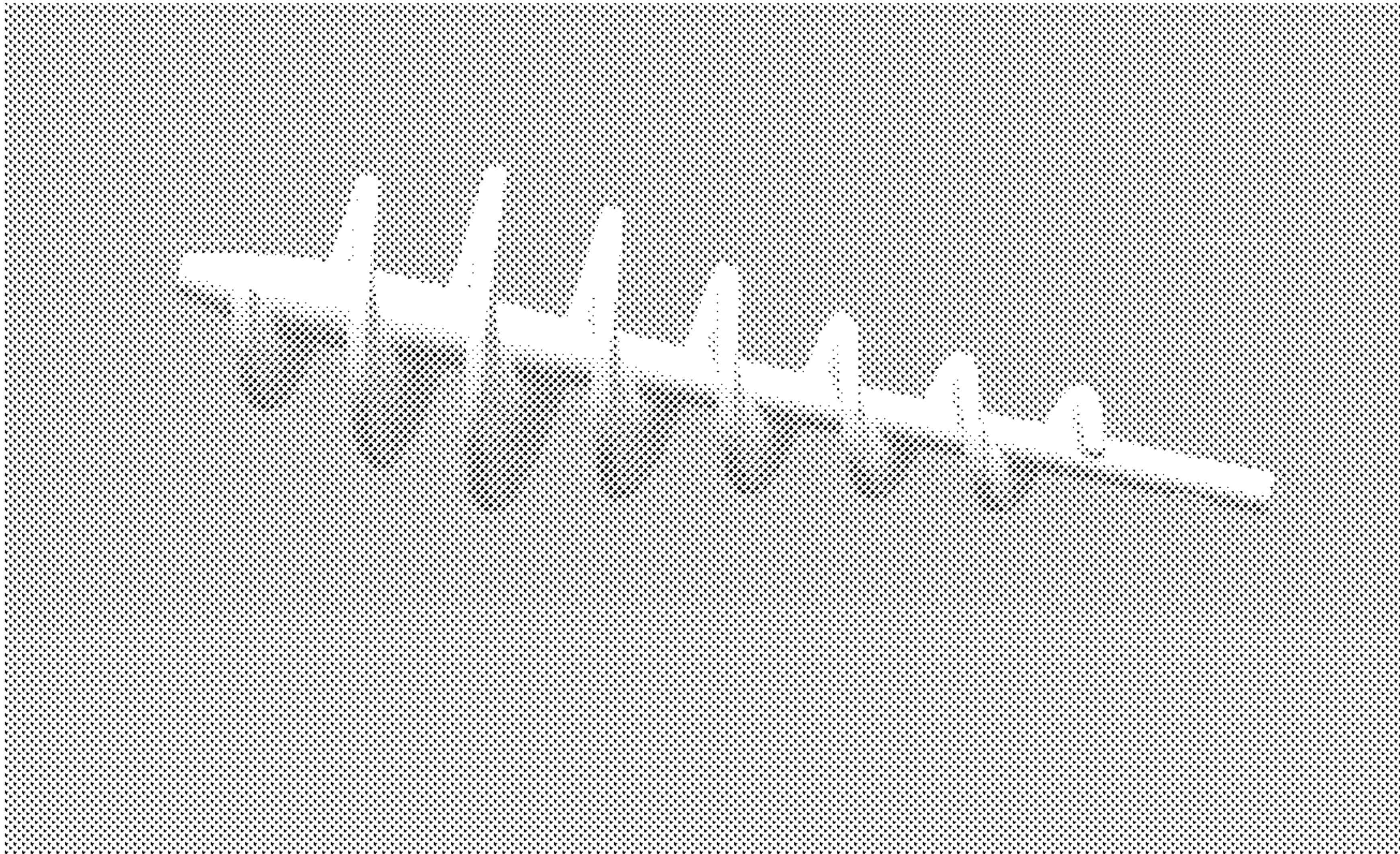
1. Fishing lure

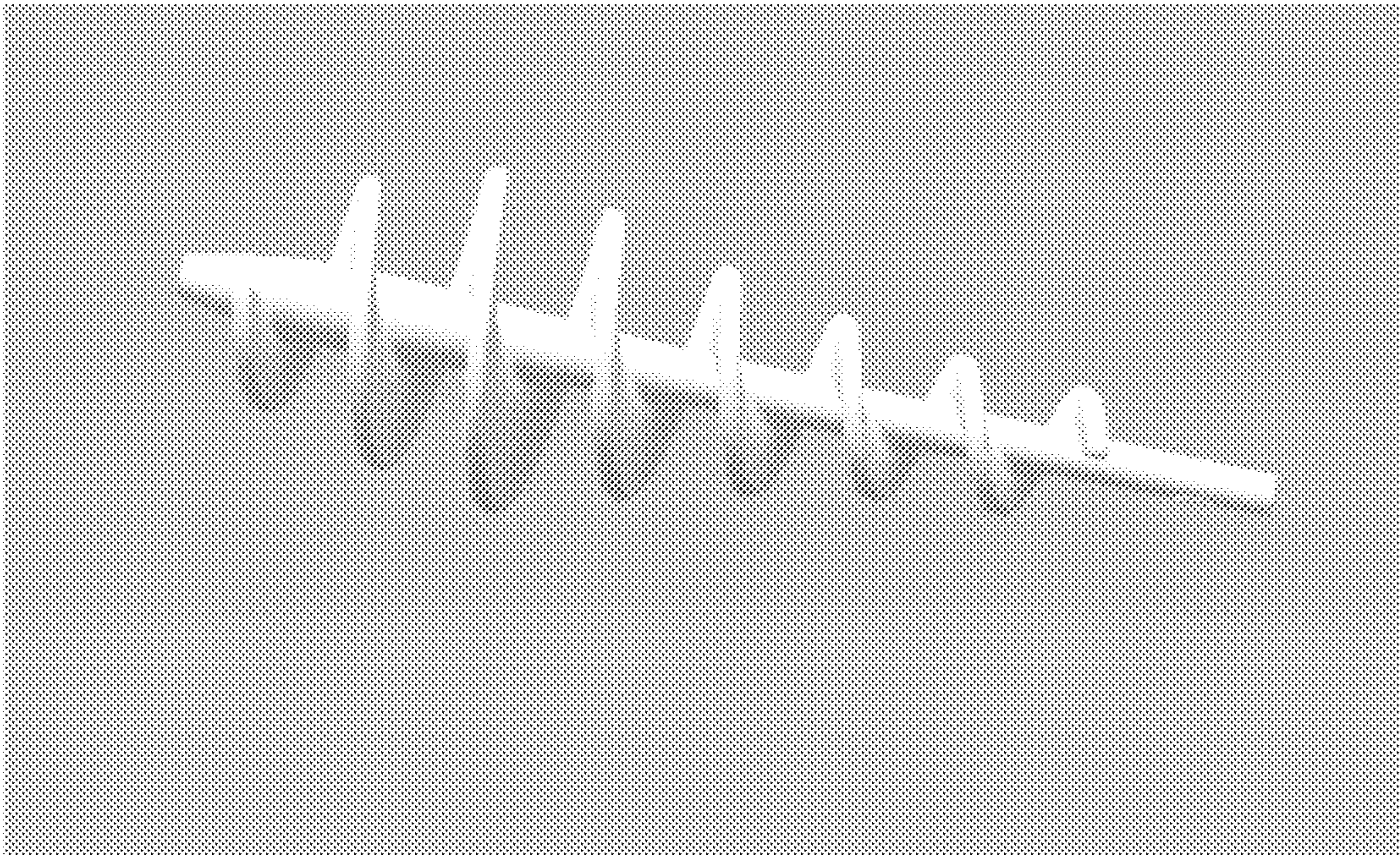
