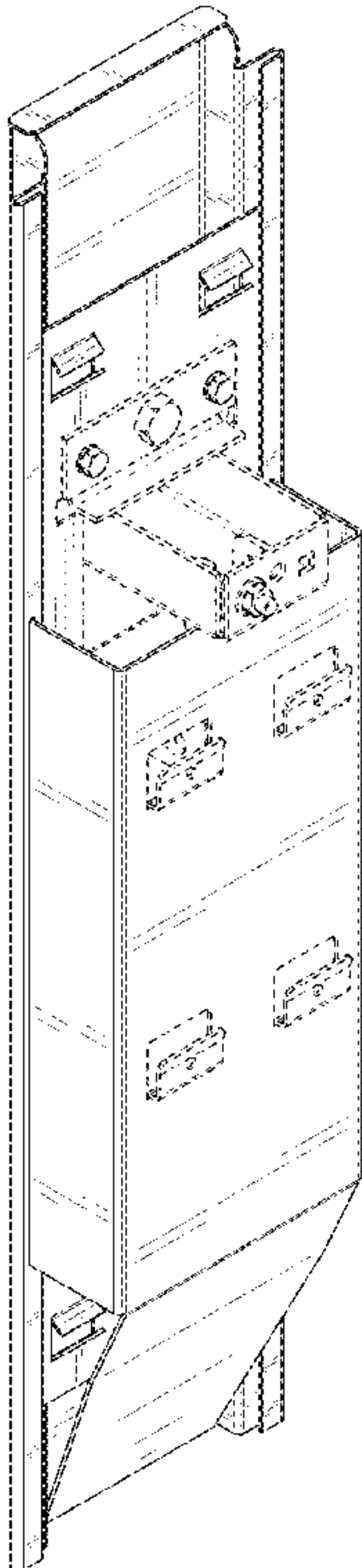
The ornamental design for a storage container drain, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

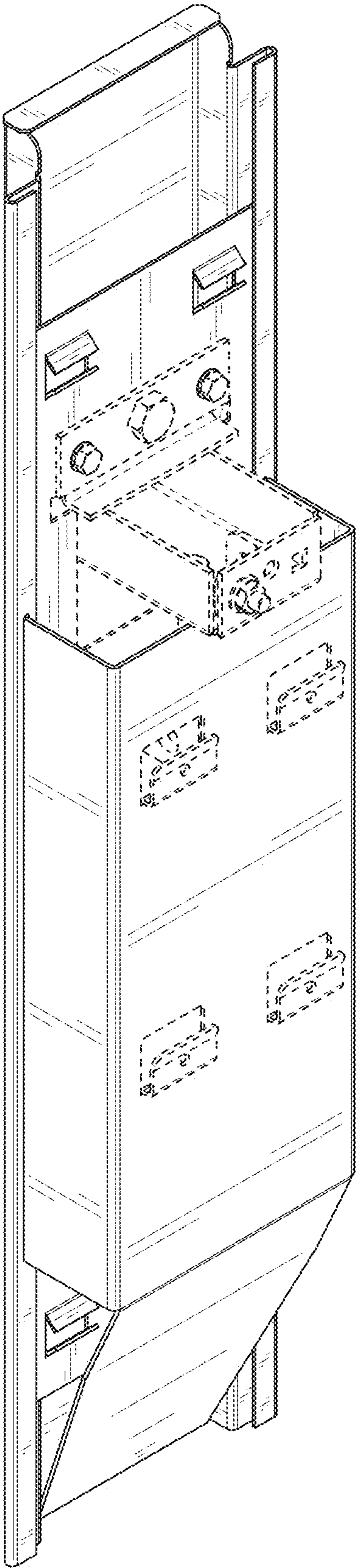

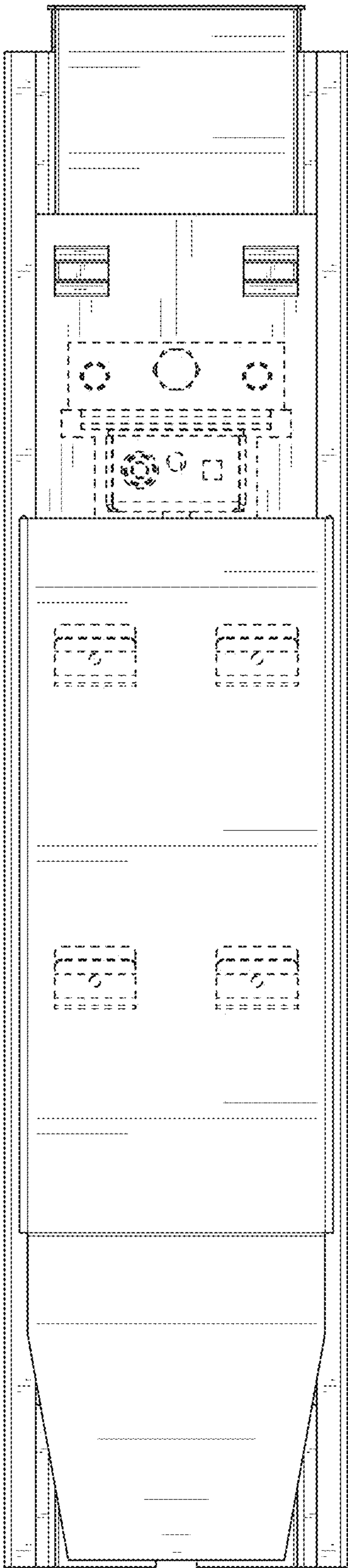

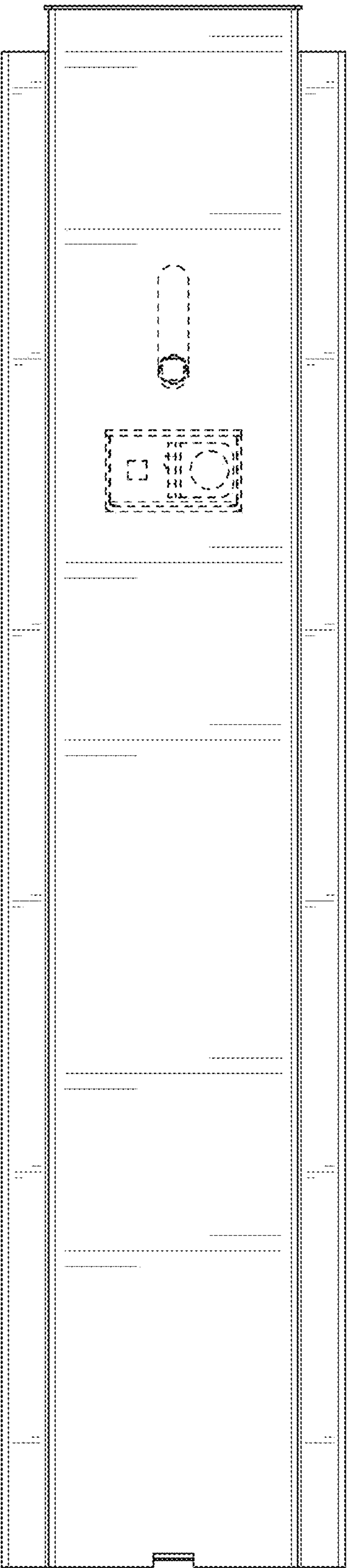

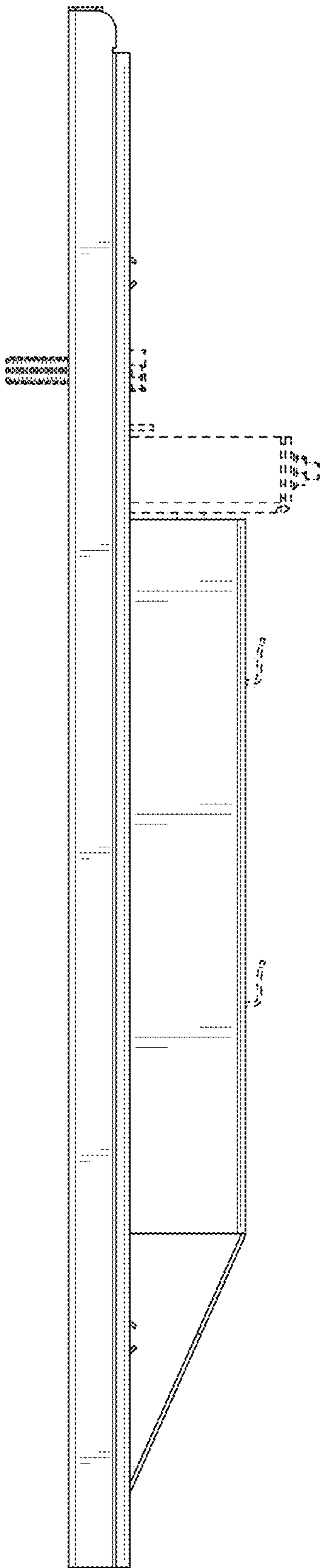

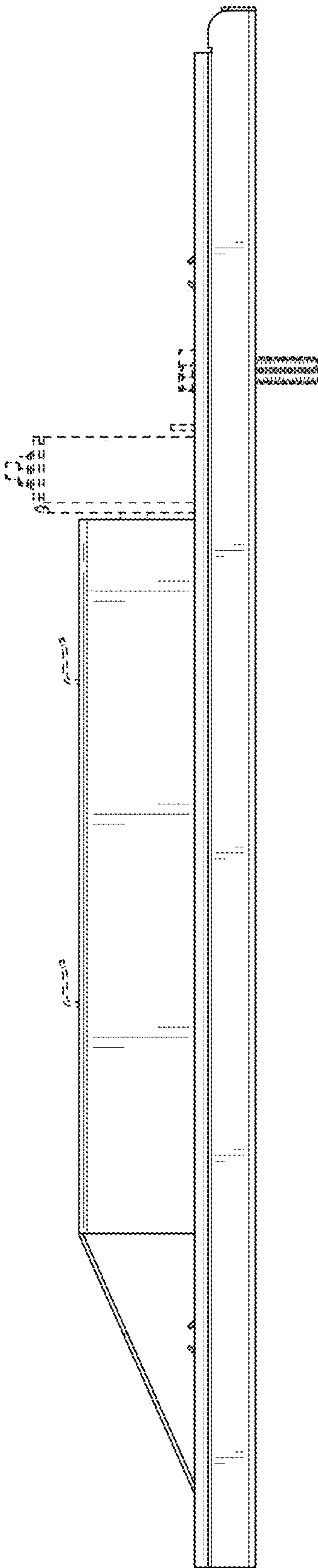

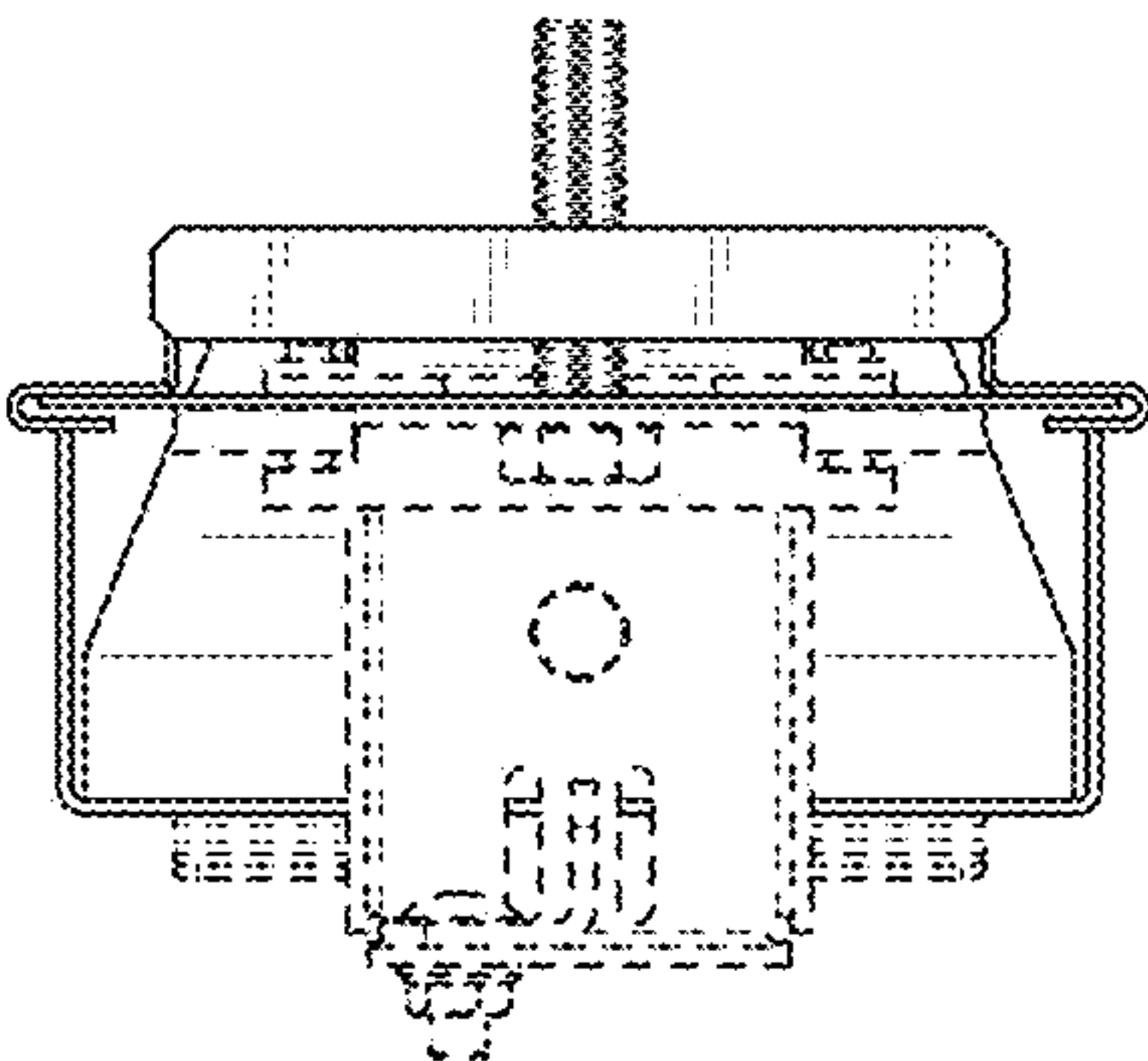

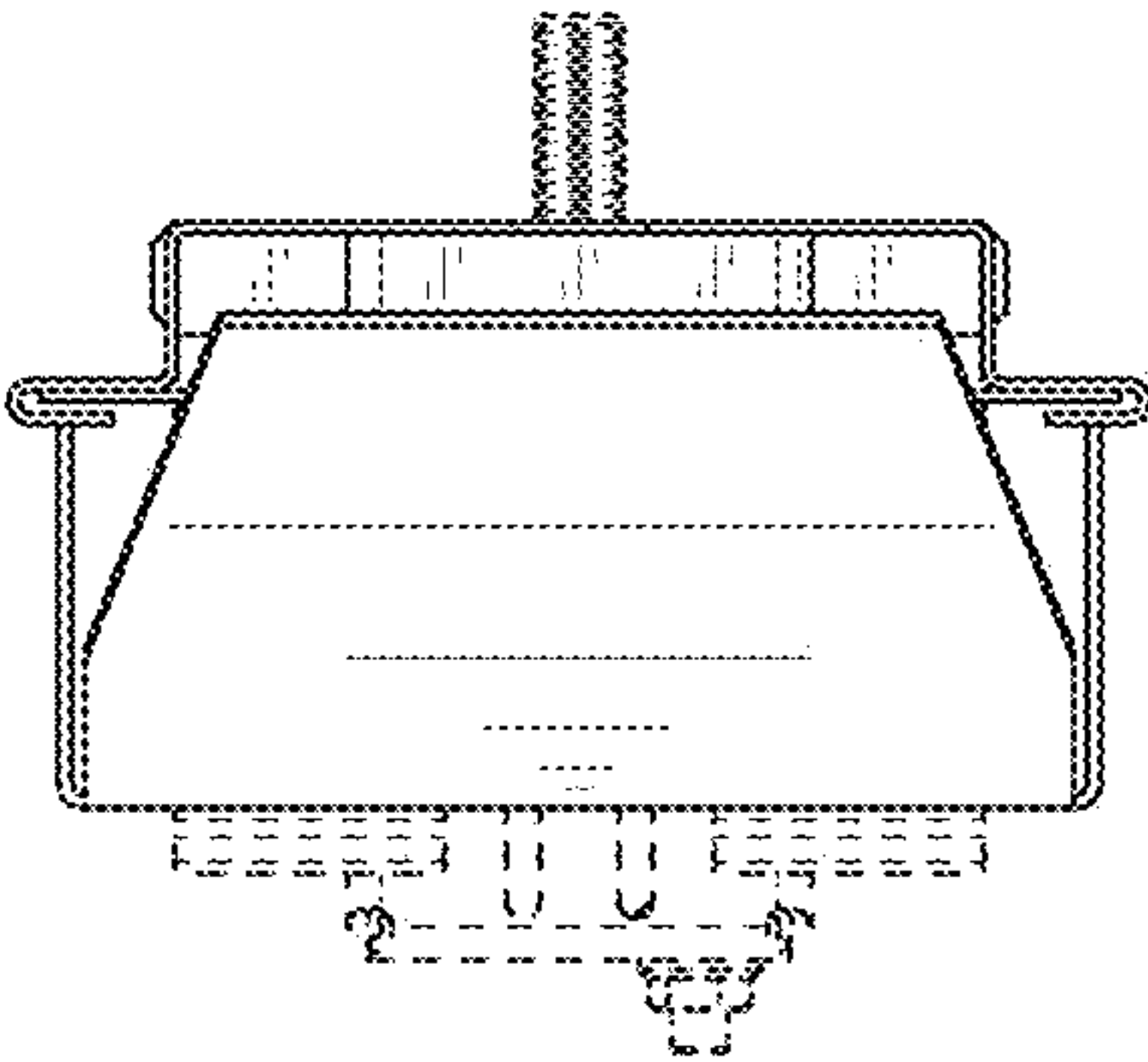

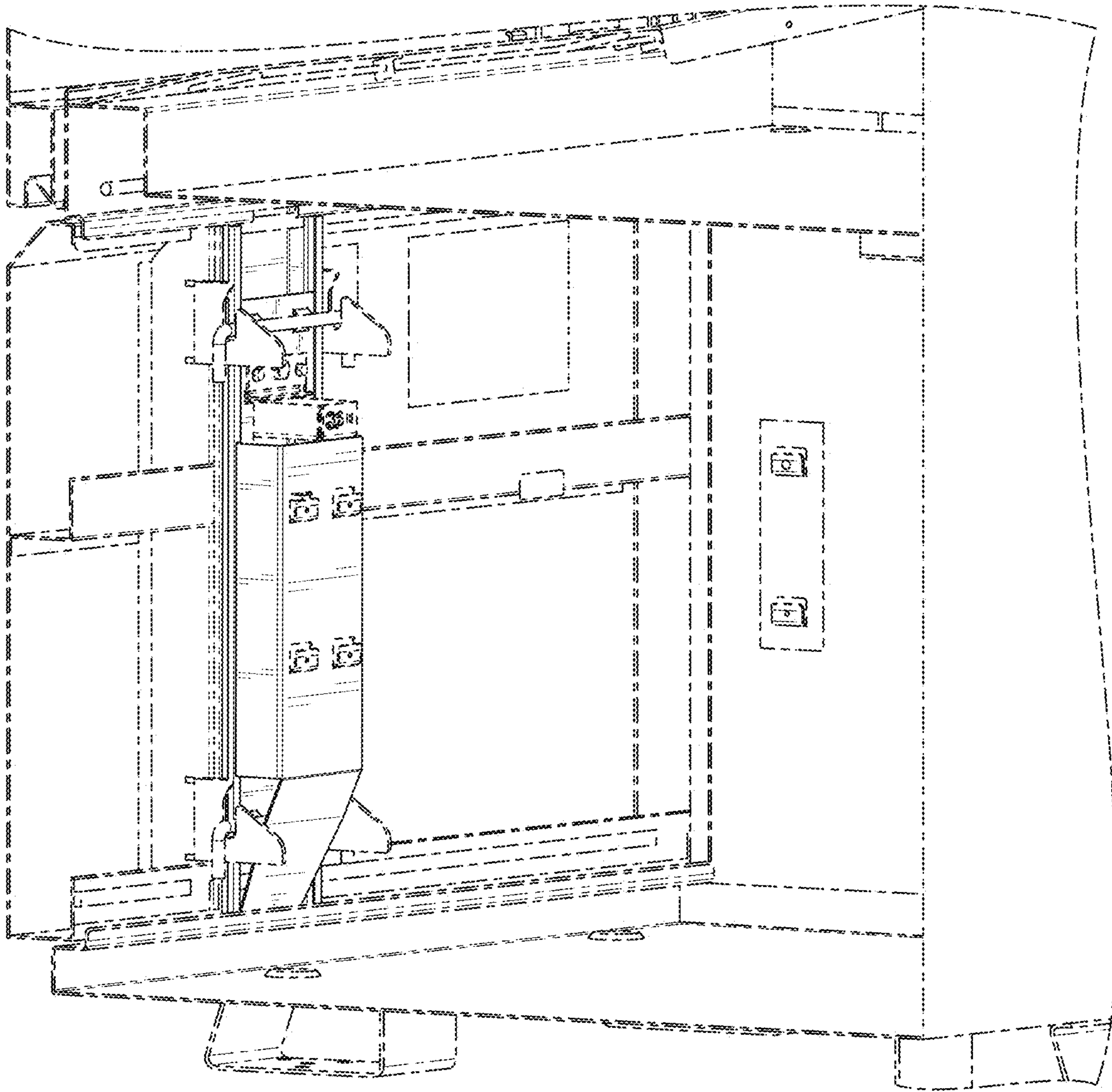
