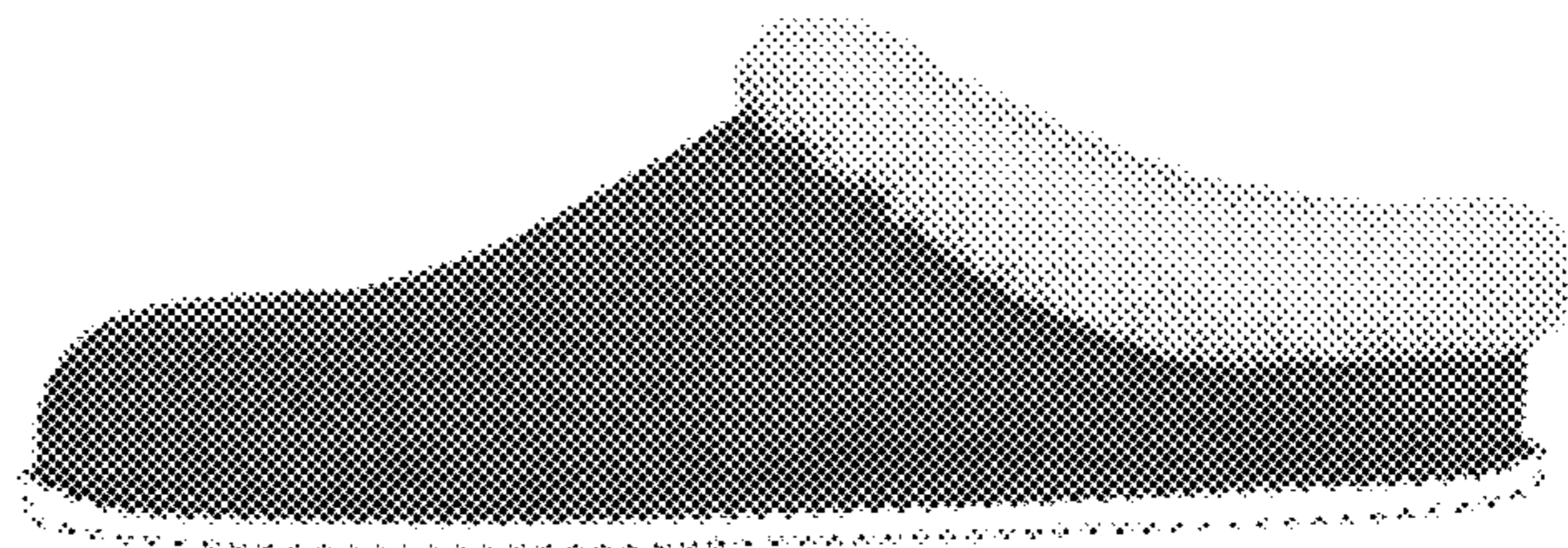
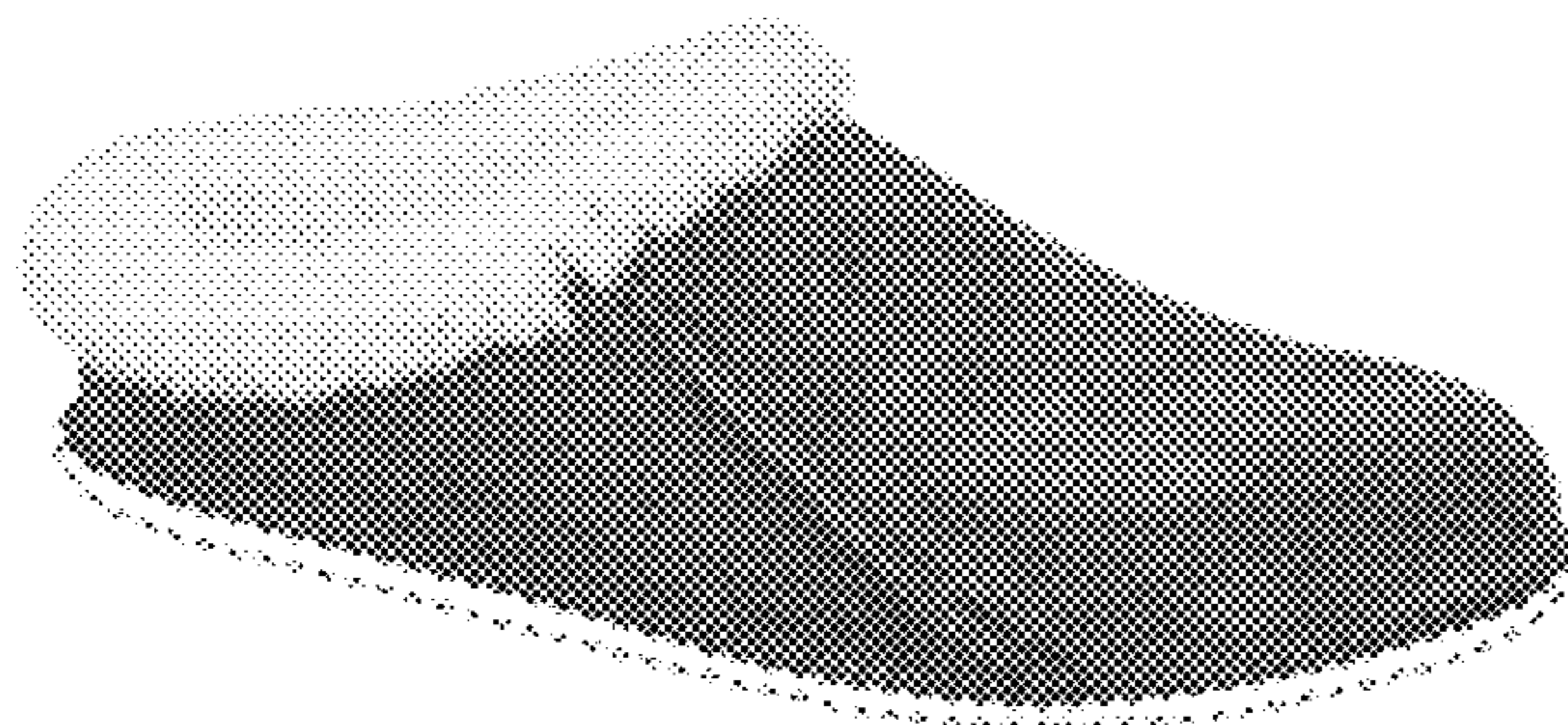
The ornamental design for a slipper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

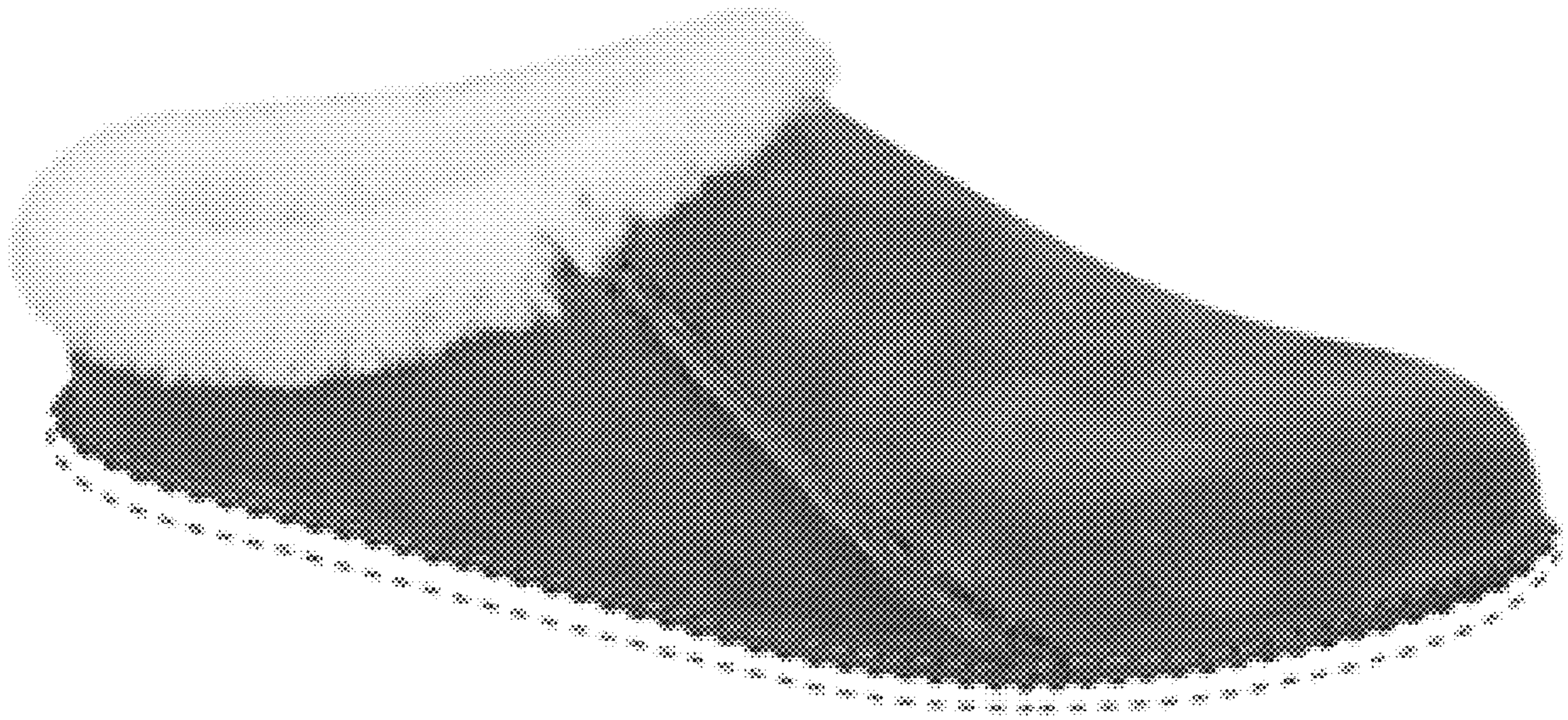

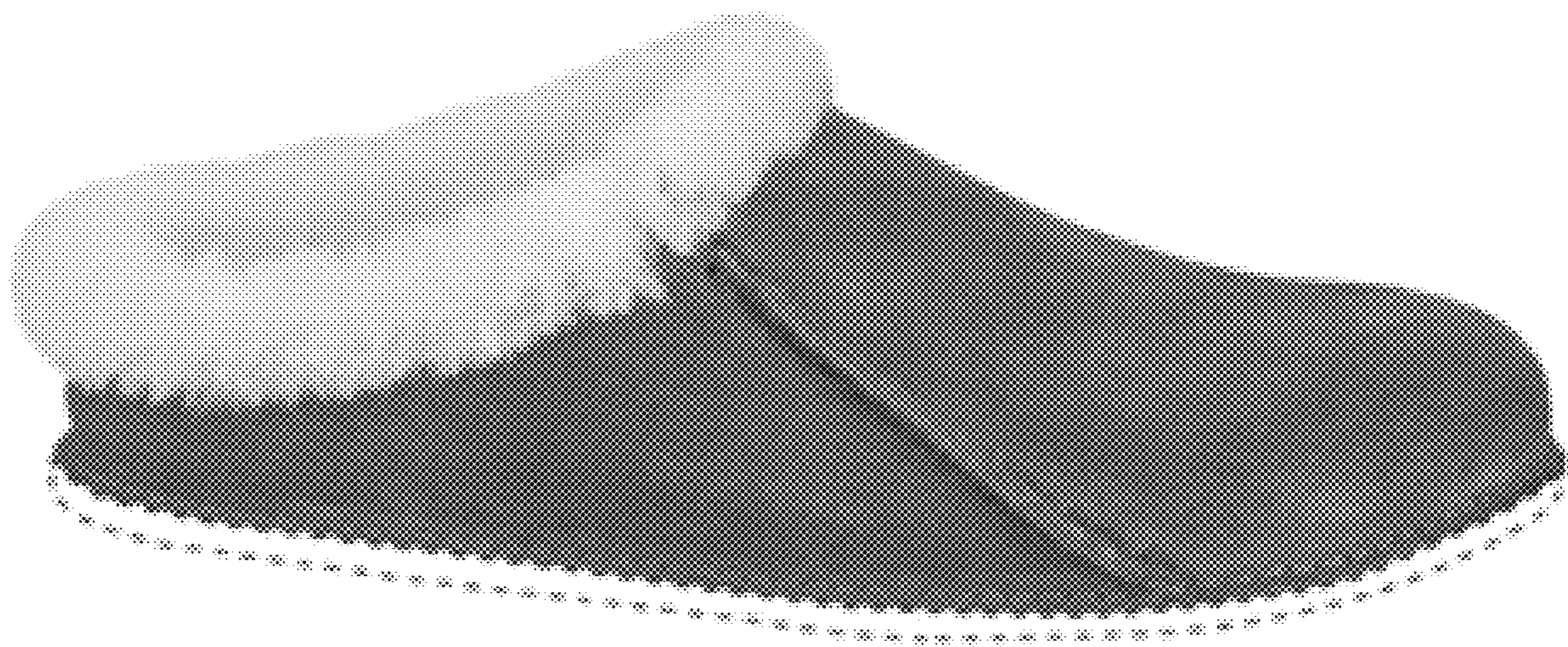

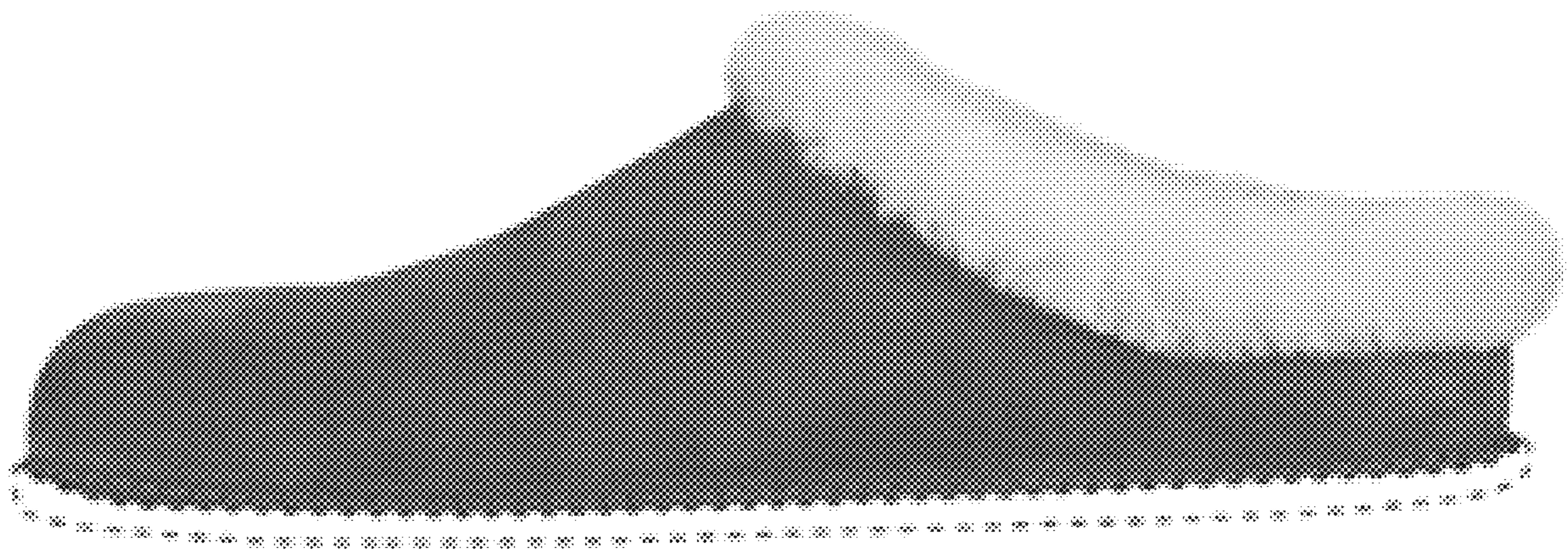

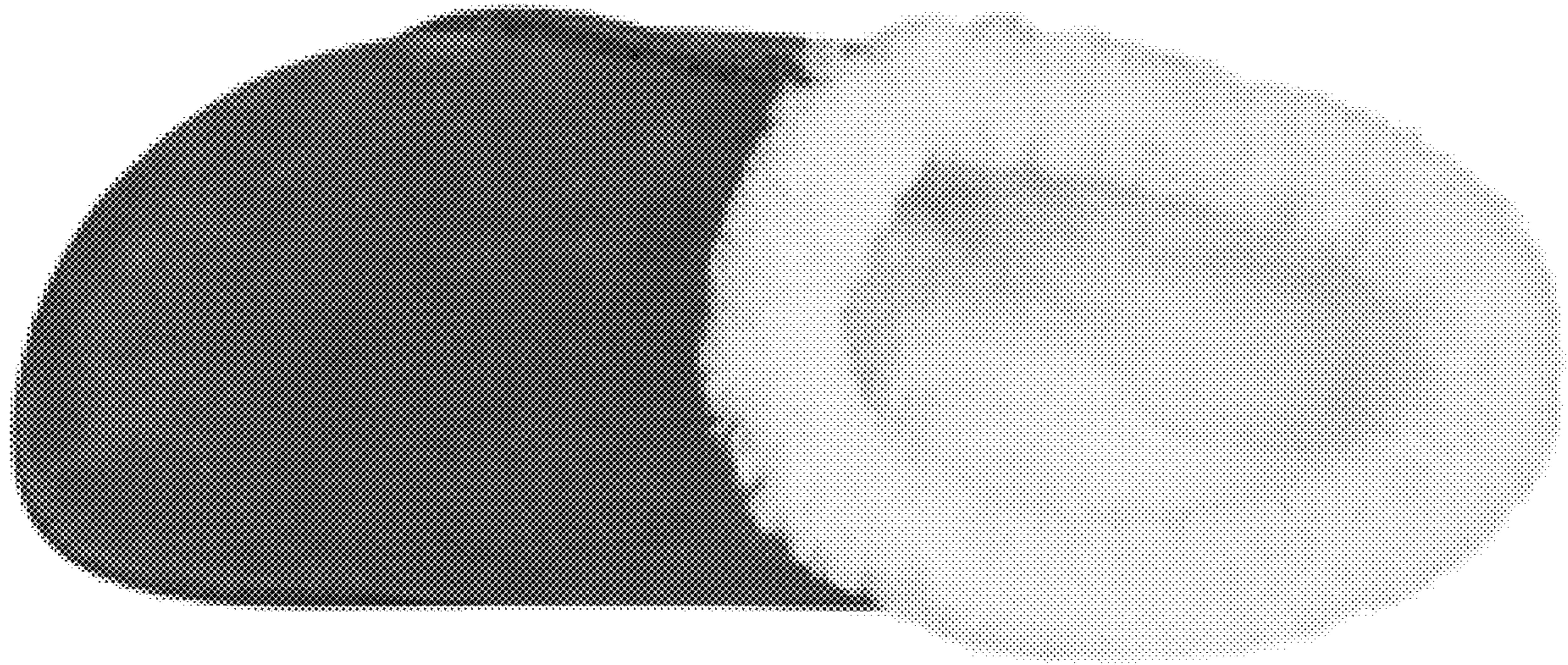

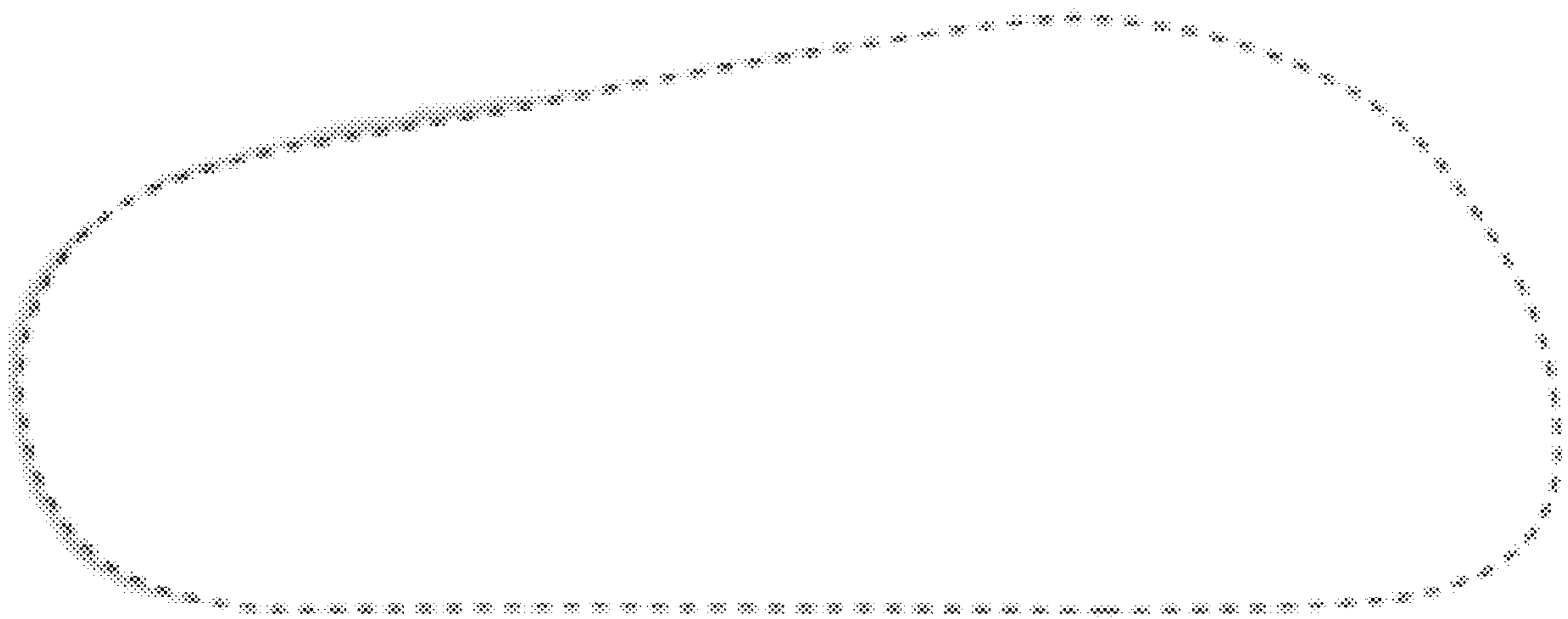
