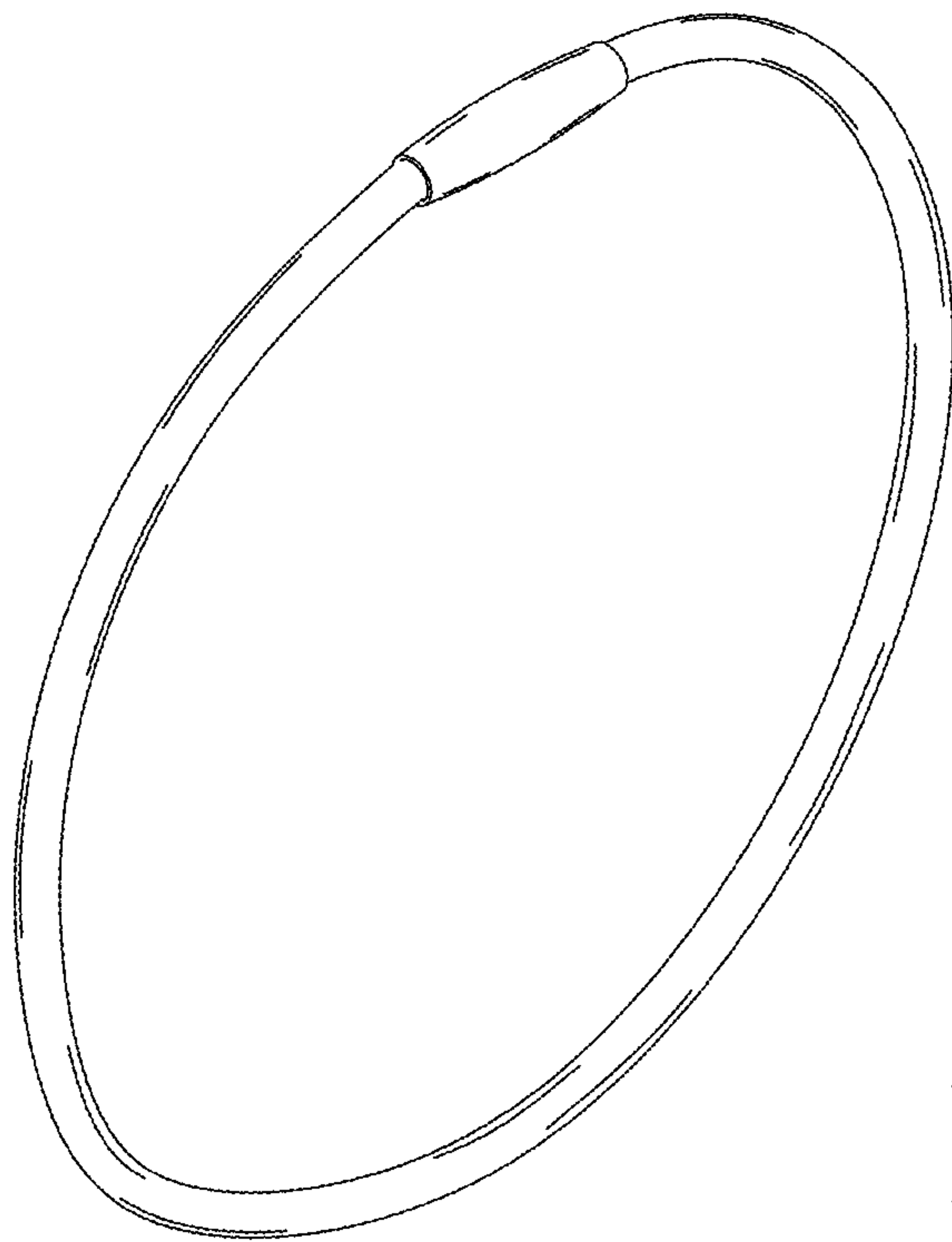

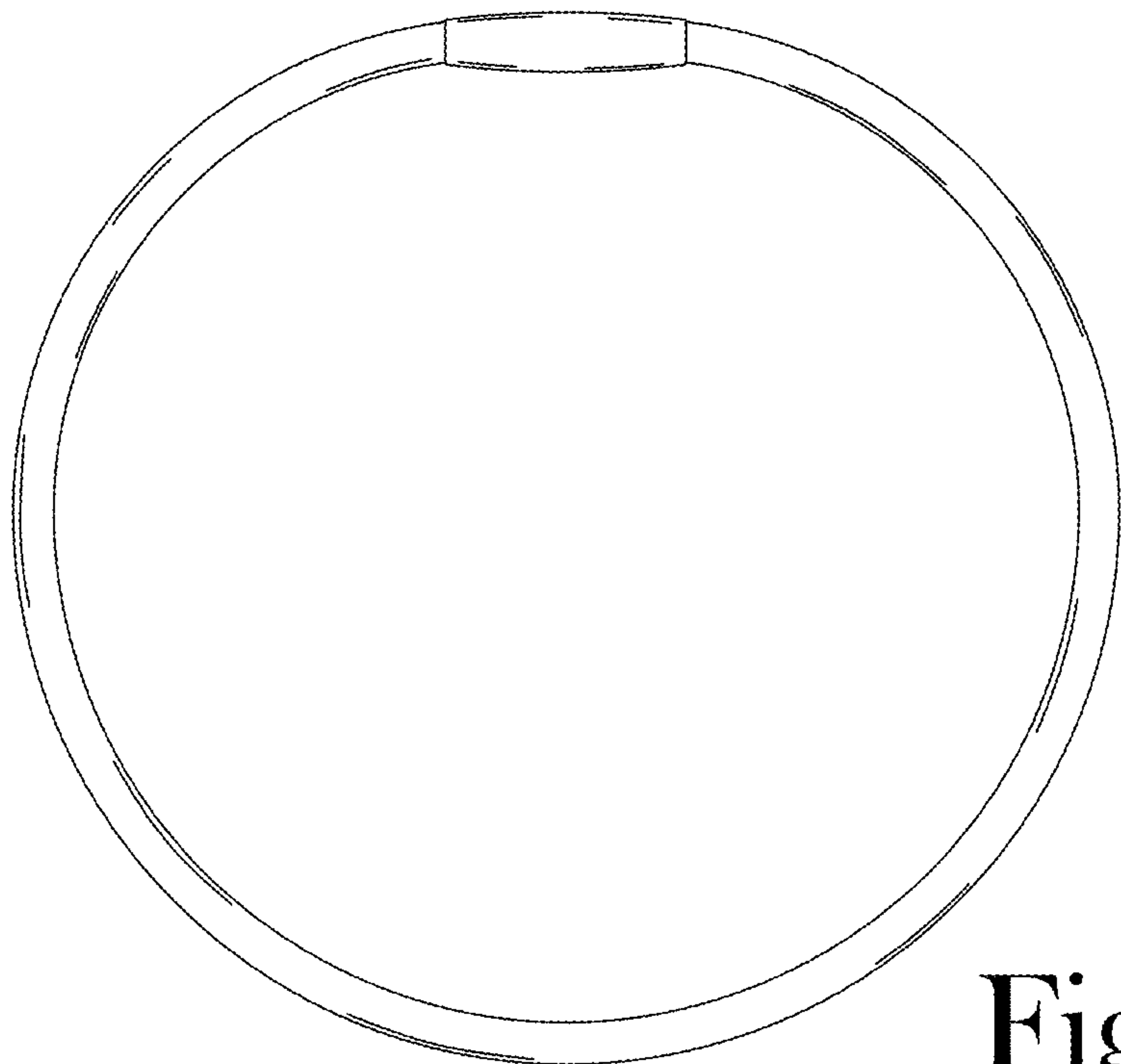

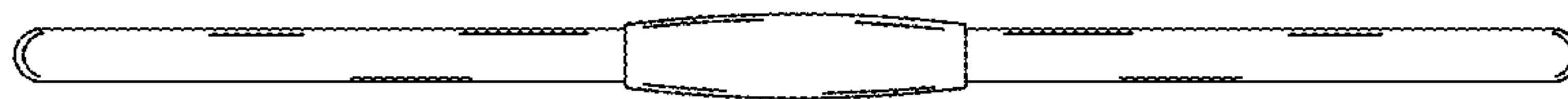

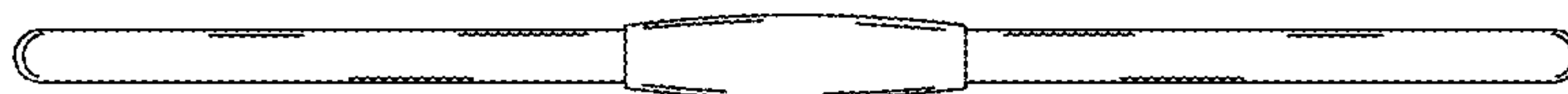

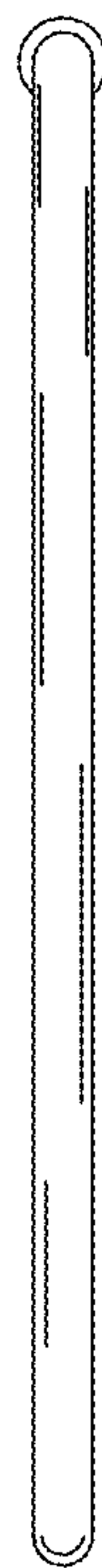

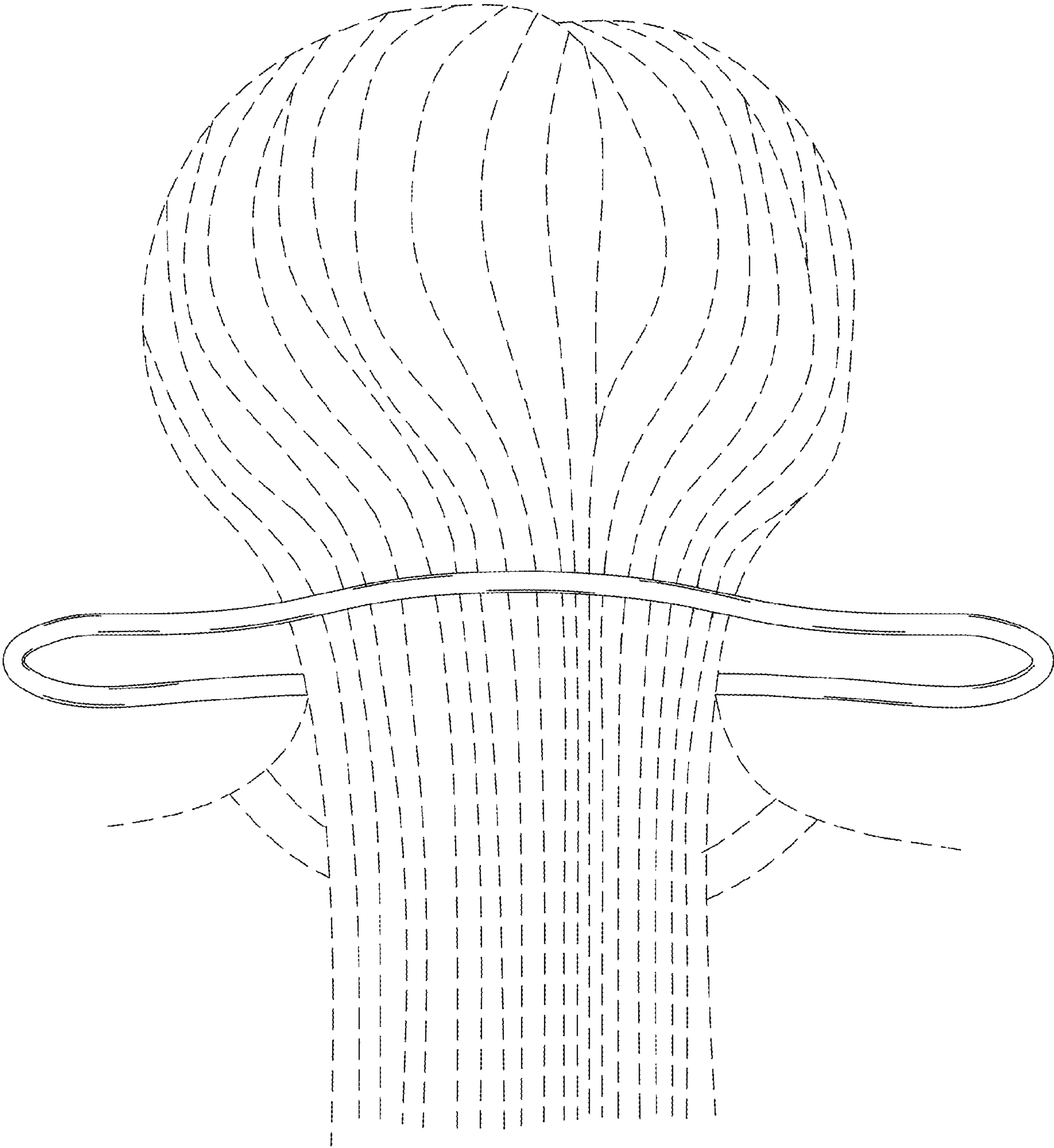

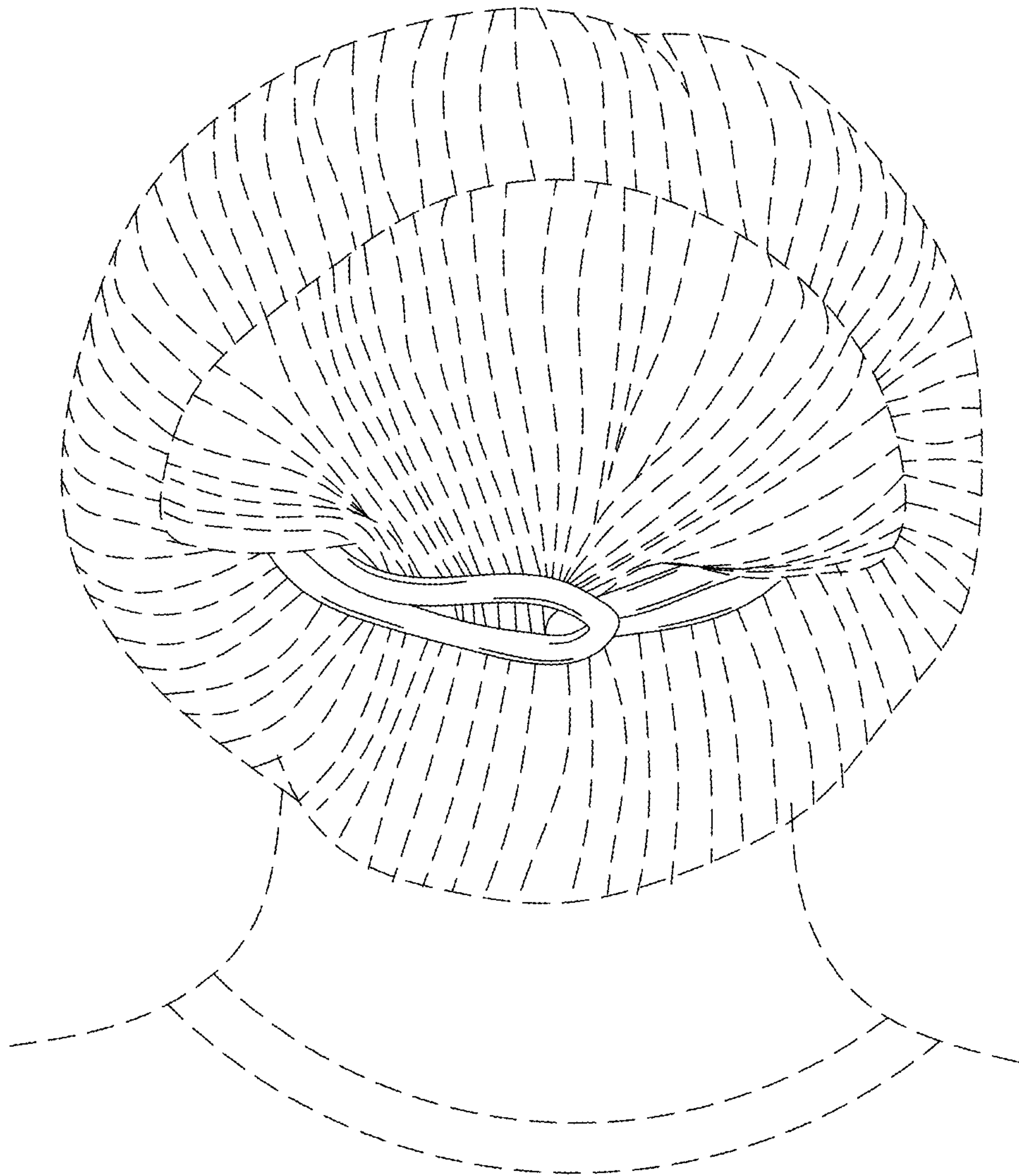
