FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view thereof.

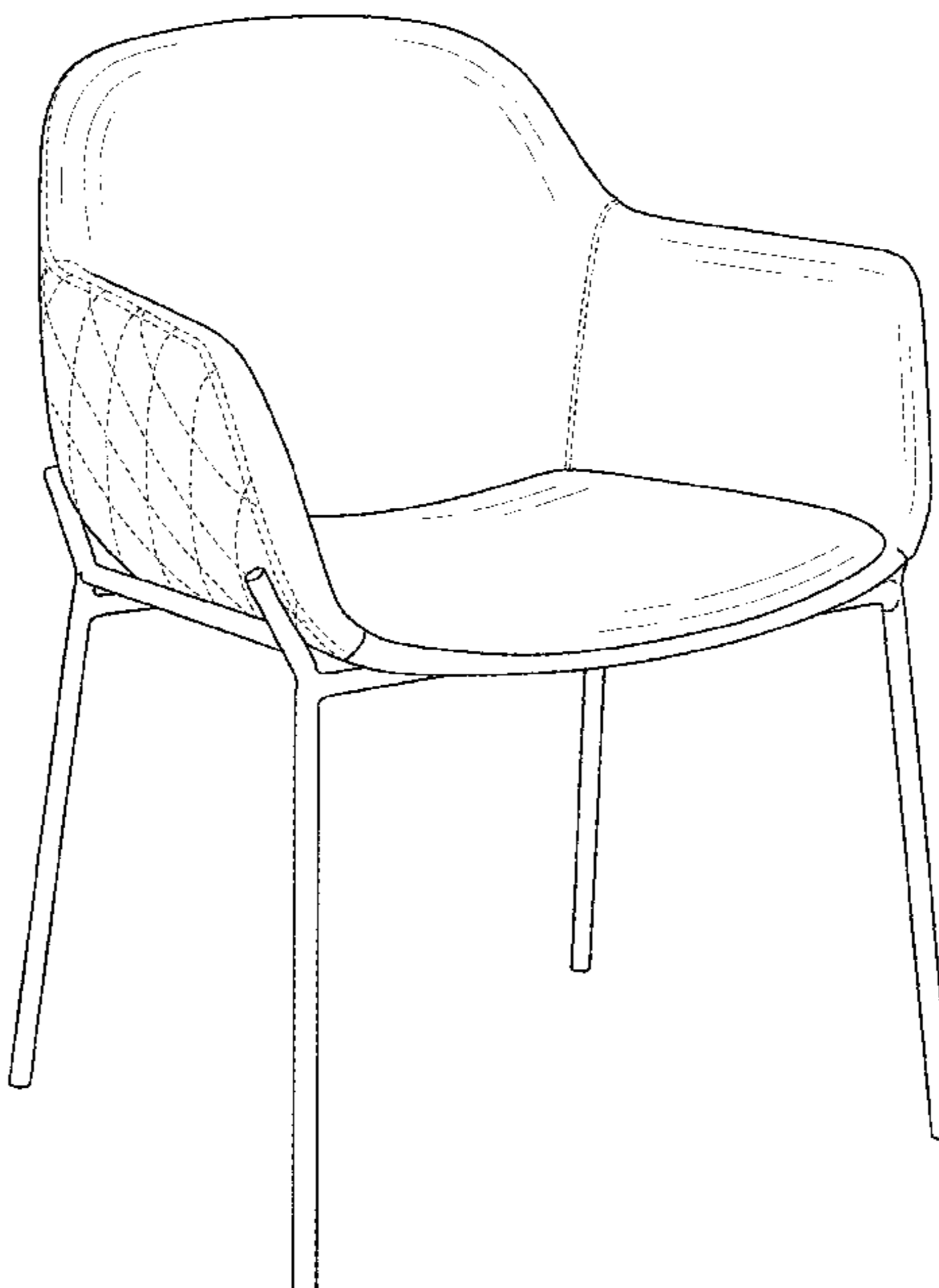
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view thereof.

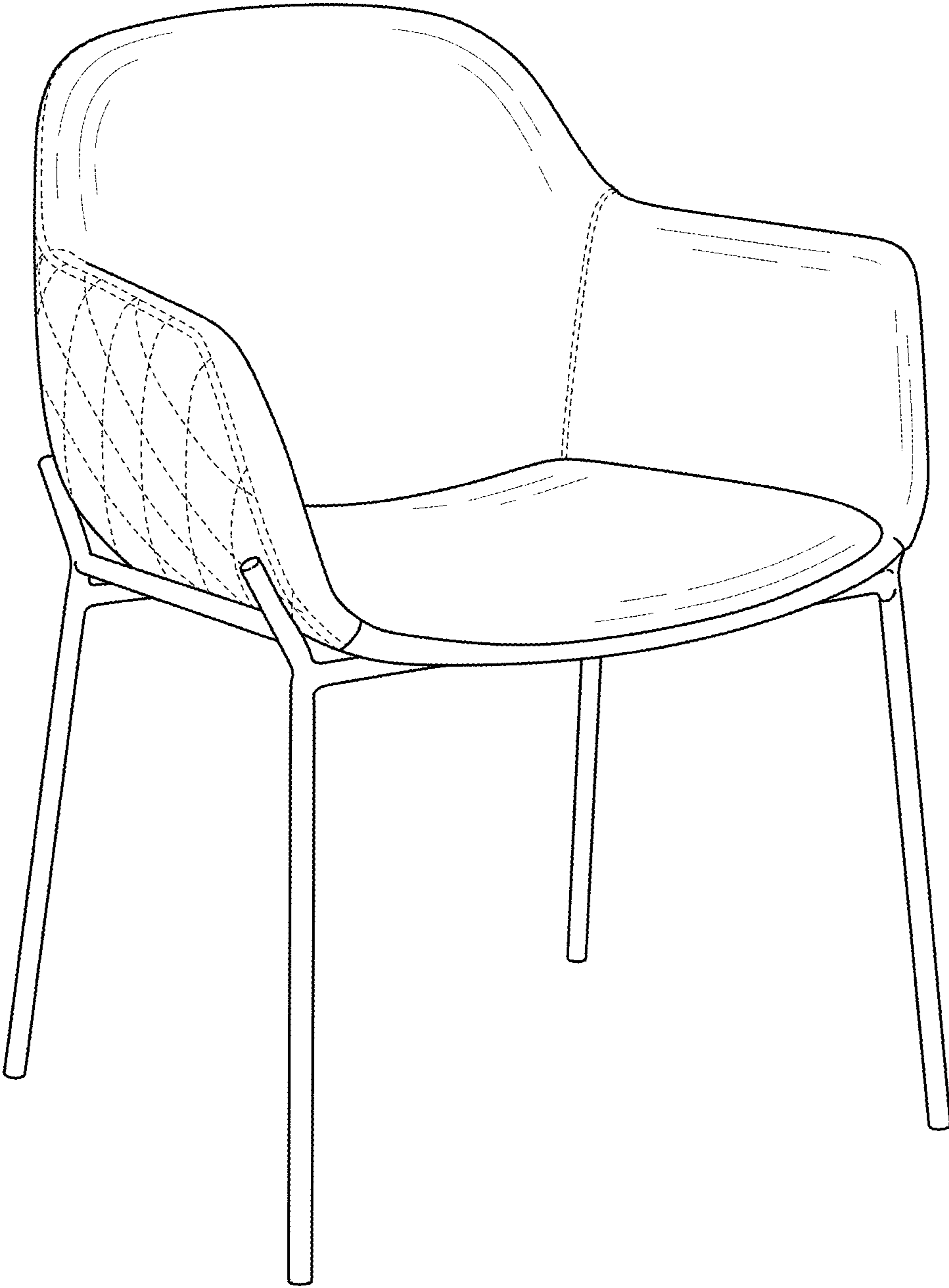

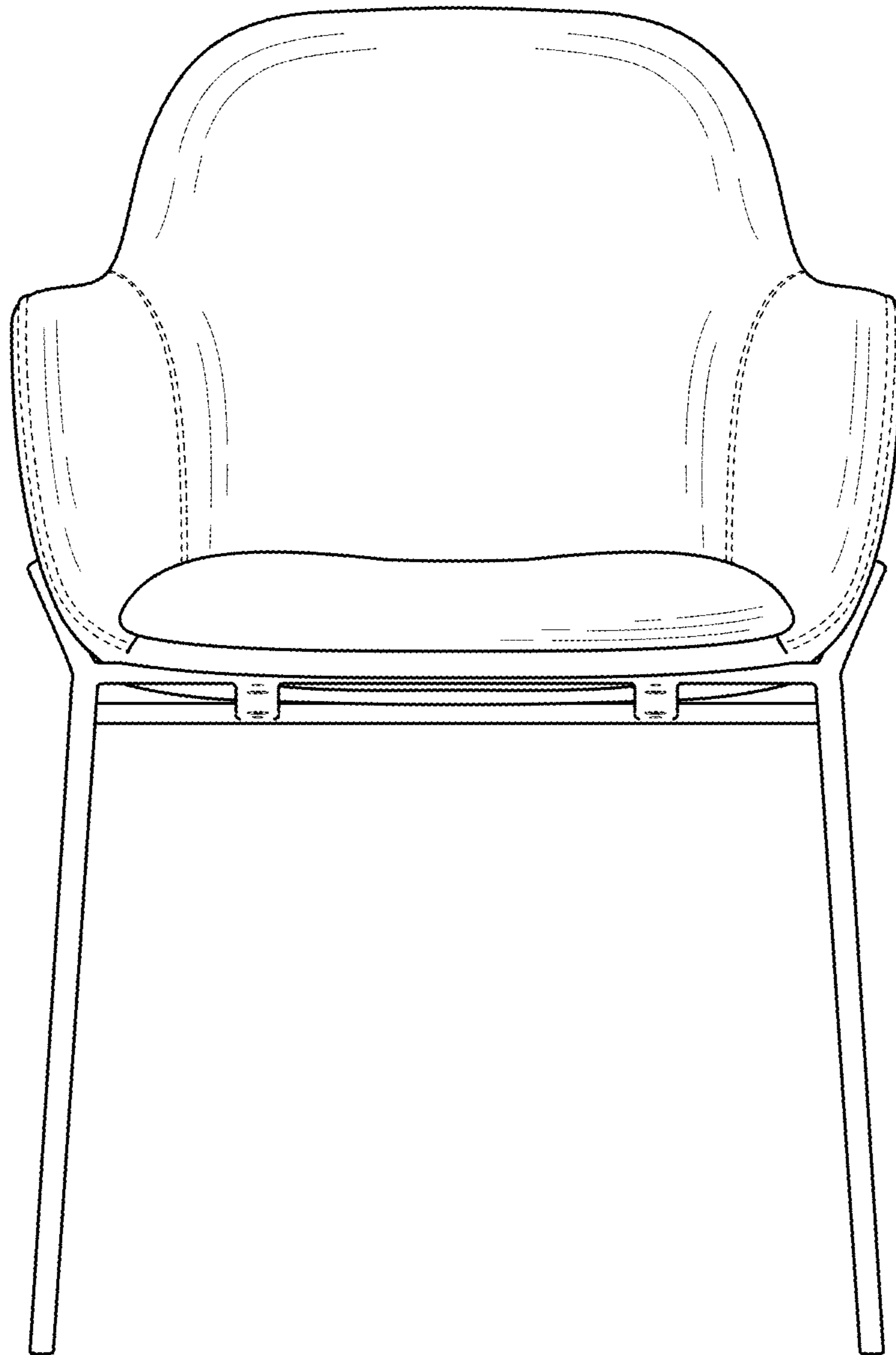

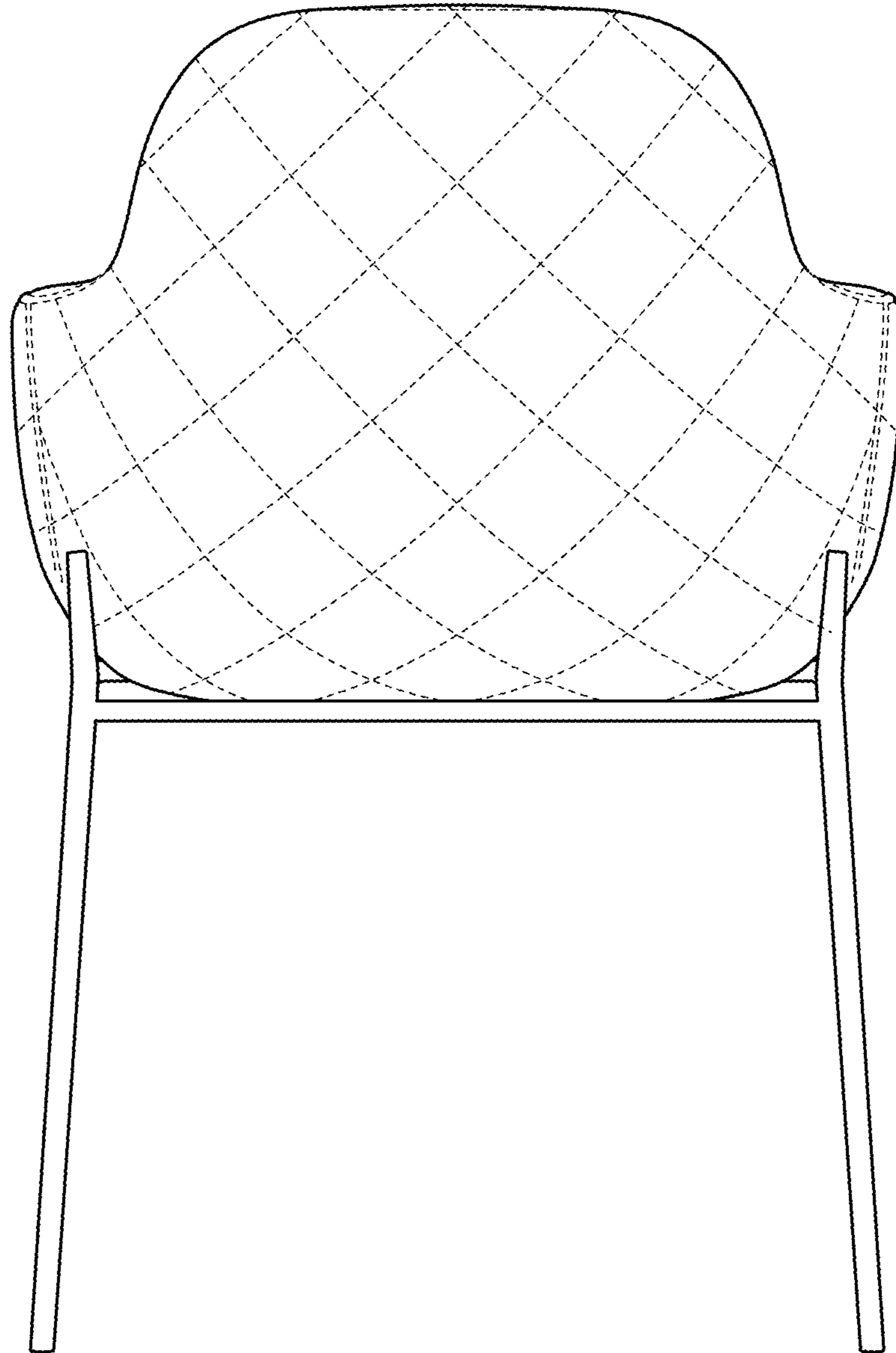

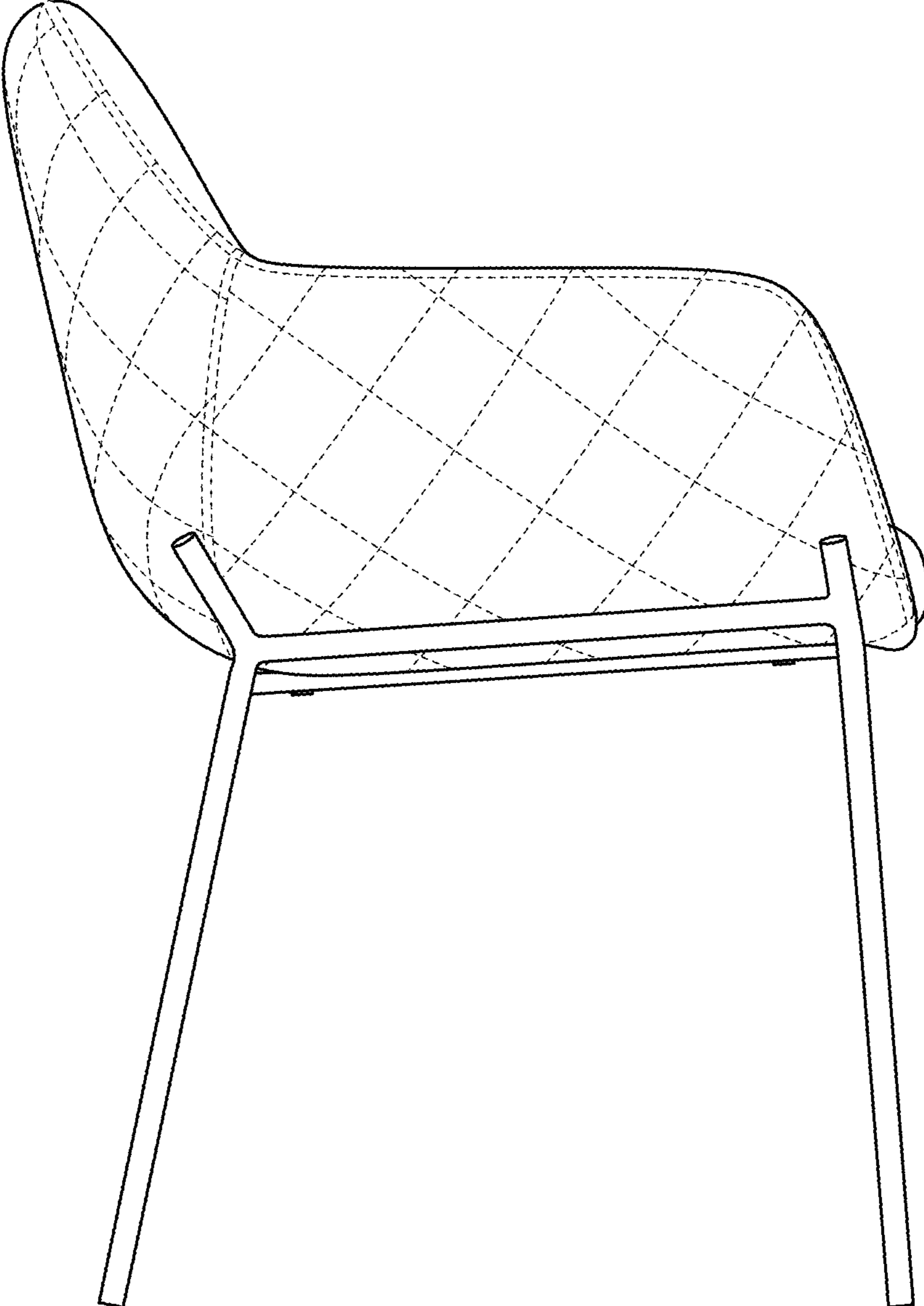

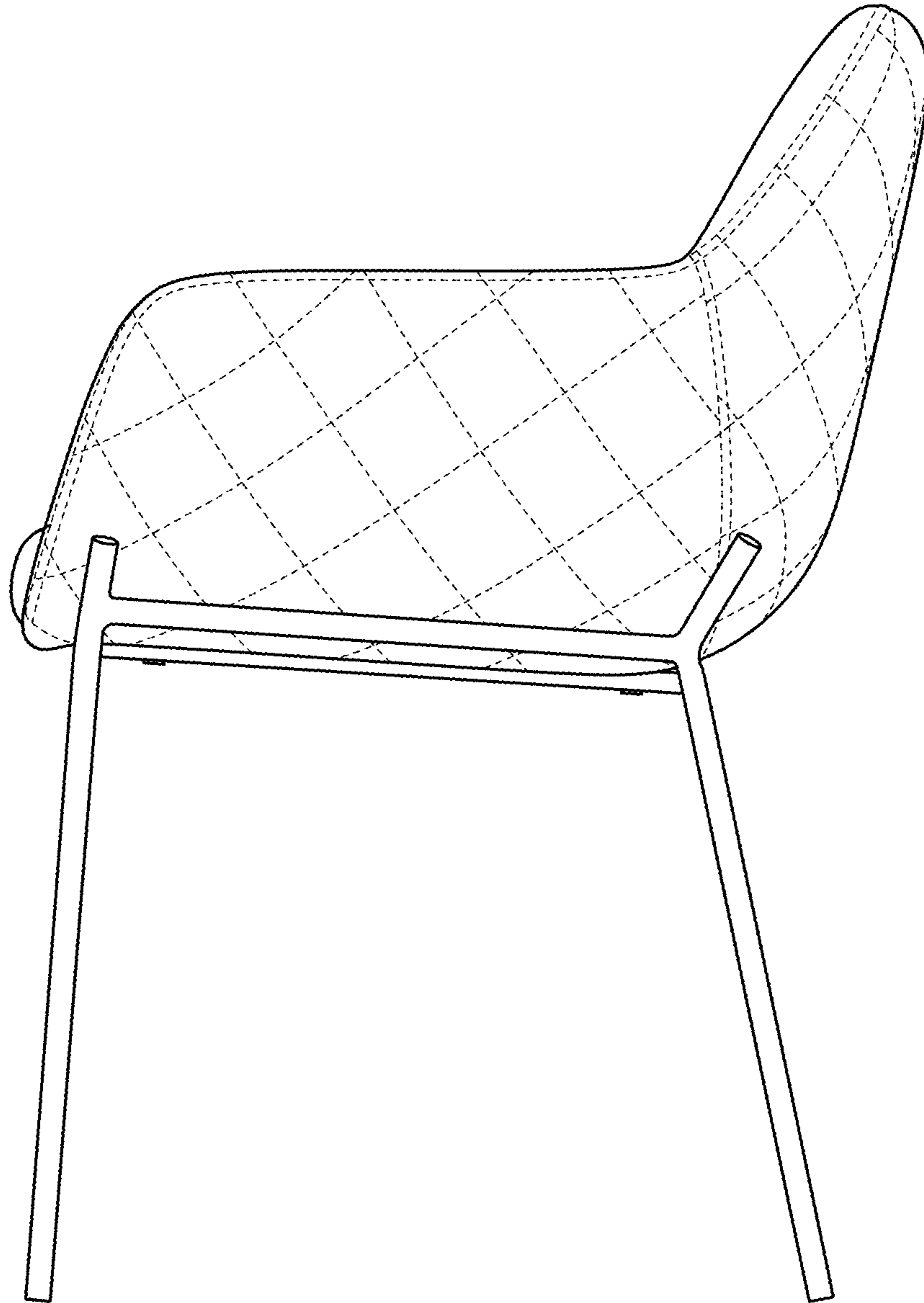

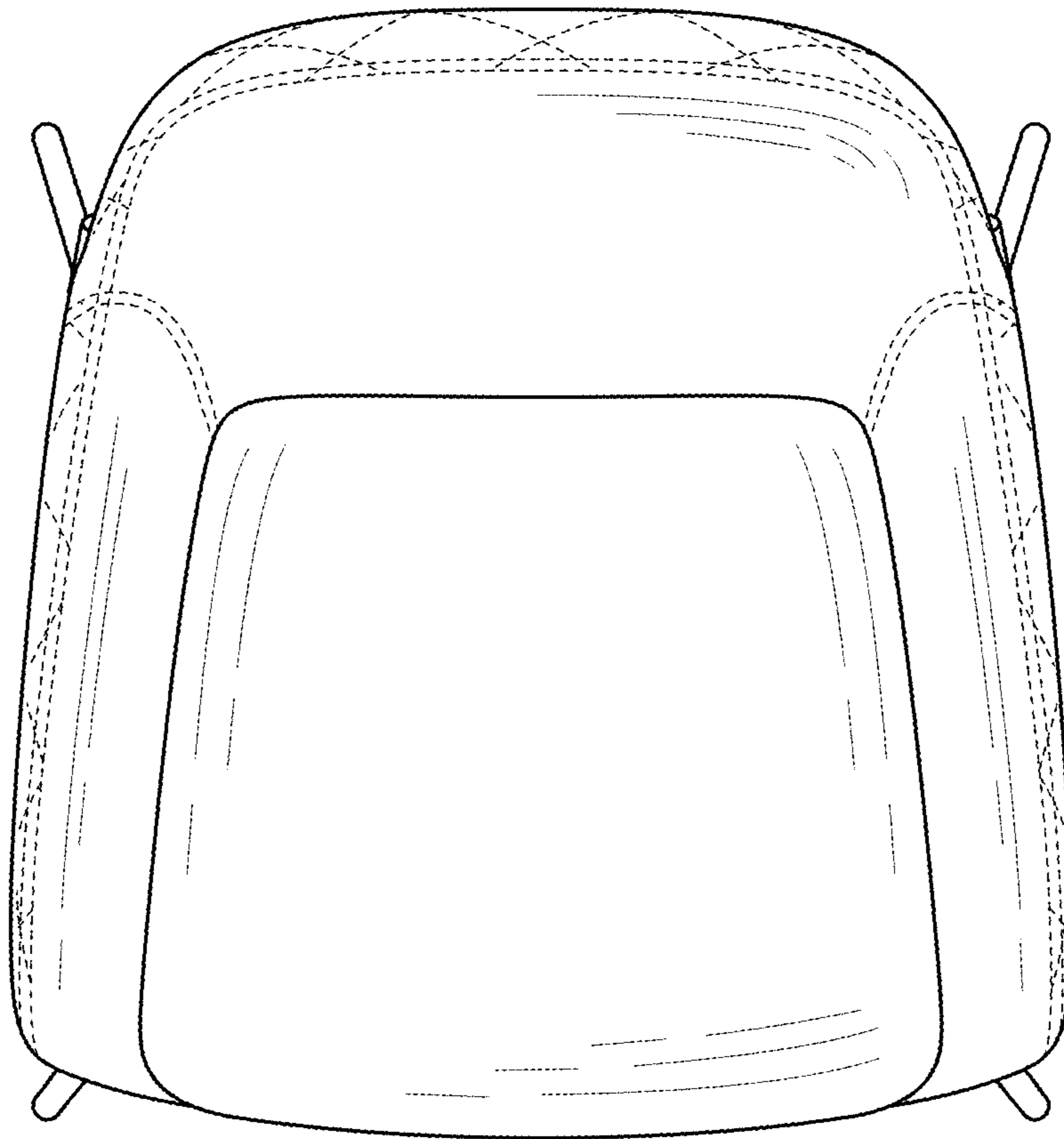

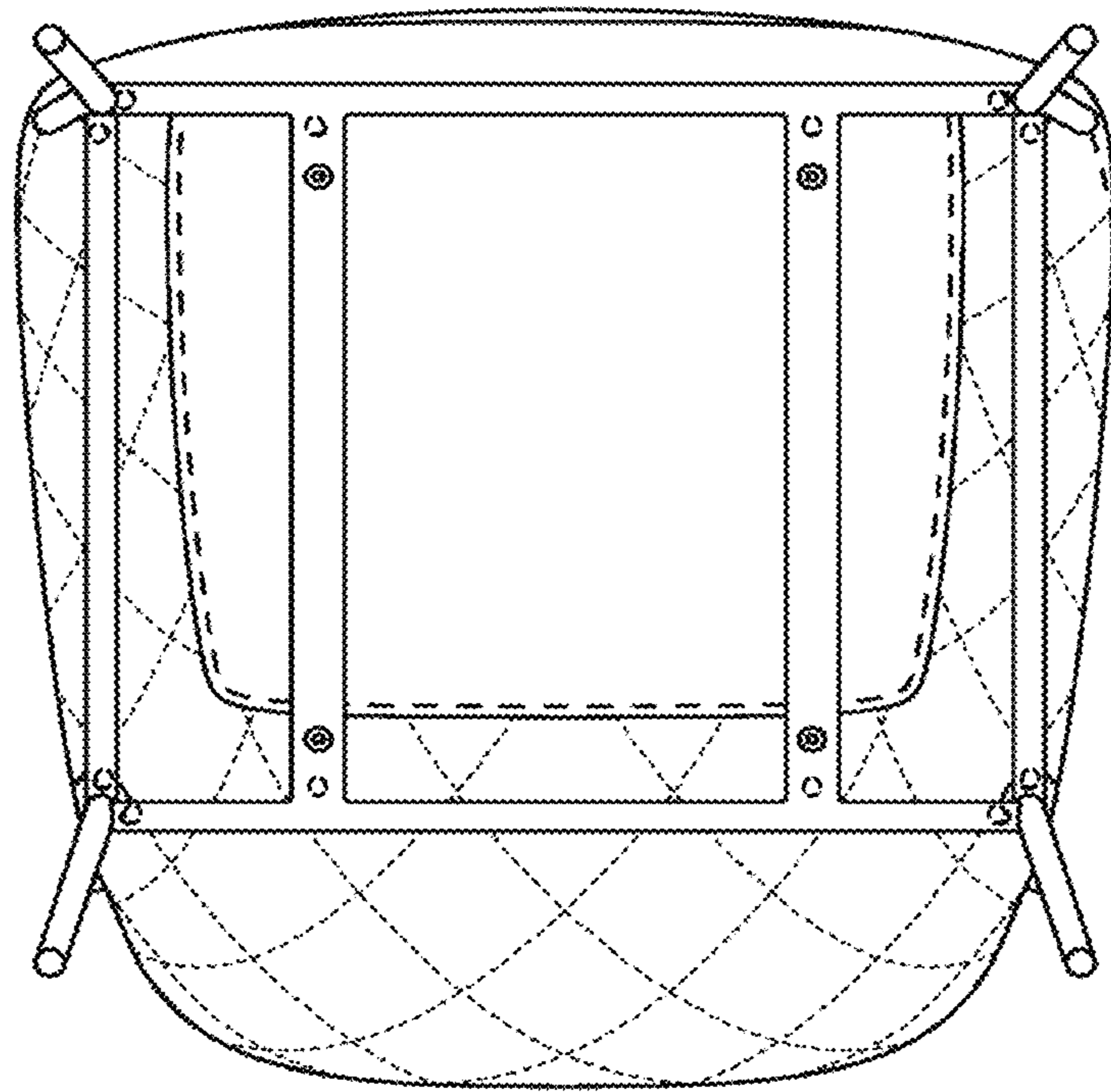
