DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

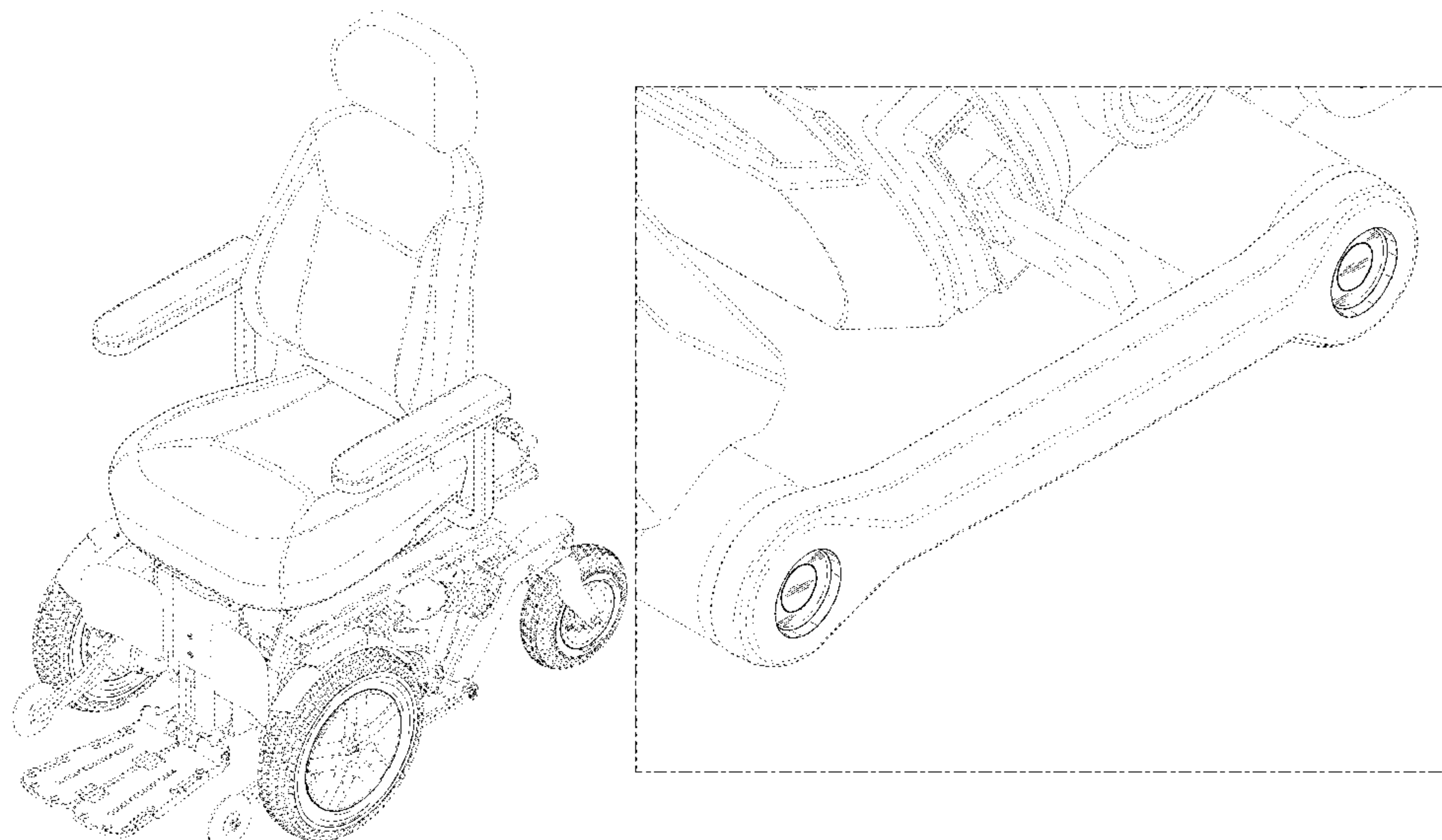
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

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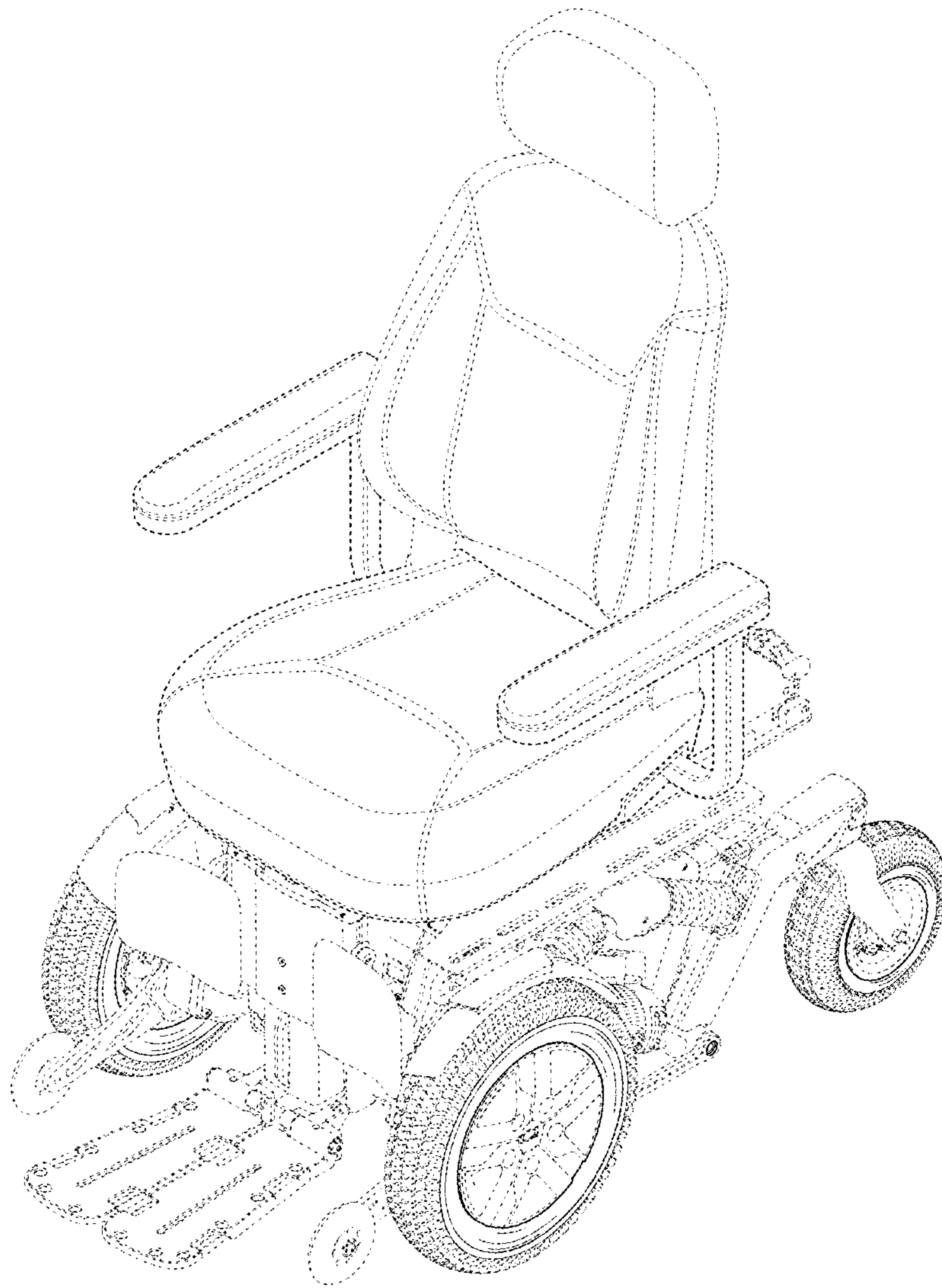

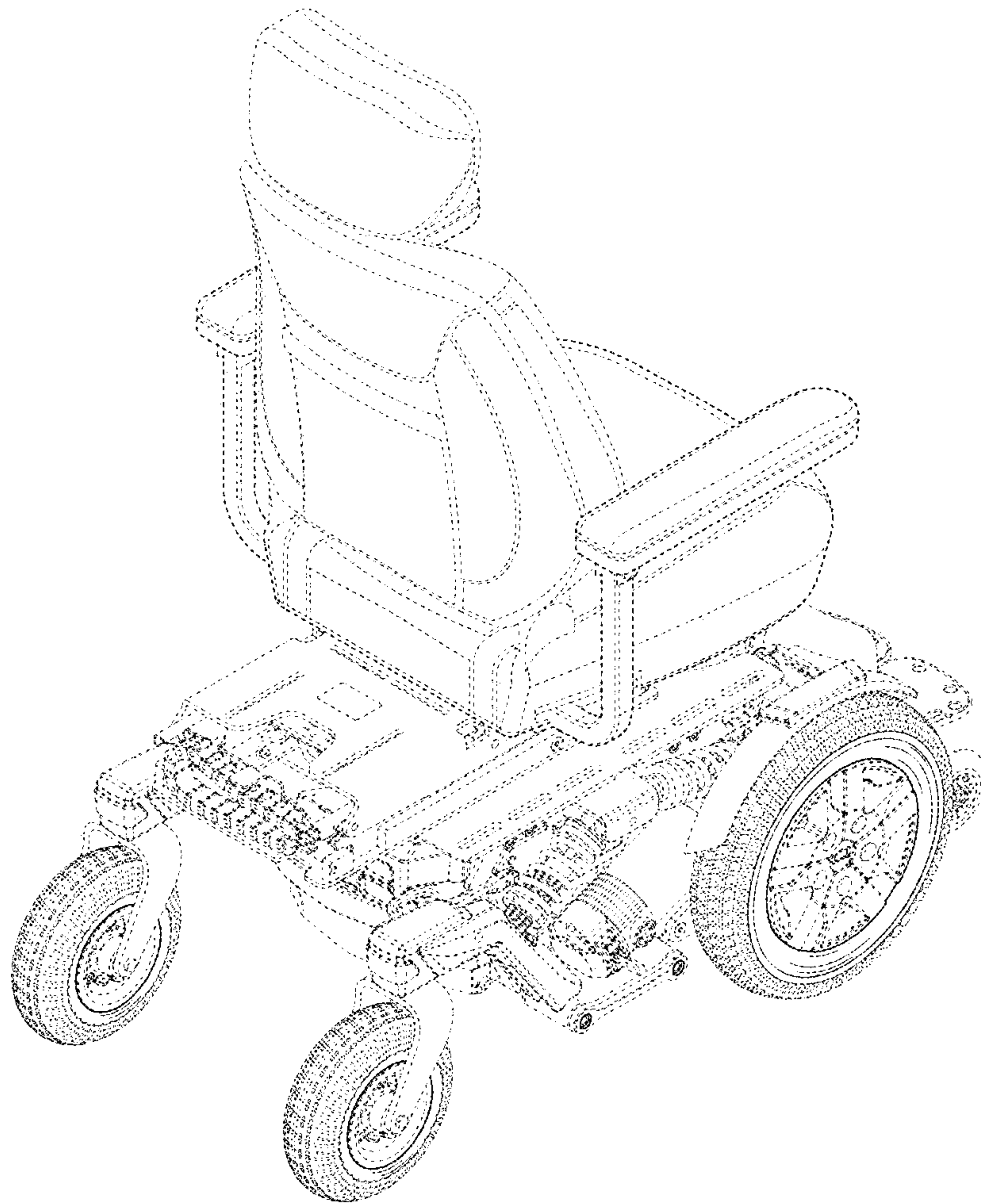

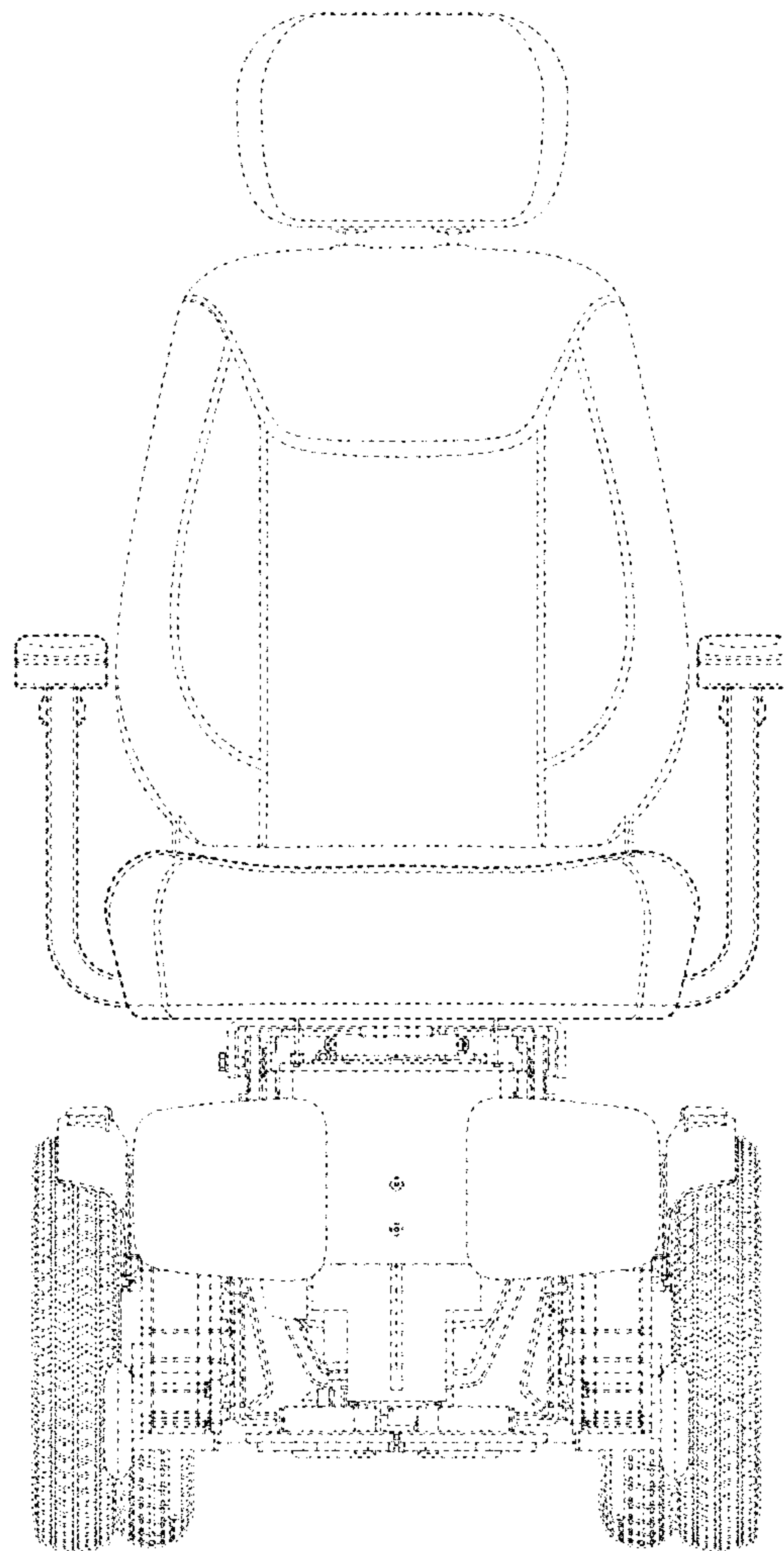

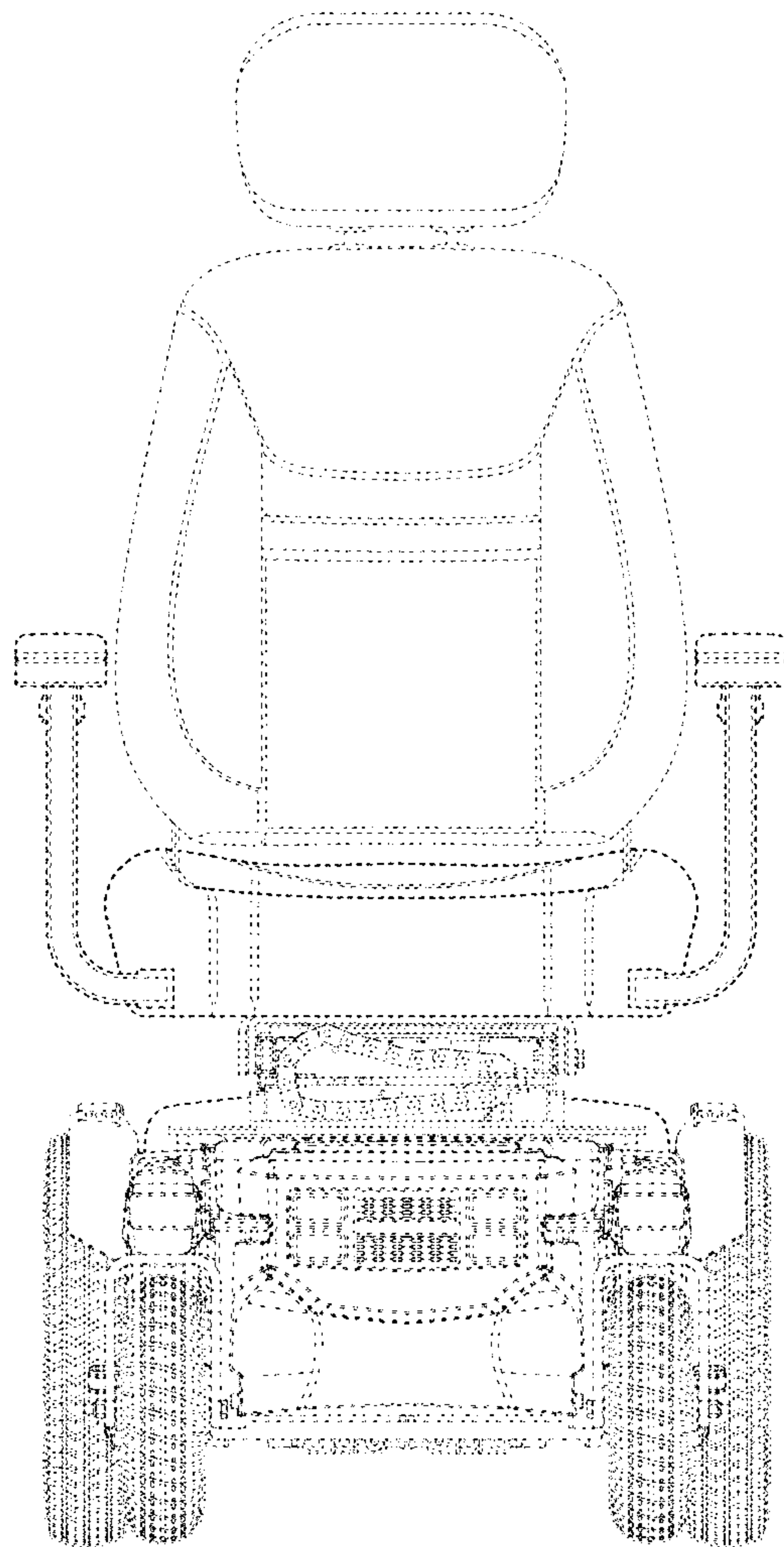

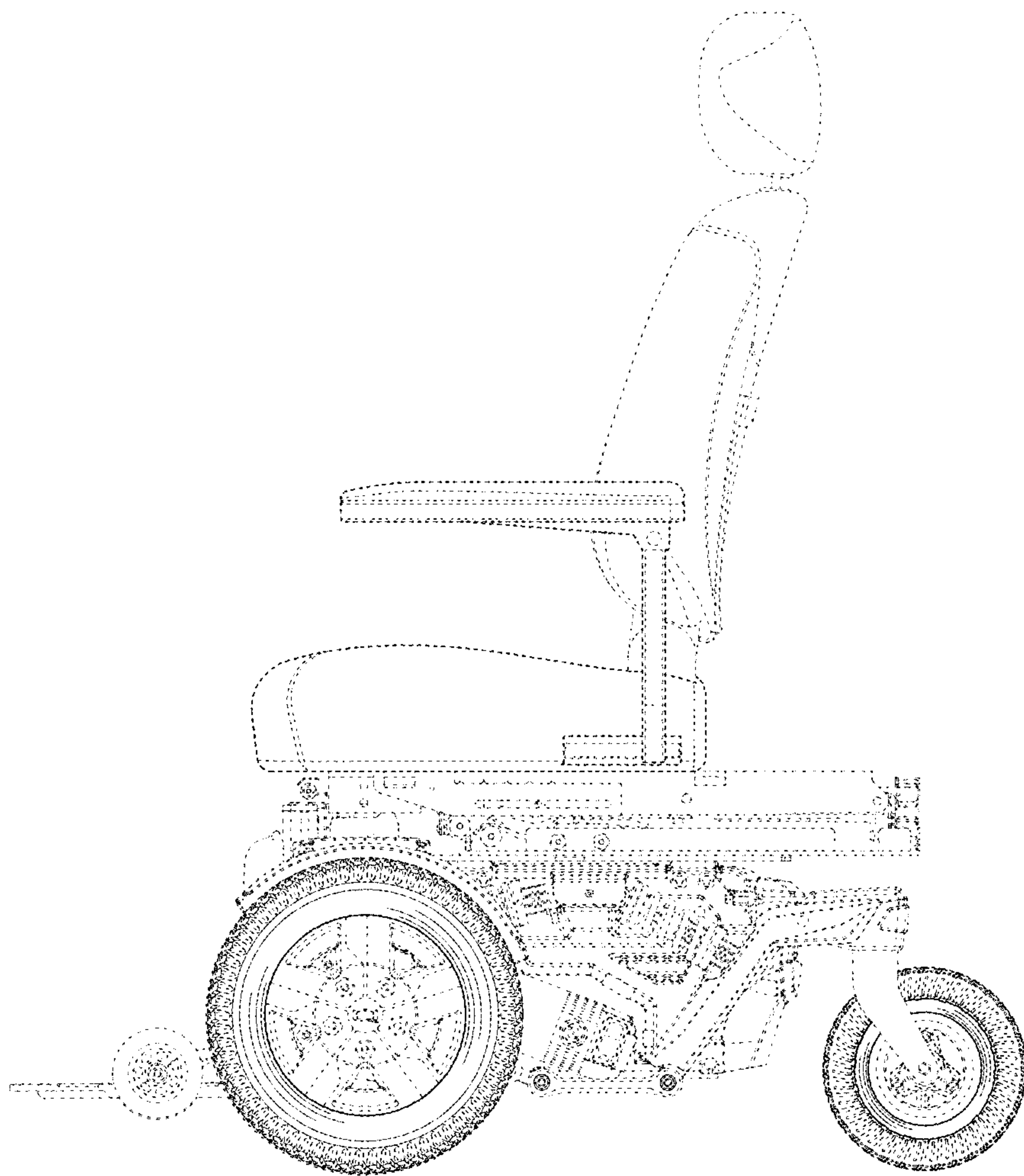

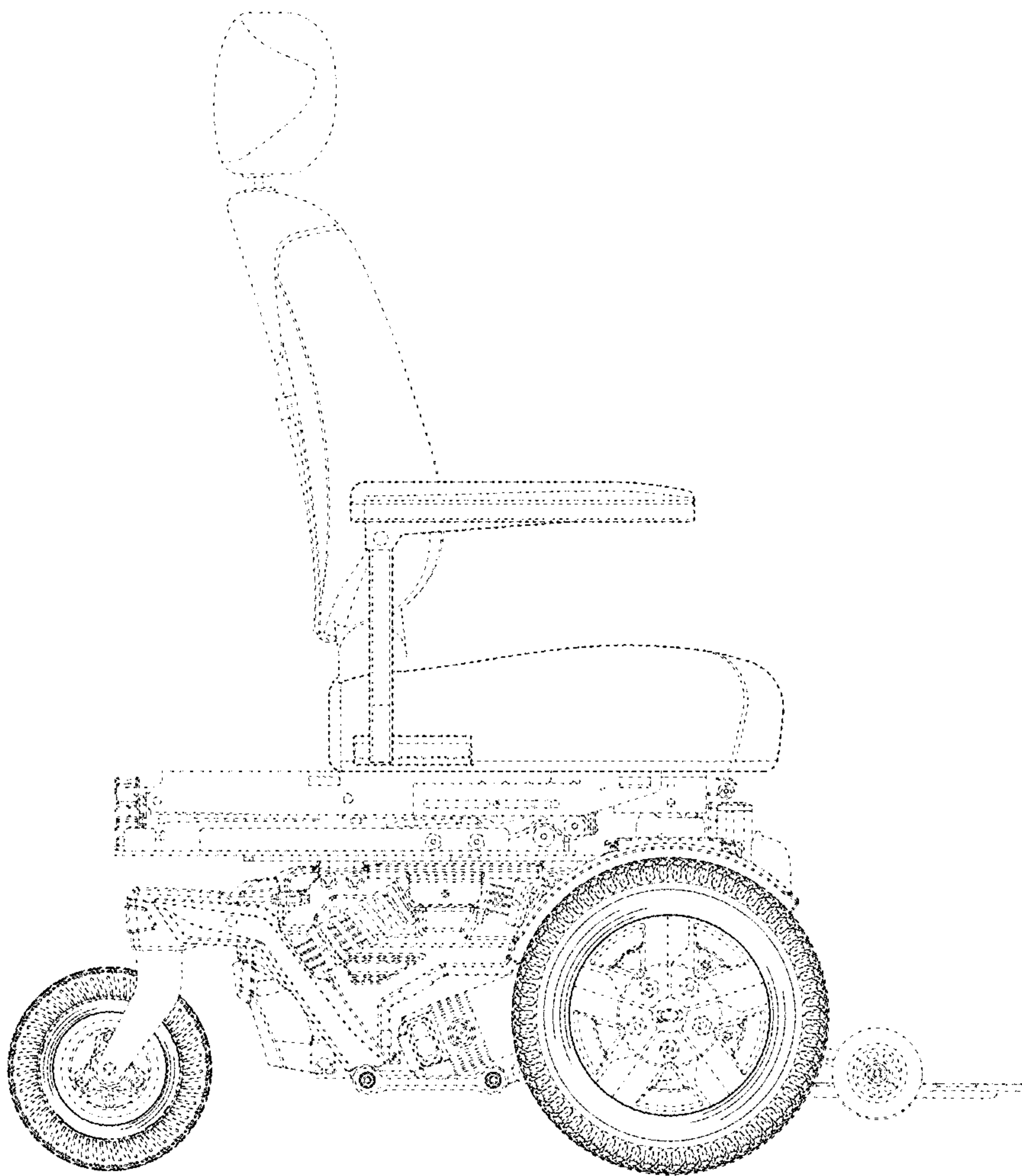

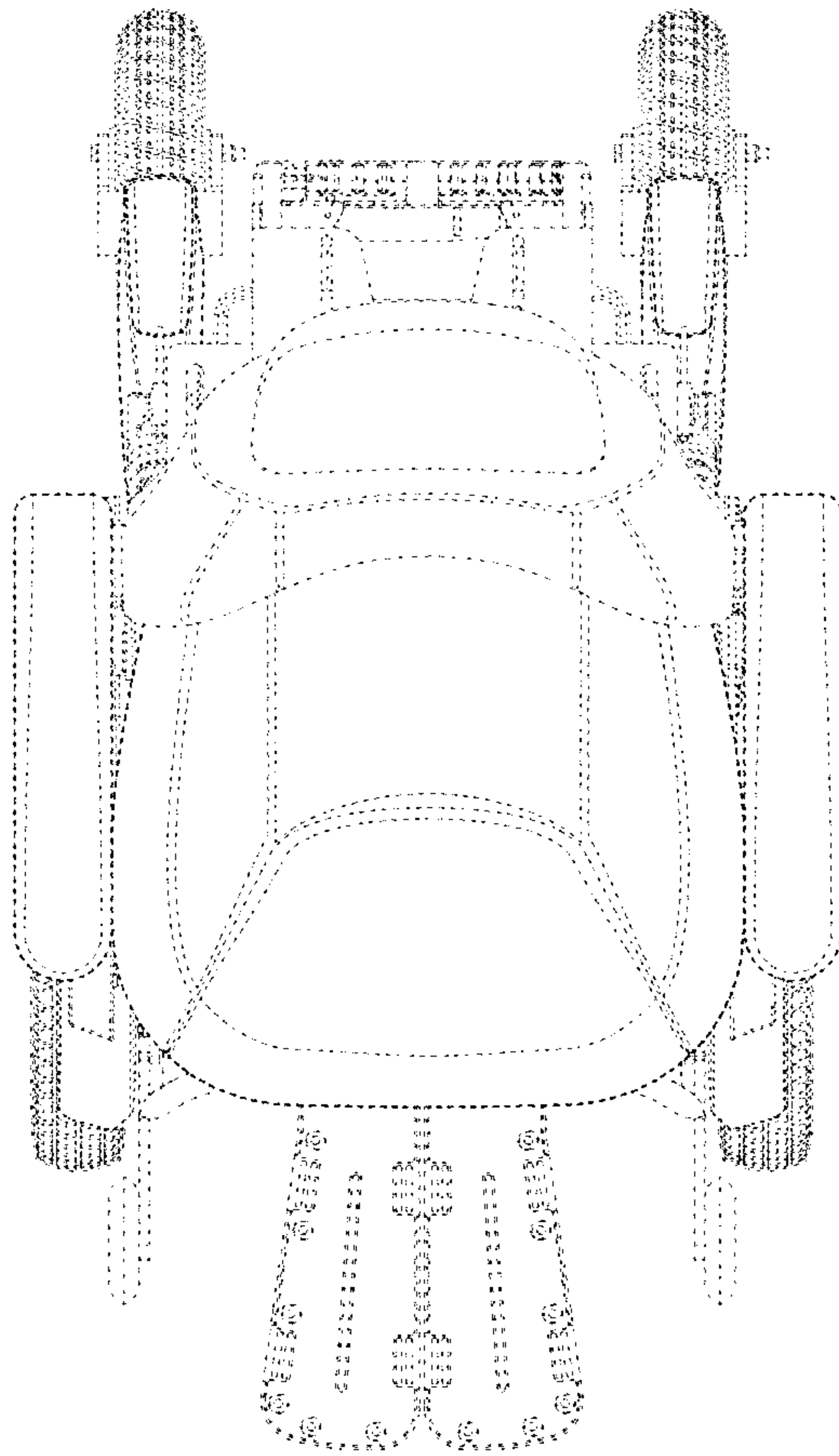

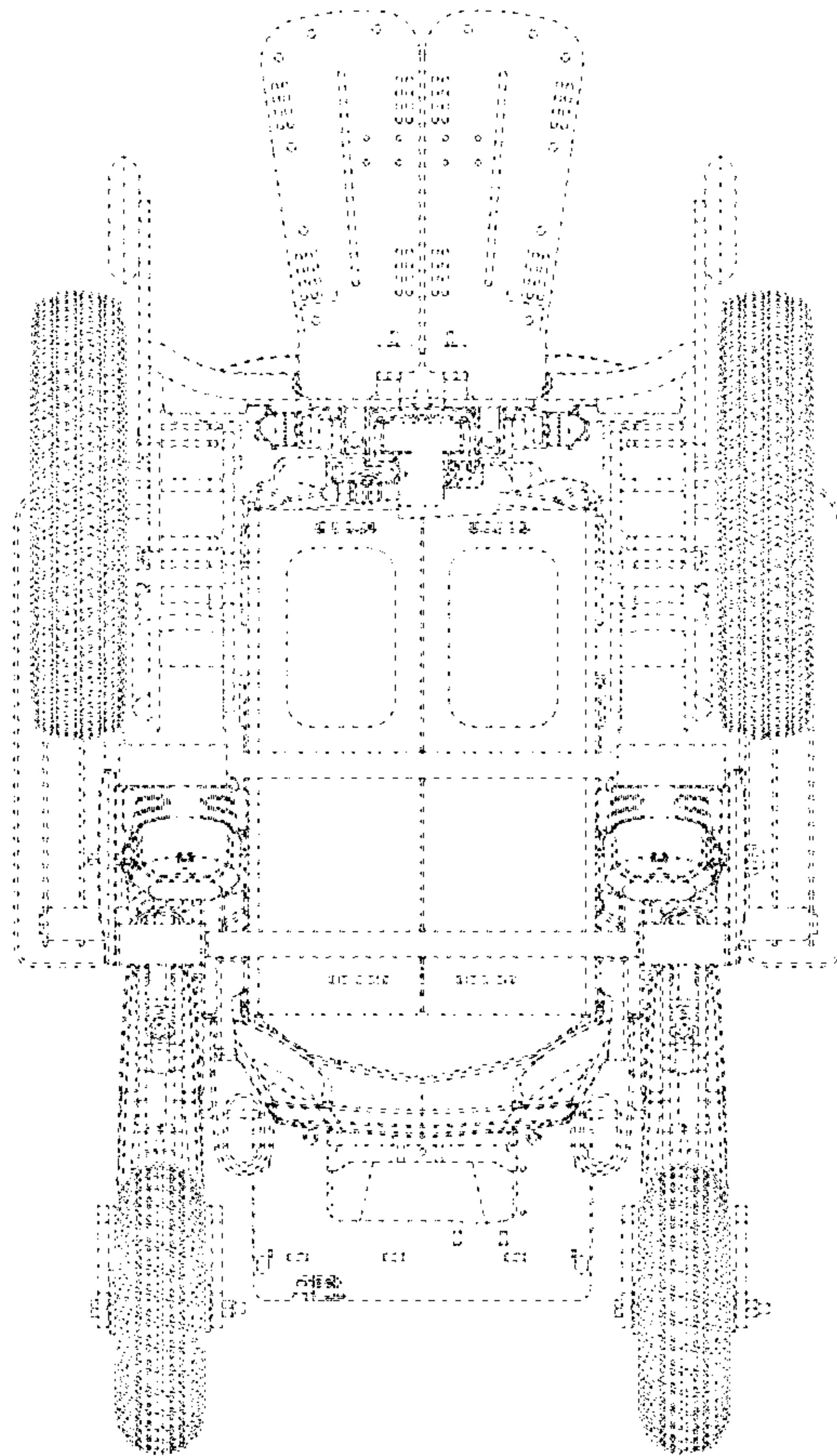

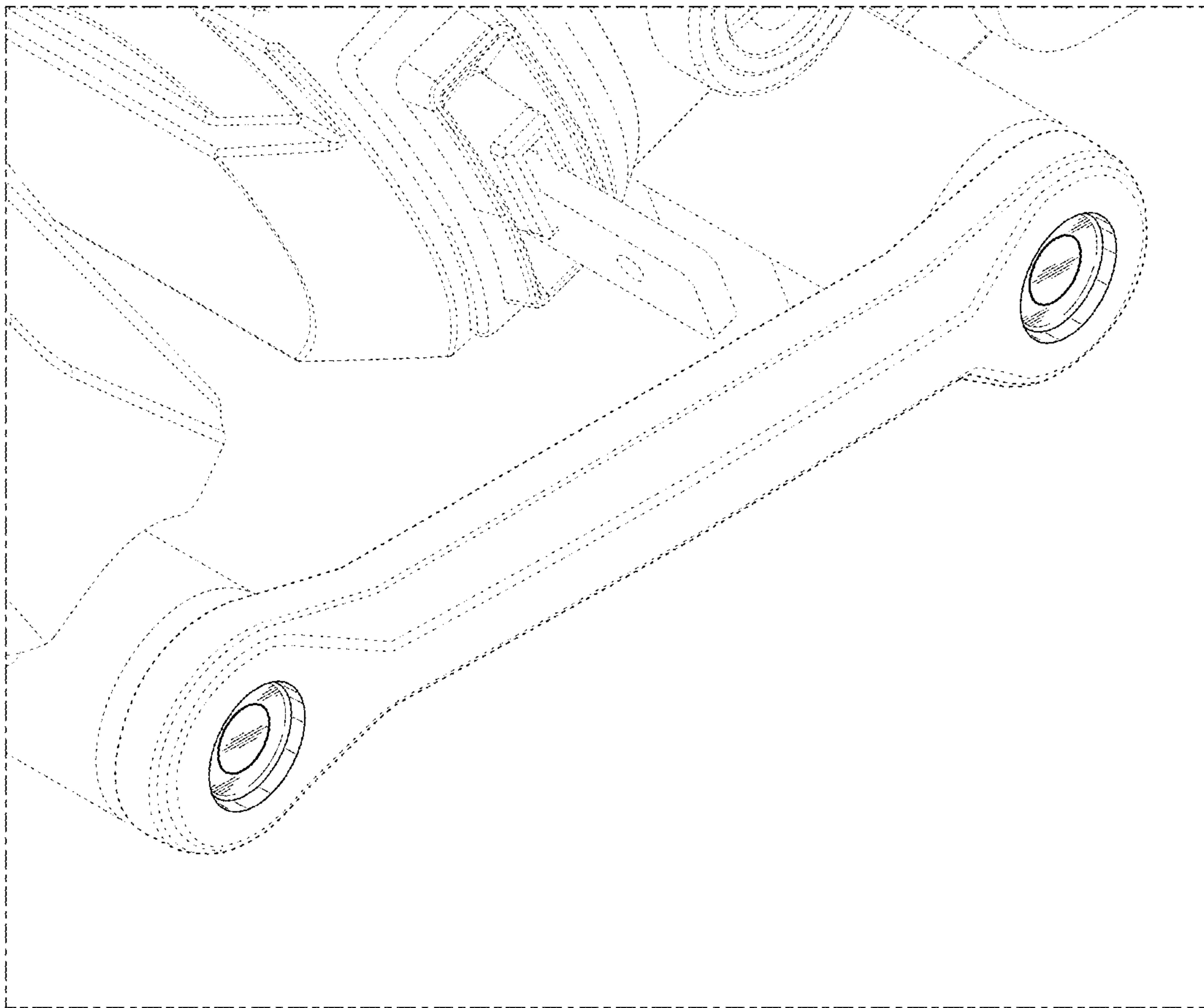

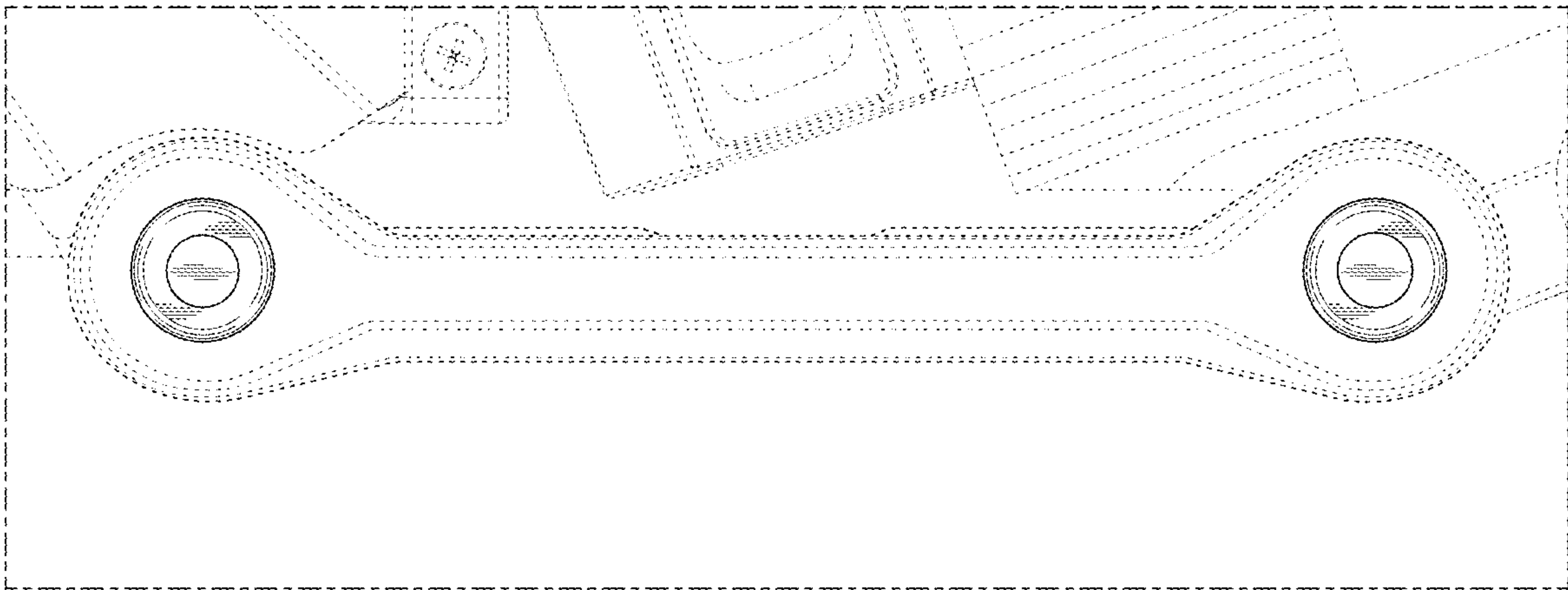
